The ornamental design for a machine for earth-moving,
material handling, lifting, and/or construction, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right-side isometric view of a
machine for earth-moving, material handling, lifting, and/or
construction showing the new design.

FIG. 2 is an enlarged top, front, and right-side isometric
view of the part of the machine that bears the claimed
design.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the part seen in FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the part seen in FIG. 2.

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view of the part seen in FIG.
2.

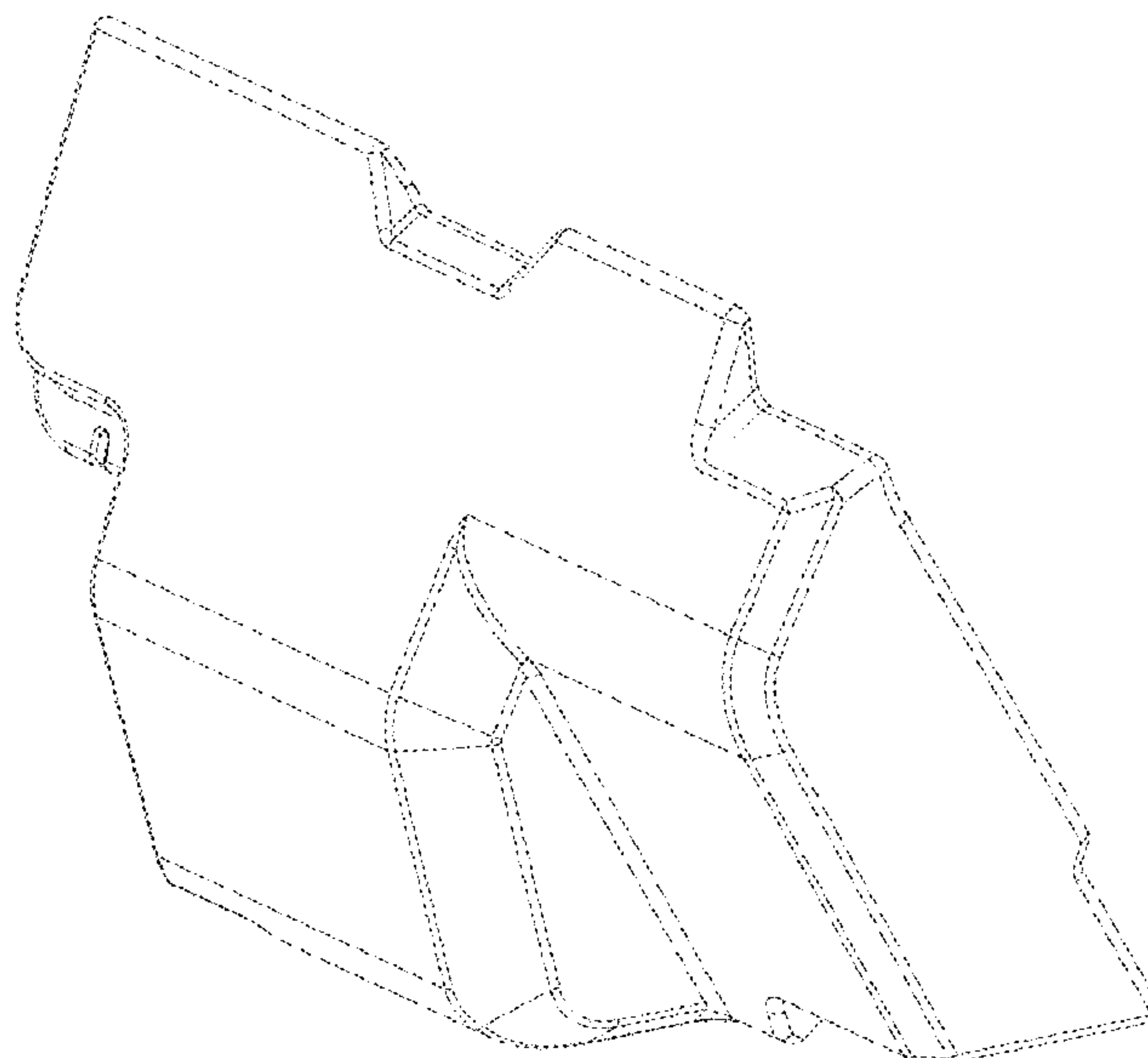
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the part seen in FIG. 2.

