The ornamental design for an instrument holding device for surgery, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a section of an instrument holding device for surgery according to the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a front view of a section of the instrument holding device for surgery of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear view of a section of the instrument holding device for surgery of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a left side view of a section of the instrument holding device for surgery of FIG. 1.

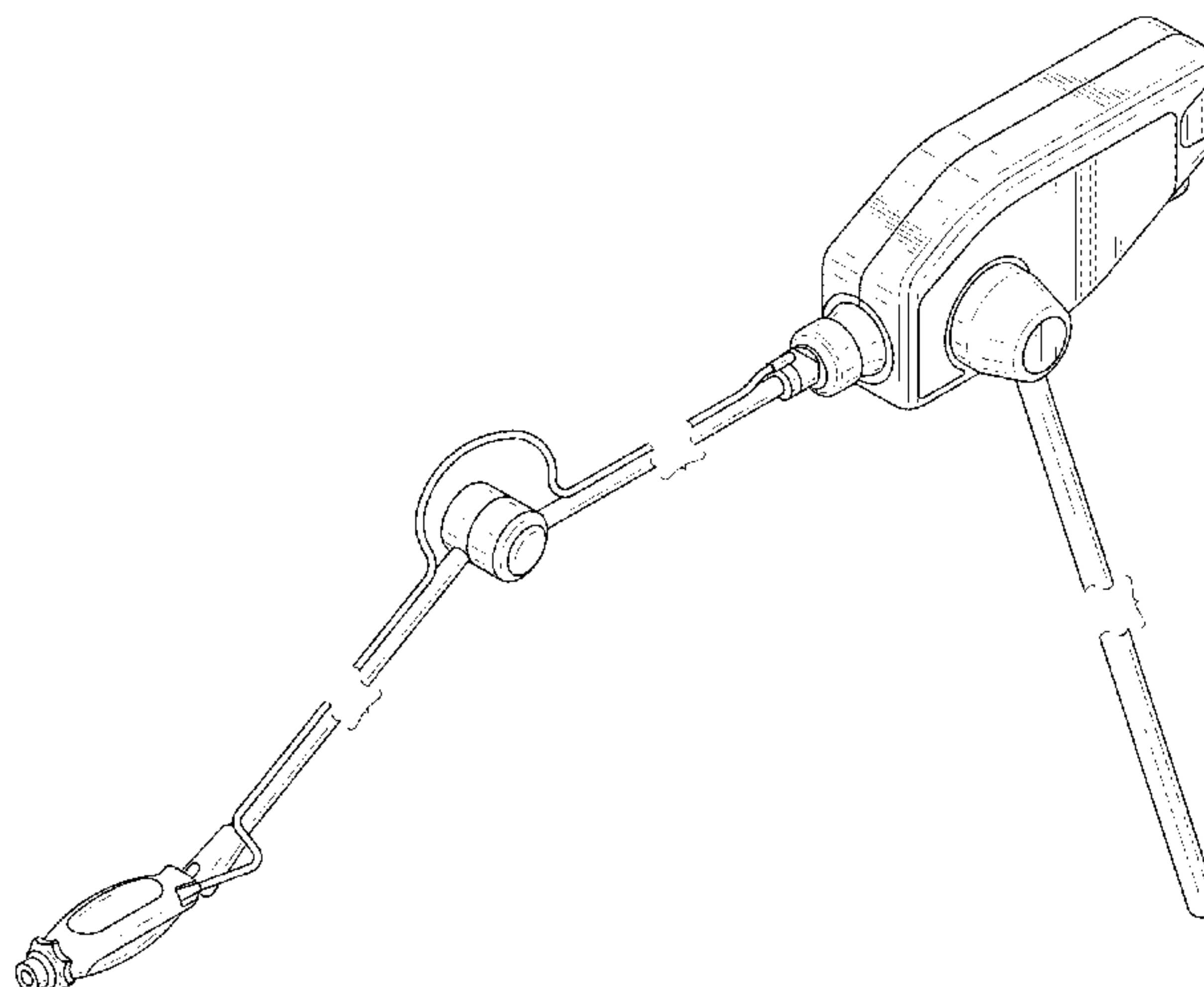
FIG. 5 is a right side view of a section of the instrument holding device for surgery