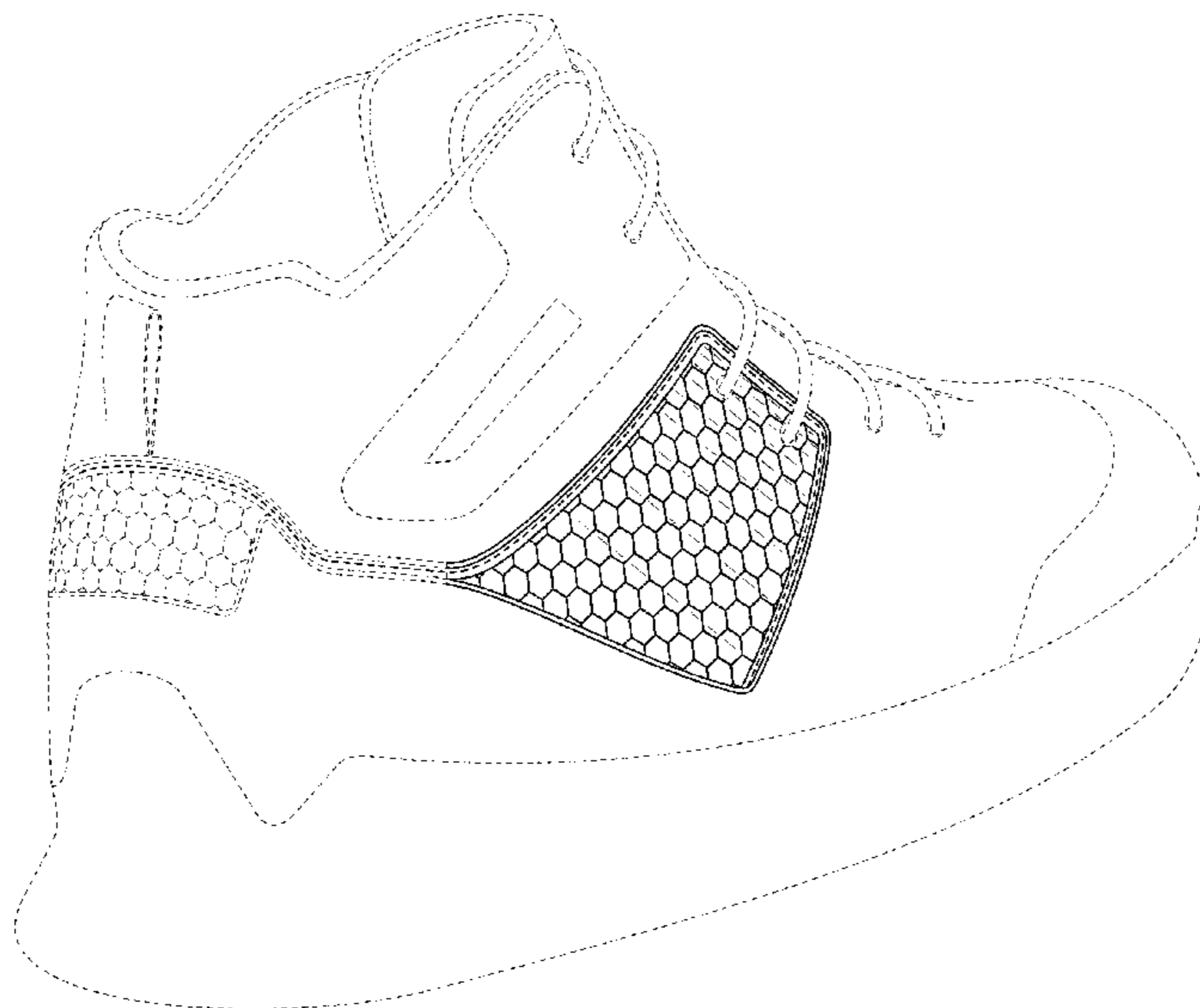
The ornamental design for shoe upper element, as shown and described.