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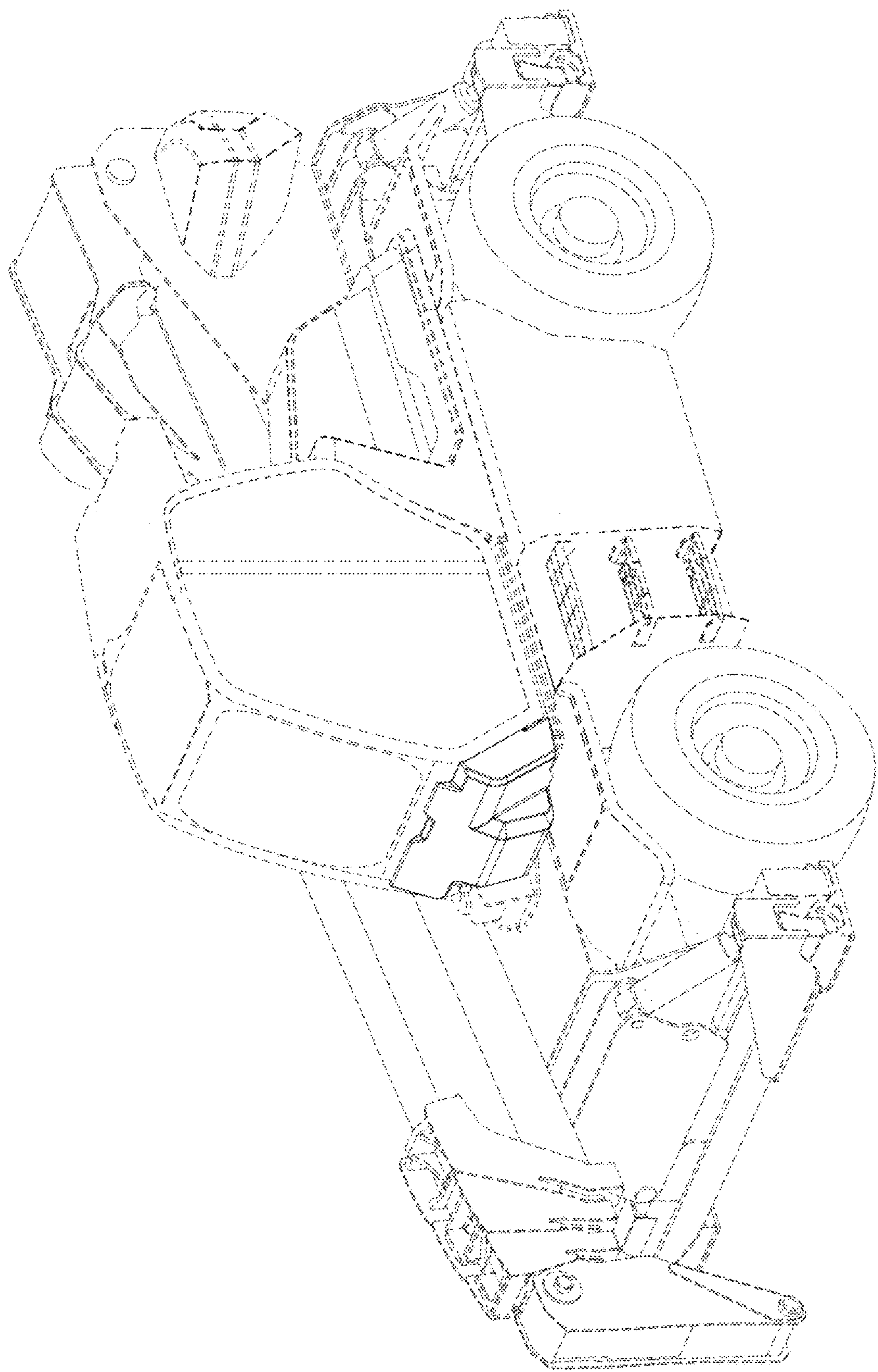

