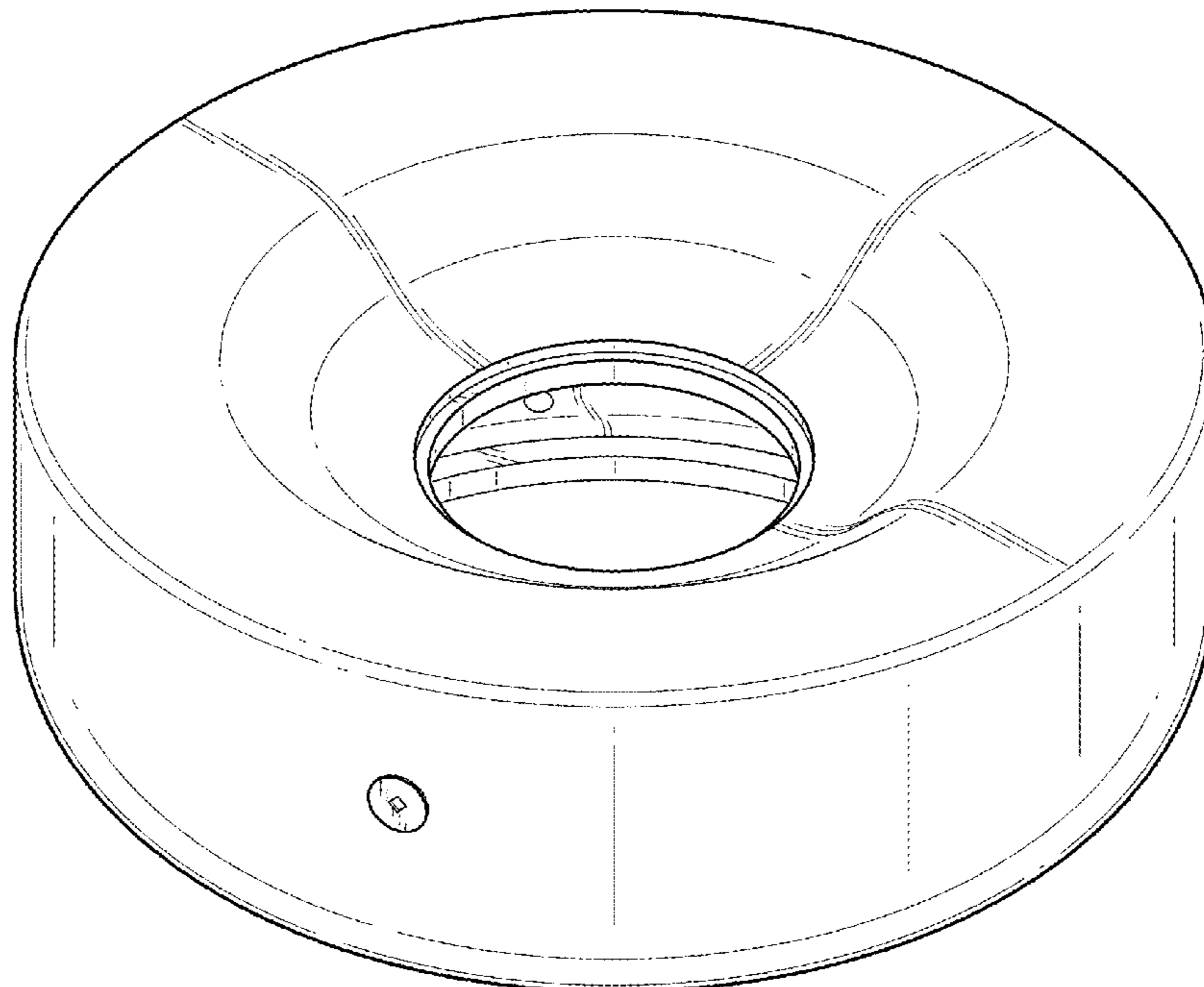
The ornamental design for a concrete fire bowl, as shown and described.

