(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an ATV and/or UTV garage bag,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front, top, and left sides
of an embodiment of an ATV and/or UTV garage bag with
a partially peripherally-extending zipper showing our new

design with the zippers and bag in a closed/zipped condition
and the zippers covered by a storm flap;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the rear, bottom, and left
sides thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;

of a second embodiment of an ATV and/or UTV garage bag
with a partially peripherally-extending zipper and a plurality
of opposing pairs of corner cinching straps with selectively
lockable/unlockable, male/female buckles showing our new
design with the zippers and bag in a closed/zipped condition
and the zippers covered by a storm flap;

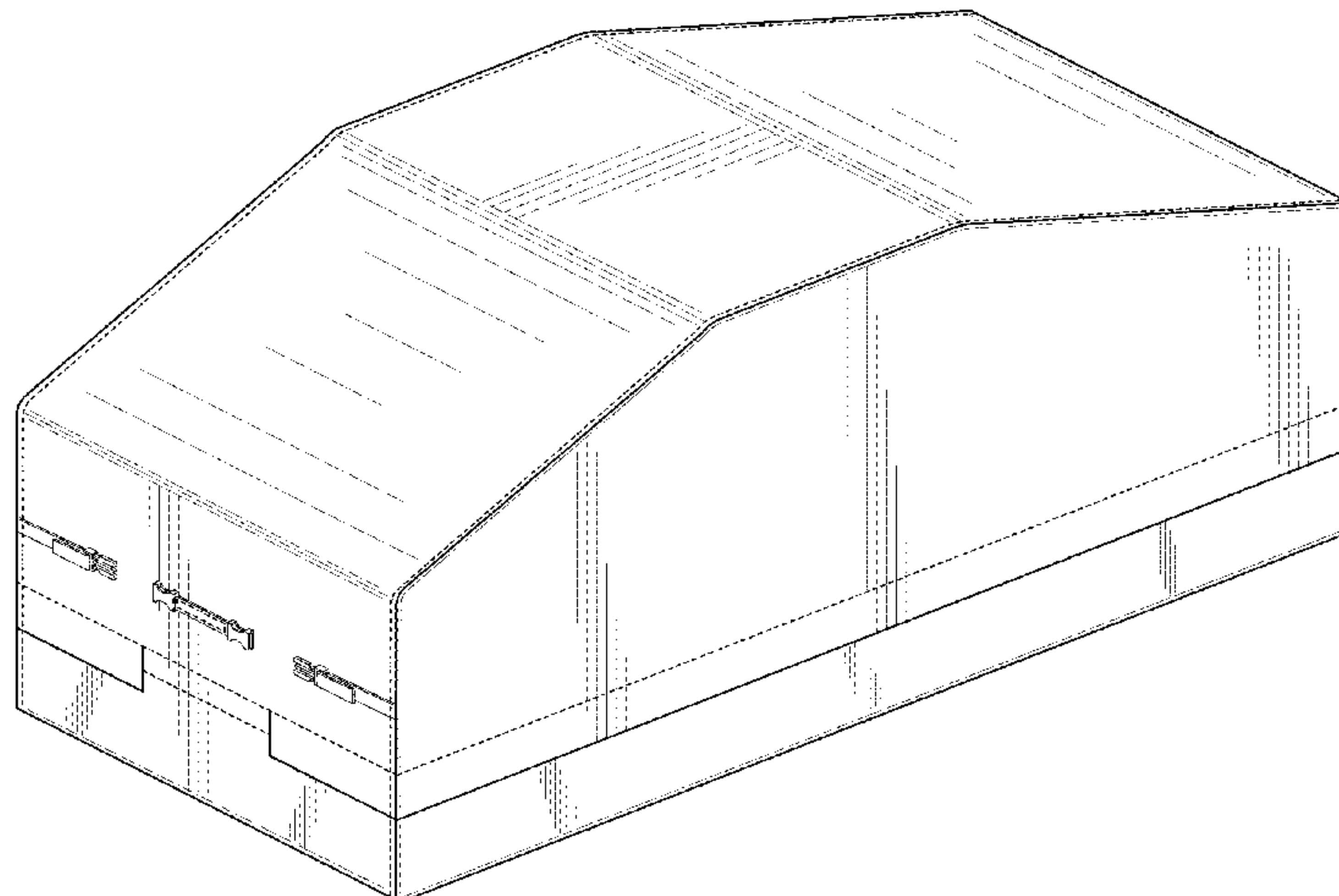


FIG. 26 is a rear view of the bag of FIG. 23;

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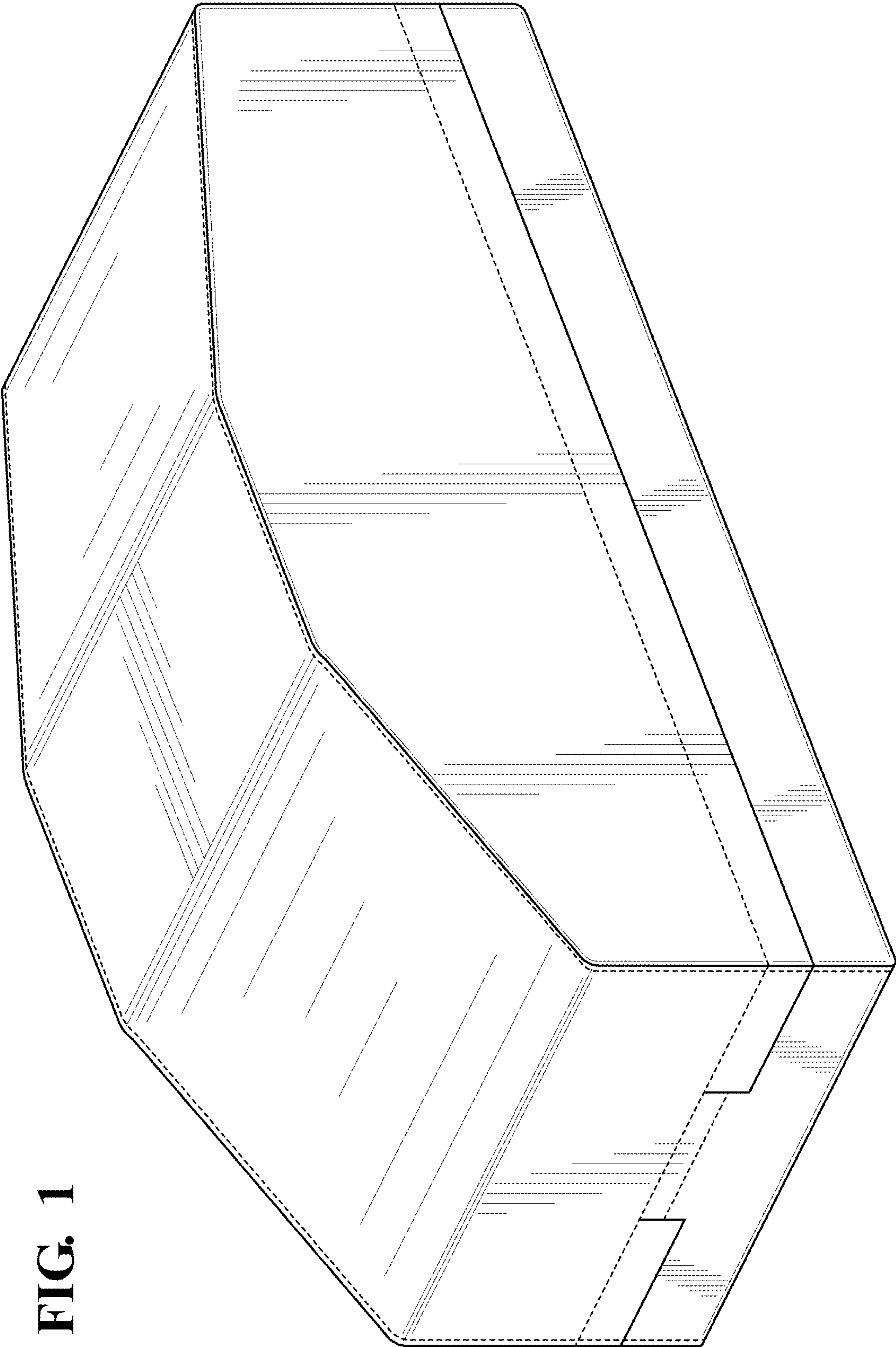