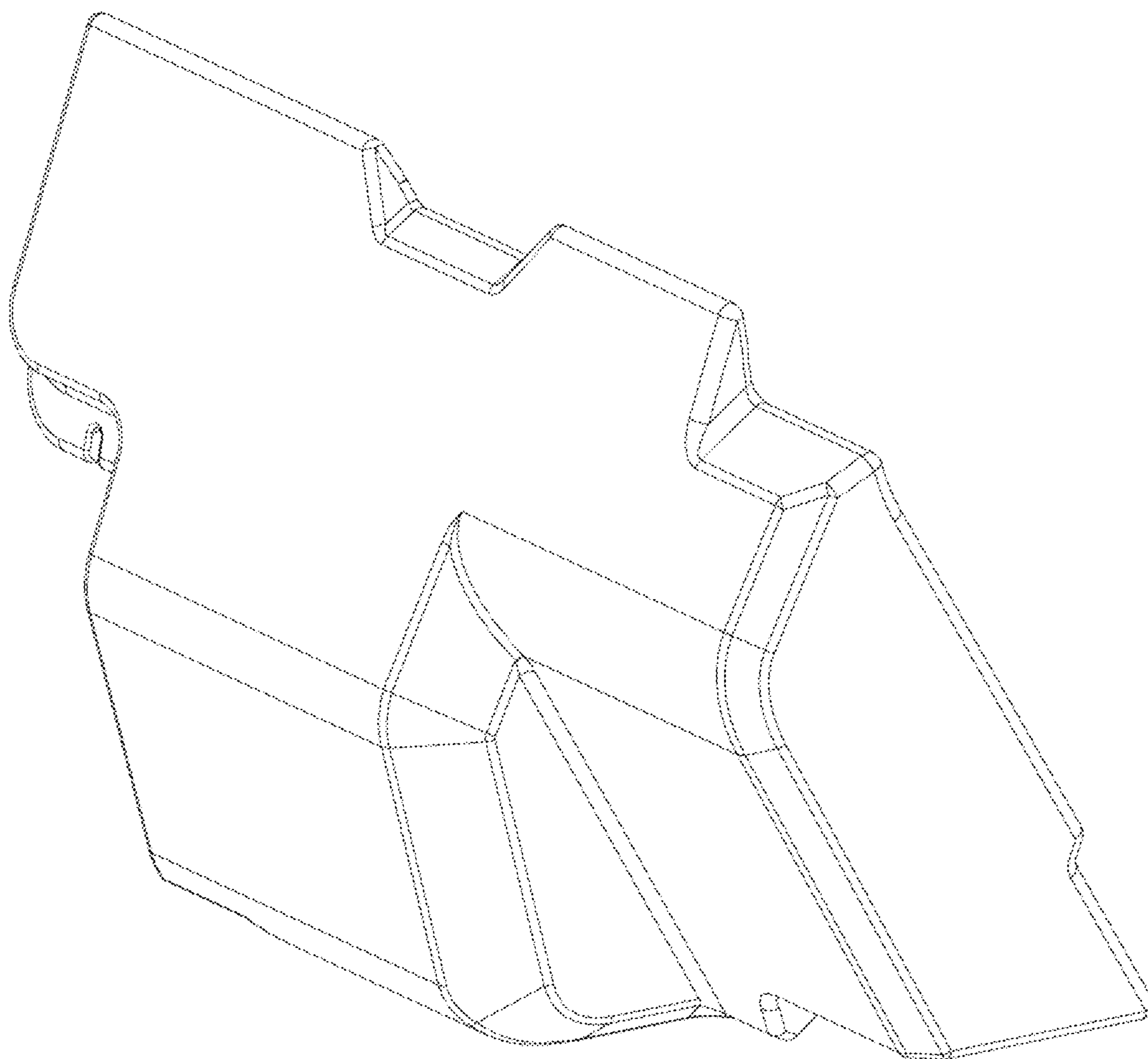

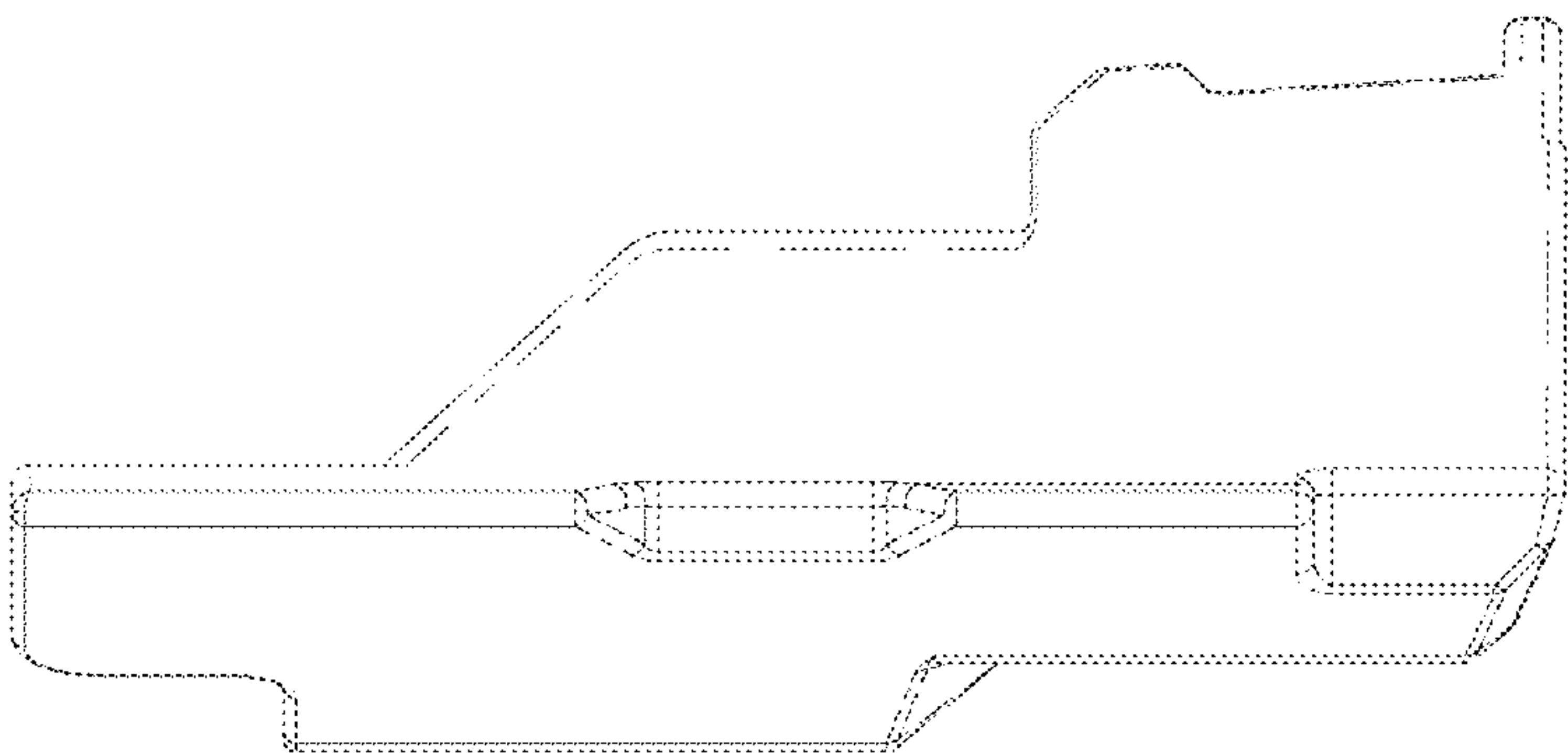