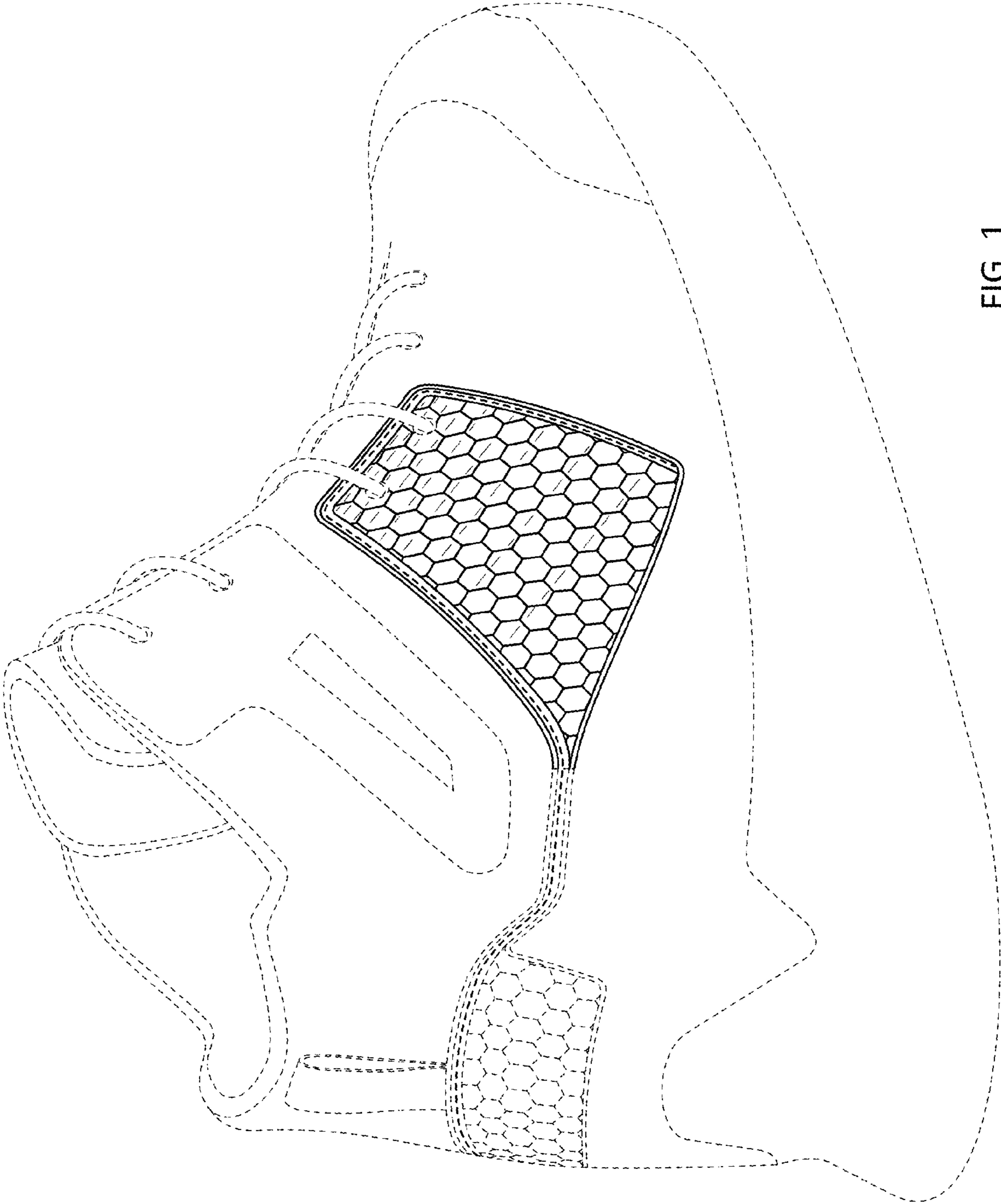

