The appearance of a confection in container, as shown and described.

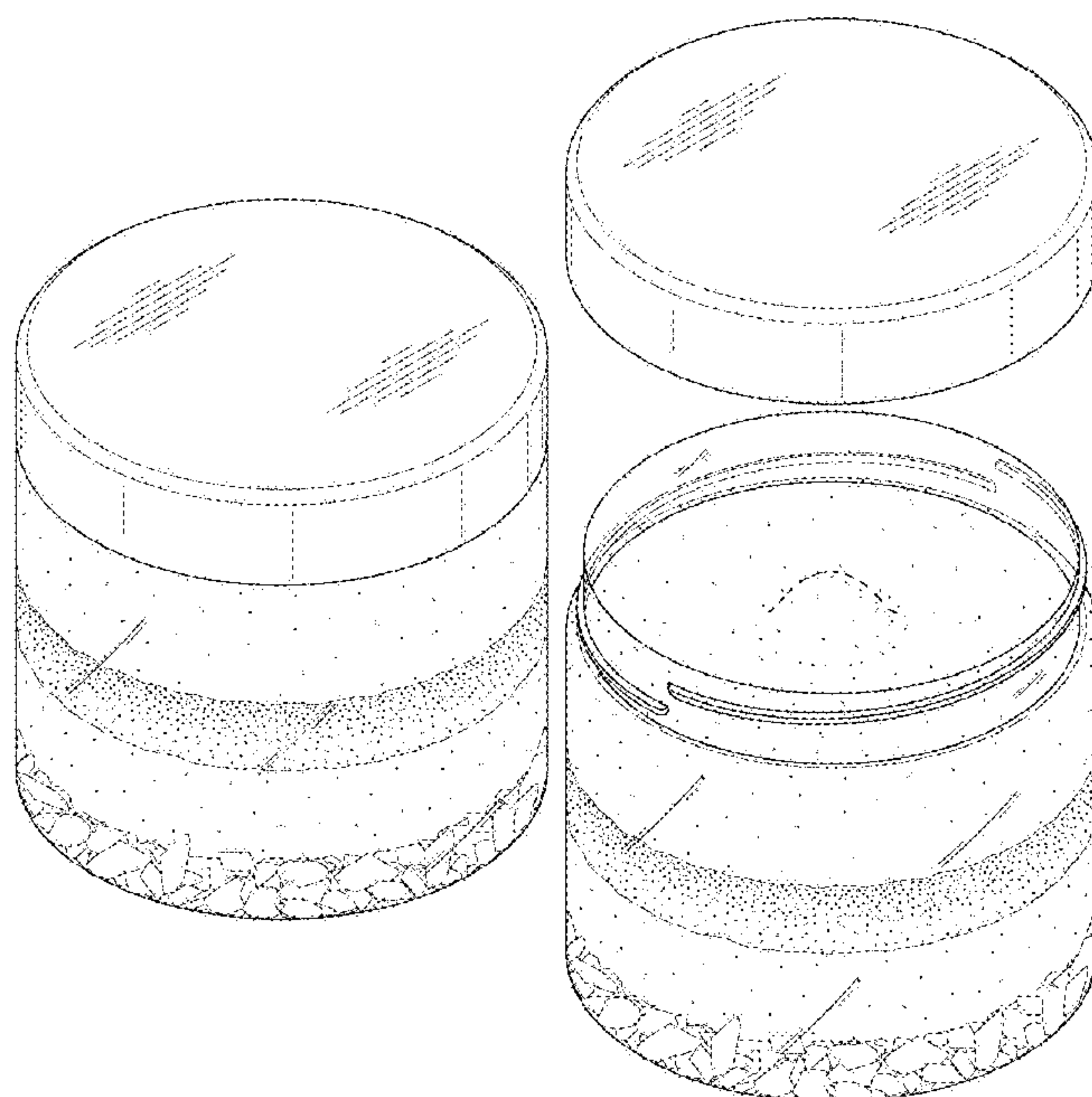
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a confection in container, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of my new design;
FIG. 4 is a left elevational view of my new design;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of my new design;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of my new design; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of my new design with the cover removed.

