FIG. 1 is a perspective view of spectacles showing my new design with the lens depicted as reflective based on the angle of viewing;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

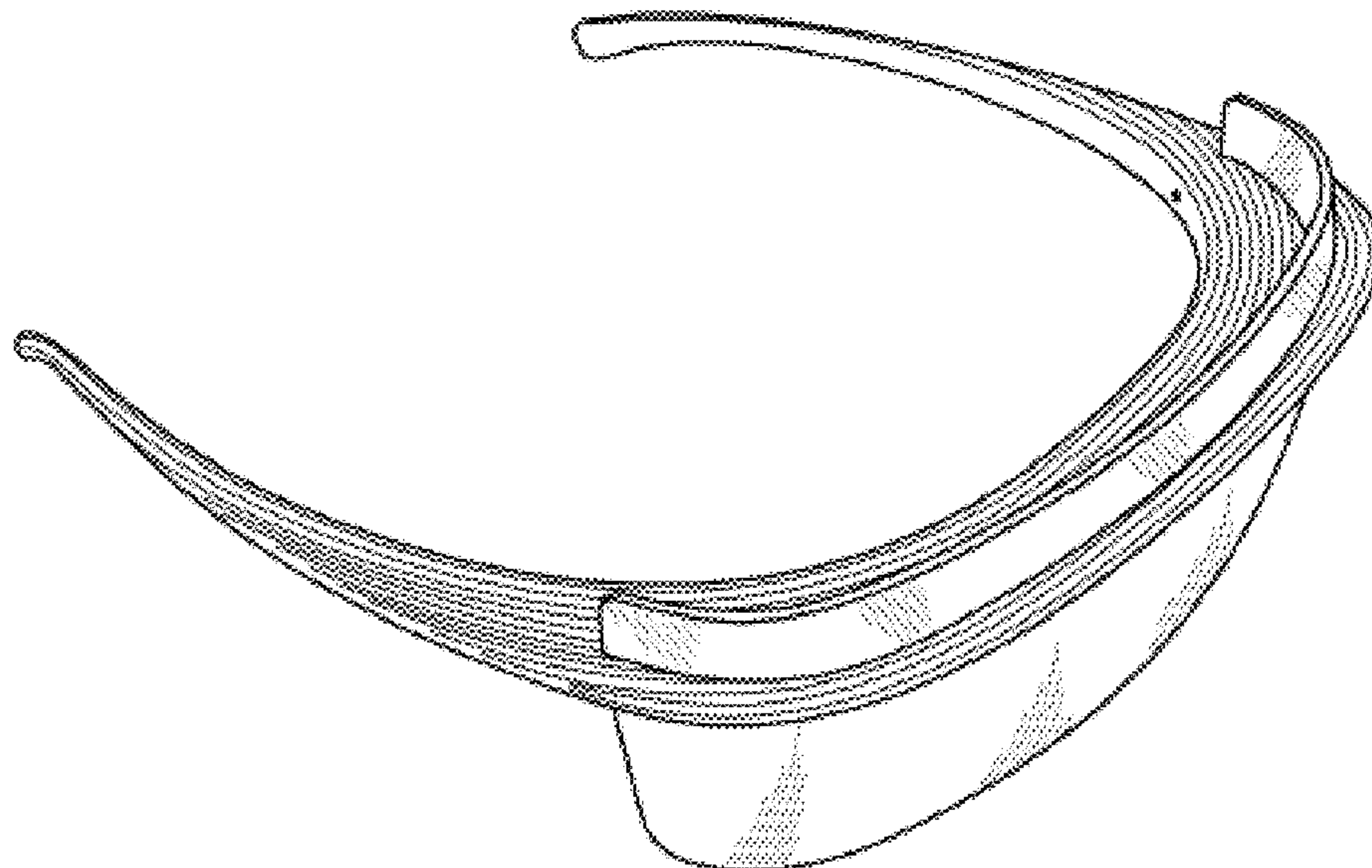
FIG. 3 is front view thereof;

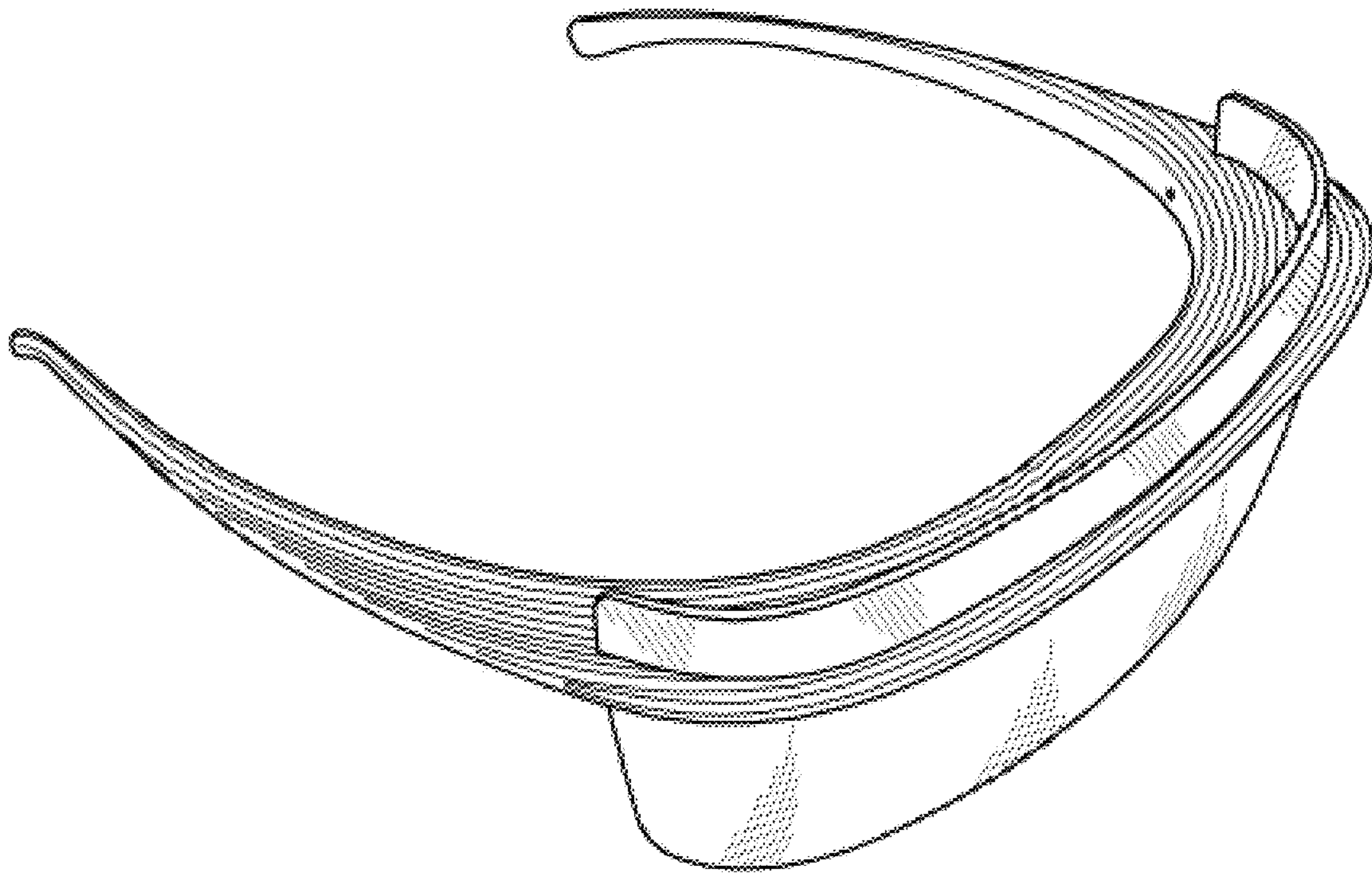