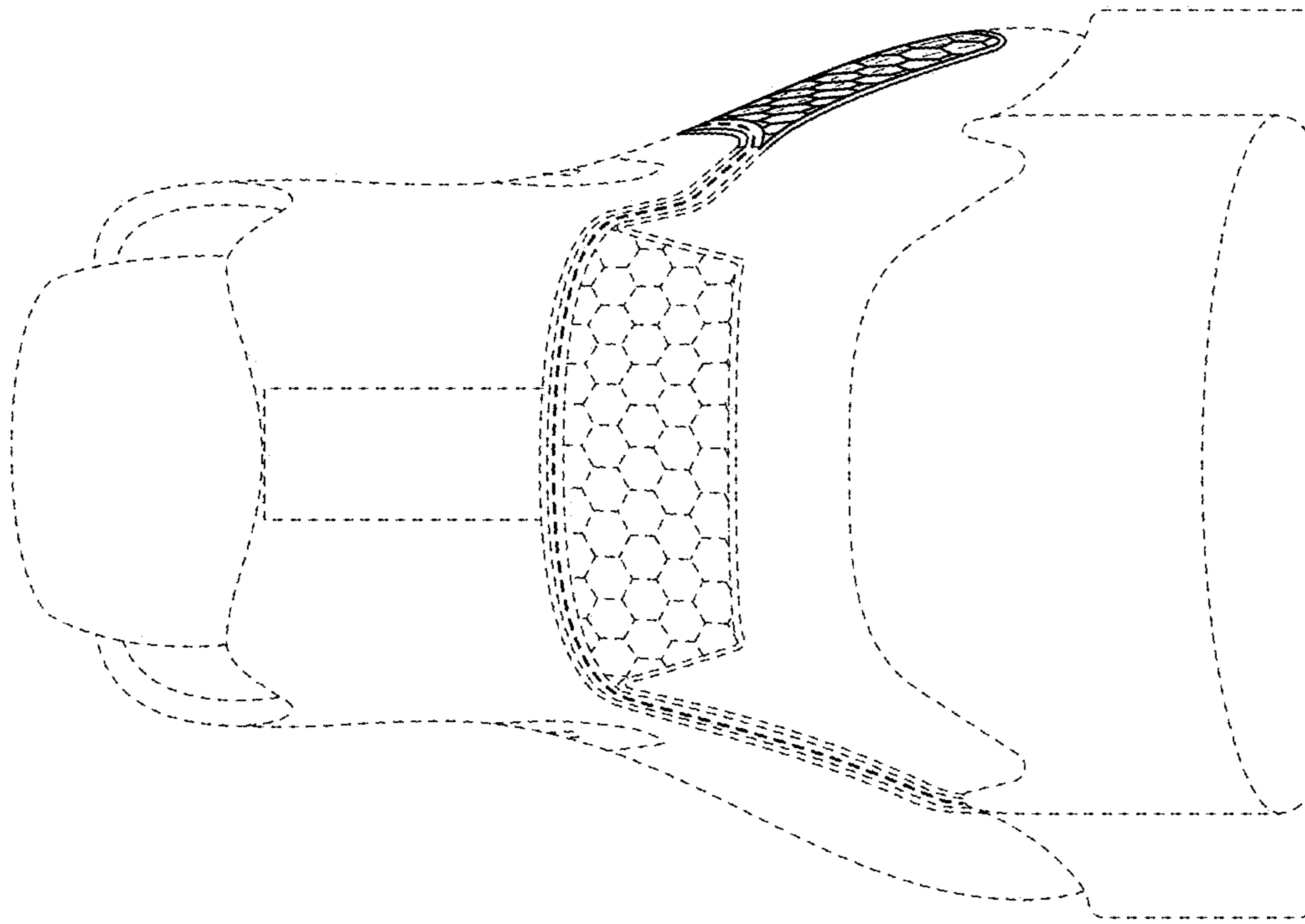