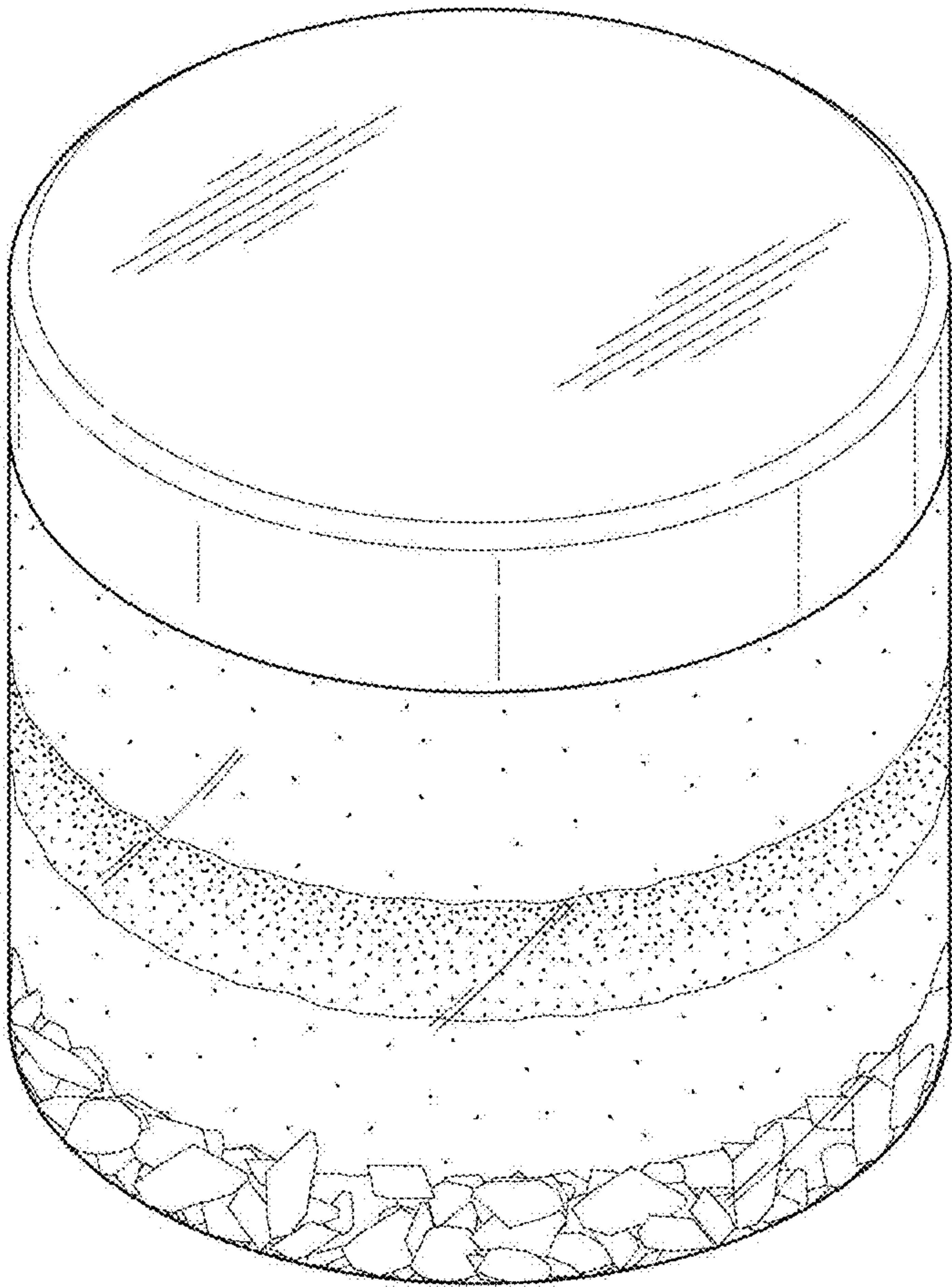