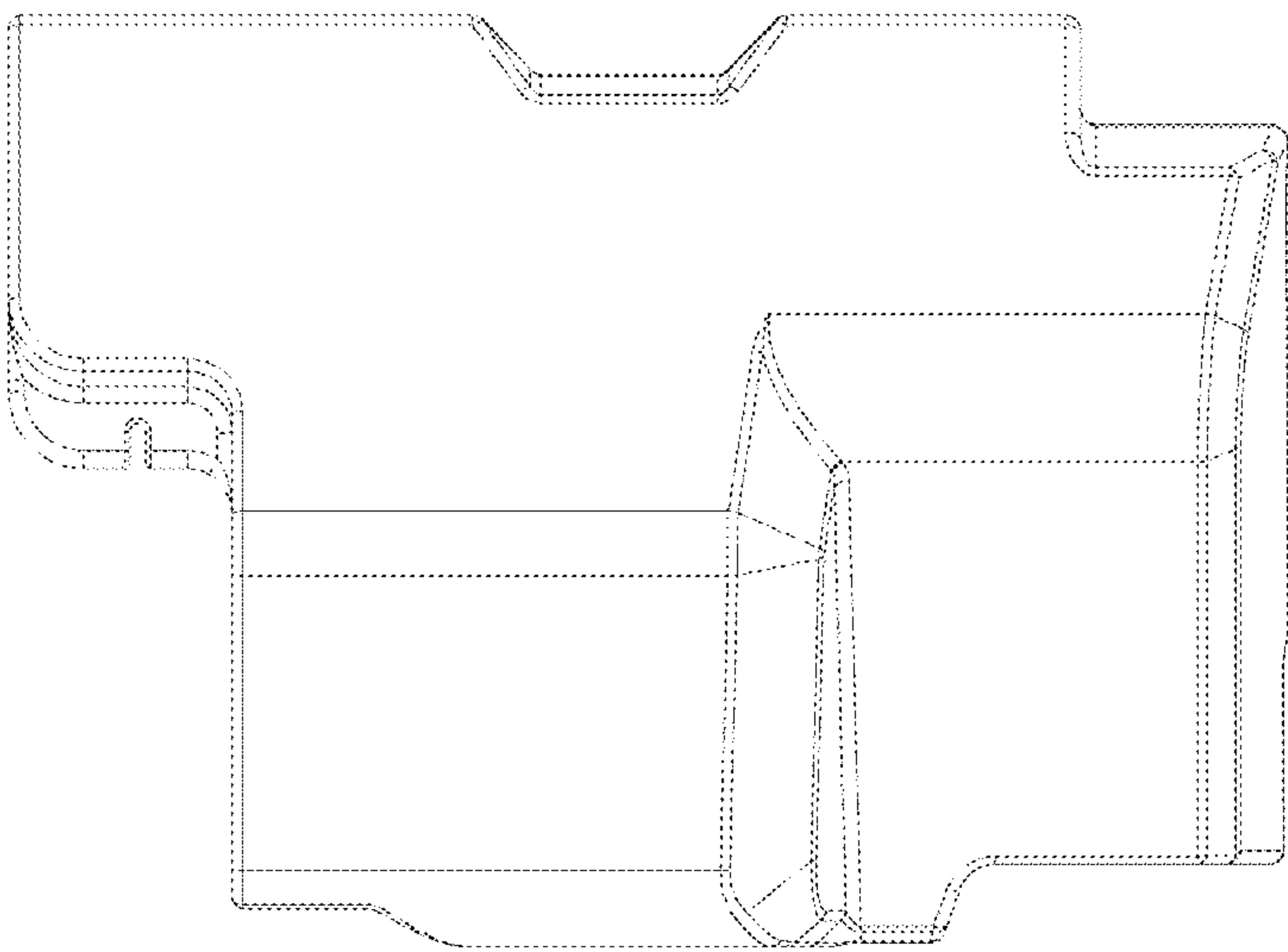

