FIG. 7 is a front view of the display screen with transitional graphical user interface, showing our new design and illustrating a seventh image of the transitional icon.

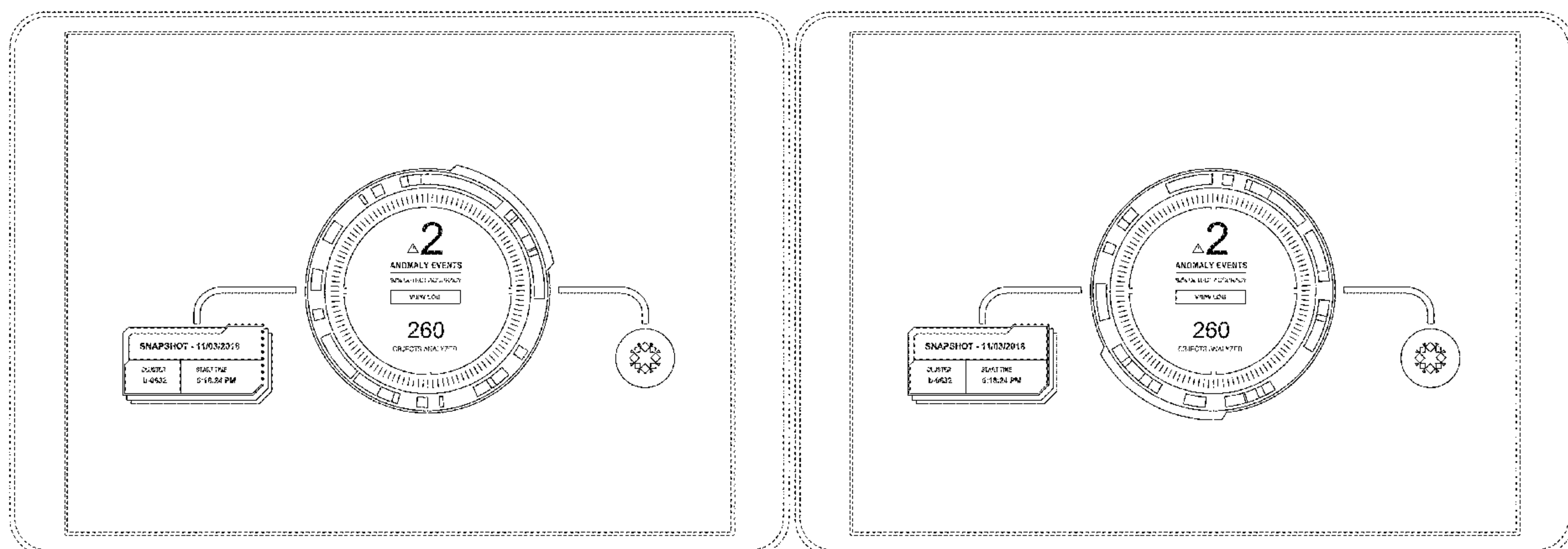
