The ornamental design for an end portion of a snack chip, as shown and described.

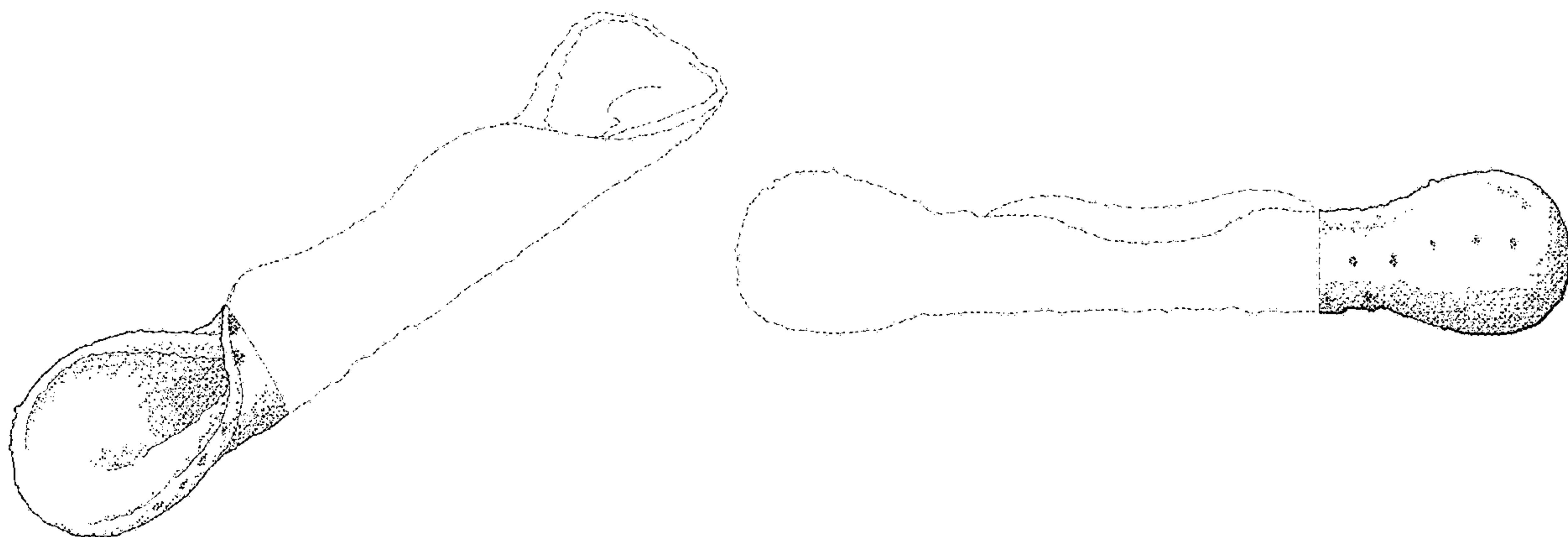
DESCRIPTION

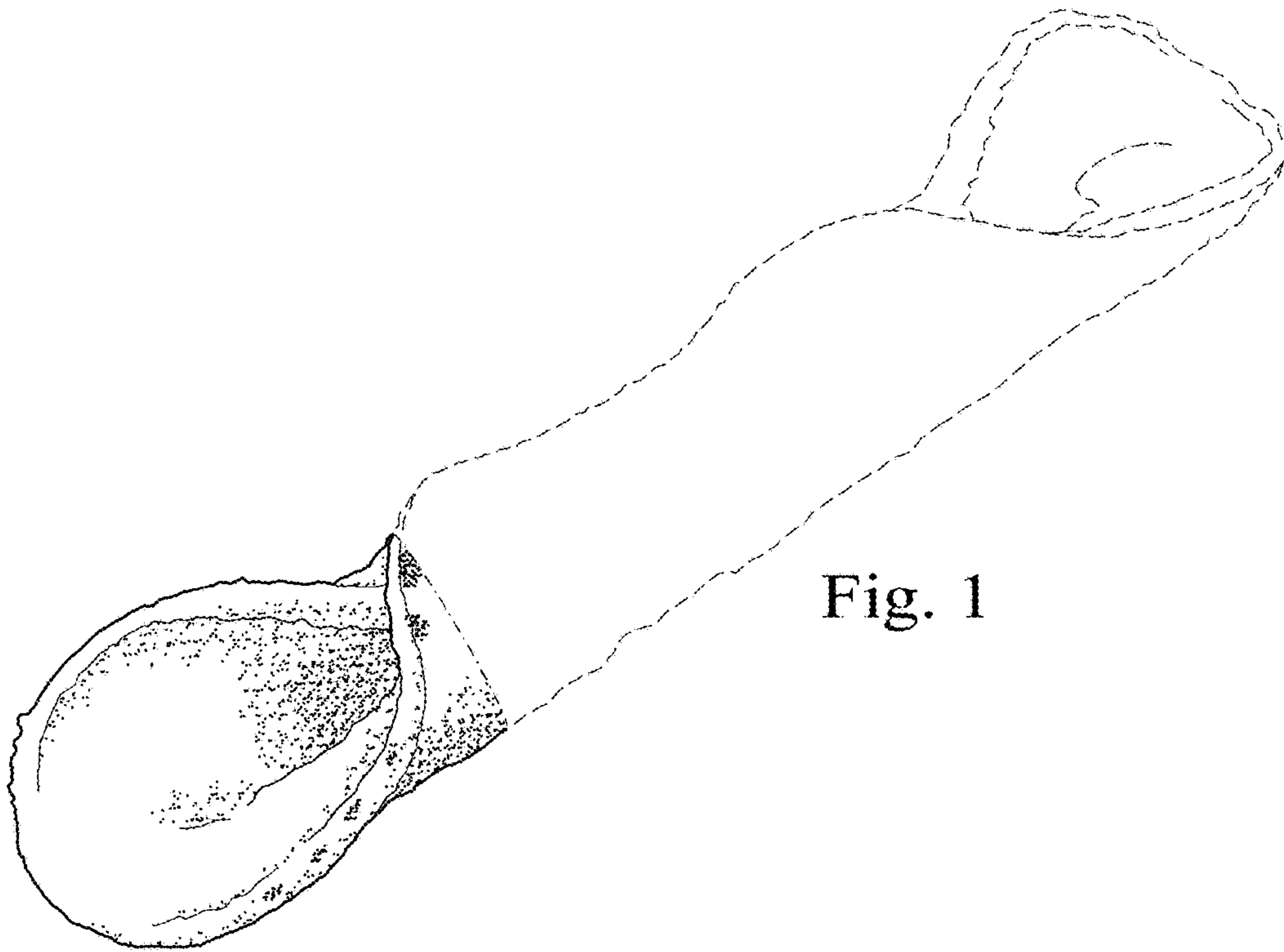