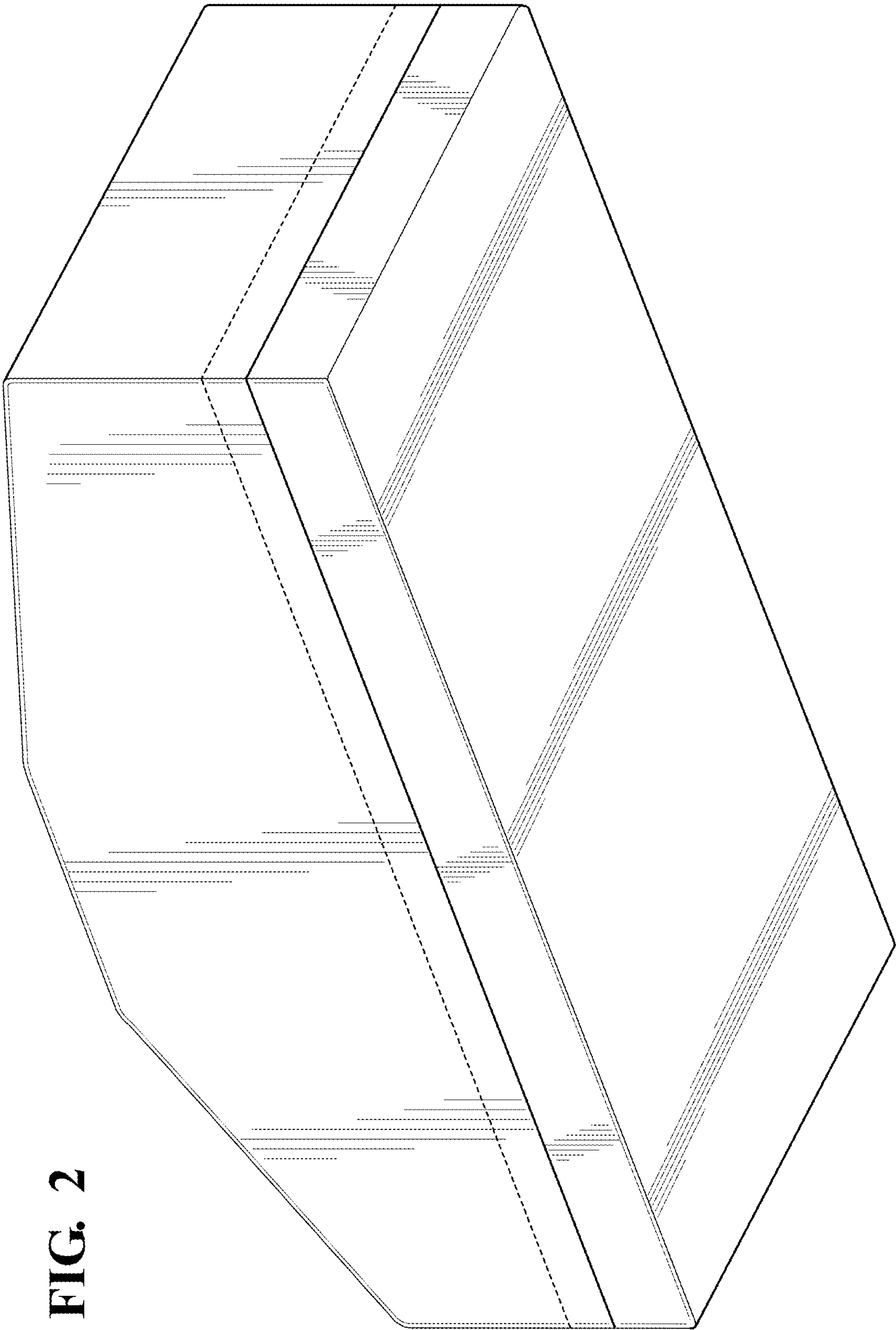

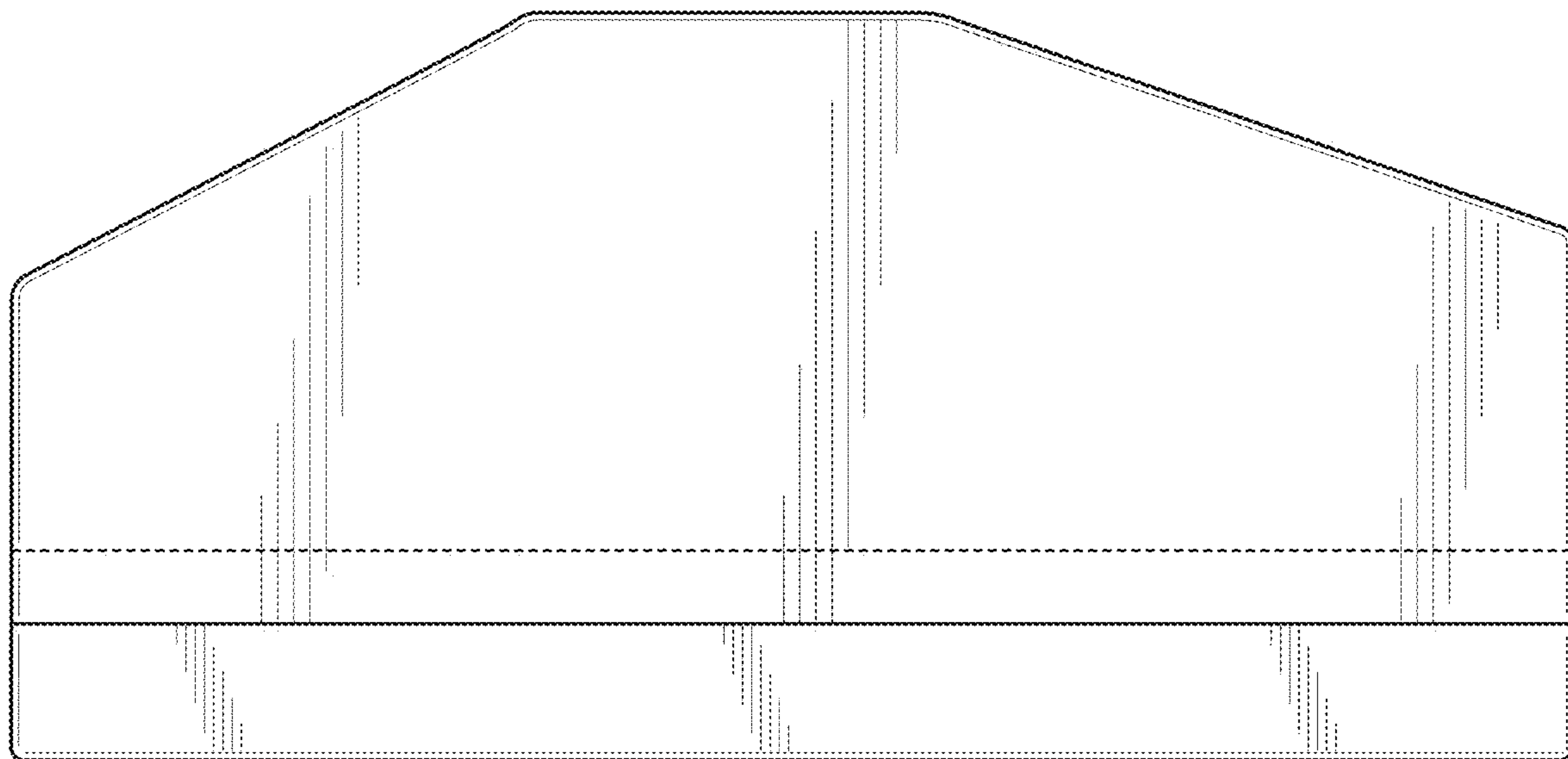

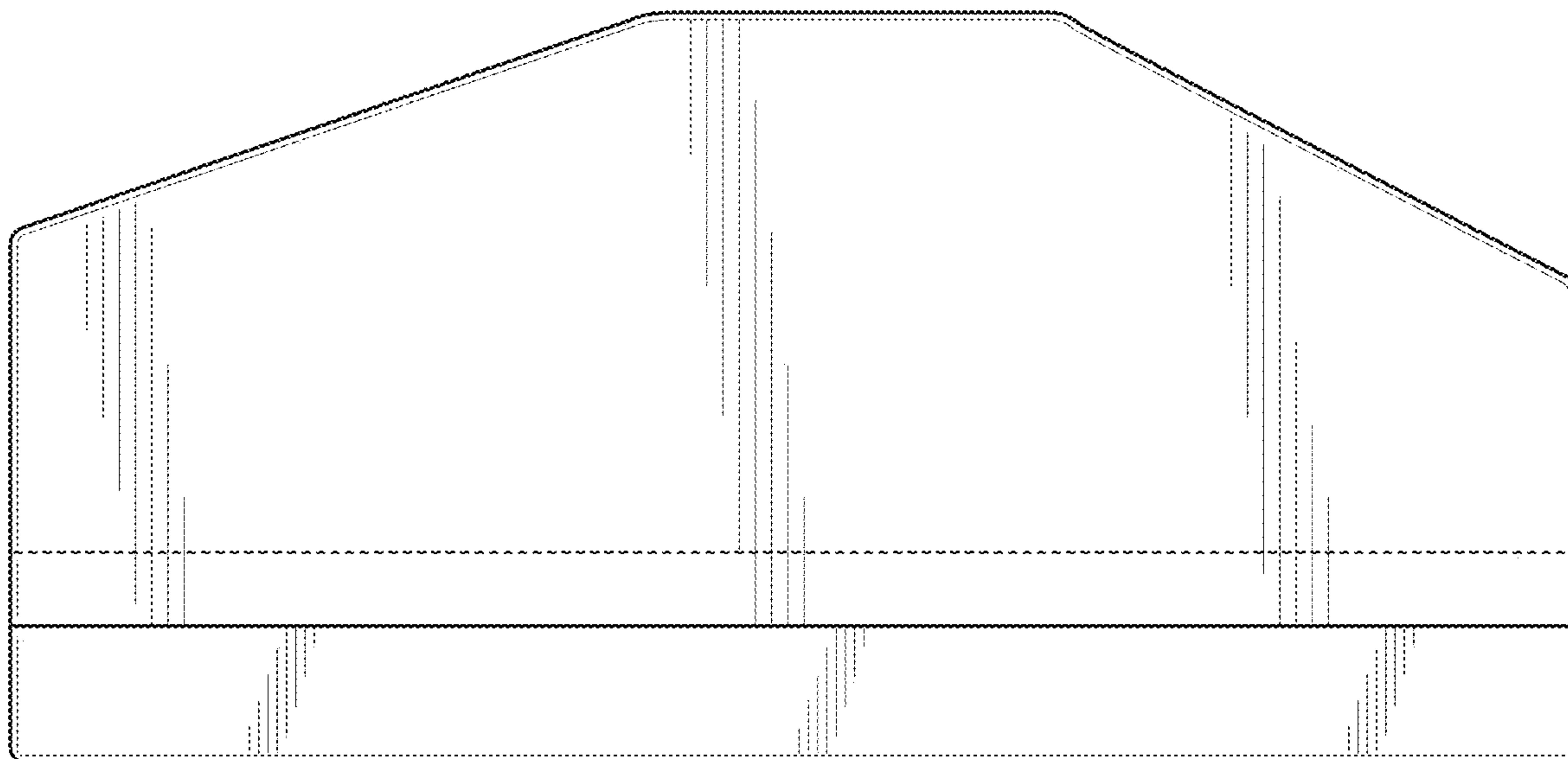

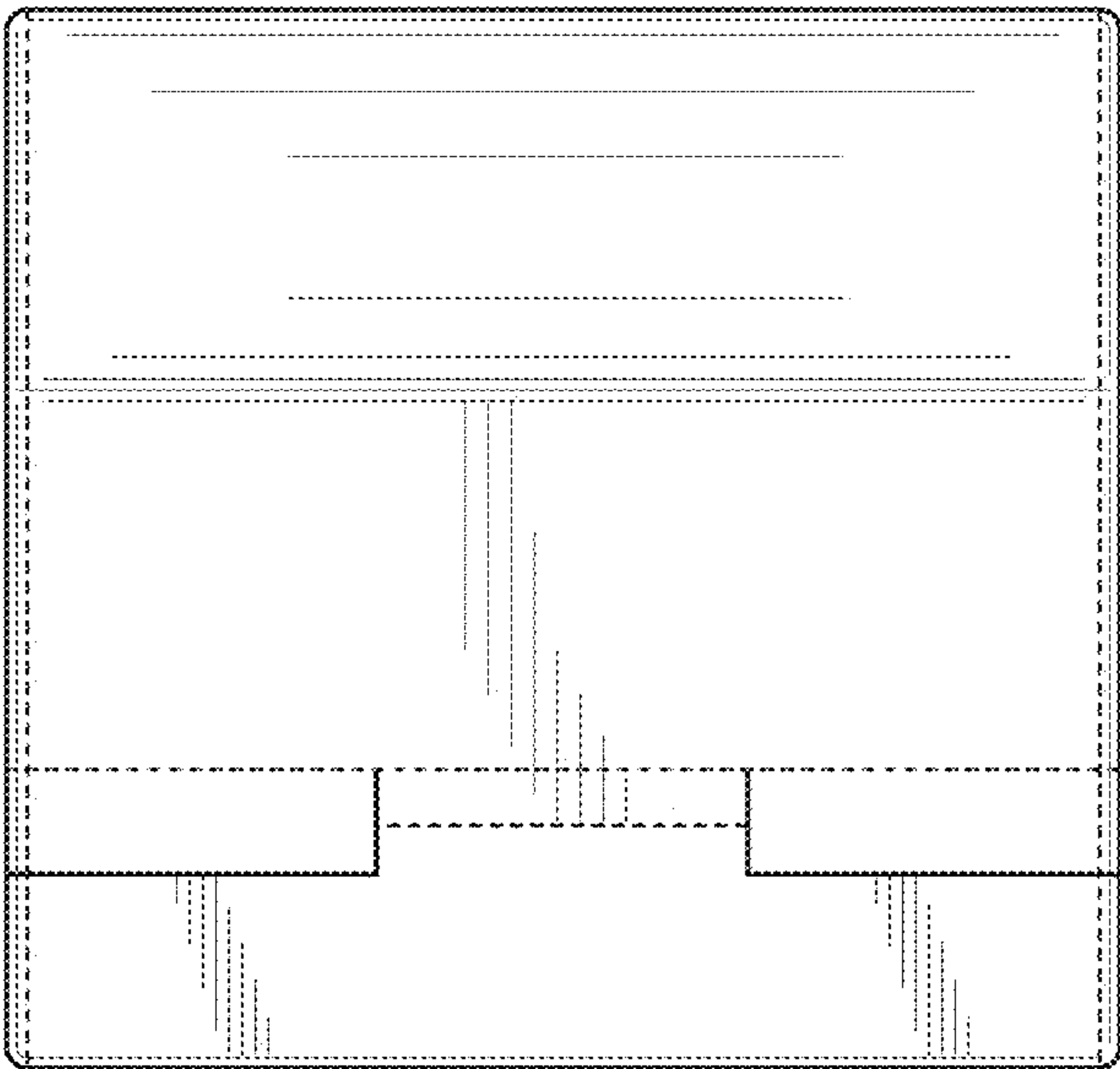

