a soffit mounting device embodying our new design;

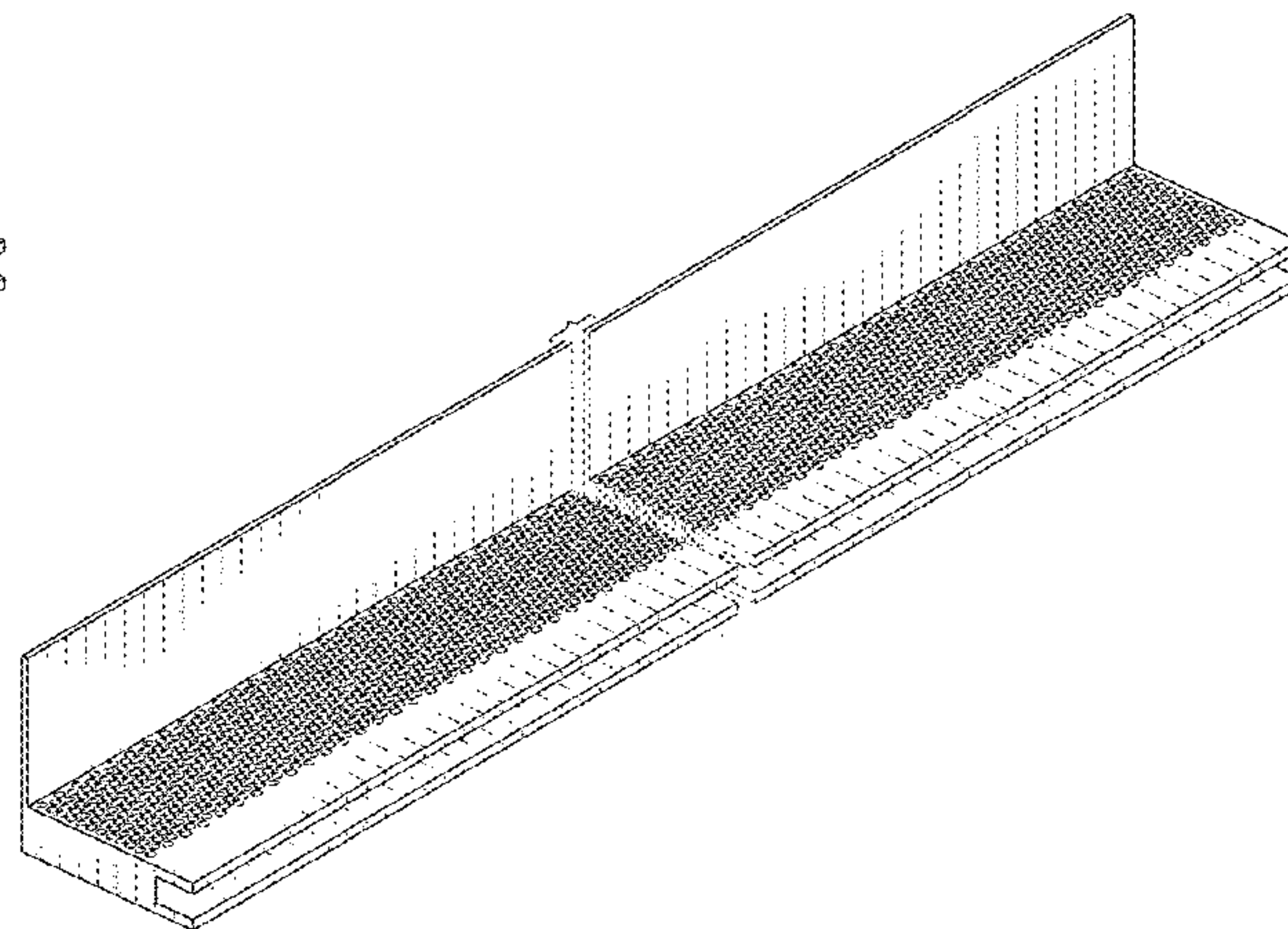