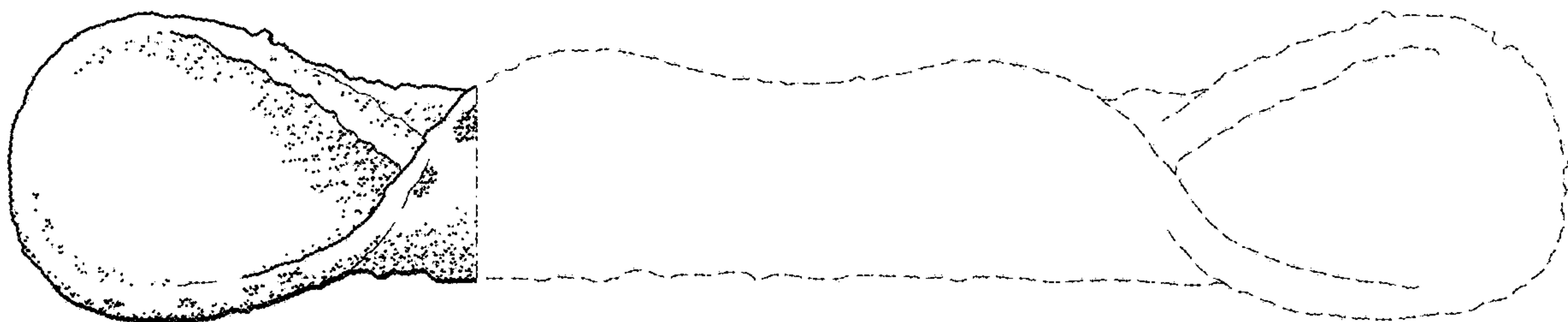

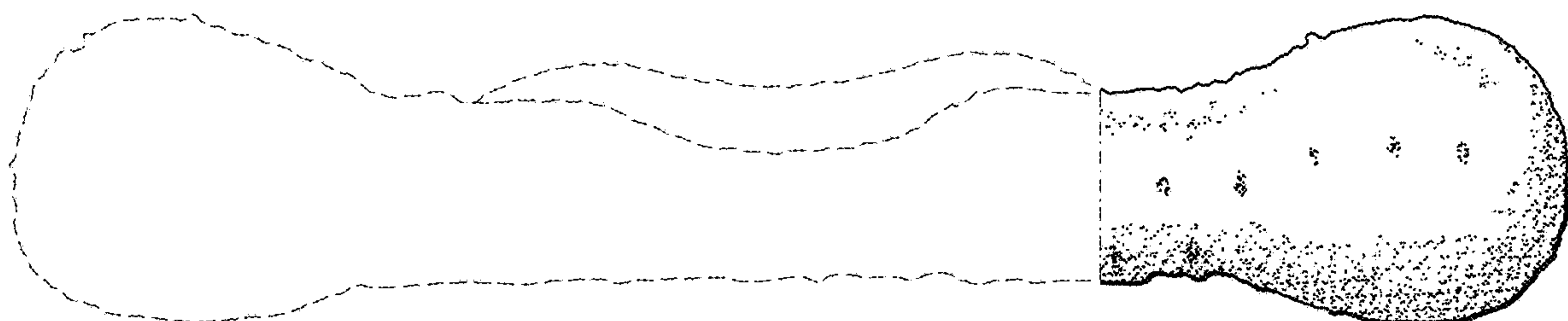

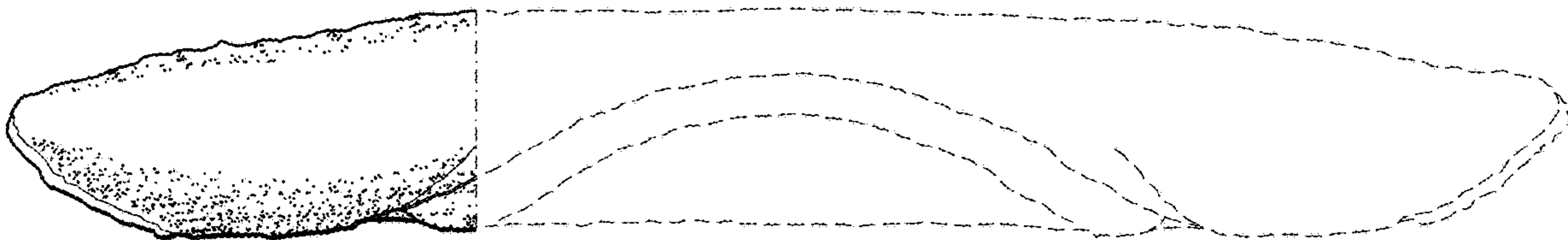

