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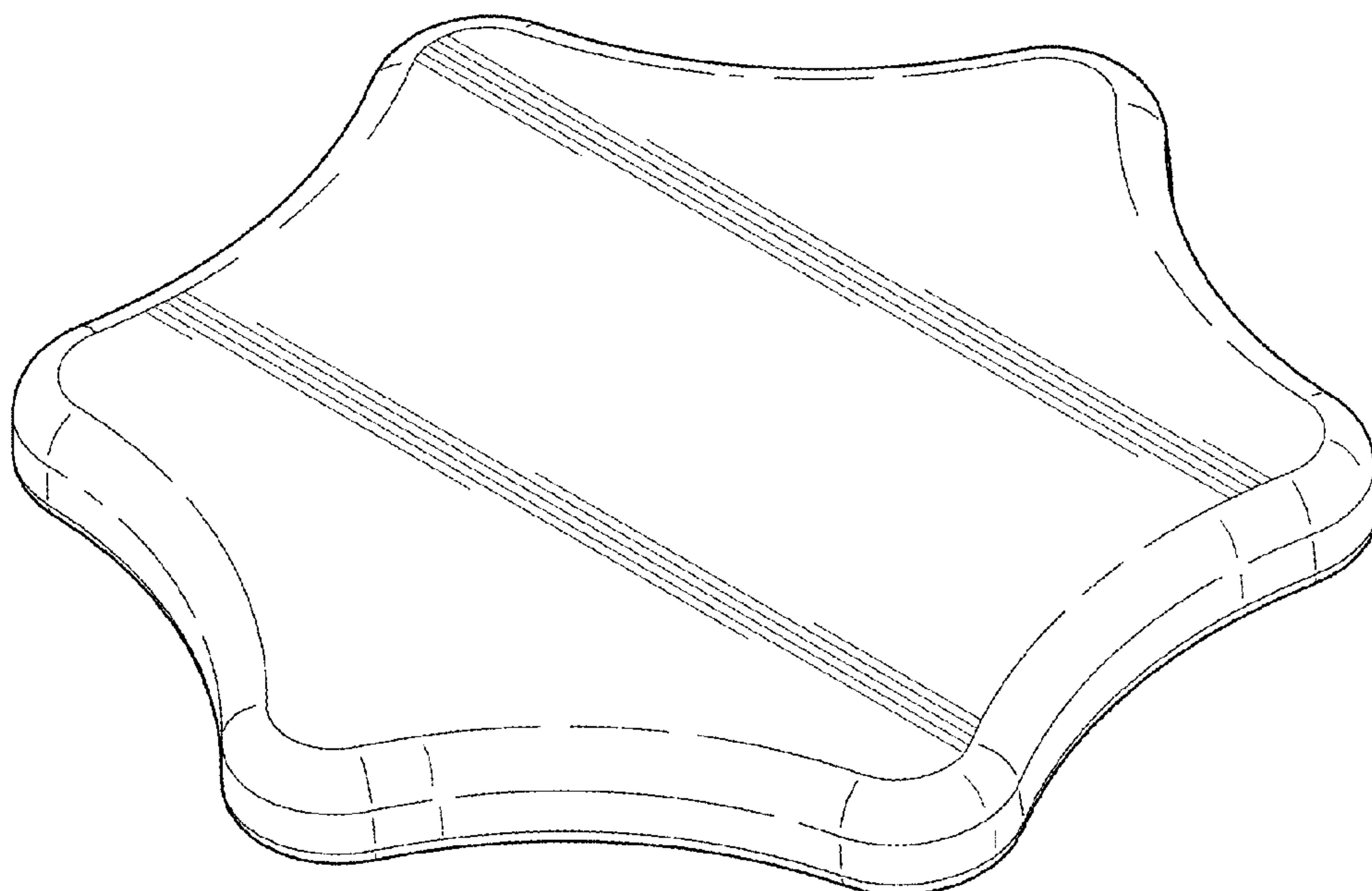
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adapter handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first perspective view of an adapter handle.
FIG. 2 is a second perspective view of the adapter handle of FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the adapter handle of FIG. 1.
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view opposite of the adapter handle of FIG. 3.
FIG. 5 is a first elevational view of the adapter handle of FIG. 1.
FIG. 6 is a second elevational view rotated 180 degrees of the first elevational view of the adapter handle of FIG. 5.