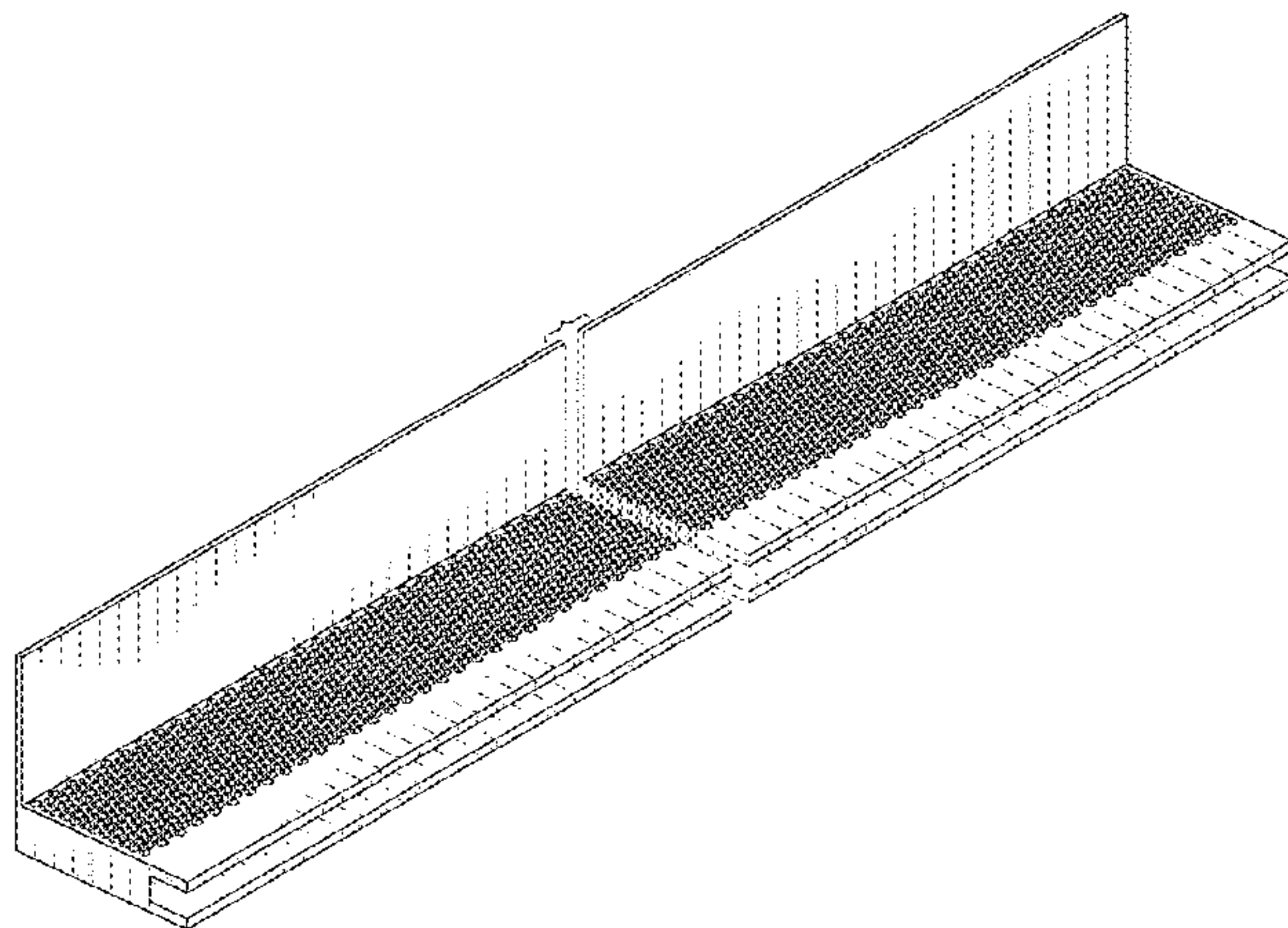
FIG. 10 is a left side profile view of the second embodiment