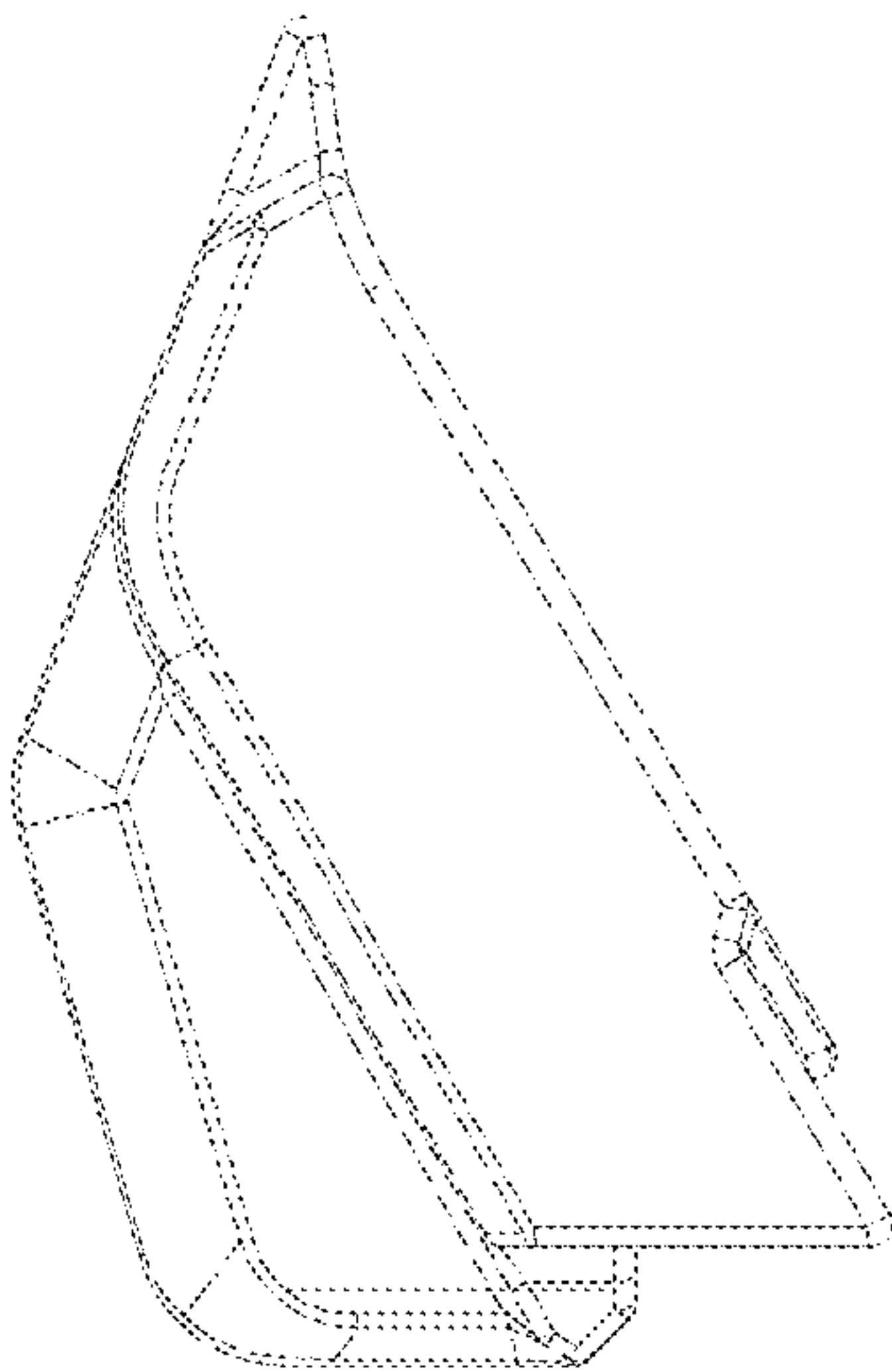