of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a top view of a section of the instrument holding device for surgery of FIG. 1; and,

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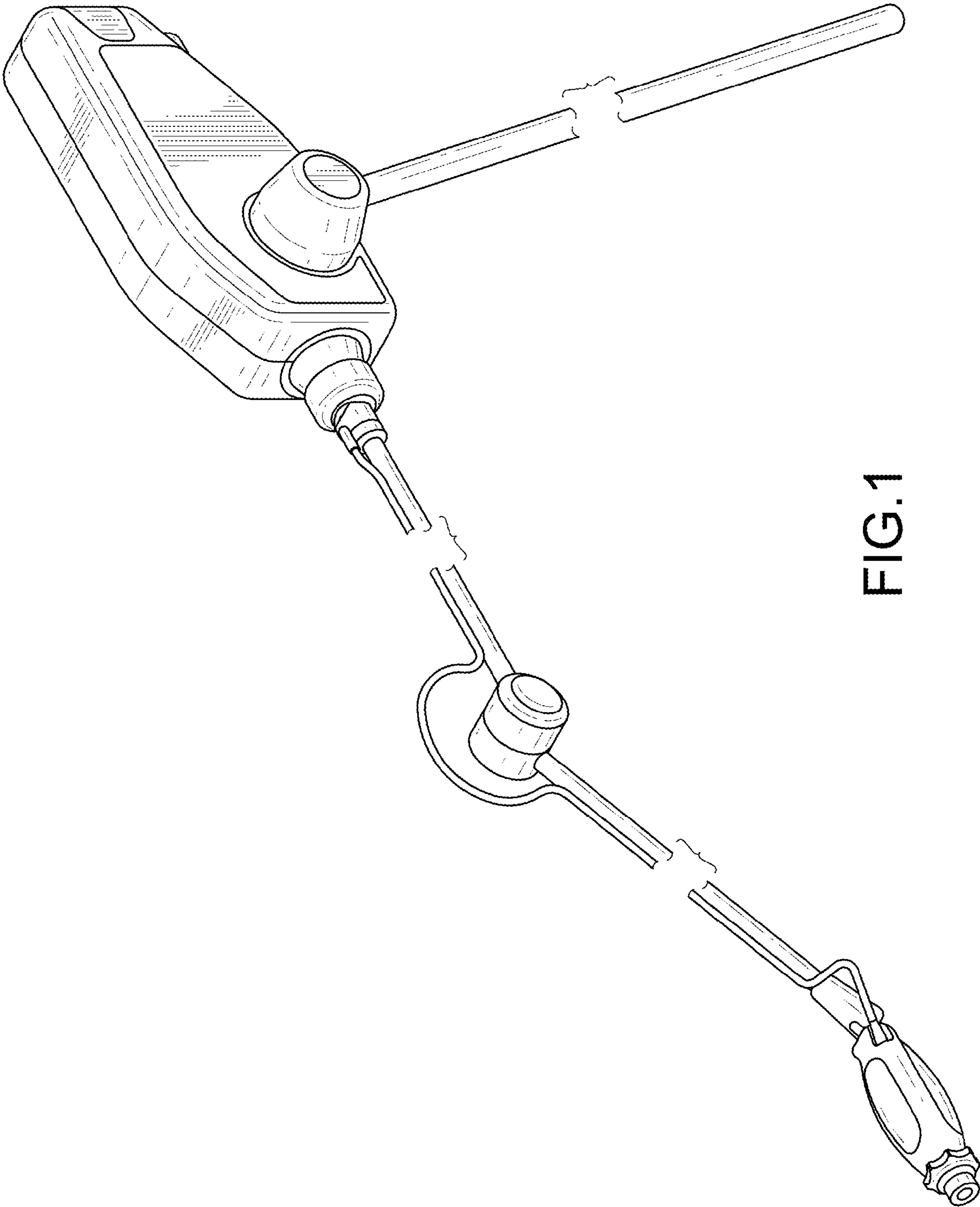