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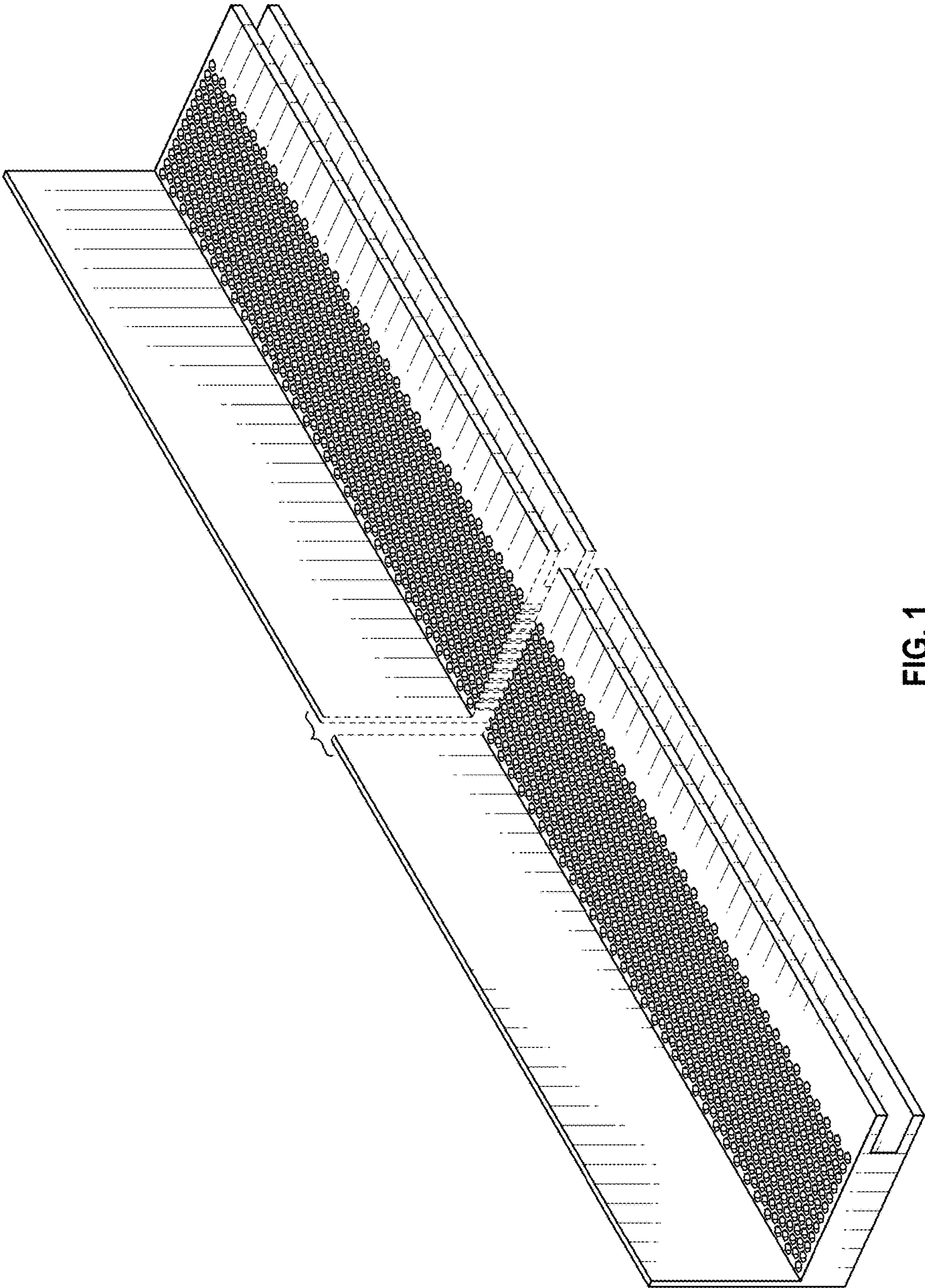

