FIG. 10 is a sectional view of the accessory holder taken along line 10-10 in FIG. 5; and,

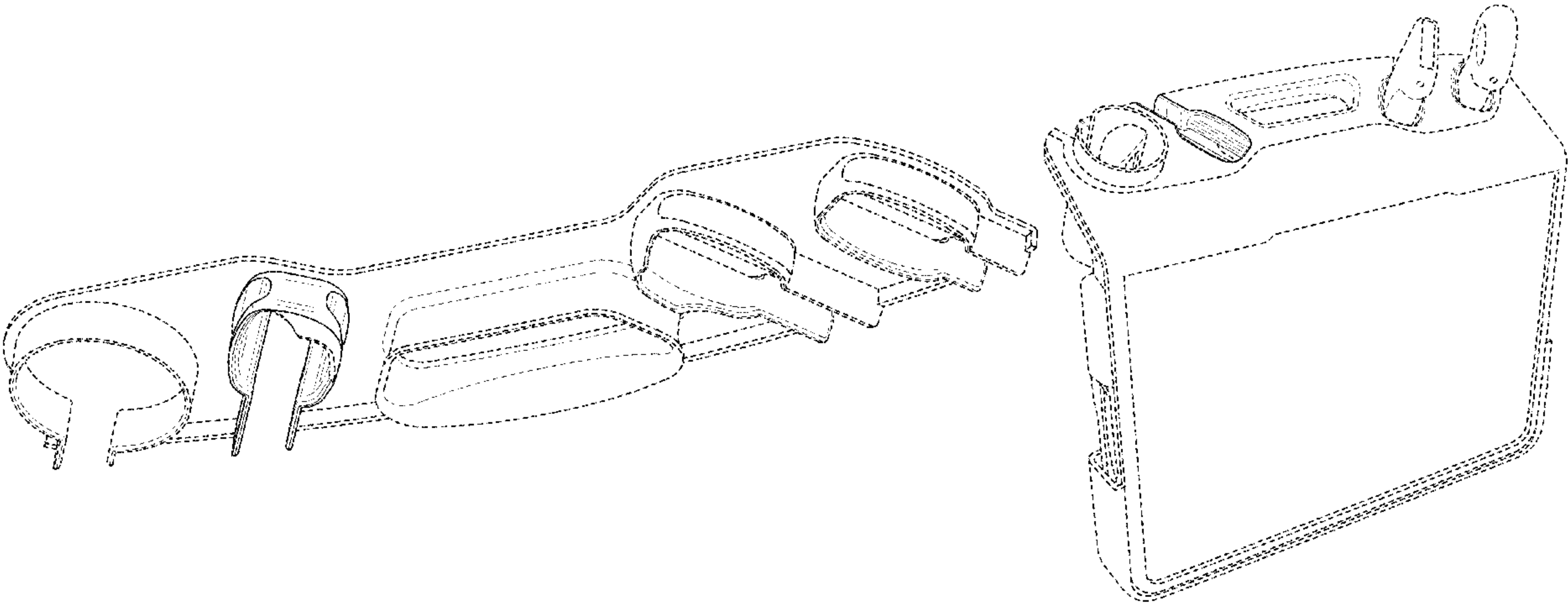
FIG. 11 is a sectional view of the accessory holder taken along line 11-11 in FIG. 5.

