The ornamental design for an led infrared skin-treatment device and base in combination, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-elevational view of the LED infrared skin-treatment device and base in combination, shown removed from the base;

FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view of the device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view of the device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a front-elevational view of the LED infrared skin-treatment device and base in combination, shown in an alternative configuration with the charging base;

FIG. 10 is a right-side elevational view of the device and base of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the device and base of FIG. 8;

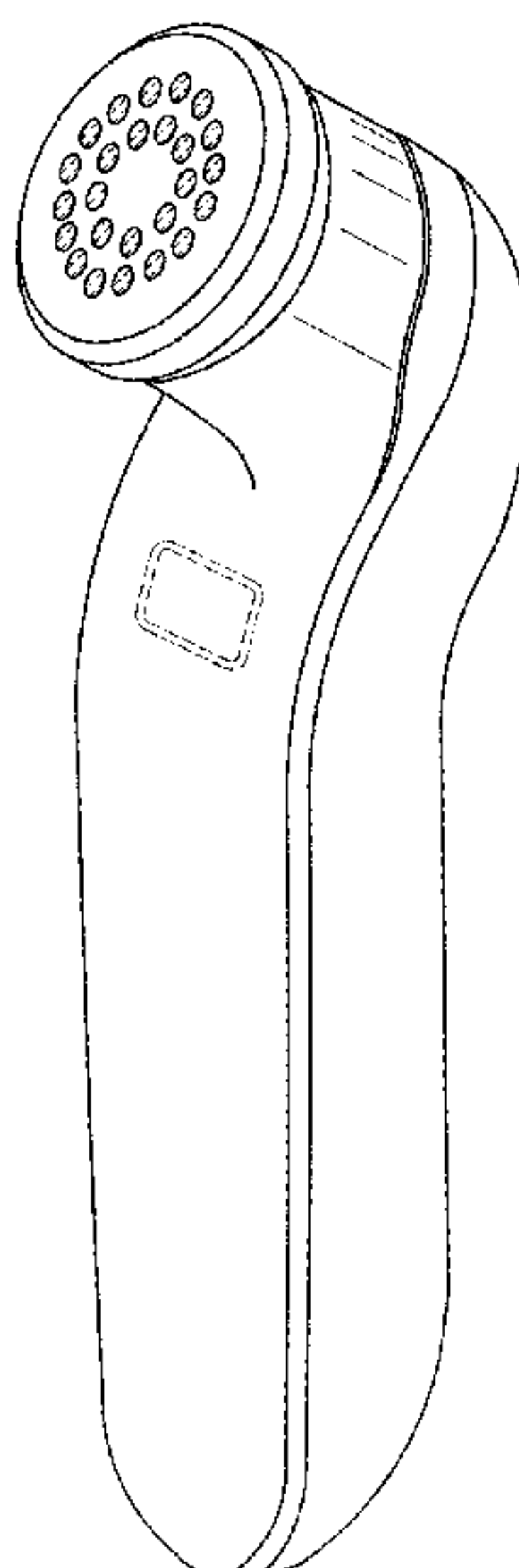
FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of the device and base of FIG. 8;

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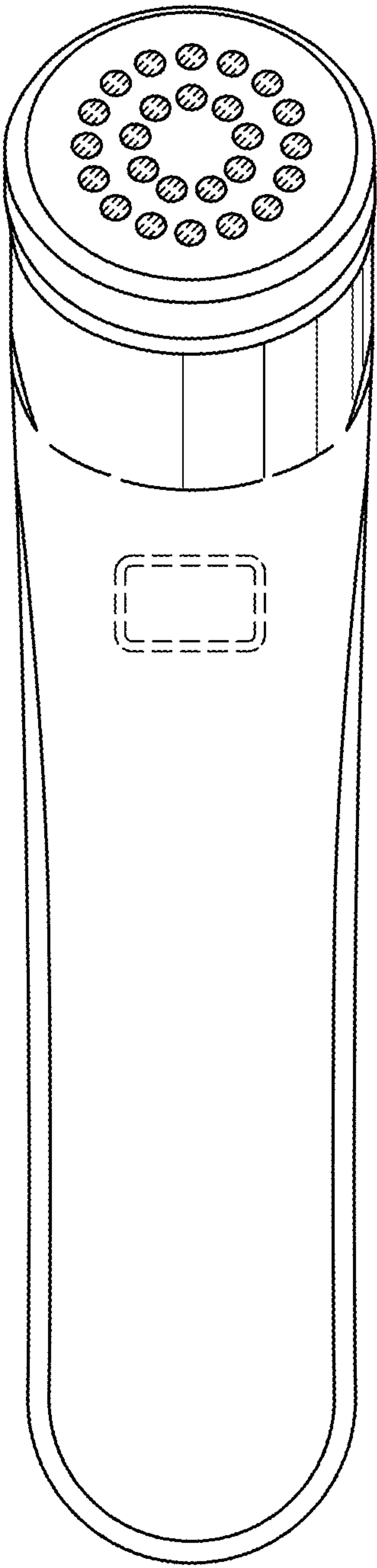