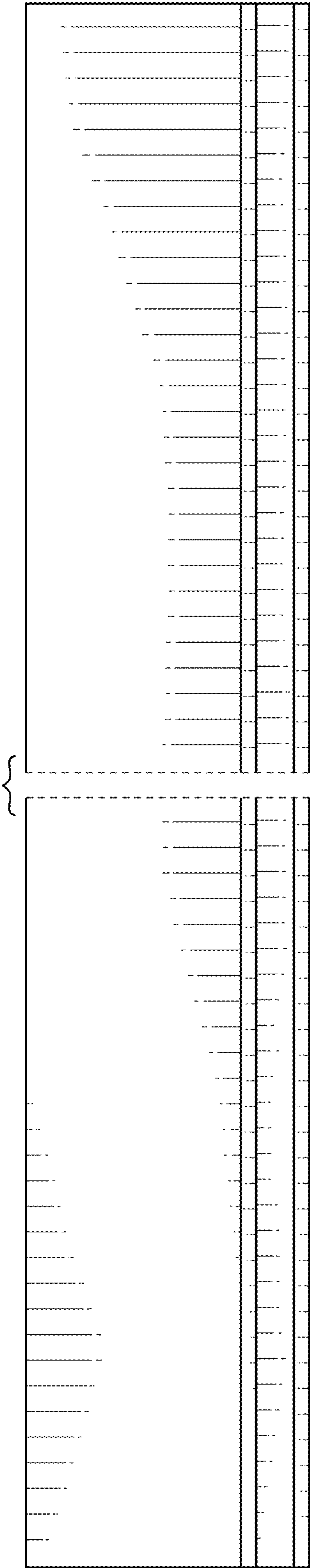

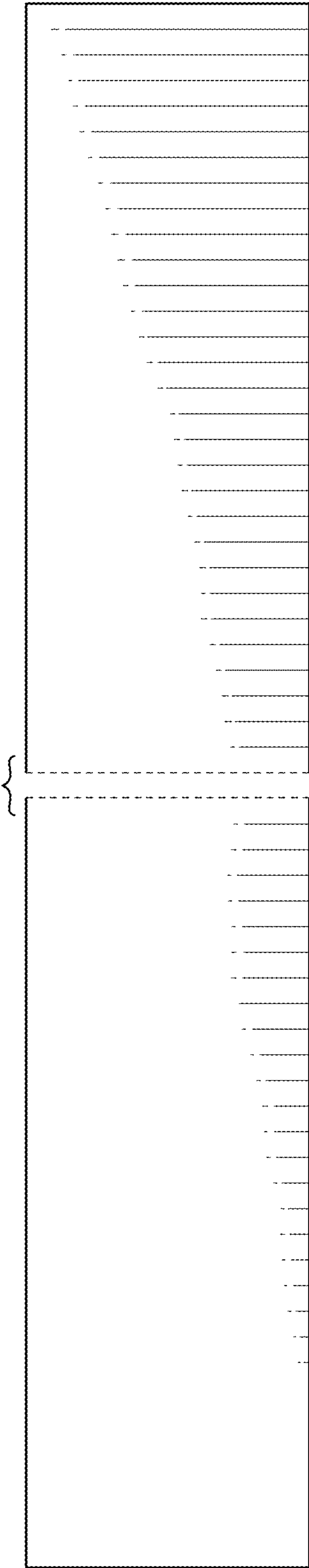