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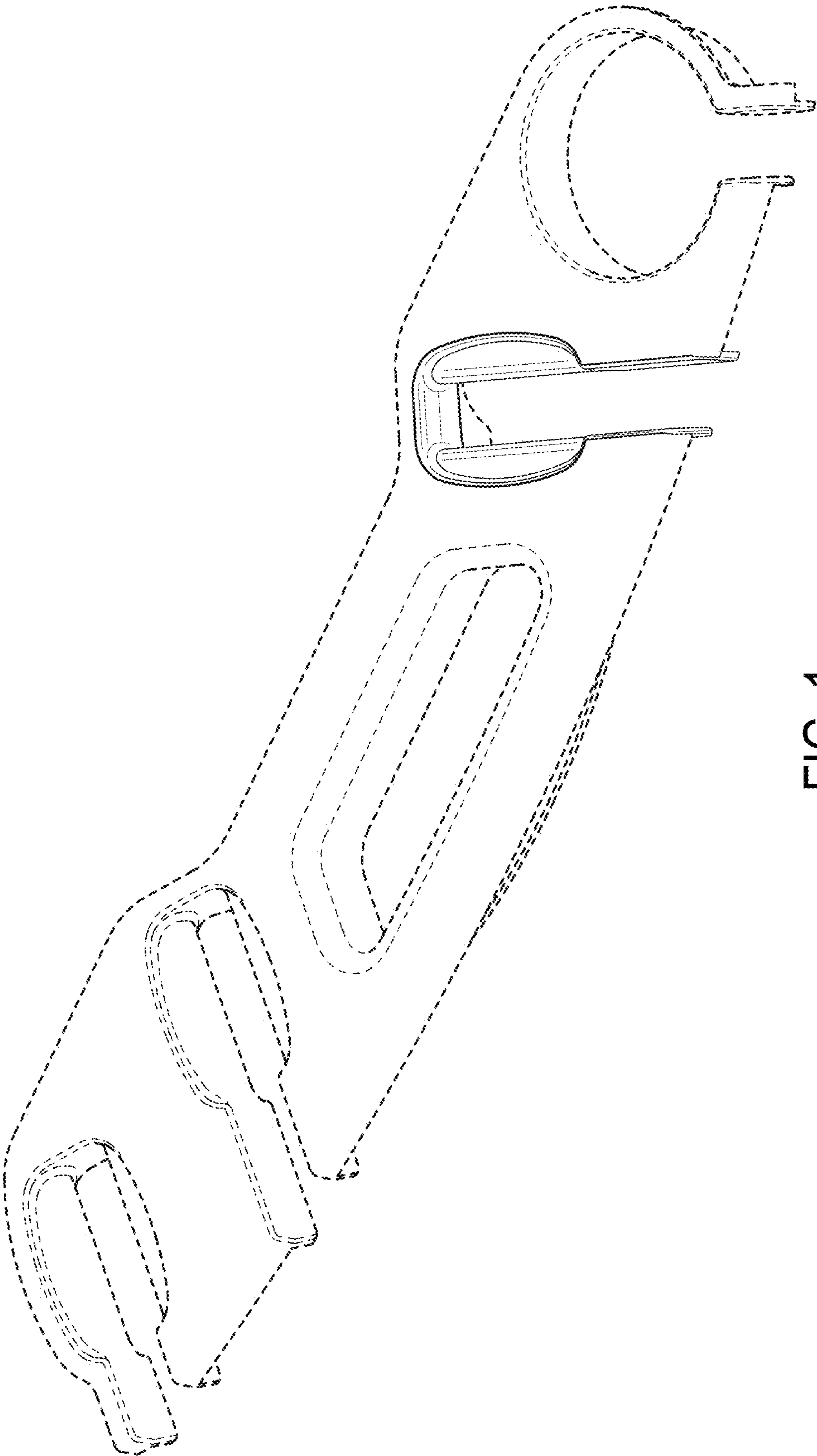