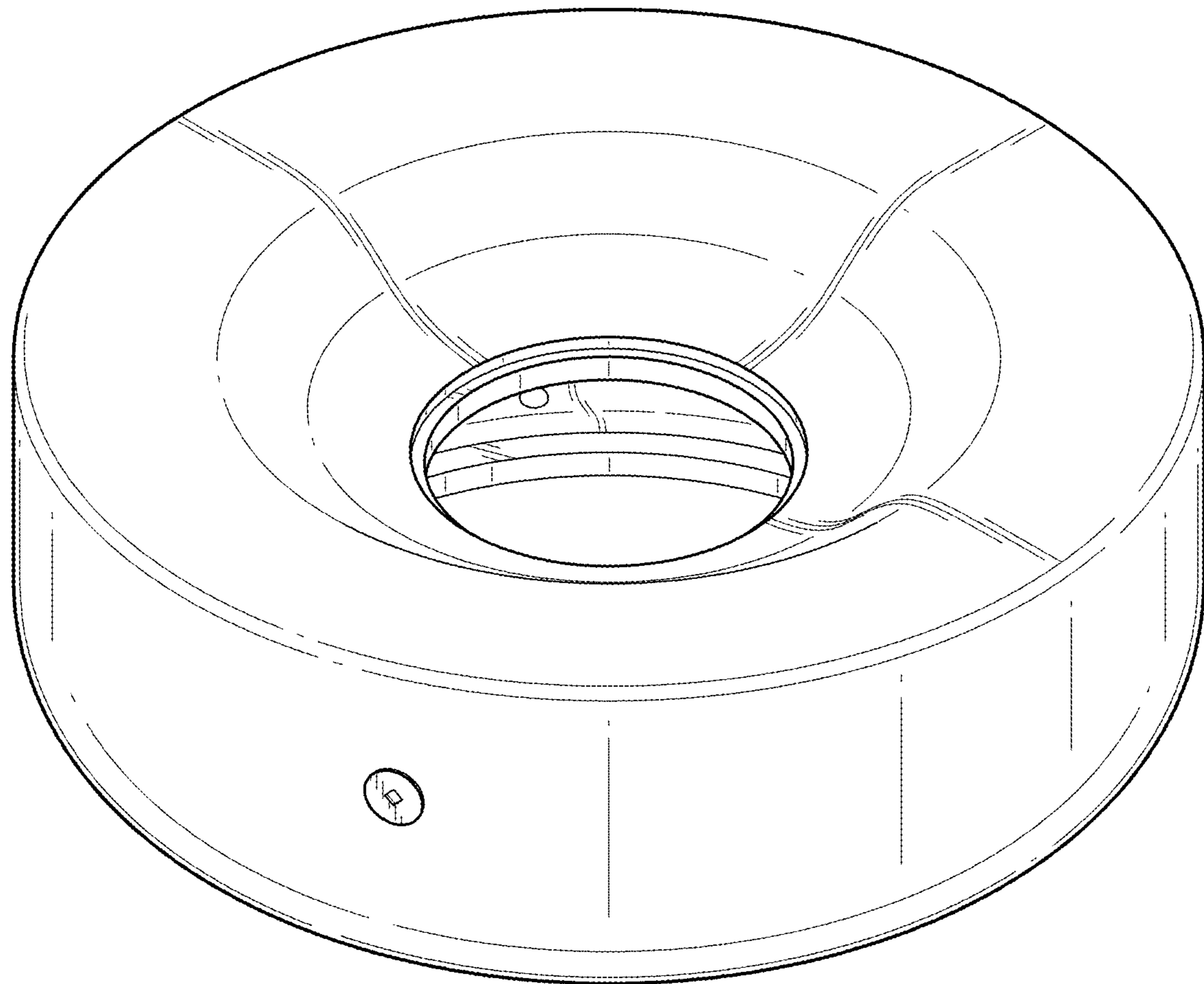
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the concrete