DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a fender extension, showing an embodiment of our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 7 is an isometric view of a fender extension, showing another embodiment of our new design, which is a mirror image of the fender extension shown in FIGS. 1-6.

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view thereof.

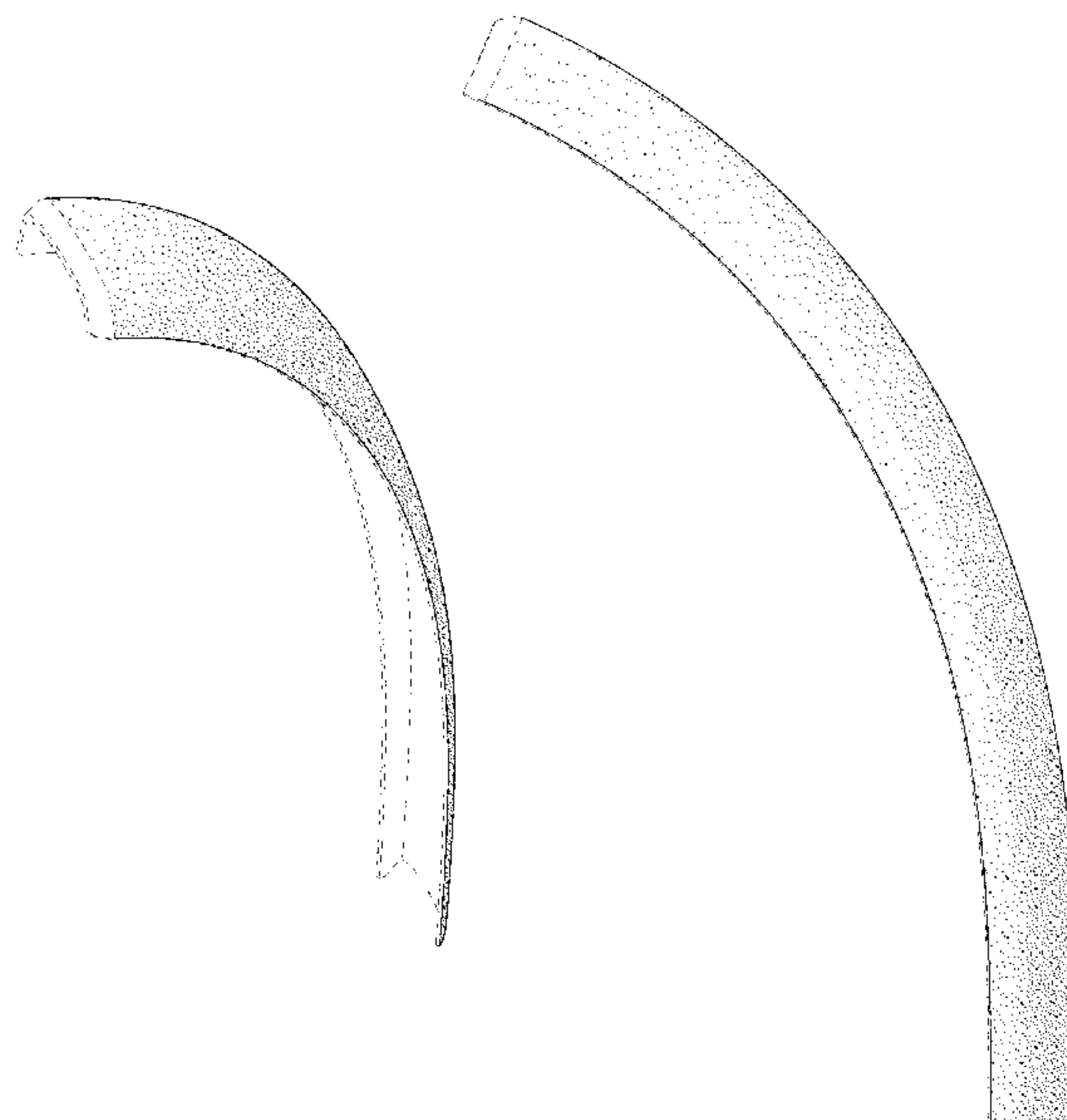
FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof.