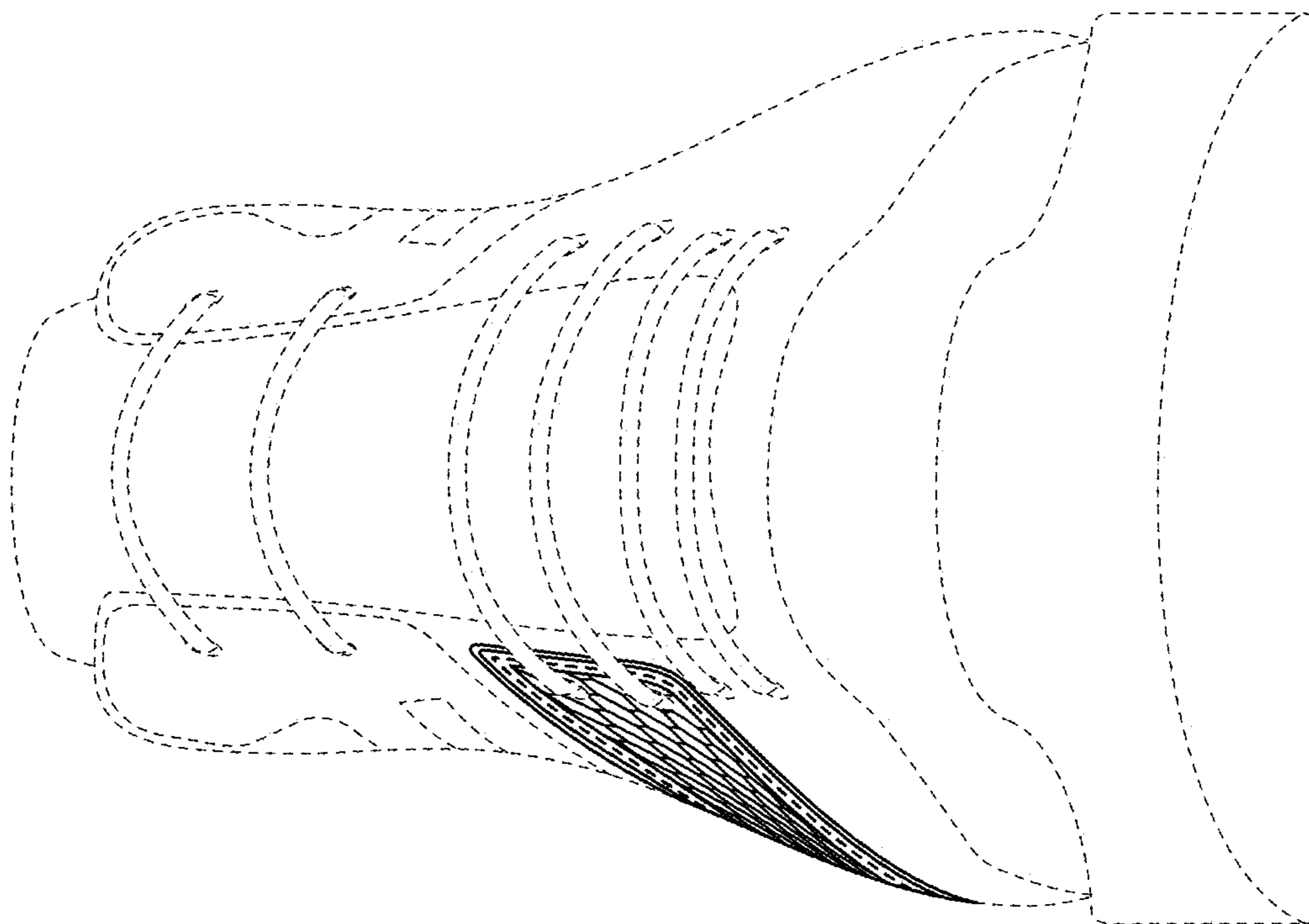

