FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a non-skid leg showing our new design, in a second embodiment.

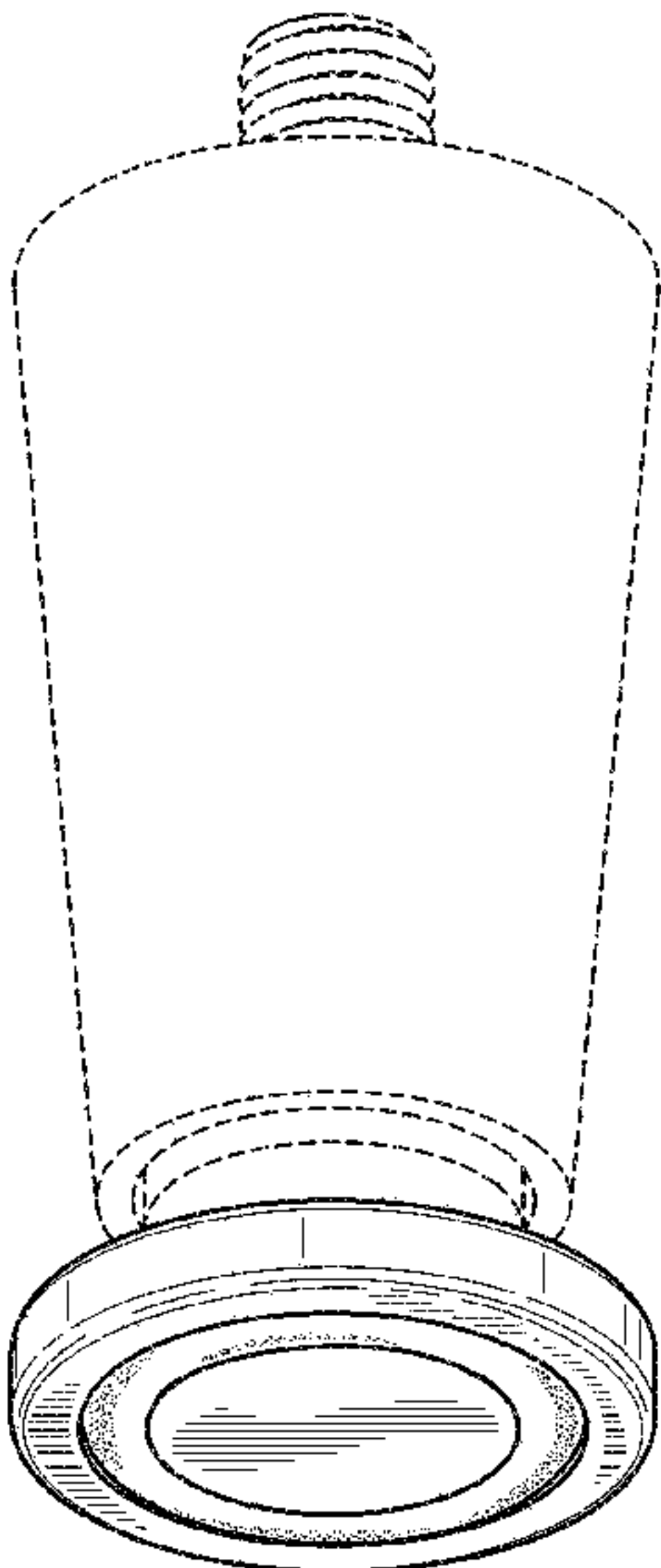
FIG. 6 is a front view thereof, the rear view, right side and left side view being the same thereof.