fire bowl embodied in the present invention;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the concrete fire bowl from FIG. 1;

The dash-dash-dash broken line shown in FIGS. 3 through 6 is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental context and forms no part of the claimed design.

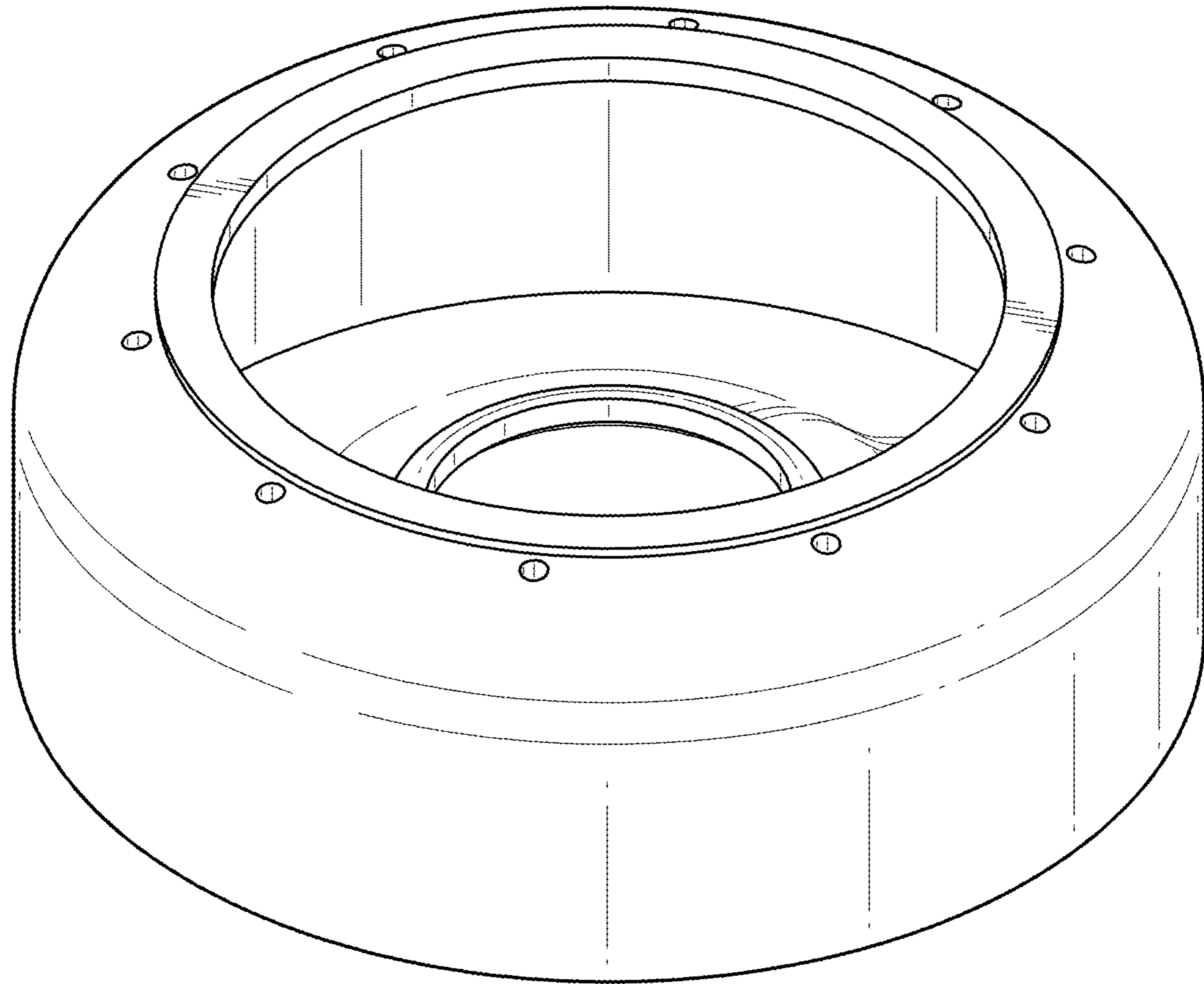

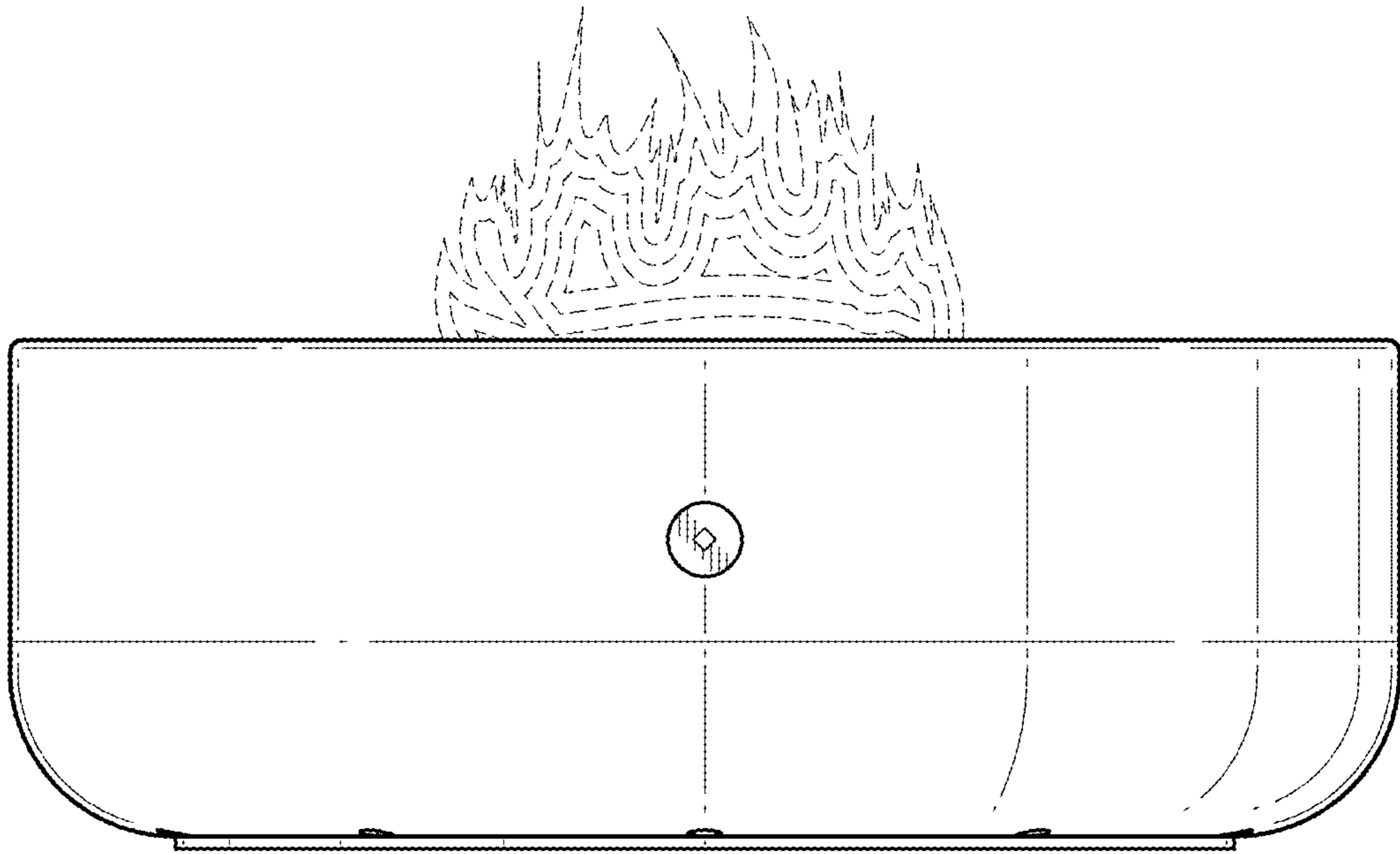




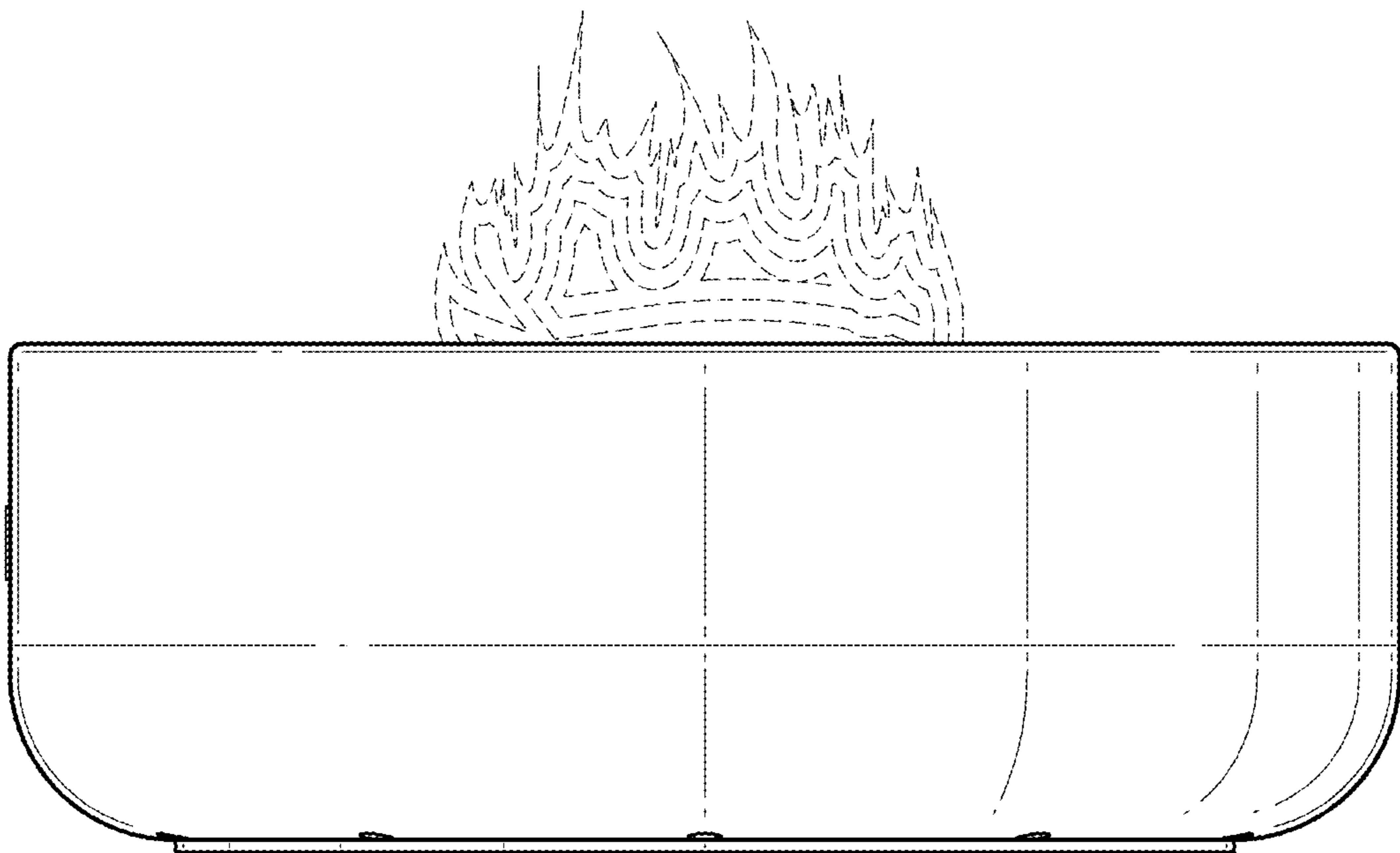