FIG. 7 is a third elevational view of the adapter handle rotated 90 degrees relative to the first elevational view of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a fourth elevational view rotated 180 degrees relative to the third elevational view of FIG. 7.

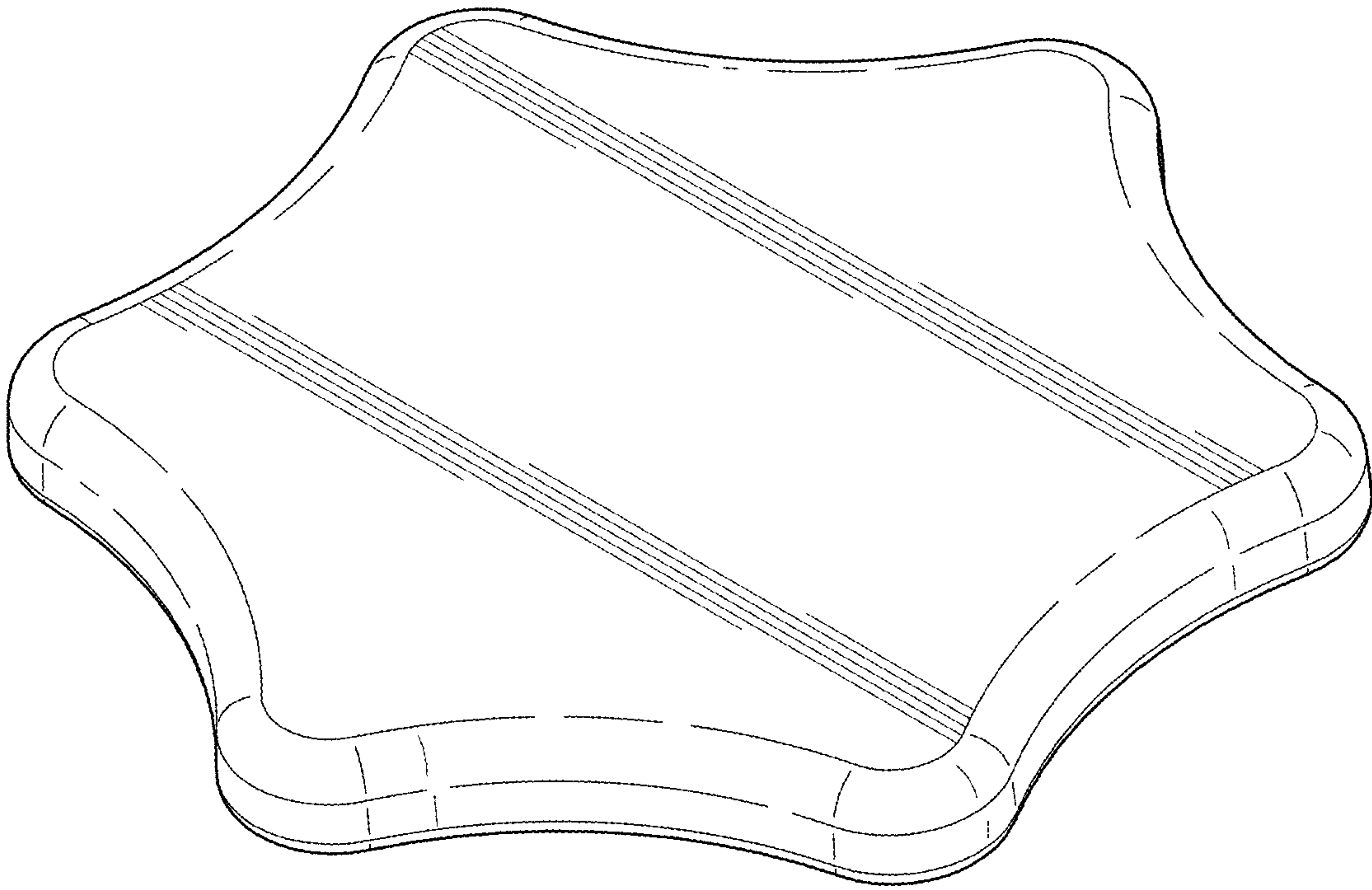

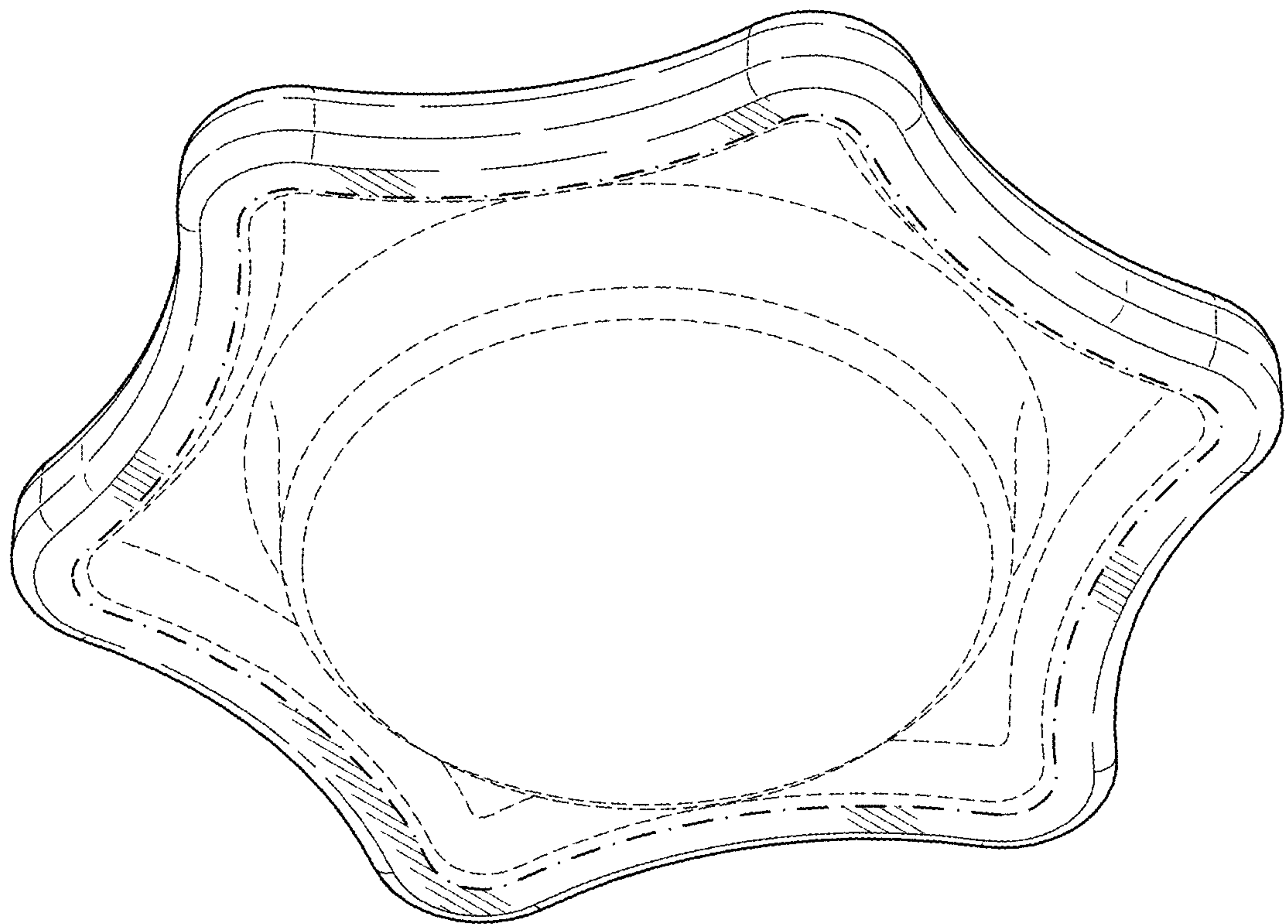