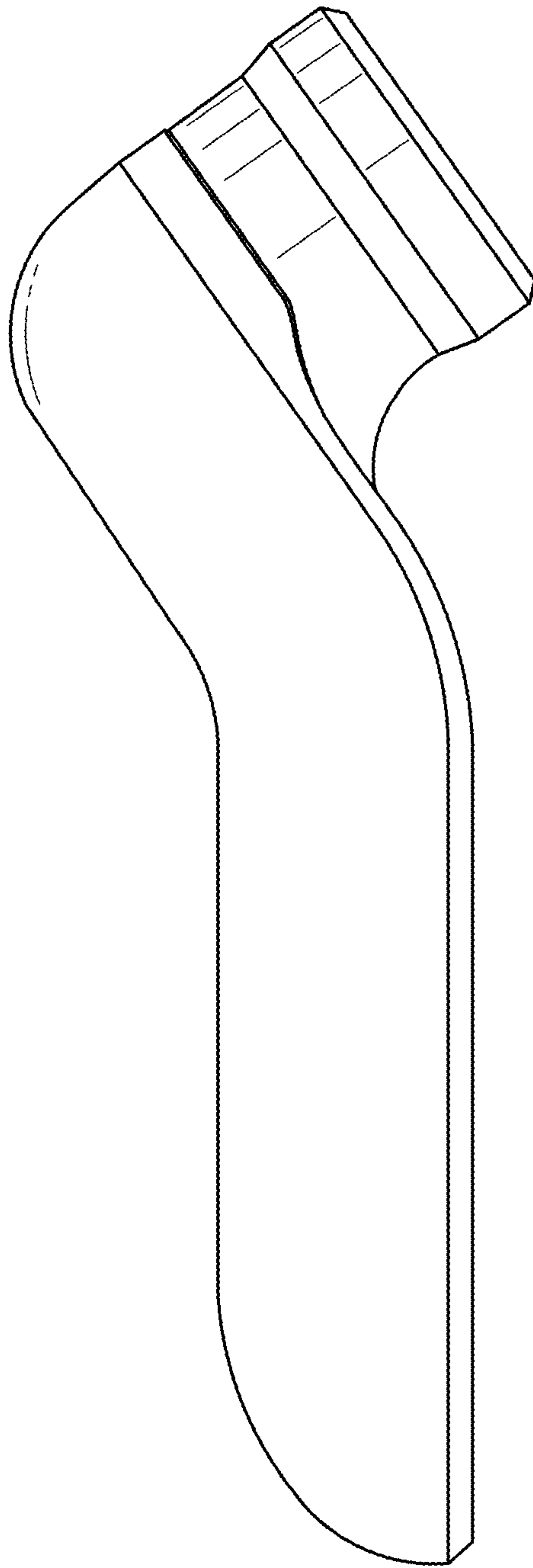

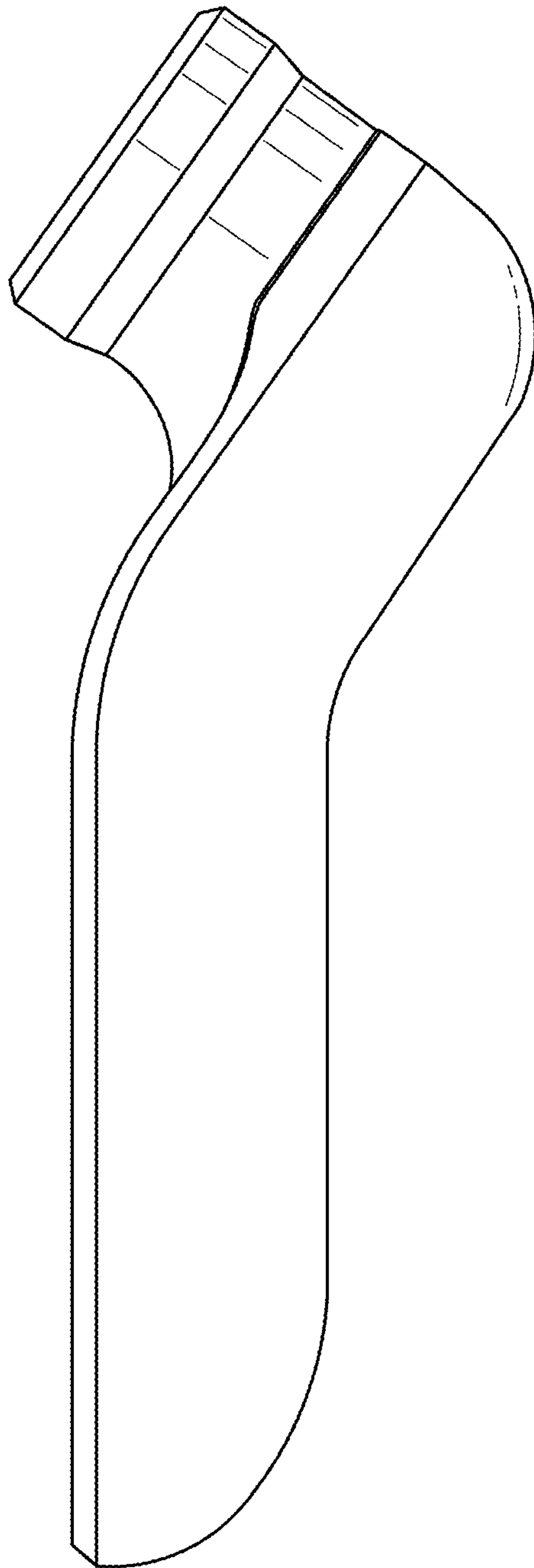