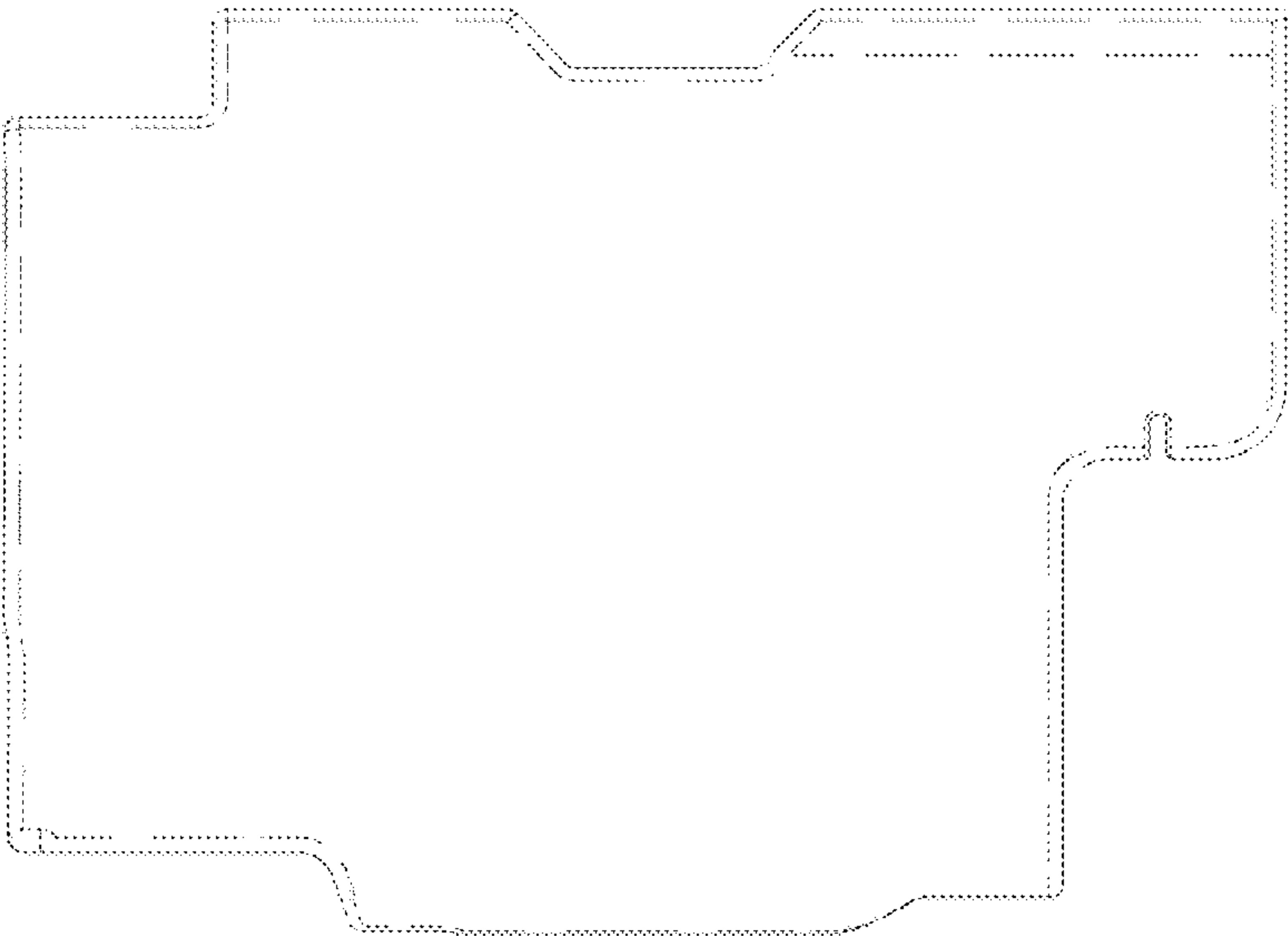

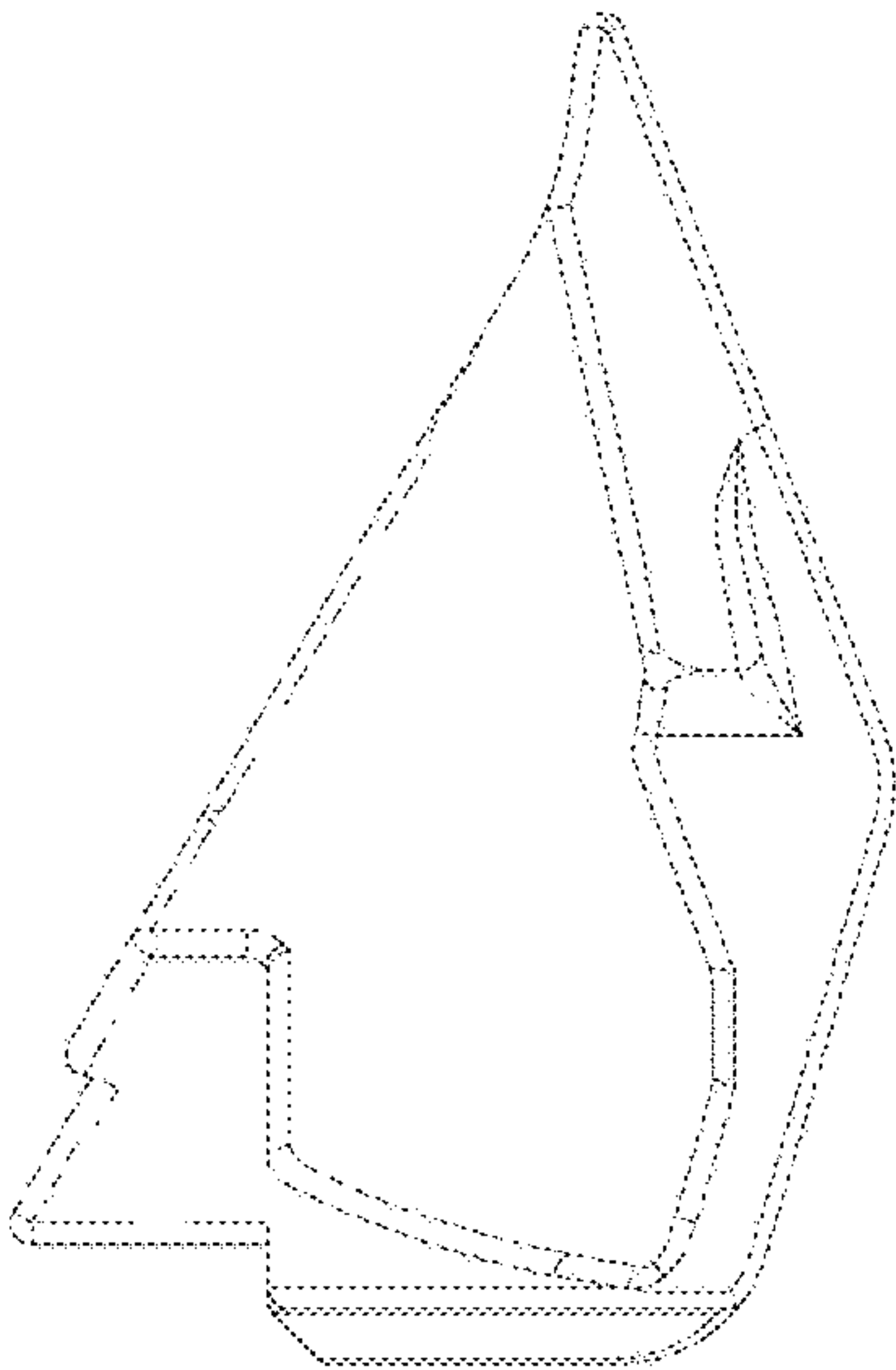

