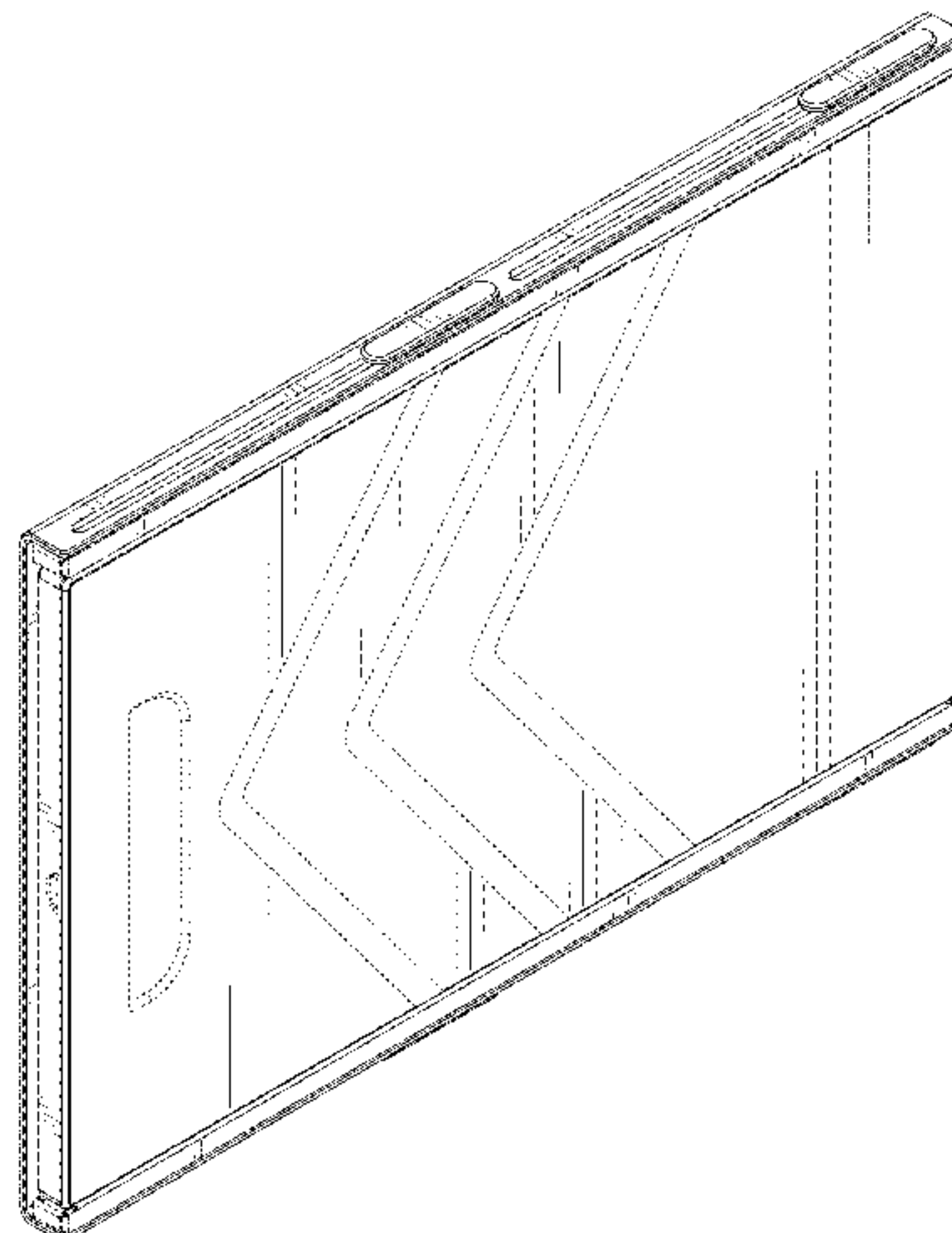

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a display screen where the display screen is shown in a closed position.