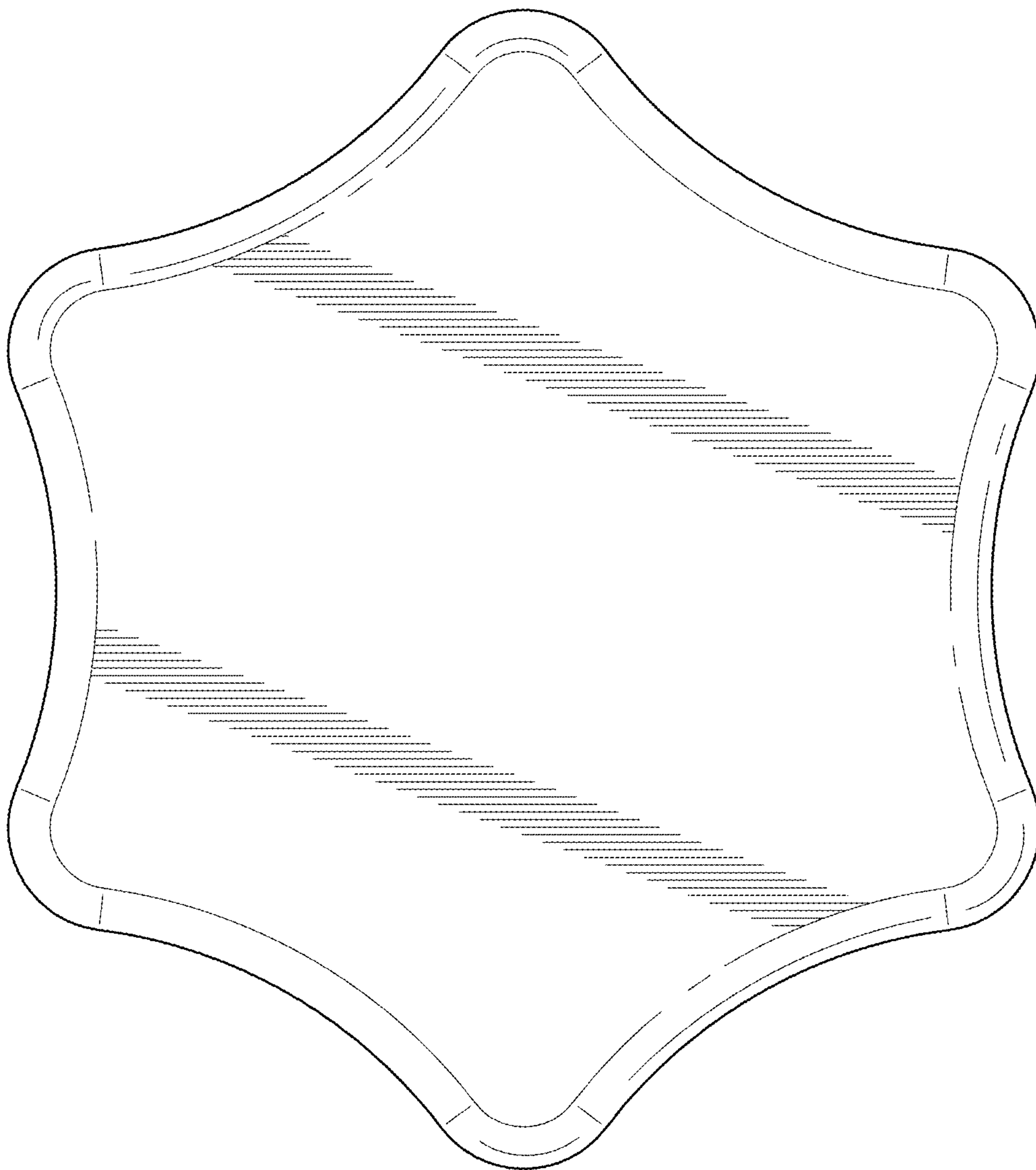

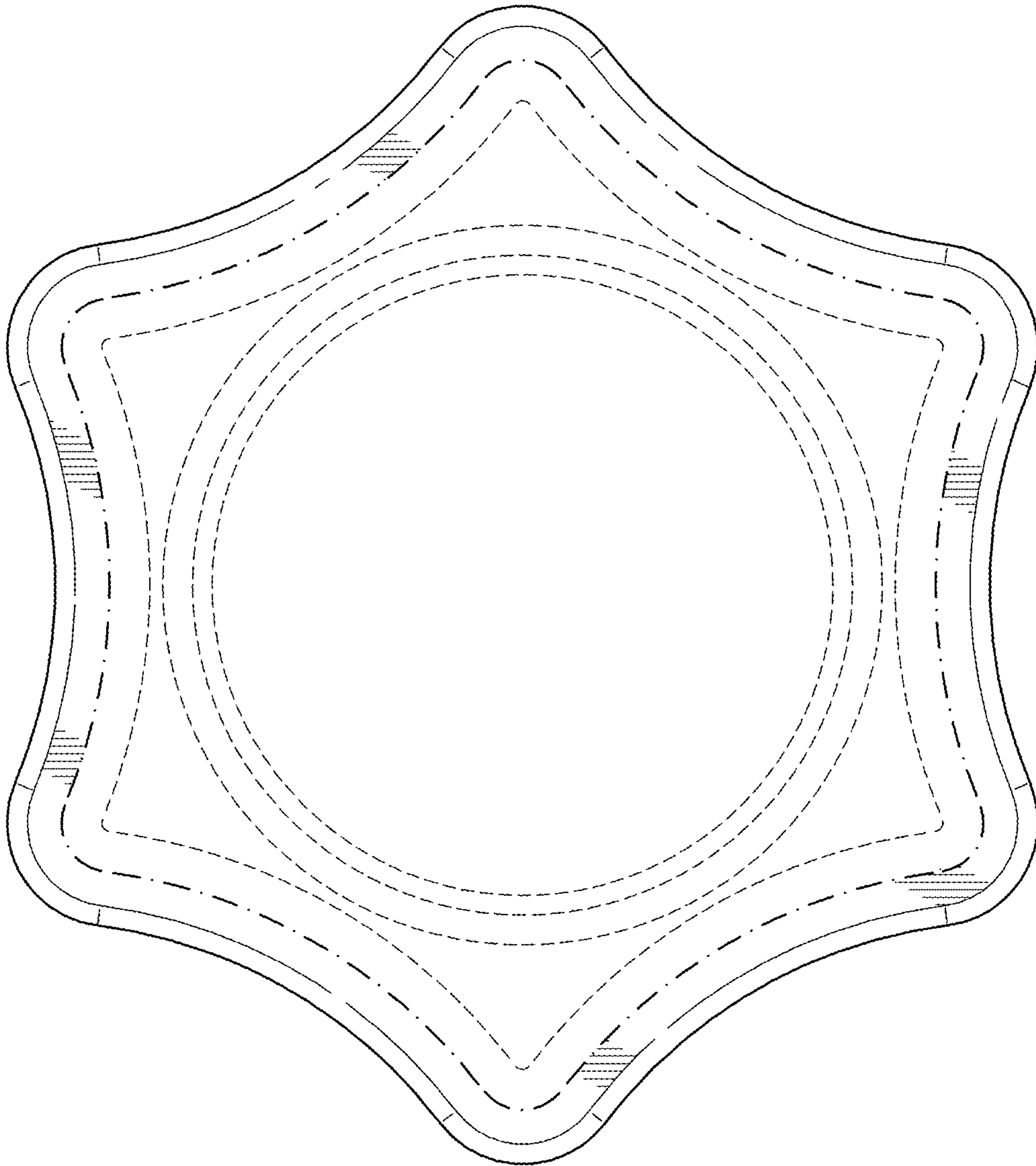

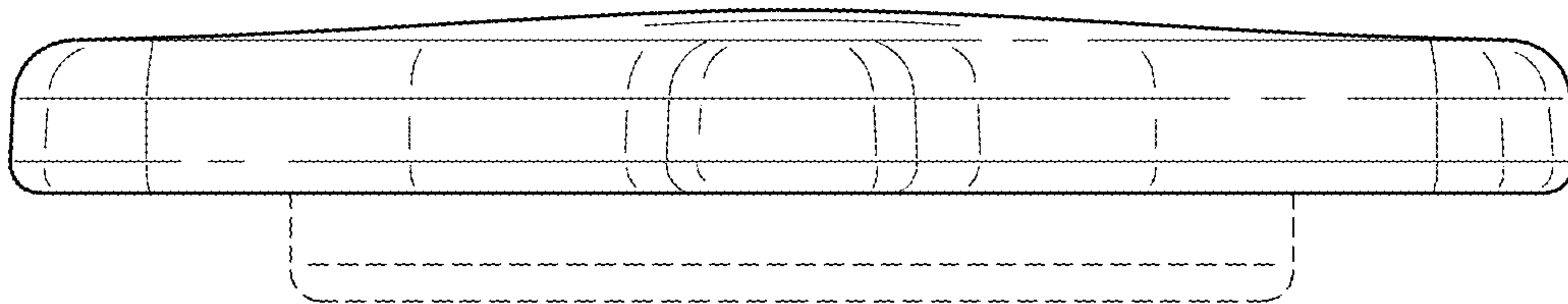