FIG. 8 is a front view of the display screen with transitional graphical user interface, showing our new design and illustrating an eighth image of the transitional icon; and,

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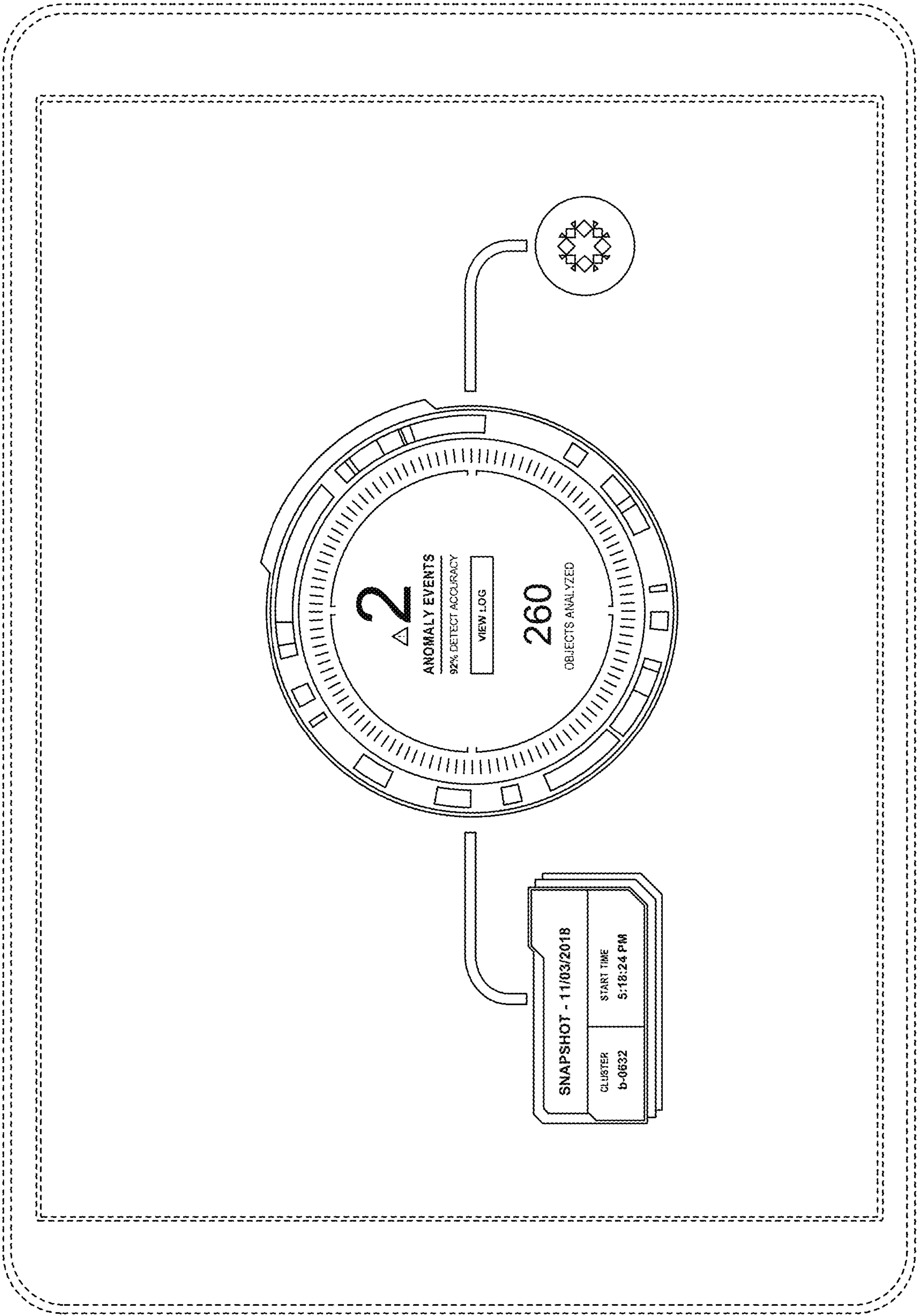

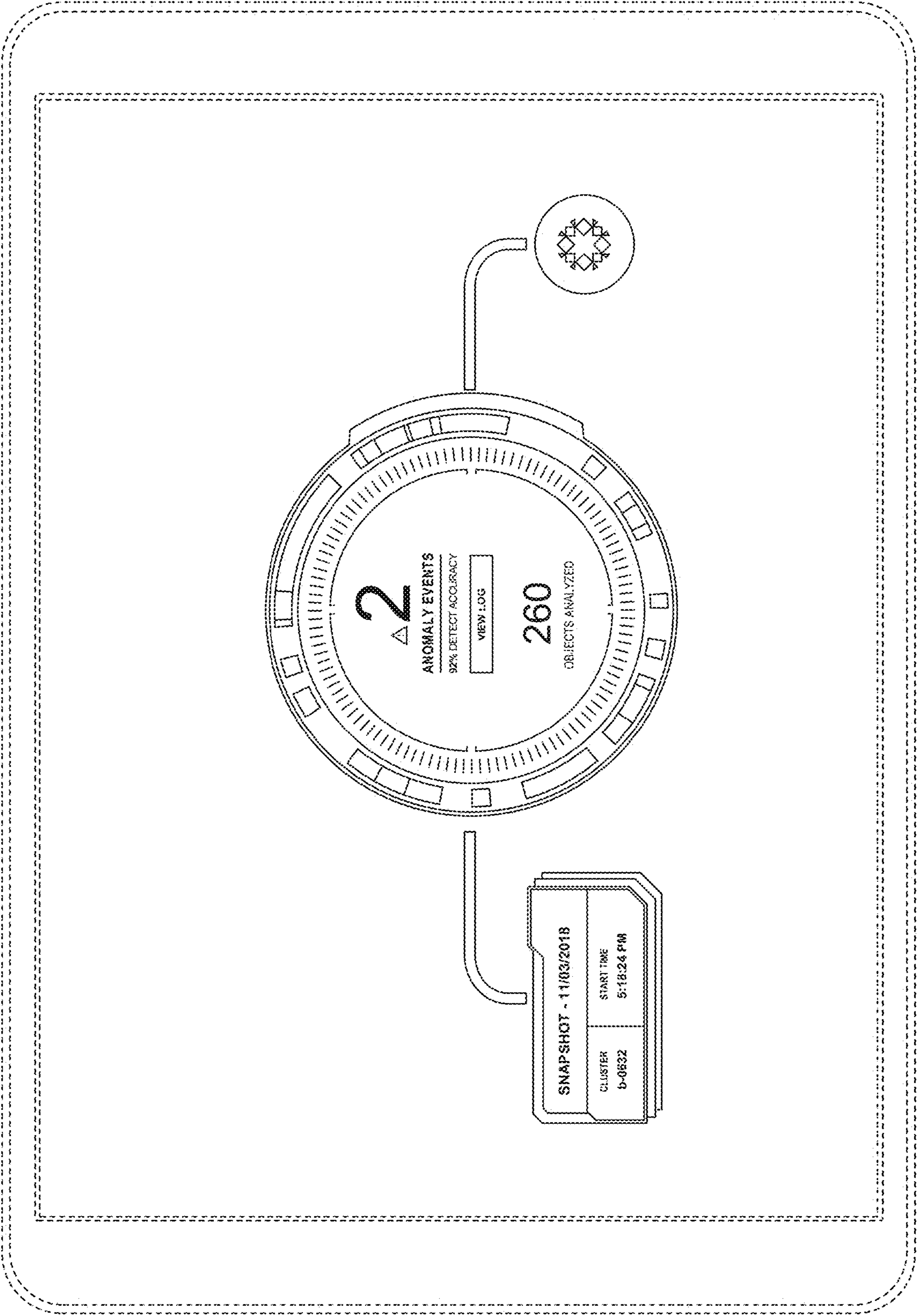

