FIG. 1 is a top view of the electronic device for musical instrument illustrating my new ornamental design;

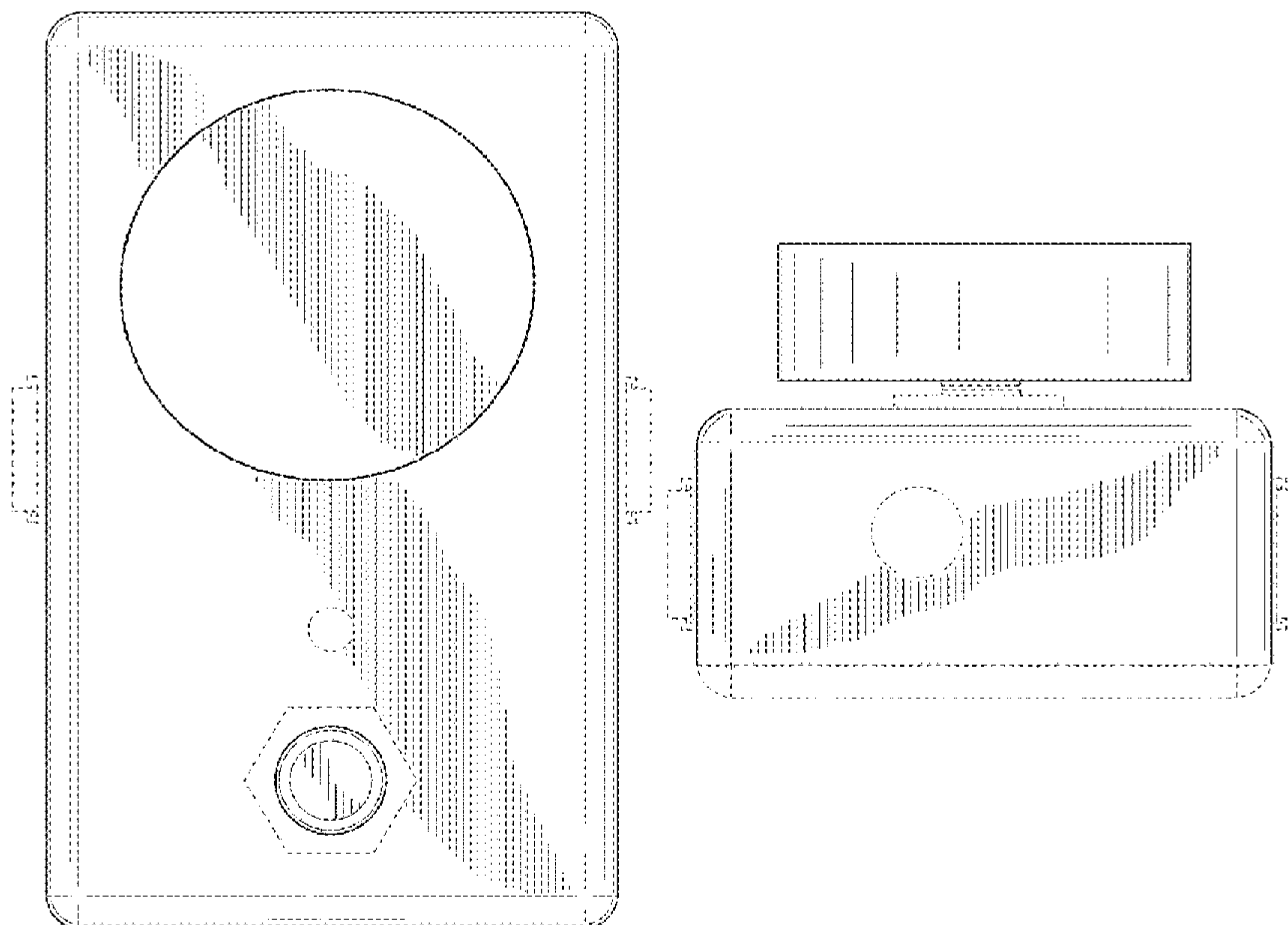
FIG. 2 is a right-side view thereof, the