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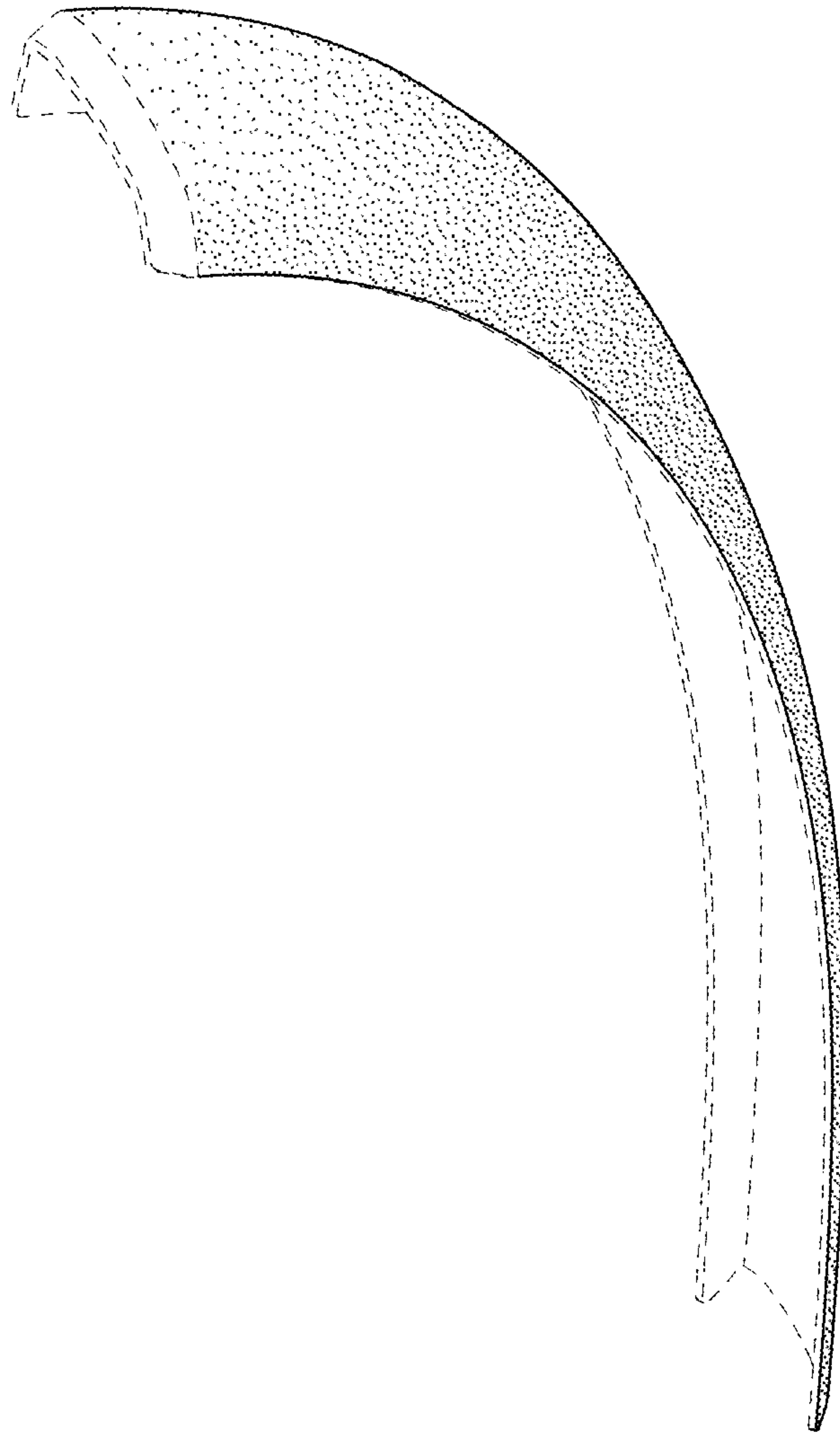

