FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof.

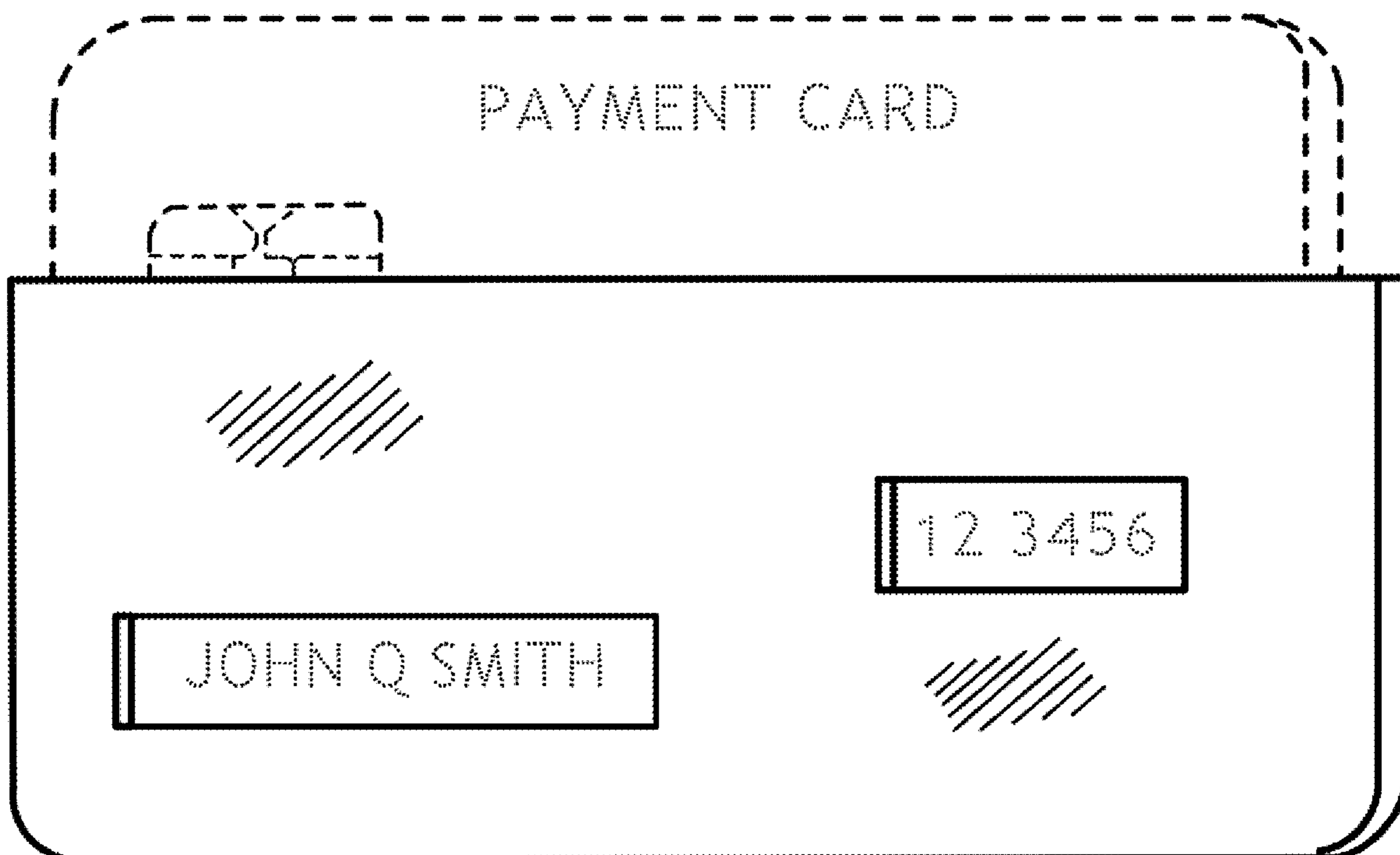
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