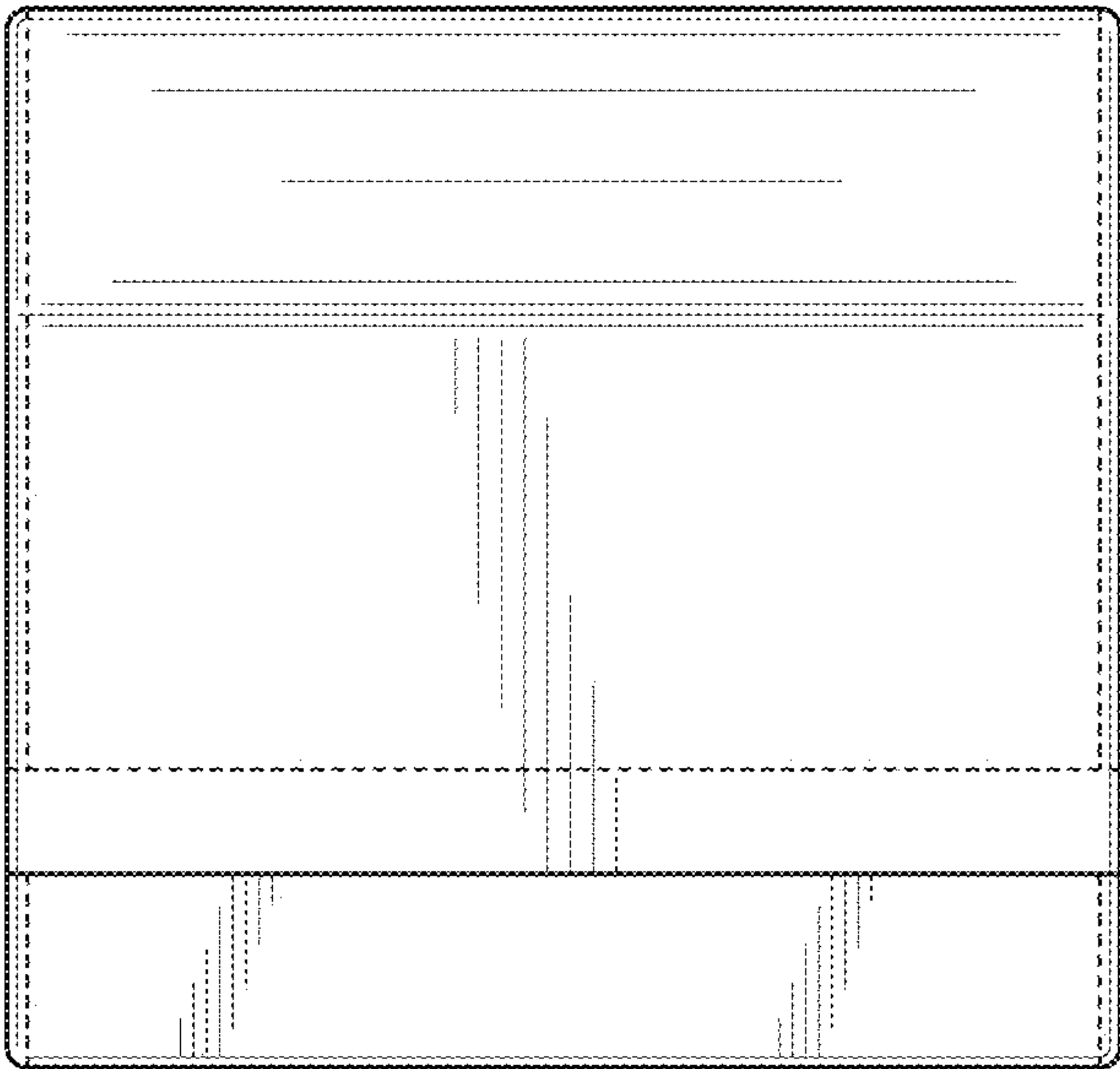

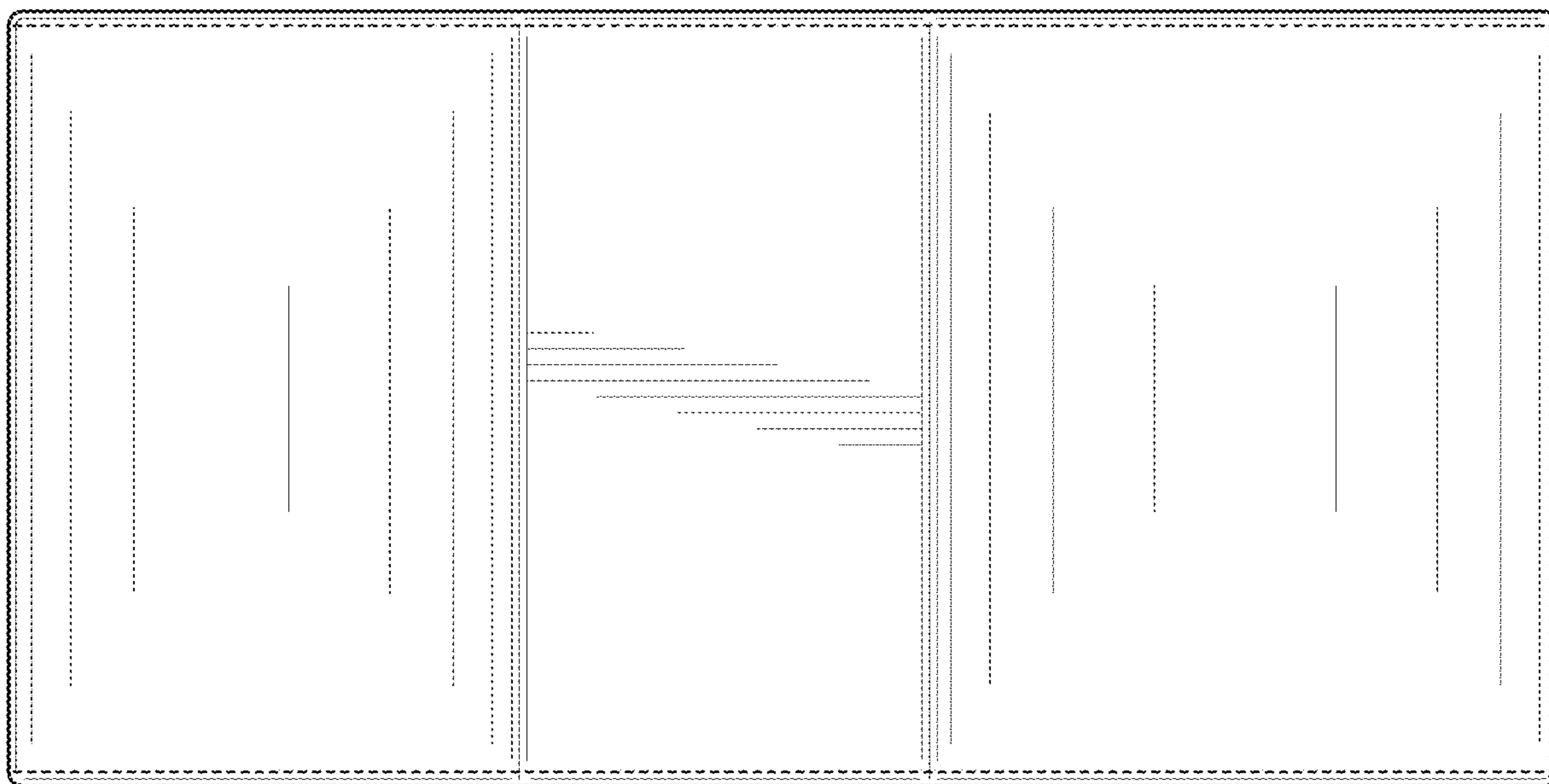

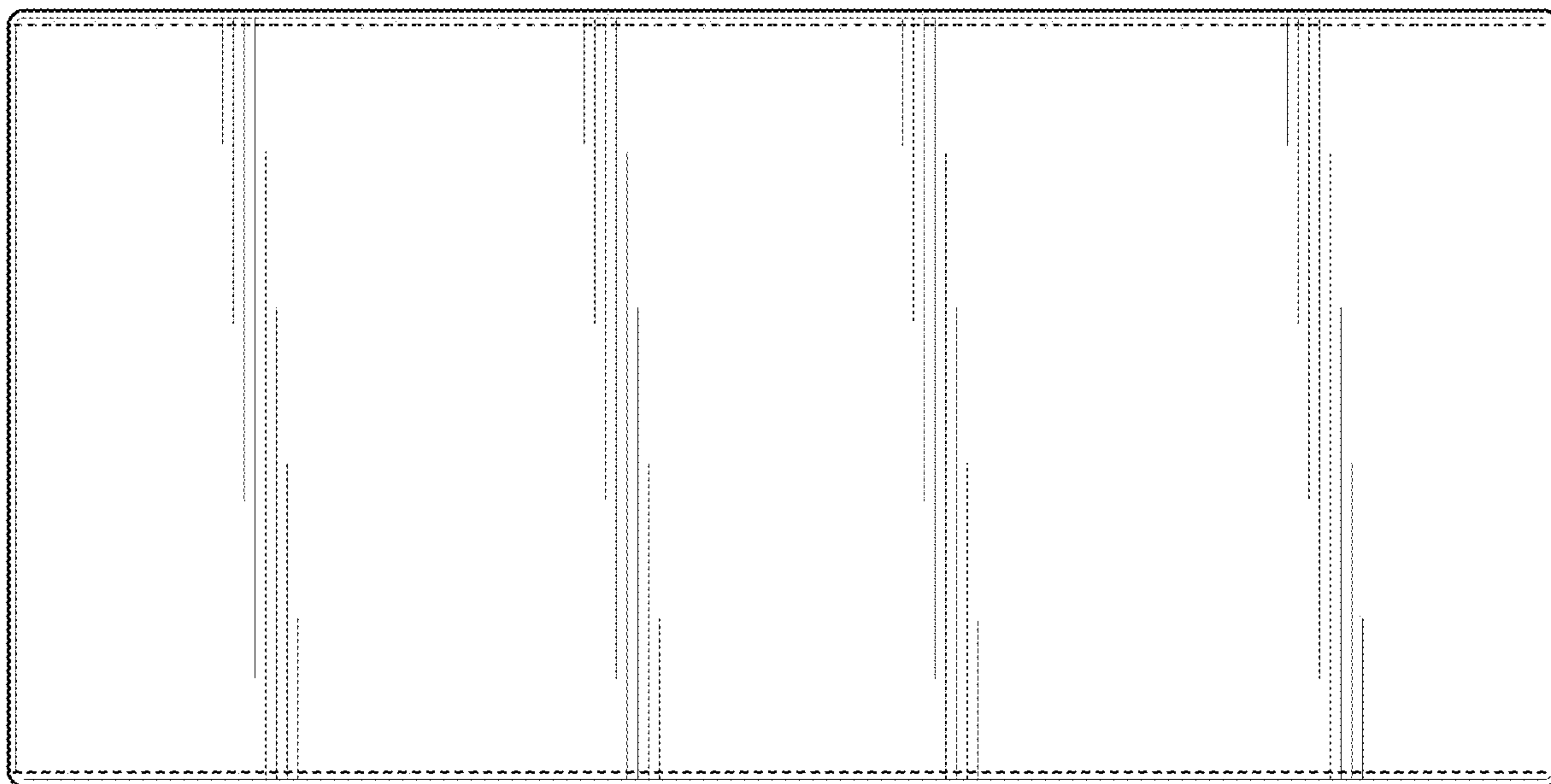

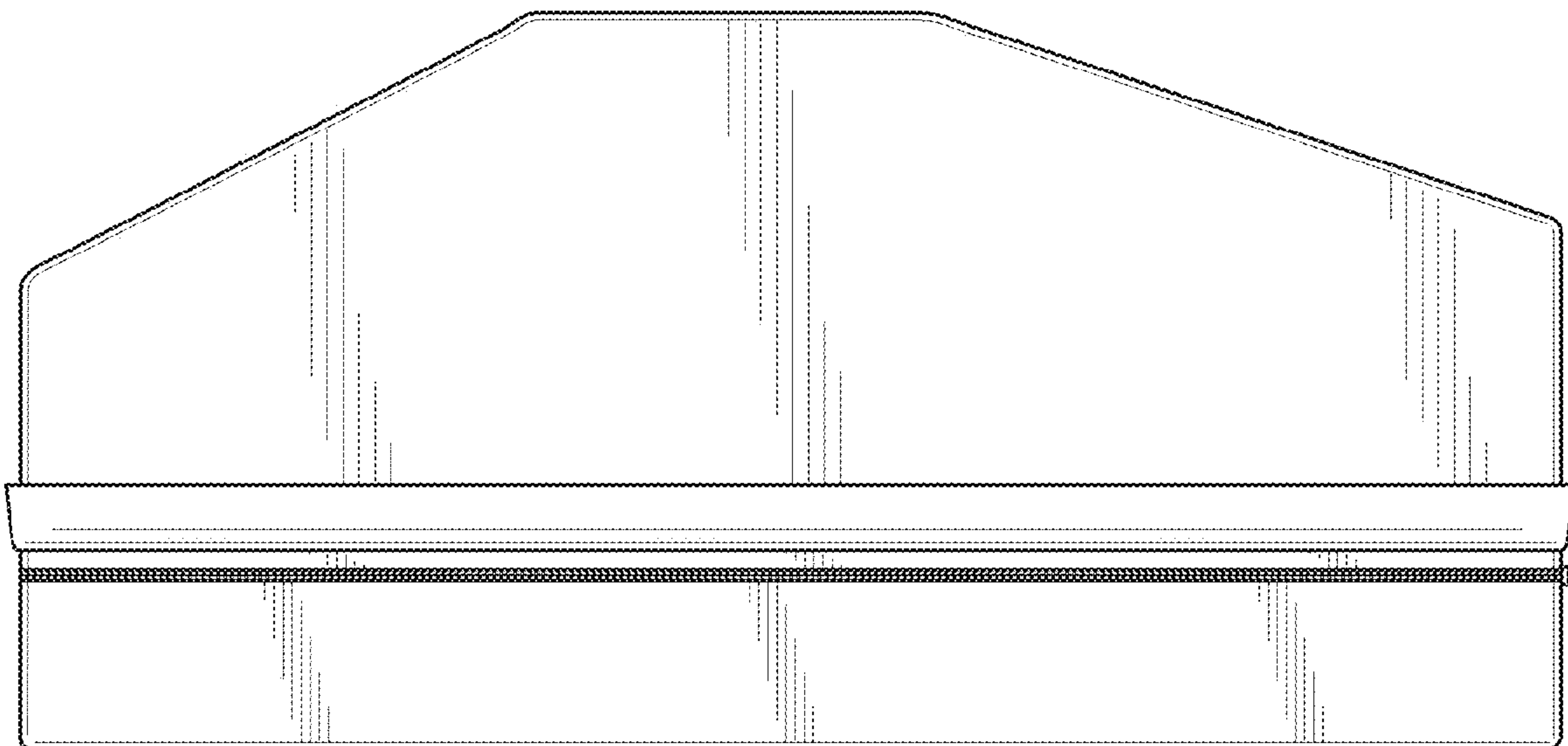