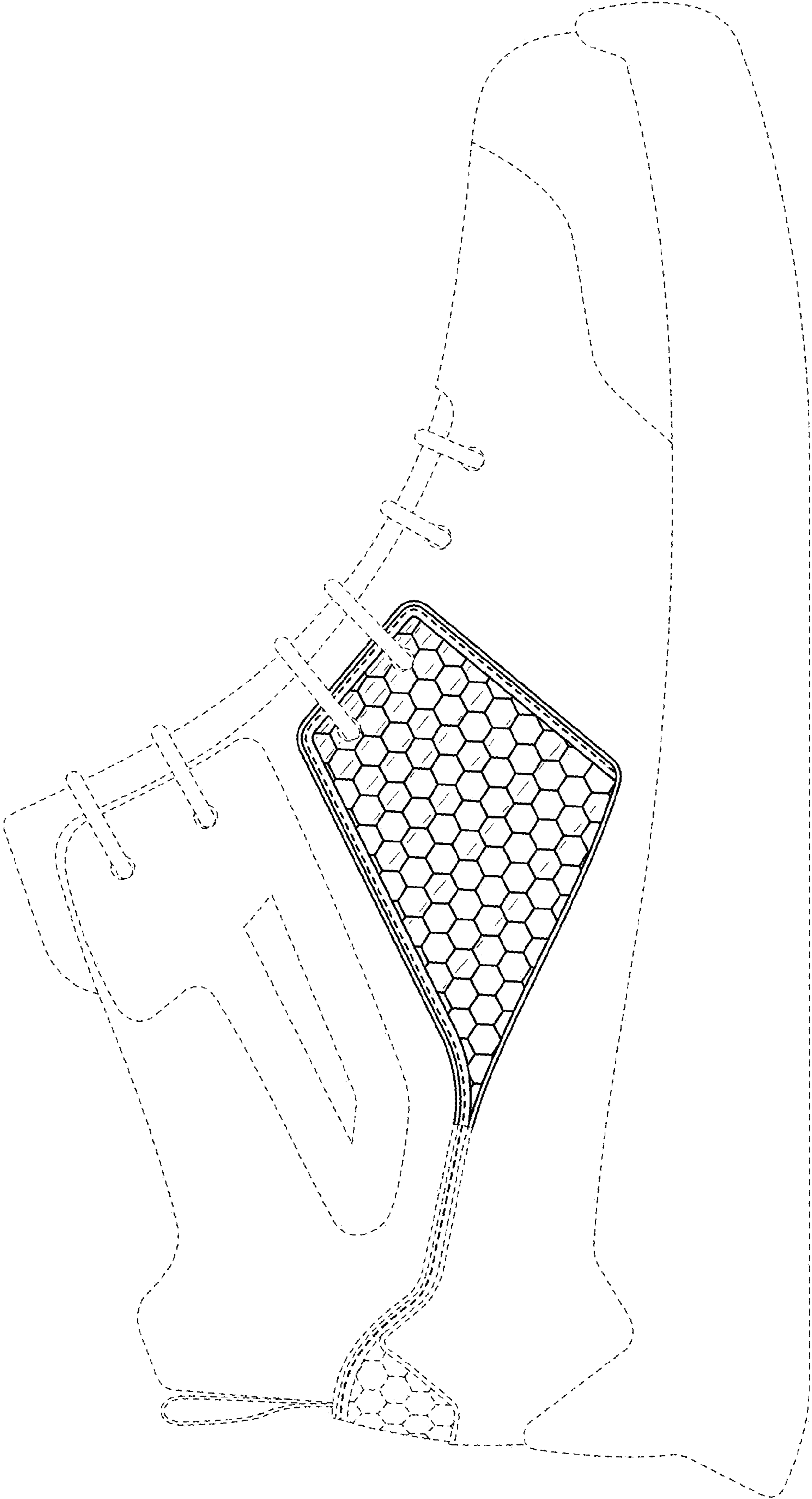

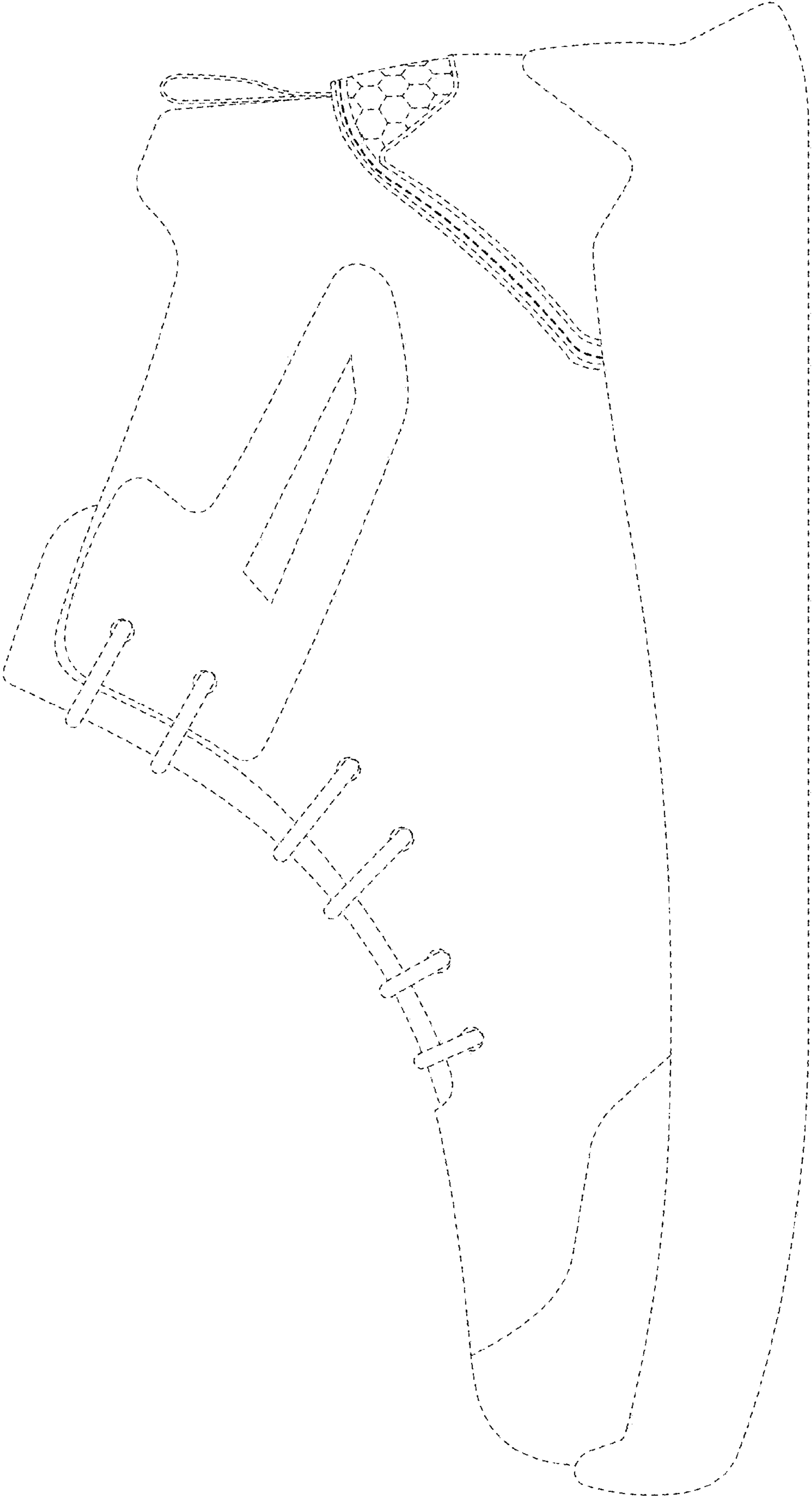