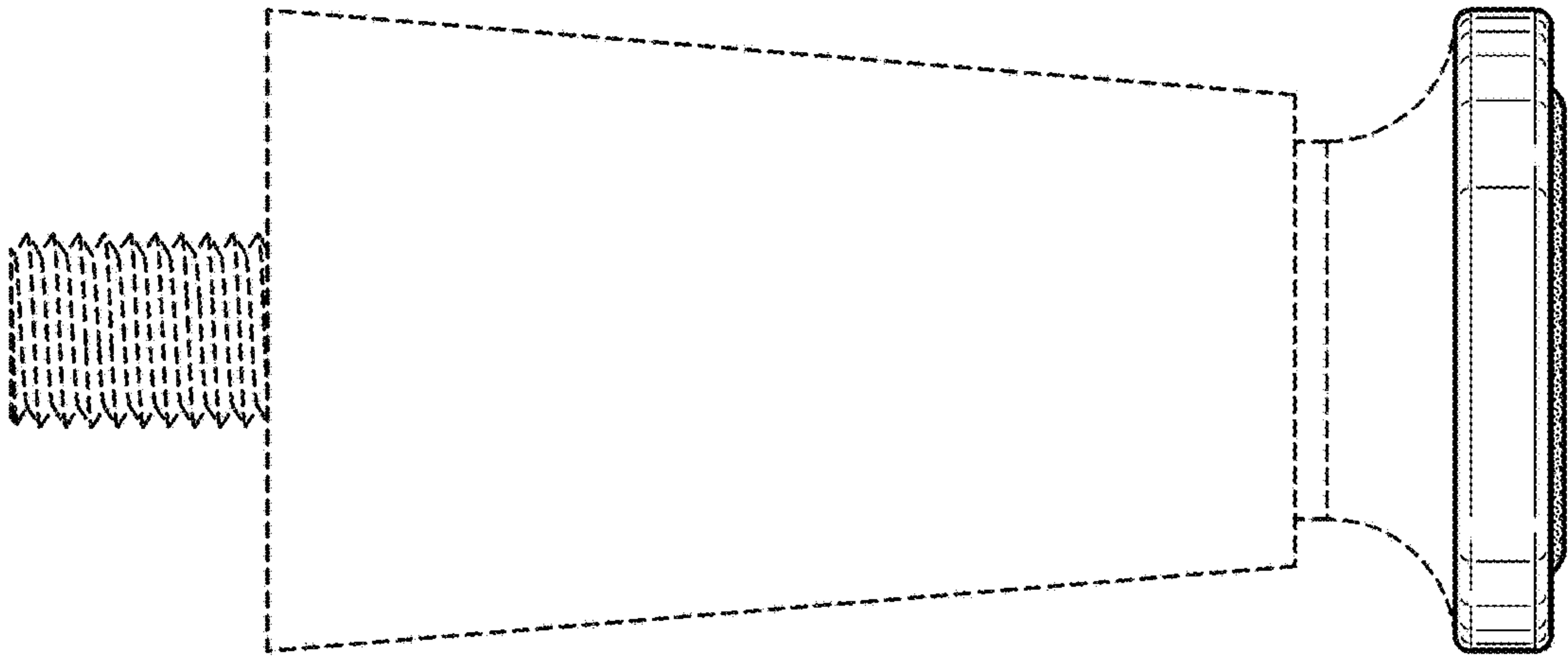

