The ornamental design of a plush toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 shows a front, right side perspective view of a plush toy showing the new design;

FIG. 2 shows a rear, left side perspective view of the plush toy;

FIG. 3 shows a front elevation view of the plush toy;

FIG. 4 shows a rear elevation view of the plush toy;

FIG. 5 shows a right side elevation view of the plush toy; the left side elevation view is a mirror image of the right side elevation view;

FIG. 6 shows a top view of the plush toy; and,

FIG. 7 shows a bottom view of the plush toy.

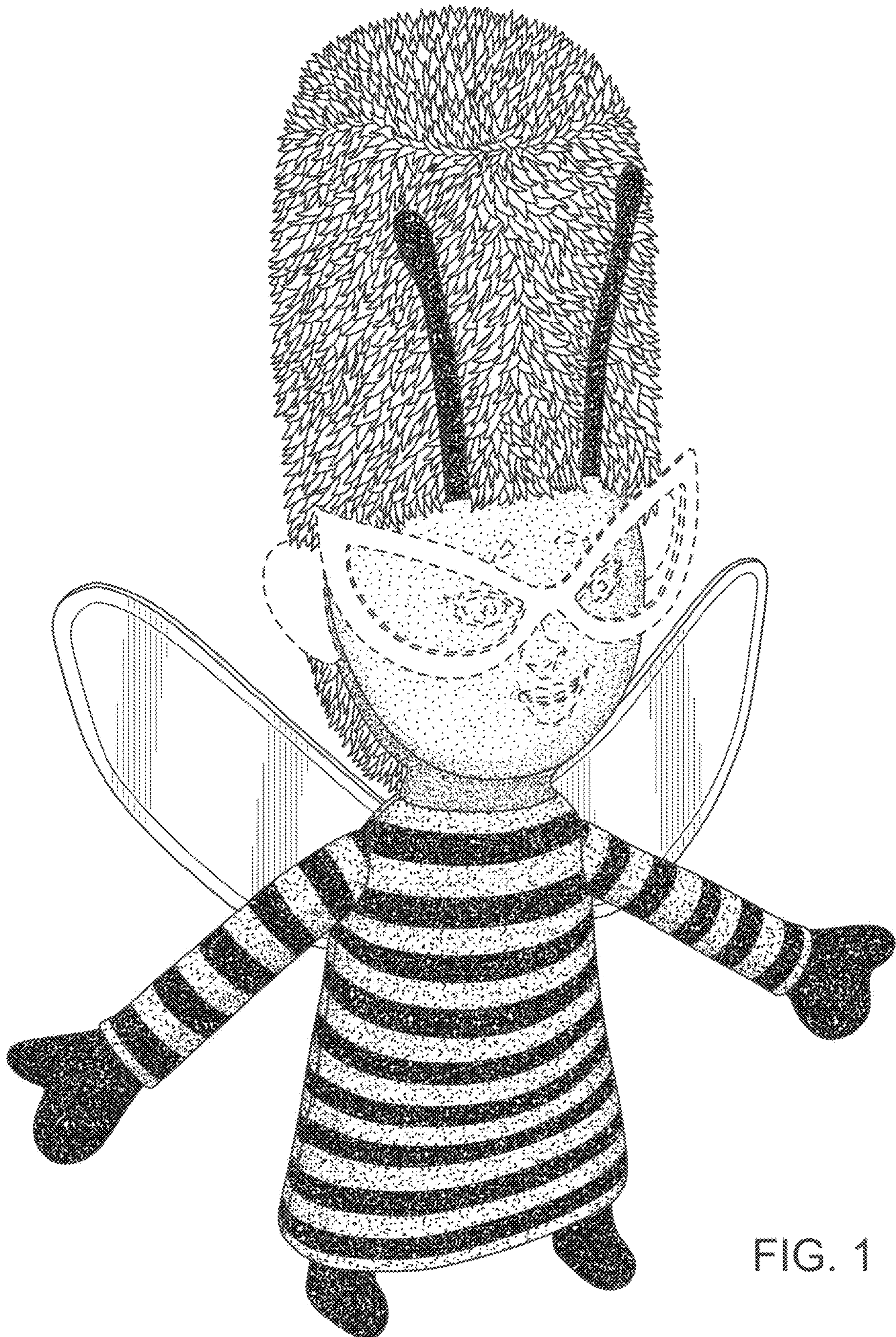

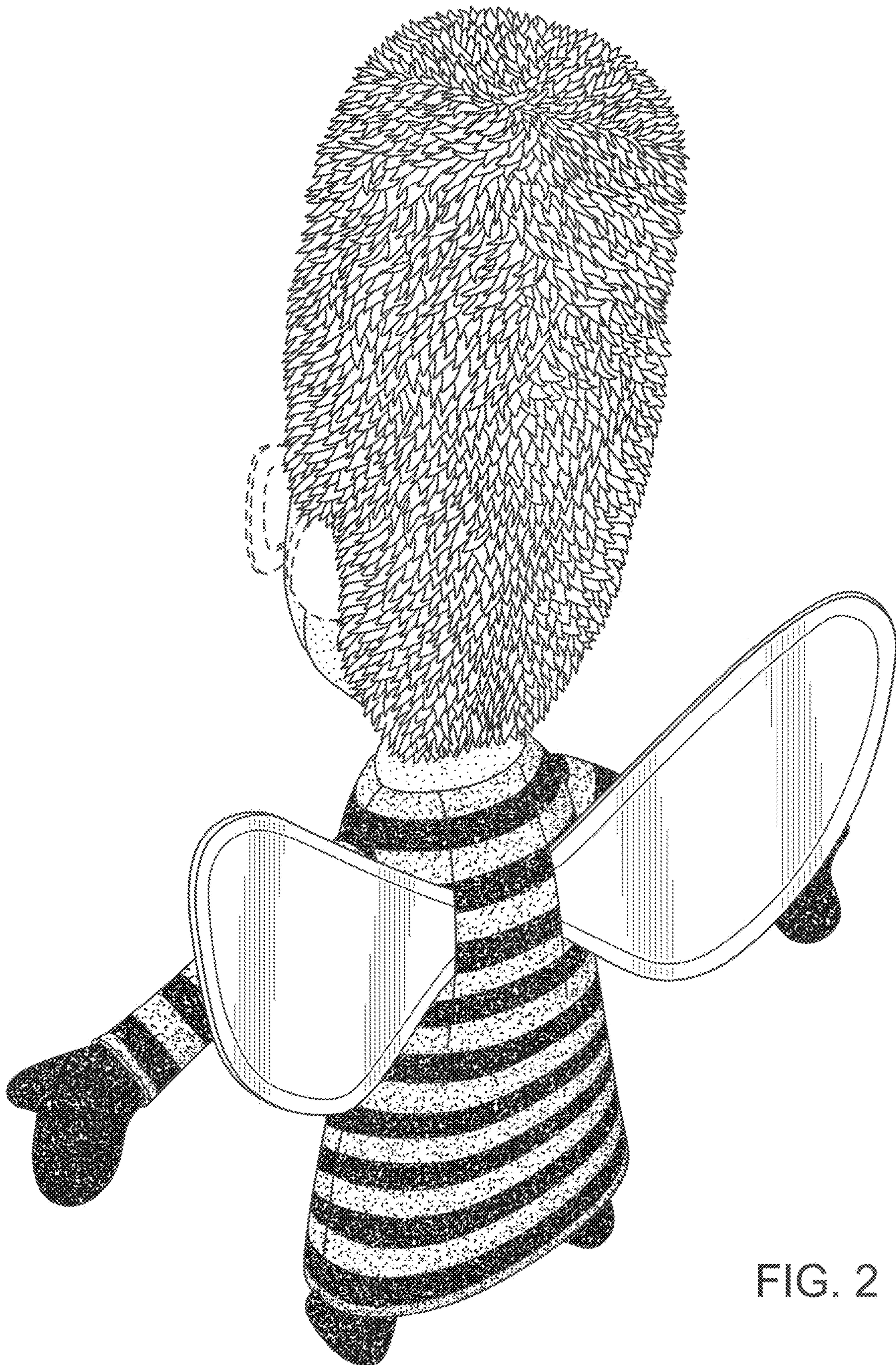

