(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a necklace, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a first embodiment of a necklace showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevation of a second embodiment of the necklace;  
FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a side view thereof.

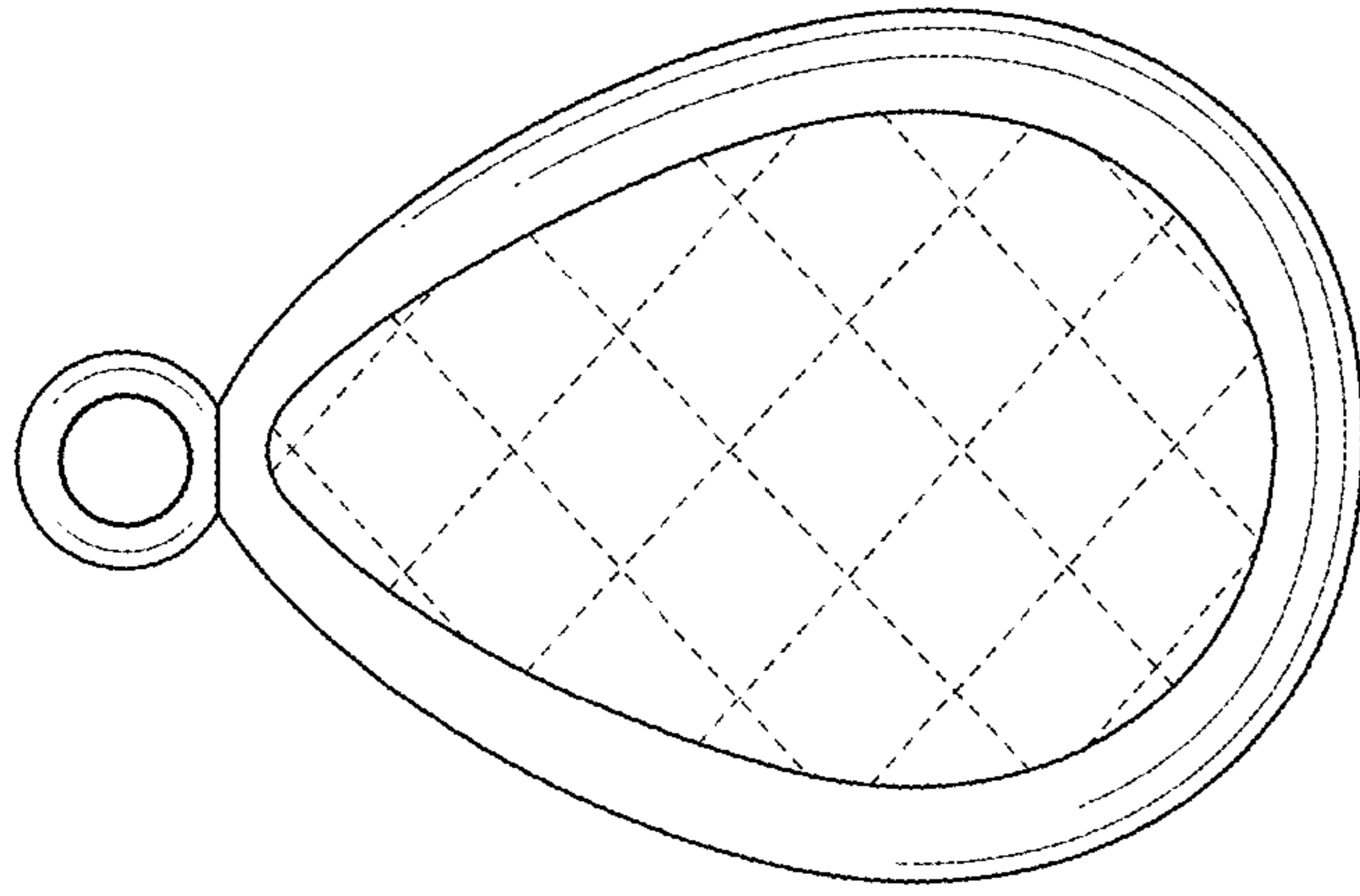

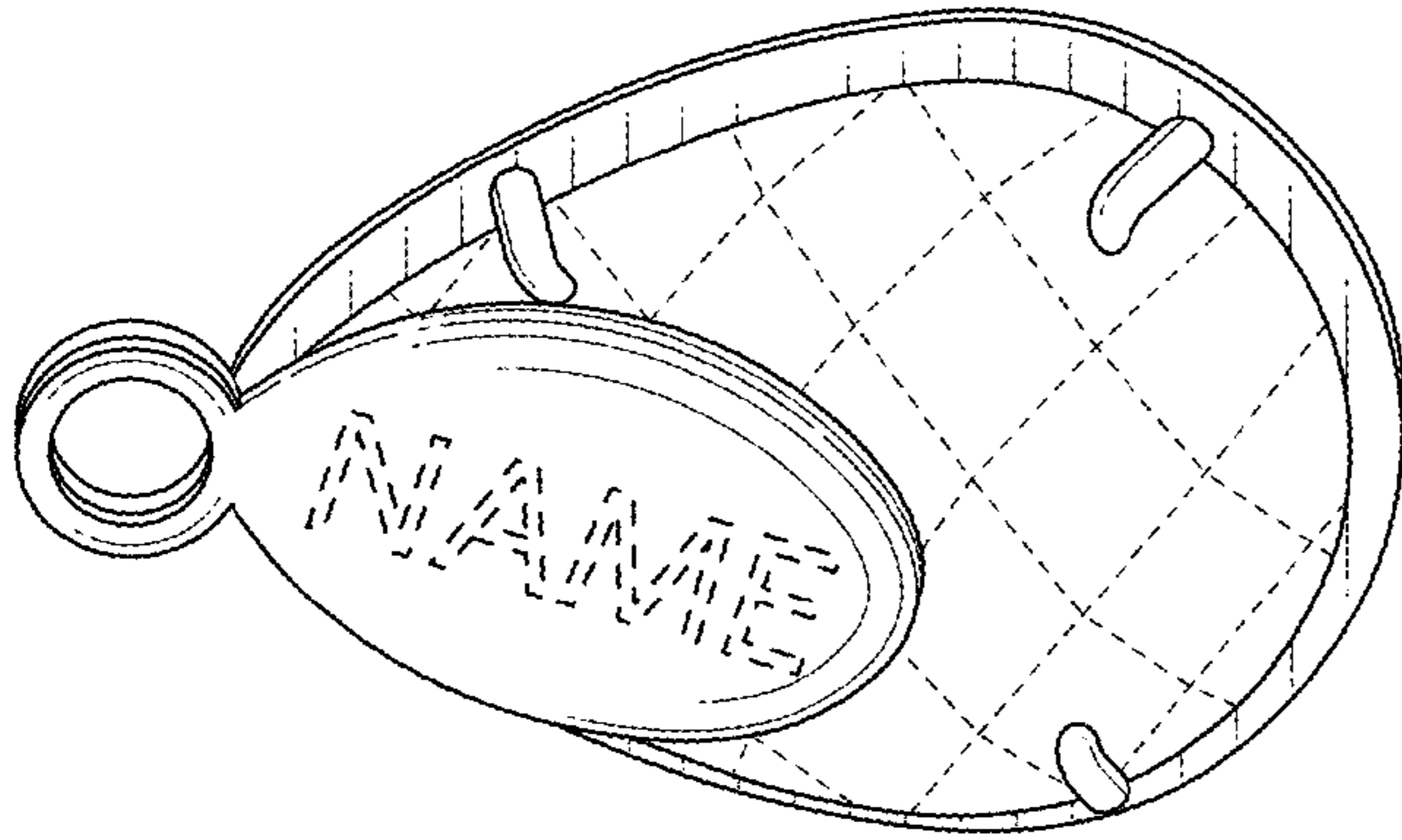

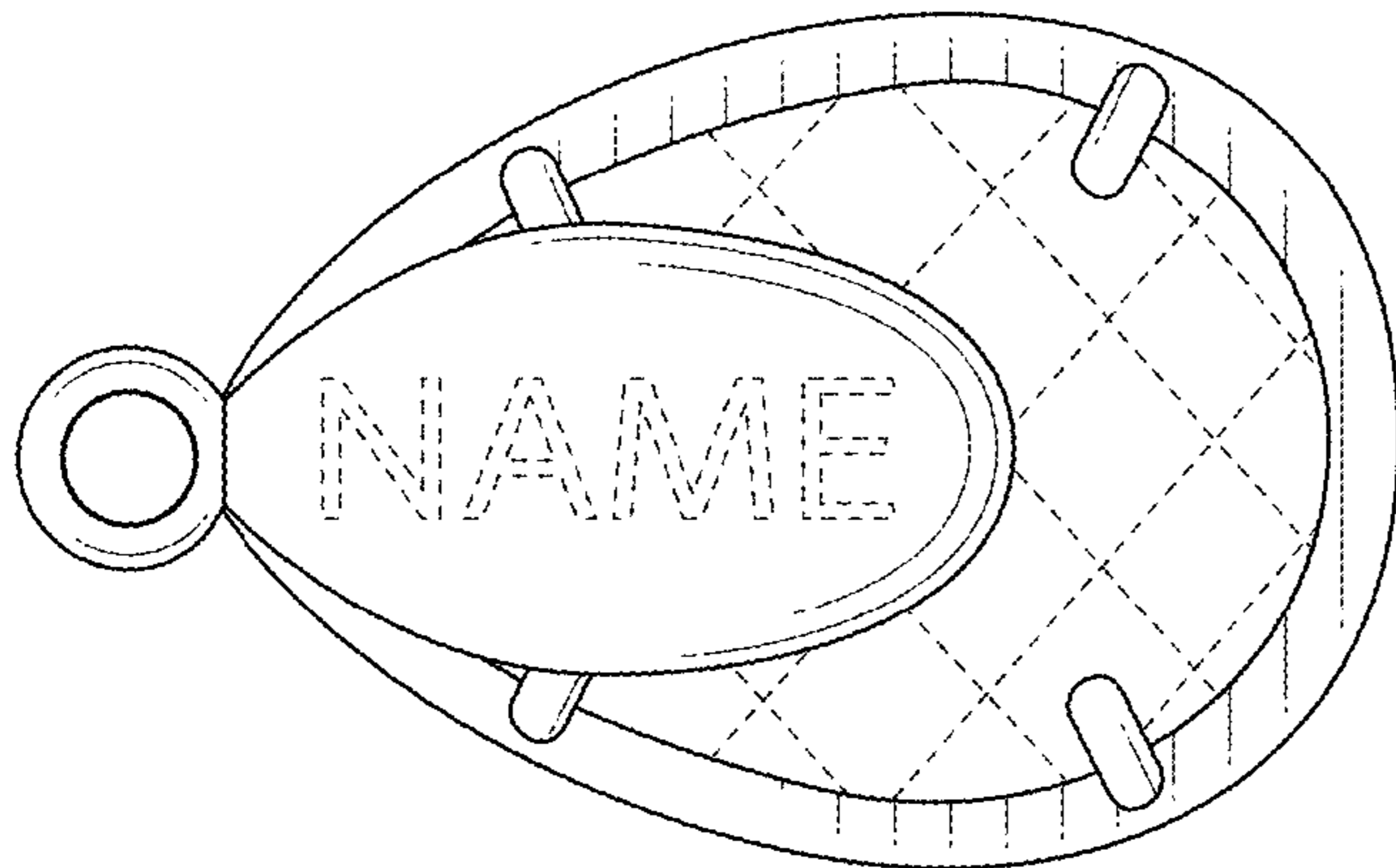