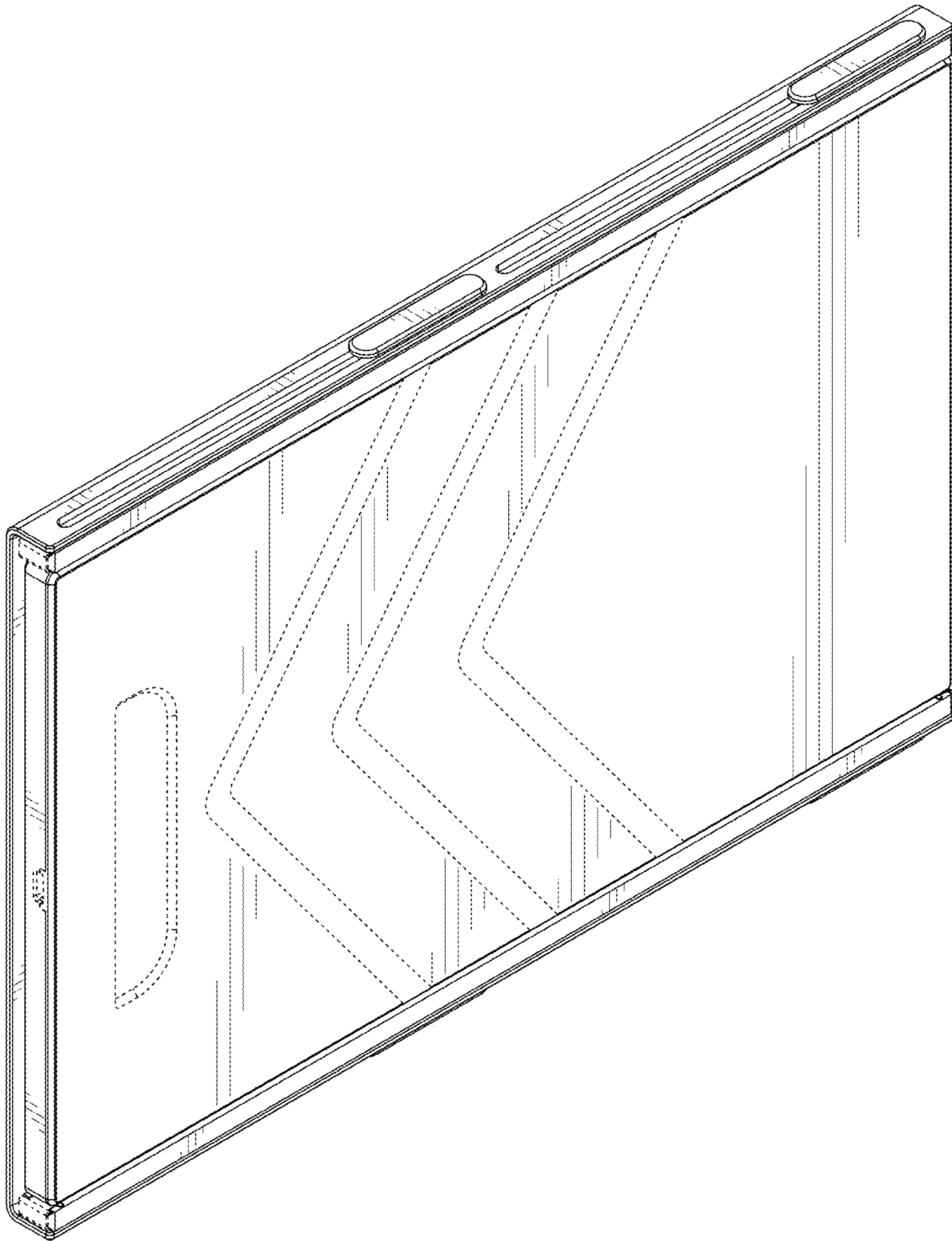

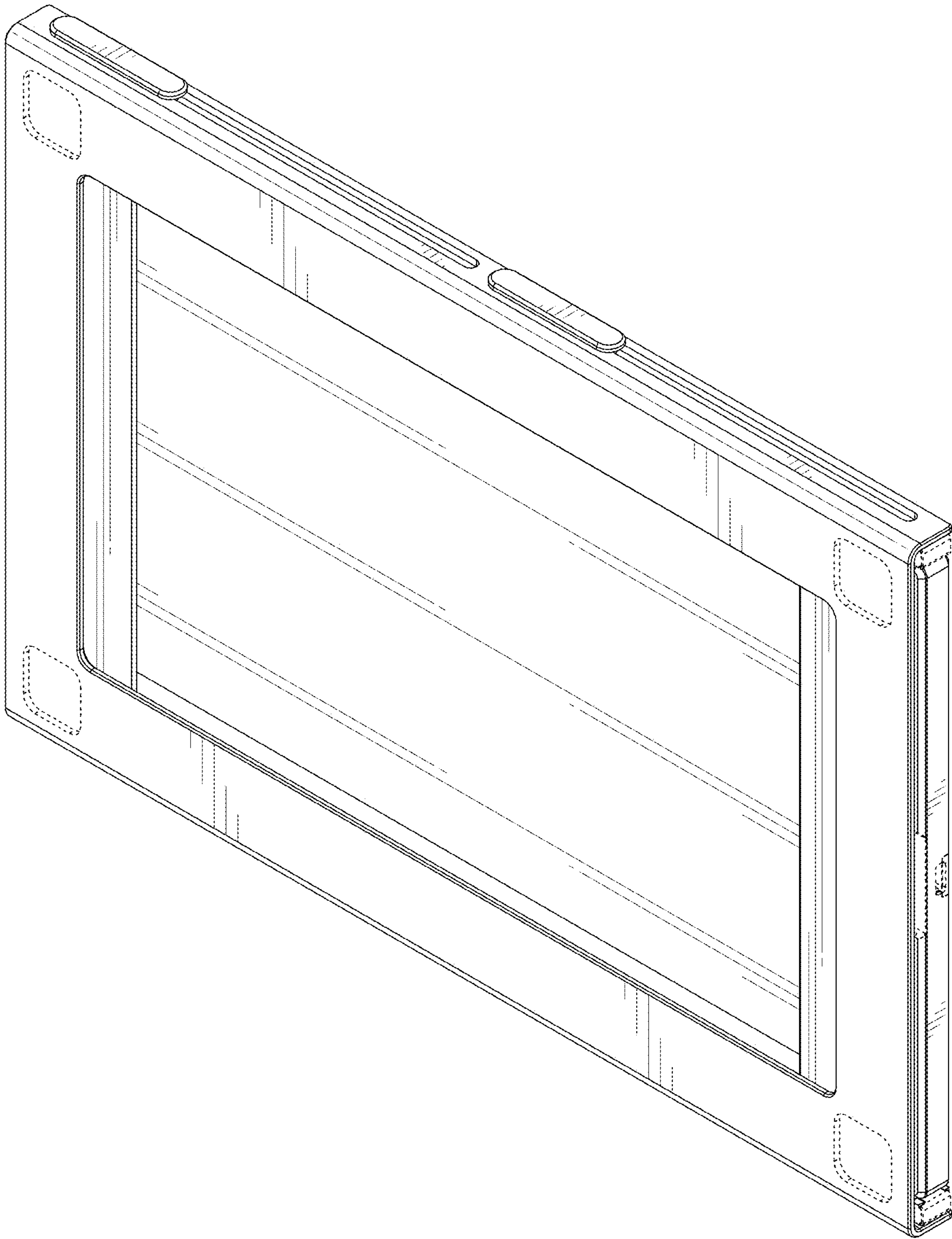

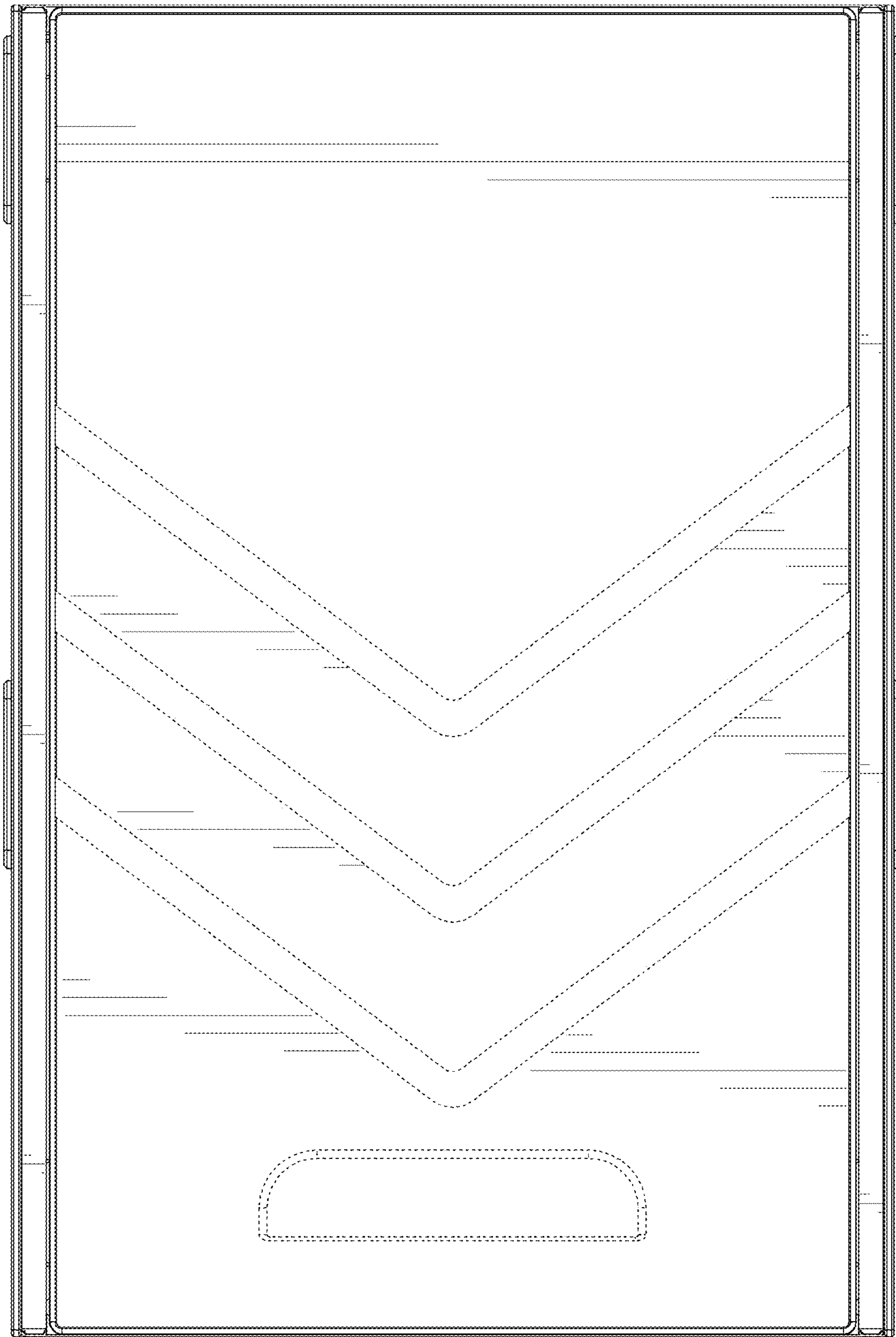