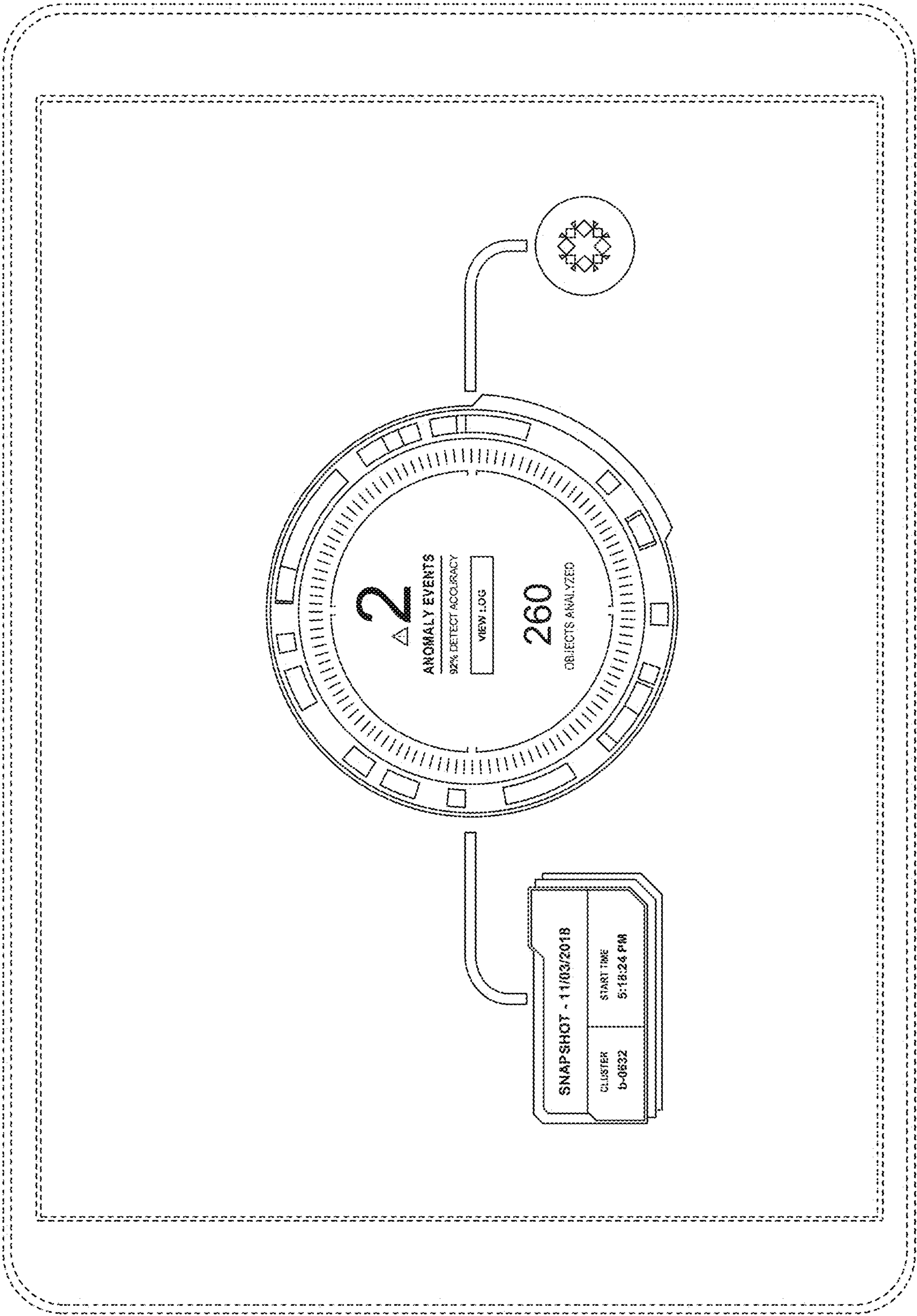

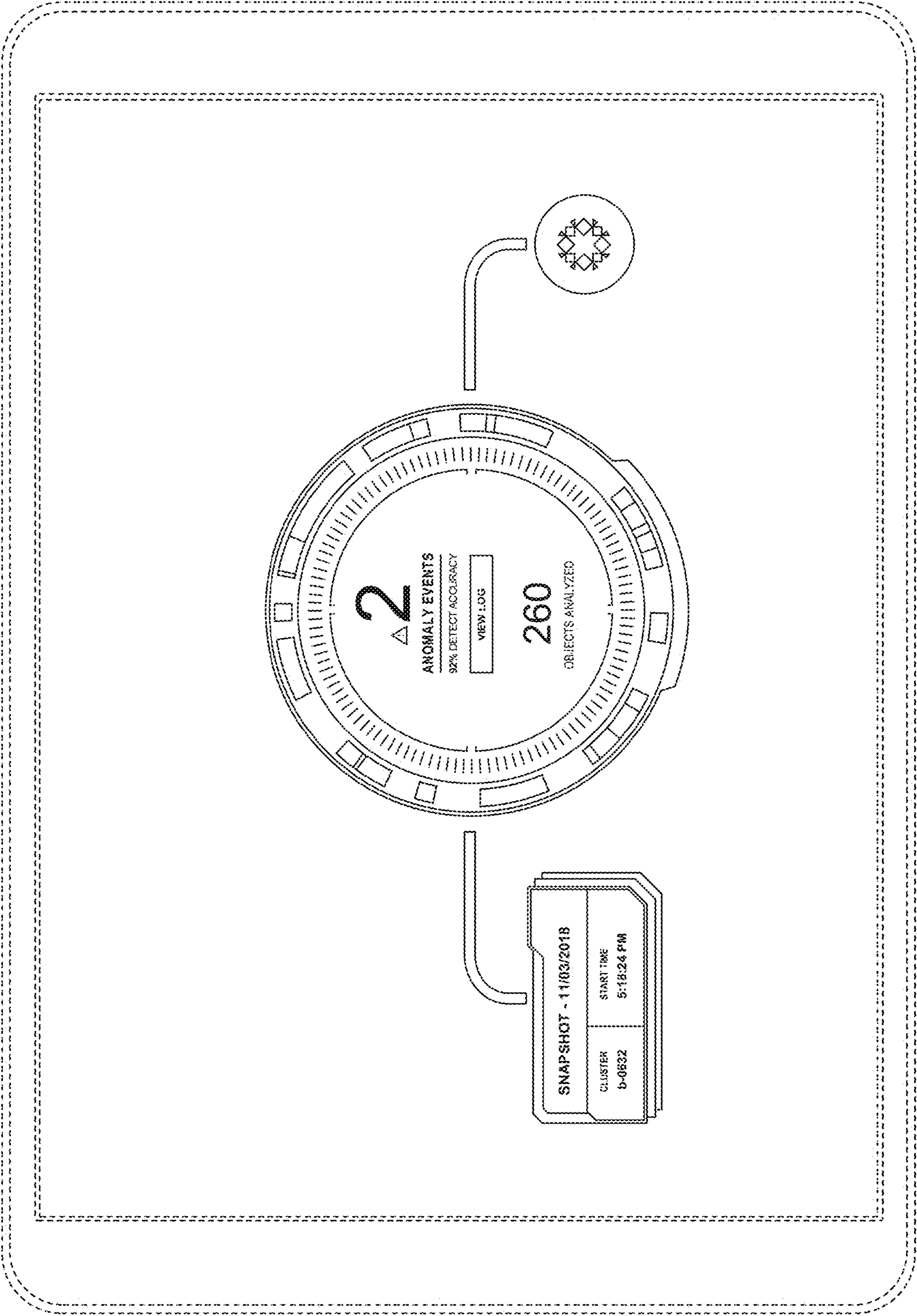

