The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,

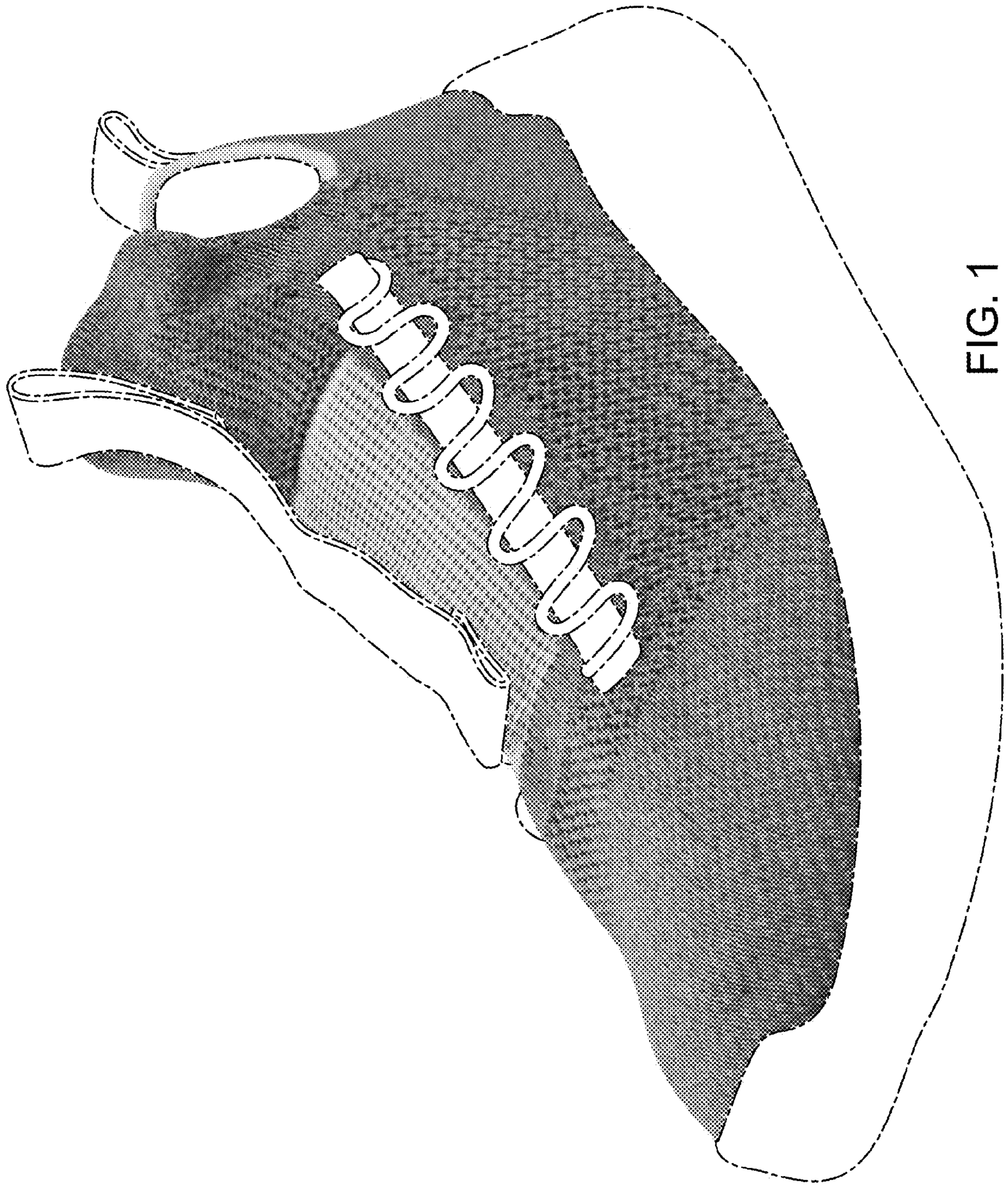

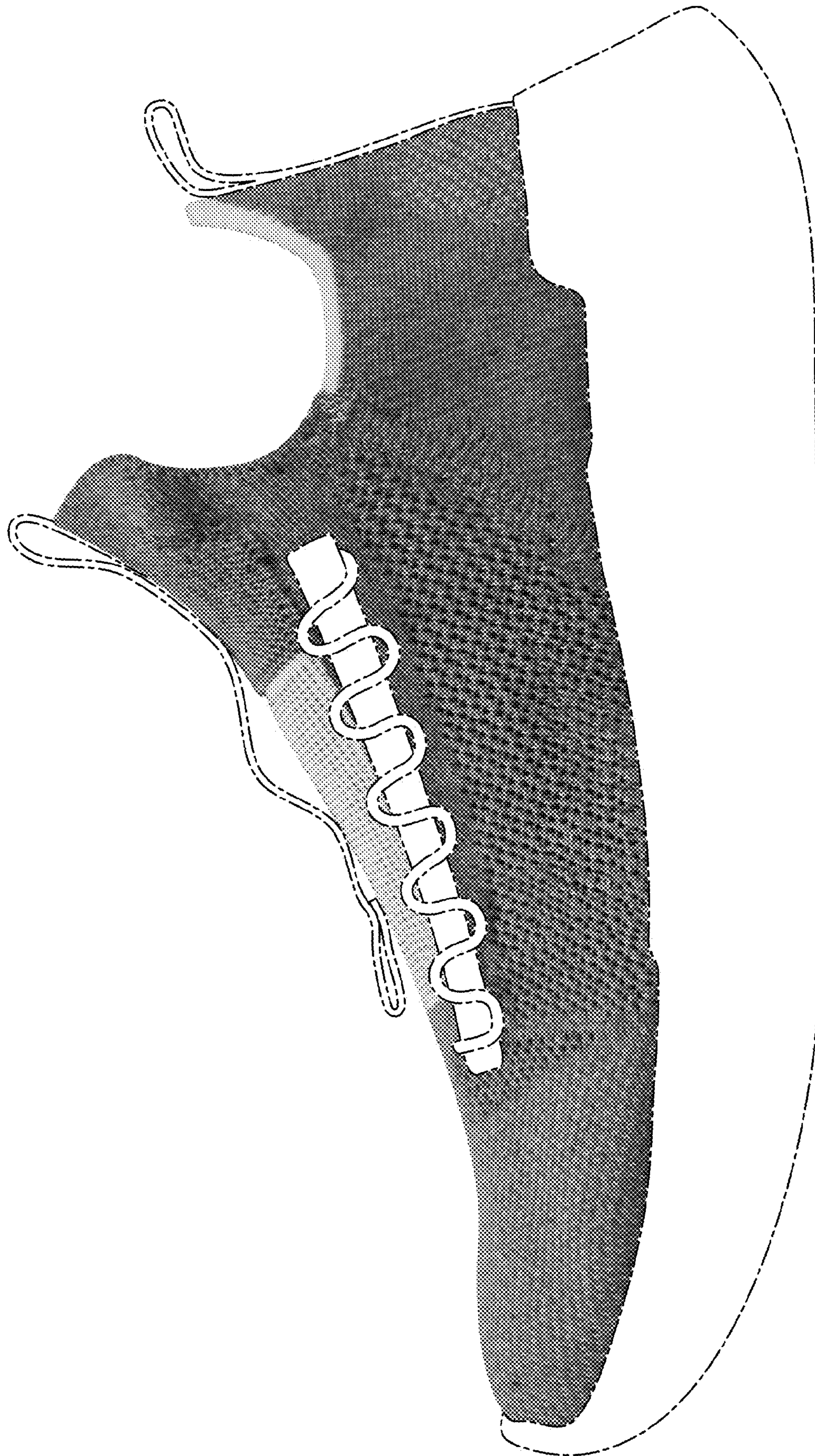