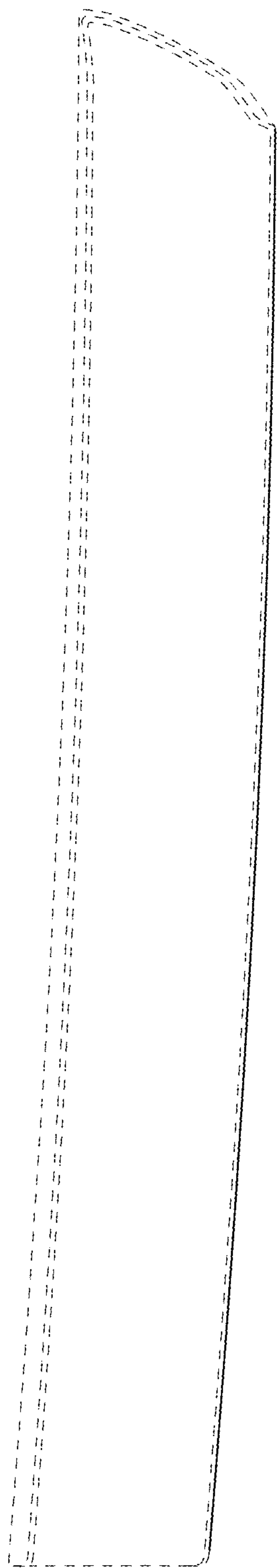

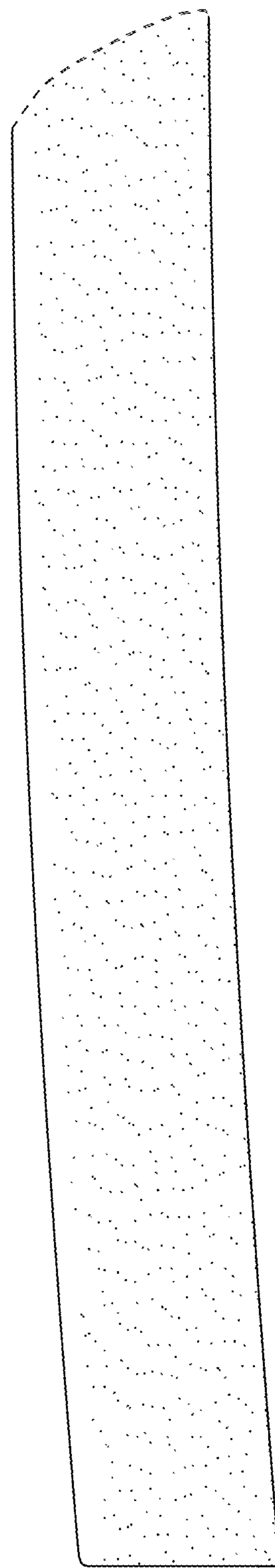

