FIG. 4 is a front view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

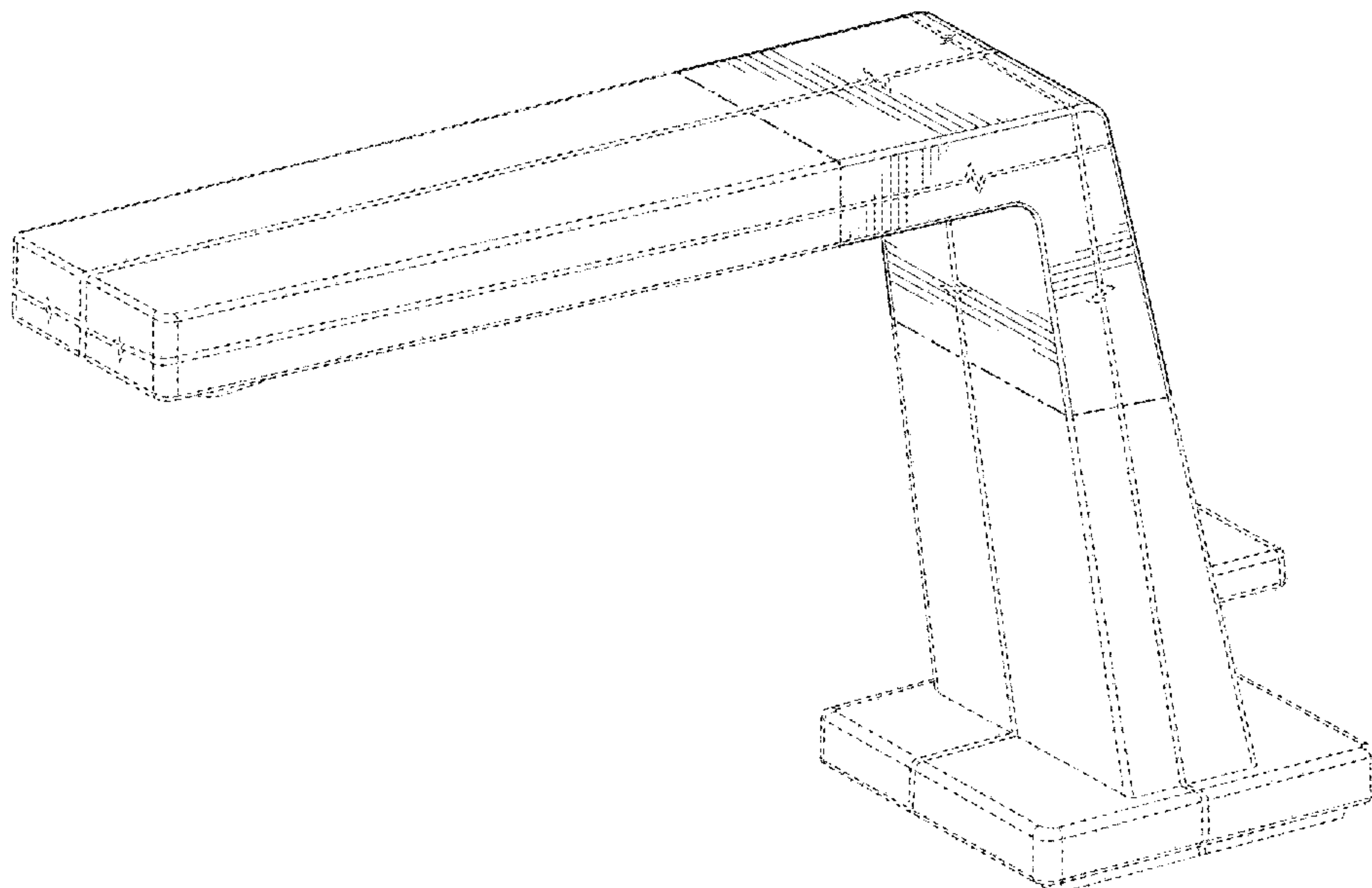
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

Break lines having a jagged element are not part of the claimed design and show that differing lengths (e.g., longer, shorter, etc.) of any portion (e.g., feature) split by a break line are possible.