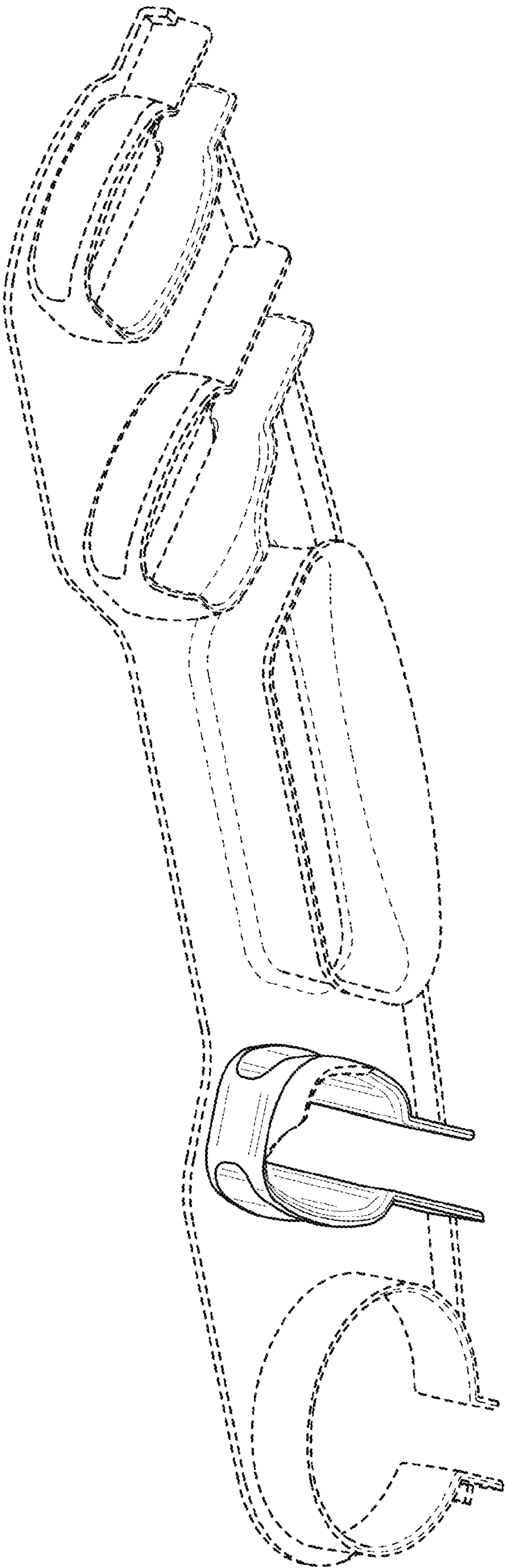

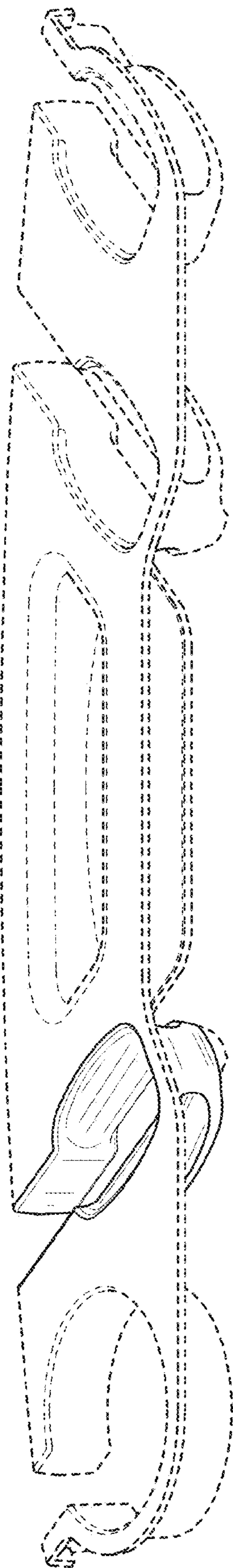