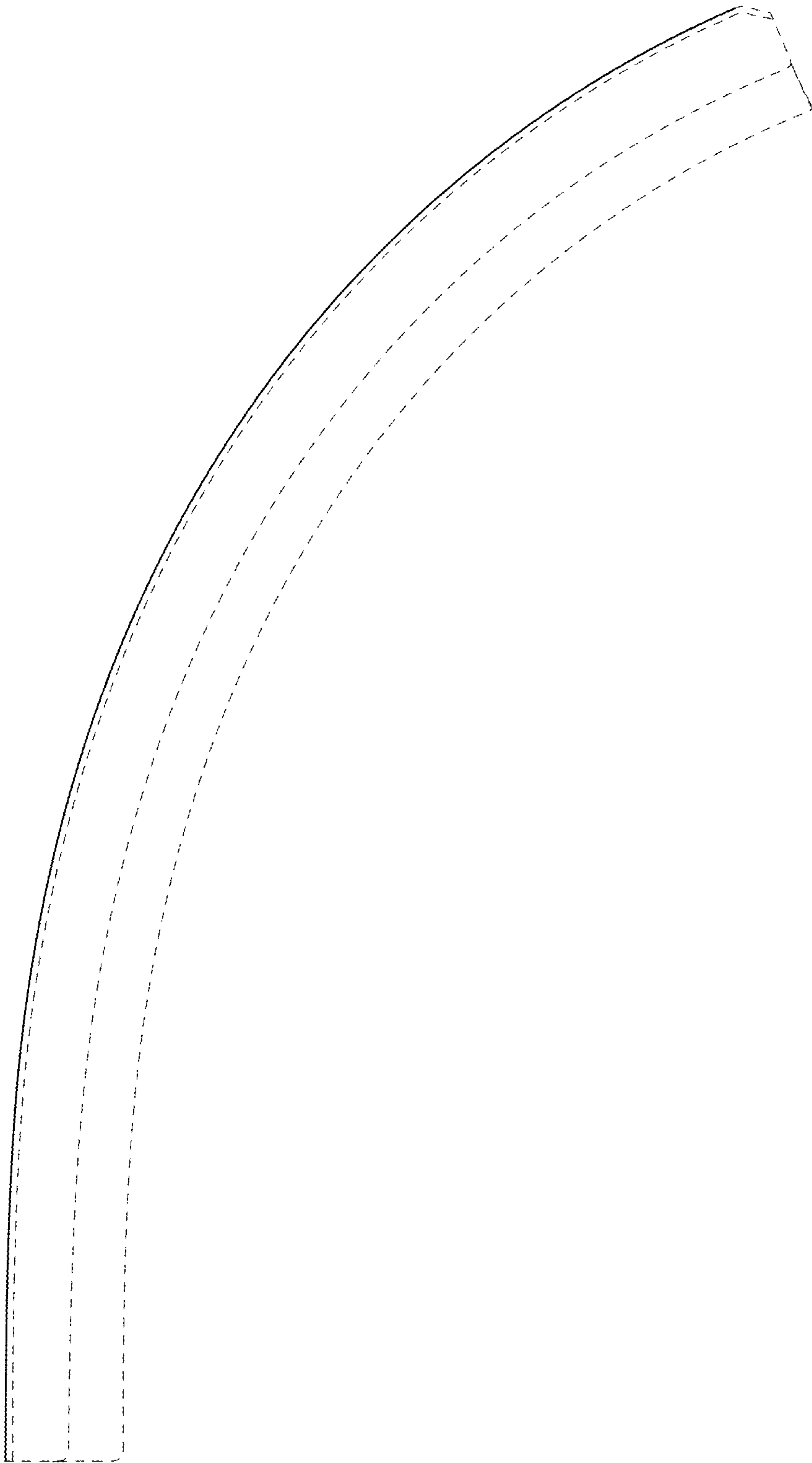