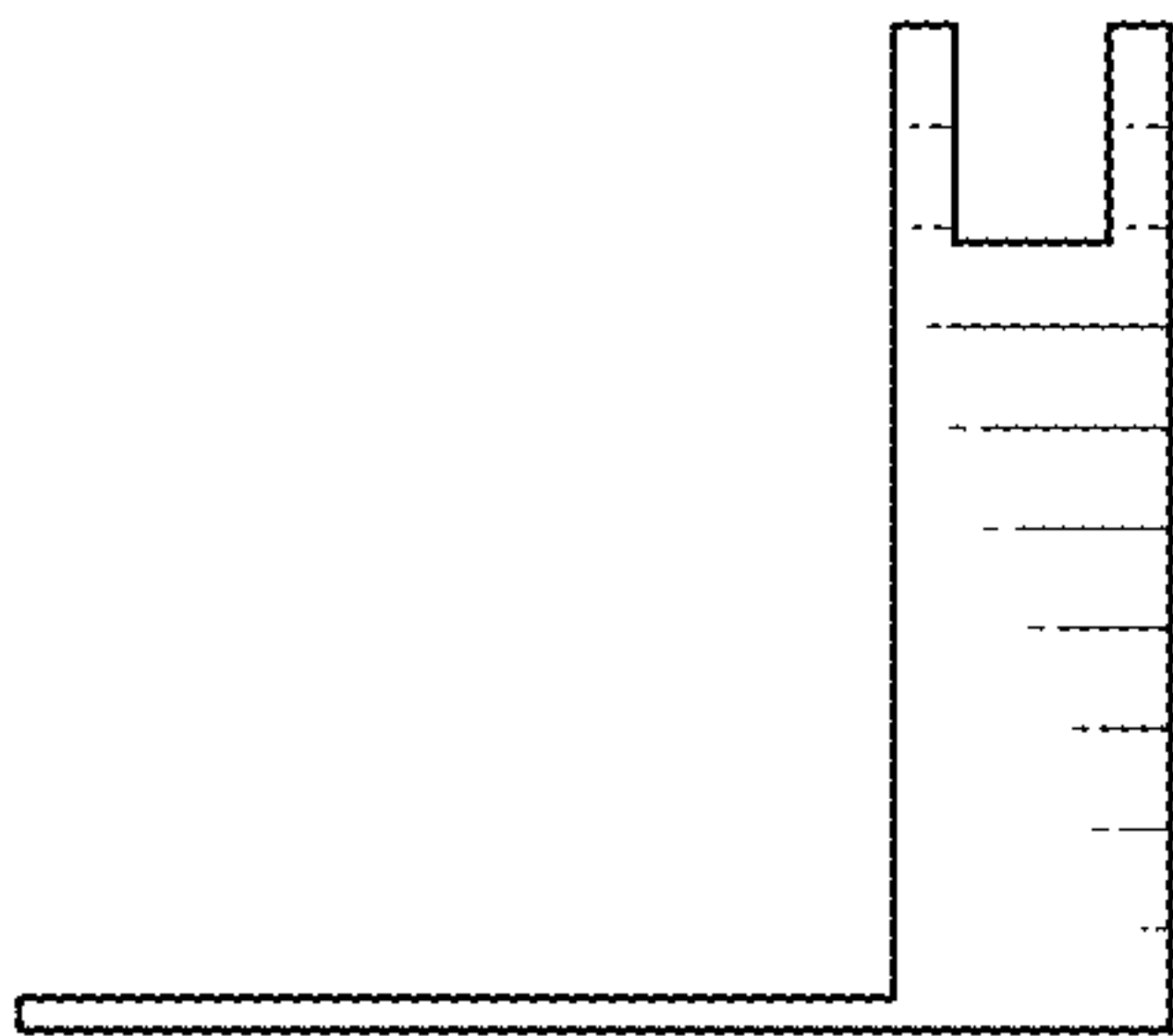

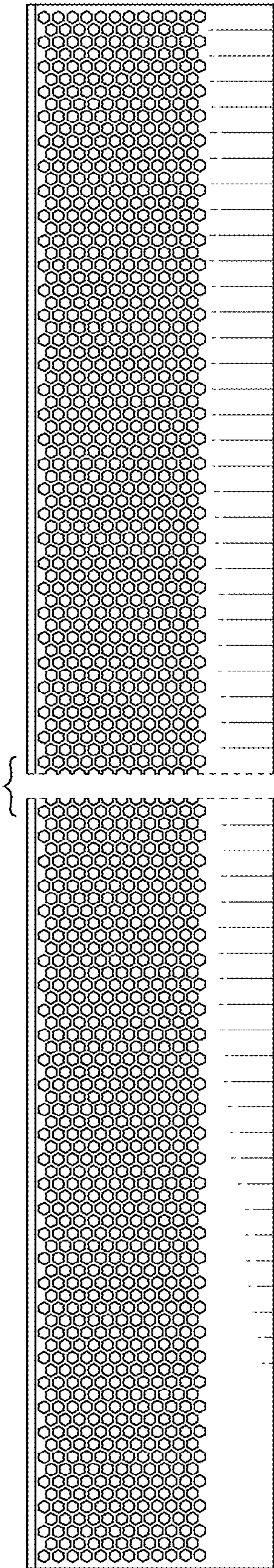