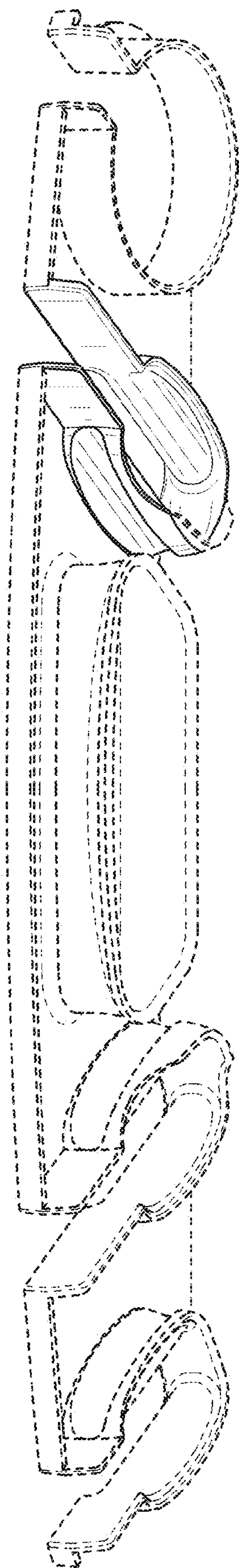

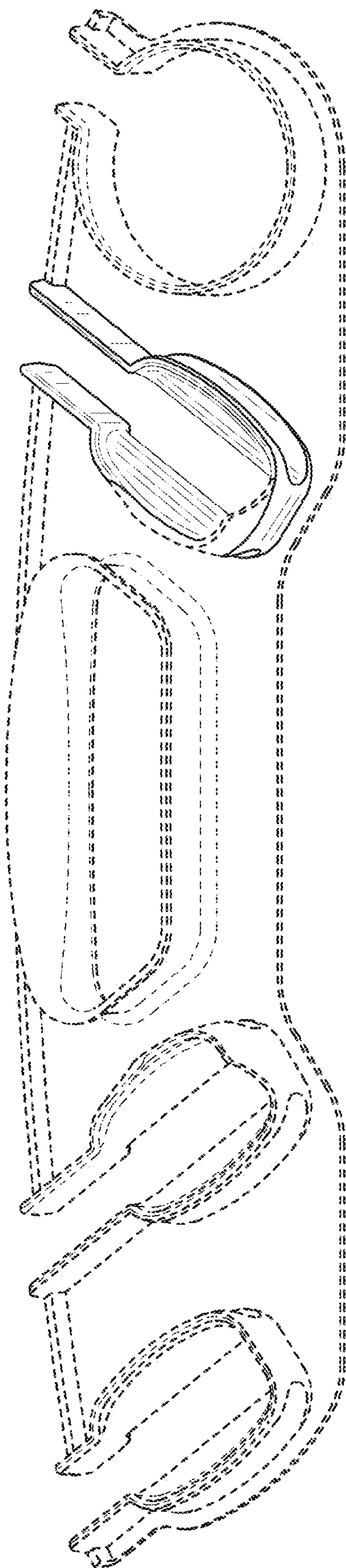

