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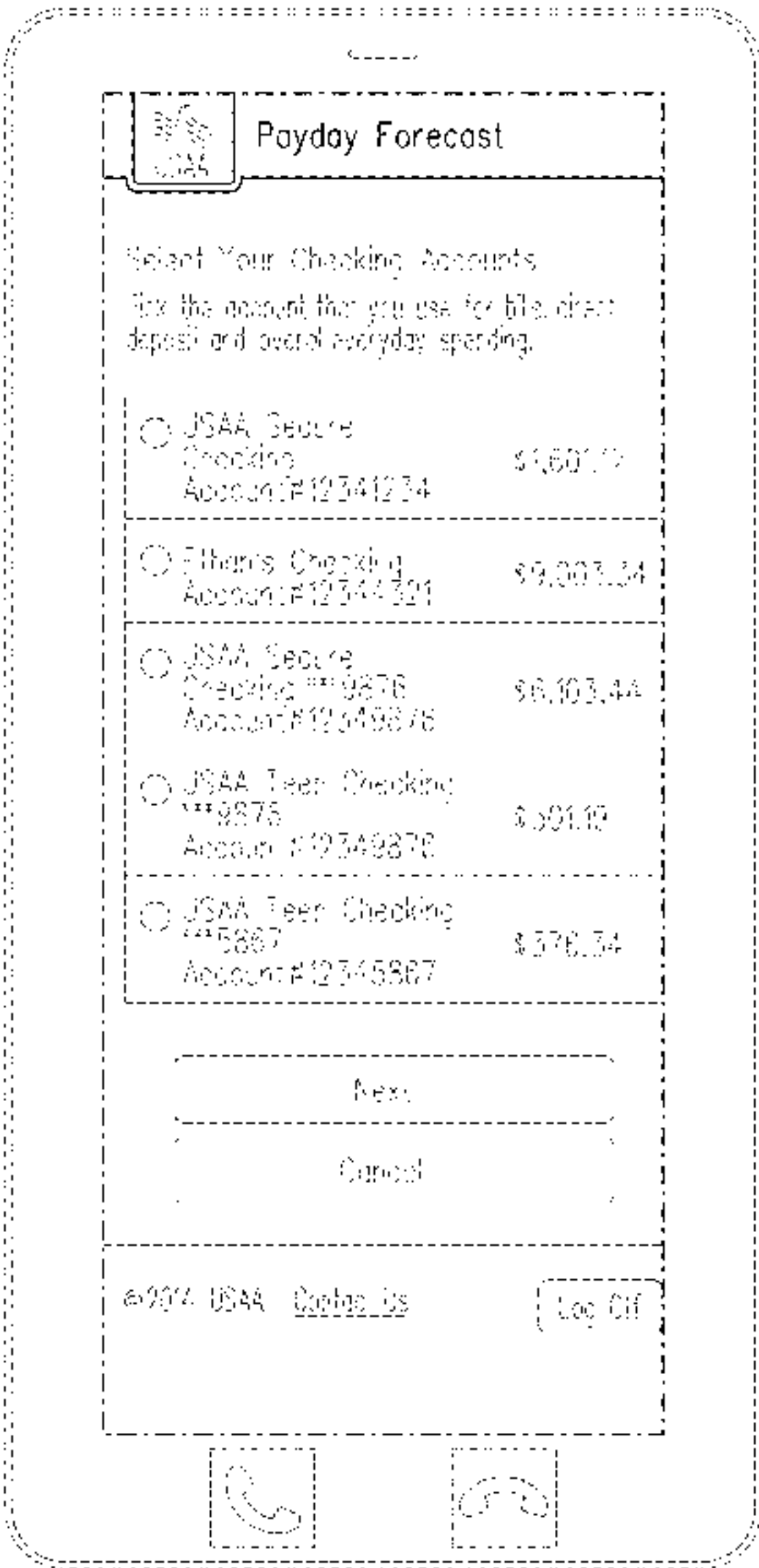
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 illustrates a front view of a display screen or portion thereof with a graphical user interface (GUI), wherein parts of the GUI are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes; and,
FIG. 2 illustrates a front view of a second embodiment of the GUI set forth in FIG. 1.