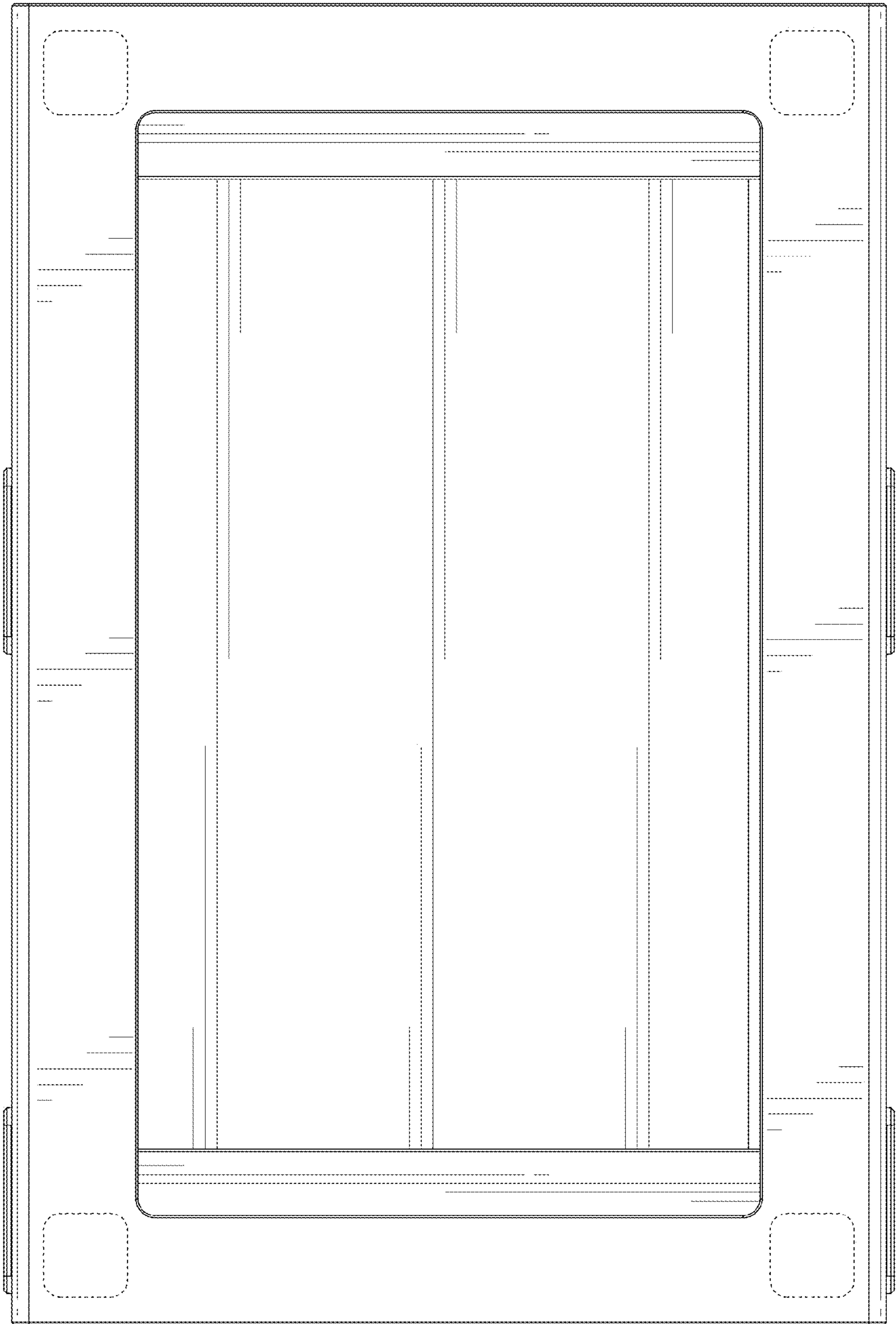

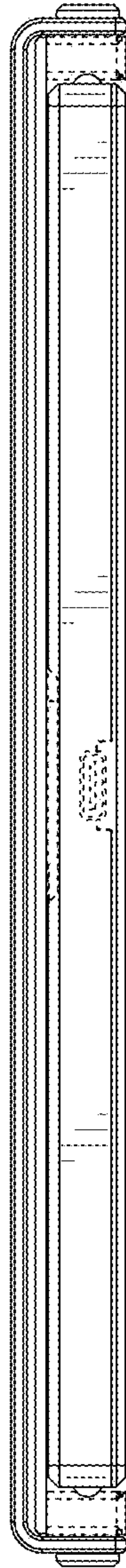

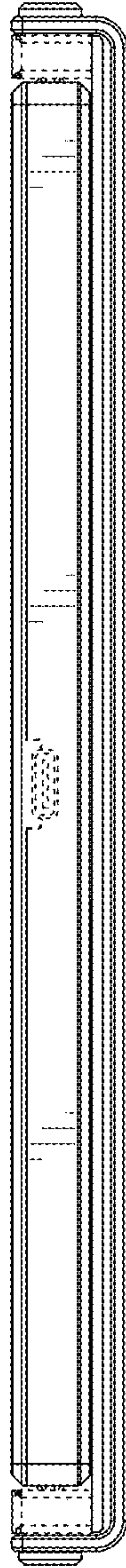