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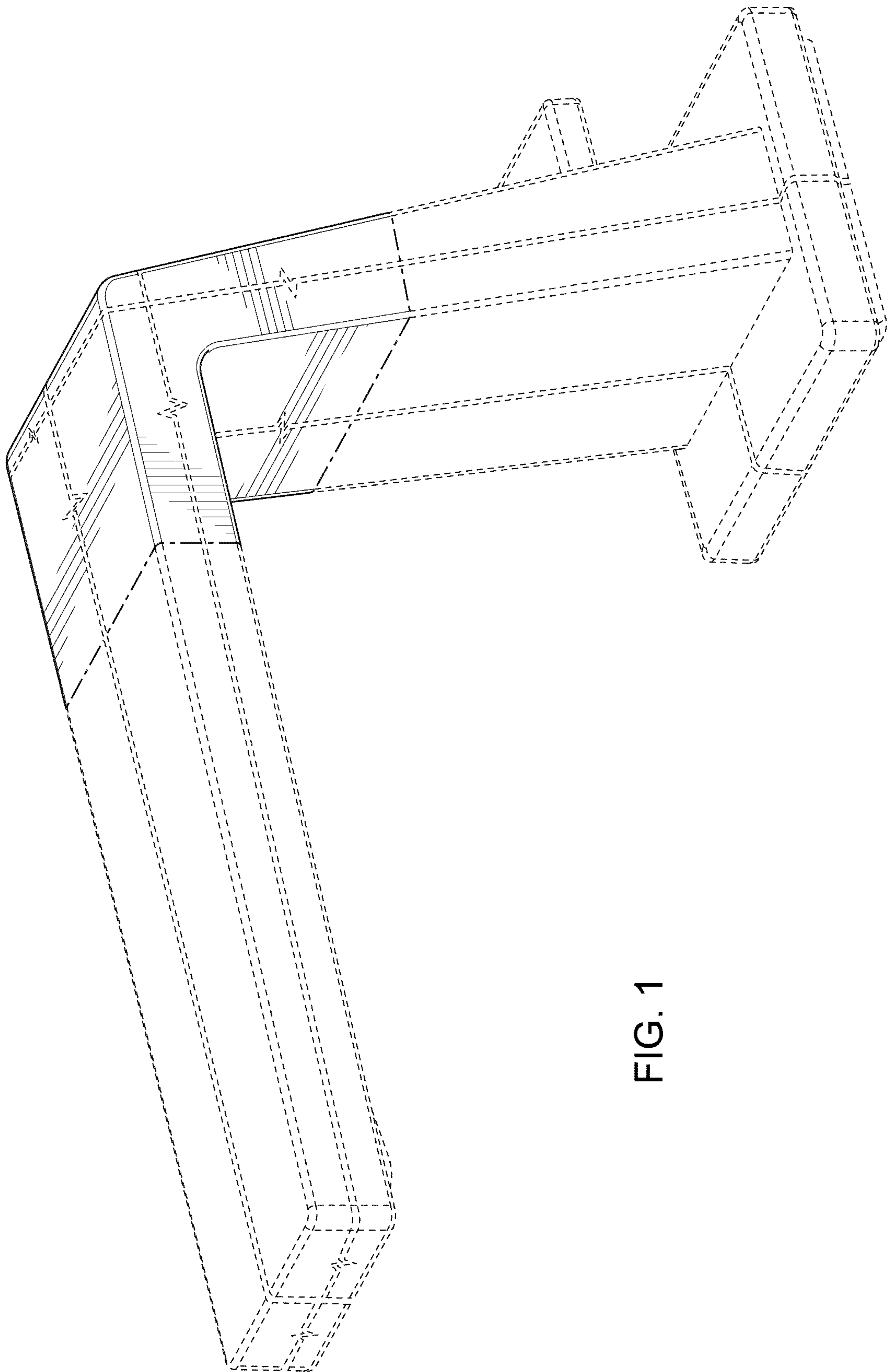

