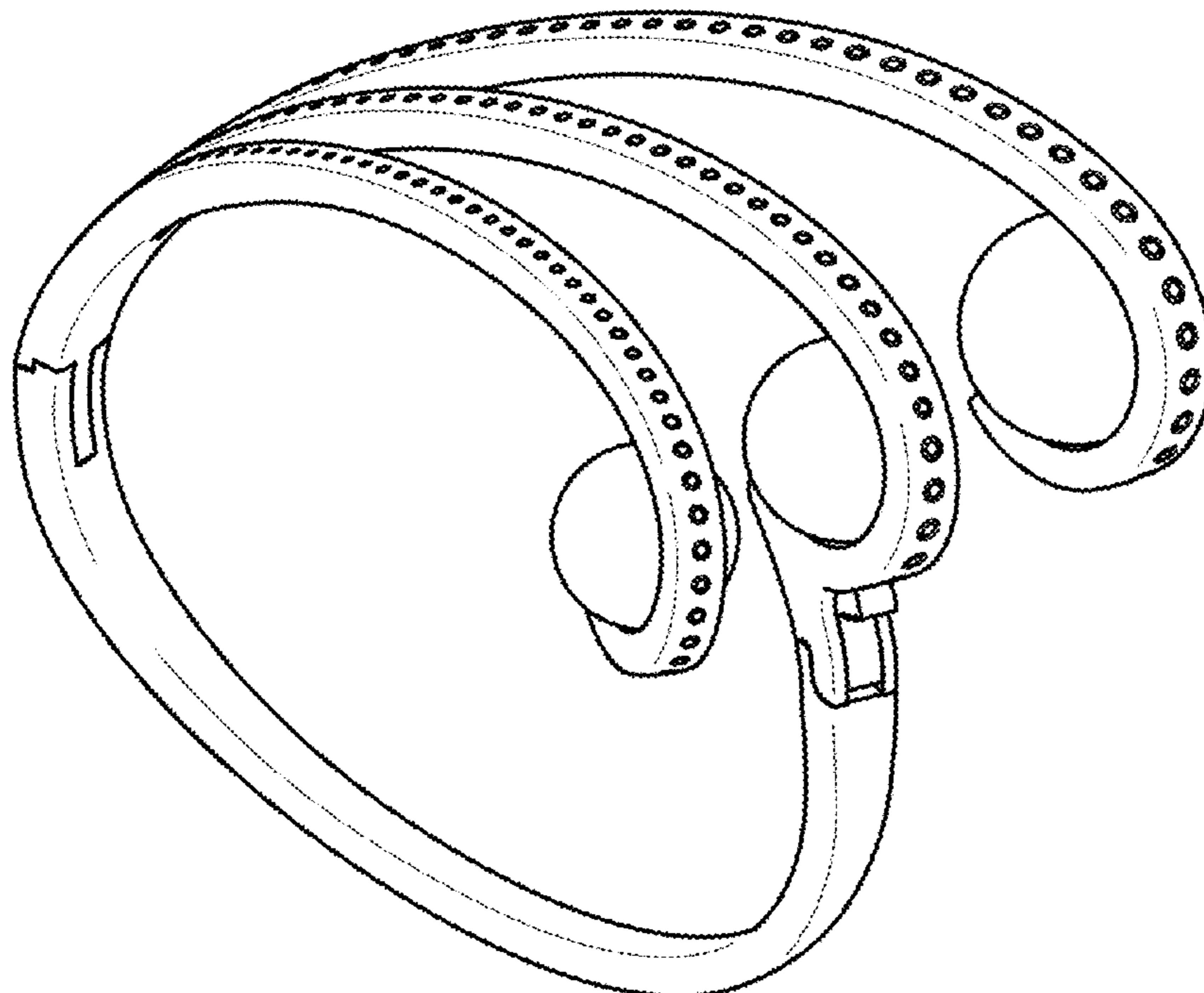

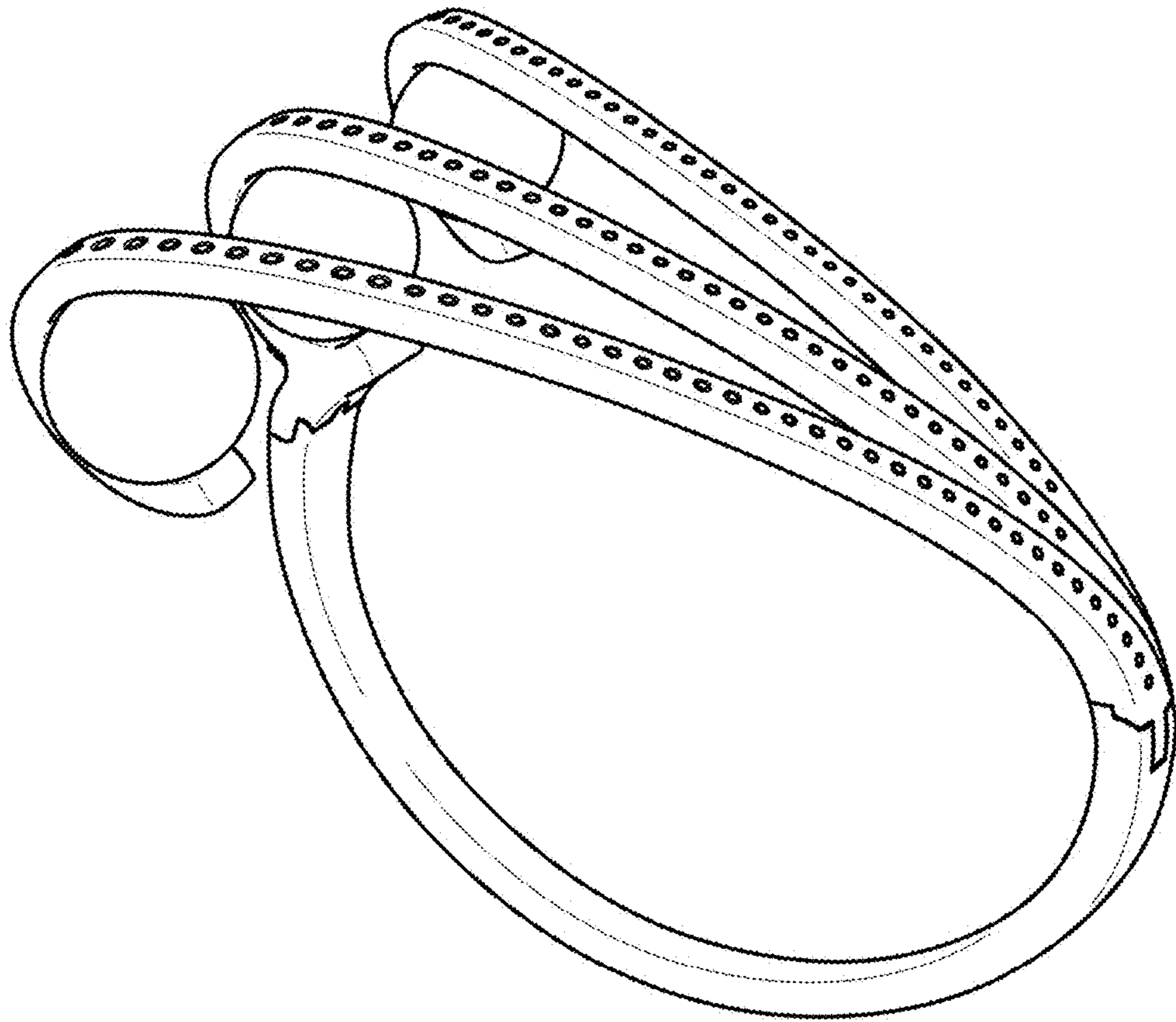

The broken lines in FIG. 1.9 depict environment that forms no part of the claimed design.