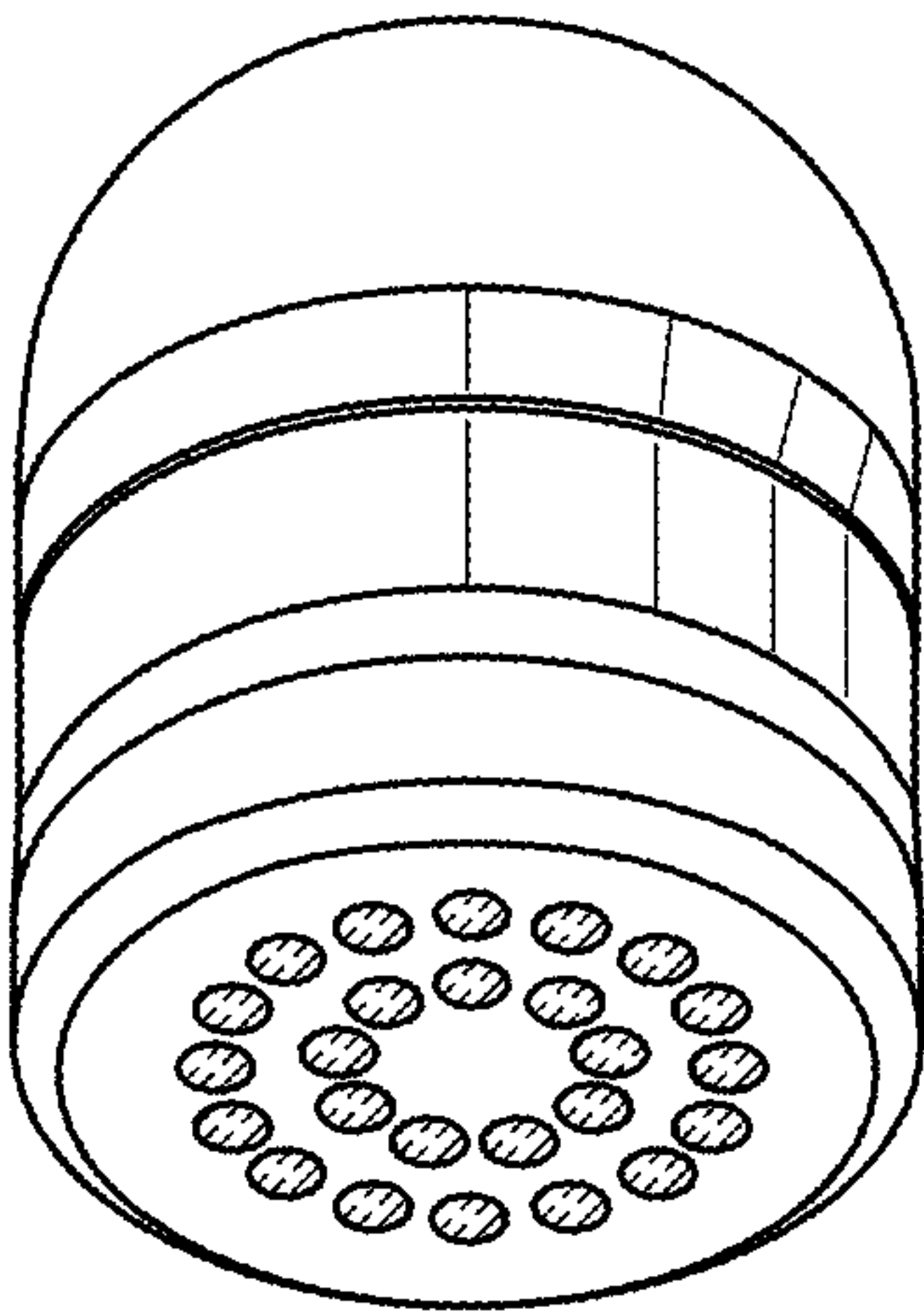

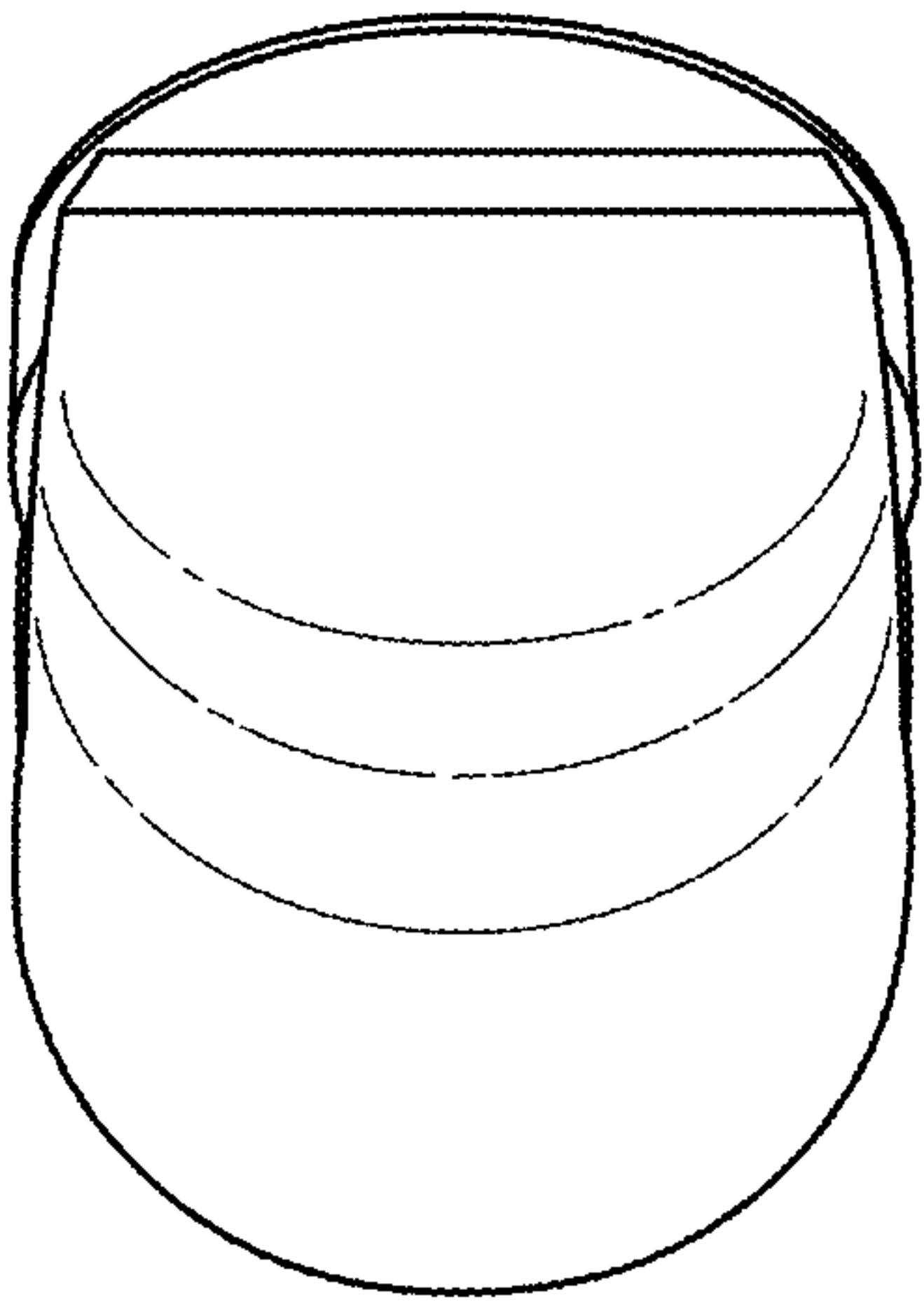