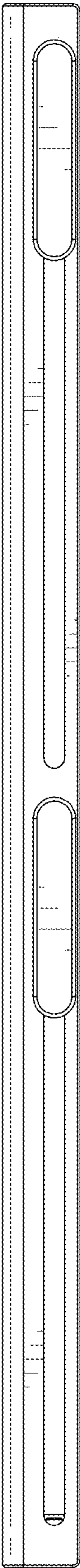

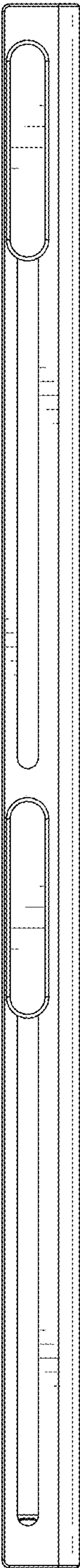
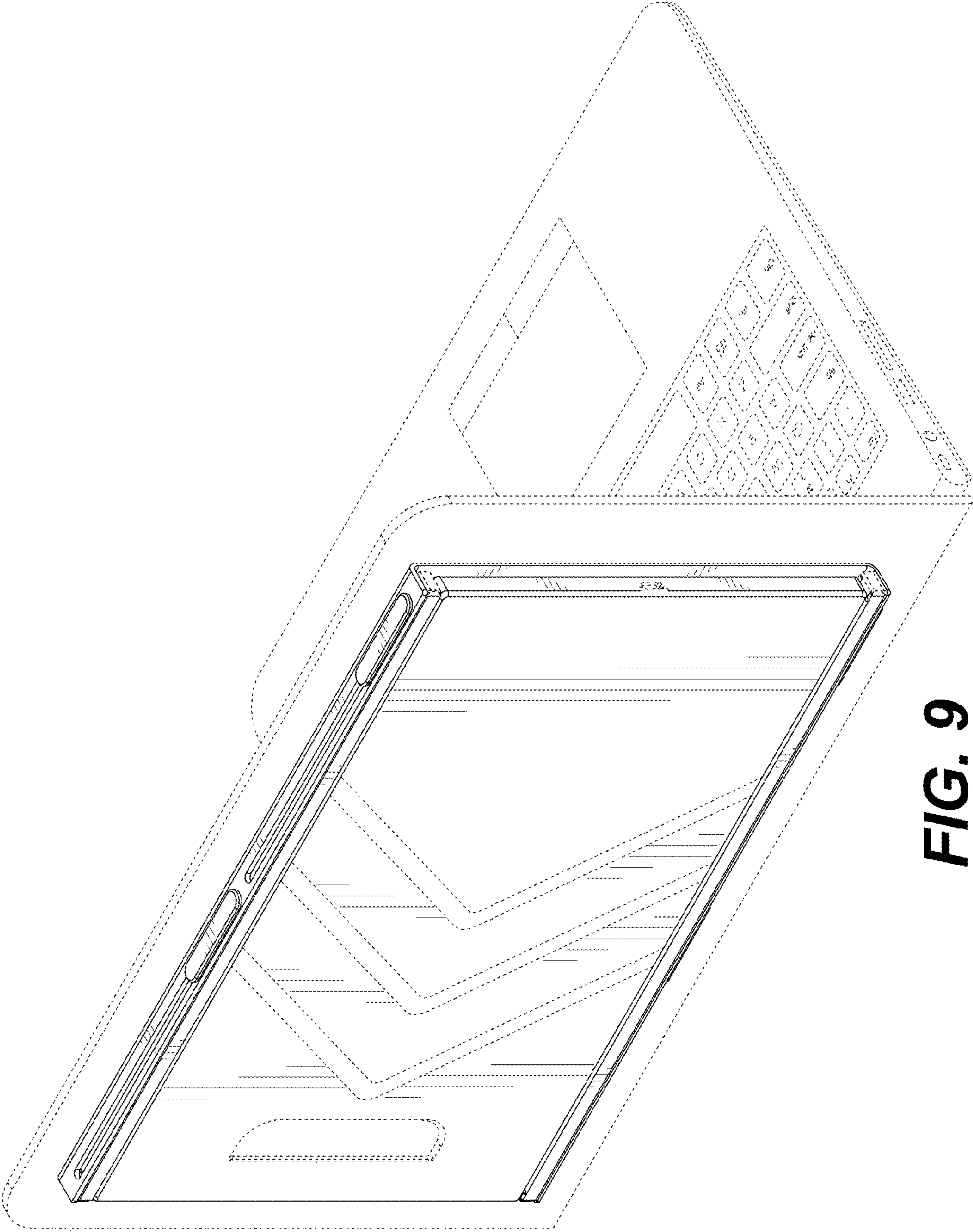