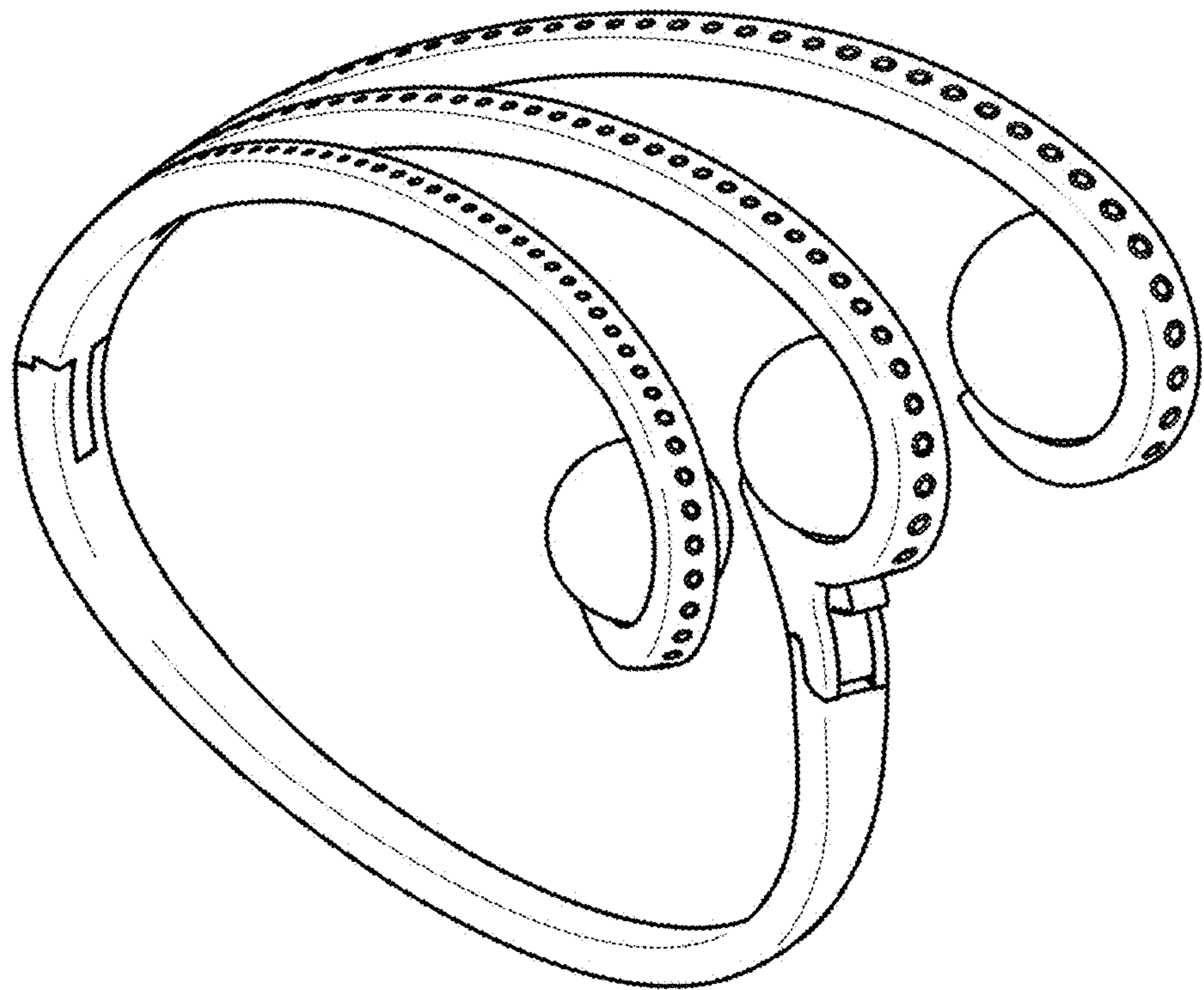