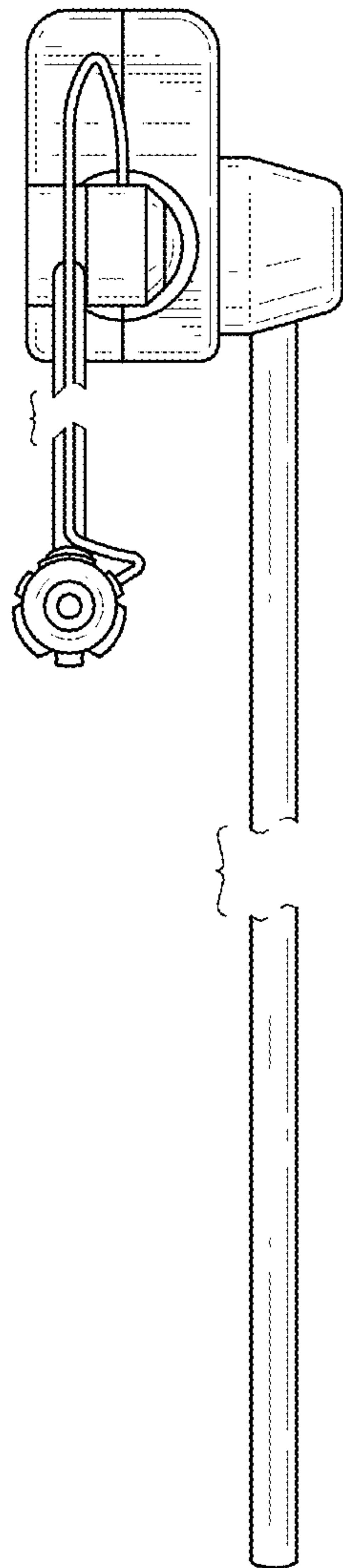

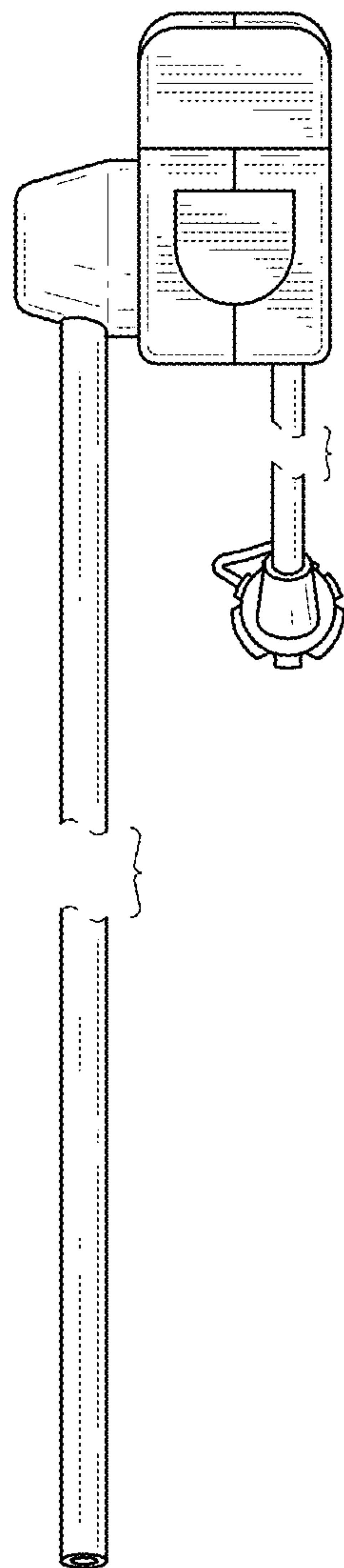

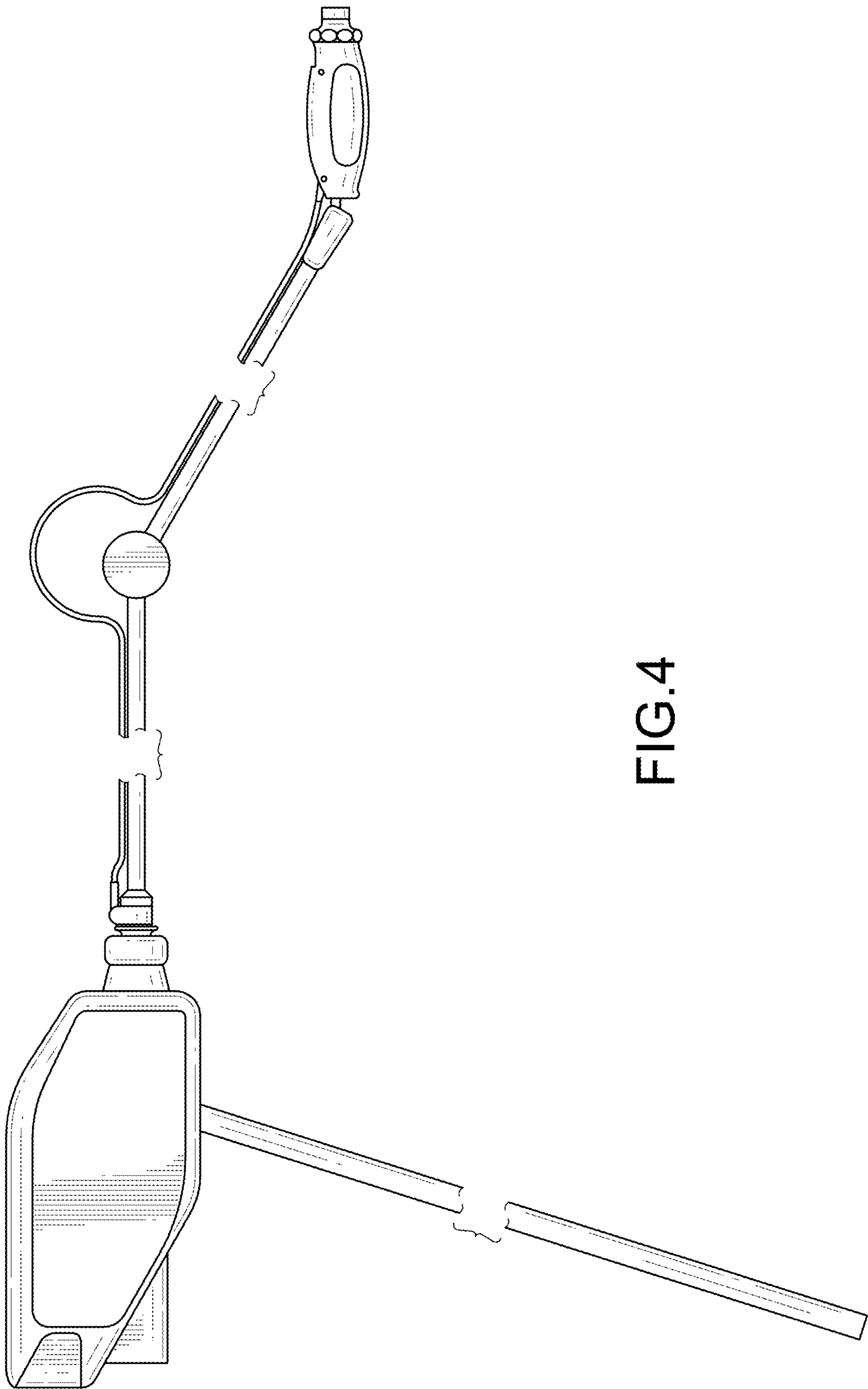

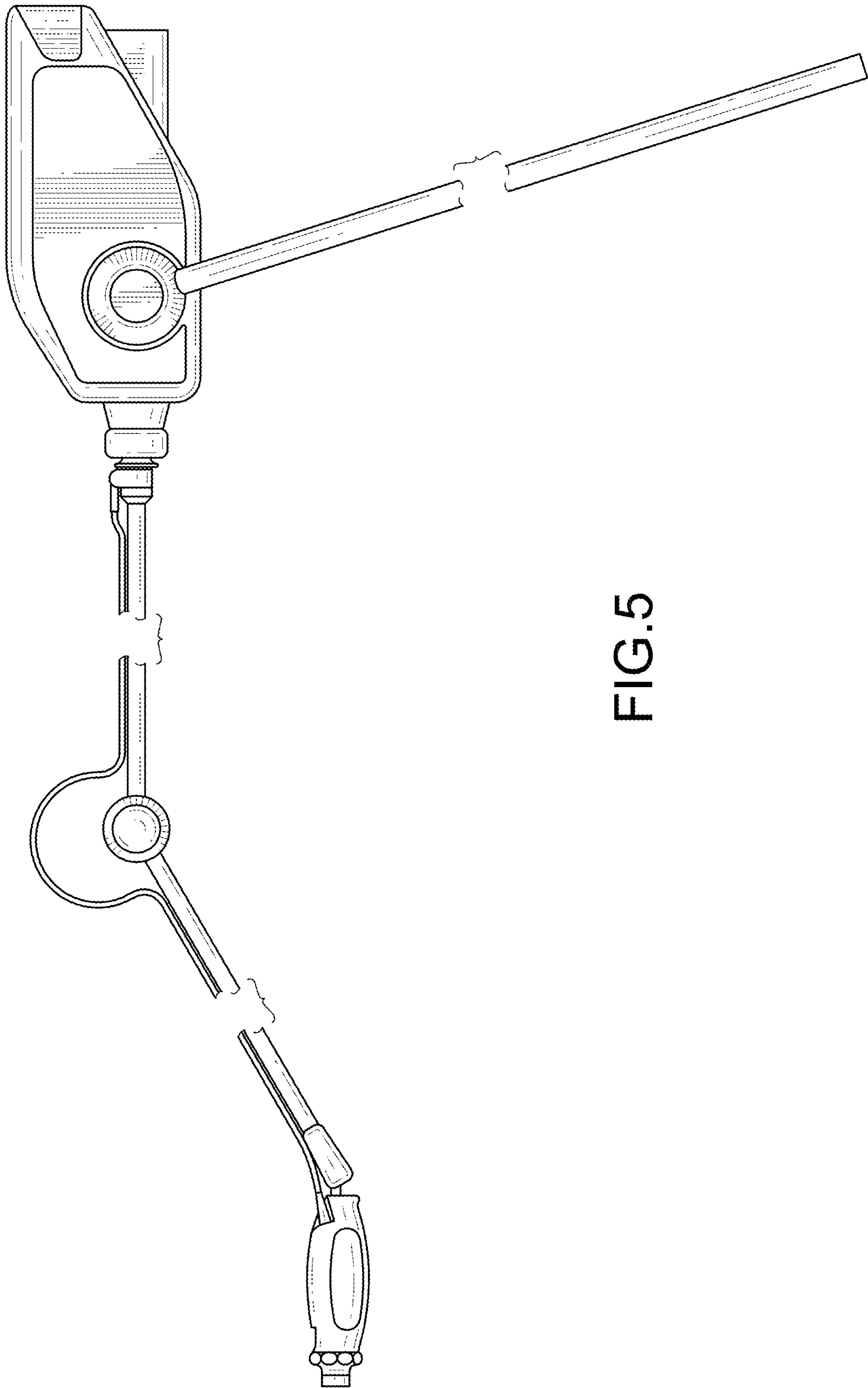

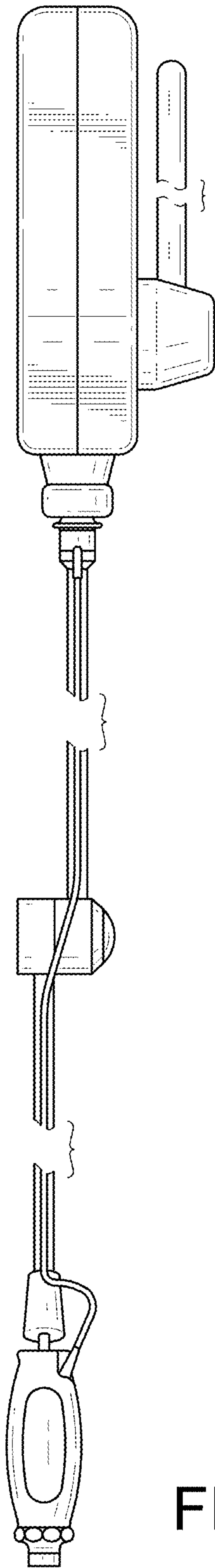

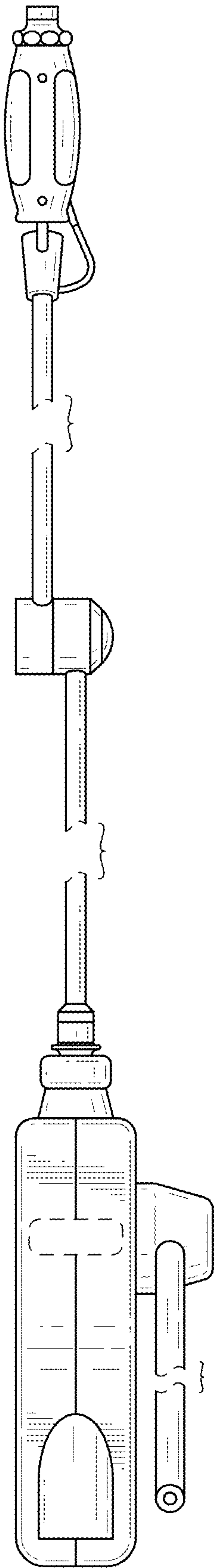