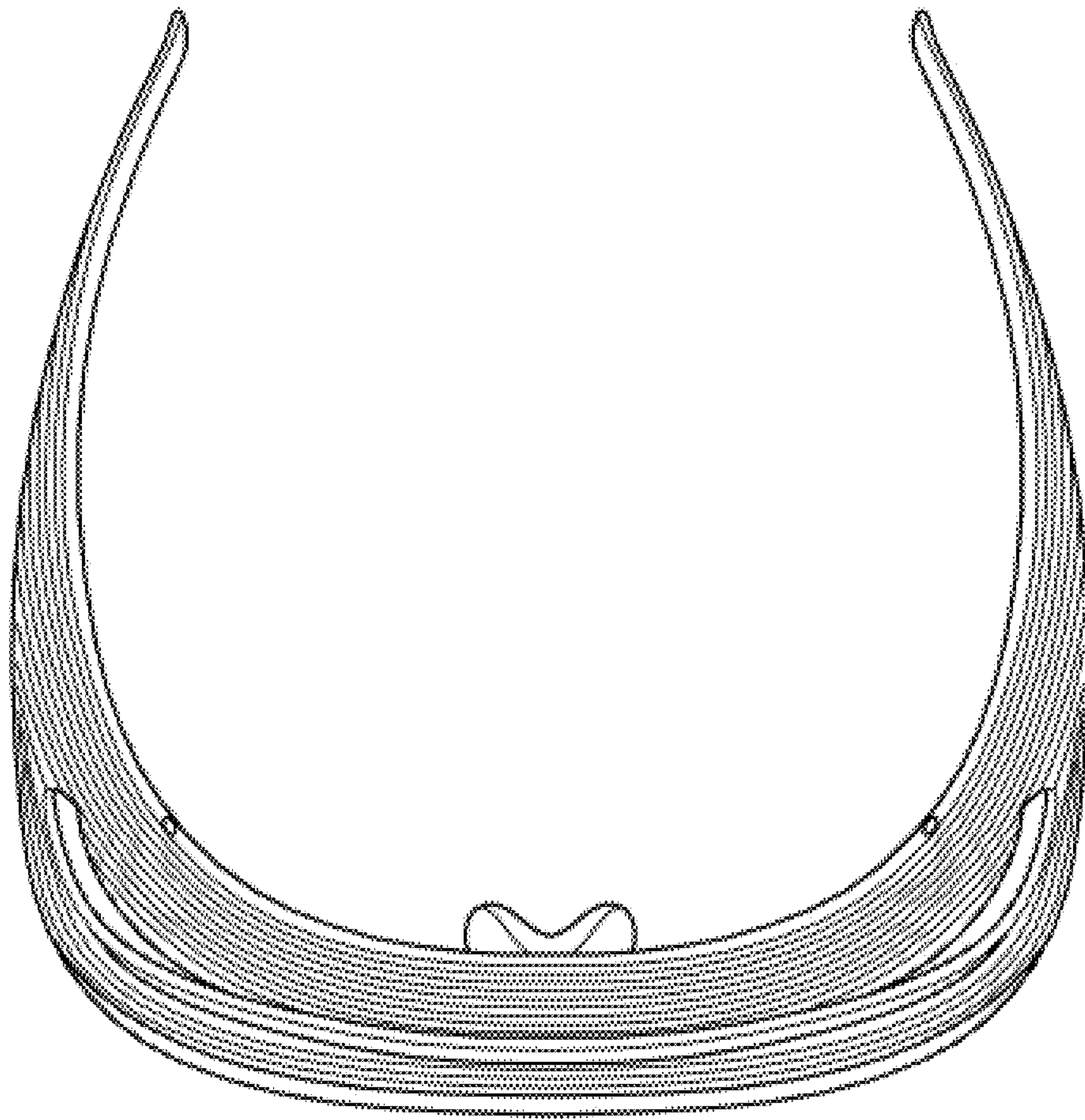

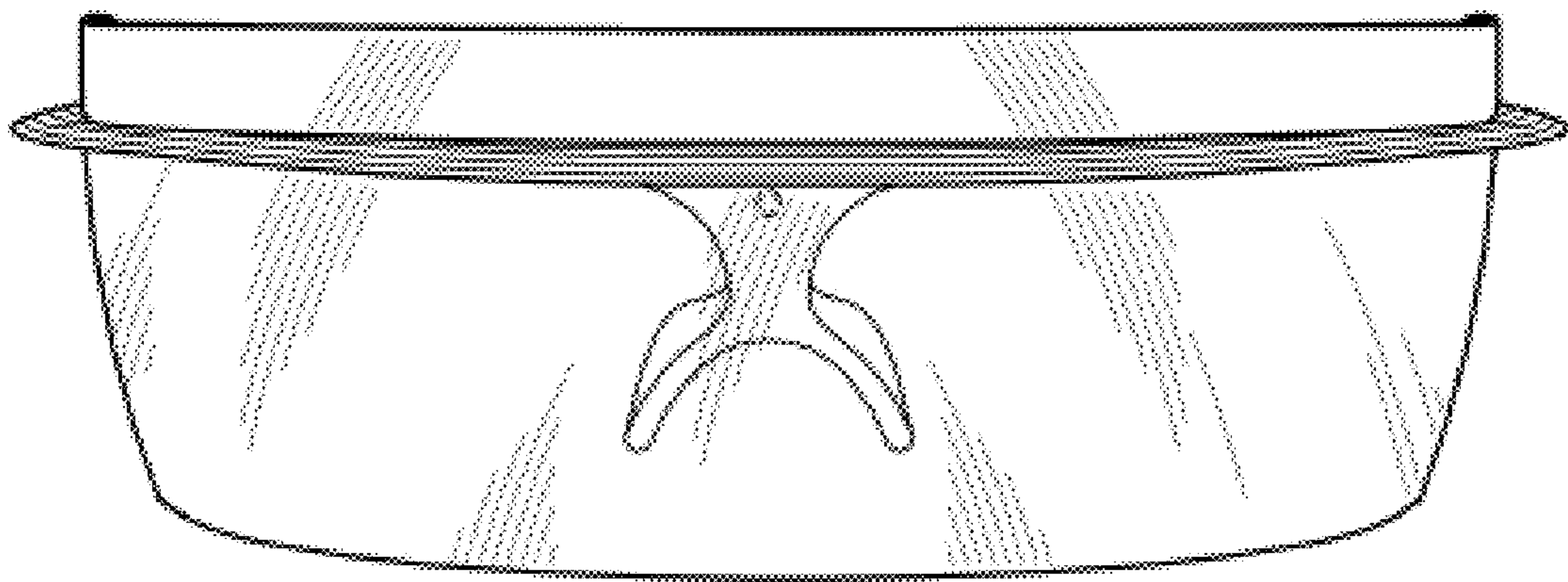