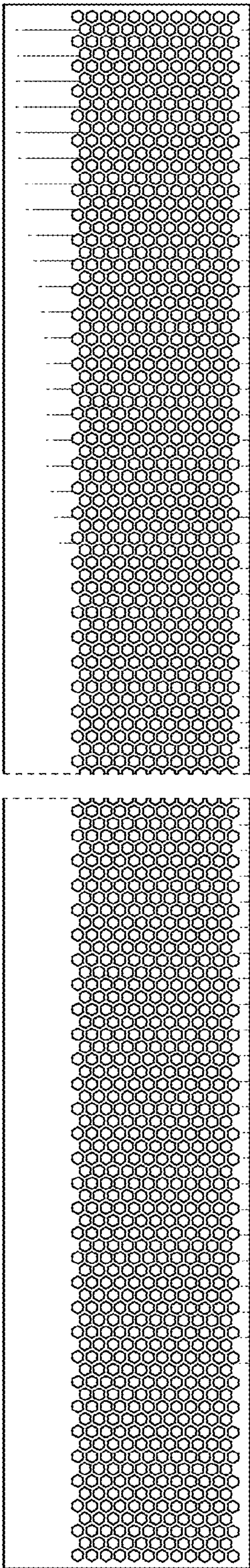

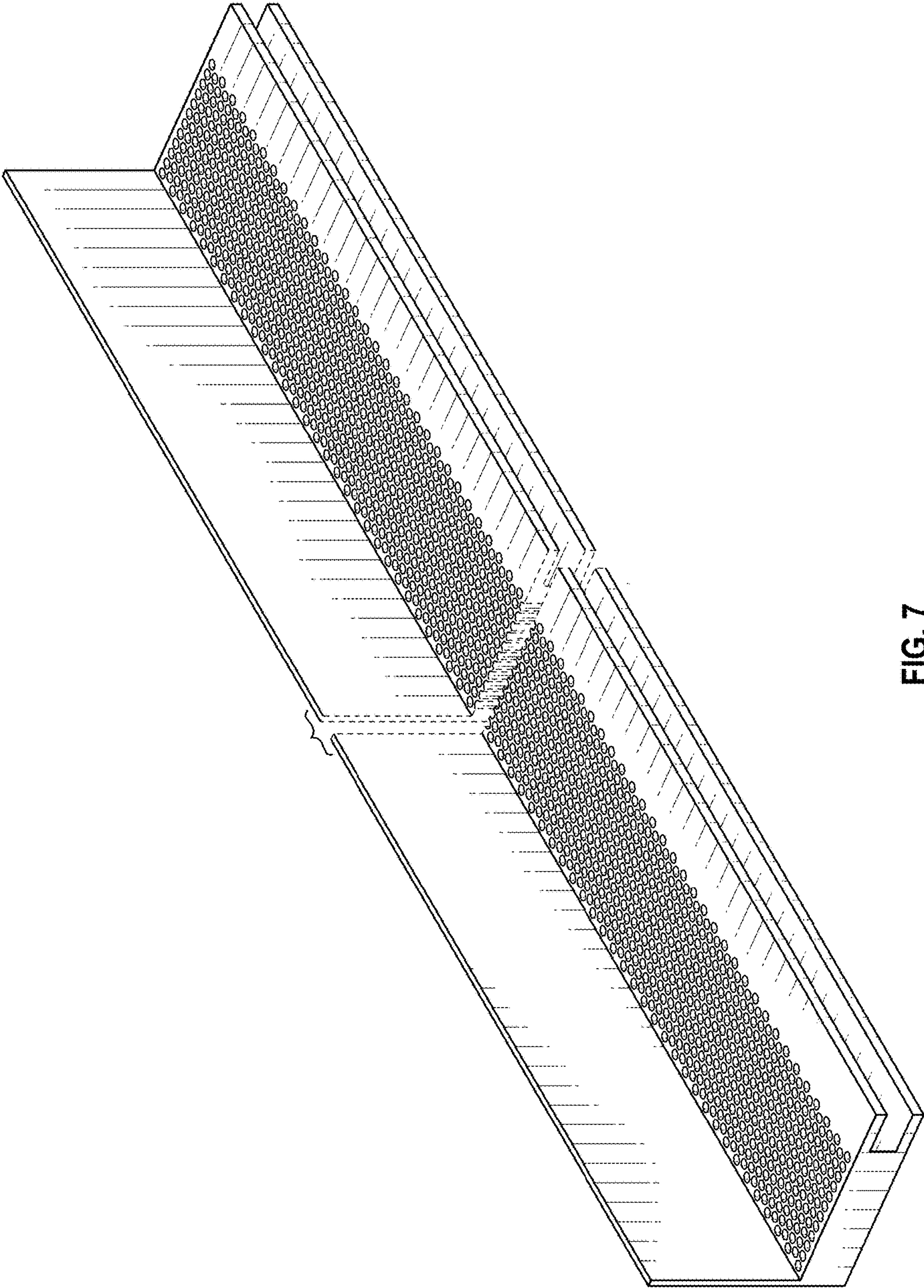

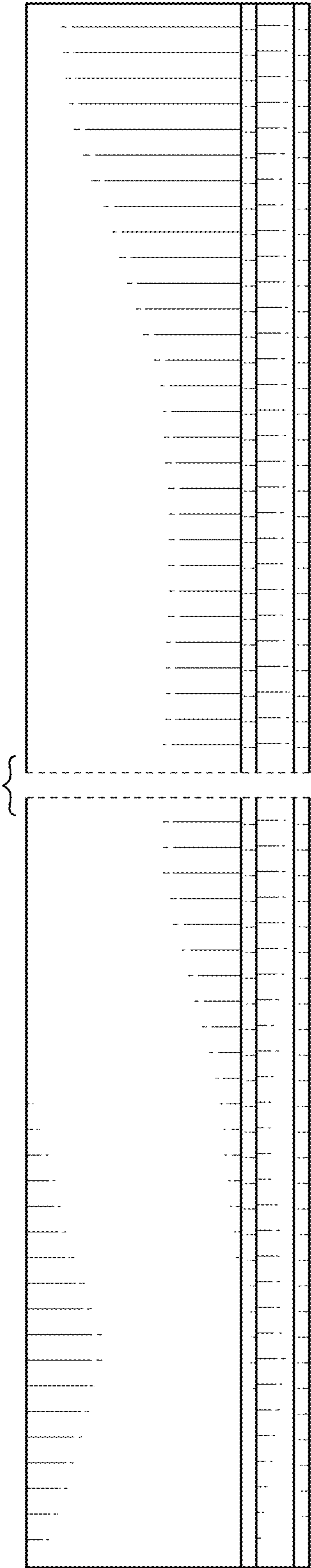