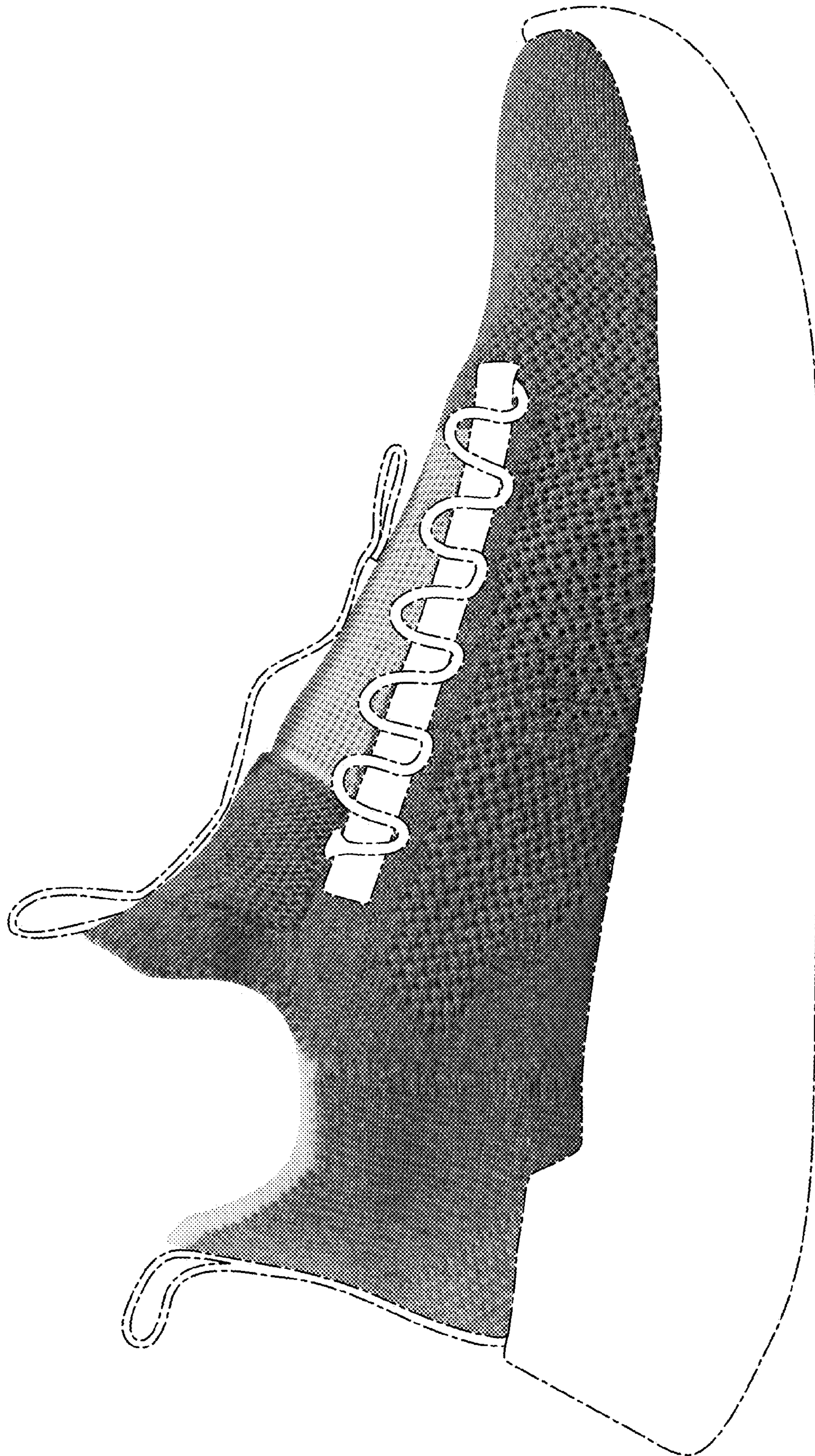