left-side view being a mirror image of the right-side view;

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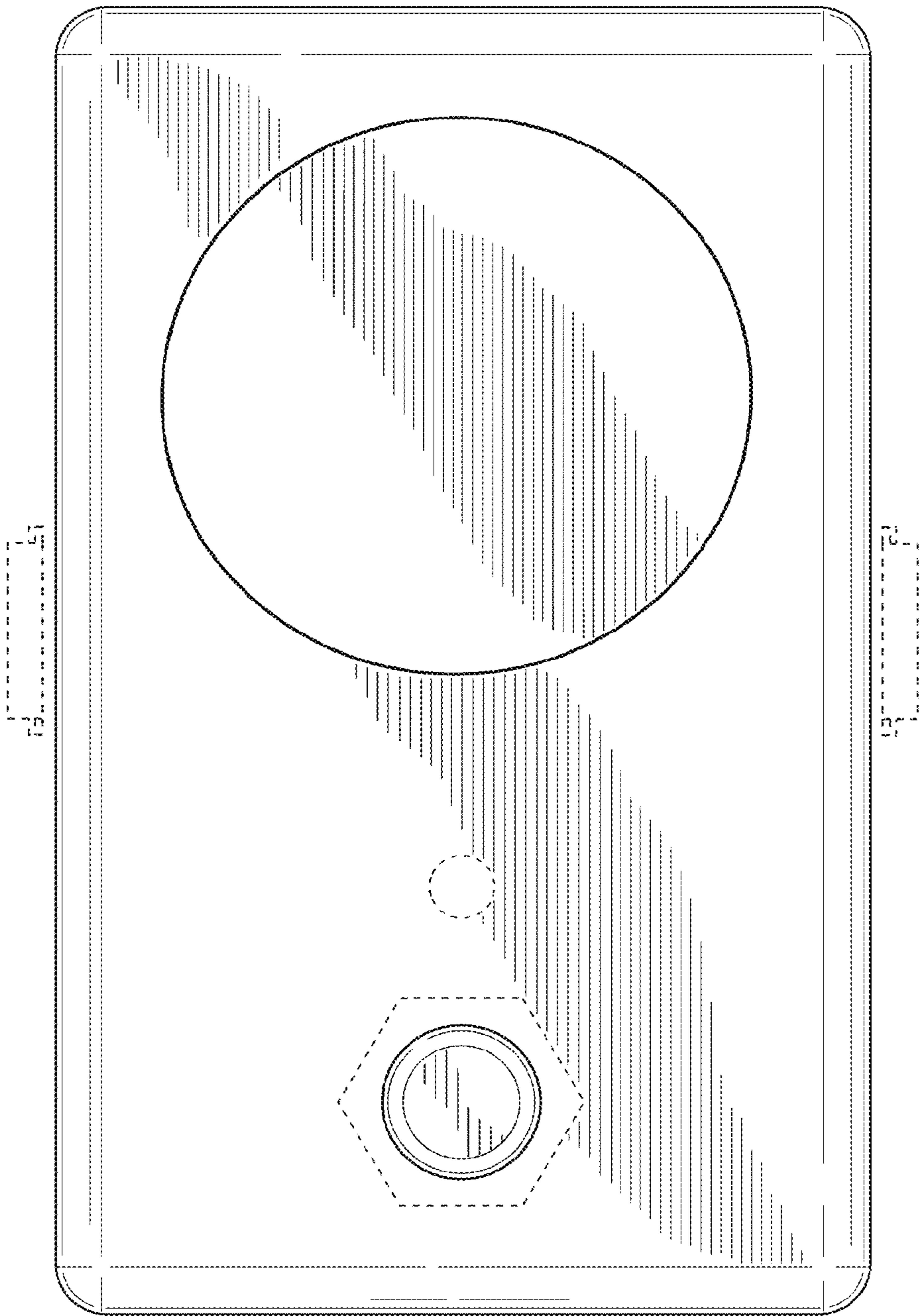

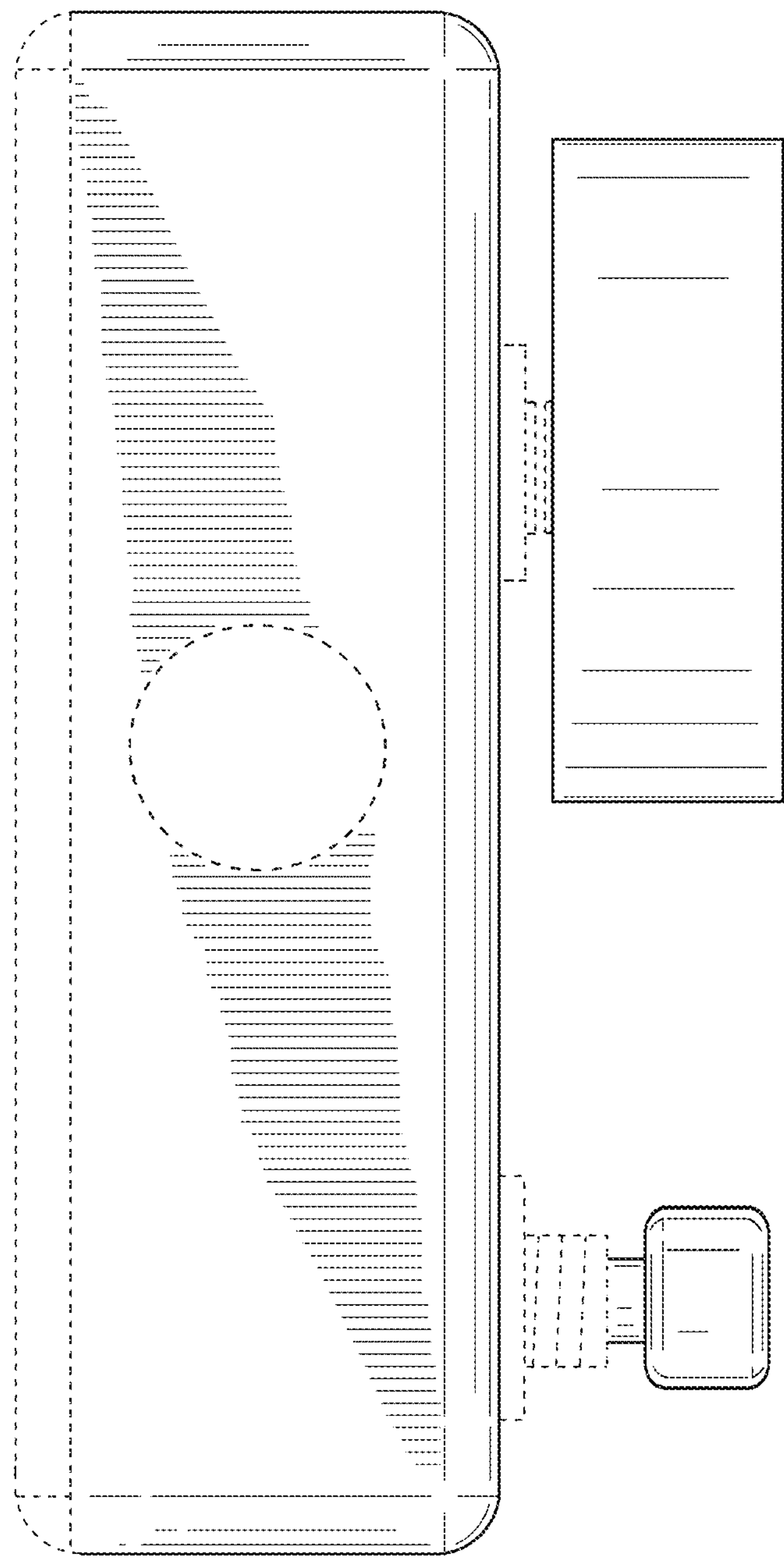