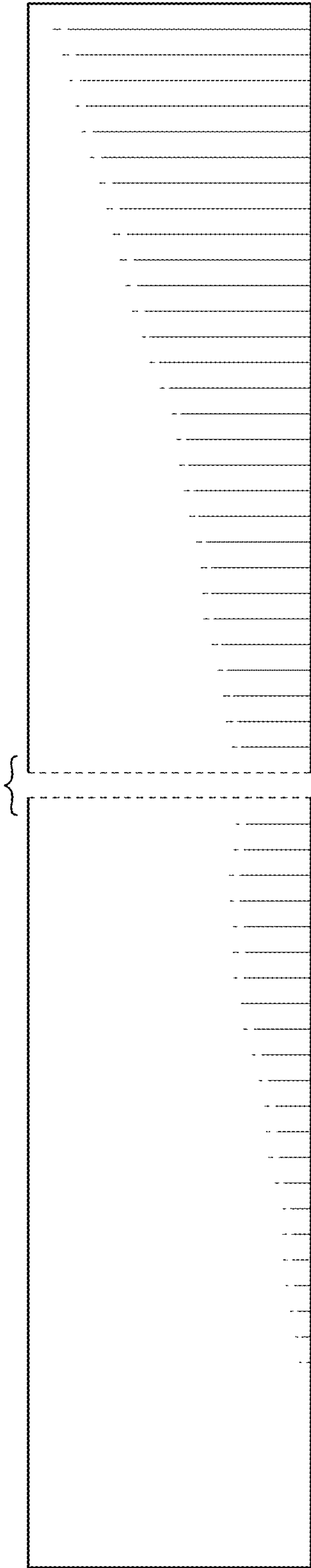

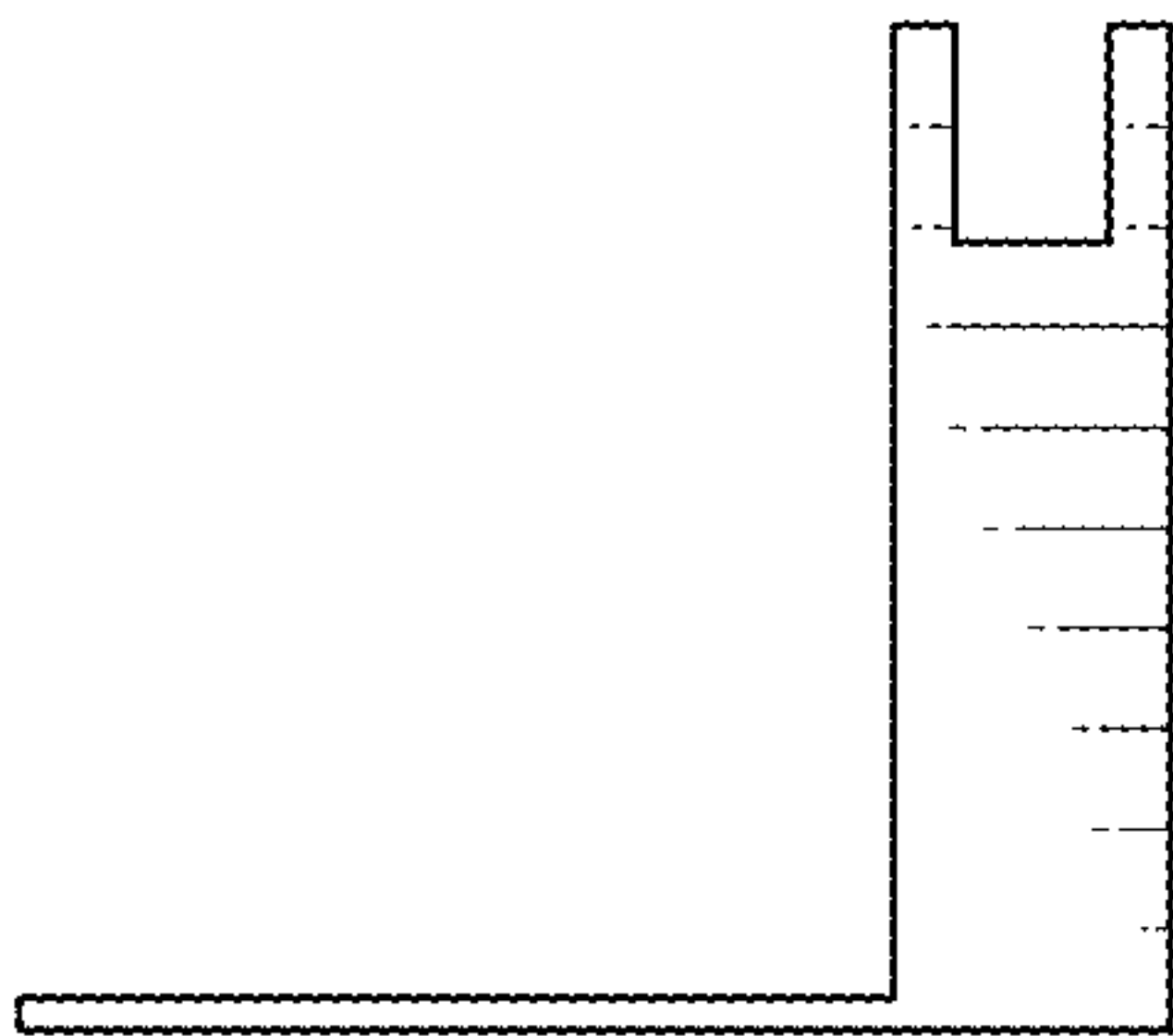