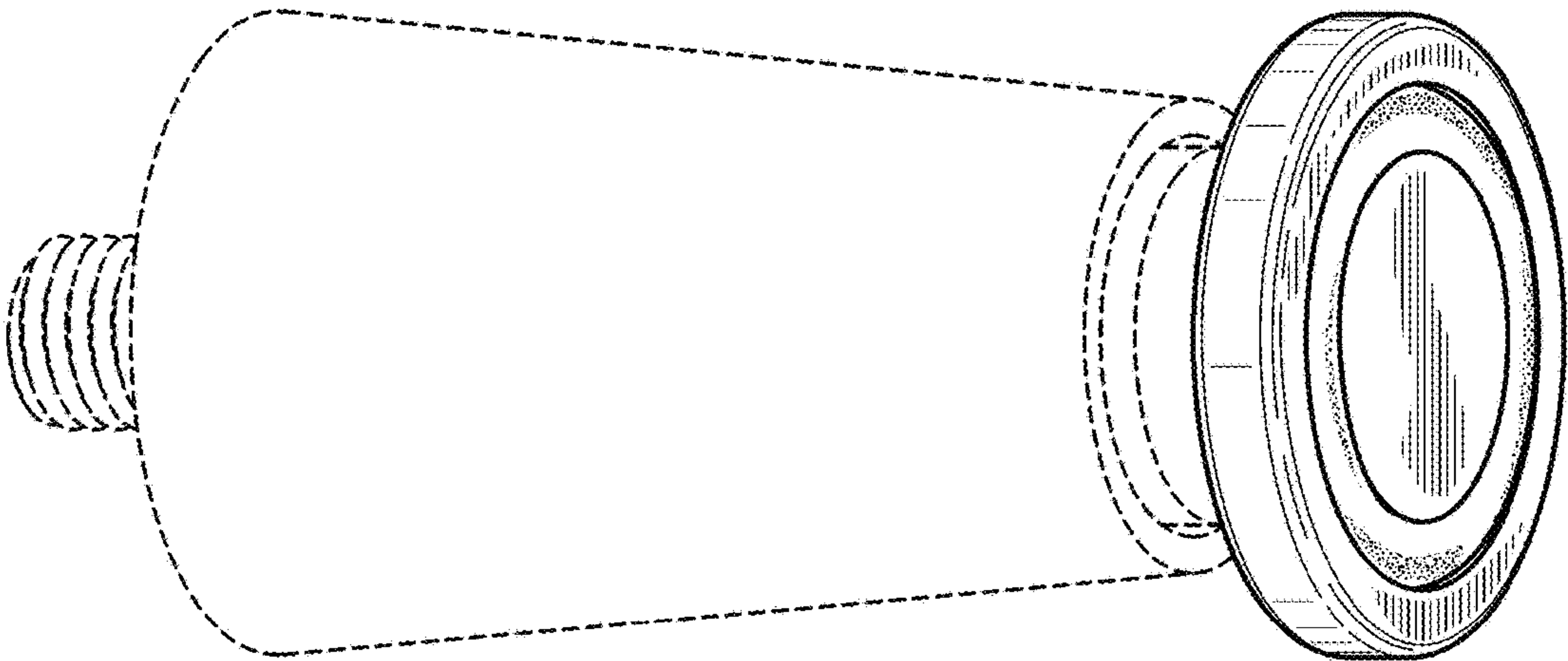