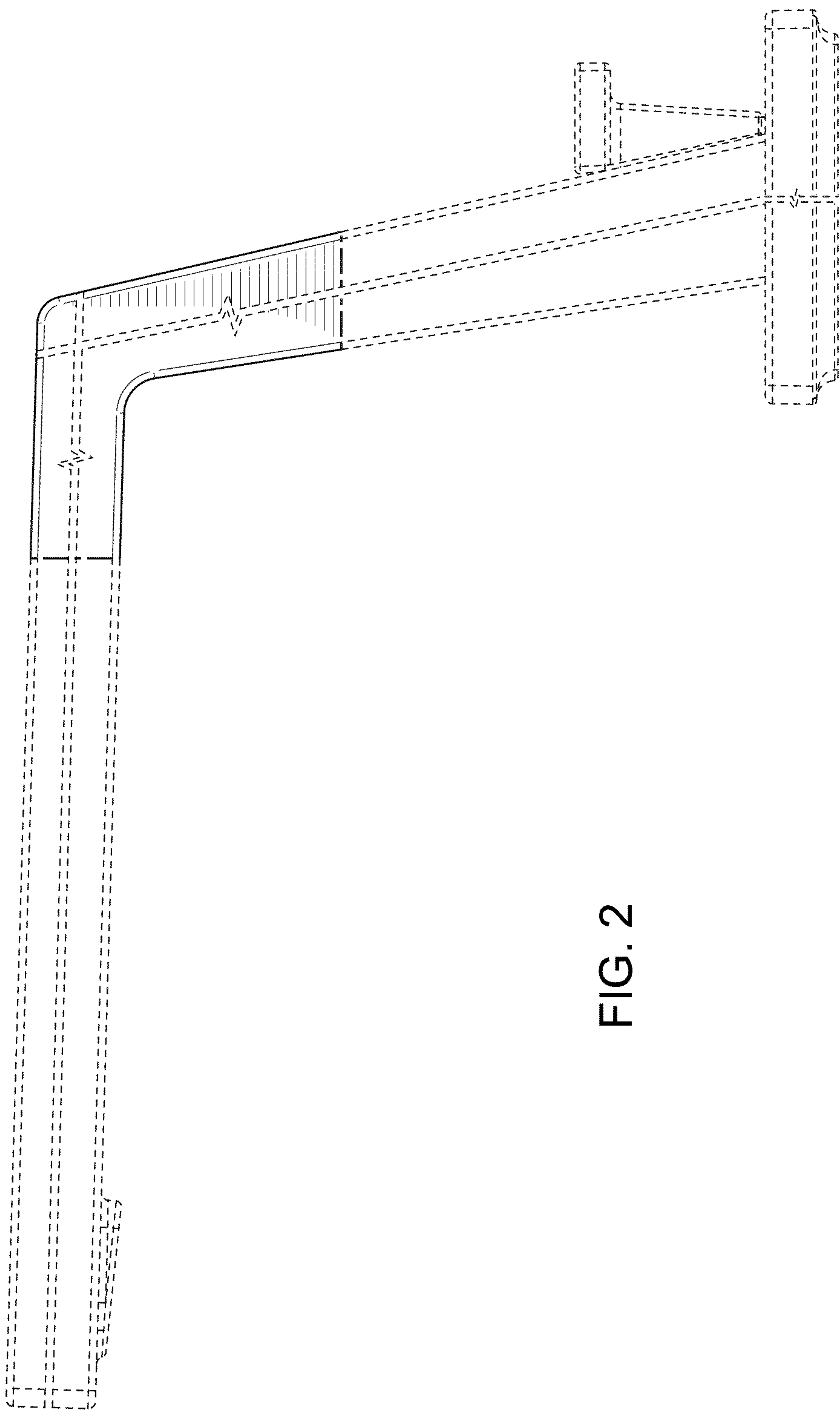
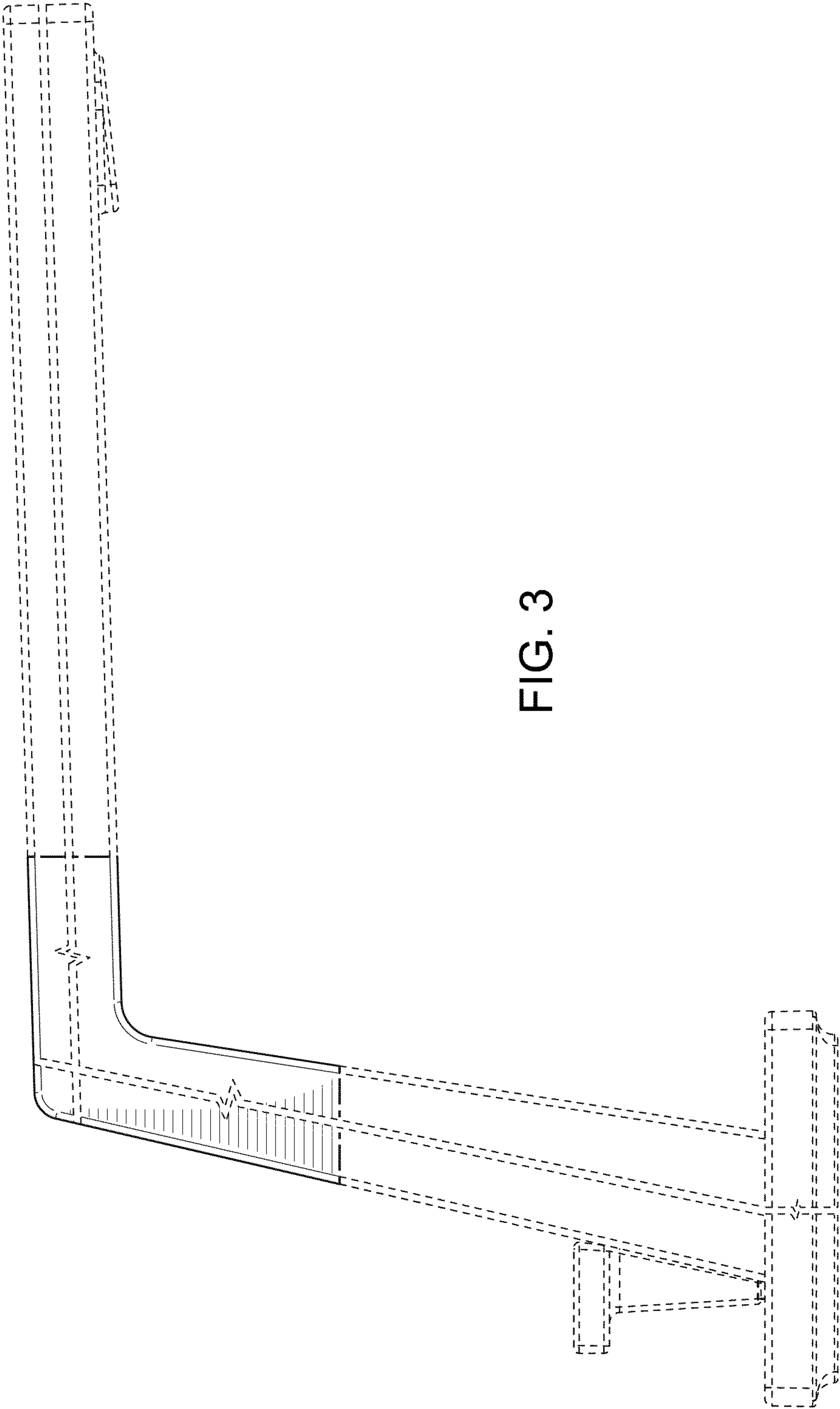