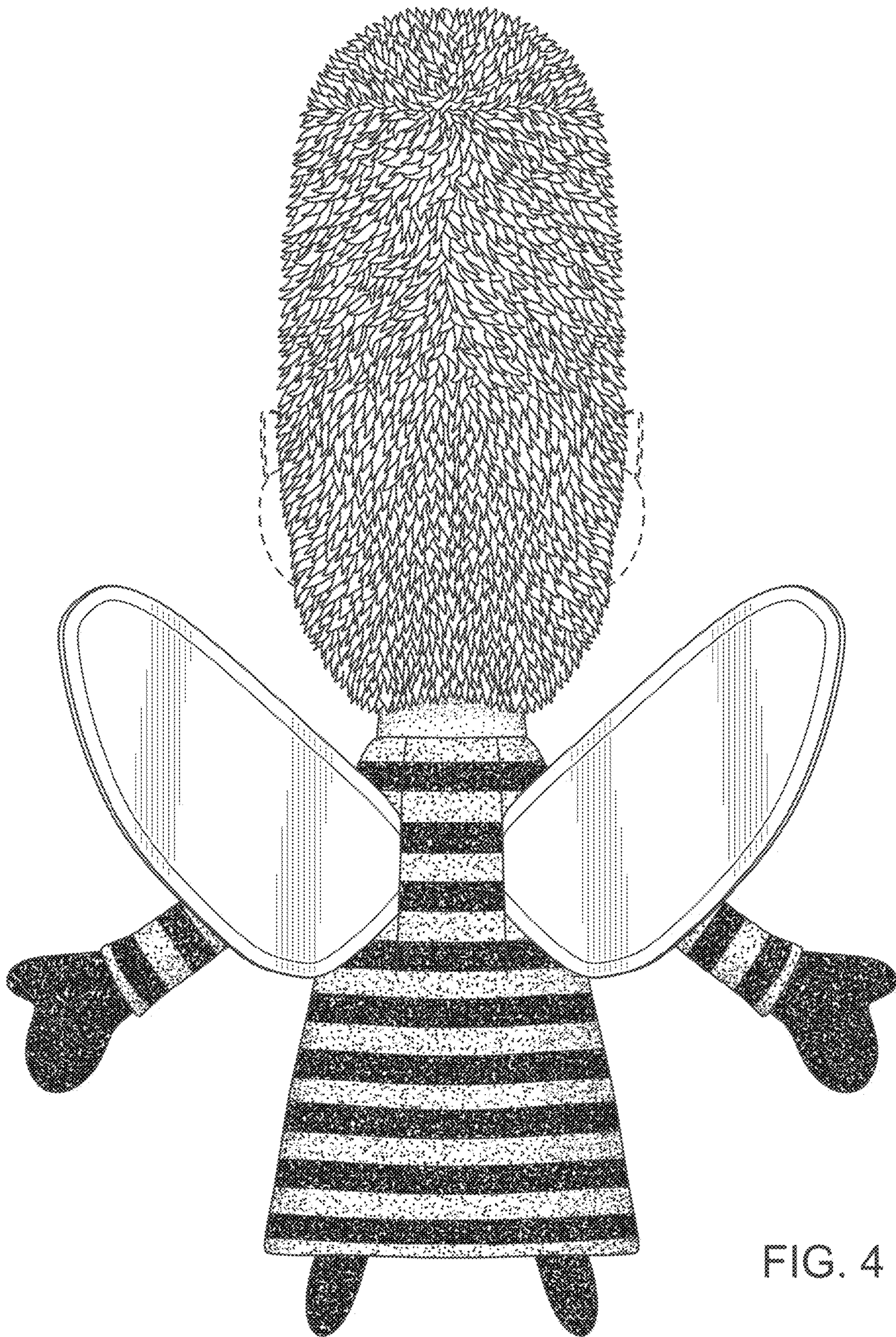

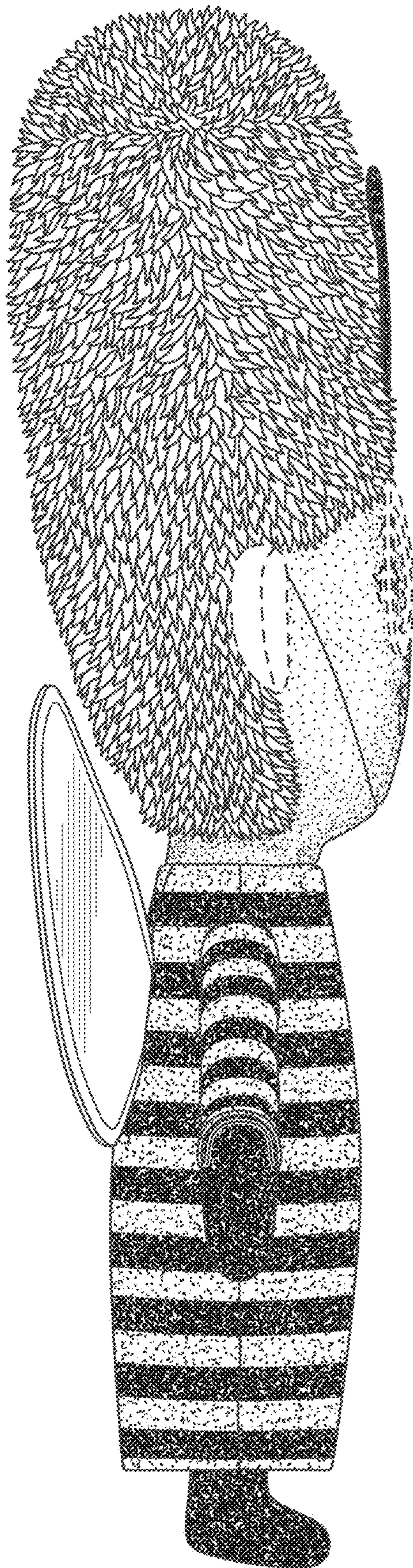

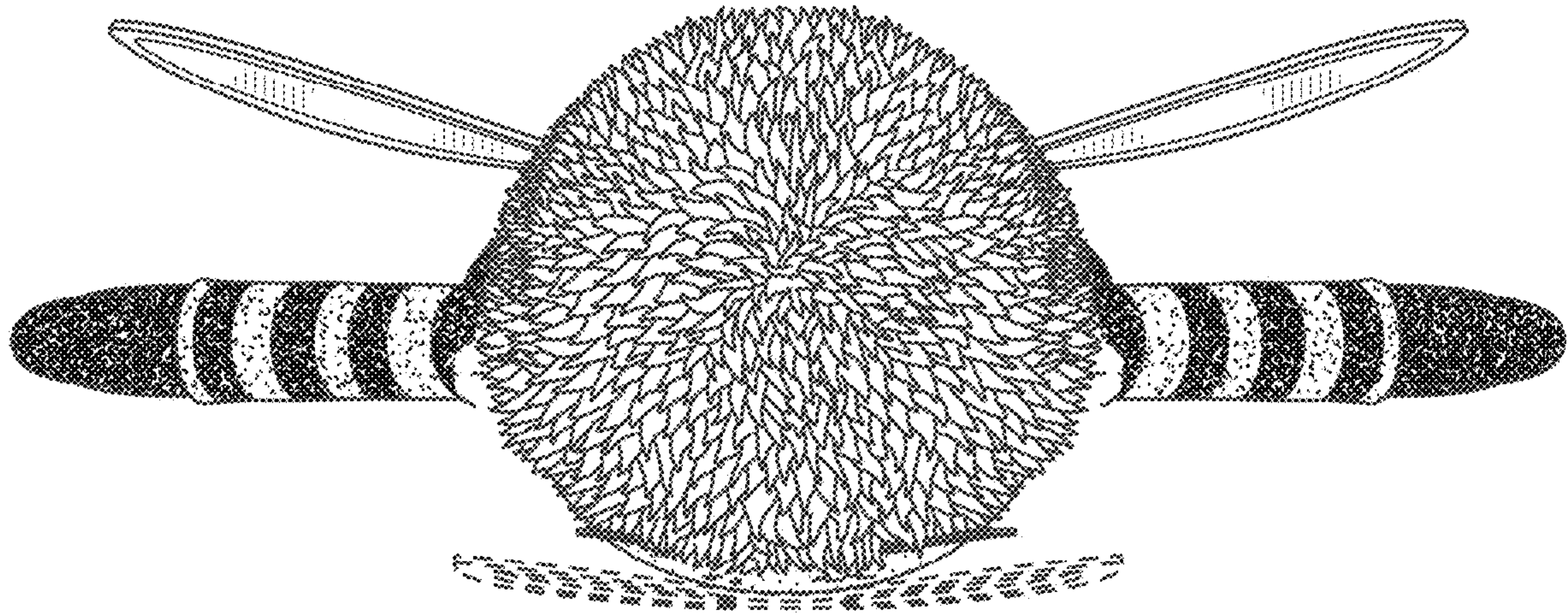

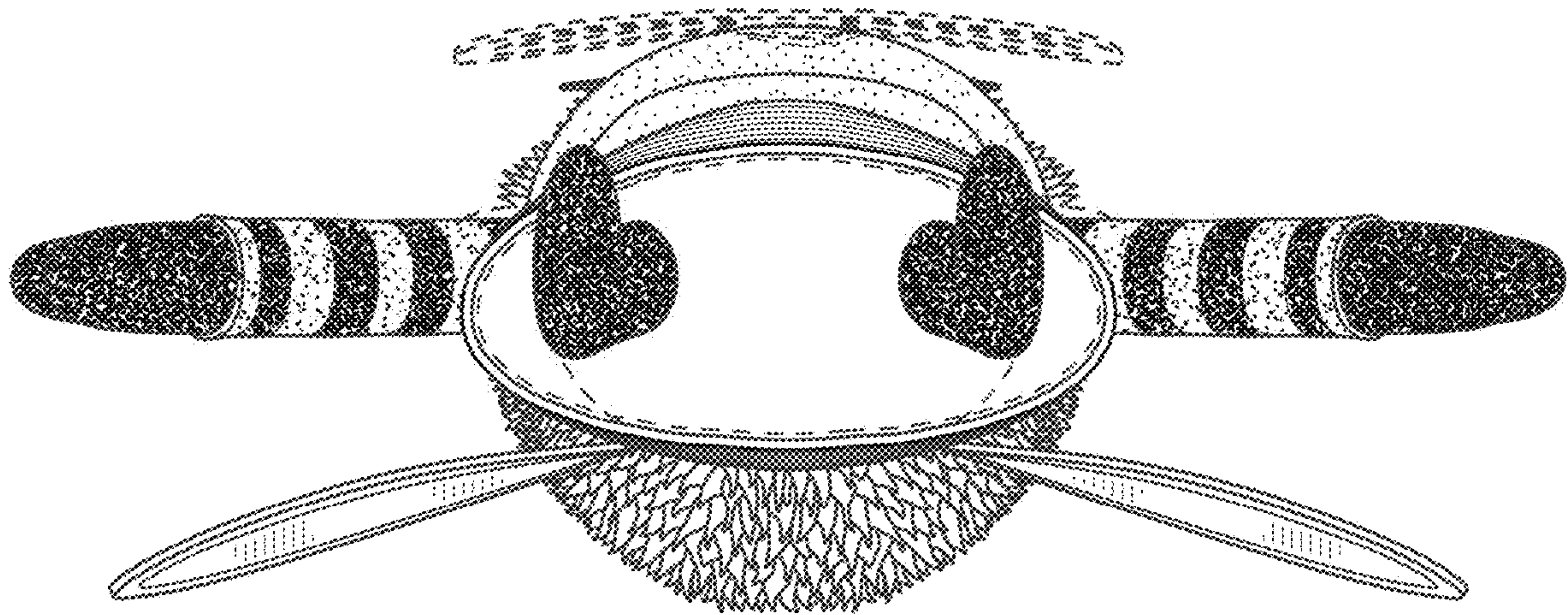