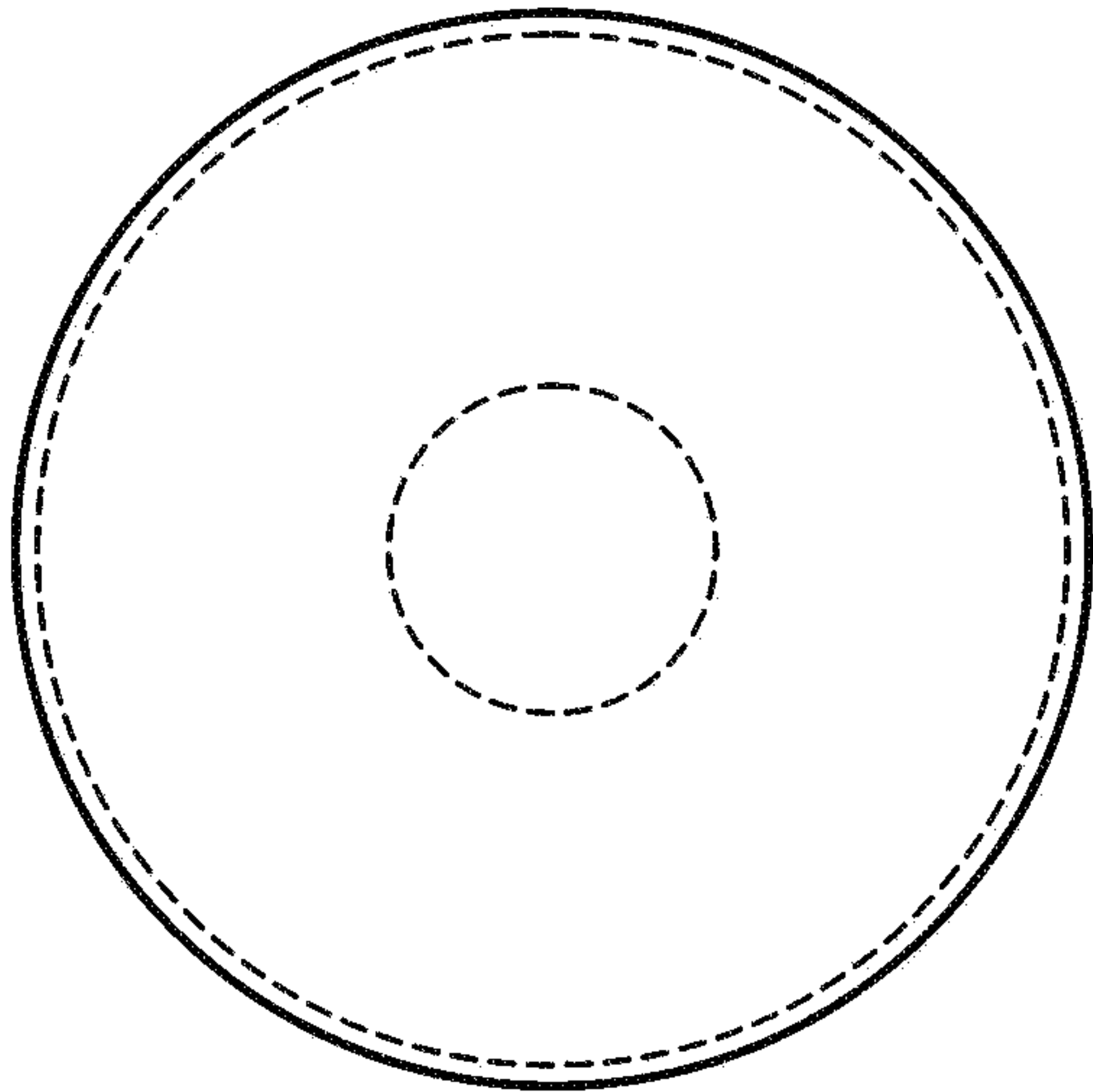