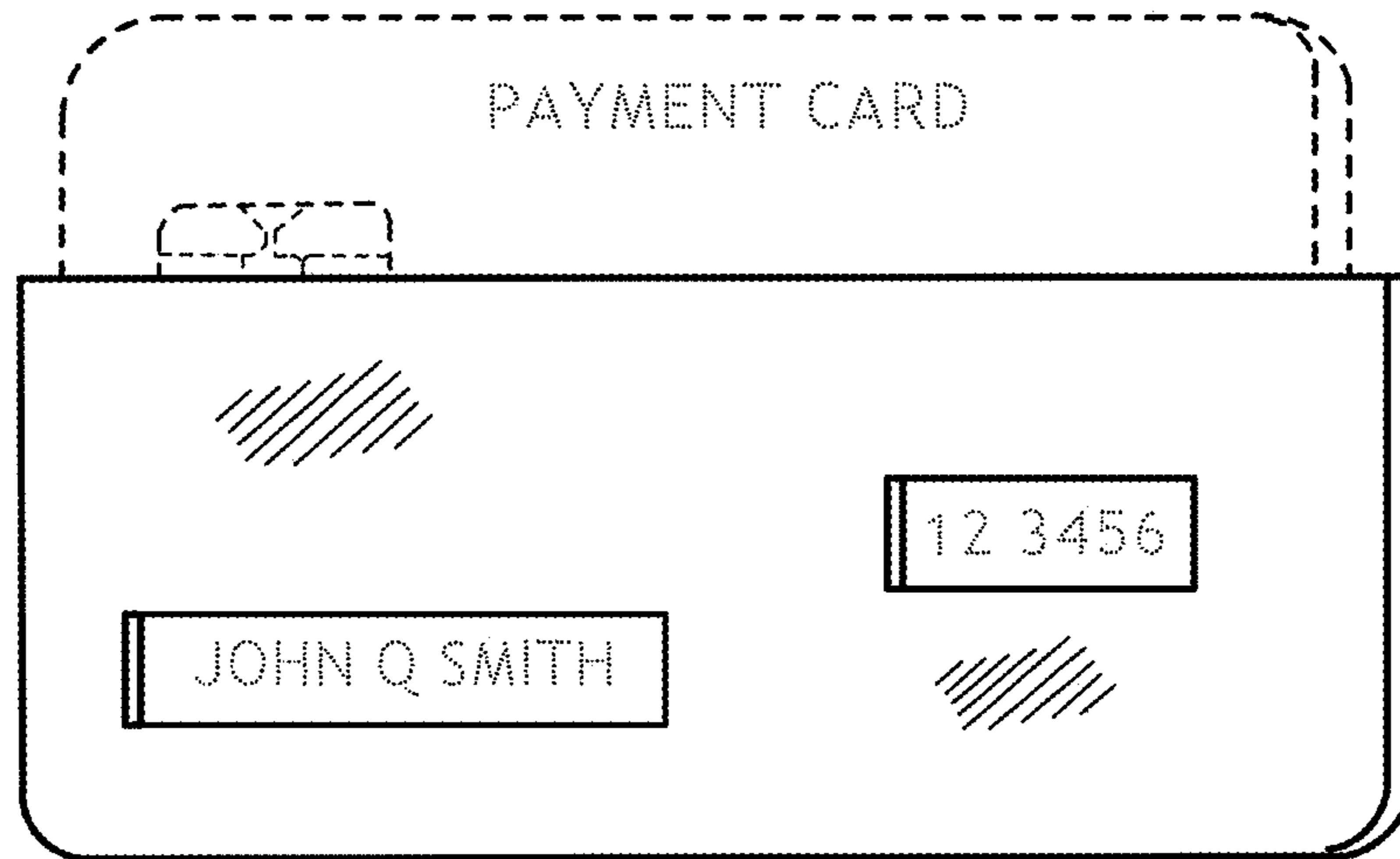

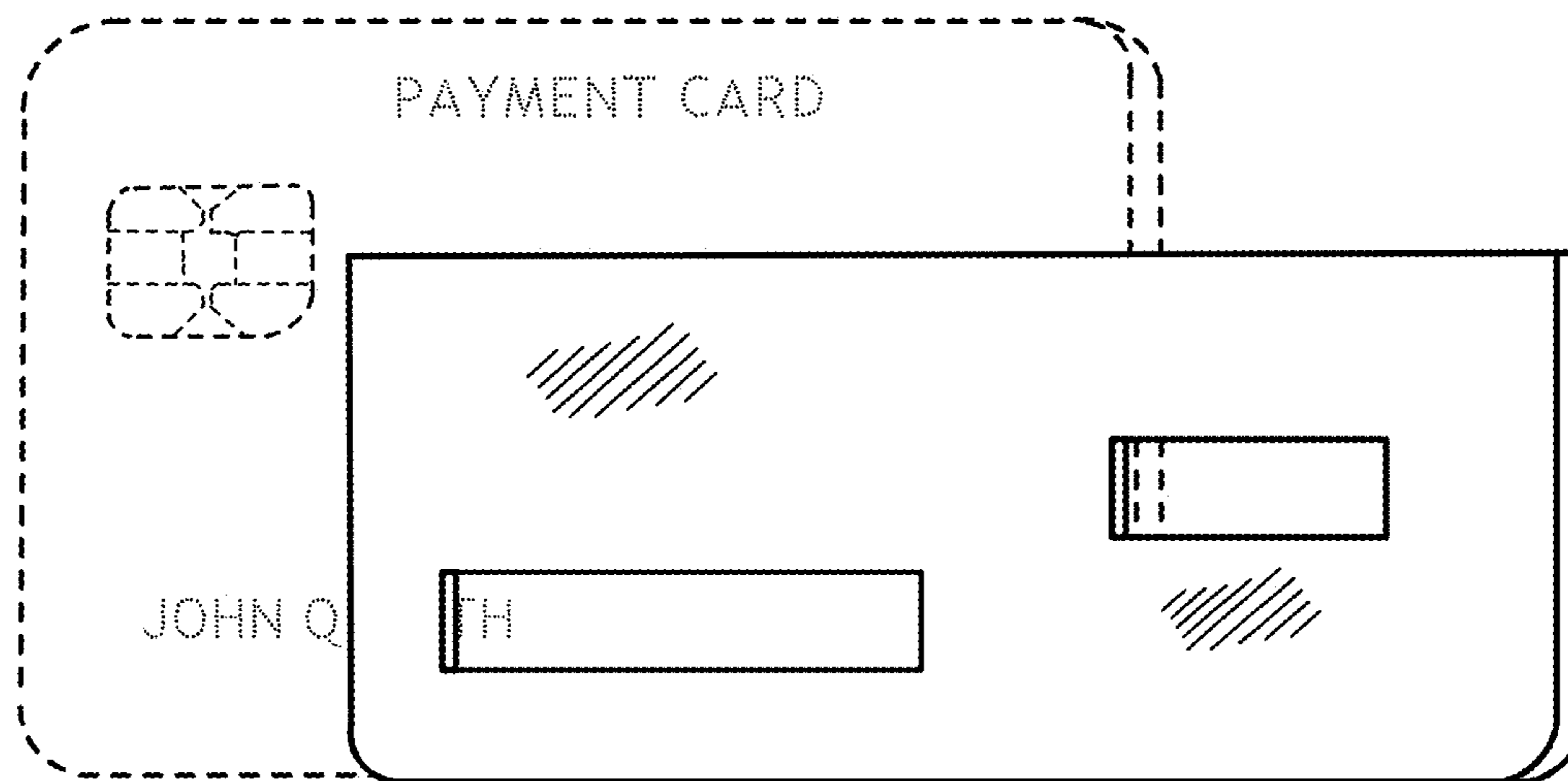