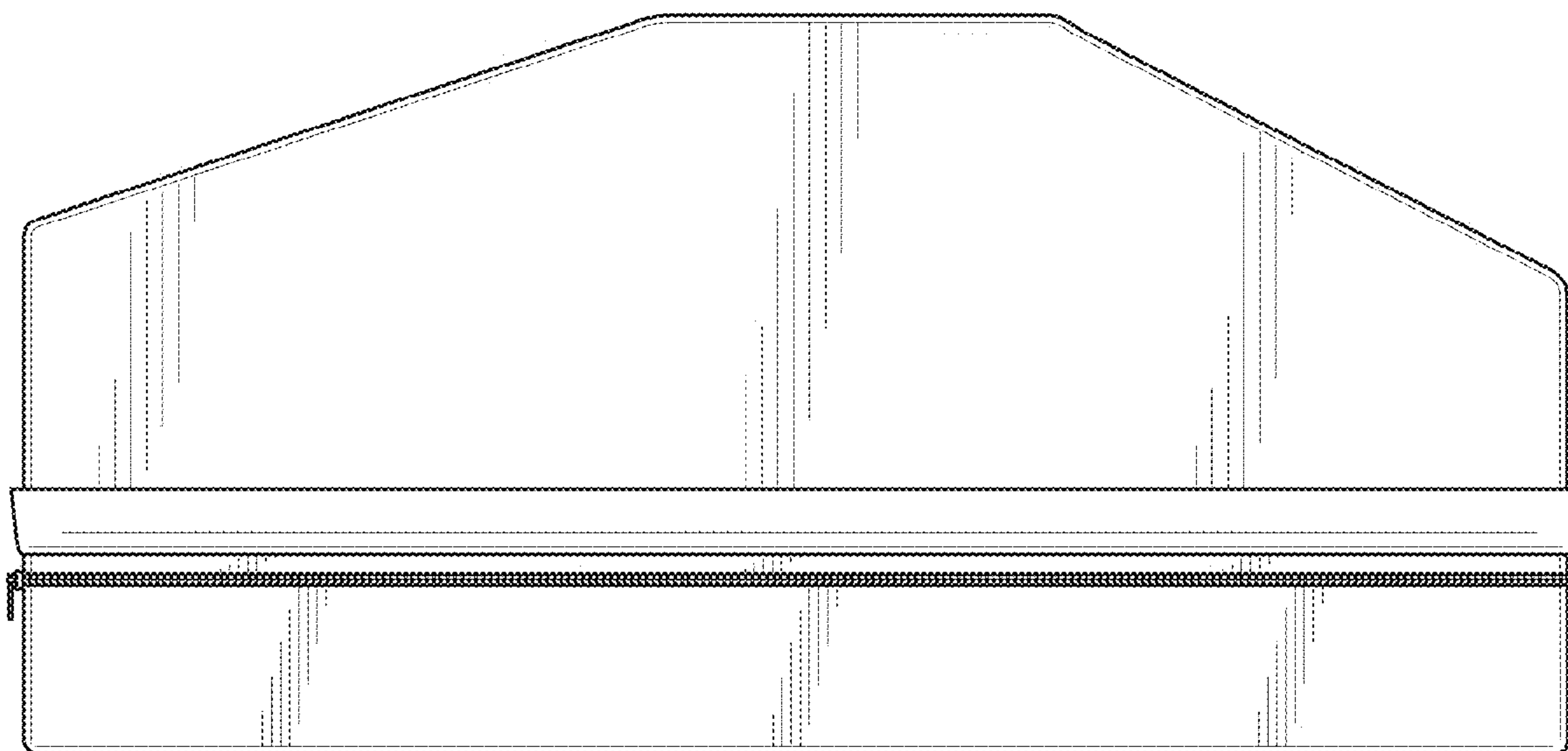

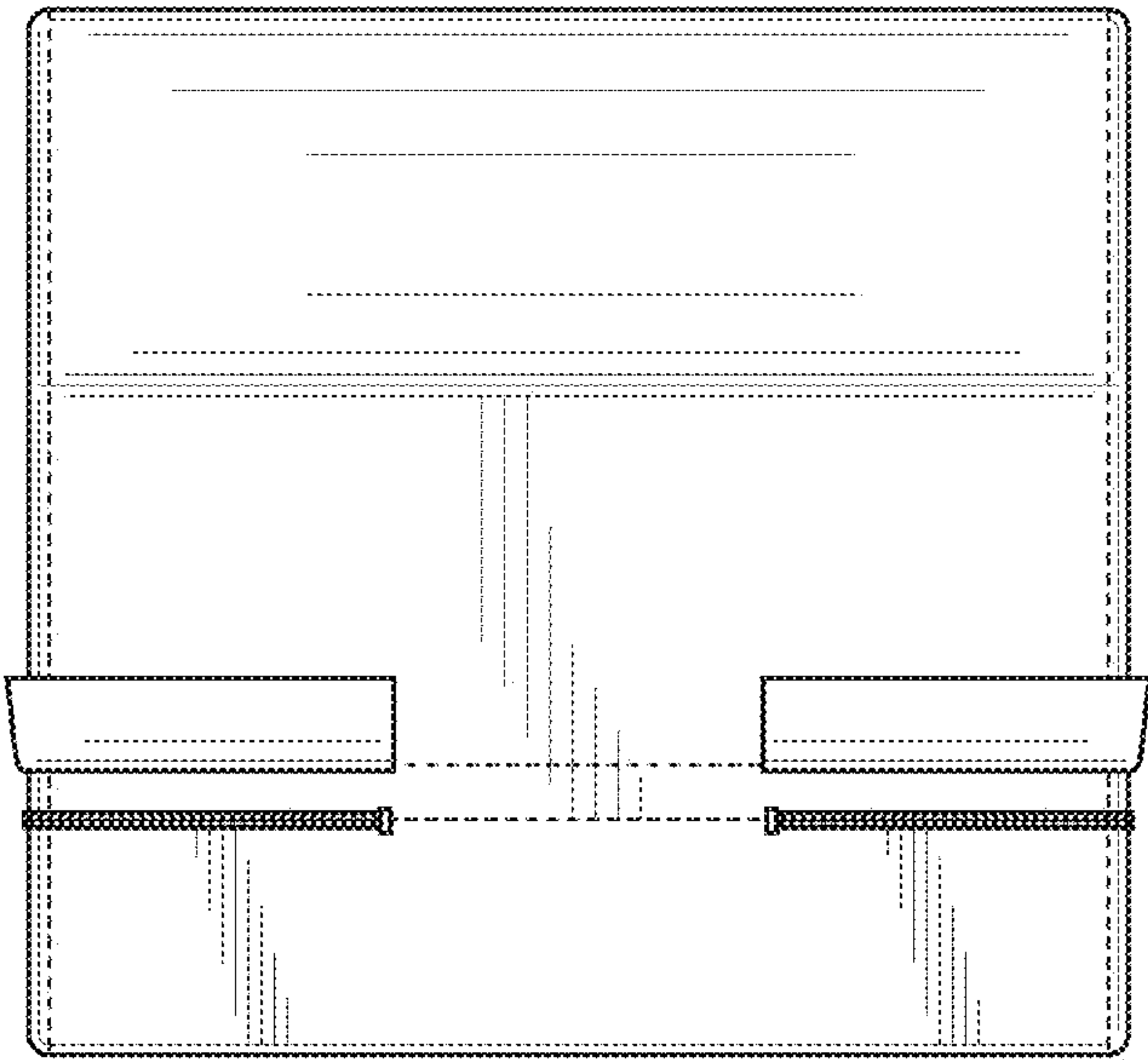


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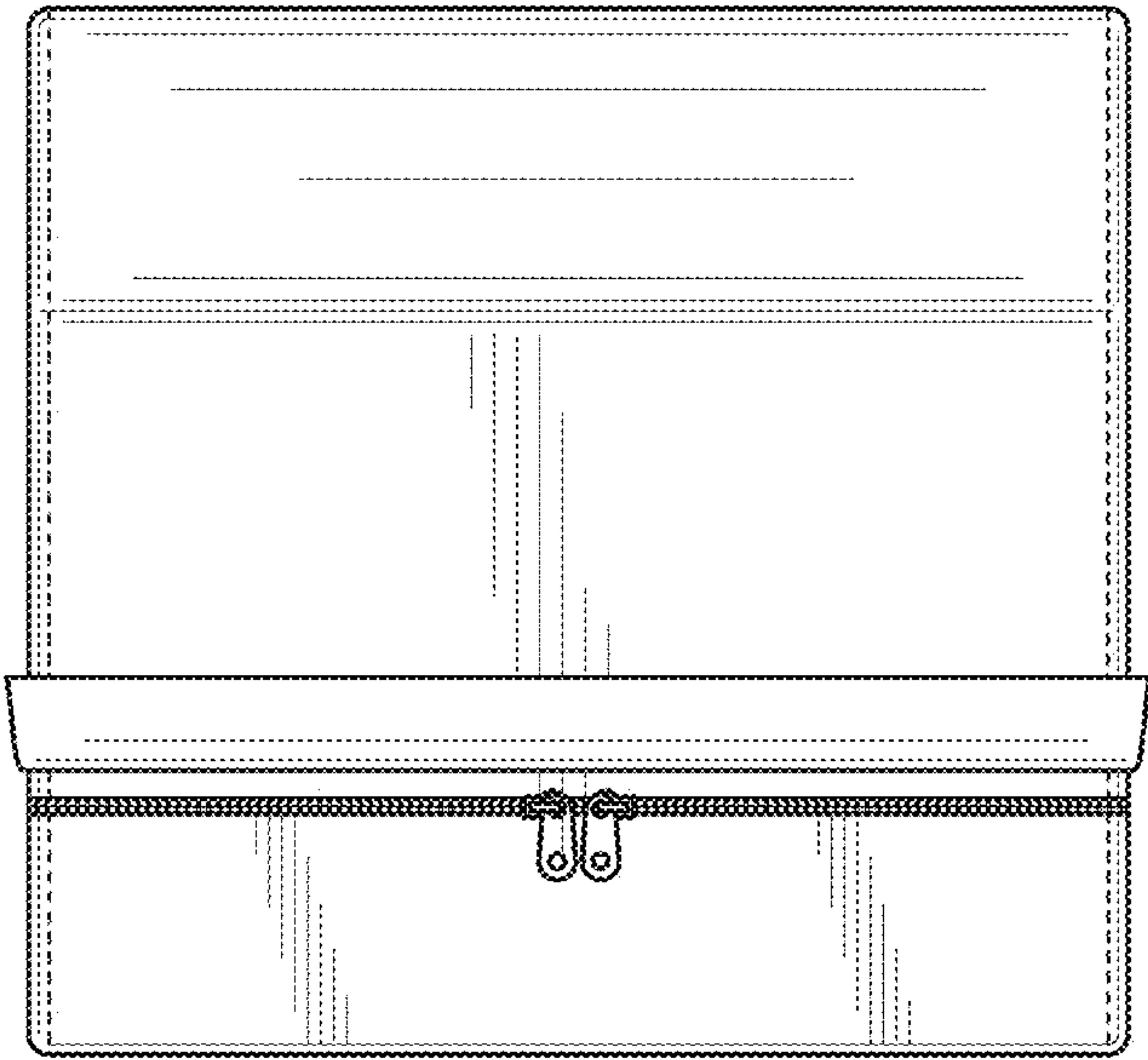