In FIGS. 1 and 2, the solid lines illustrate the claimed ornamental design. The broken lines showing an electronic device illustrate environmental matter, whereas the dot-dash broken lines showing a display screen and regular broken lines within showing elements of the graphical user interface illustrate portions of the article. 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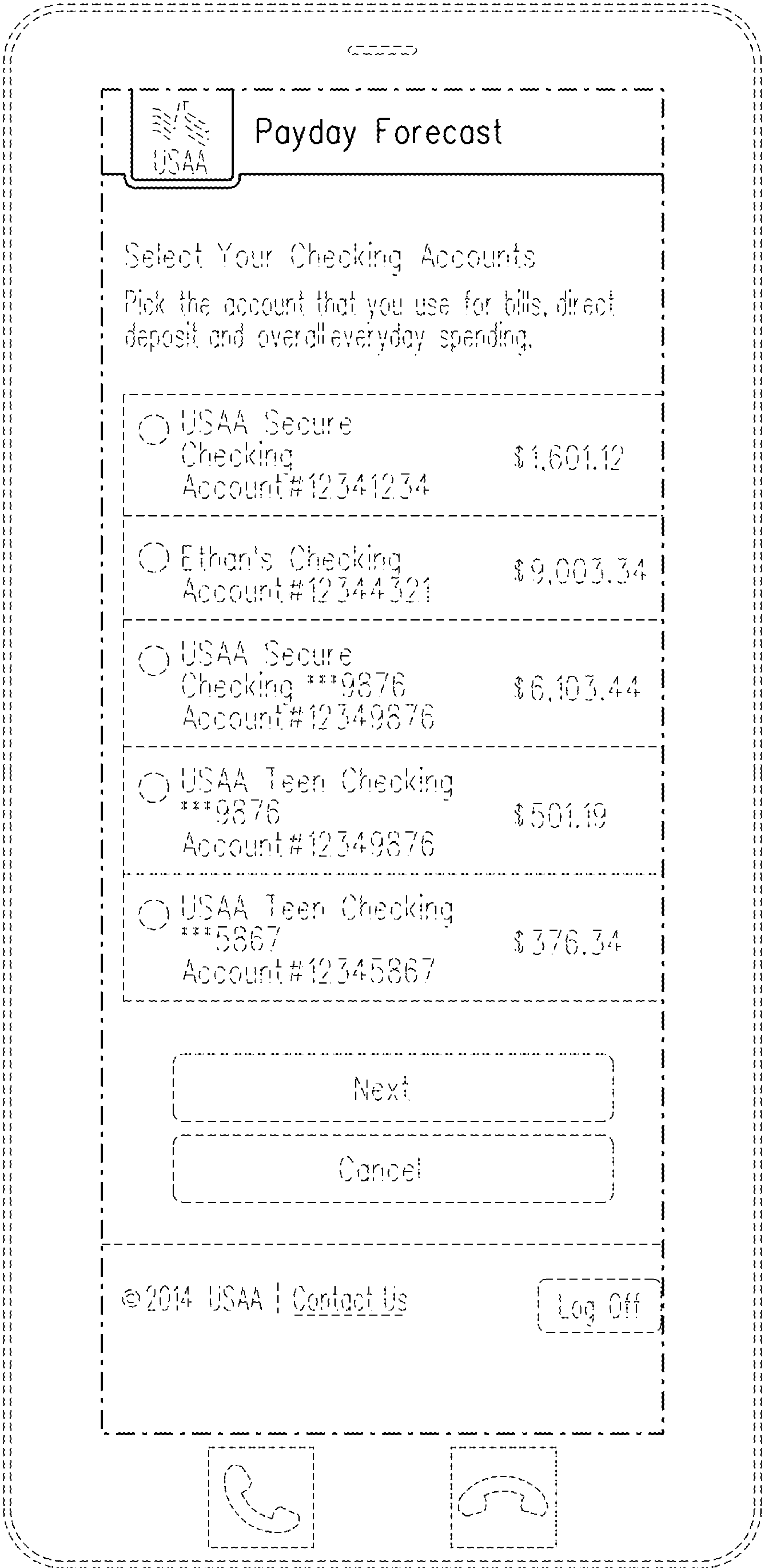

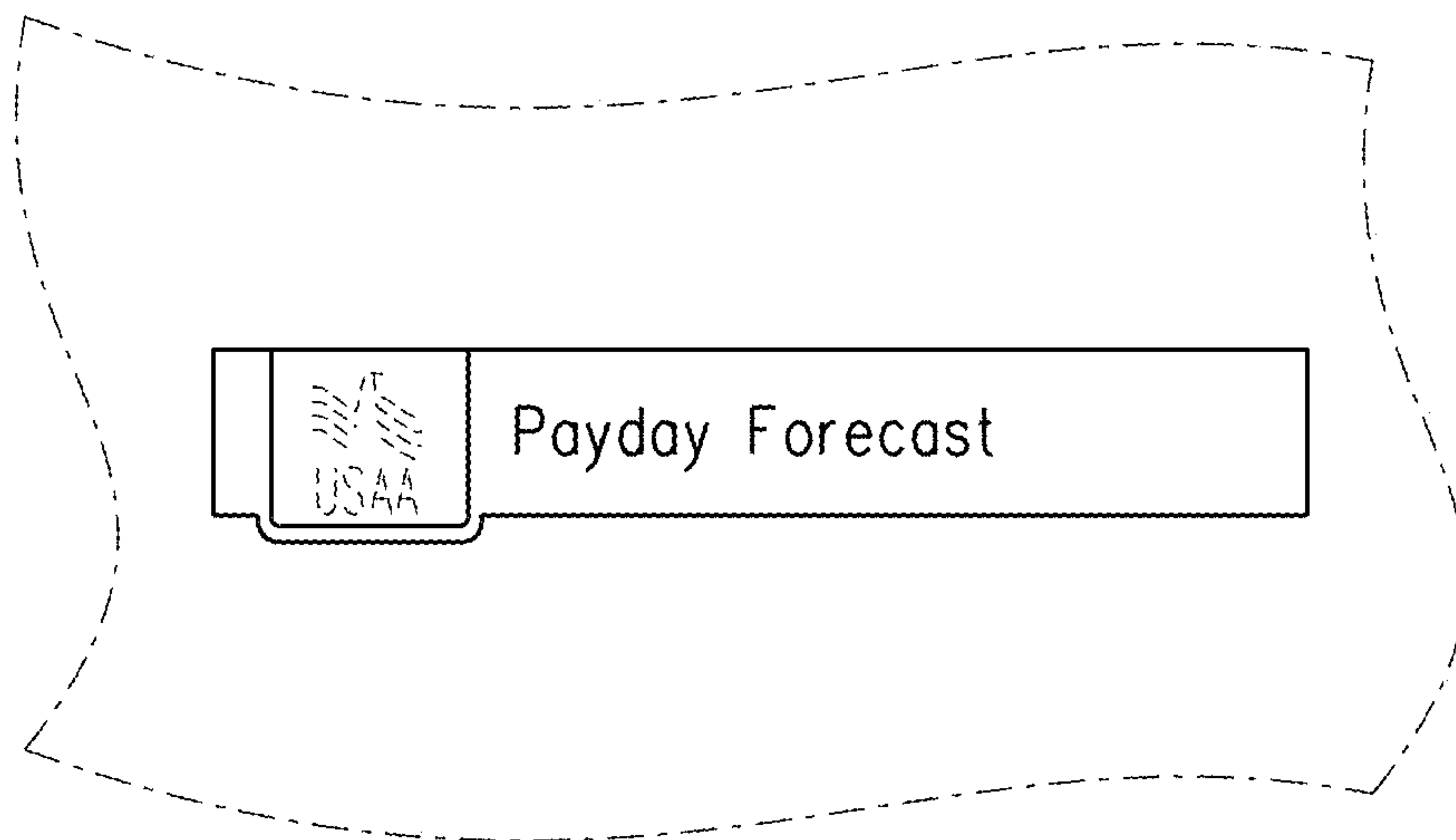
