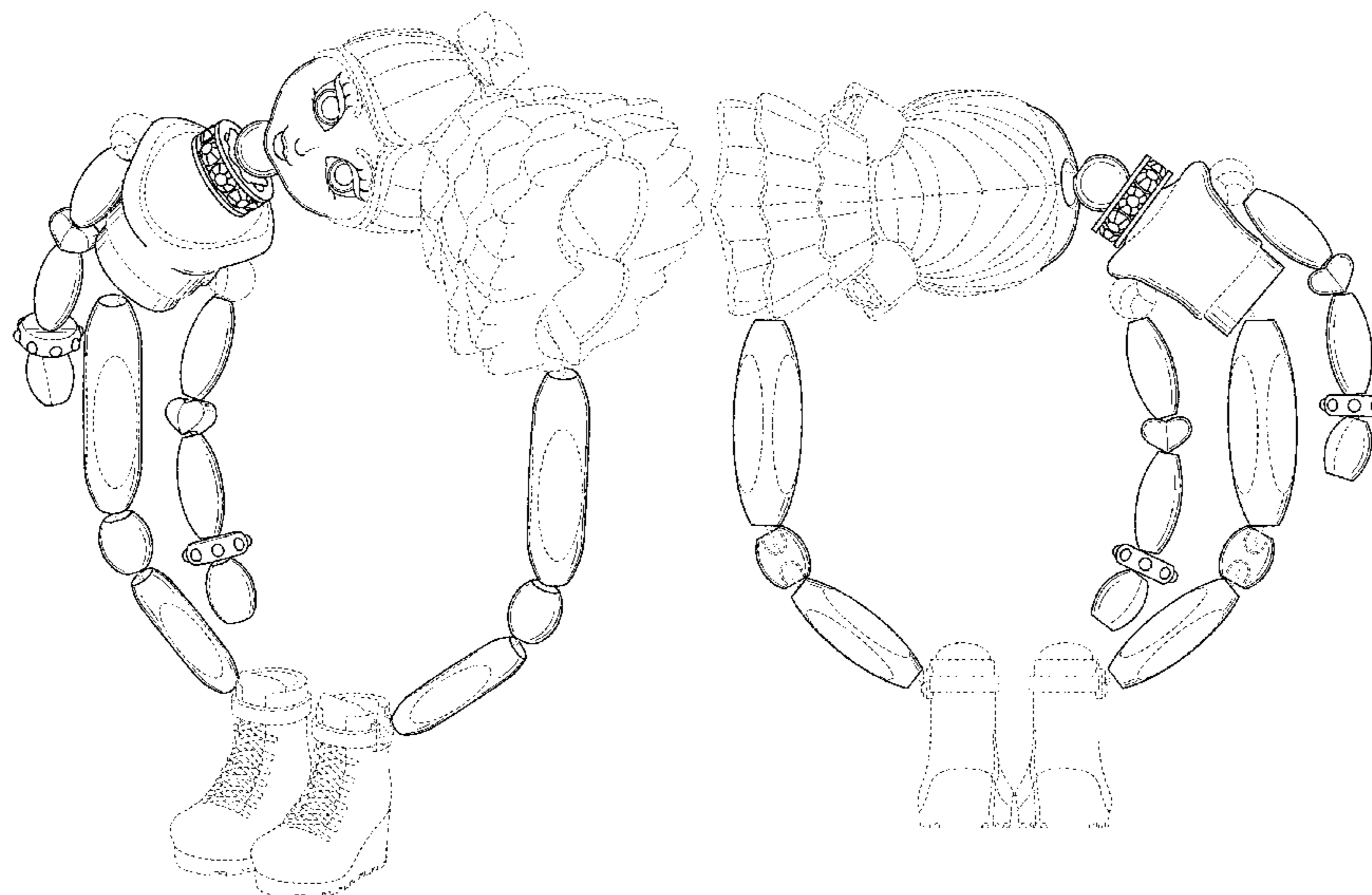
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jewelry toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above, to