(57) CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for the article, integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities, as herein shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a three dimensional view of the integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities.

FIG. 2 is a right view of the integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities.

FIG. 3 is a left view of the integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities.

FIG. 4 is a top side view of the short-integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities.

FIG. 5 is a bottom side view of the integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities.


FIG. 6 is a front view of the integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities; and,

FIG. 7 is a back view of the integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities.

All broken lines, in all figures, are for the purpose of illustrating portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

The integral firearm accessory having first aid and wound care capabilities is a distinctive insertable device used for securing and carrying emergency first aid treatment in the handle or stock of a firearm.