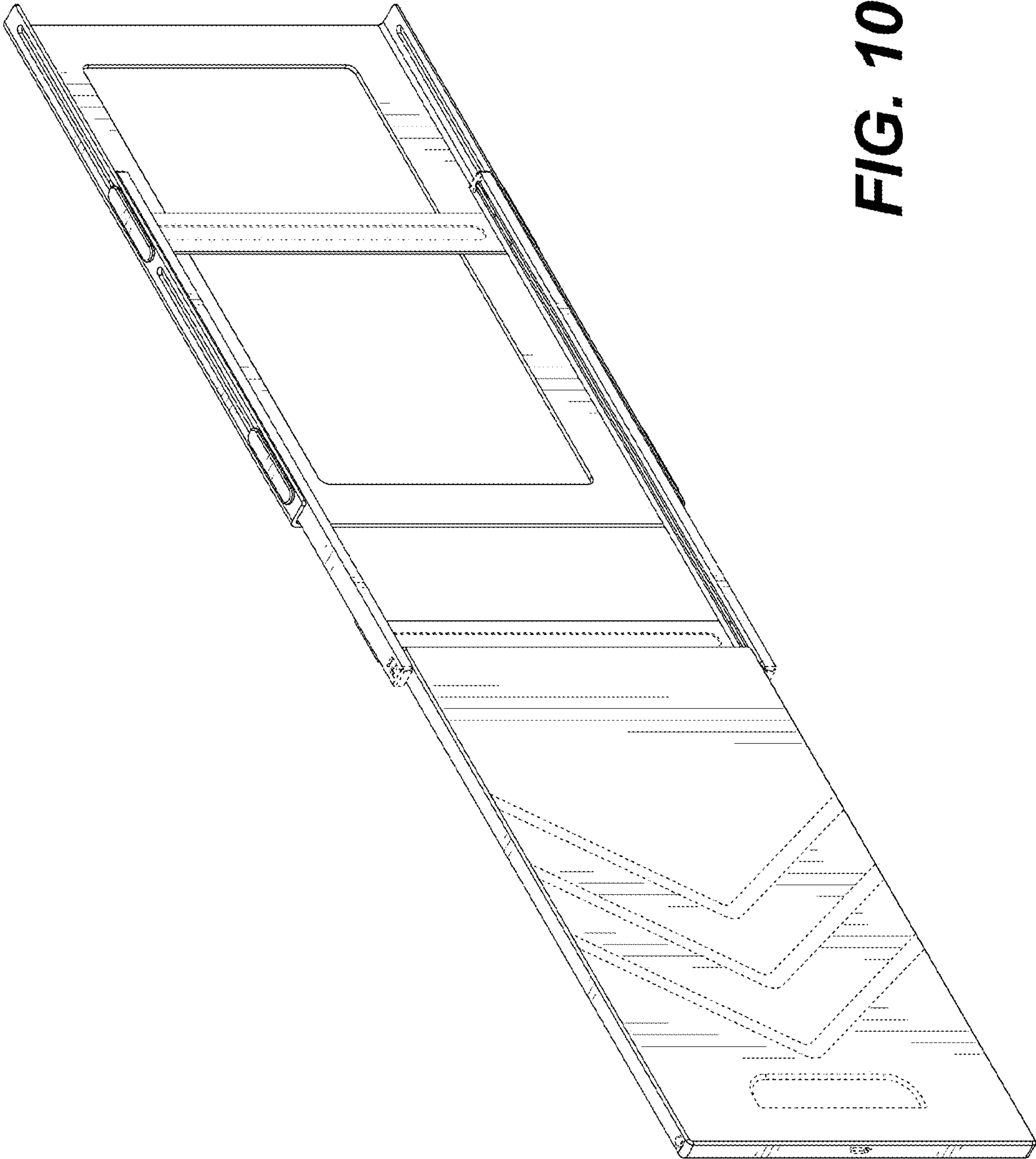

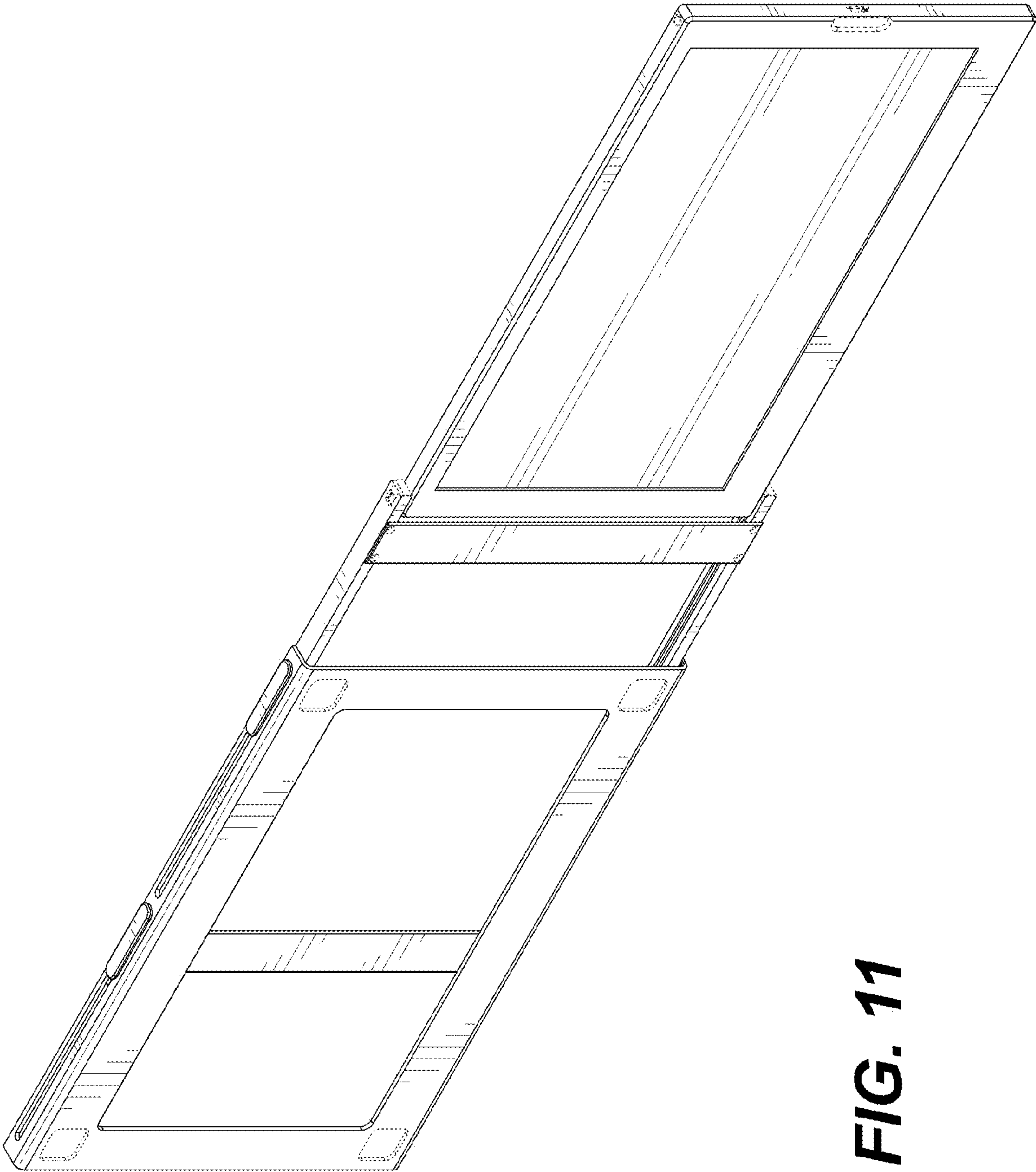