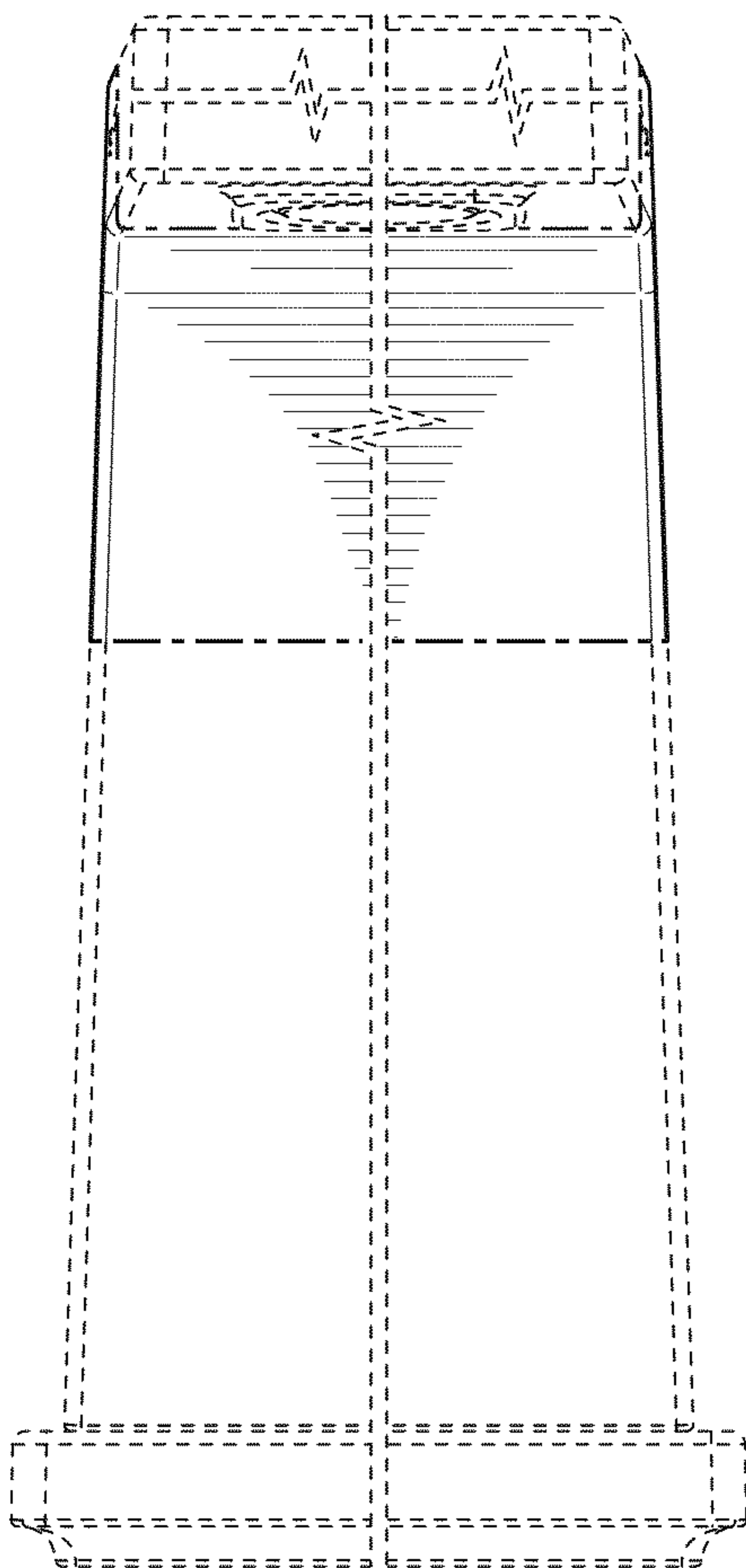