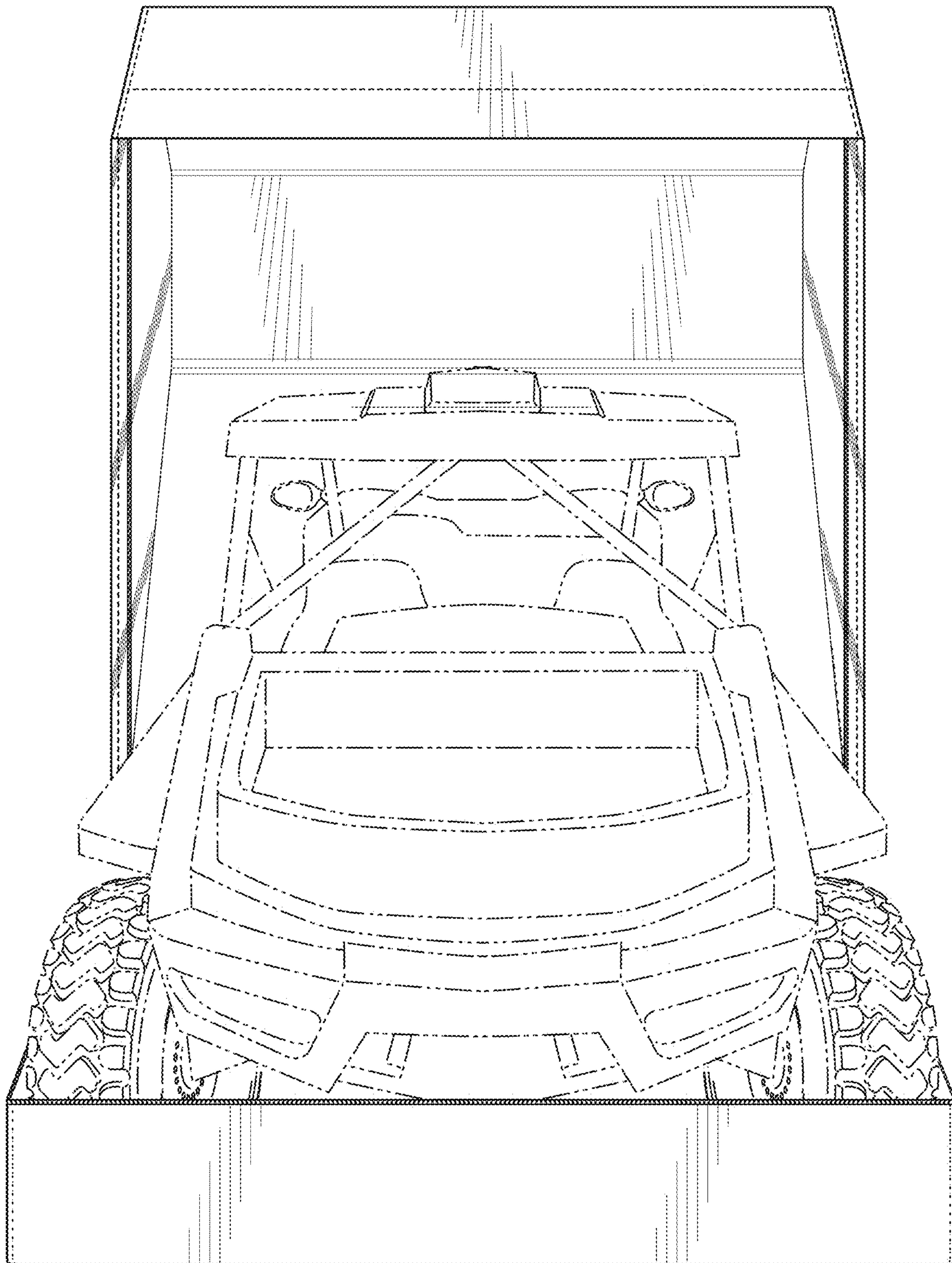

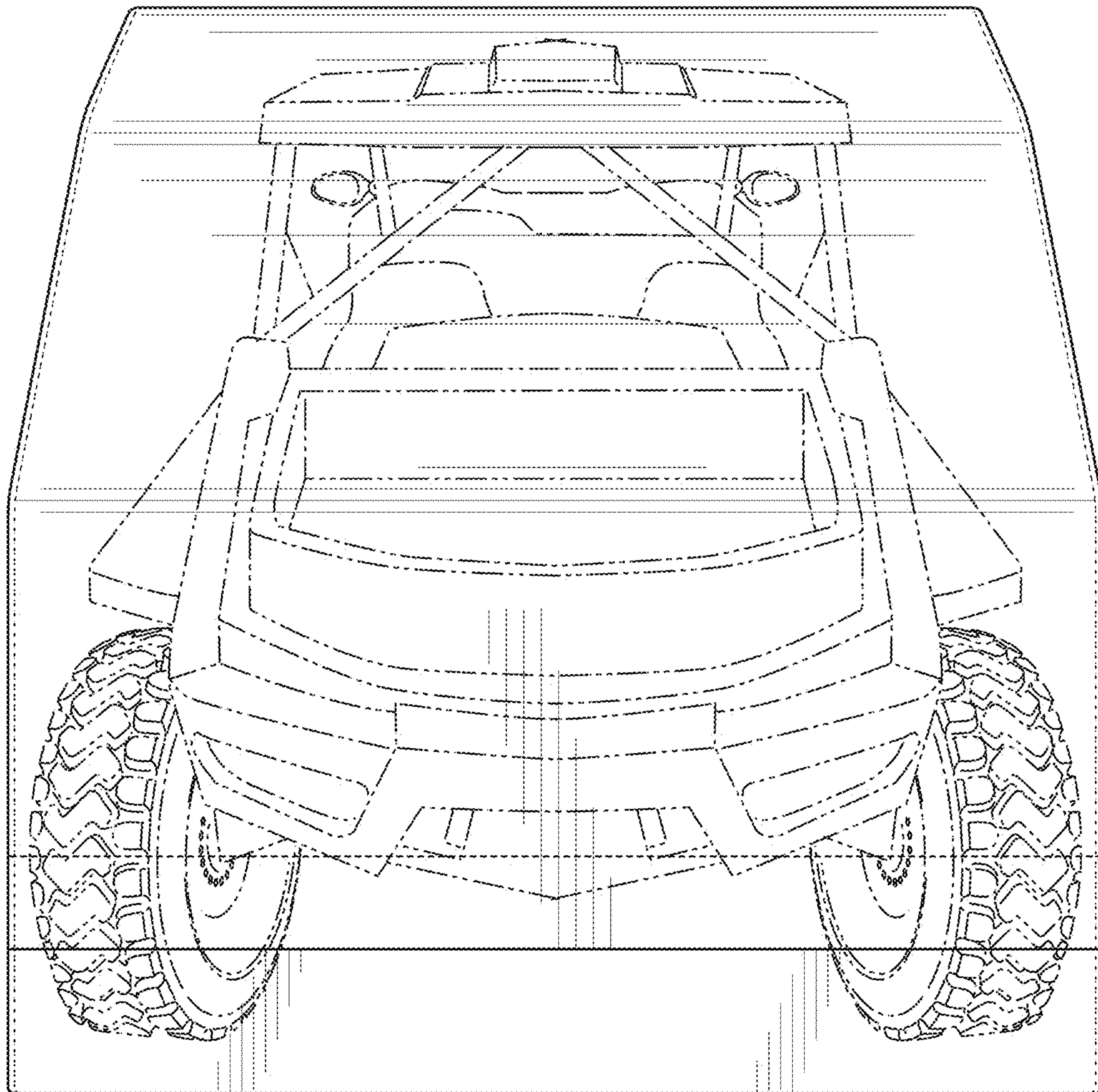

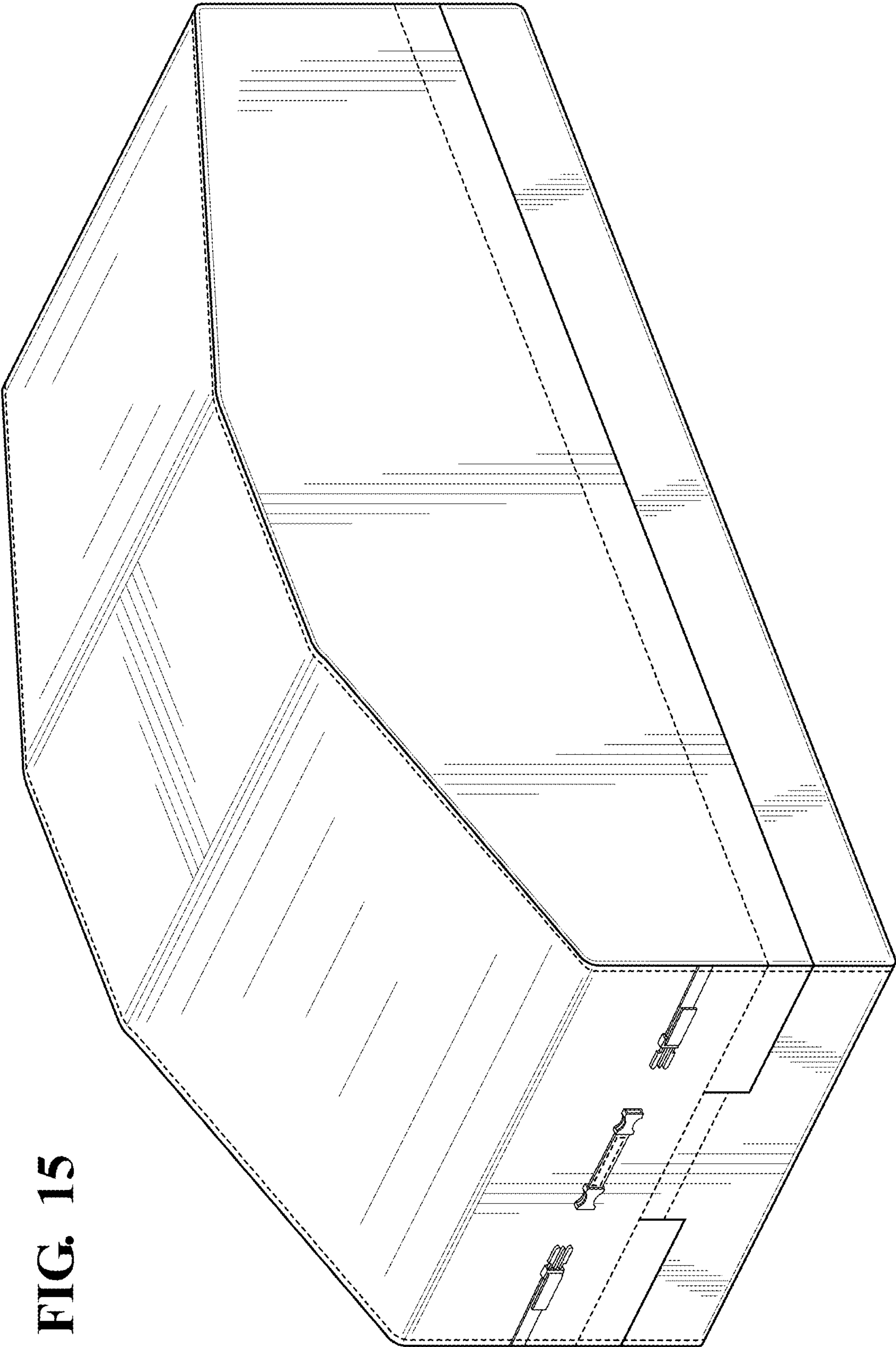

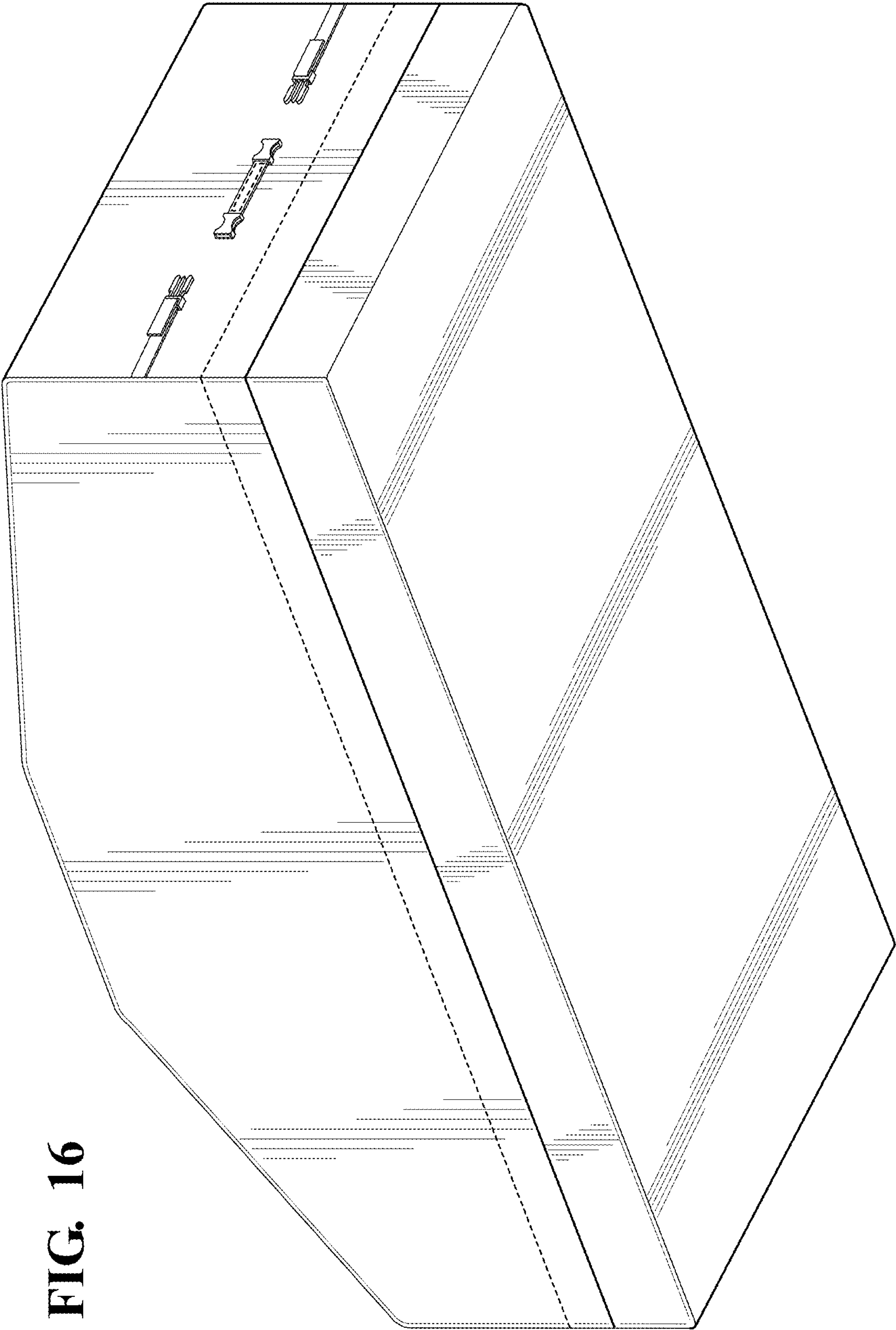

