DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ring holder.

FIG. 2 is a plane view of the front the ring holder shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a plane view of the back of the ring holder shown in FIG. 1

FIG. 4 is a plane view of the top of the ring holder shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a plane view of the bottom of the ring holder shown in FIG. 1.


FIG. 6 is a plane view of the left side of the ring holder shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a plane view of the right side of the ring holder shown in FIG. 1.