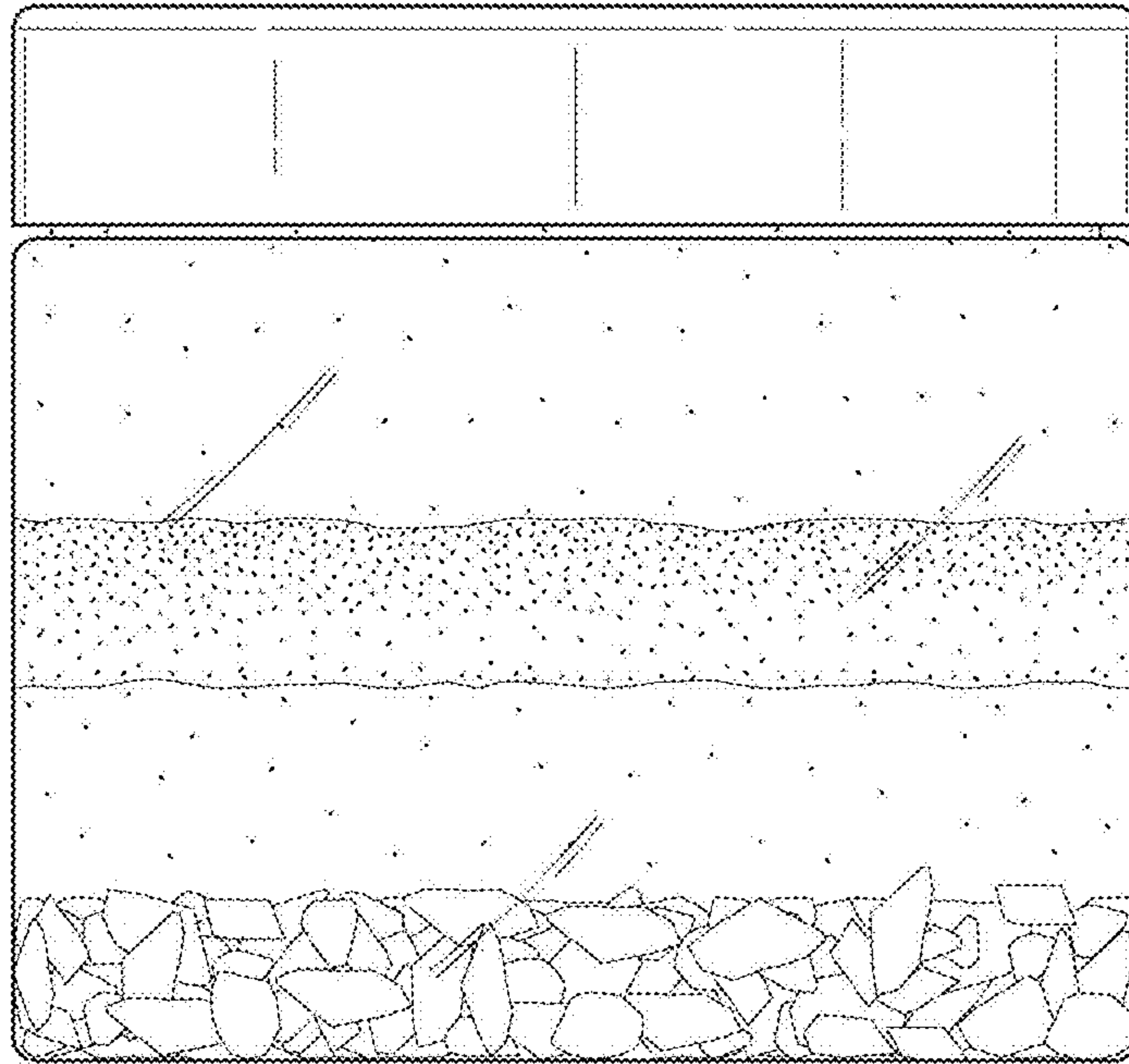