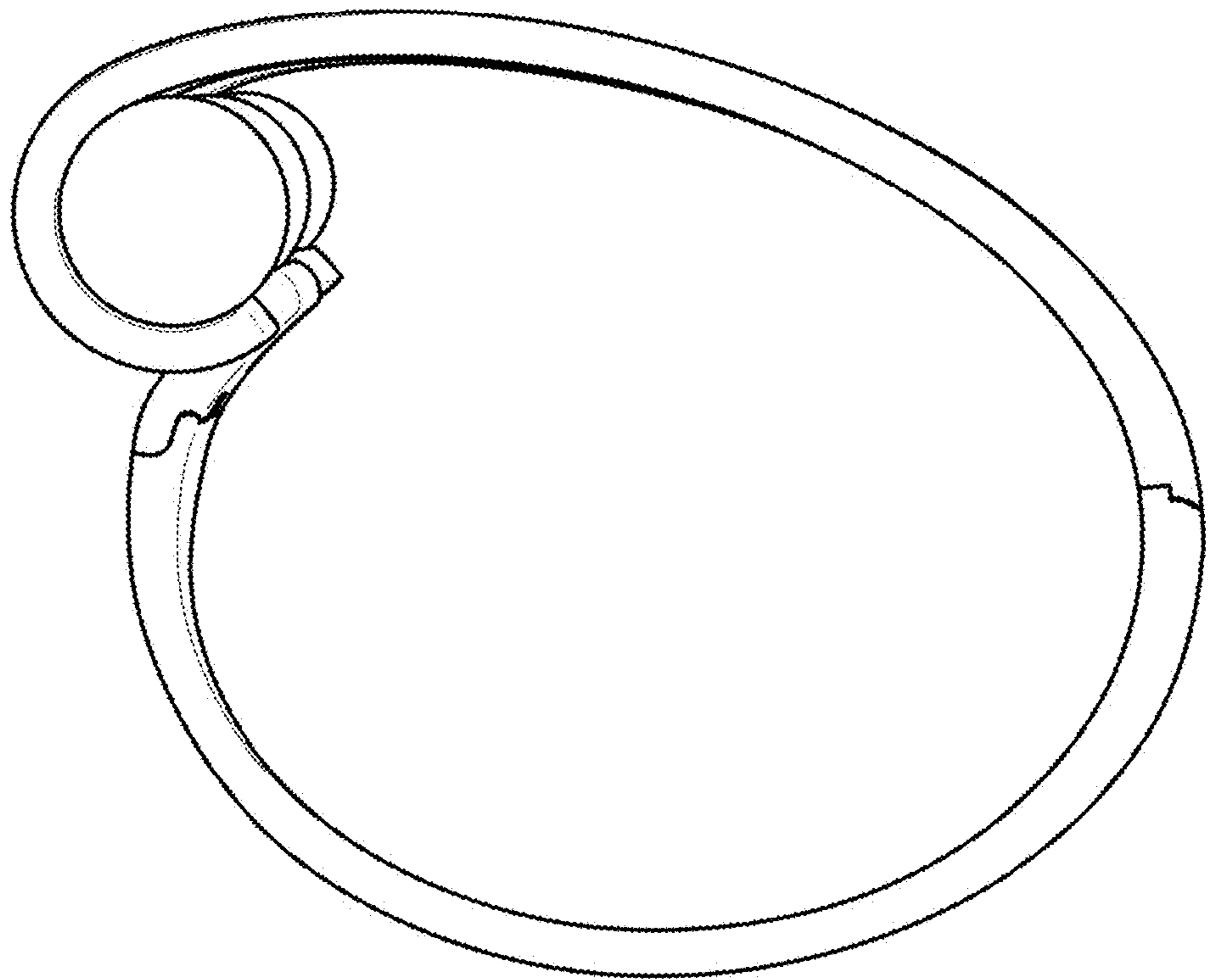