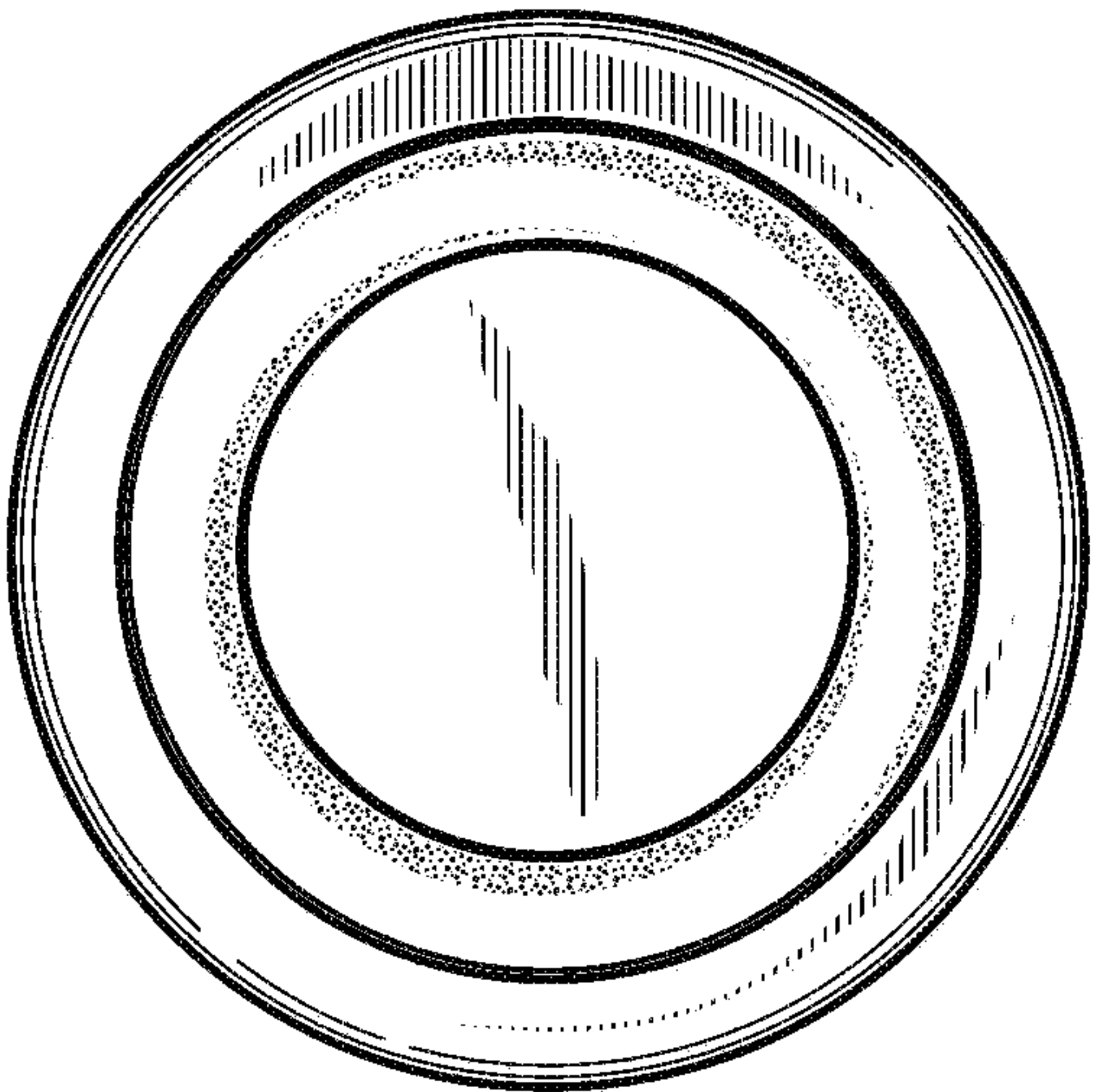

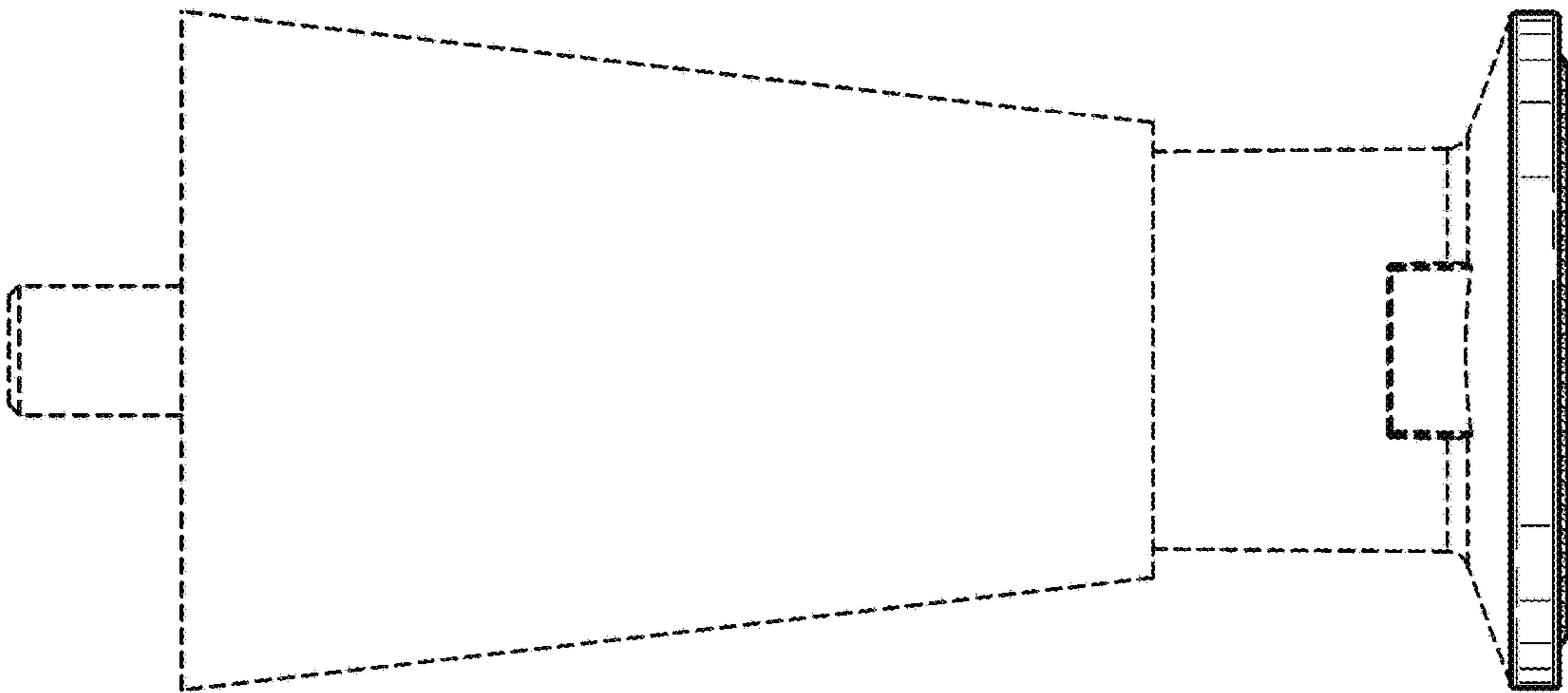