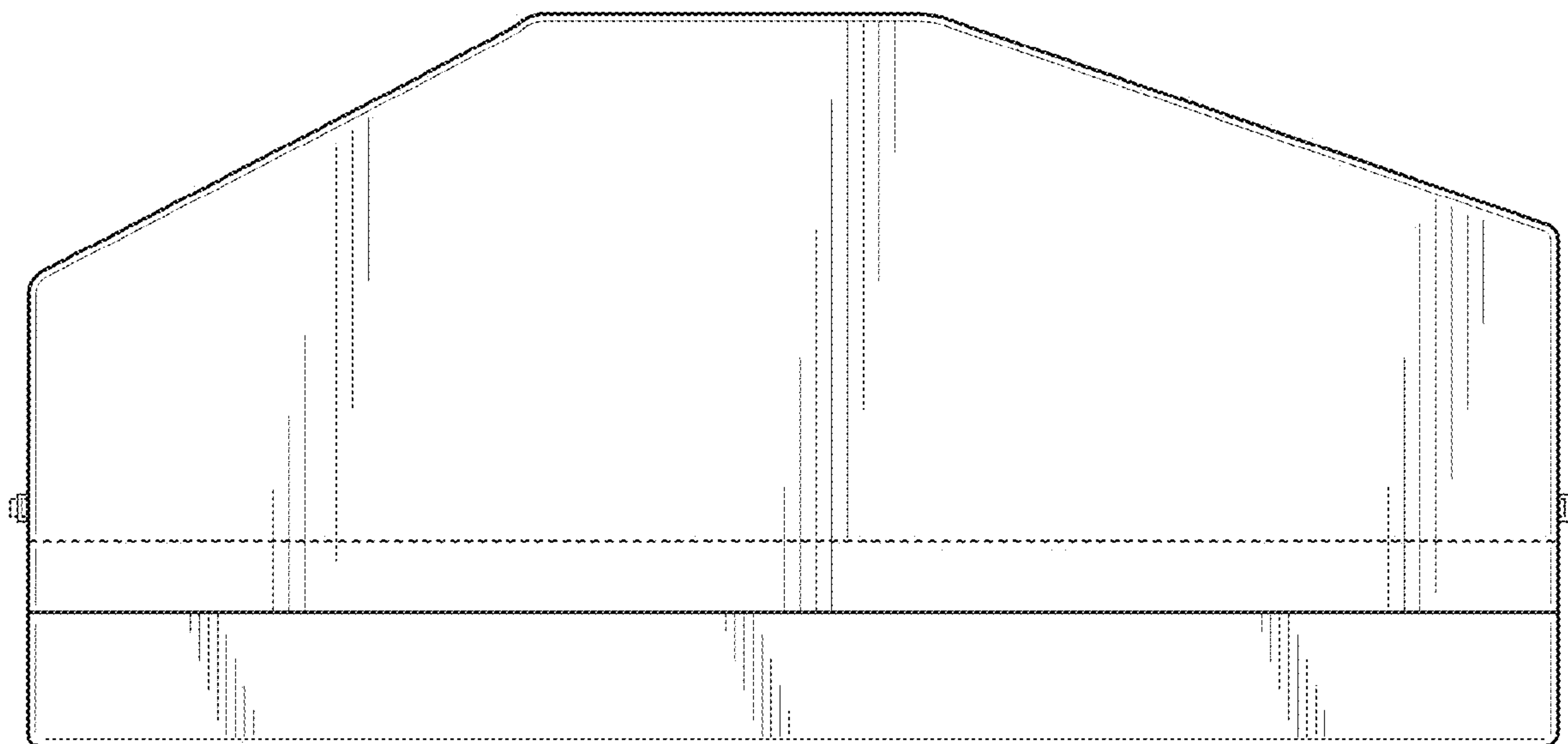

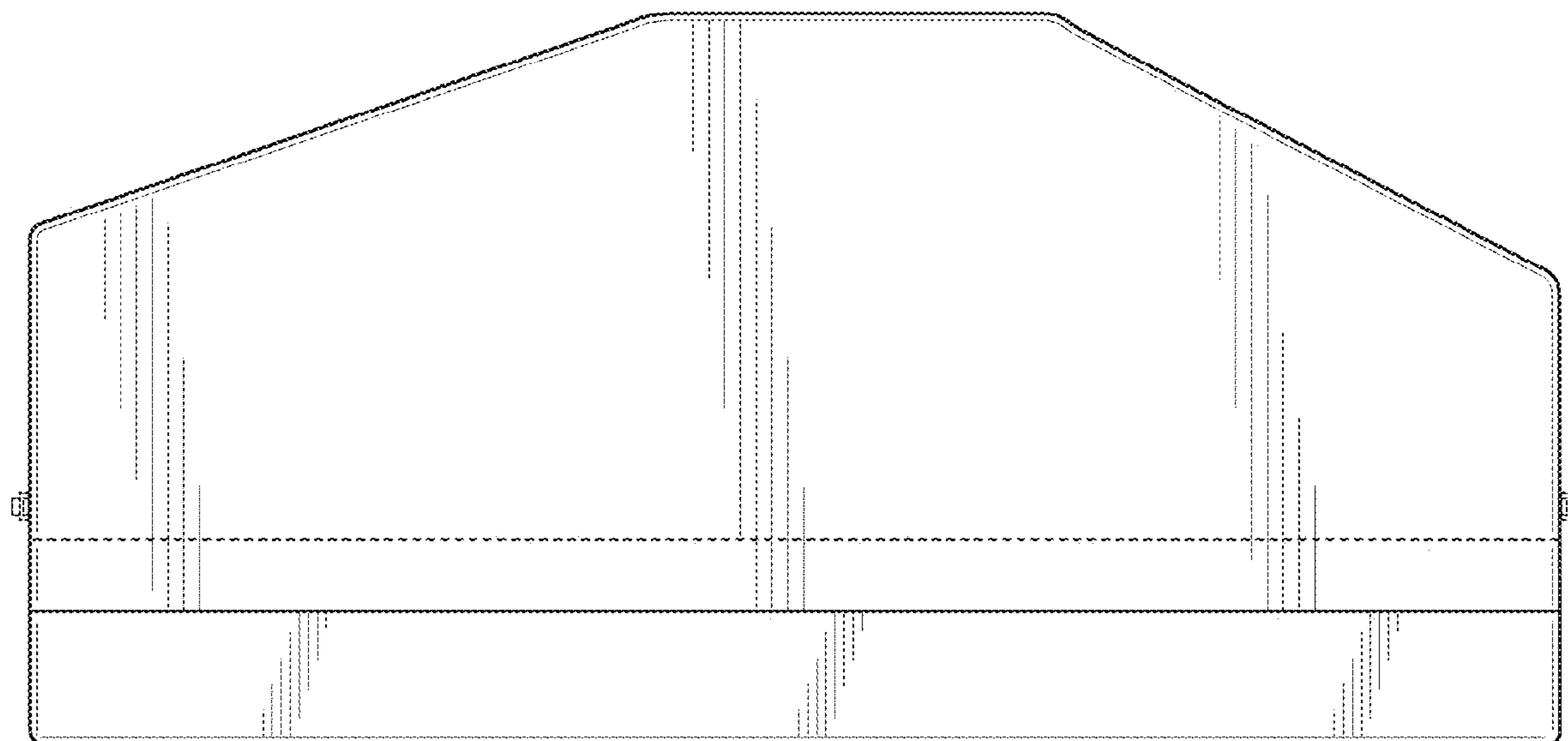

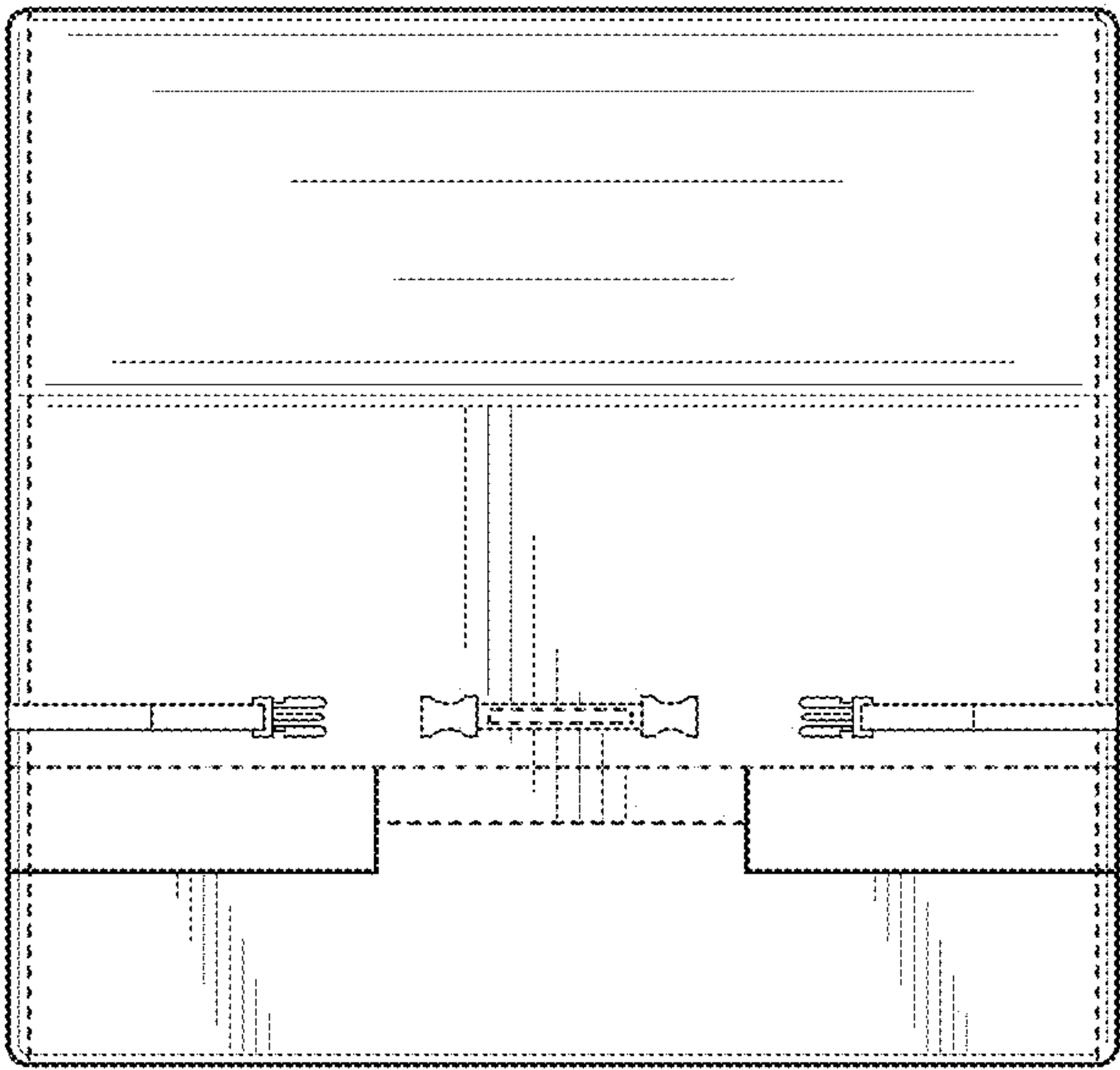

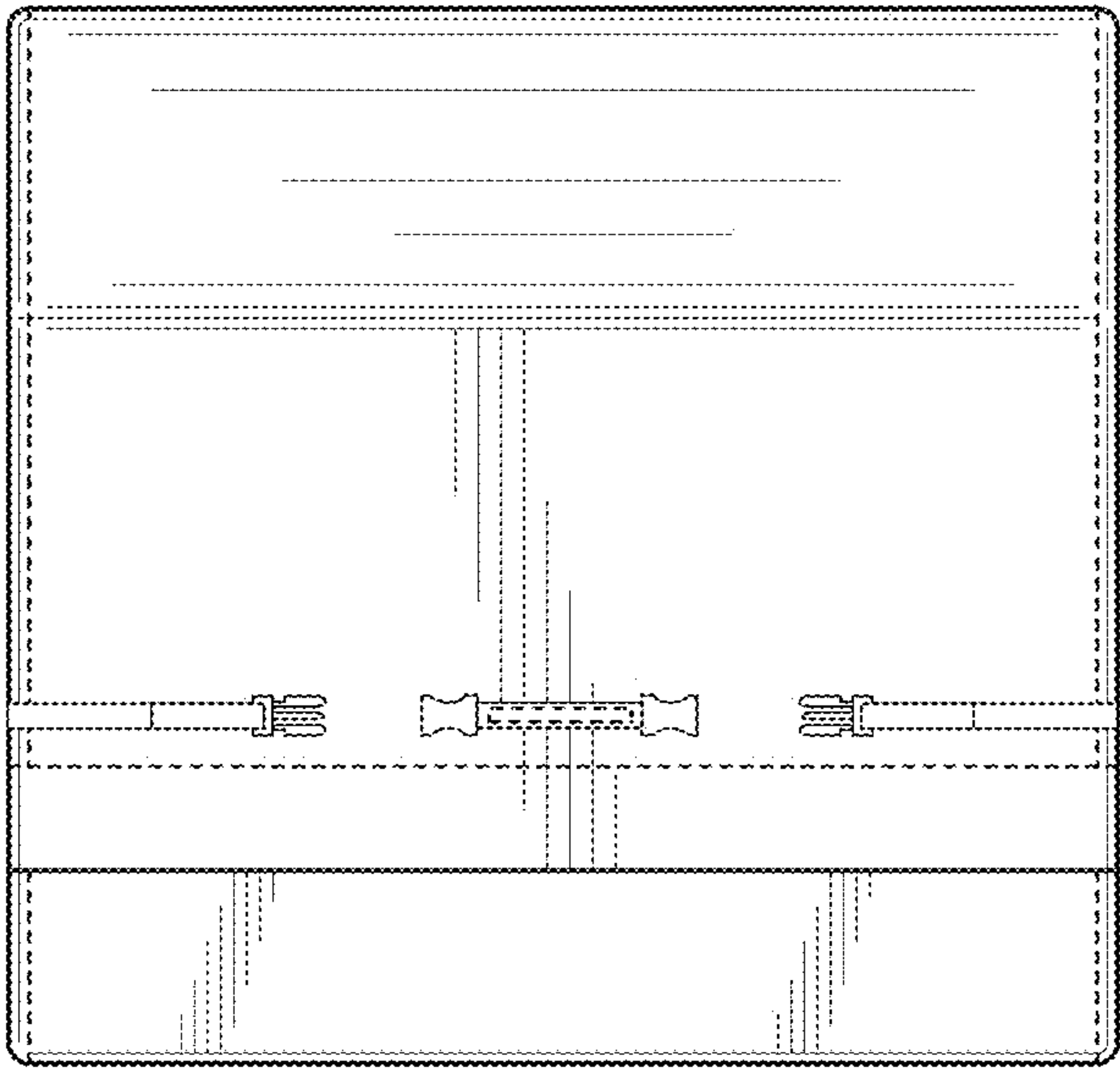