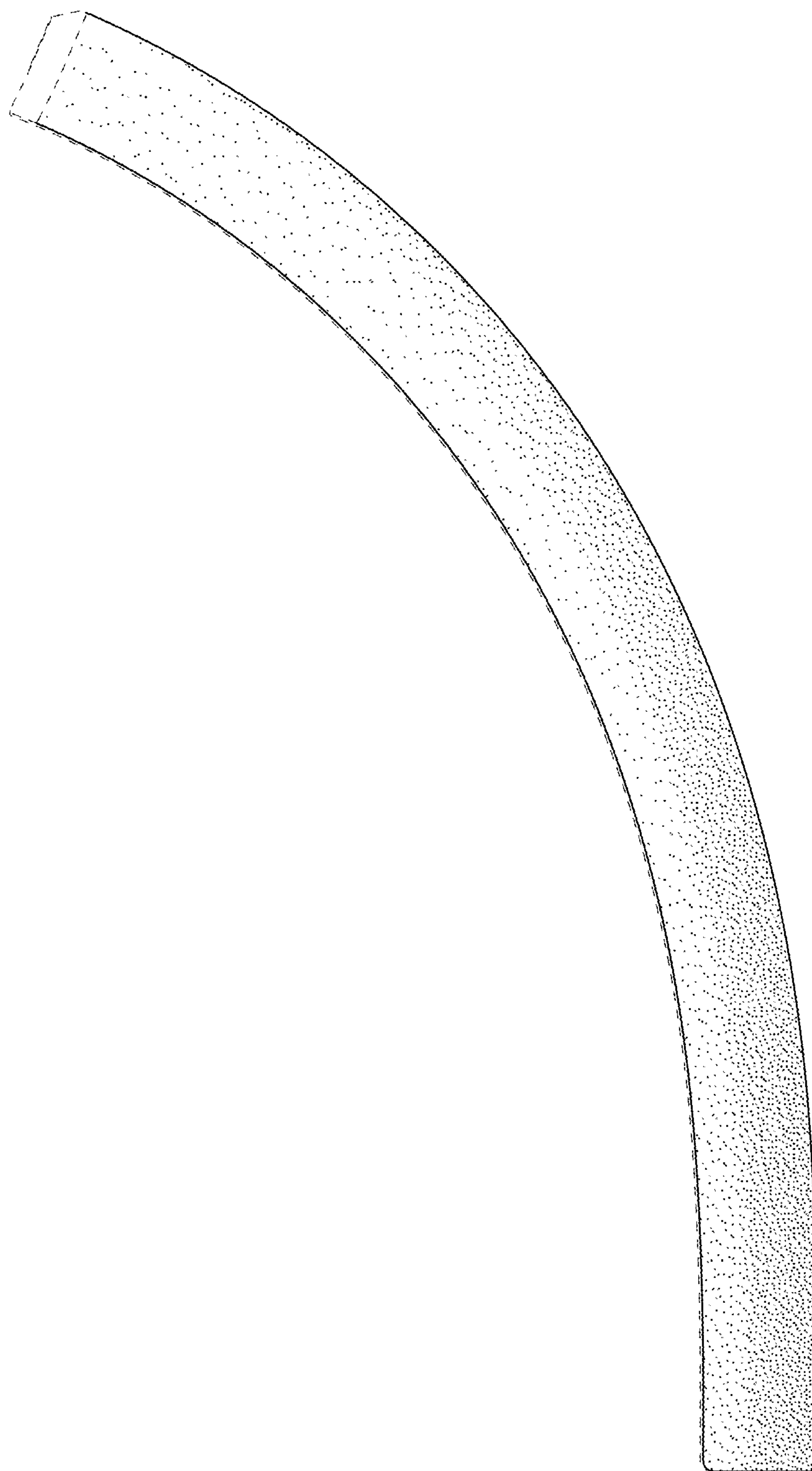

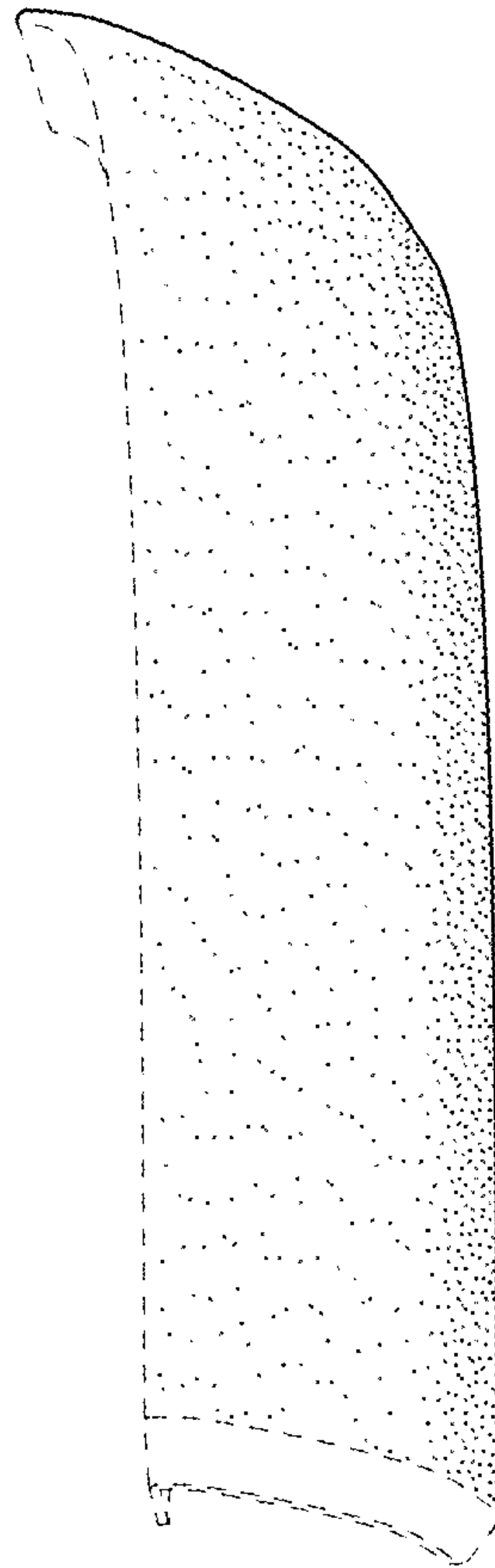