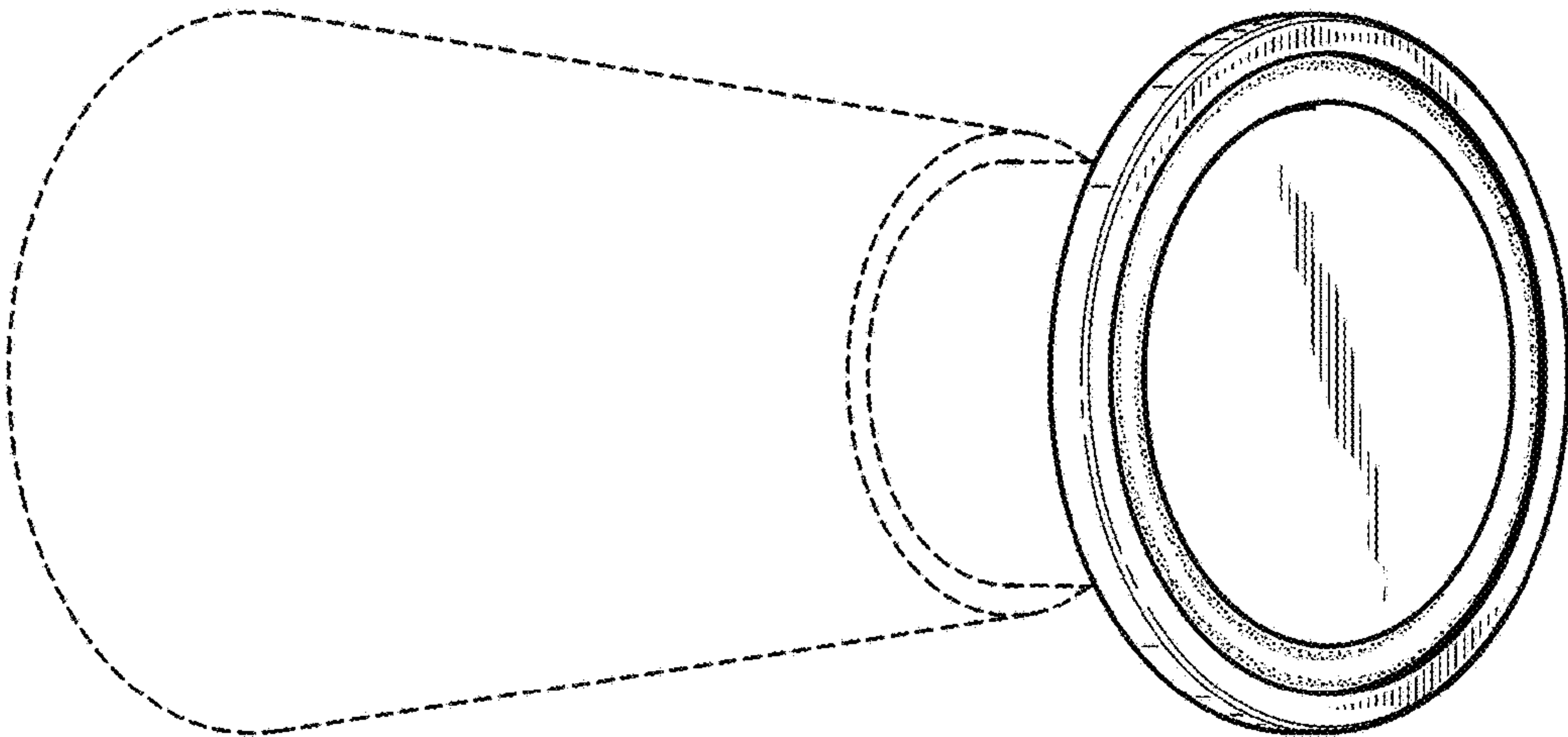