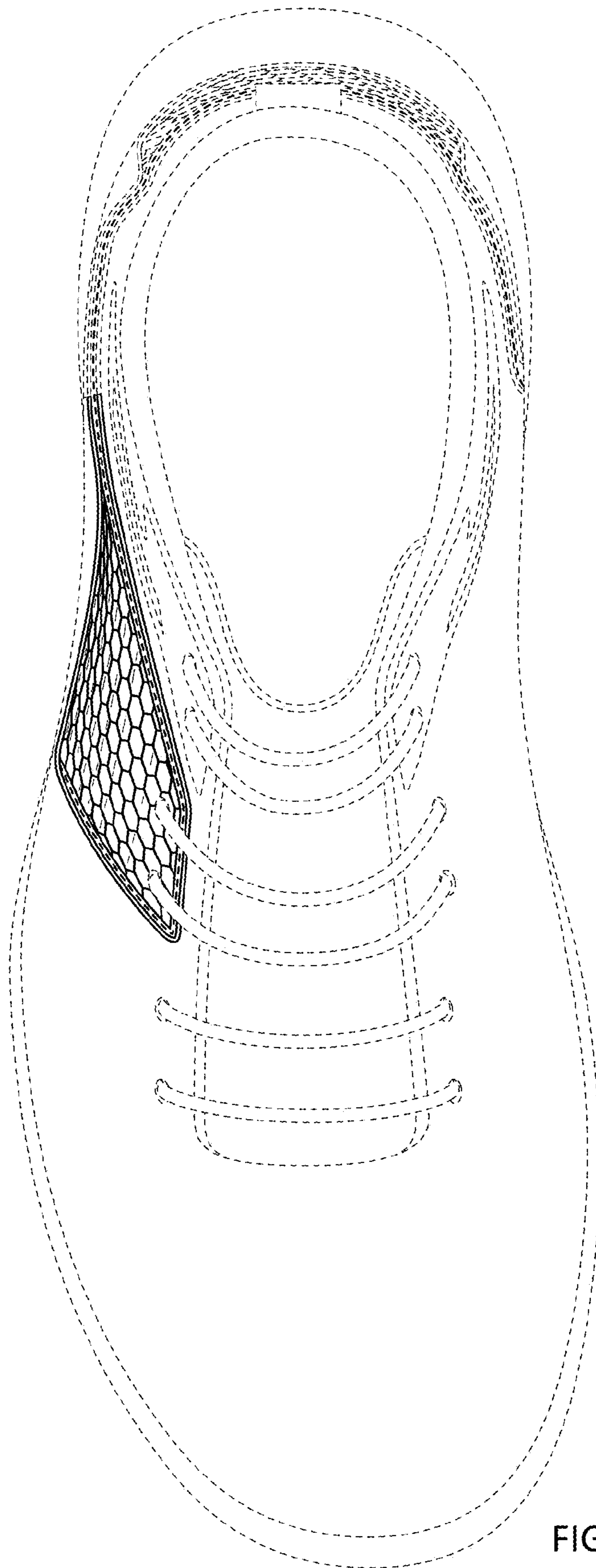

