(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a swimming rod, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a swimming rod showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.  
The swimming rod is shown with a symbolic break in its length, as illustrated with the dash-dot broken lines. The appearance of any portion of the article between the dash-dot broken lines forms no part of the claimed design.

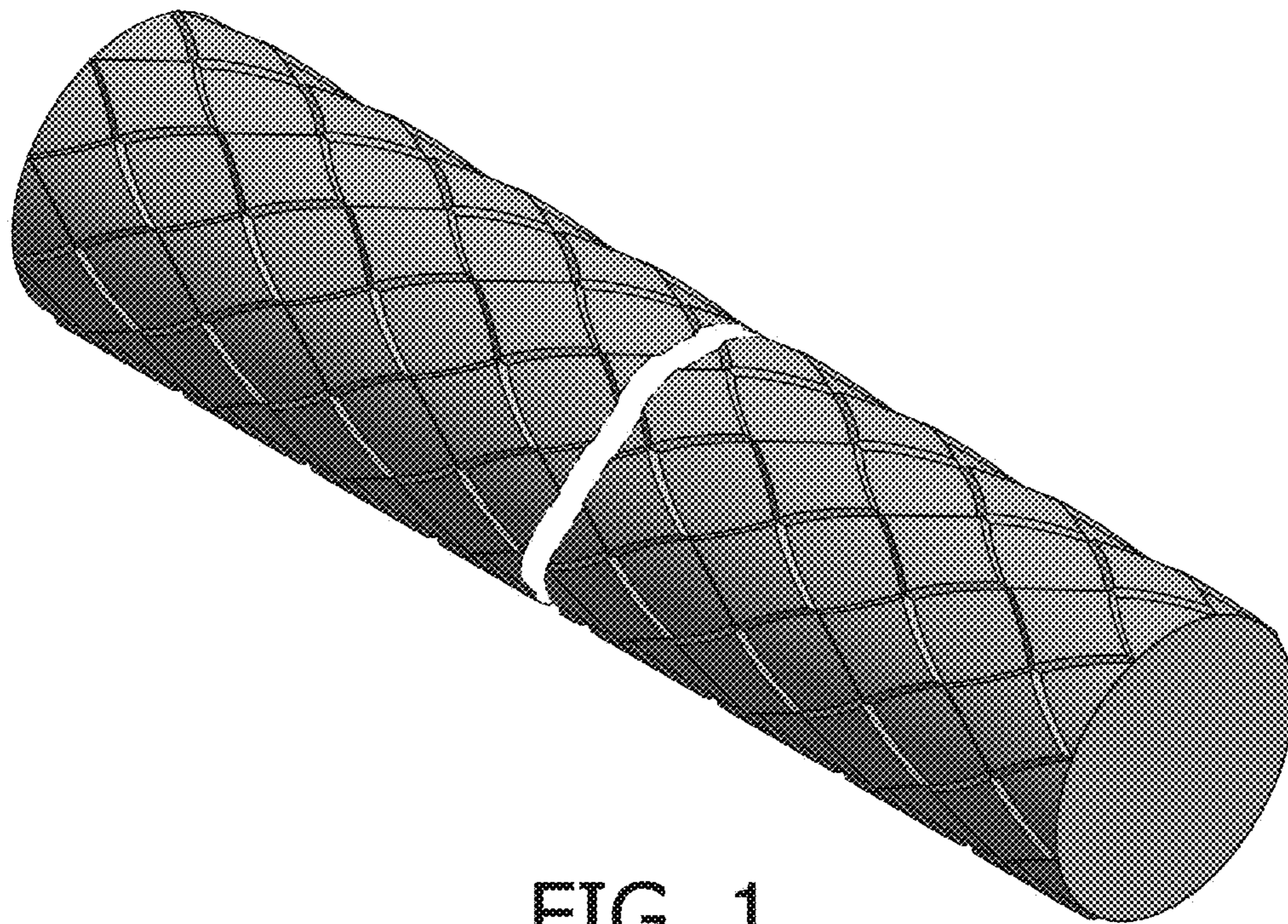

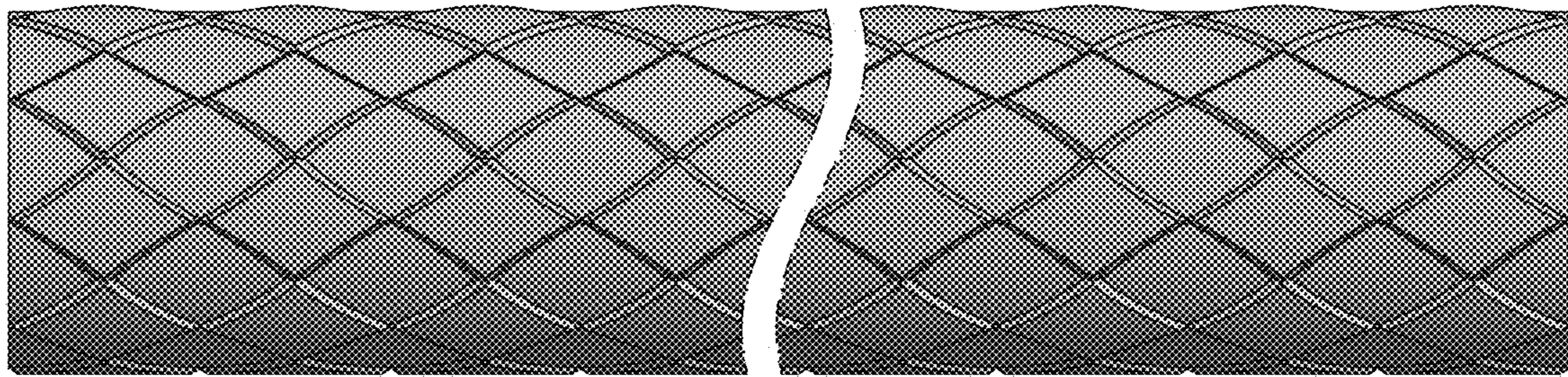

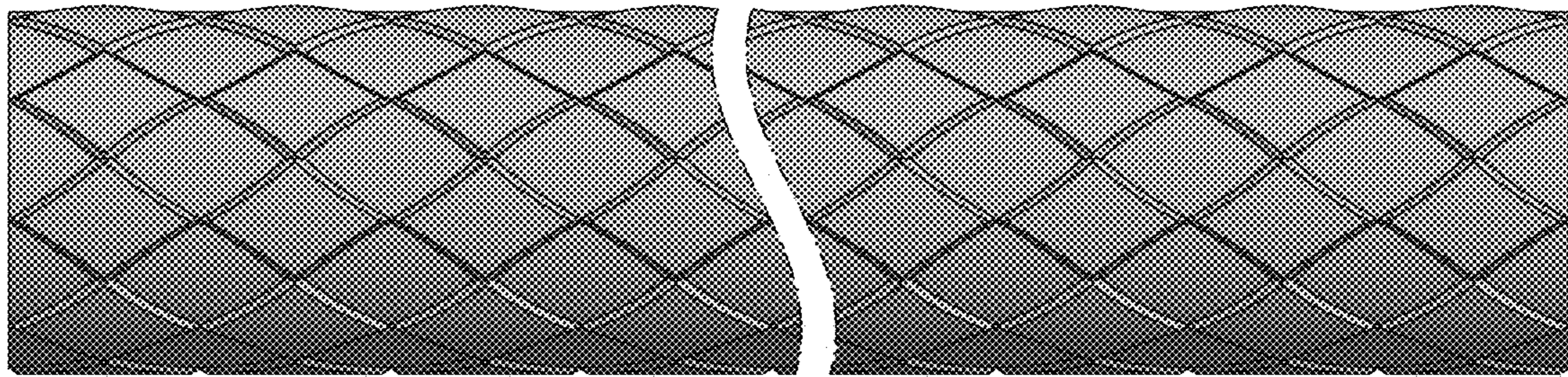

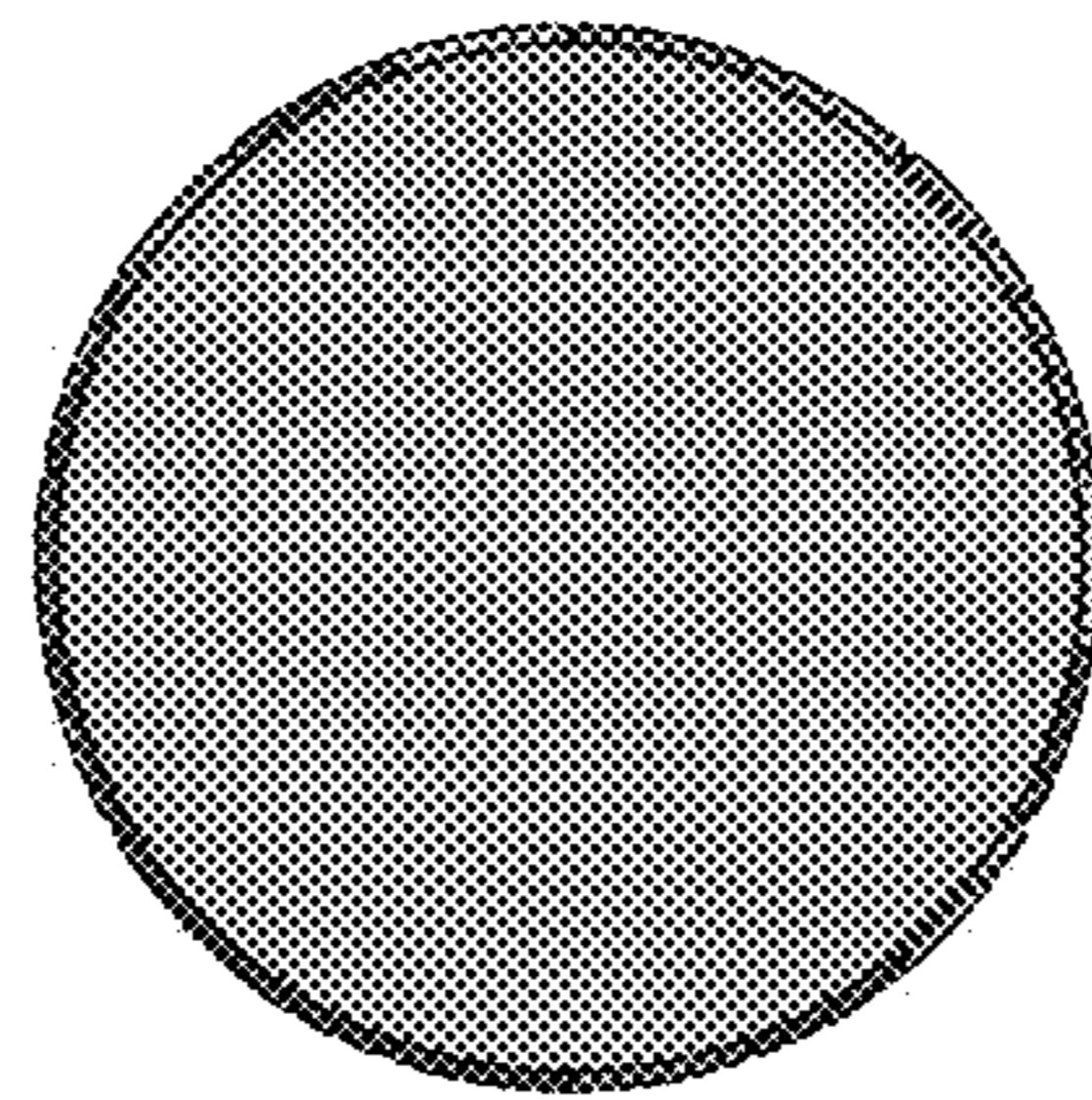