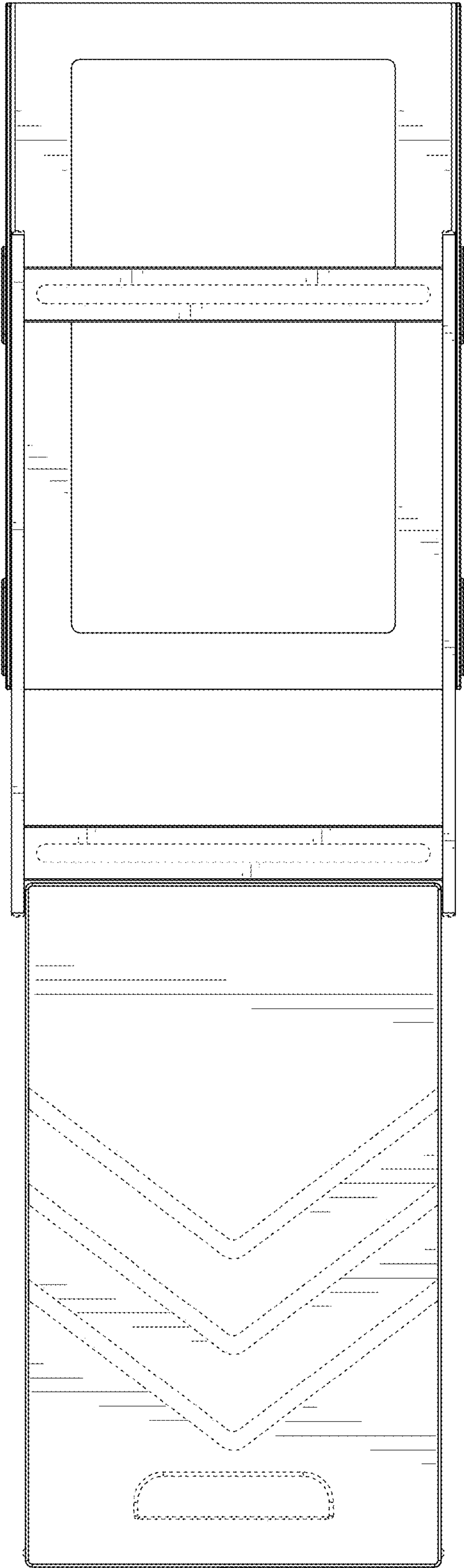

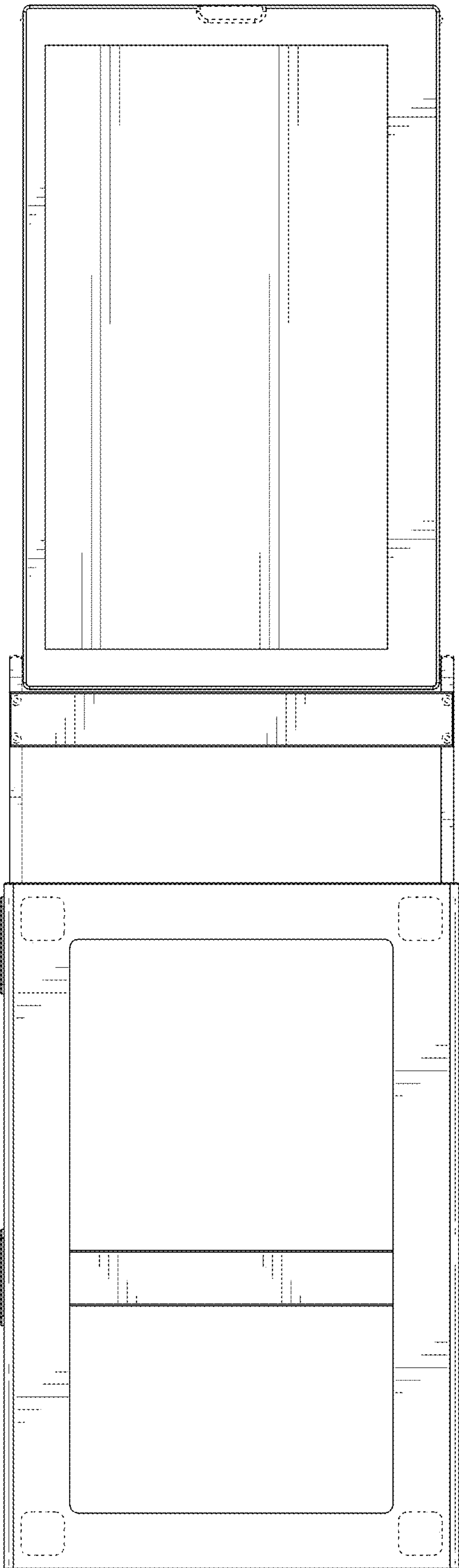