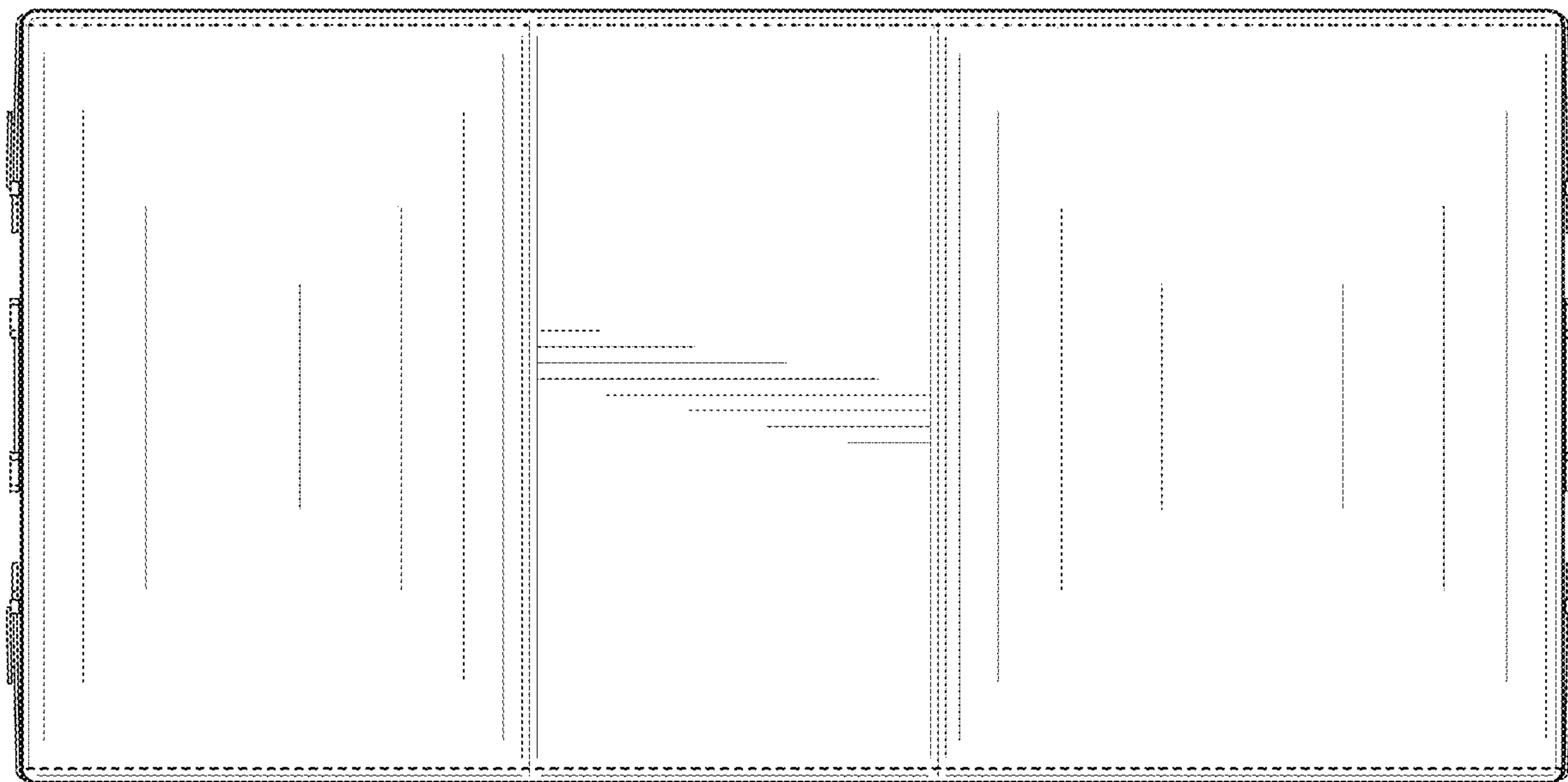

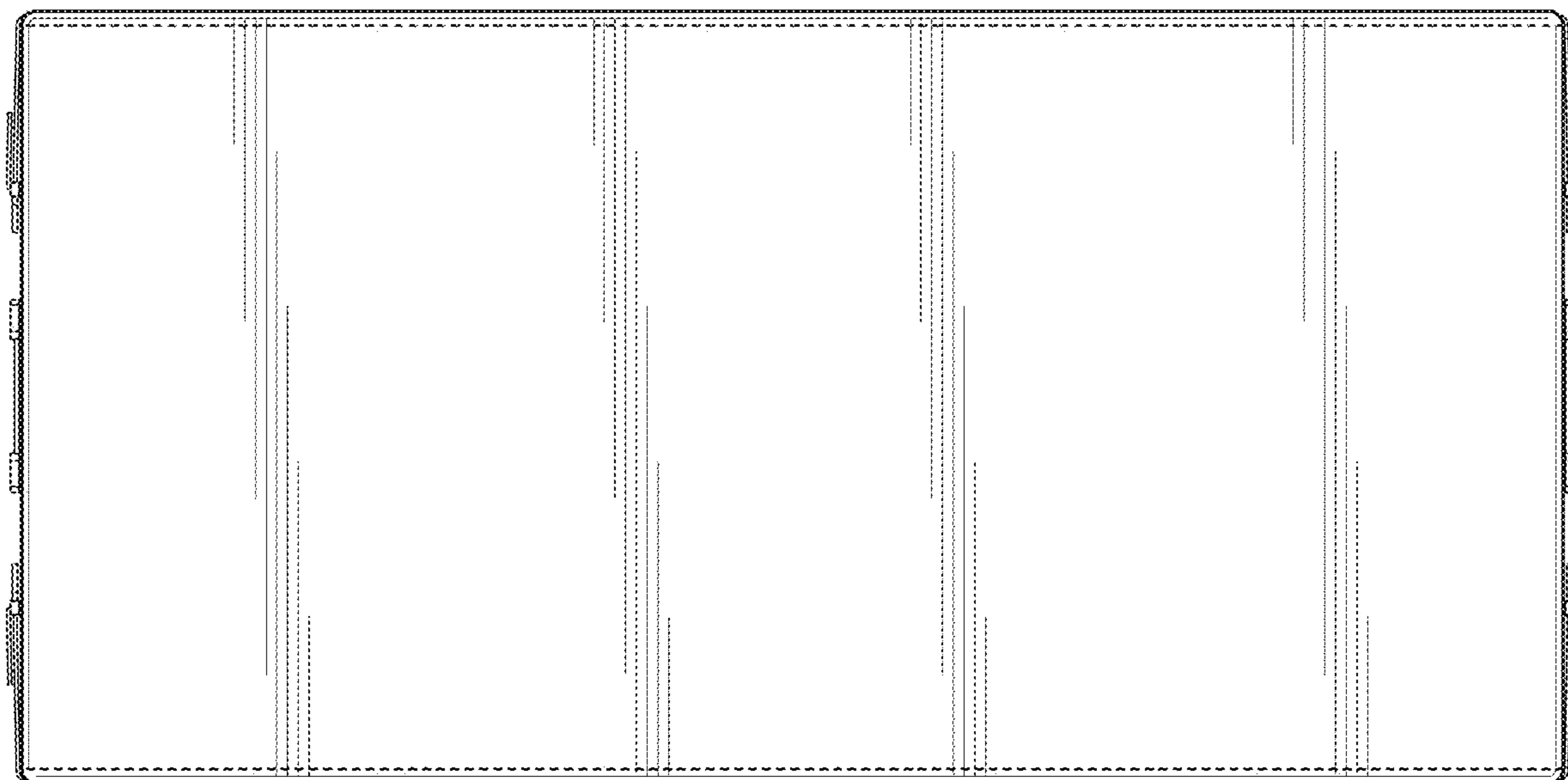


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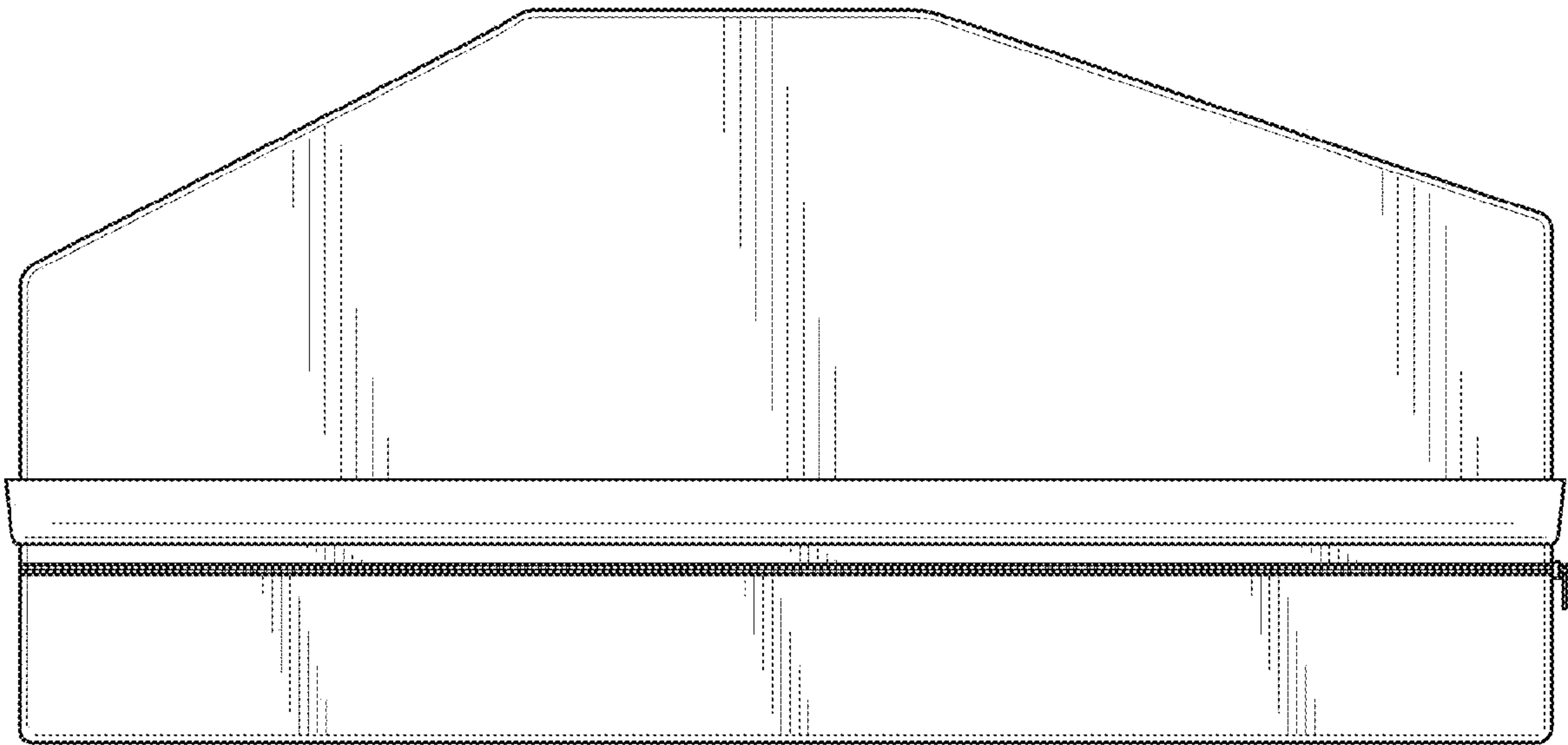