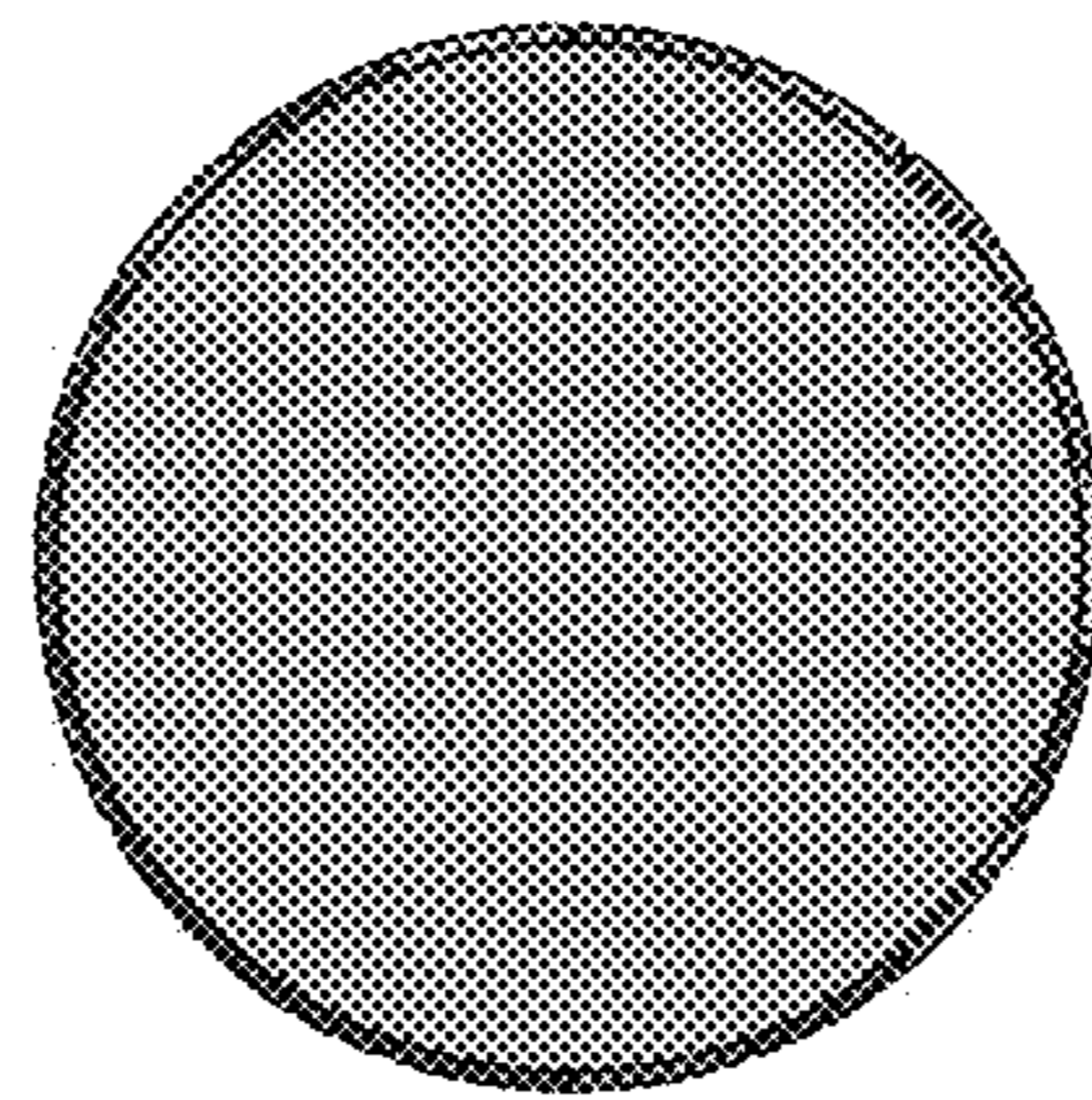

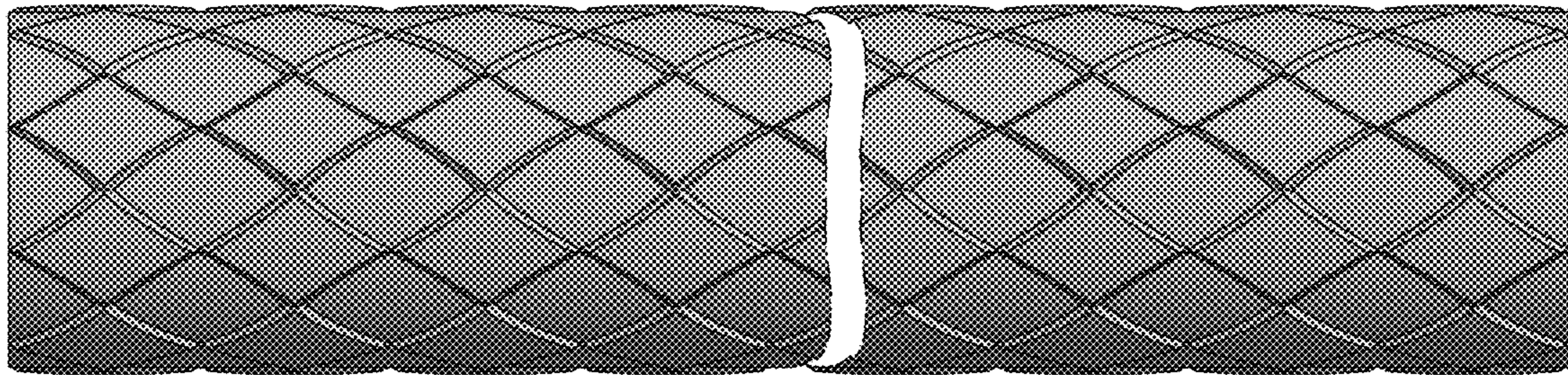

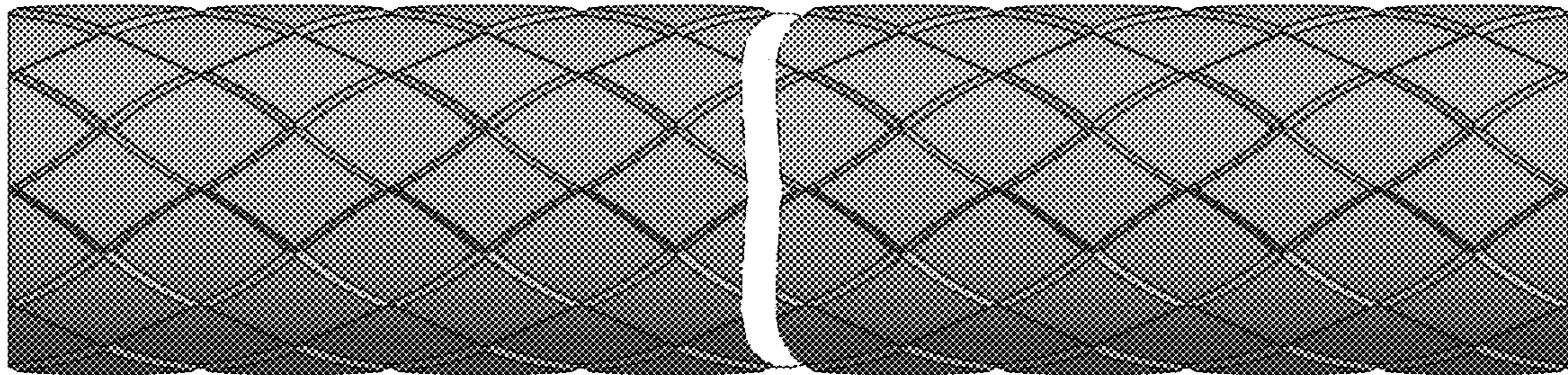