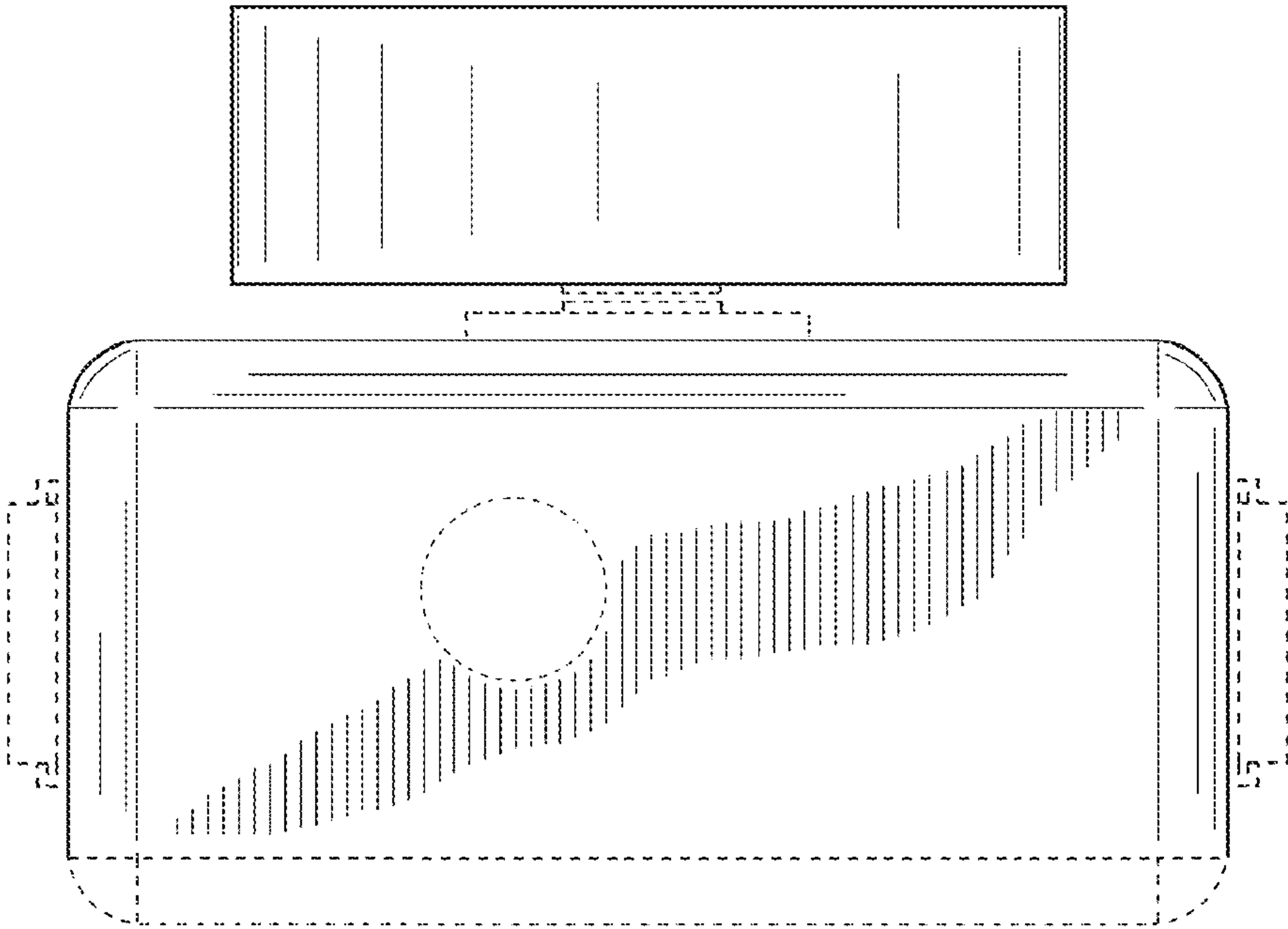

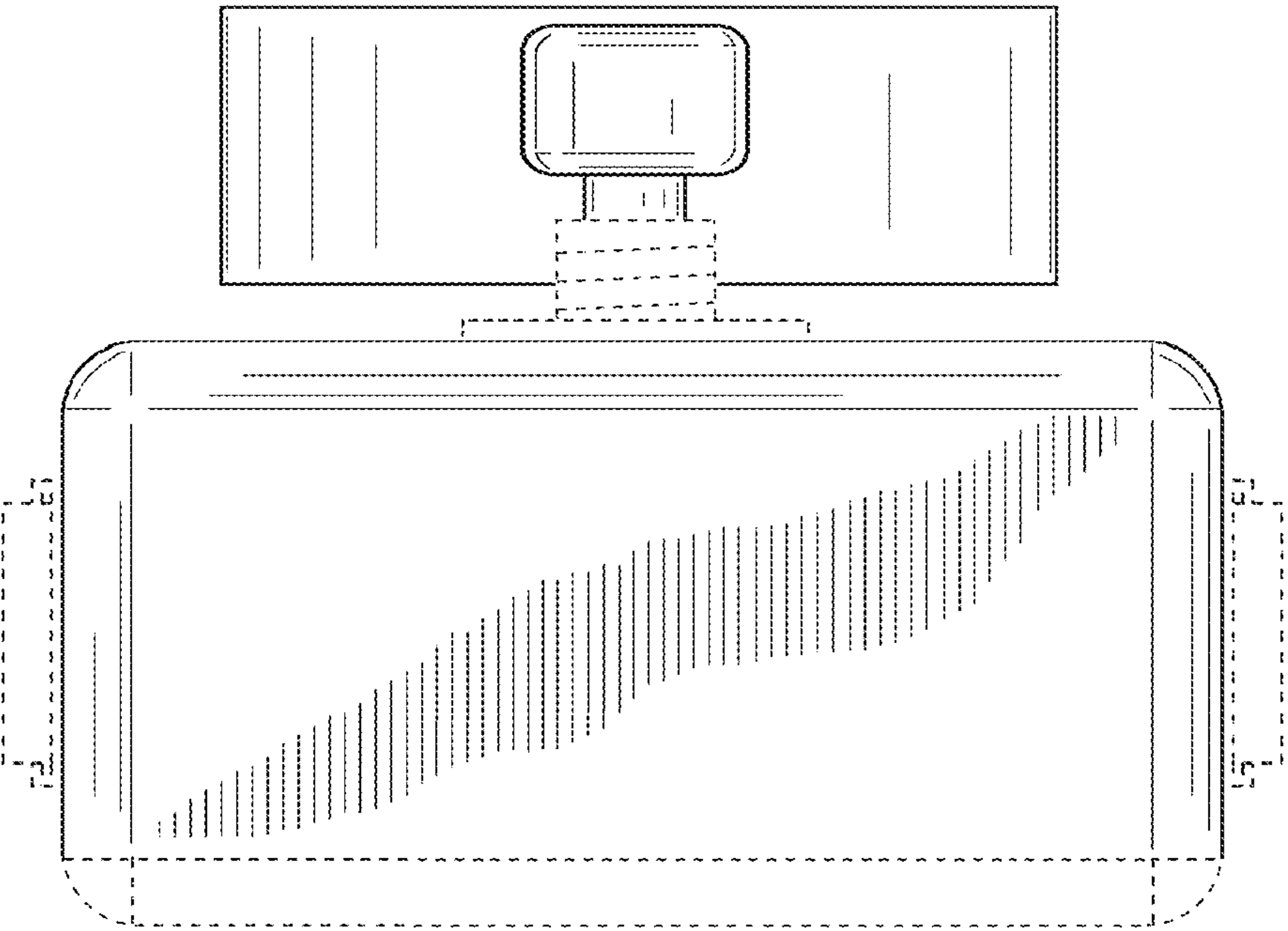