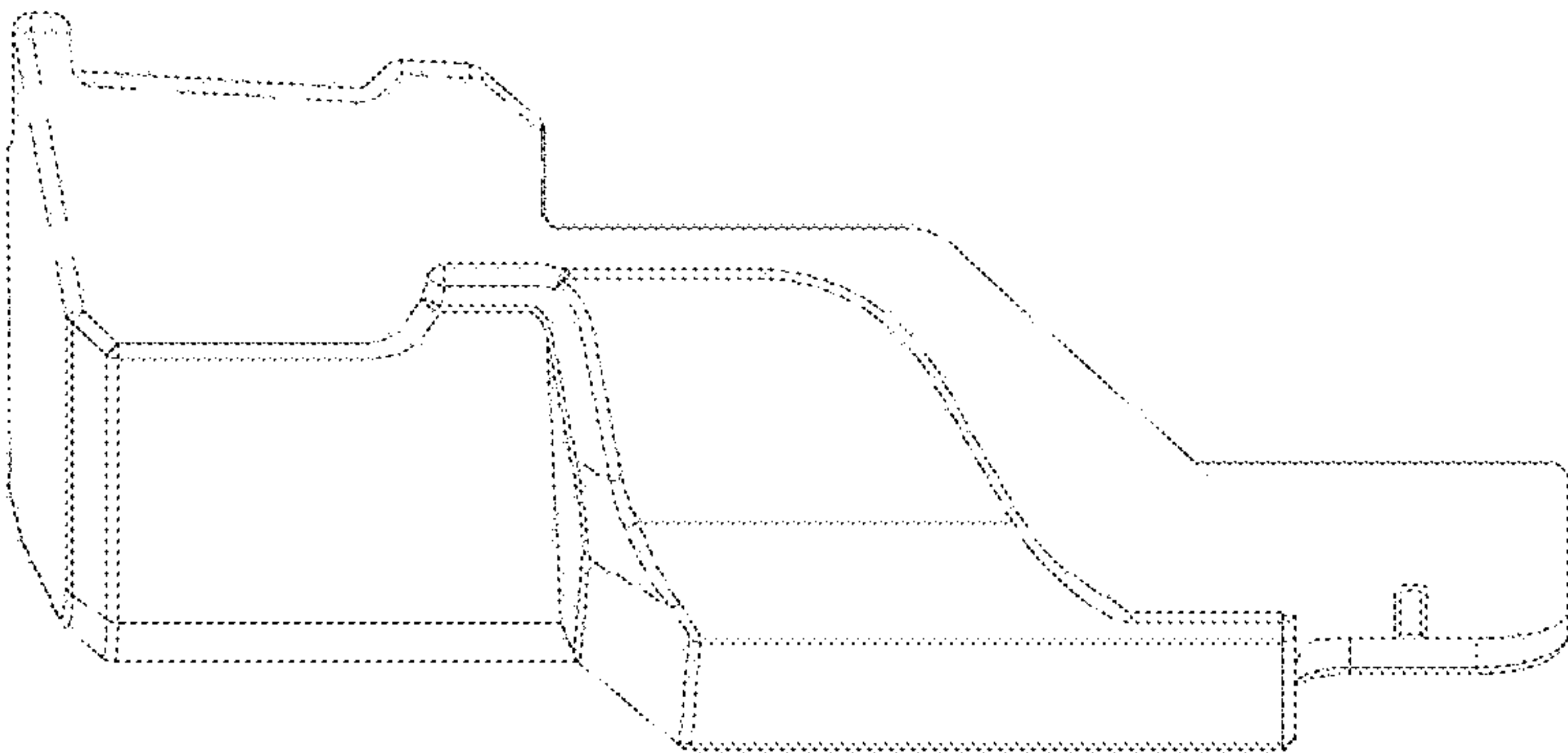