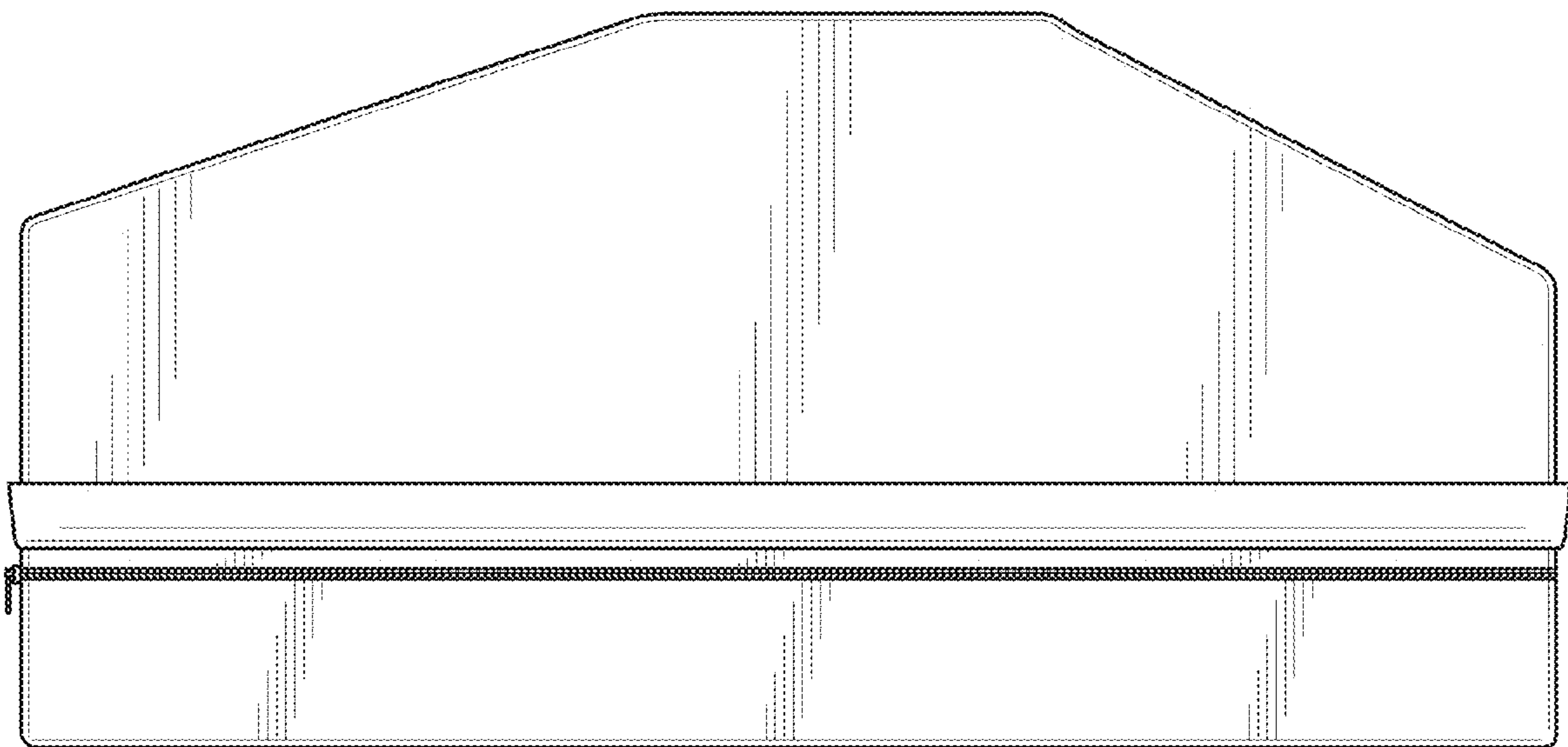


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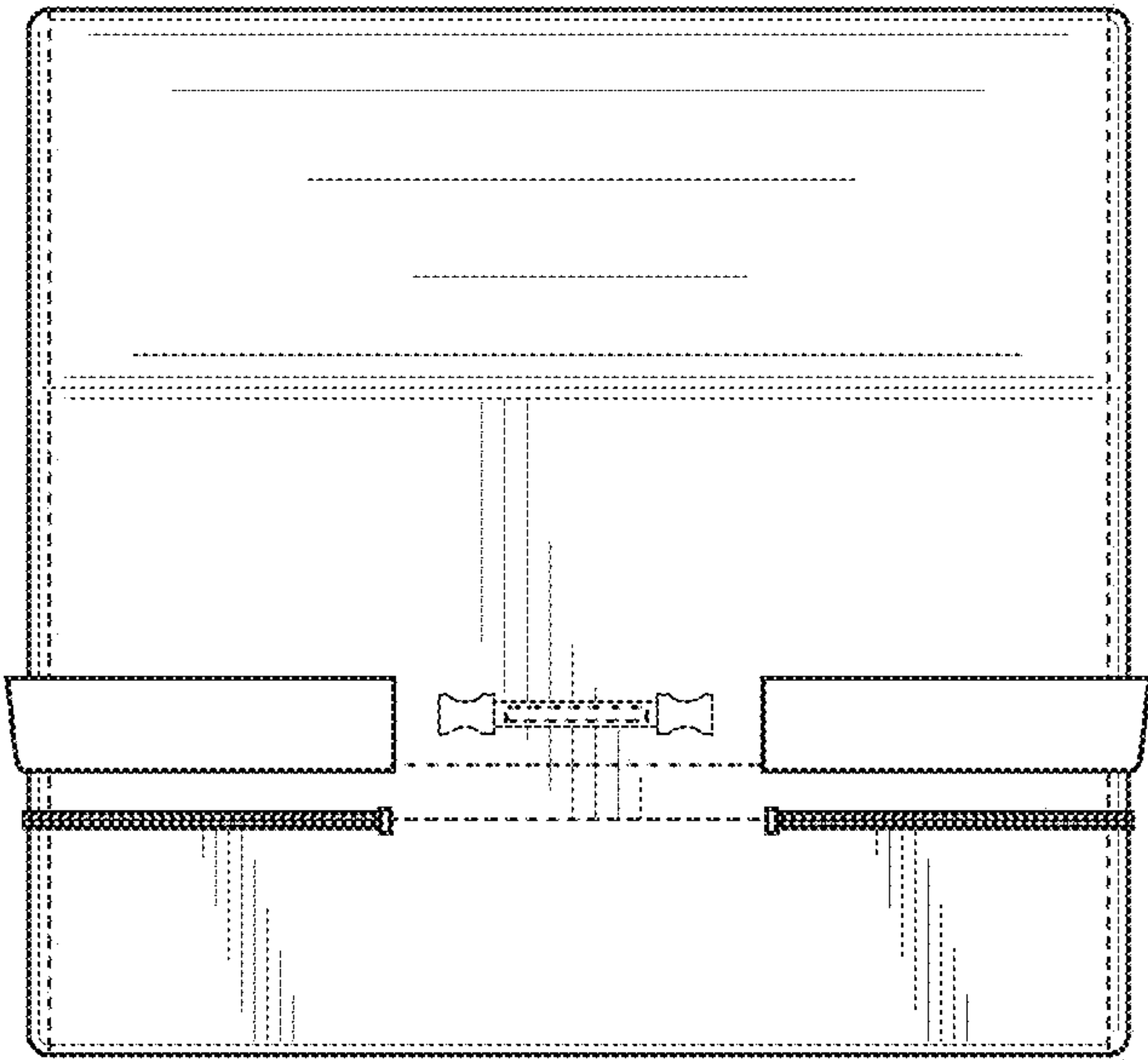

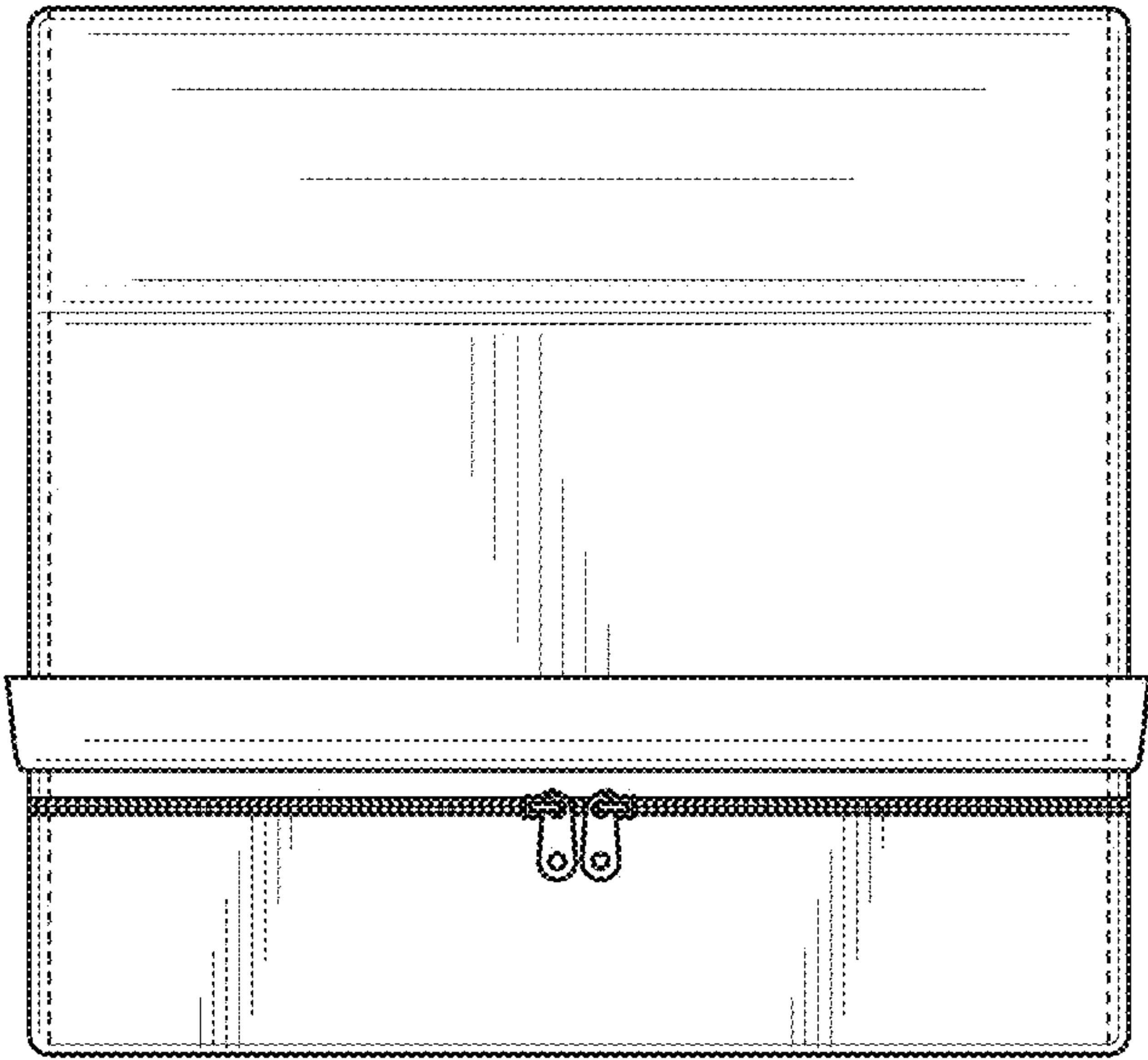

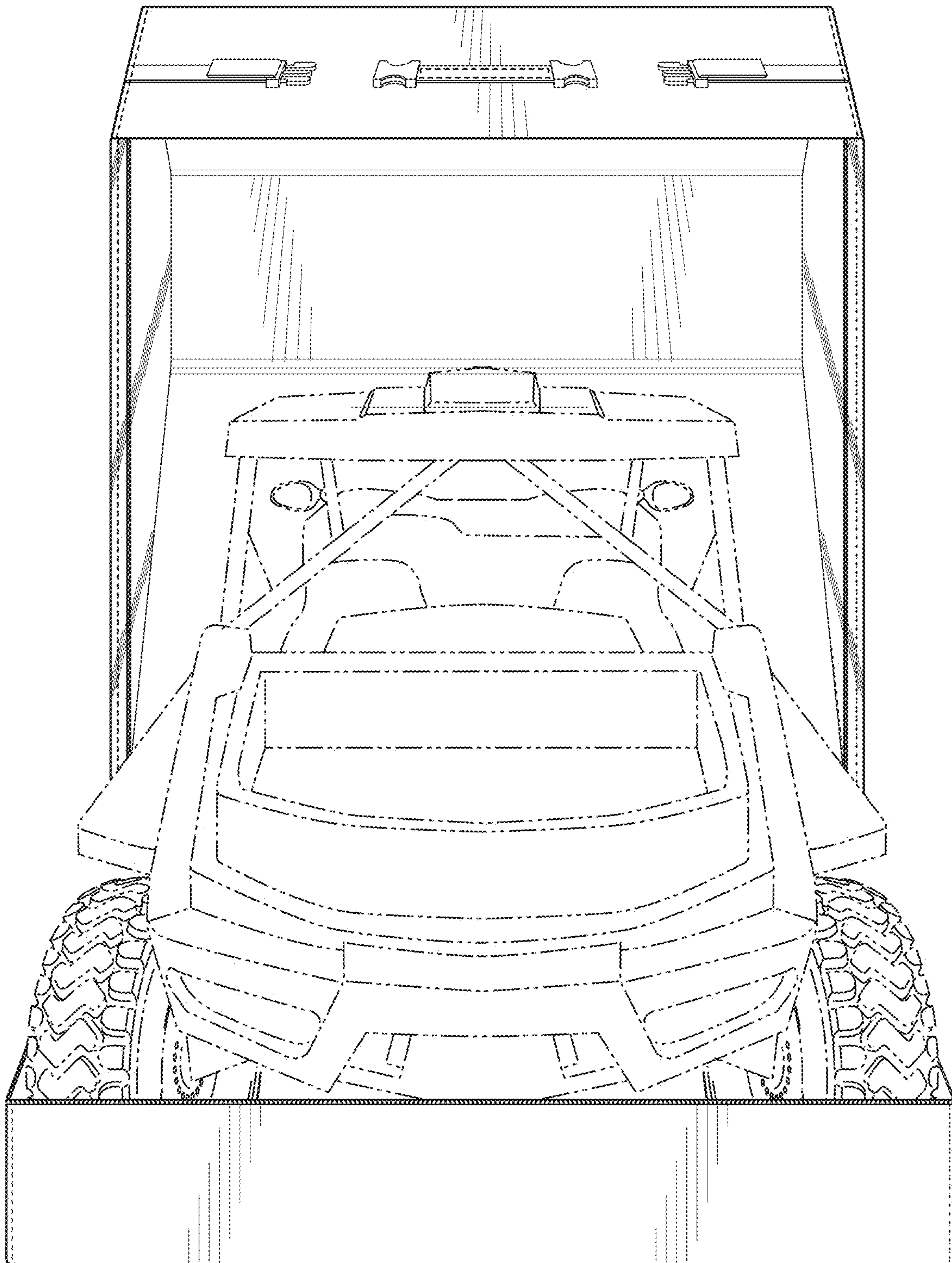

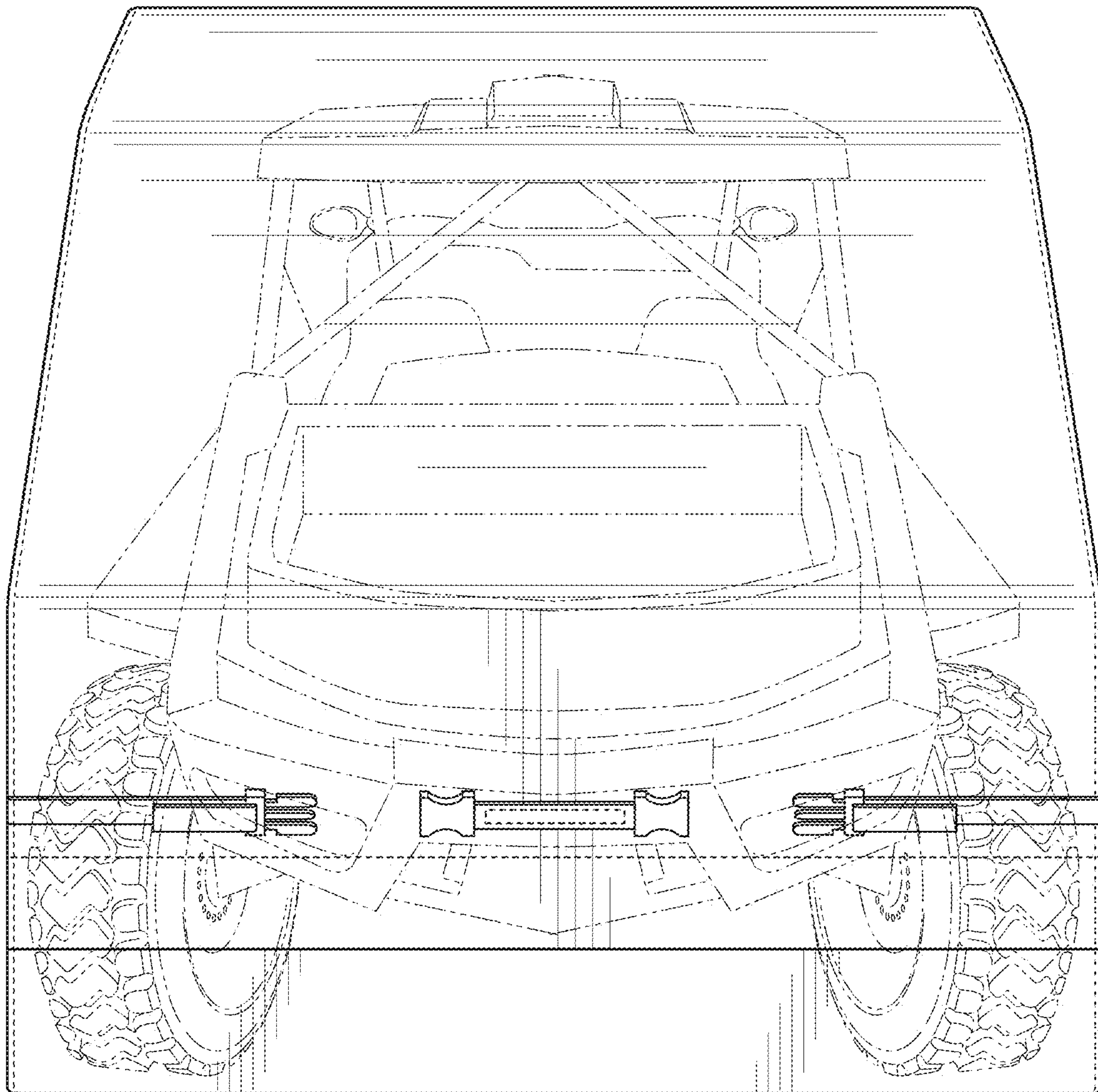