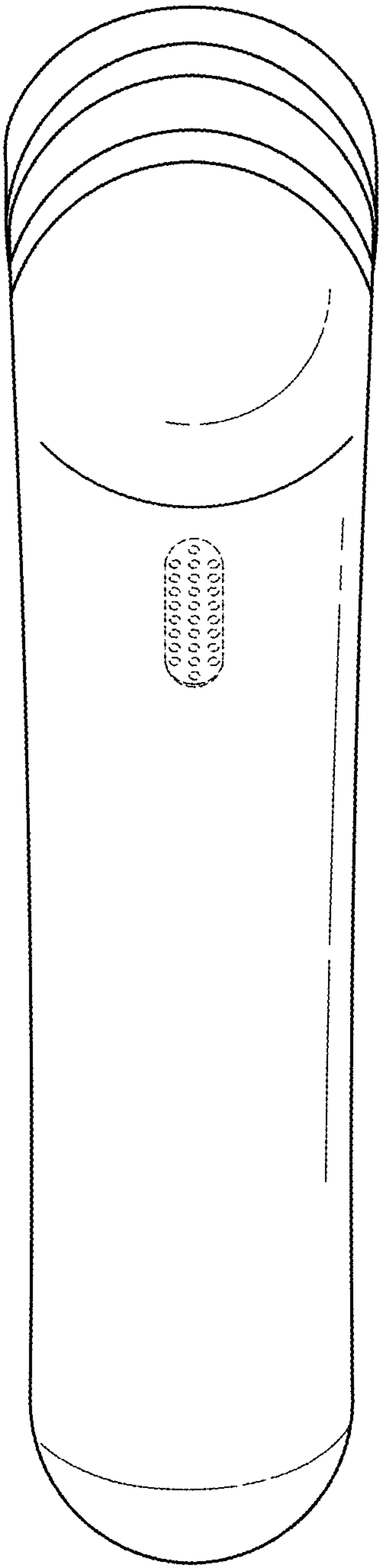

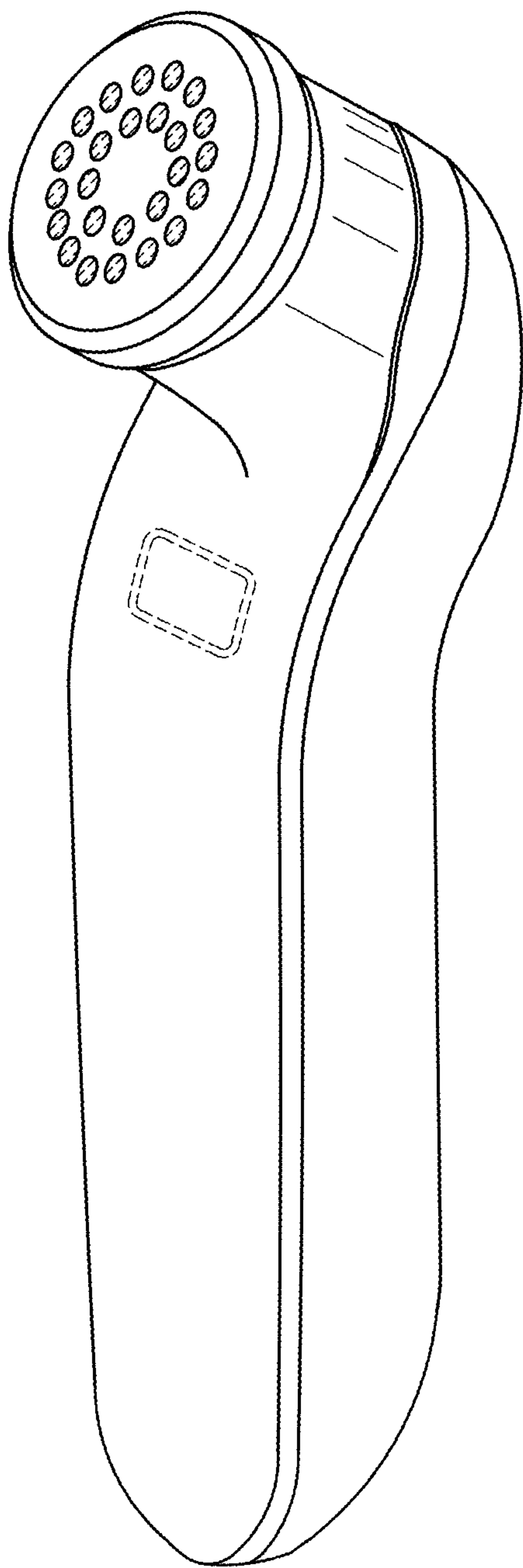