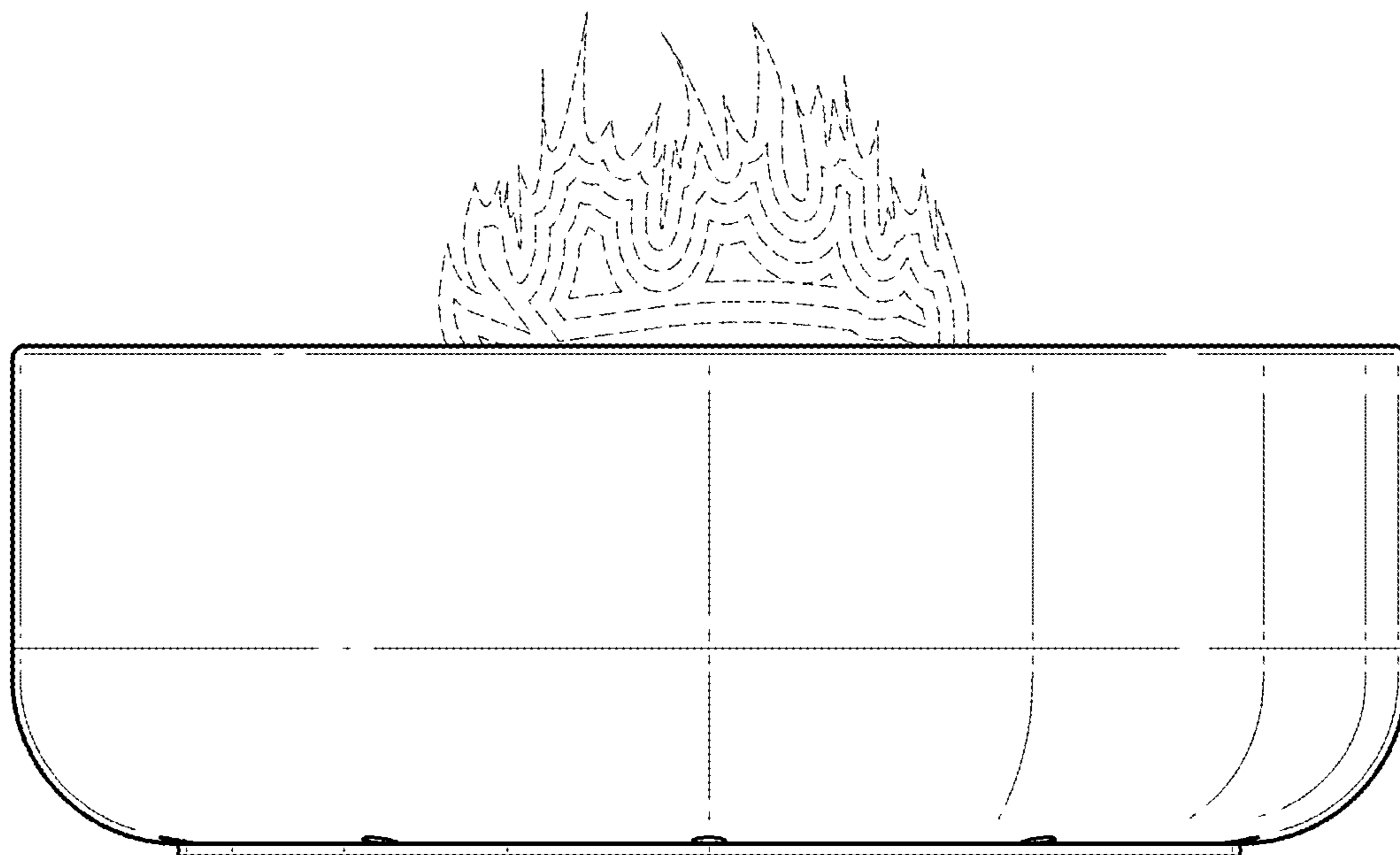

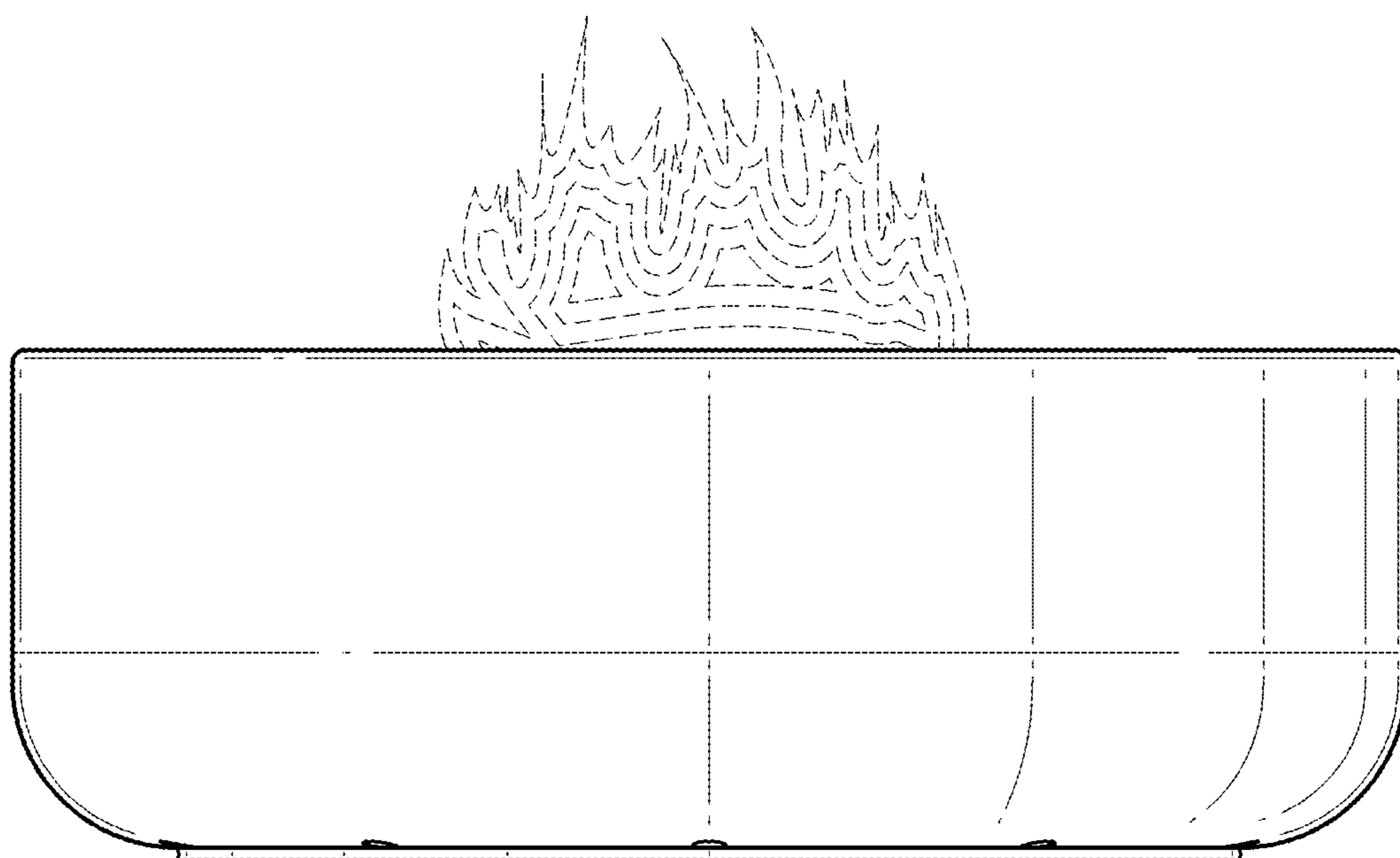