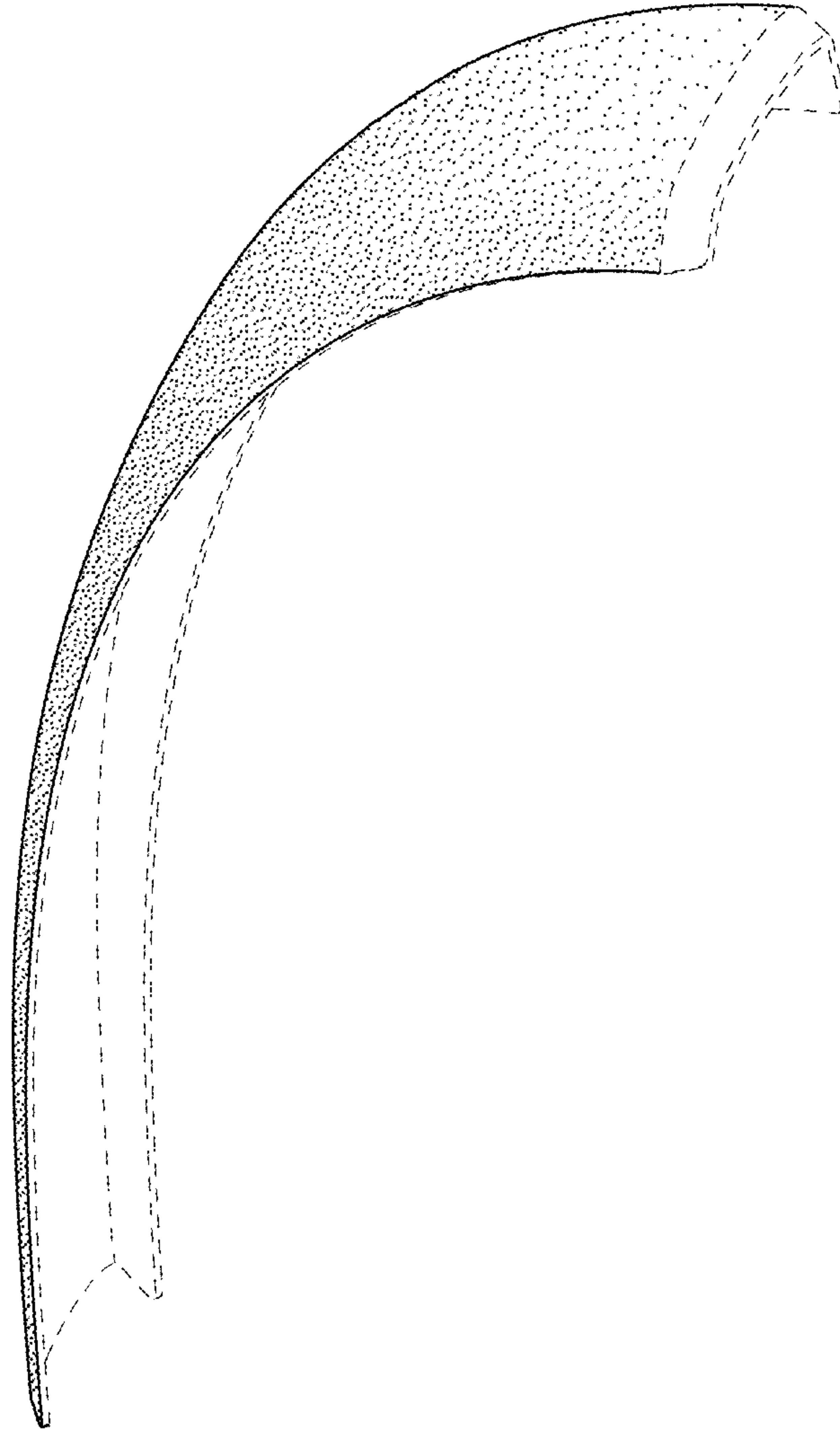

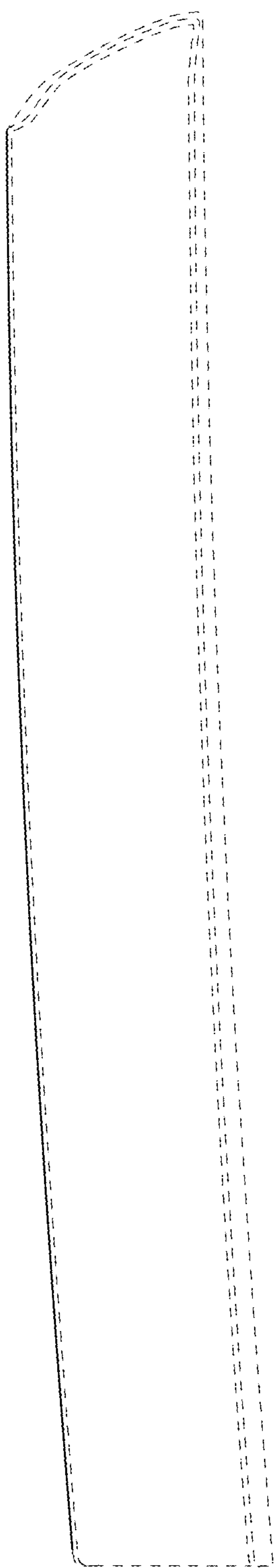