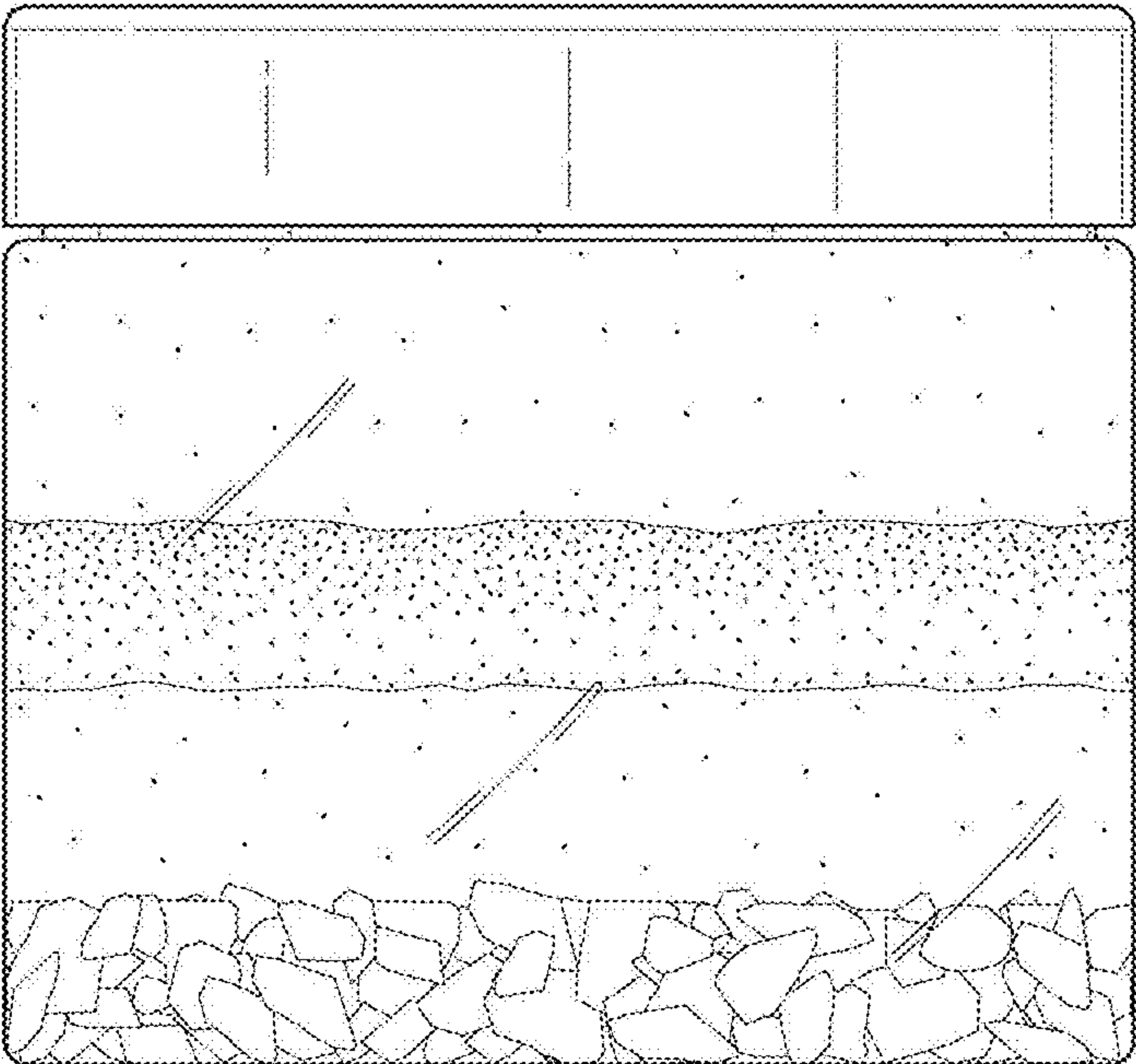