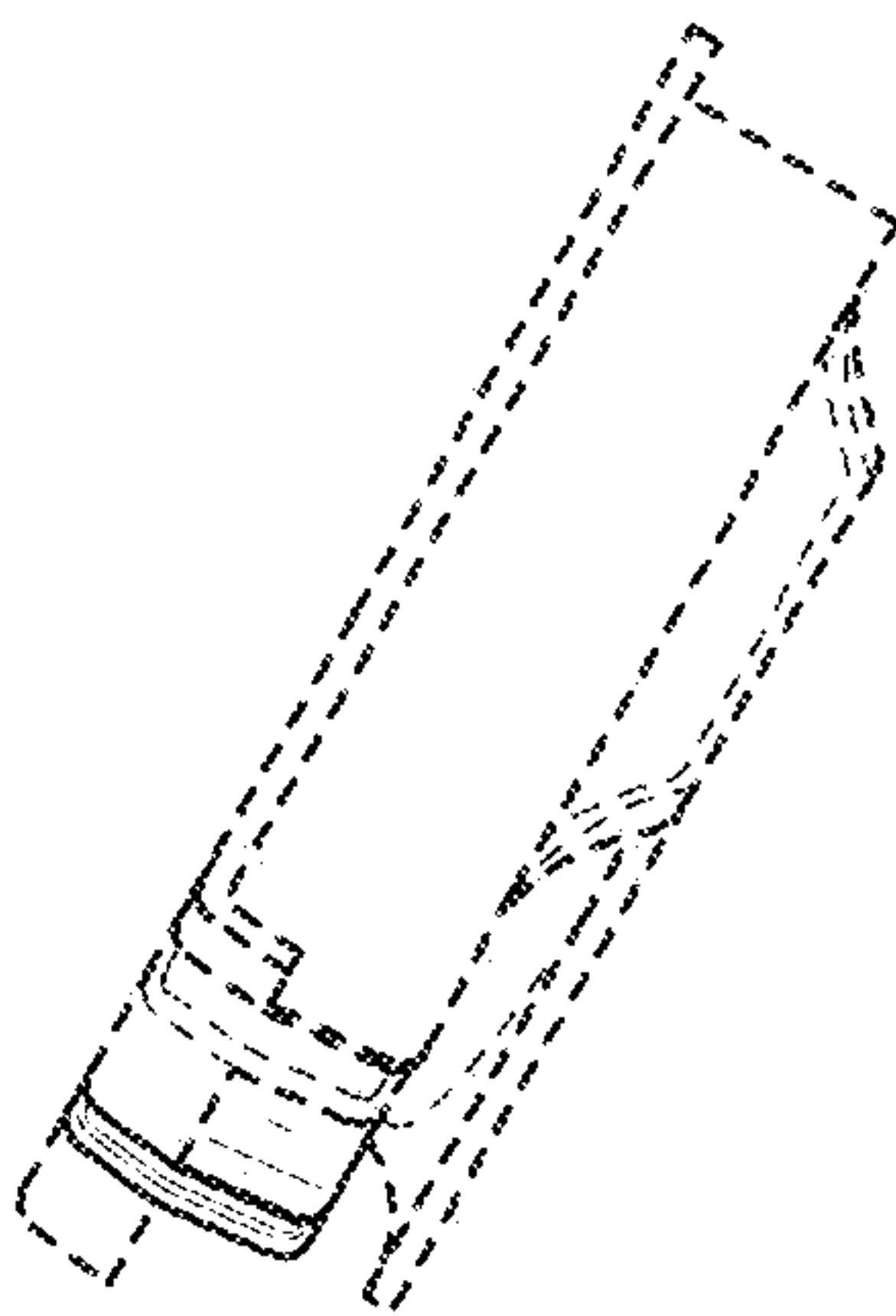

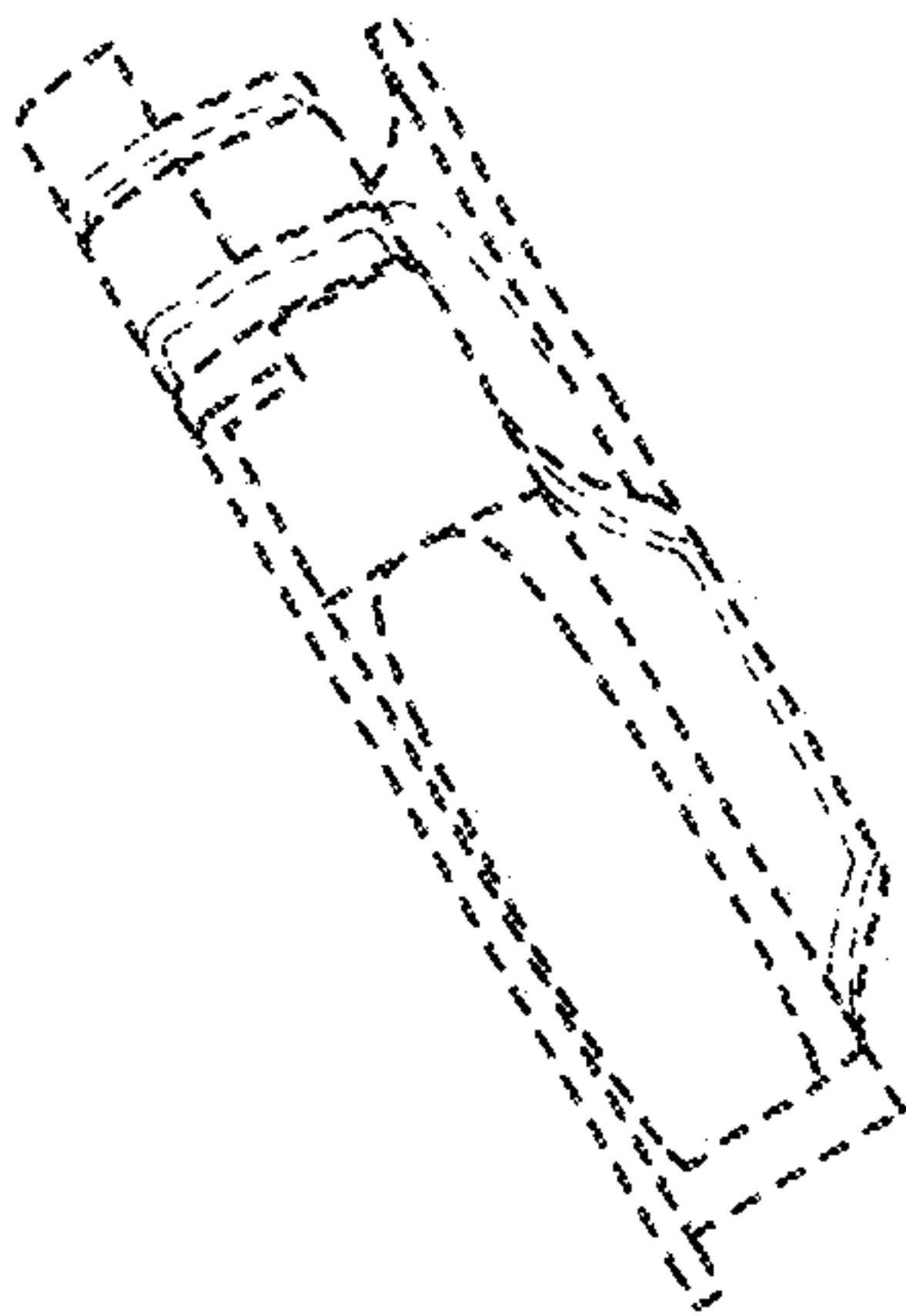