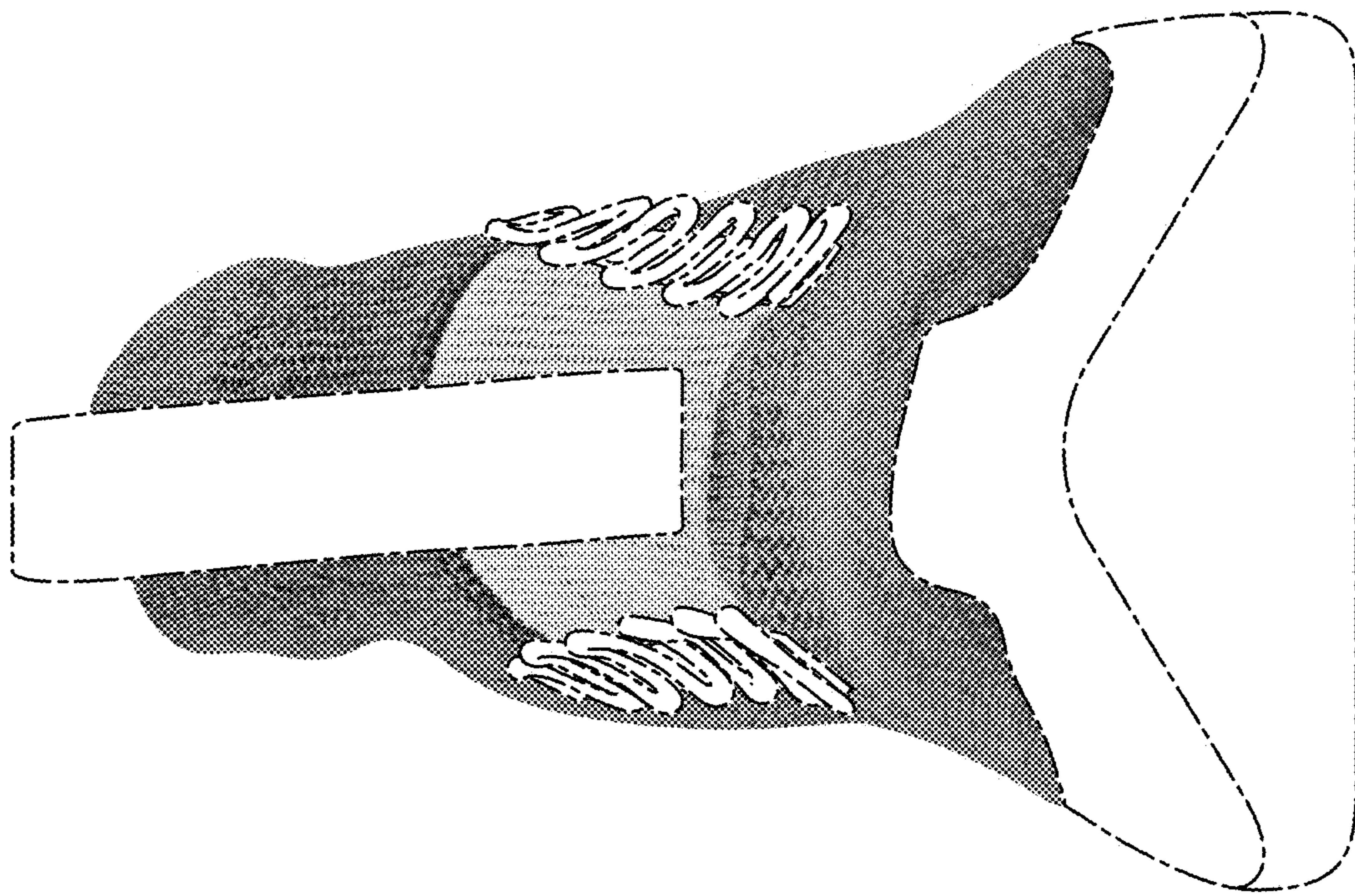

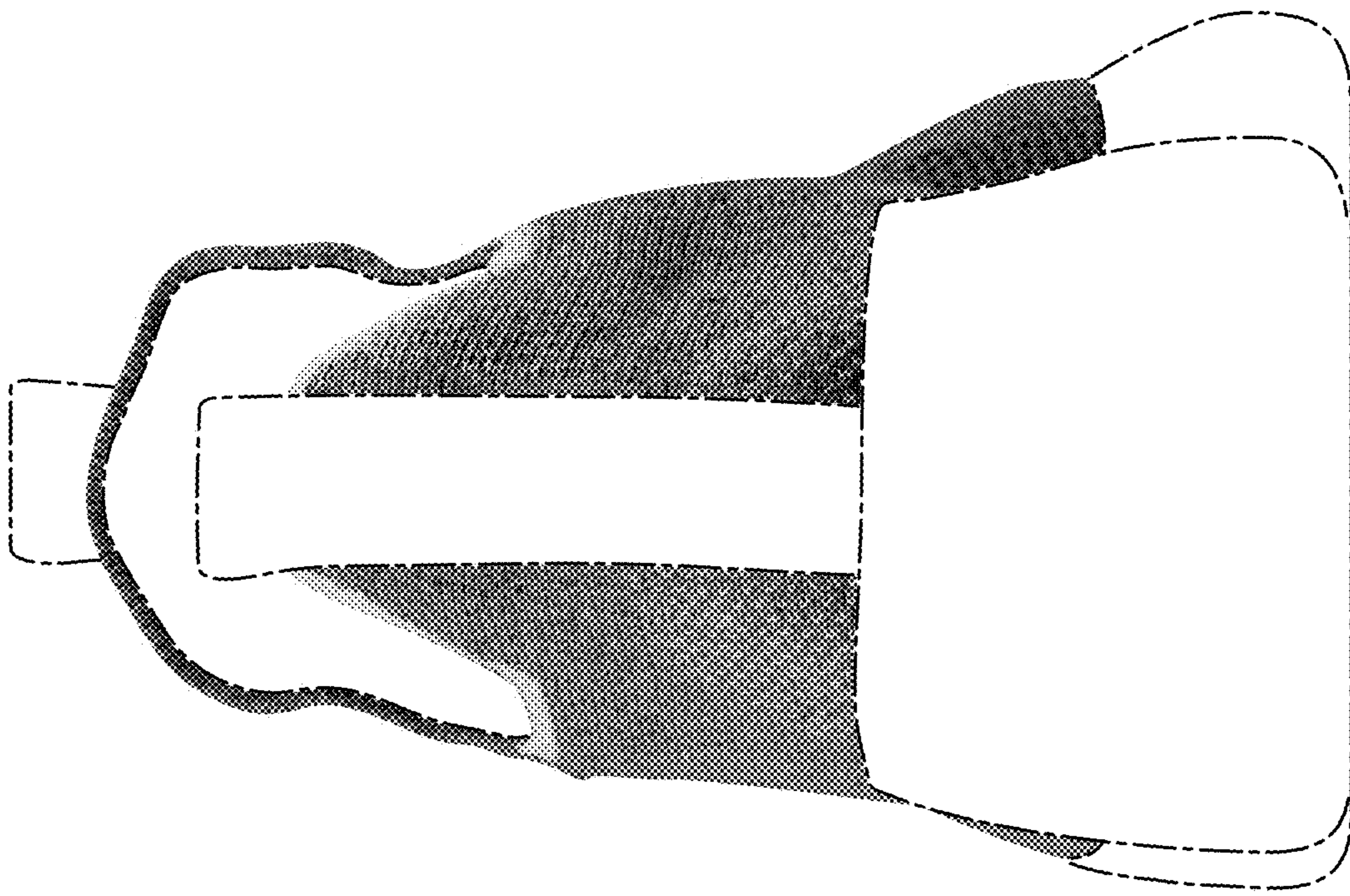