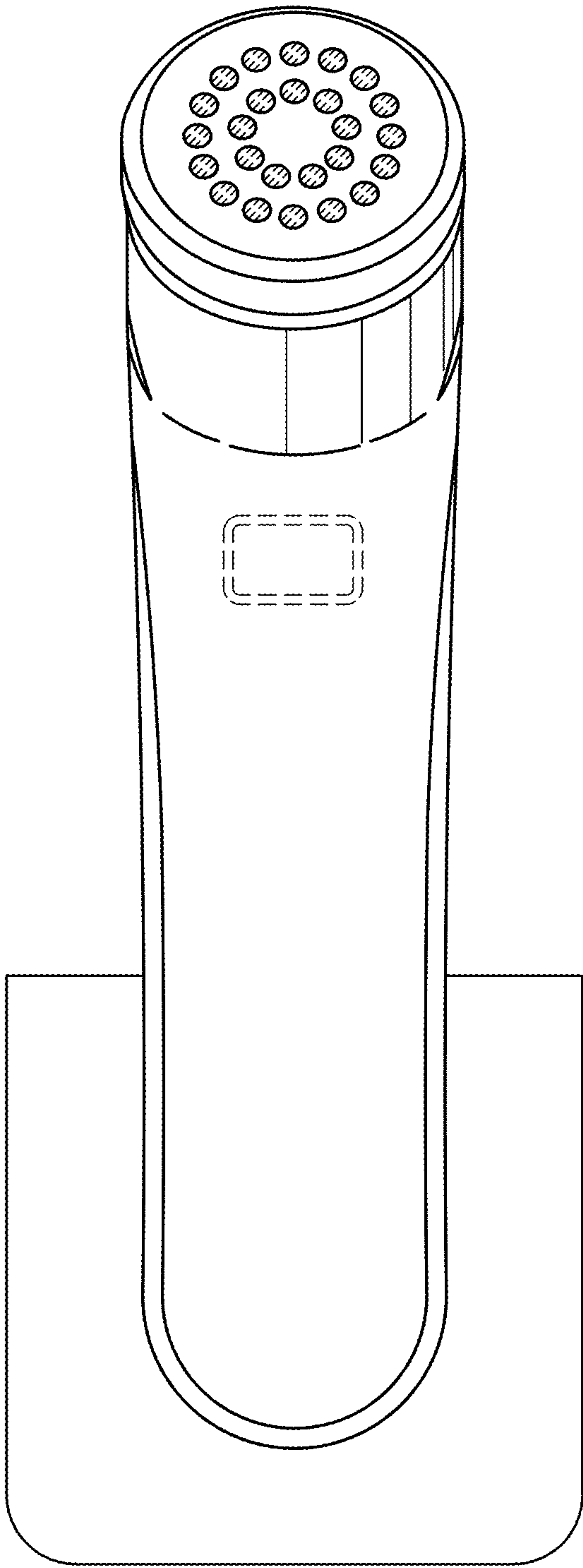