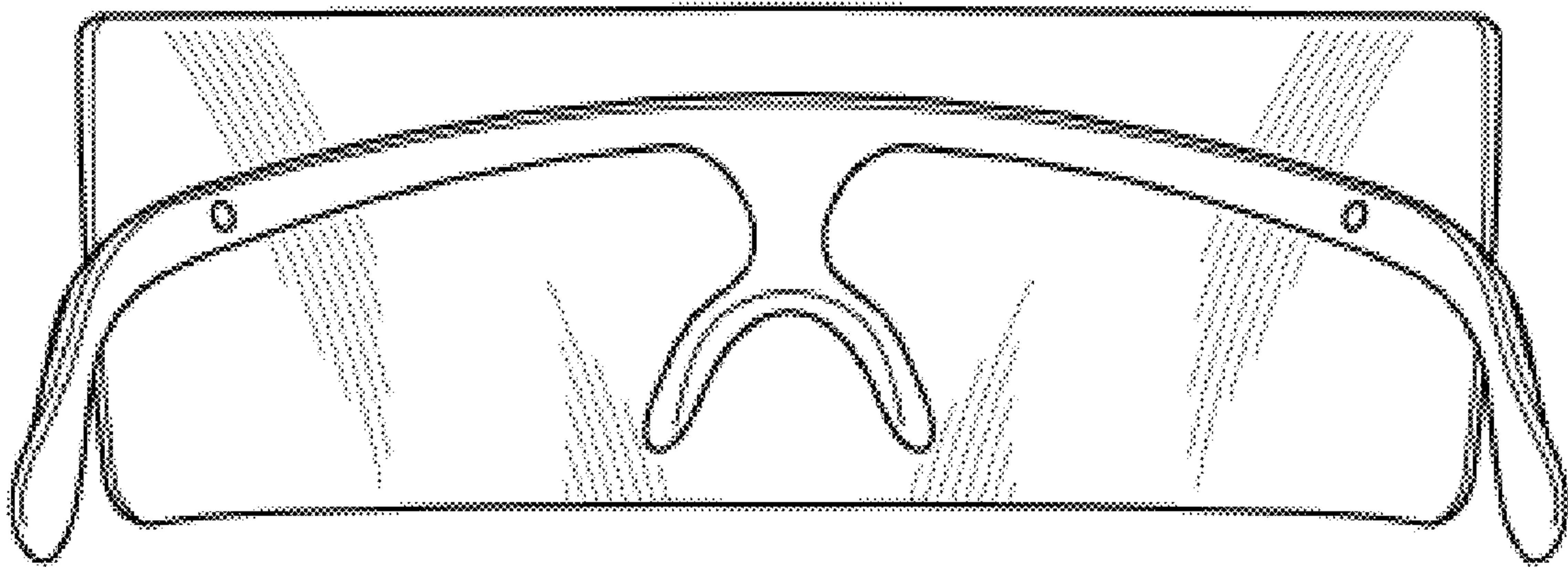

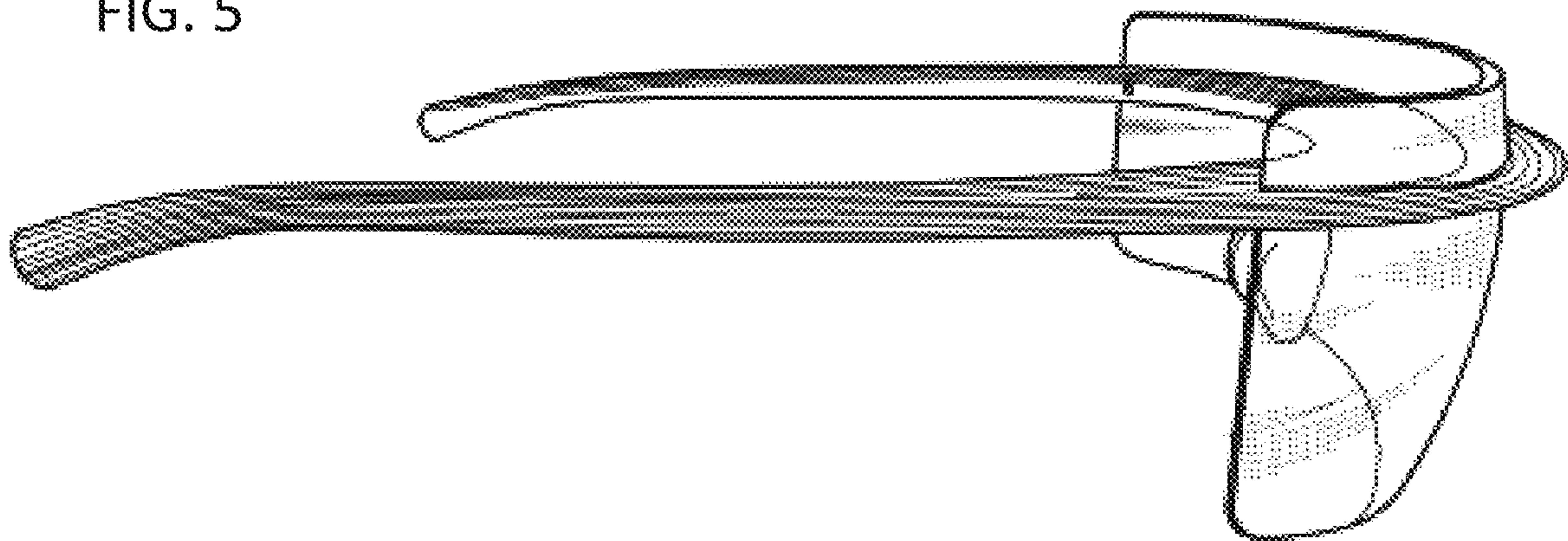