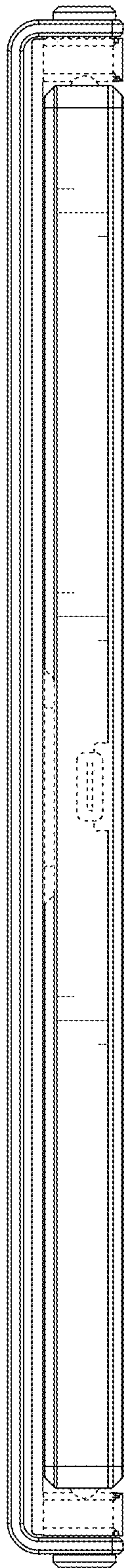

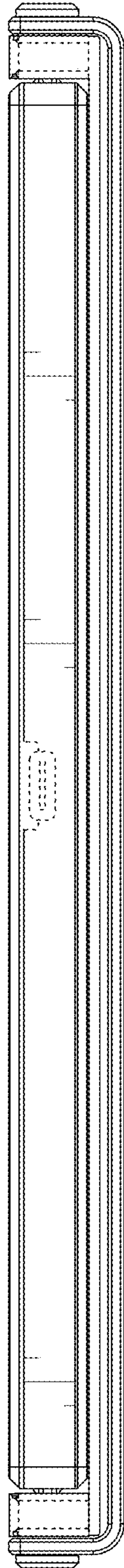