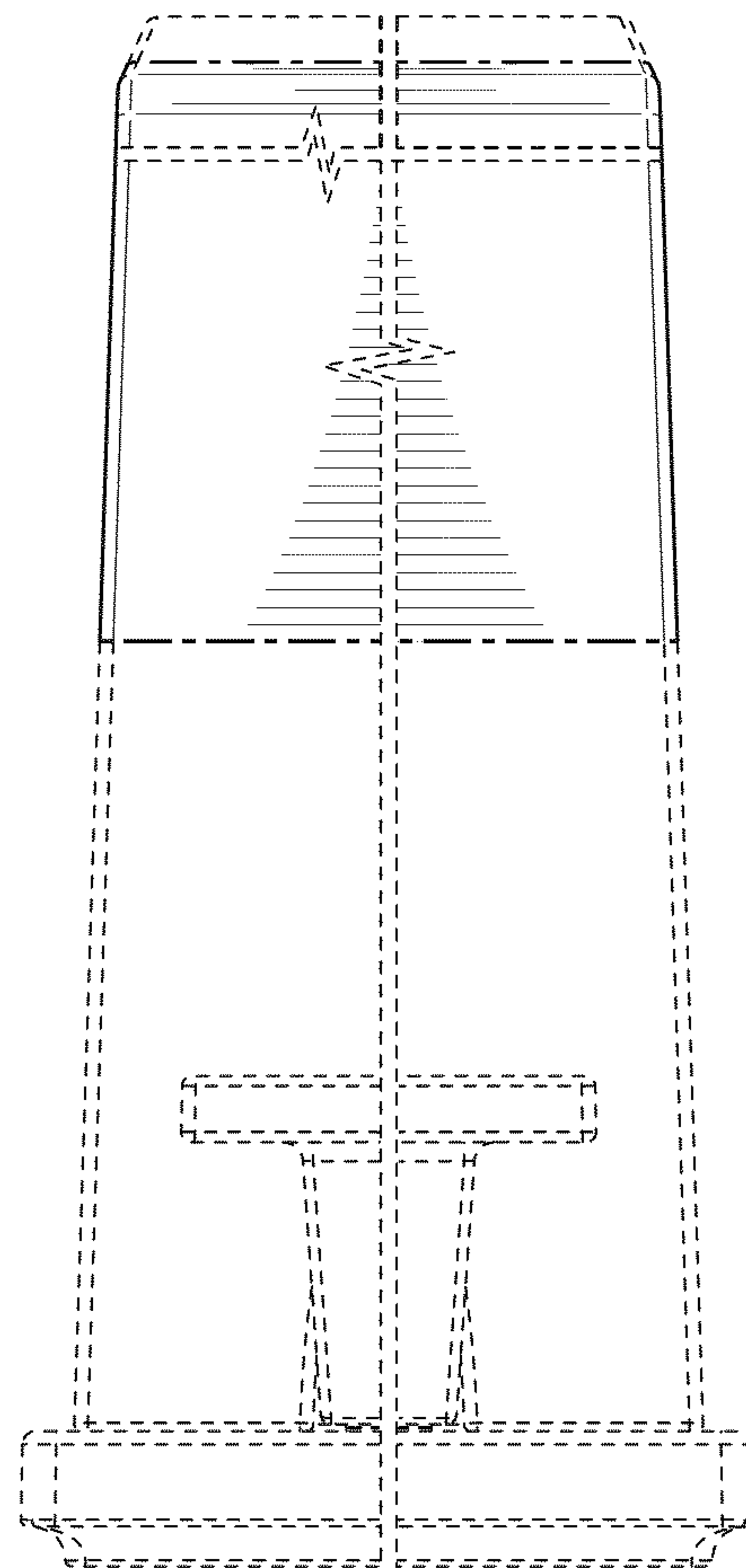

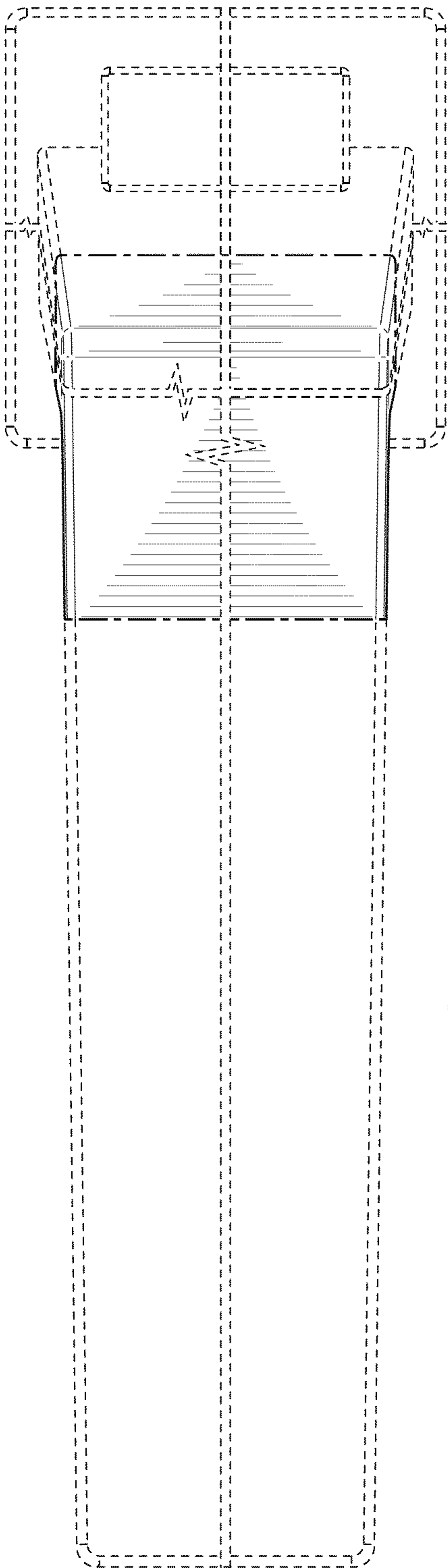