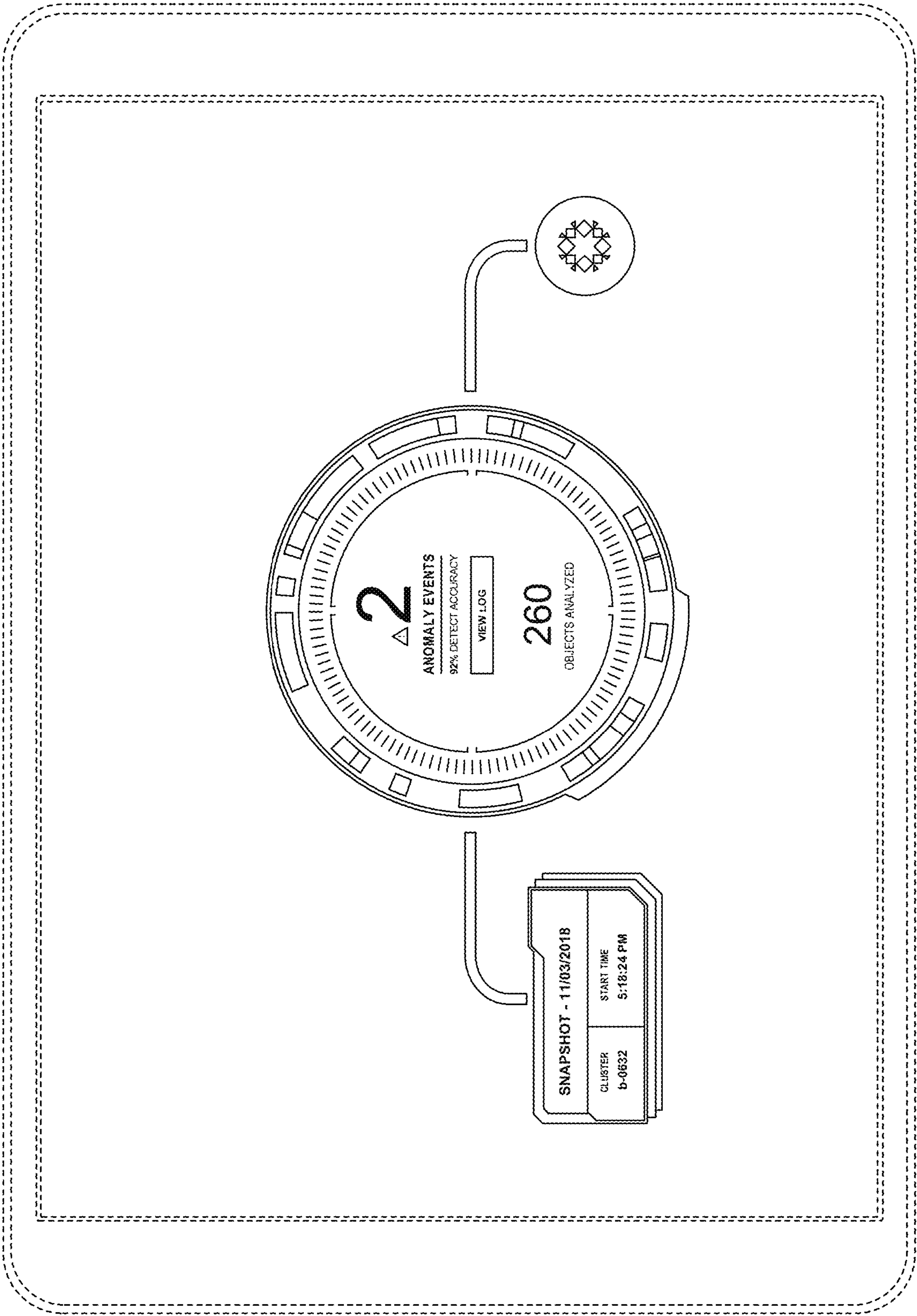

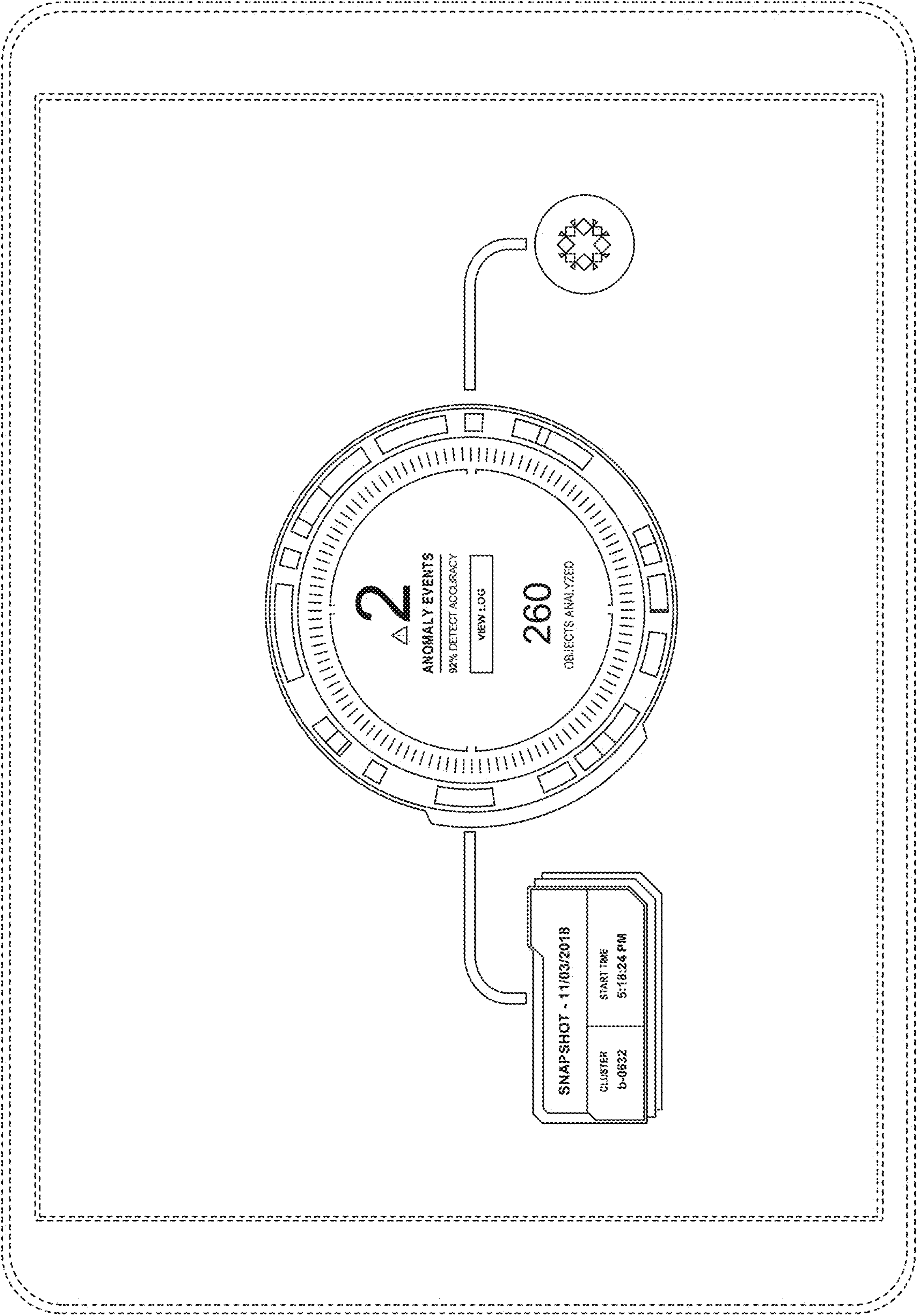

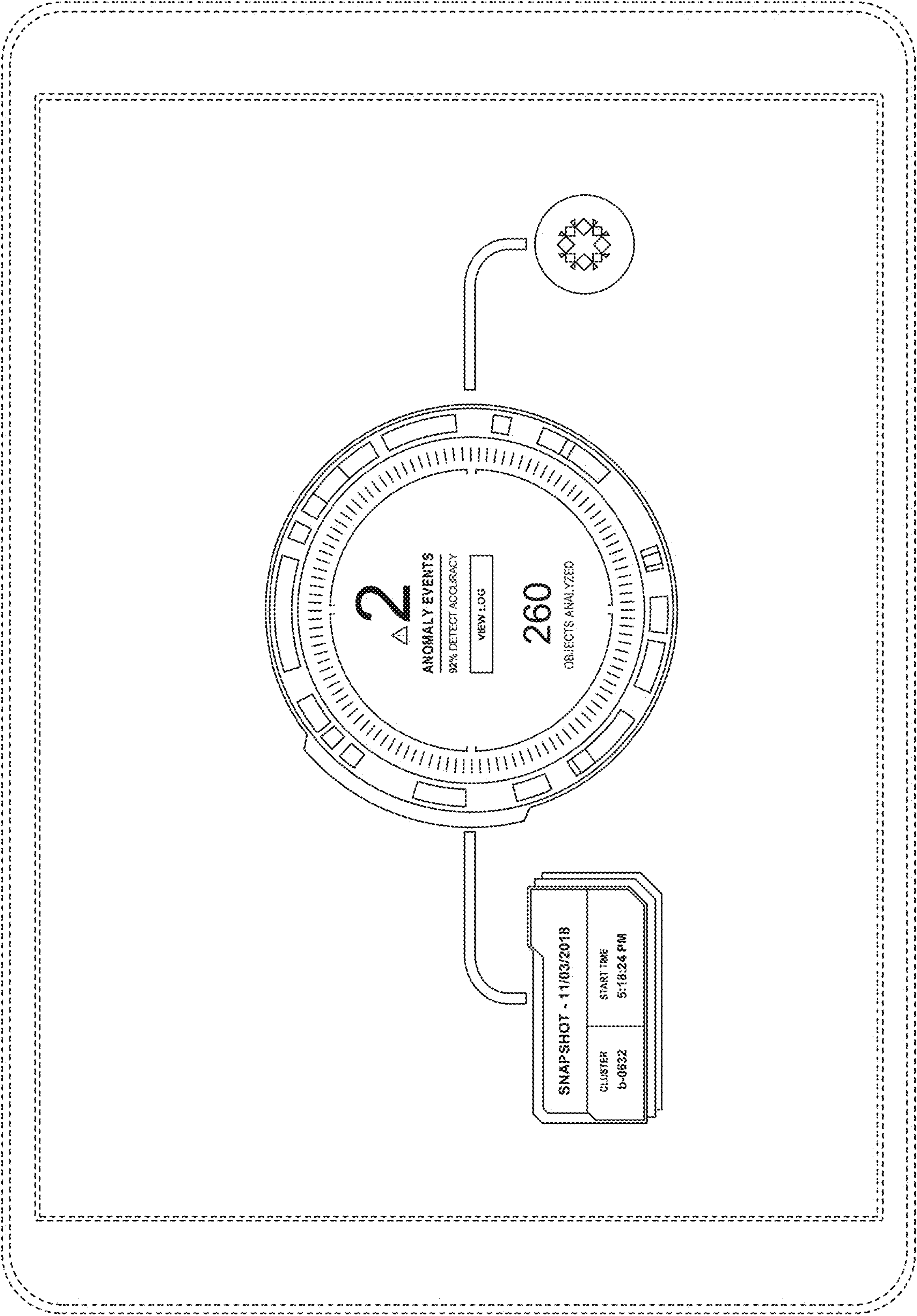