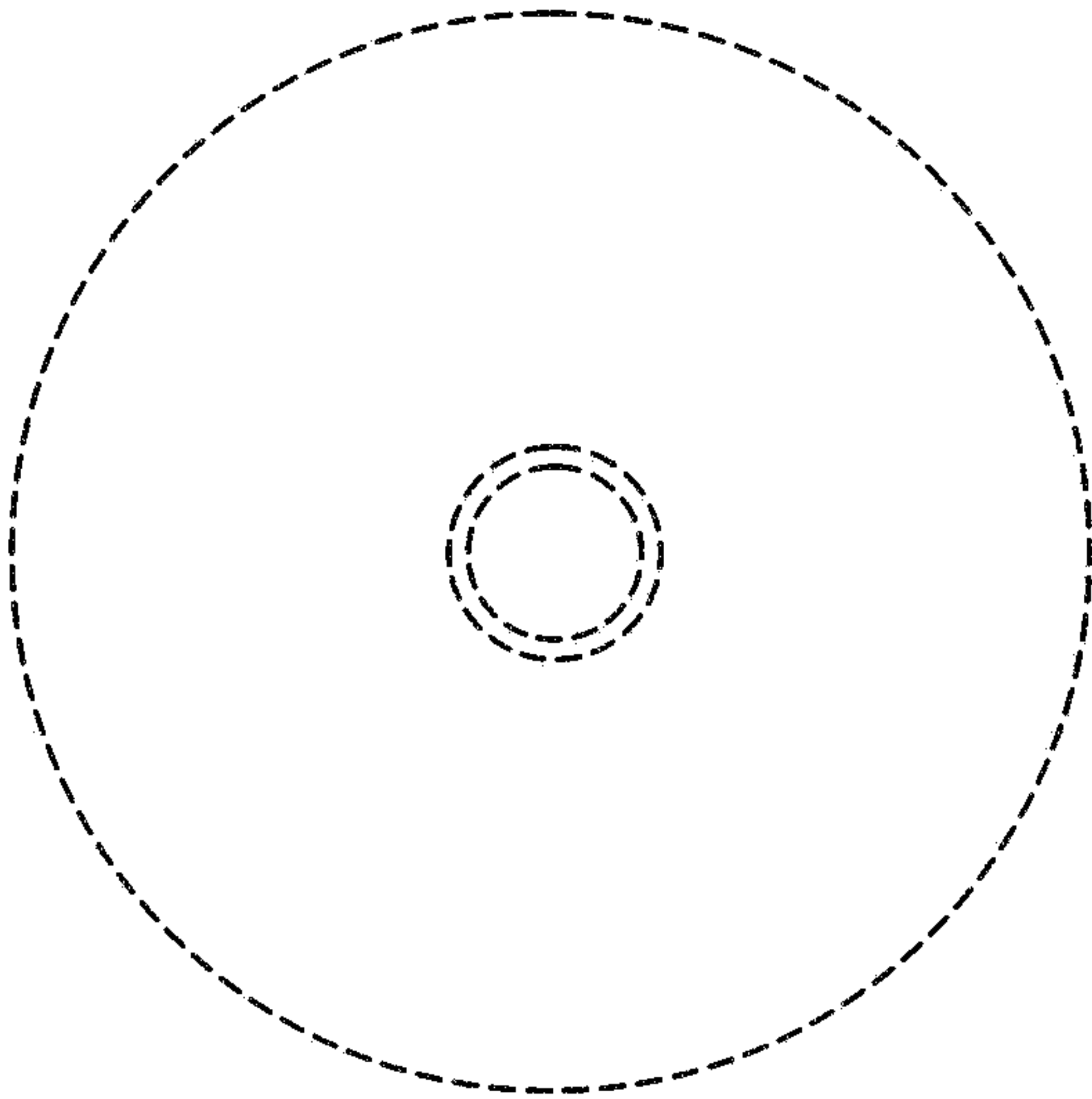