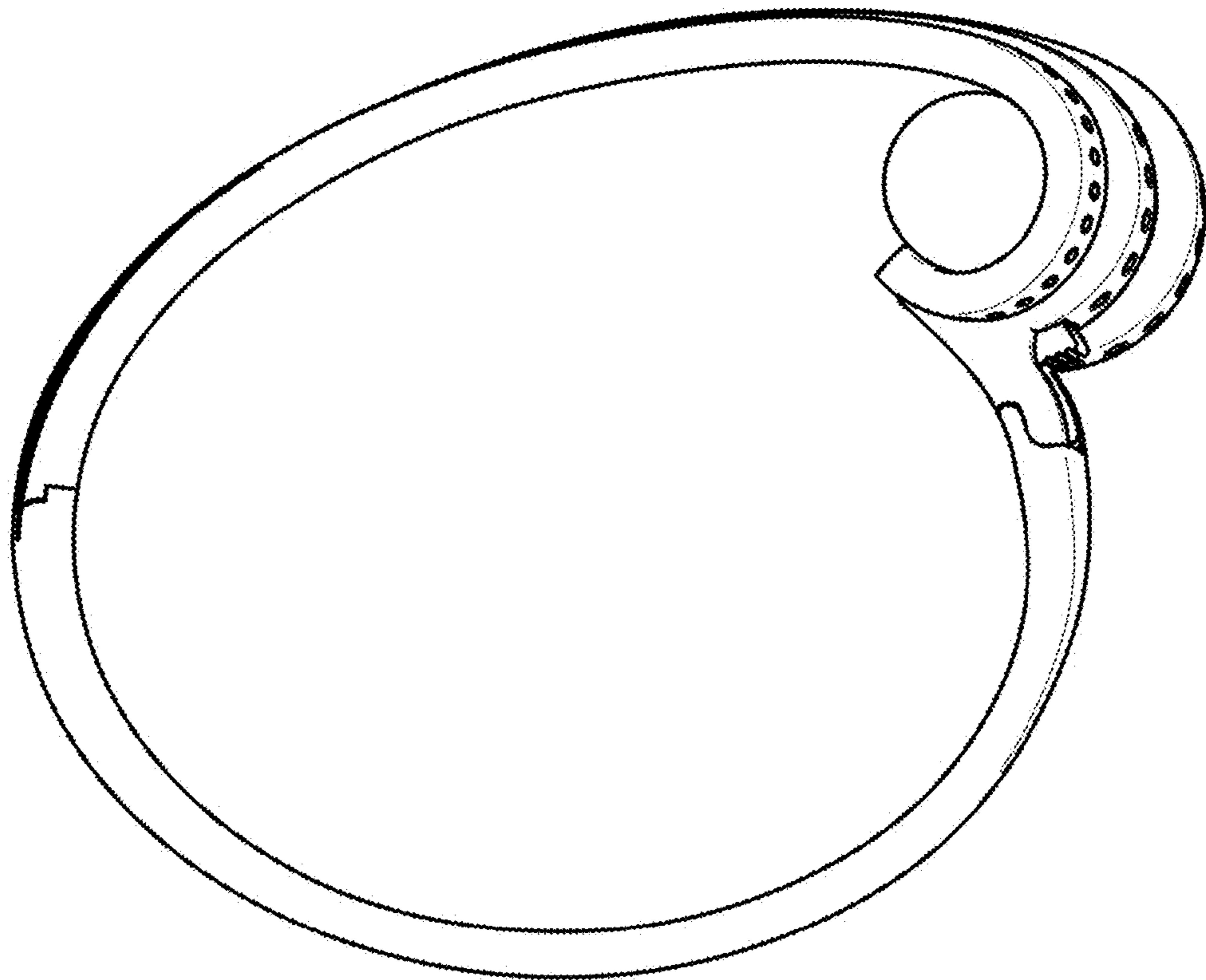