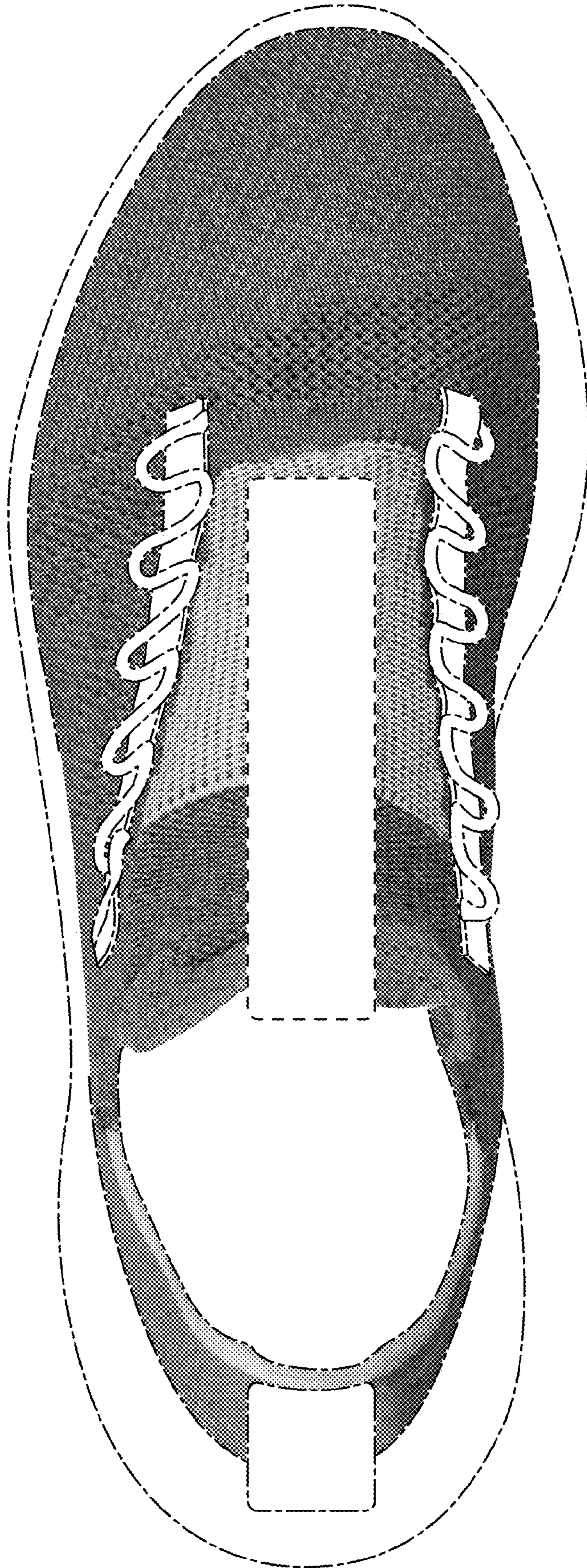