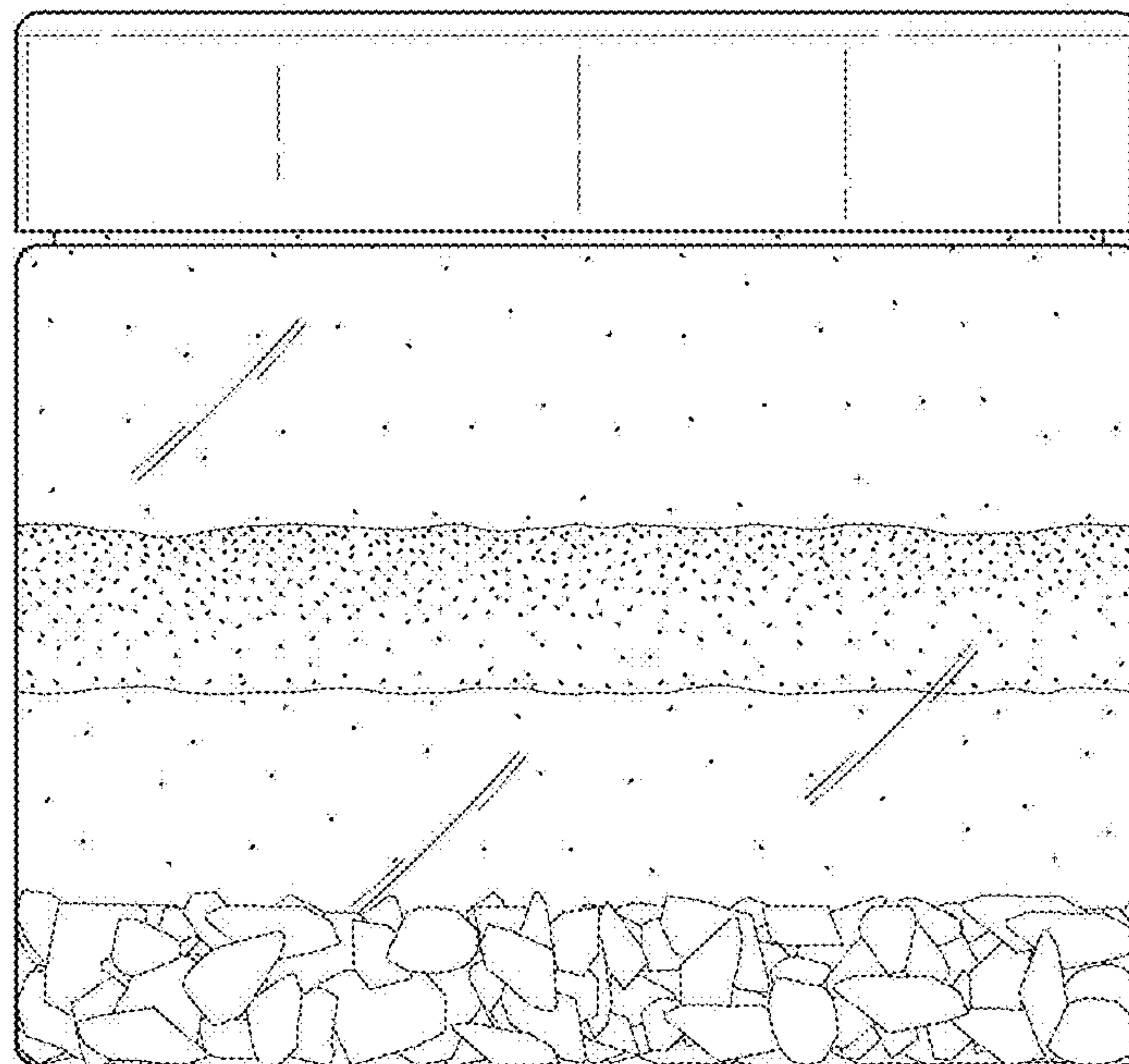