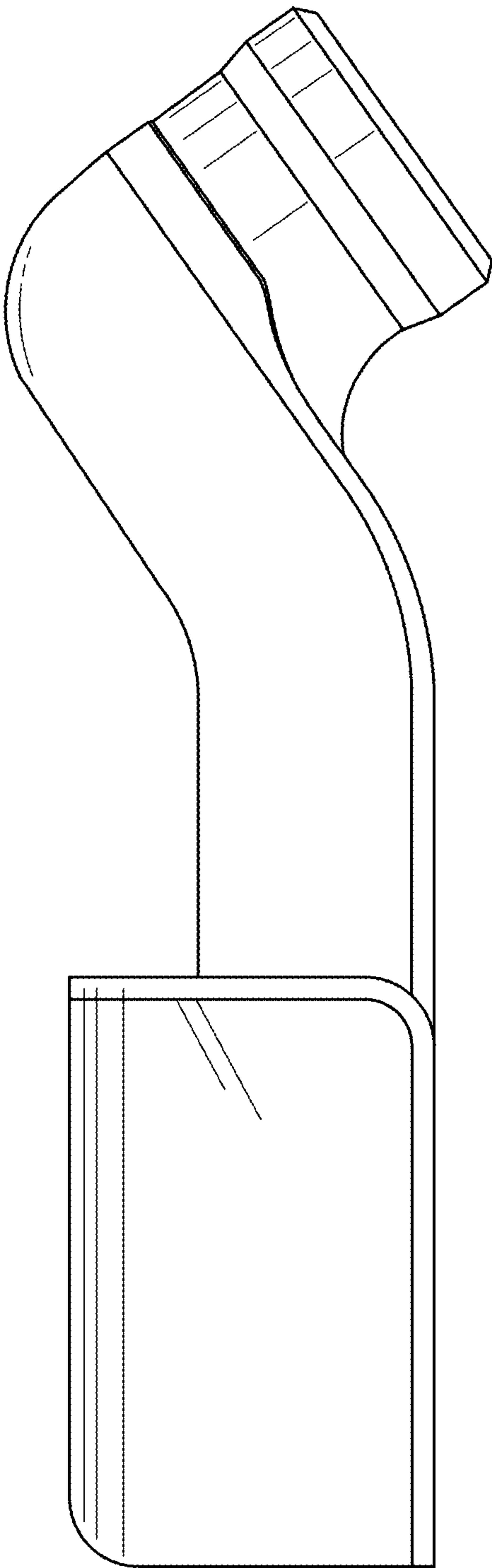

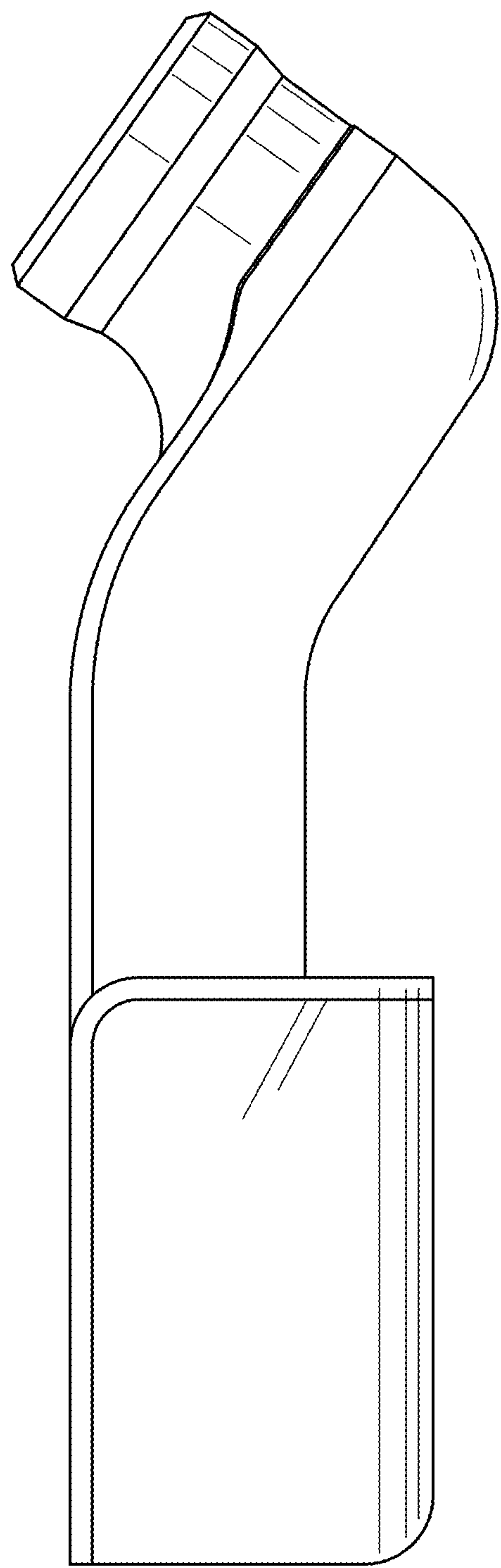