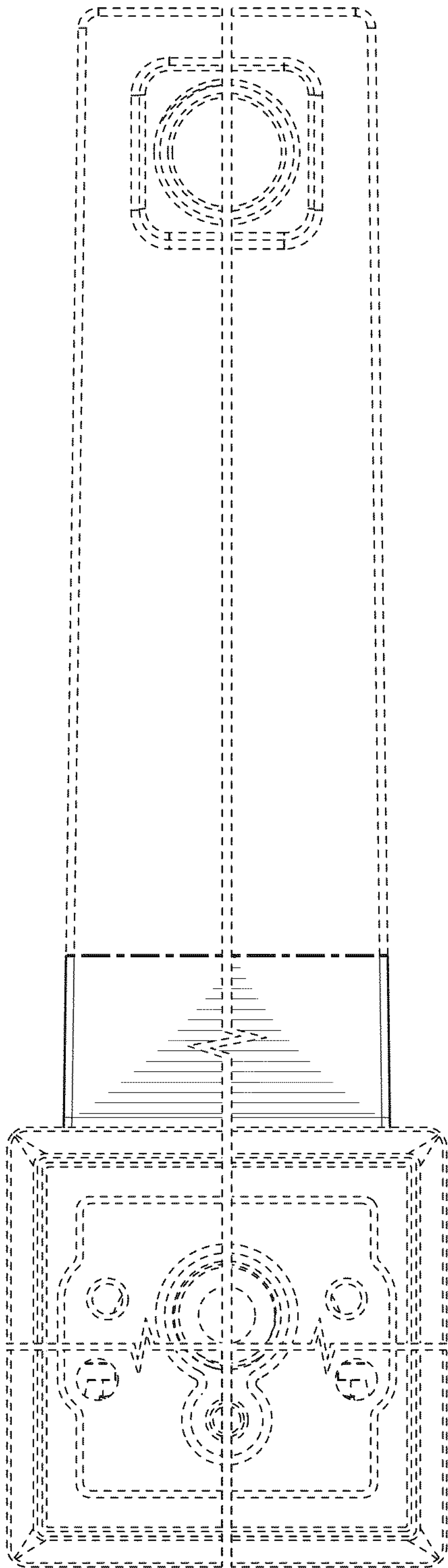