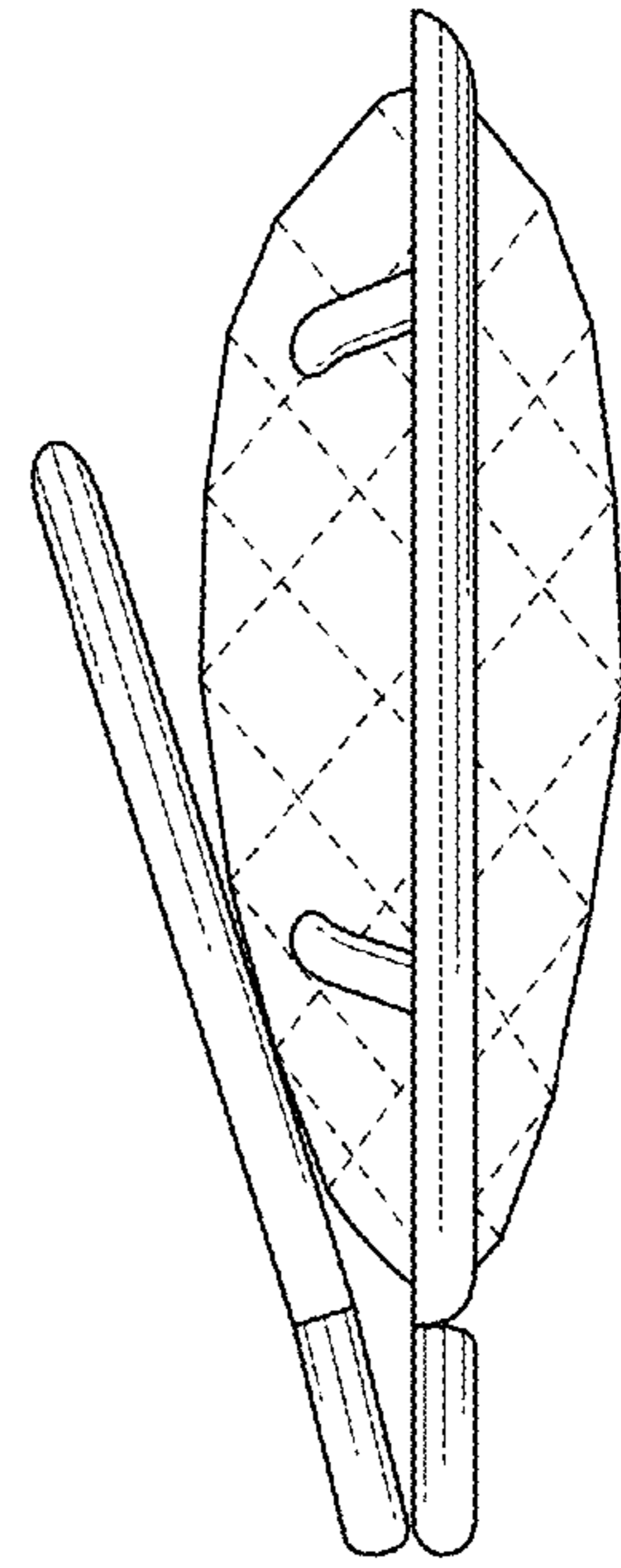

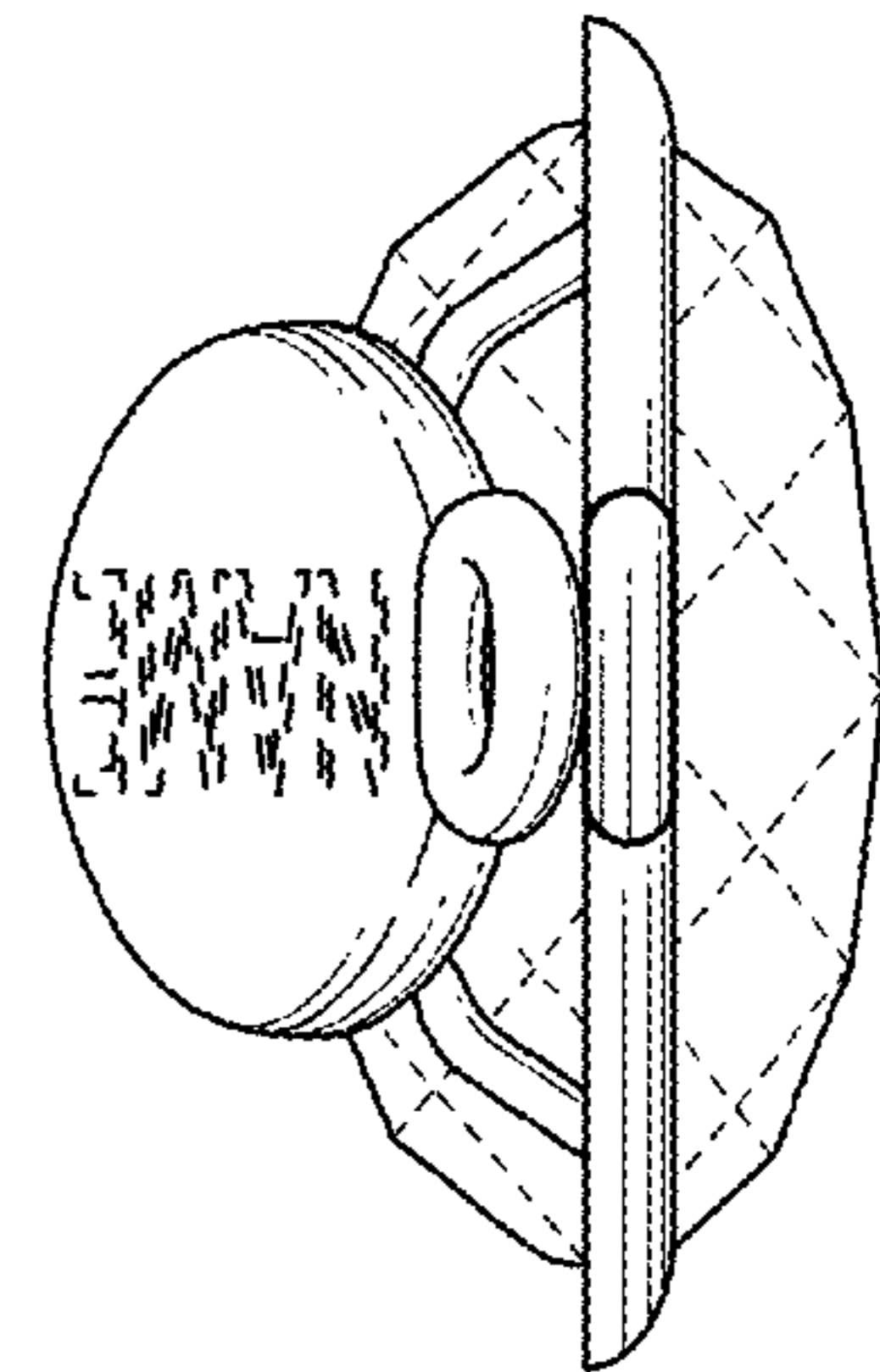

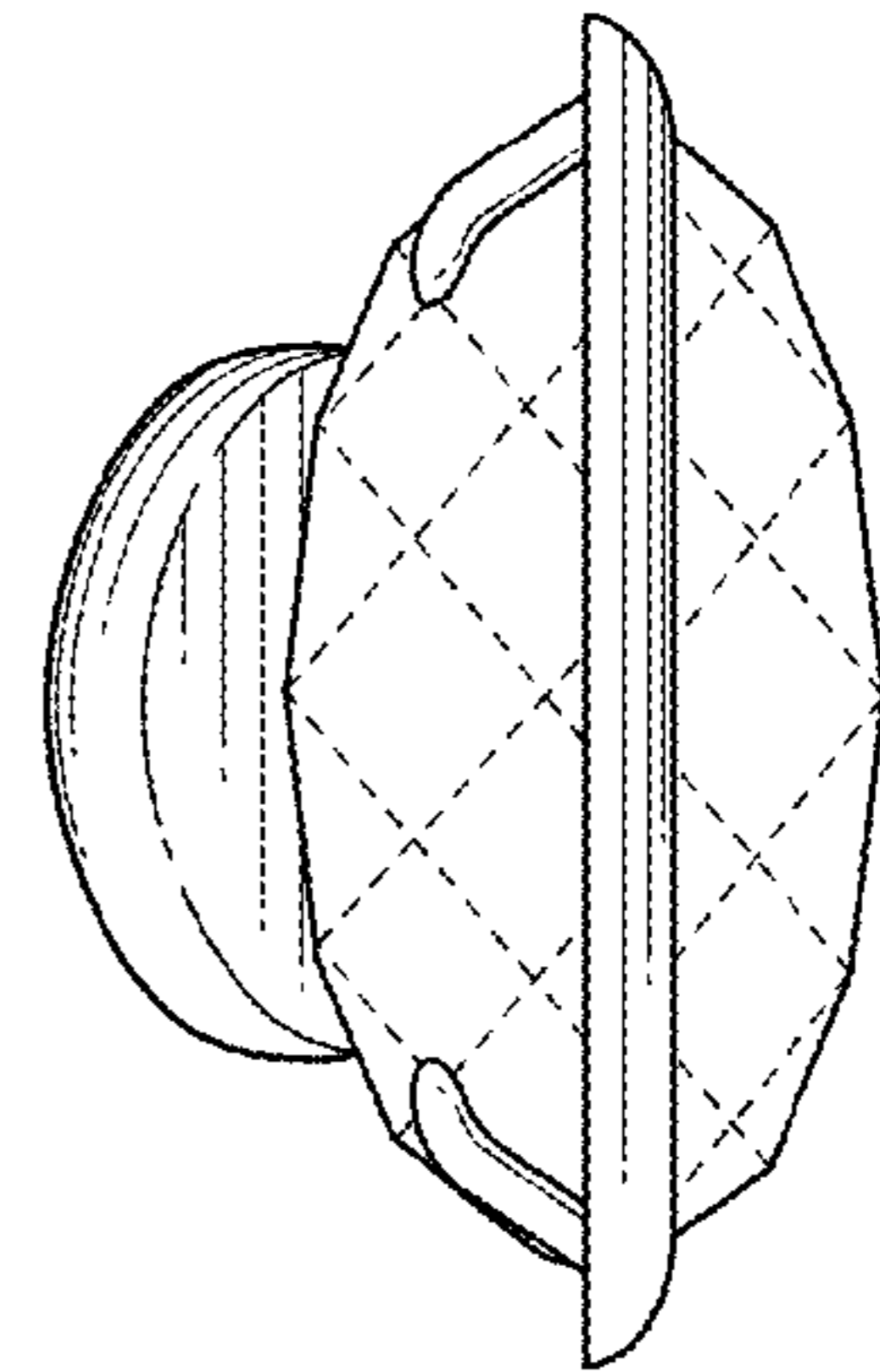