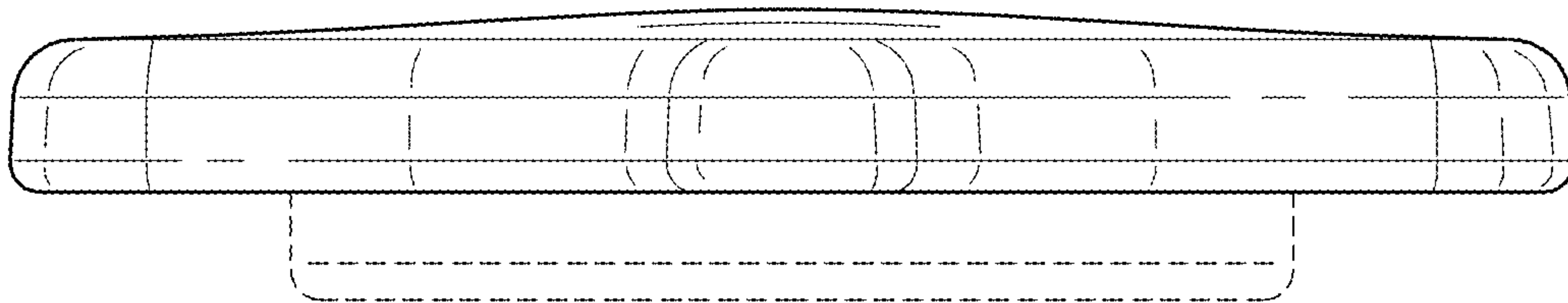

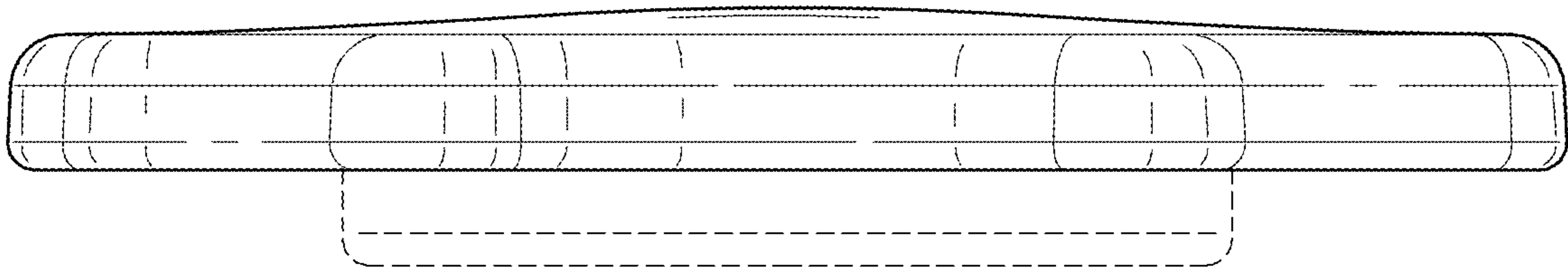

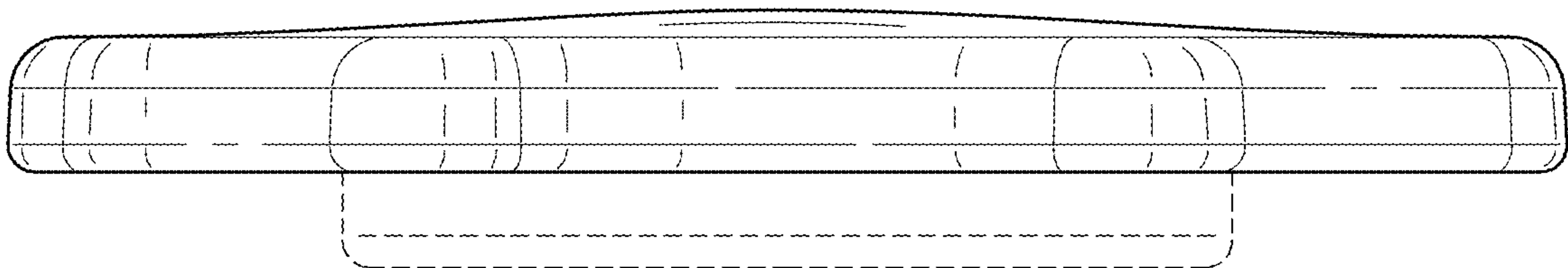