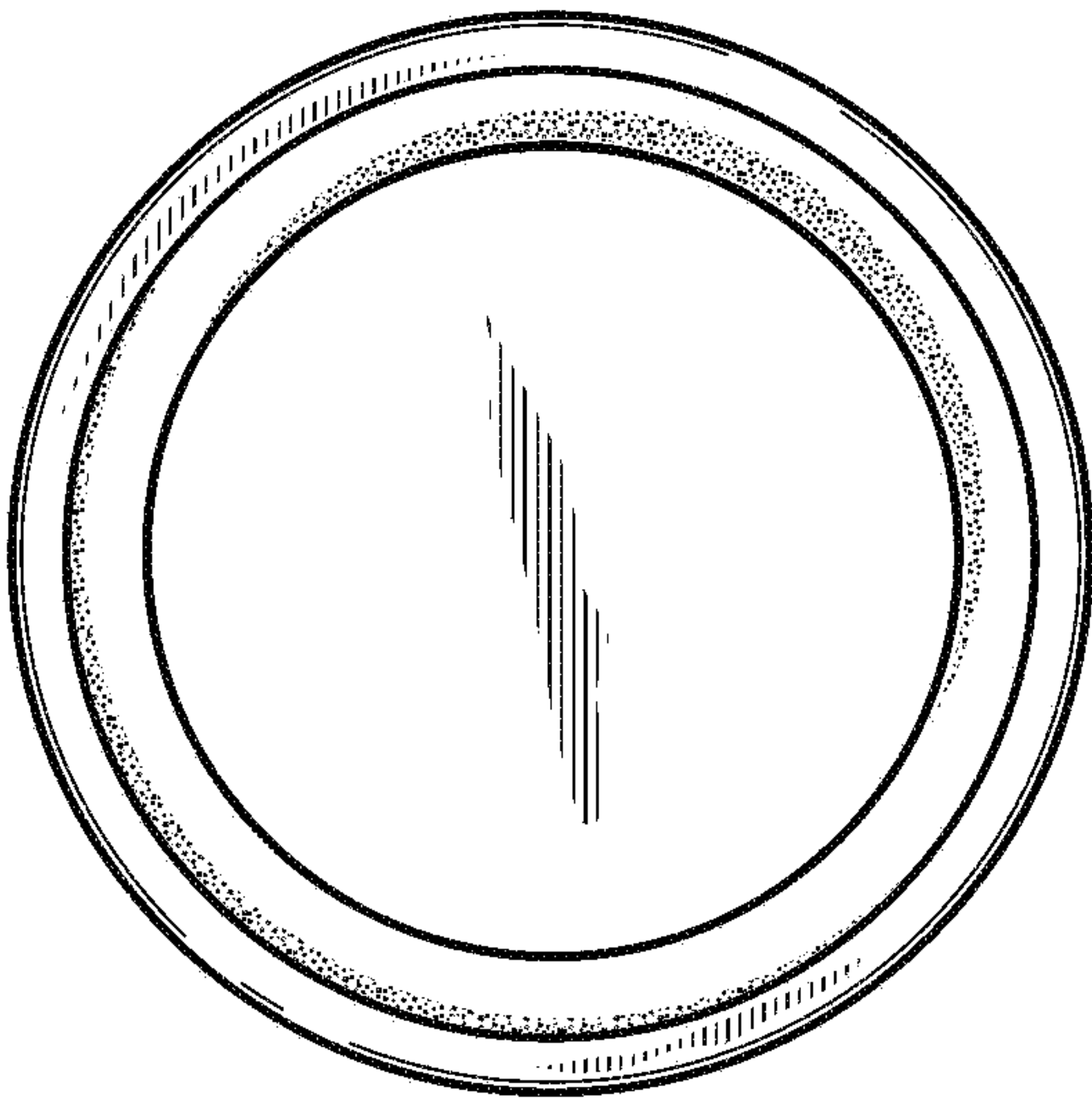