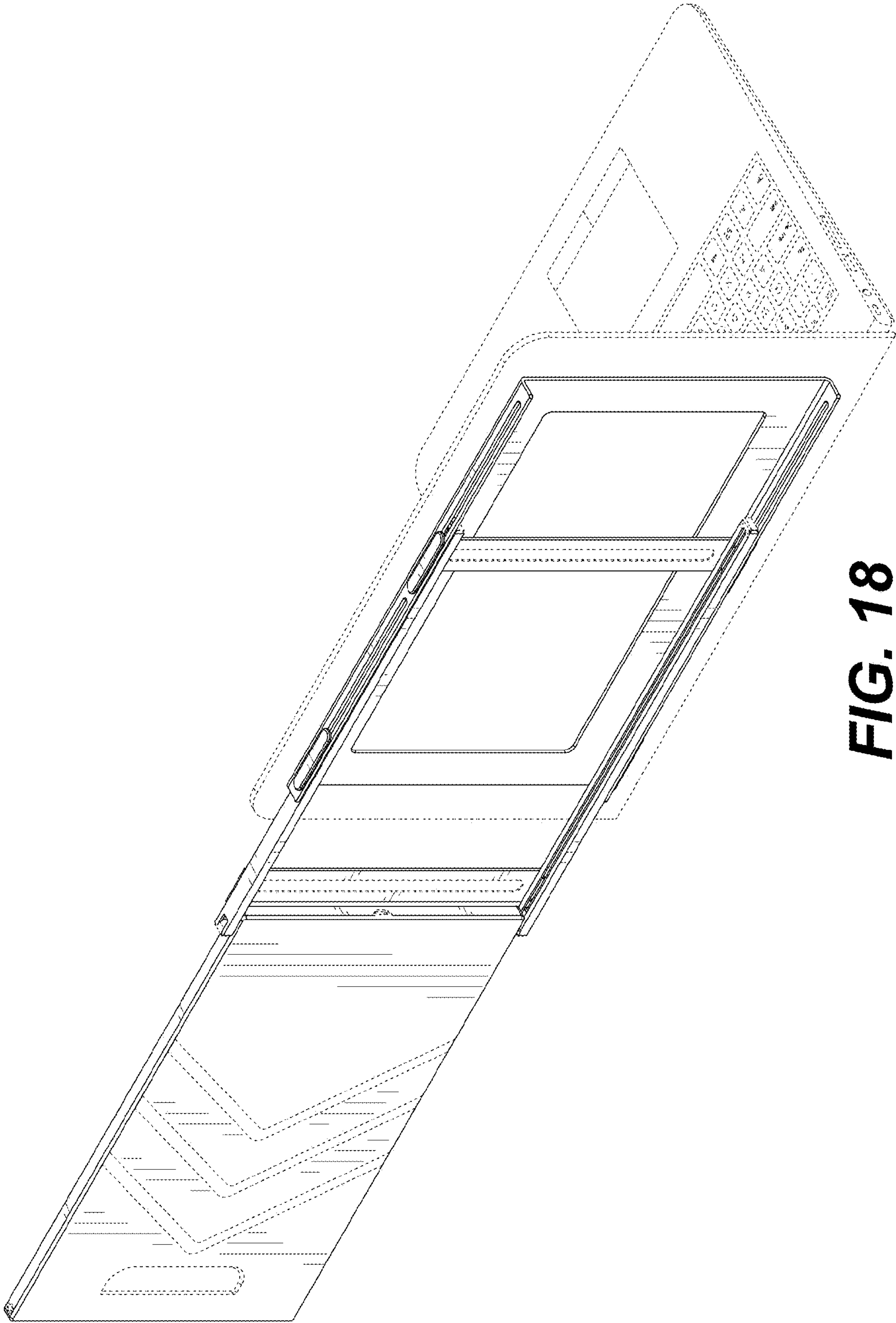

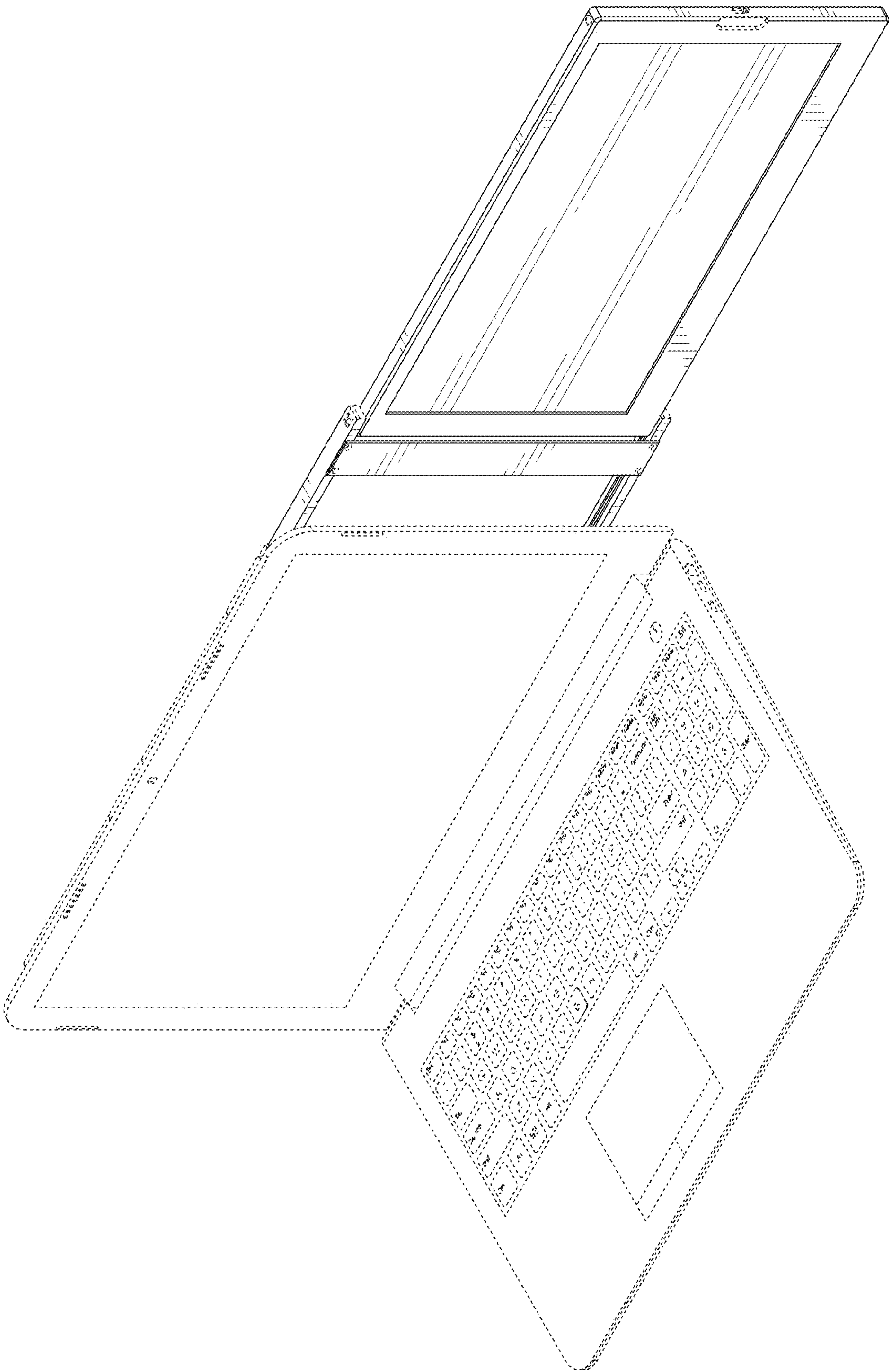