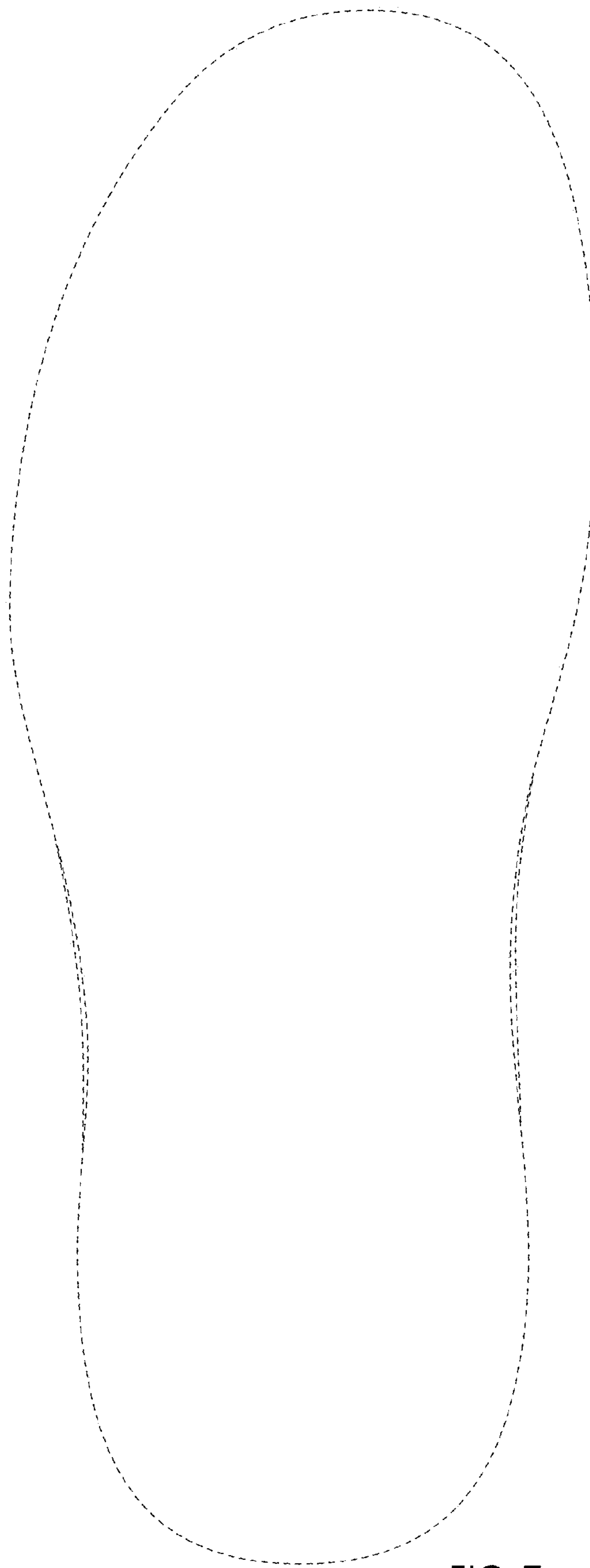