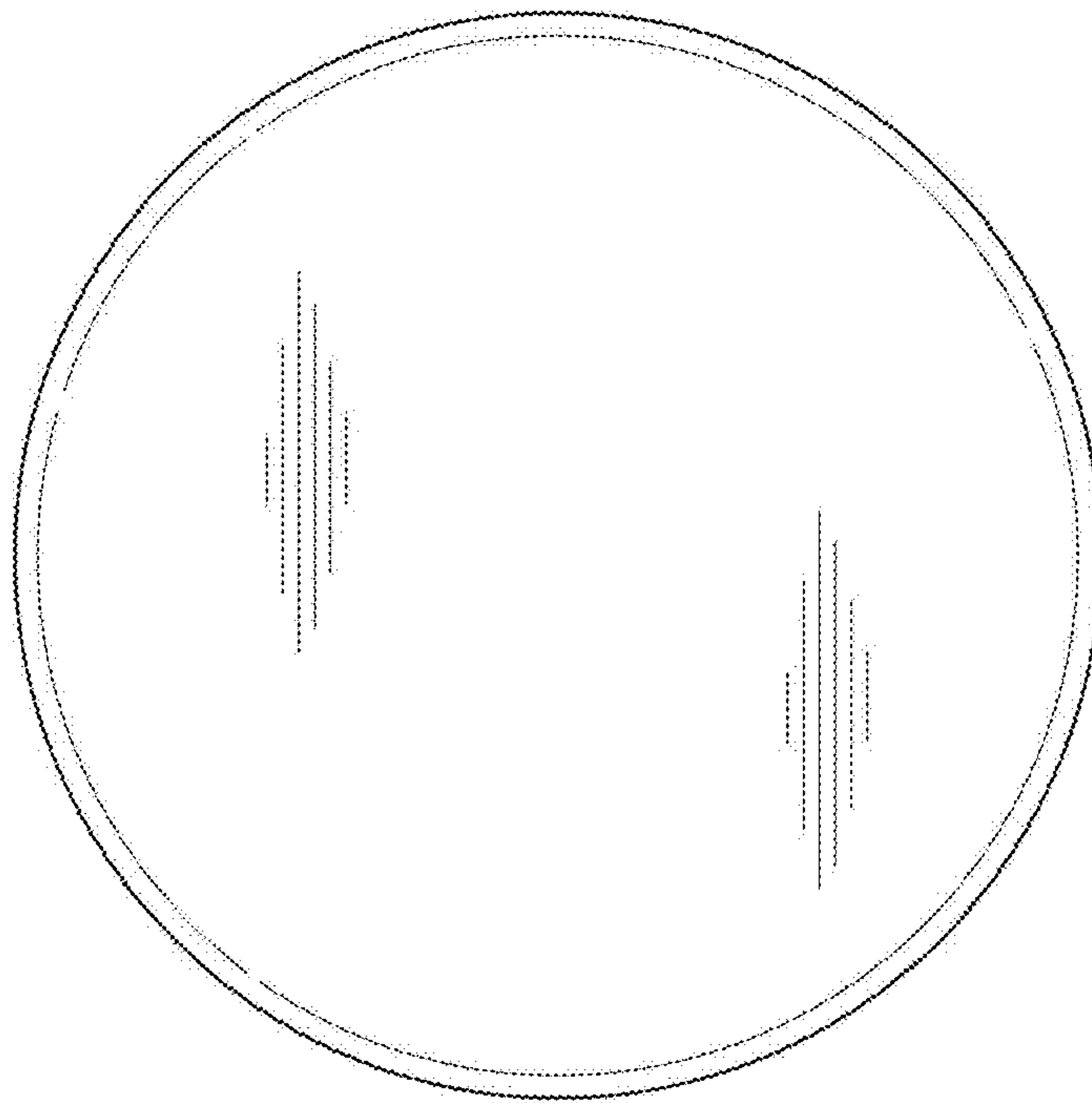