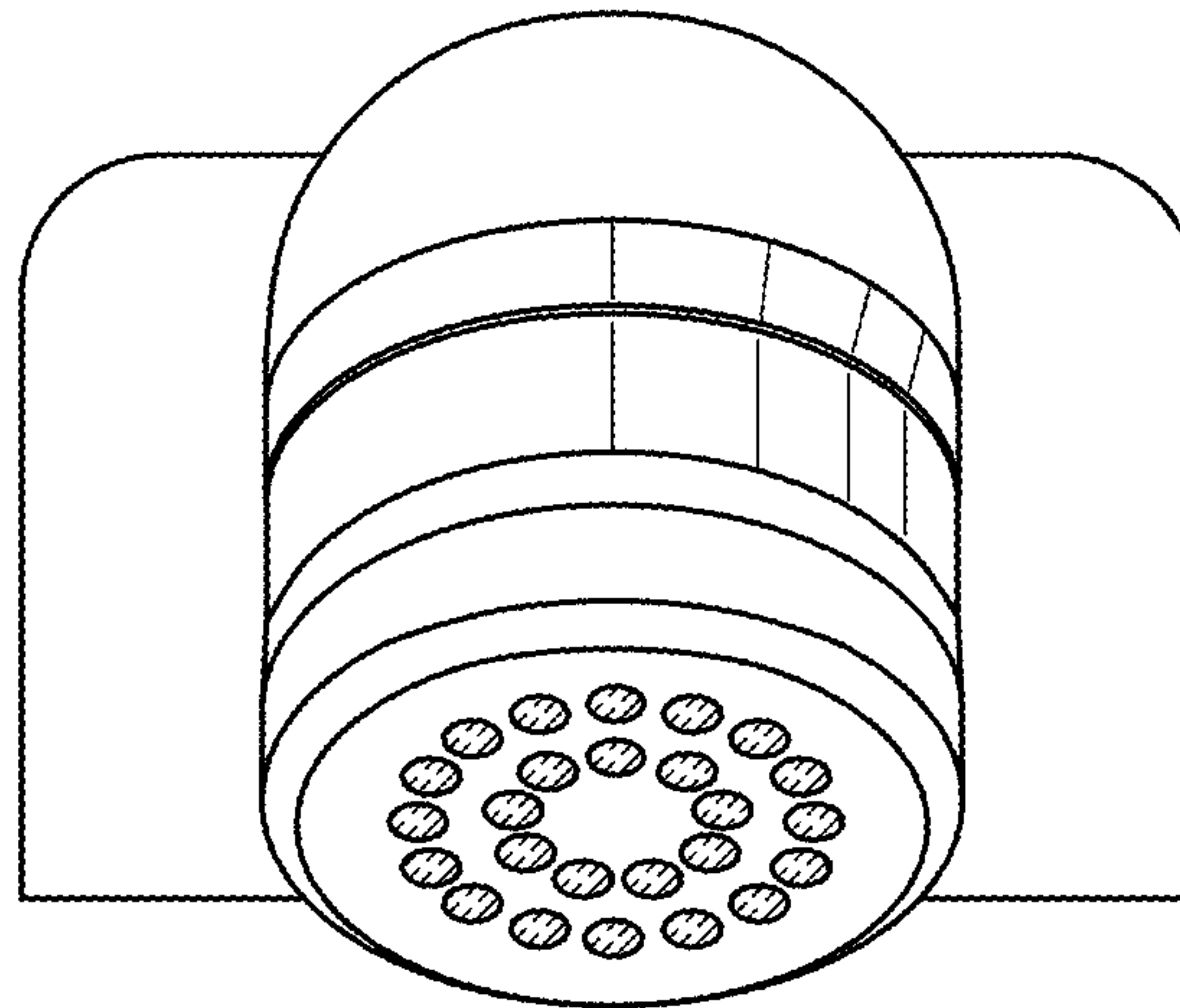

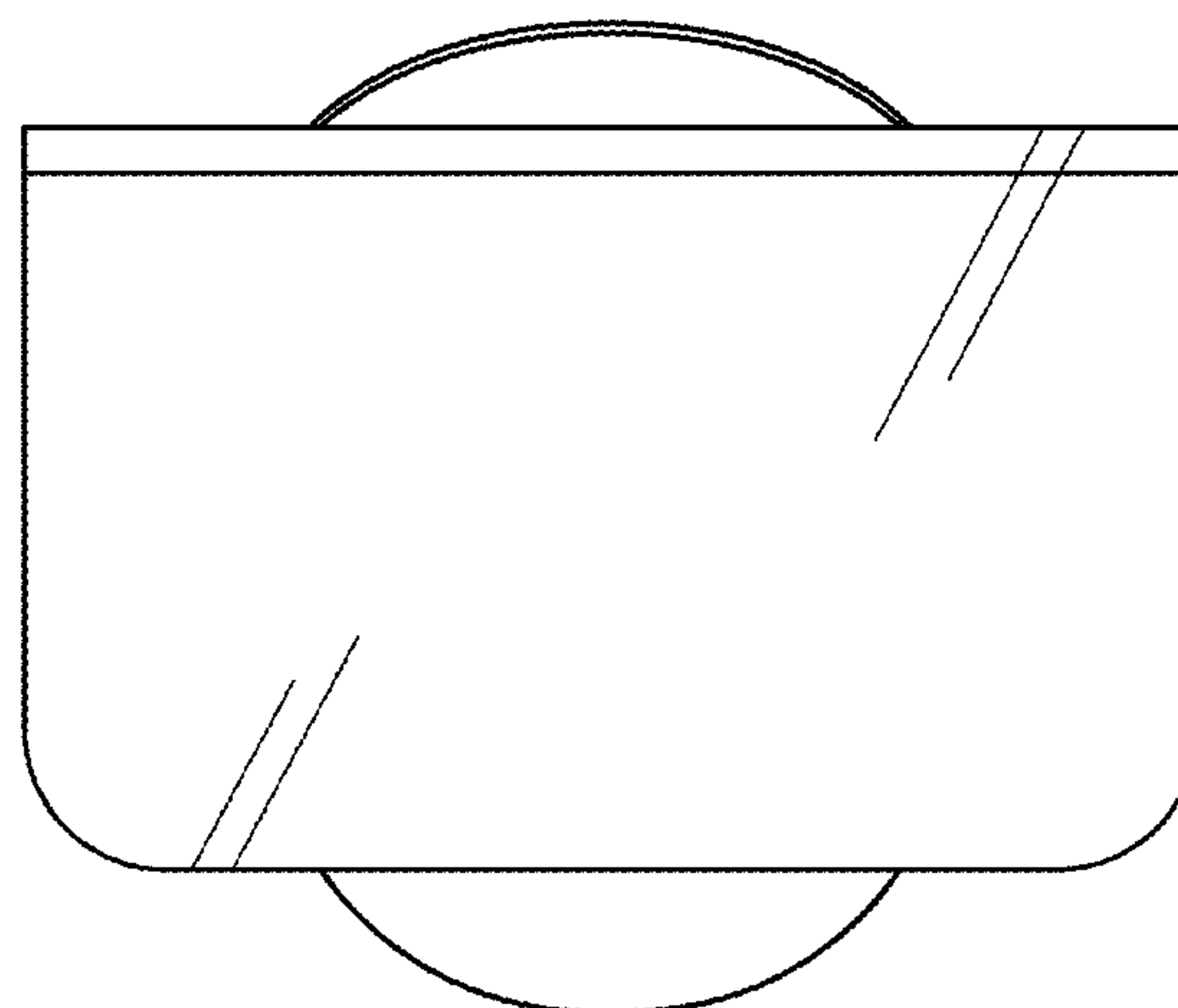