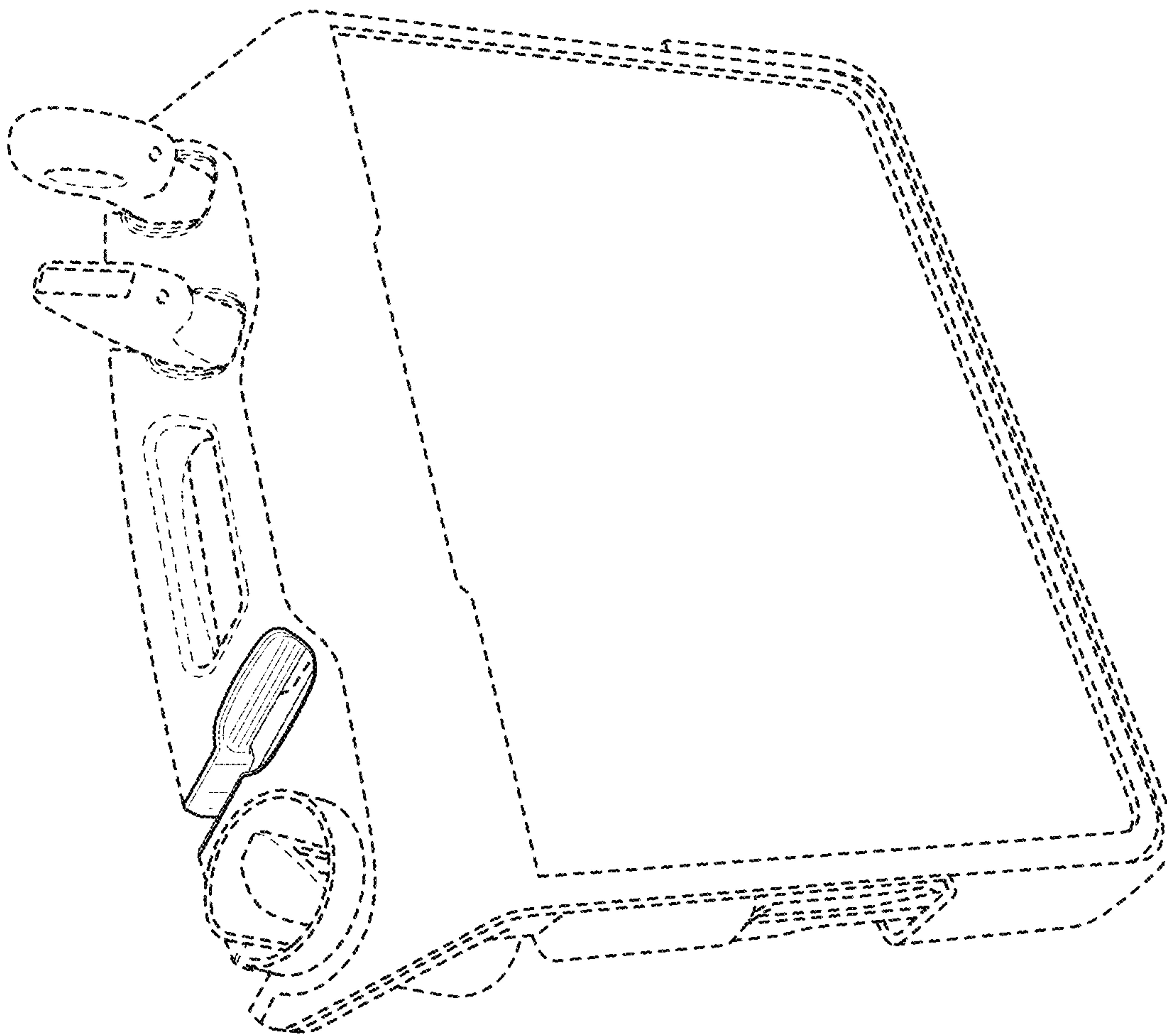

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