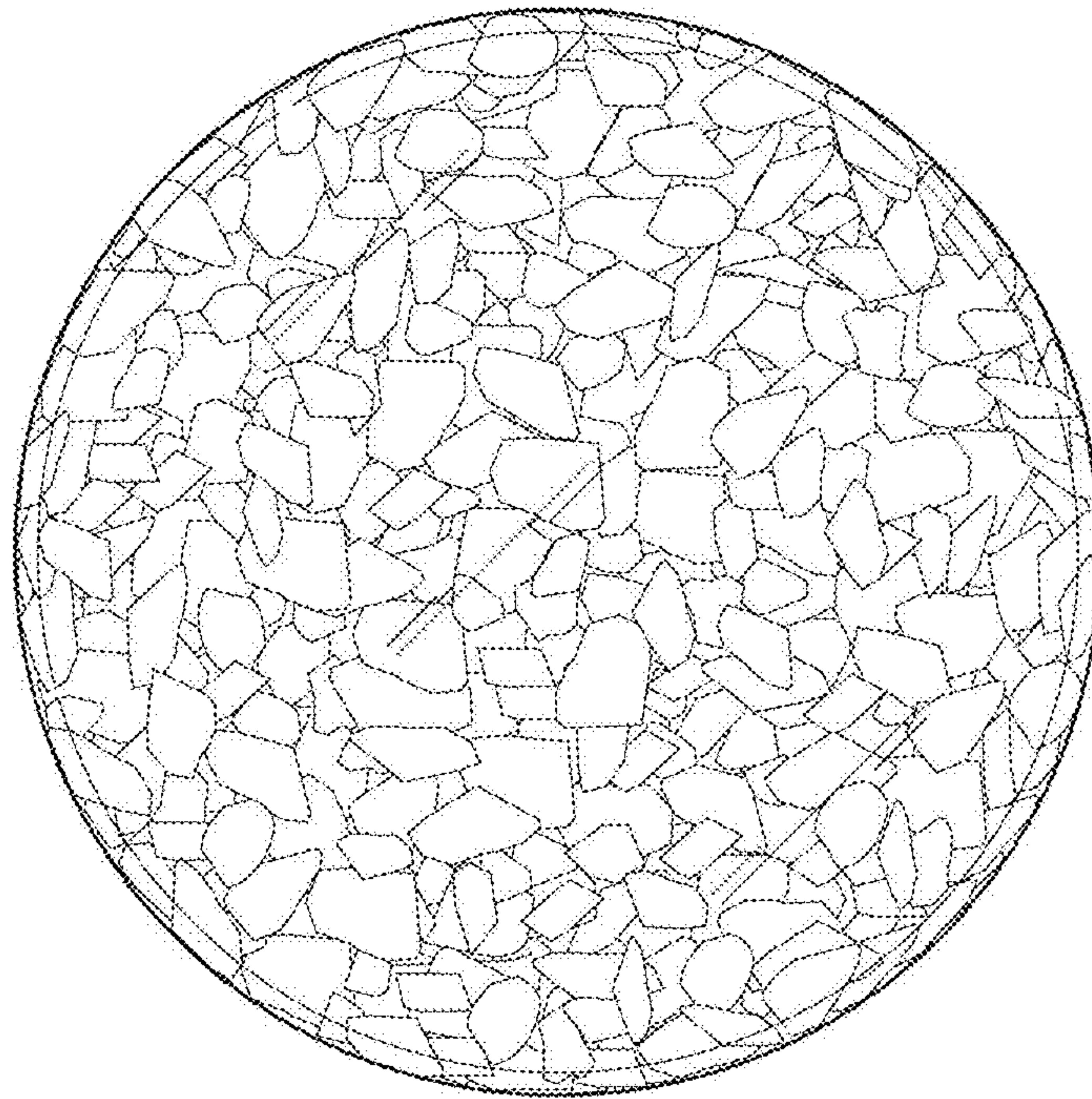