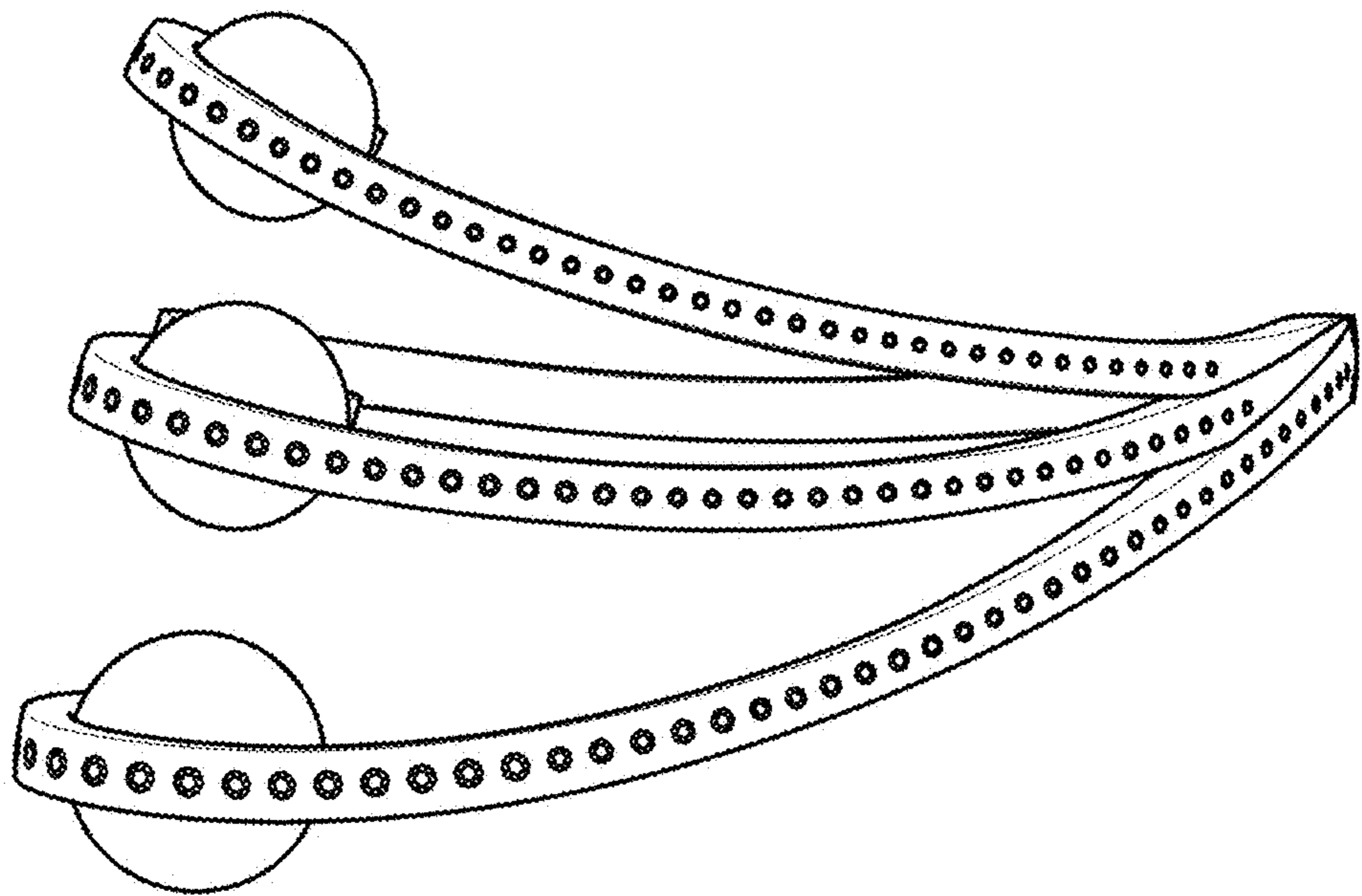

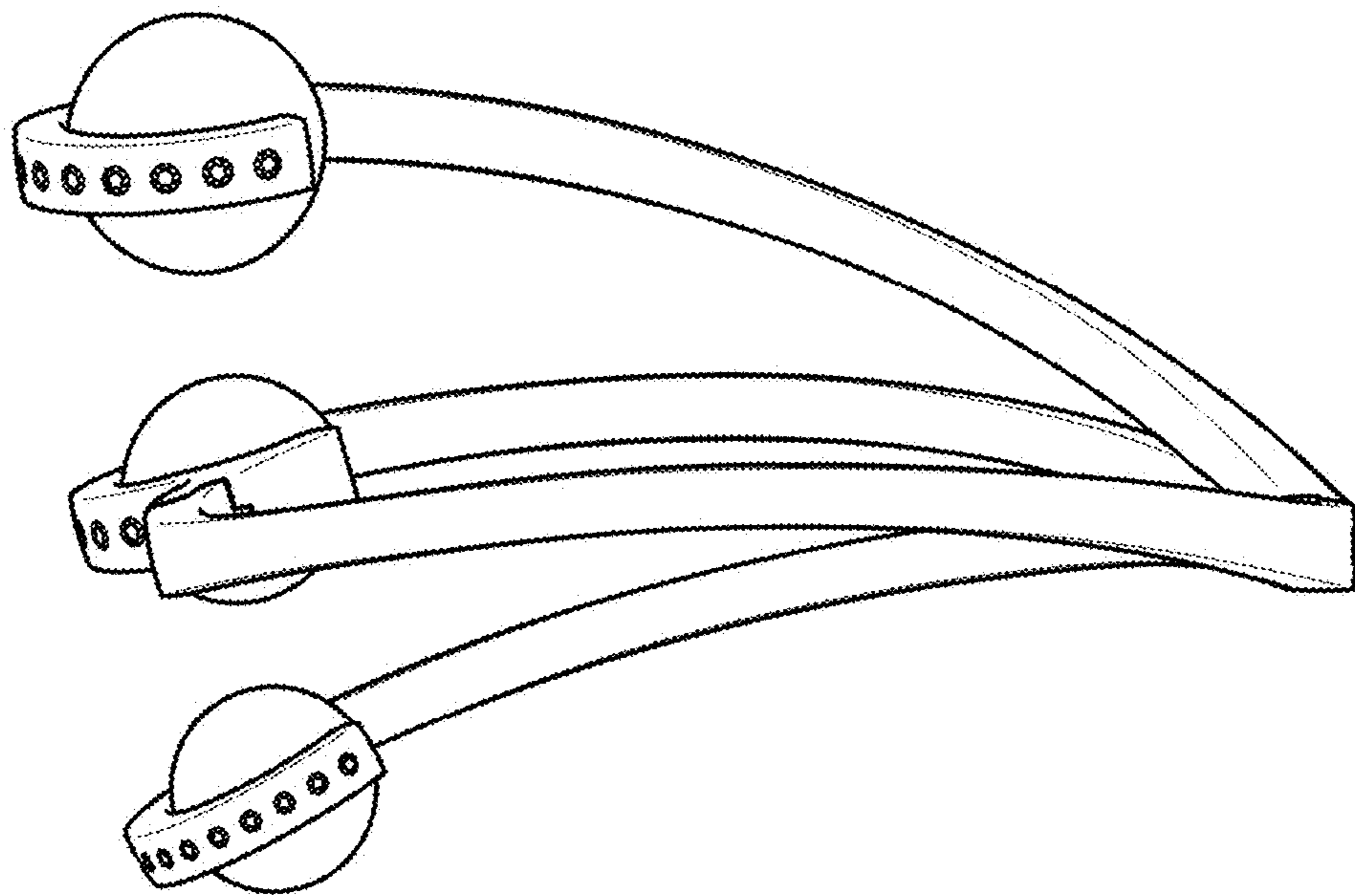