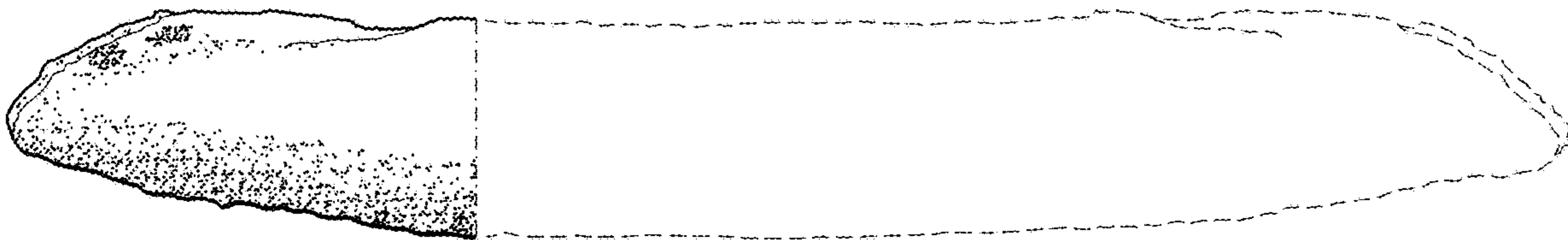

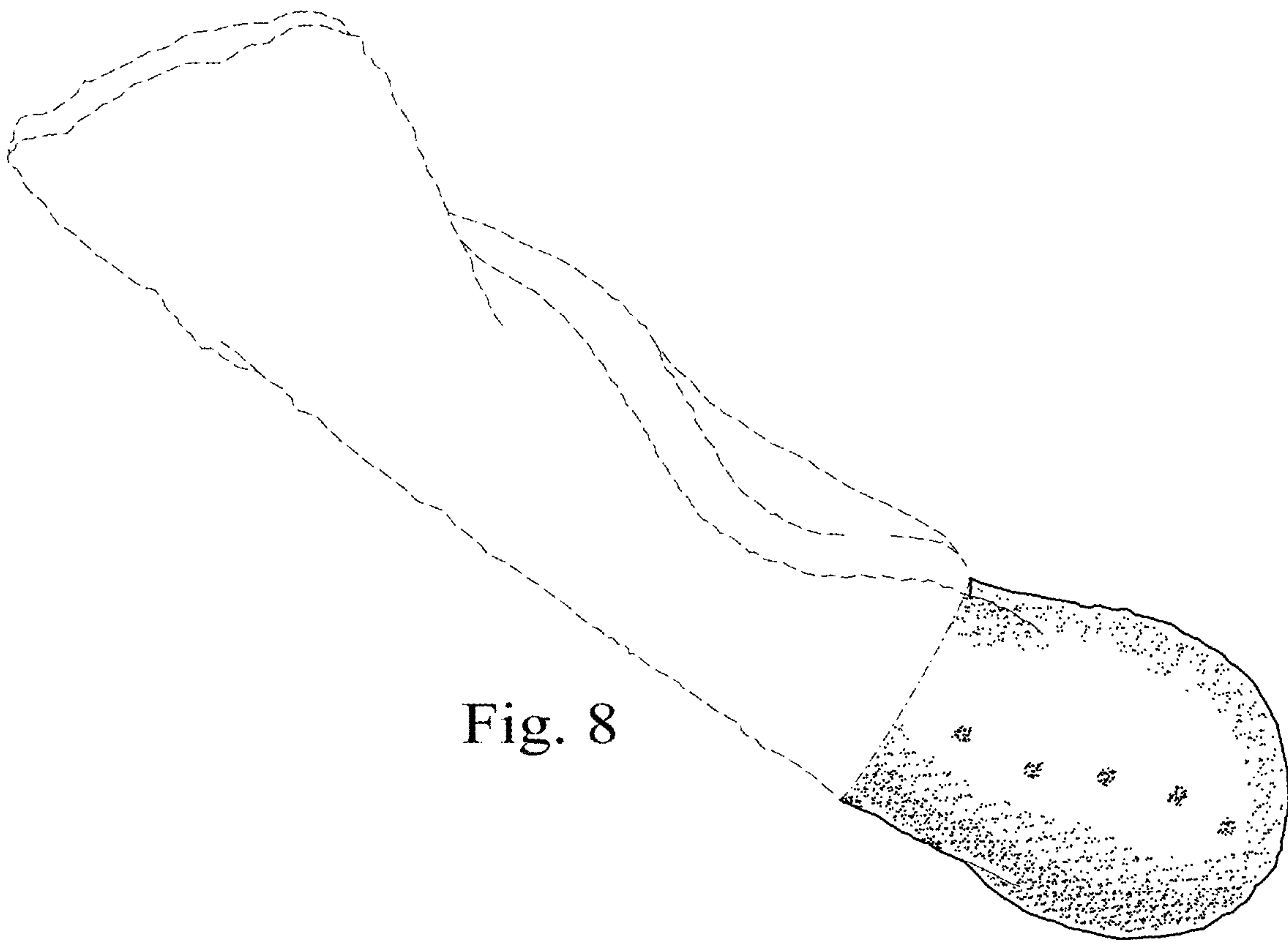