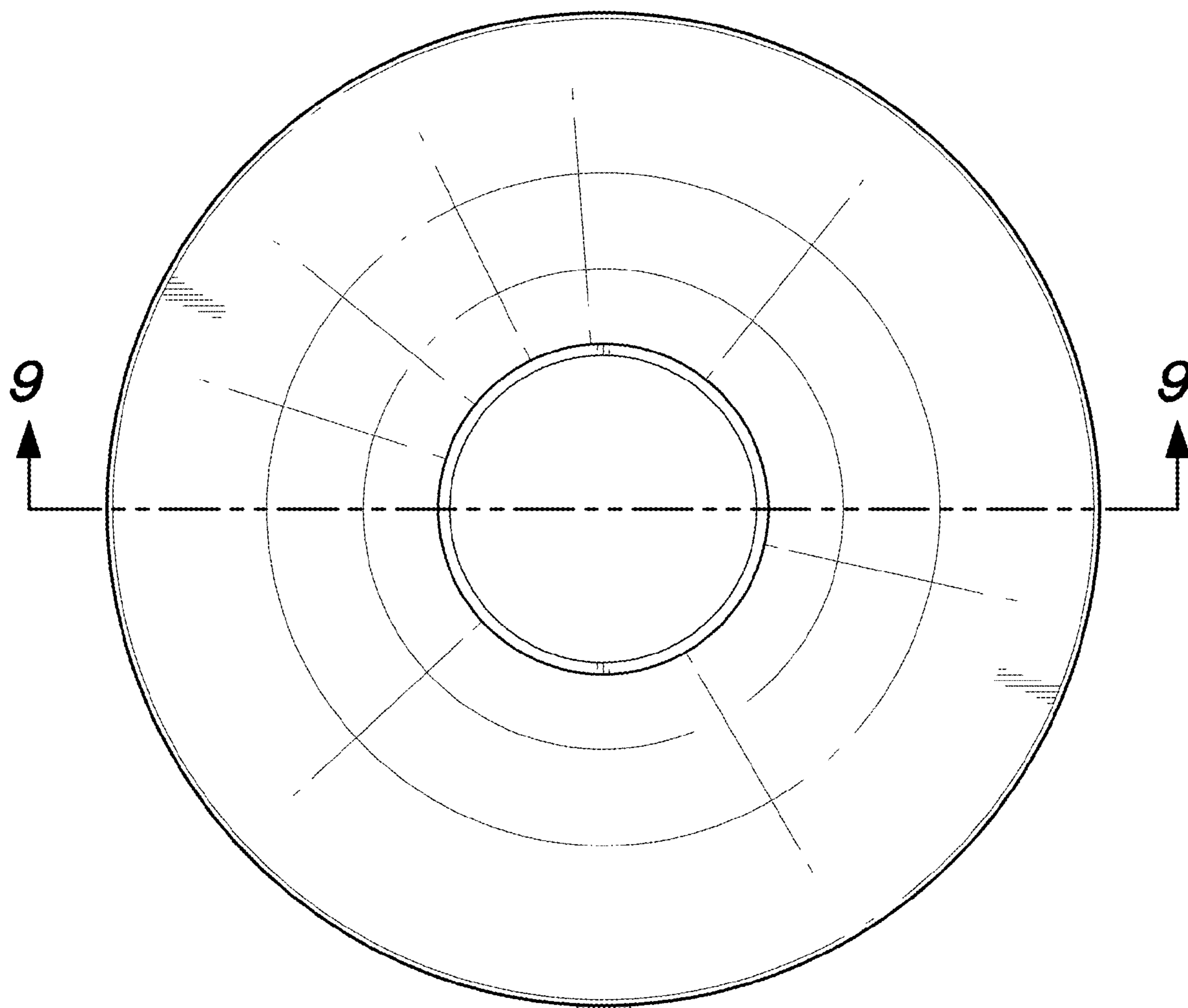

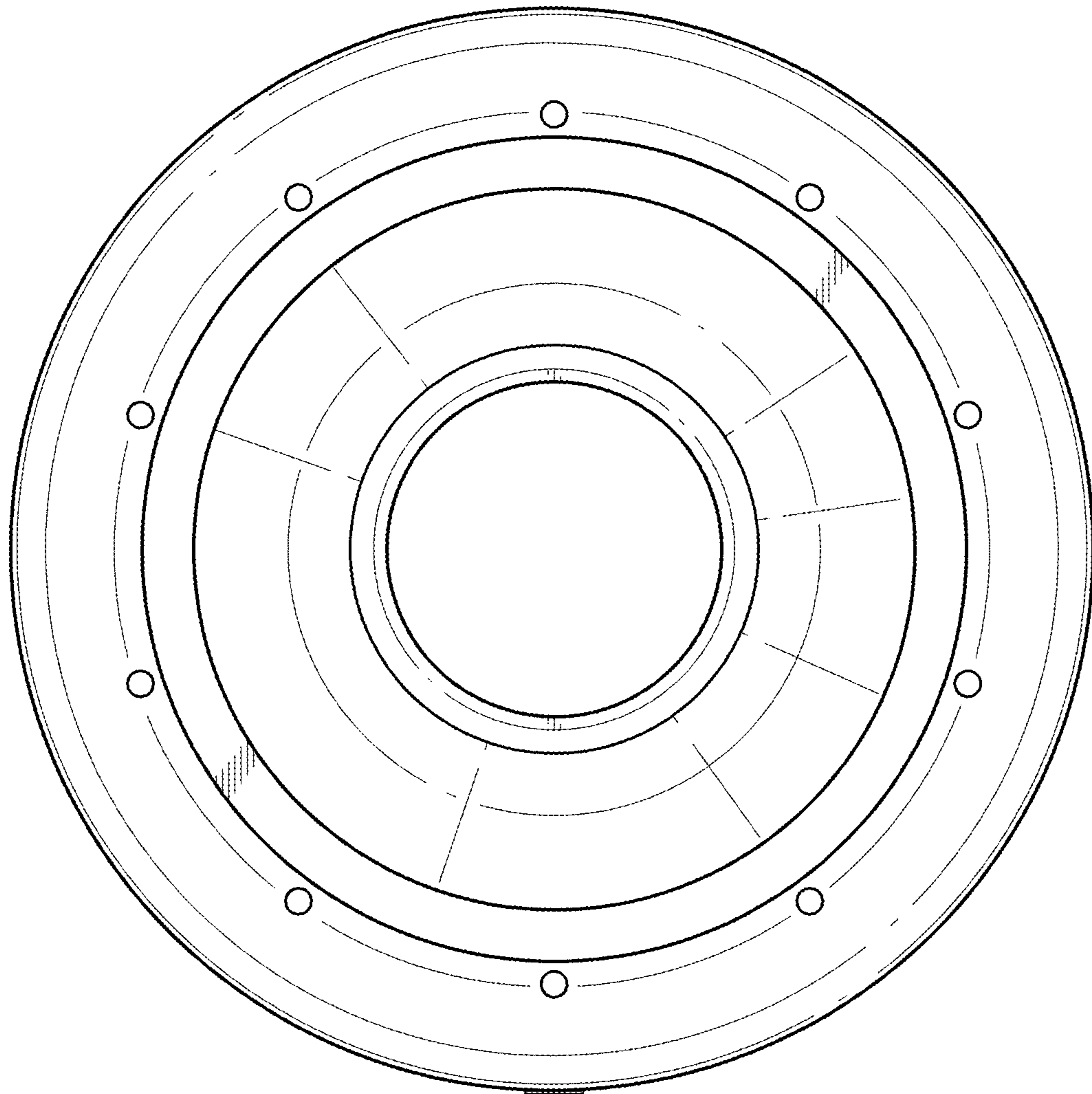

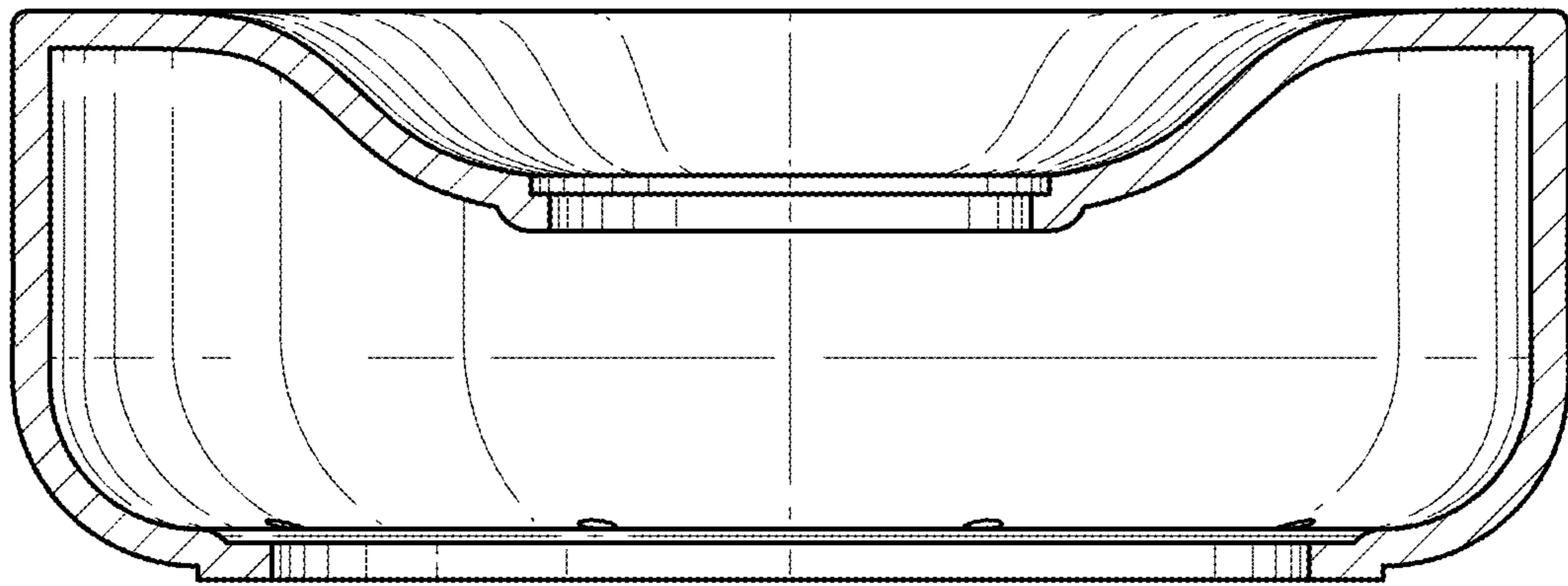