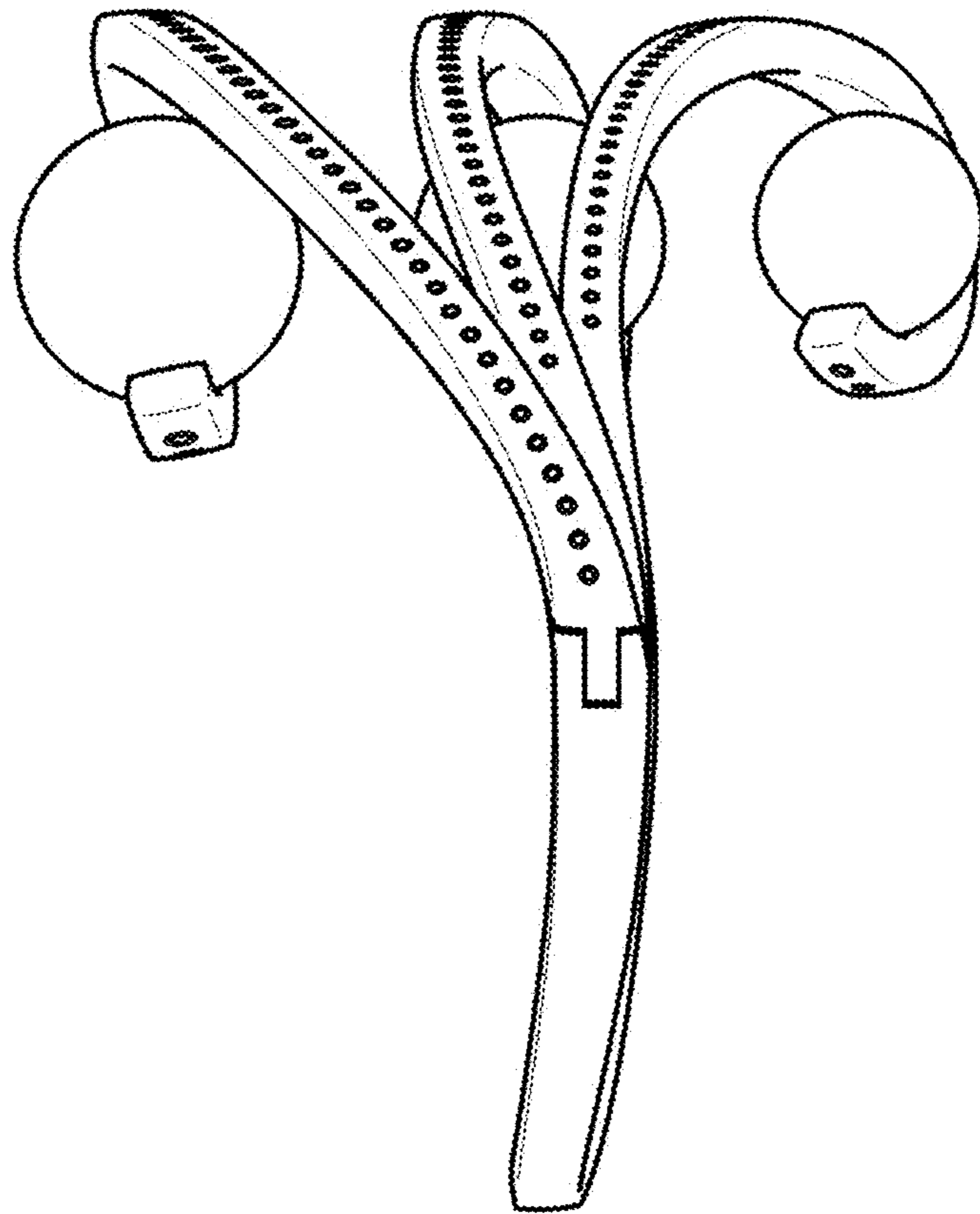