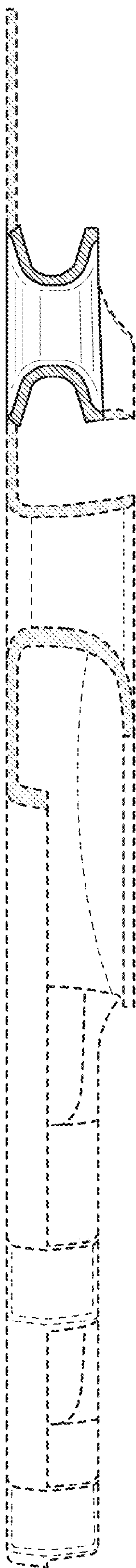

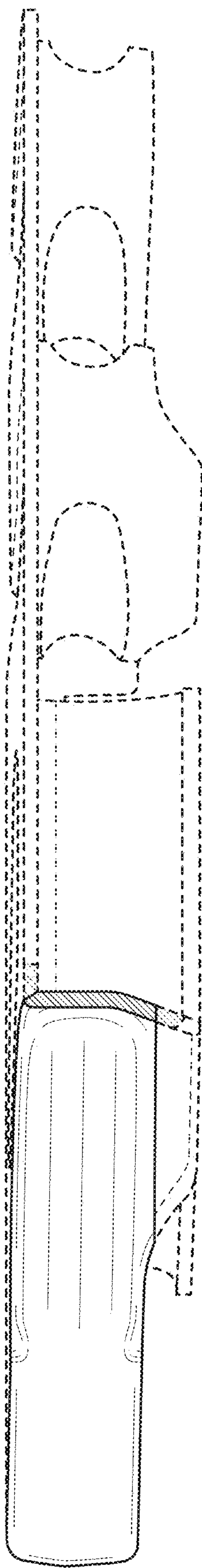