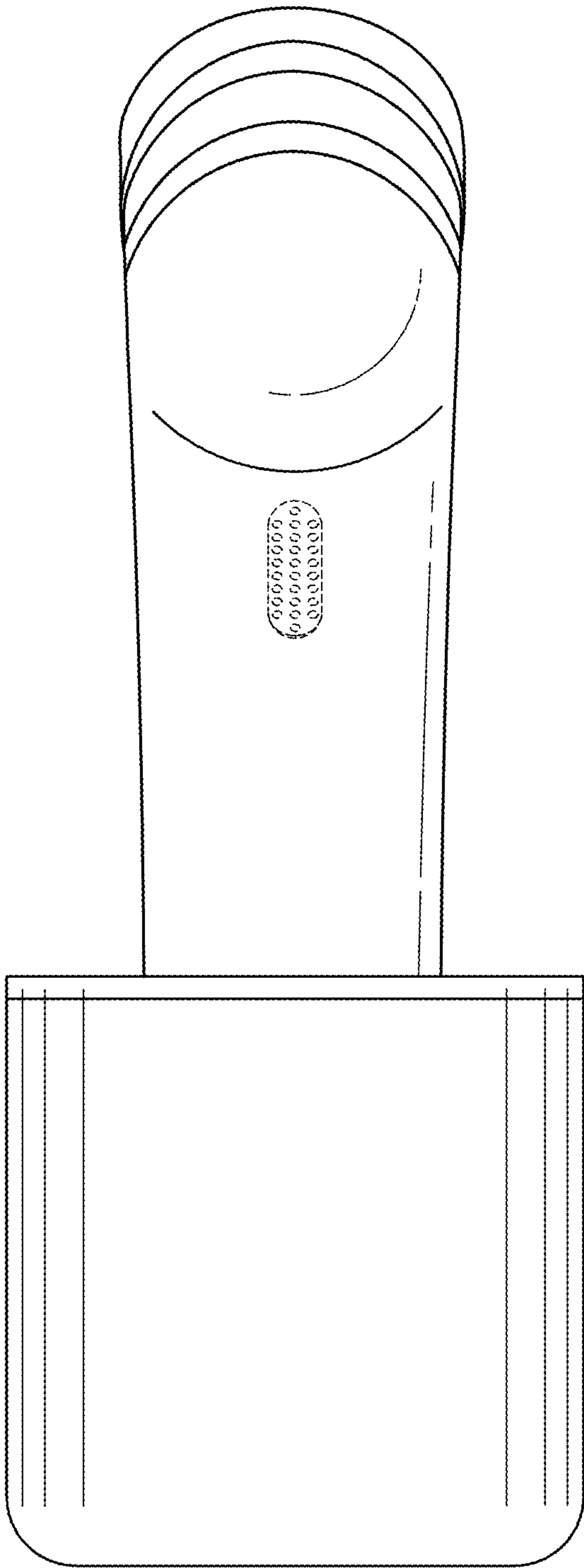

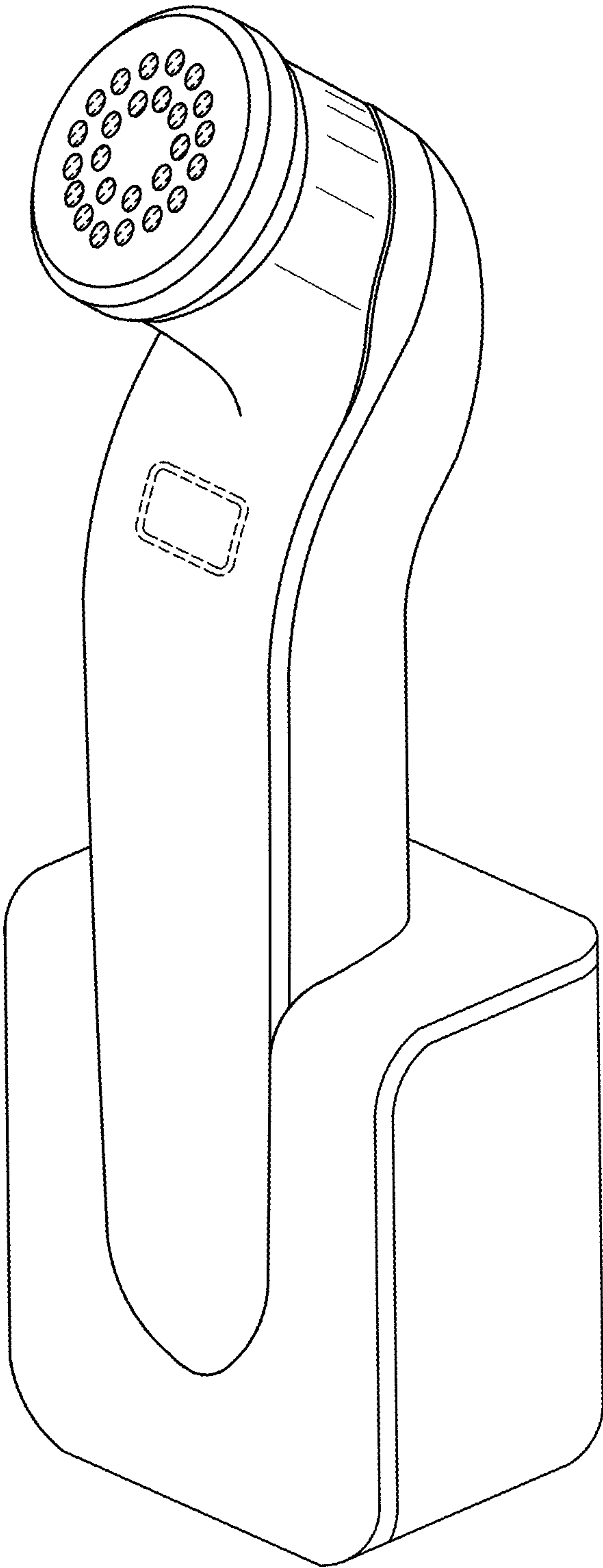