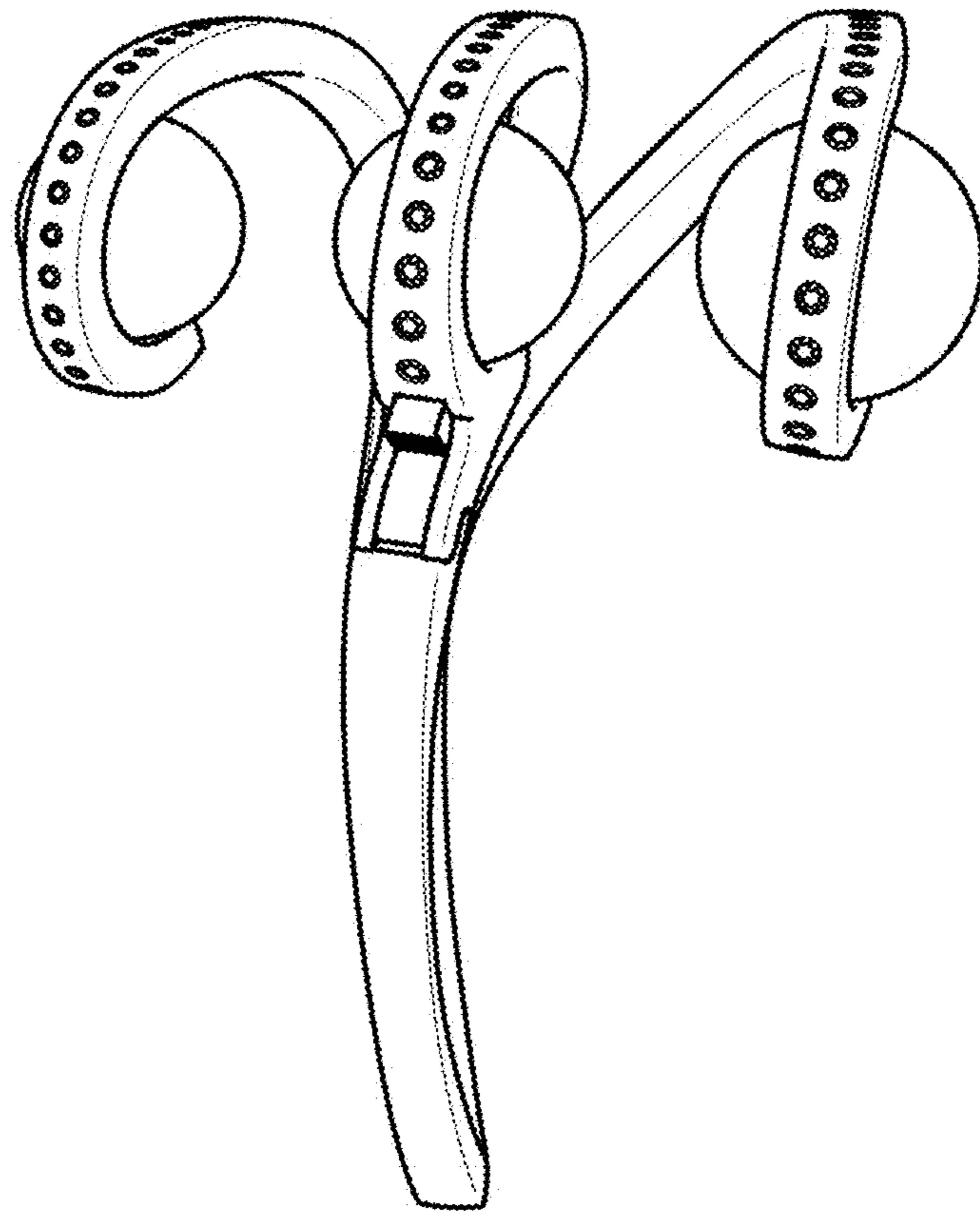