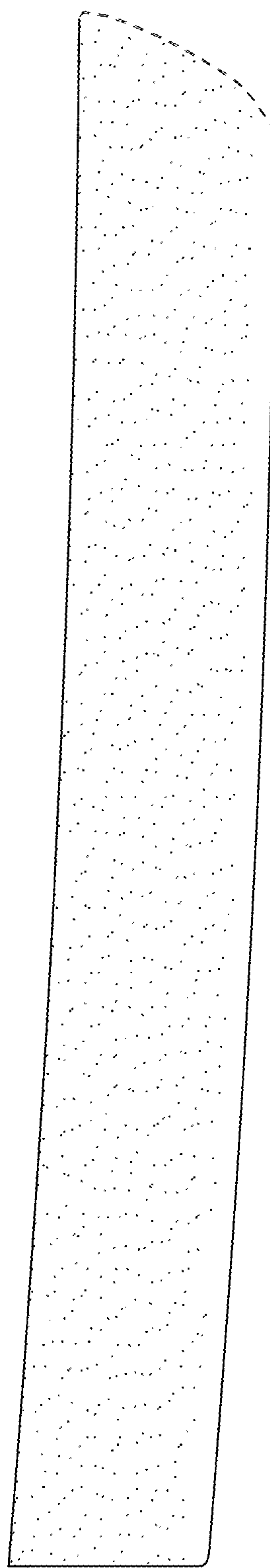

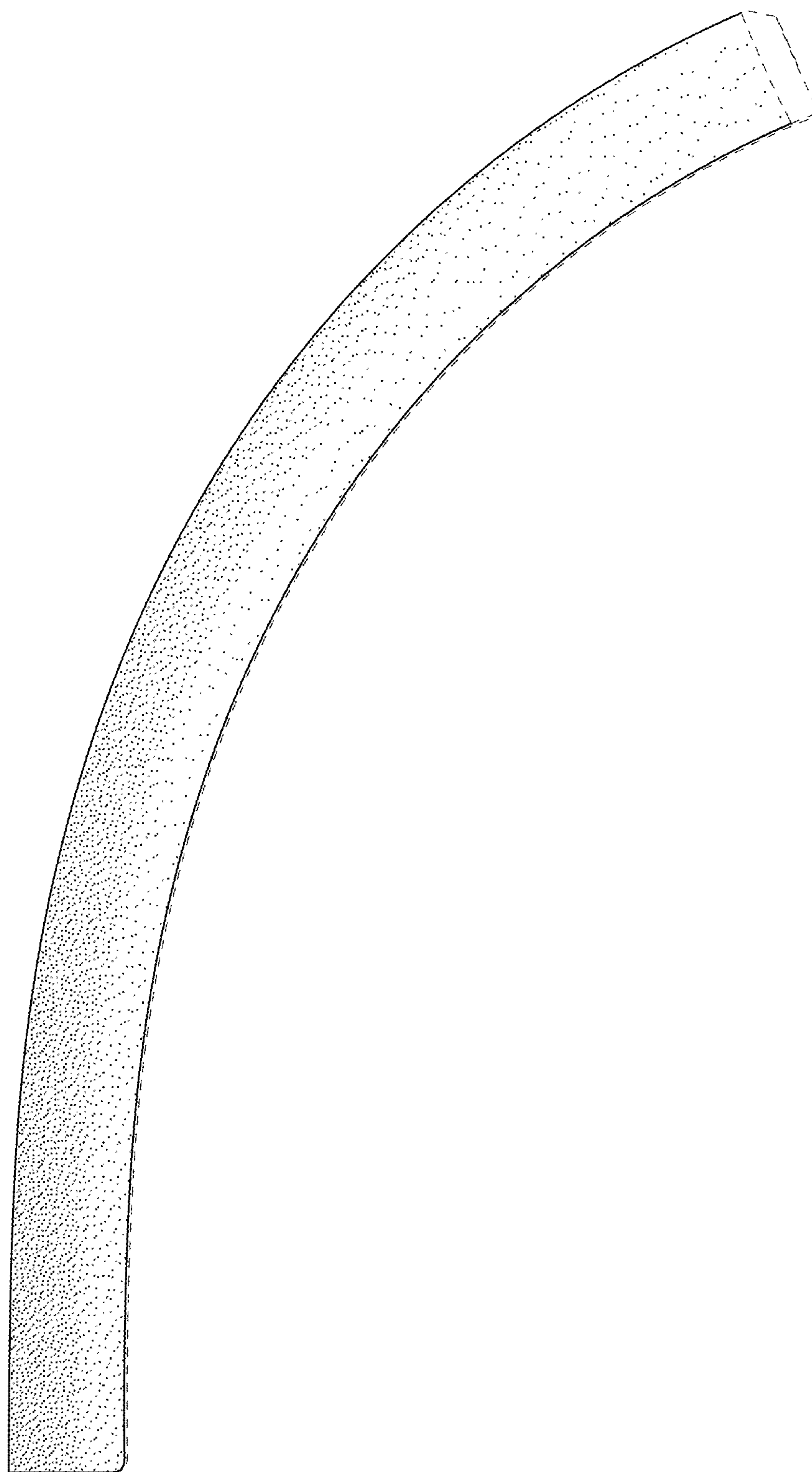