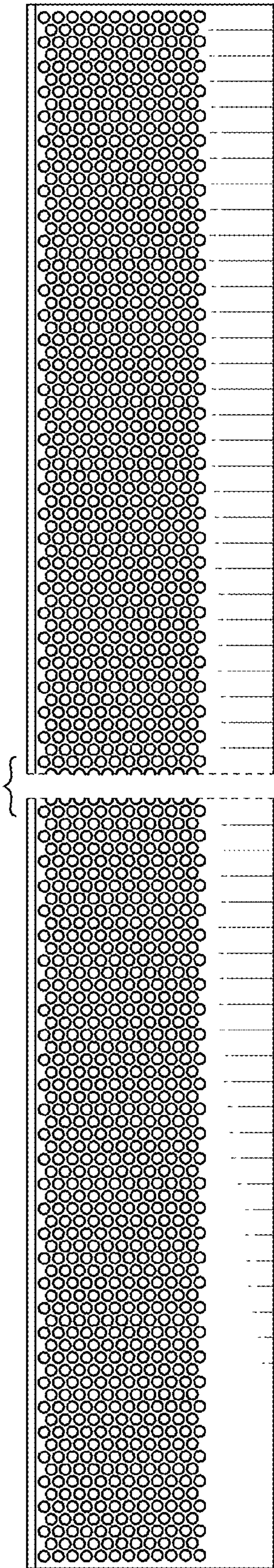

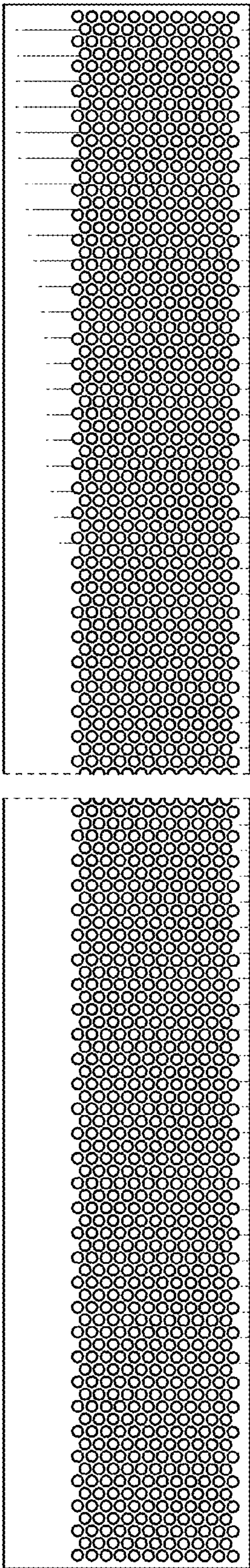