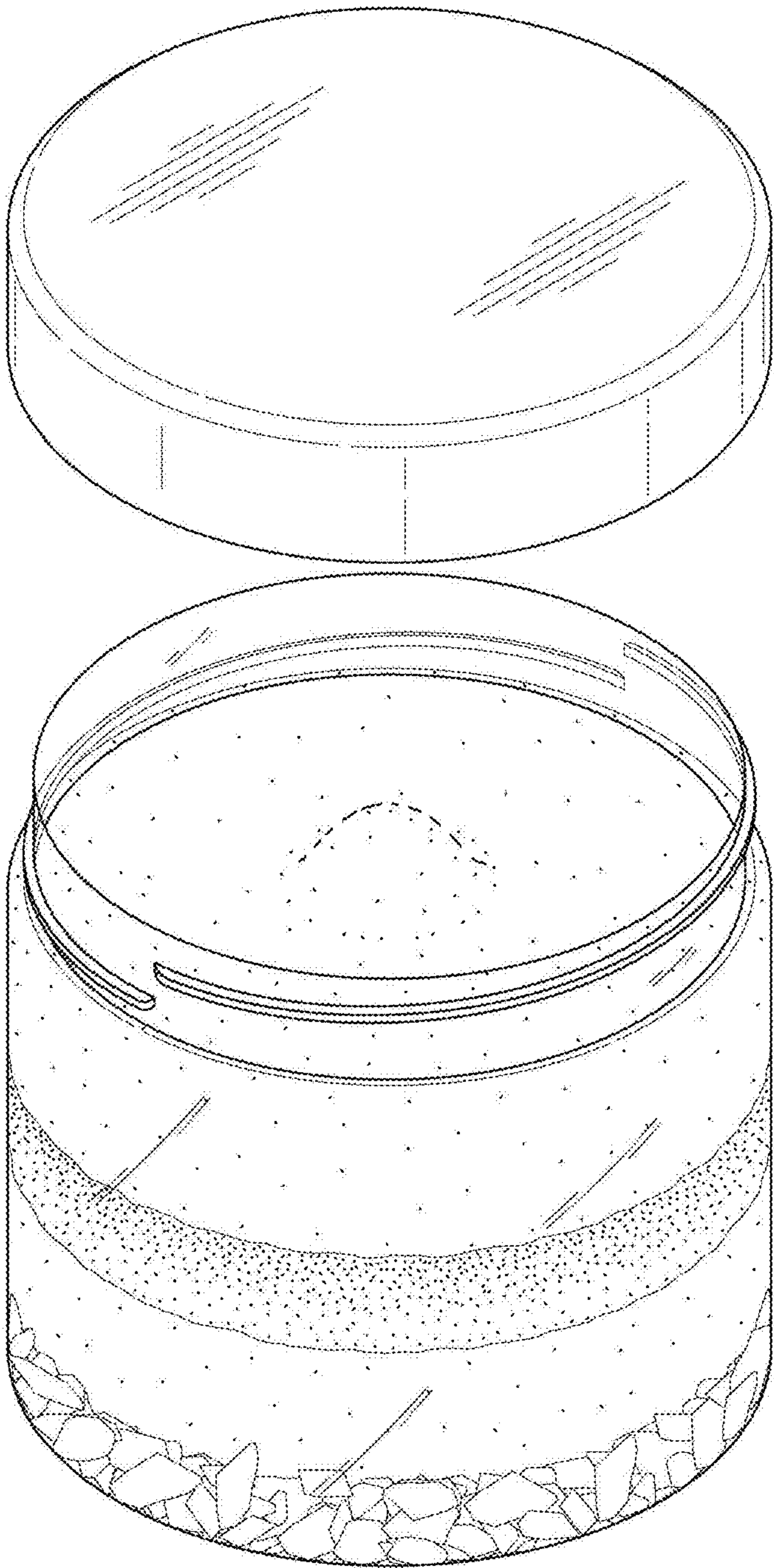