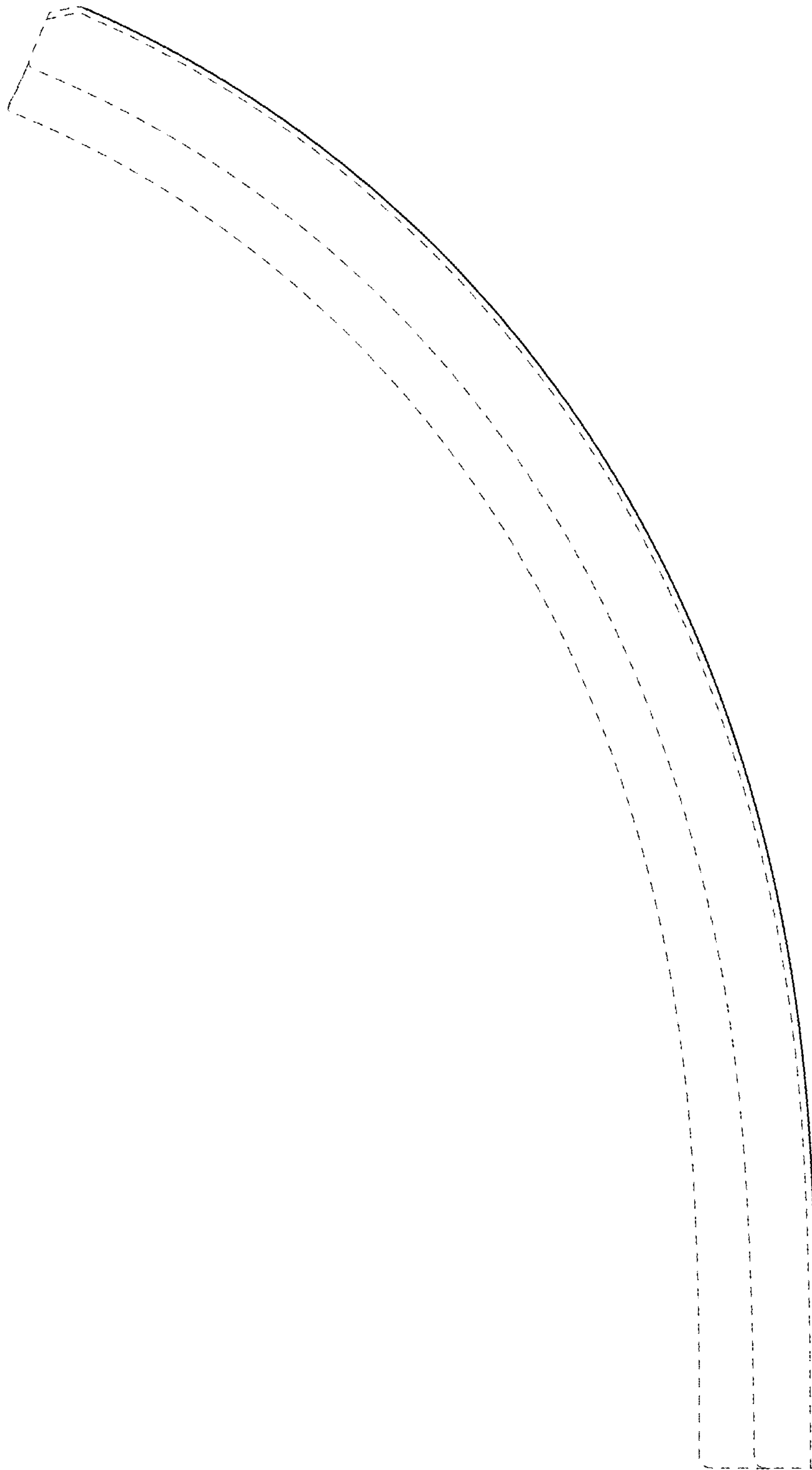

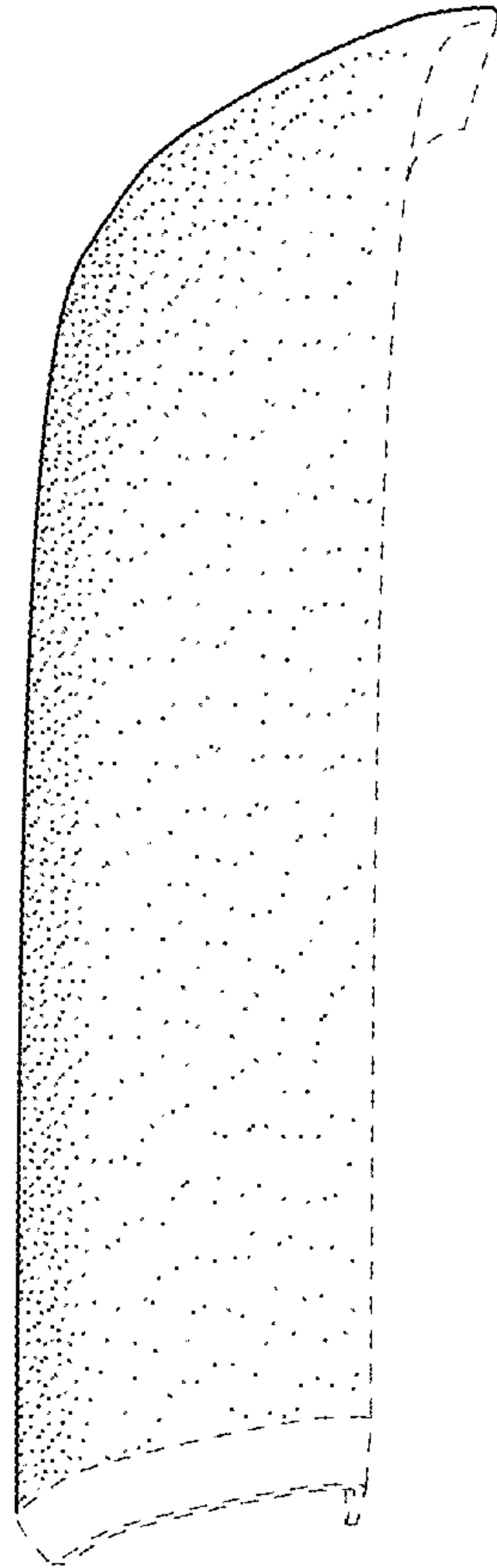