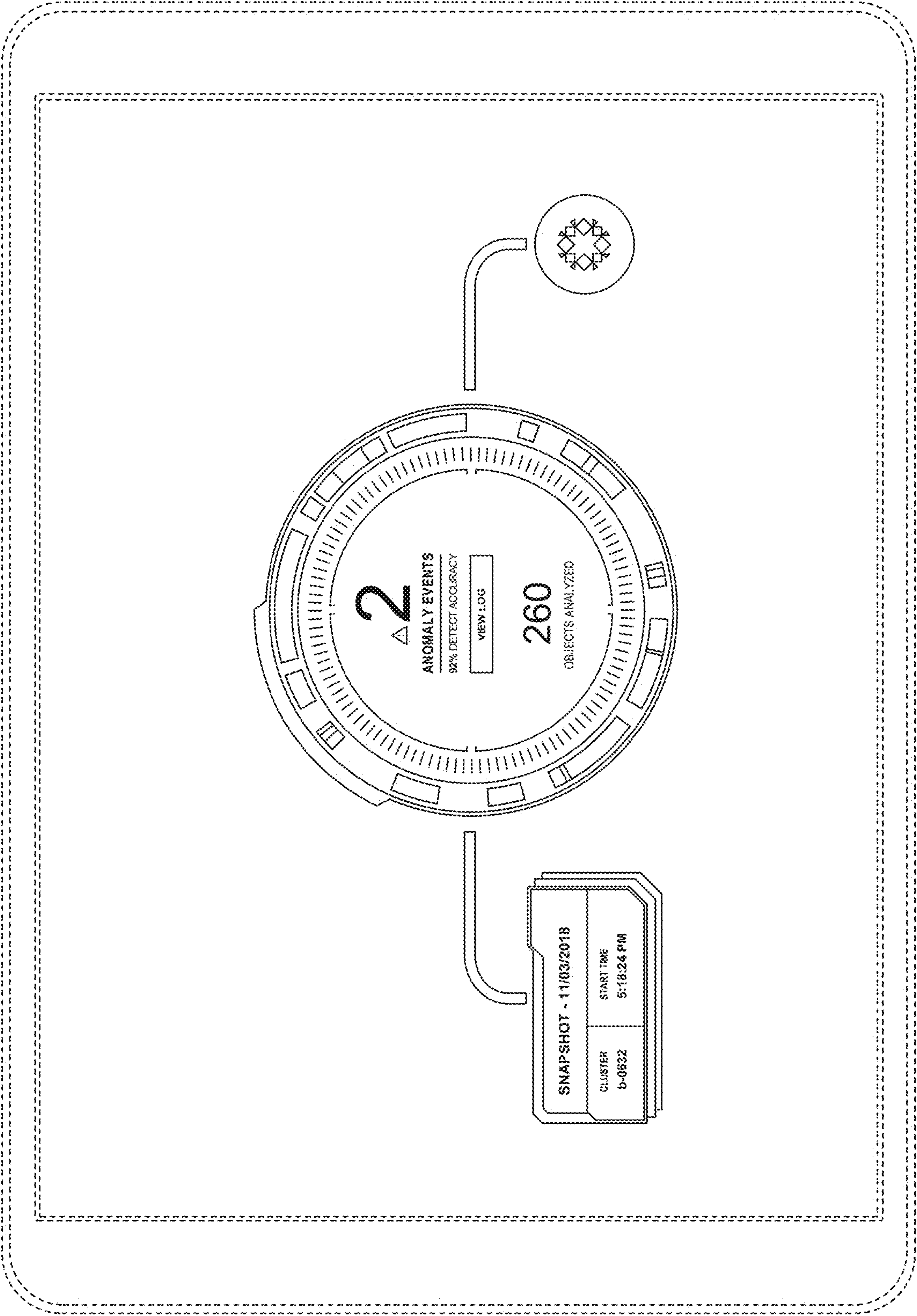

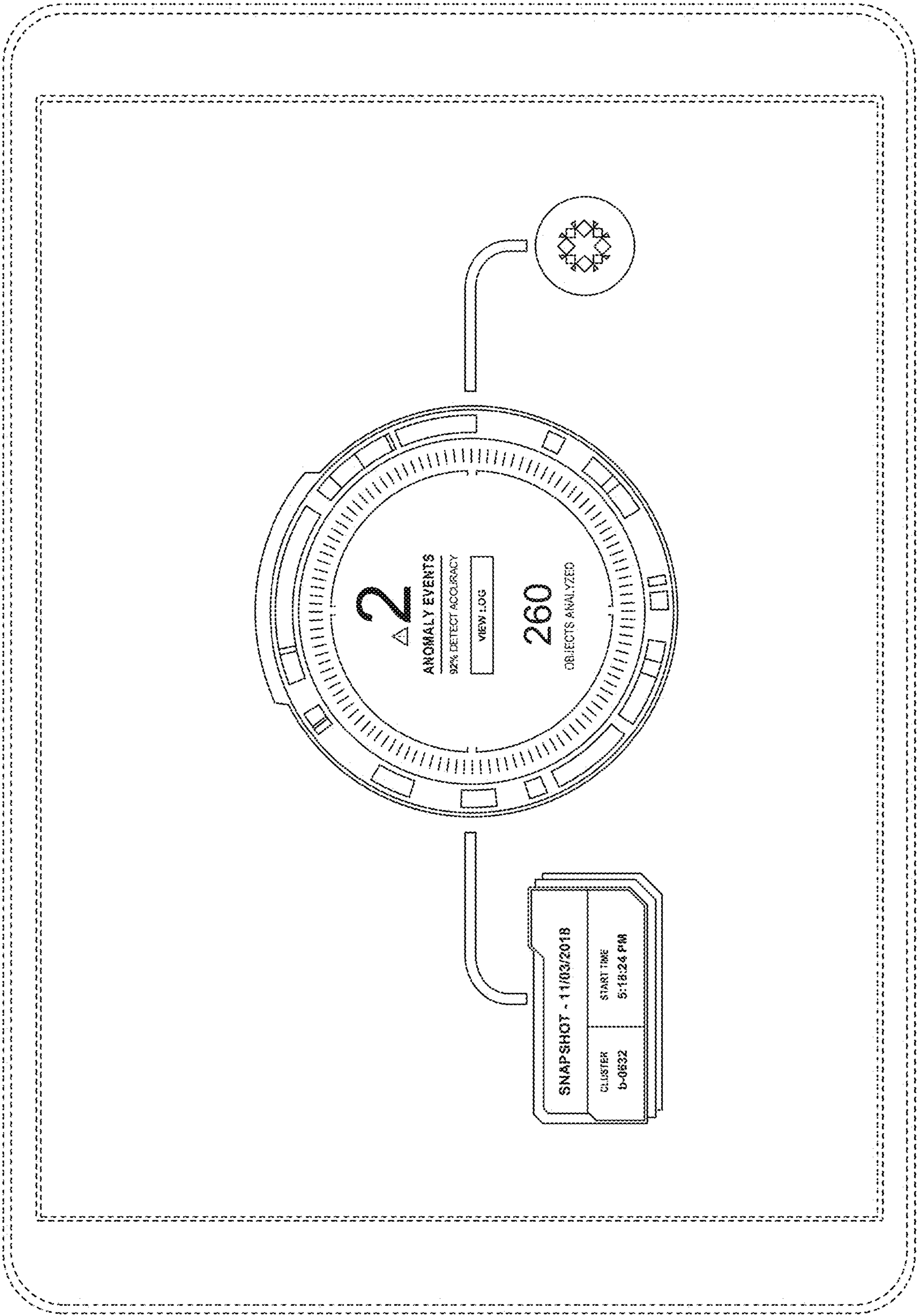