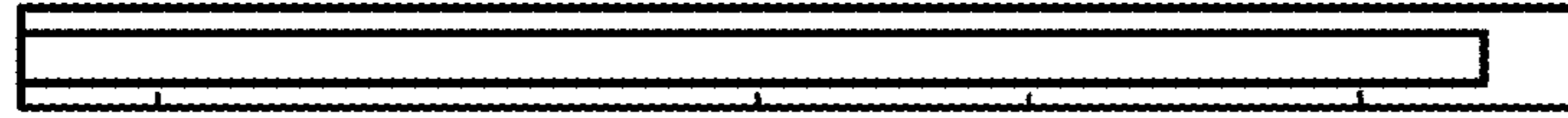

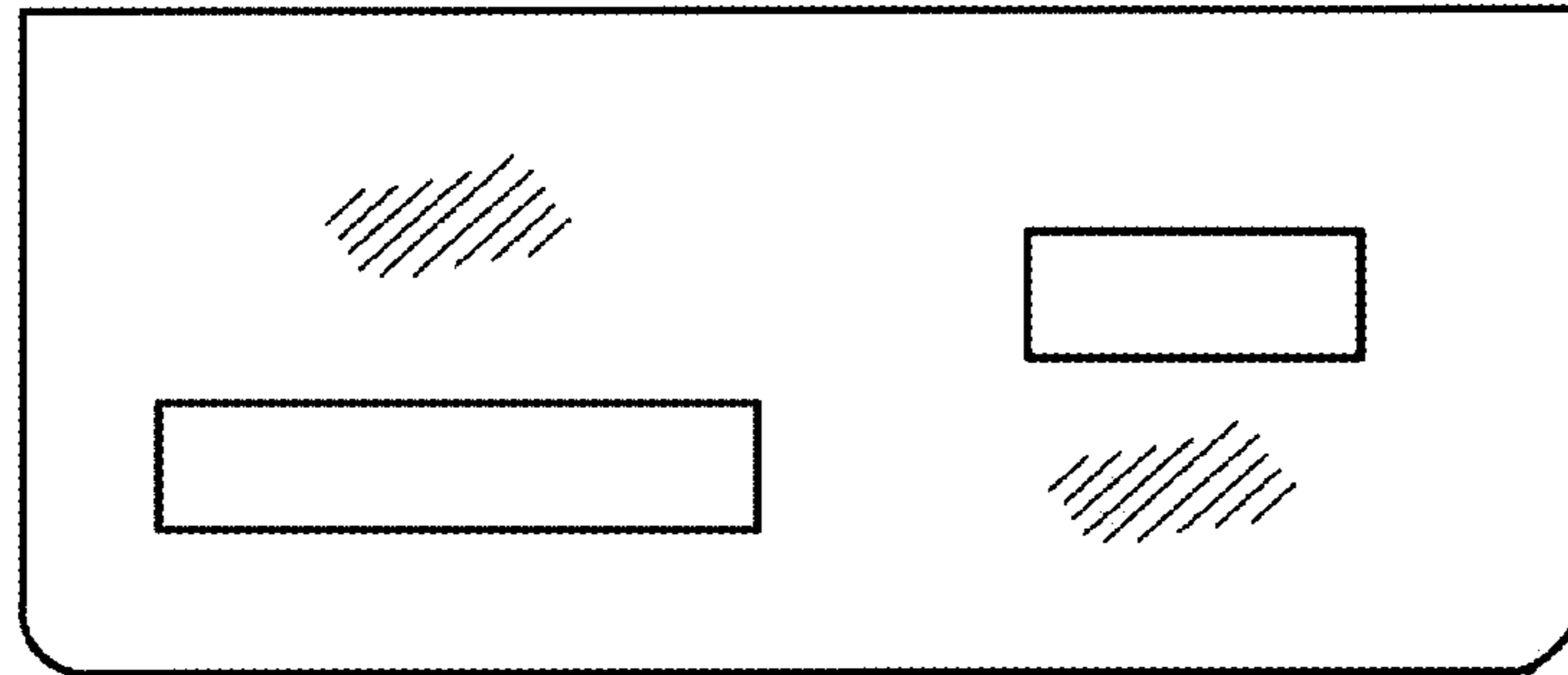

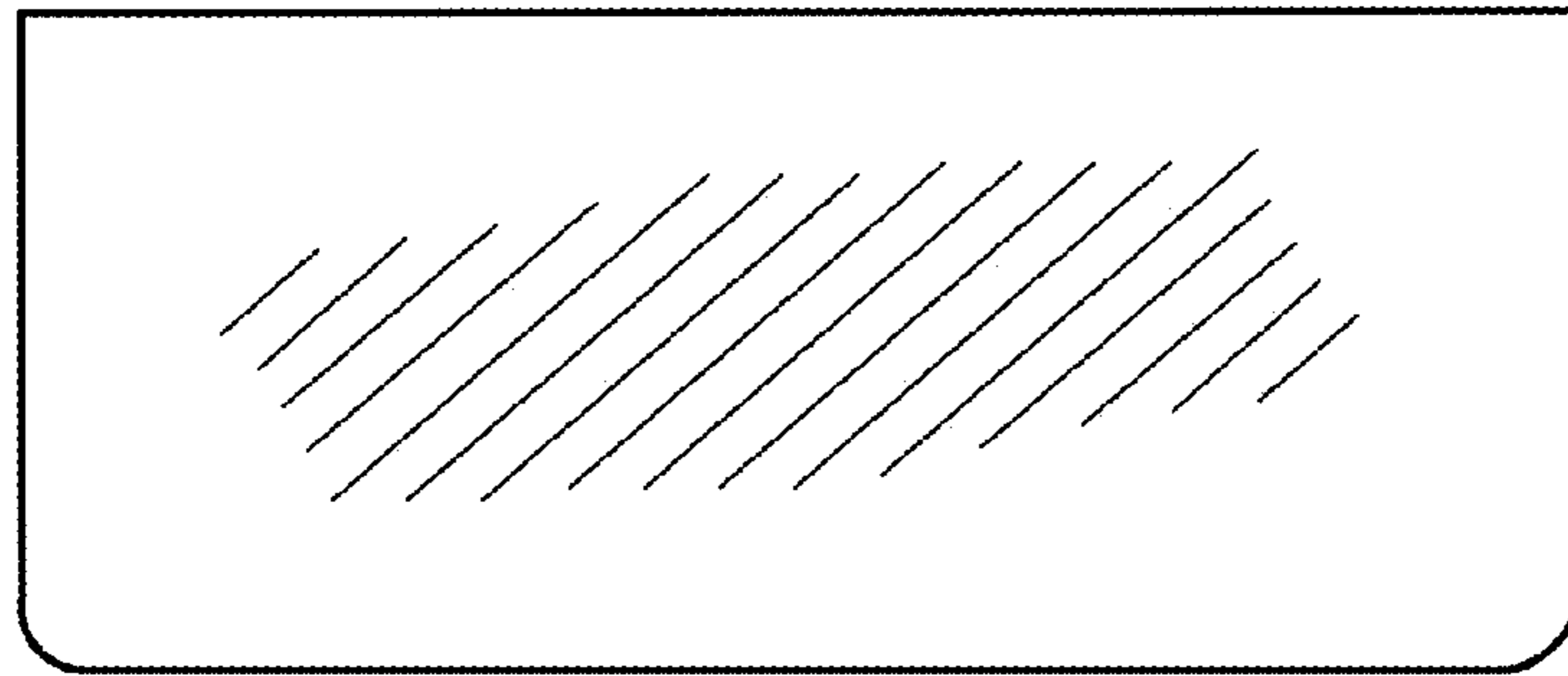