the front and the left side of the new design for a jewelry toy;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

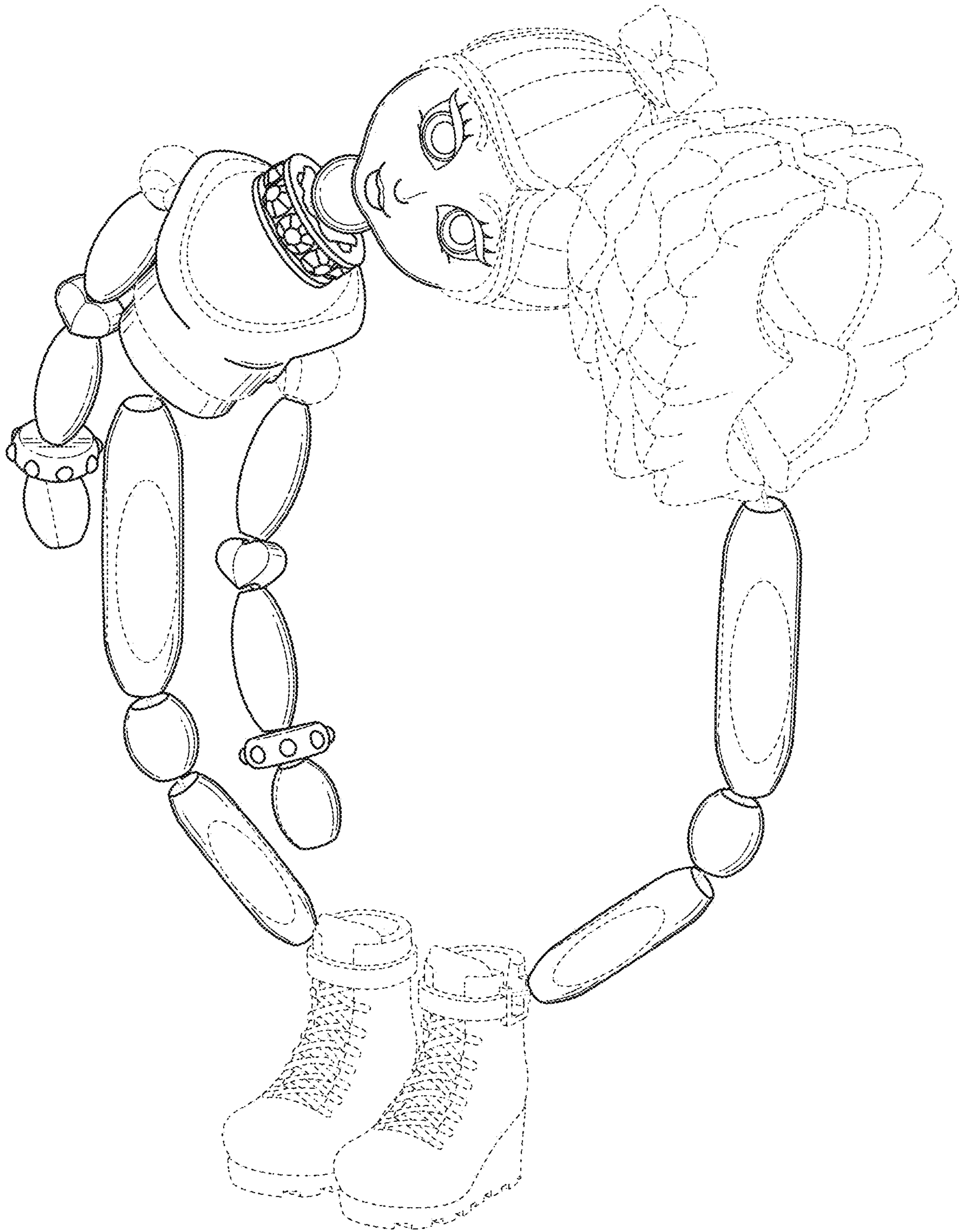

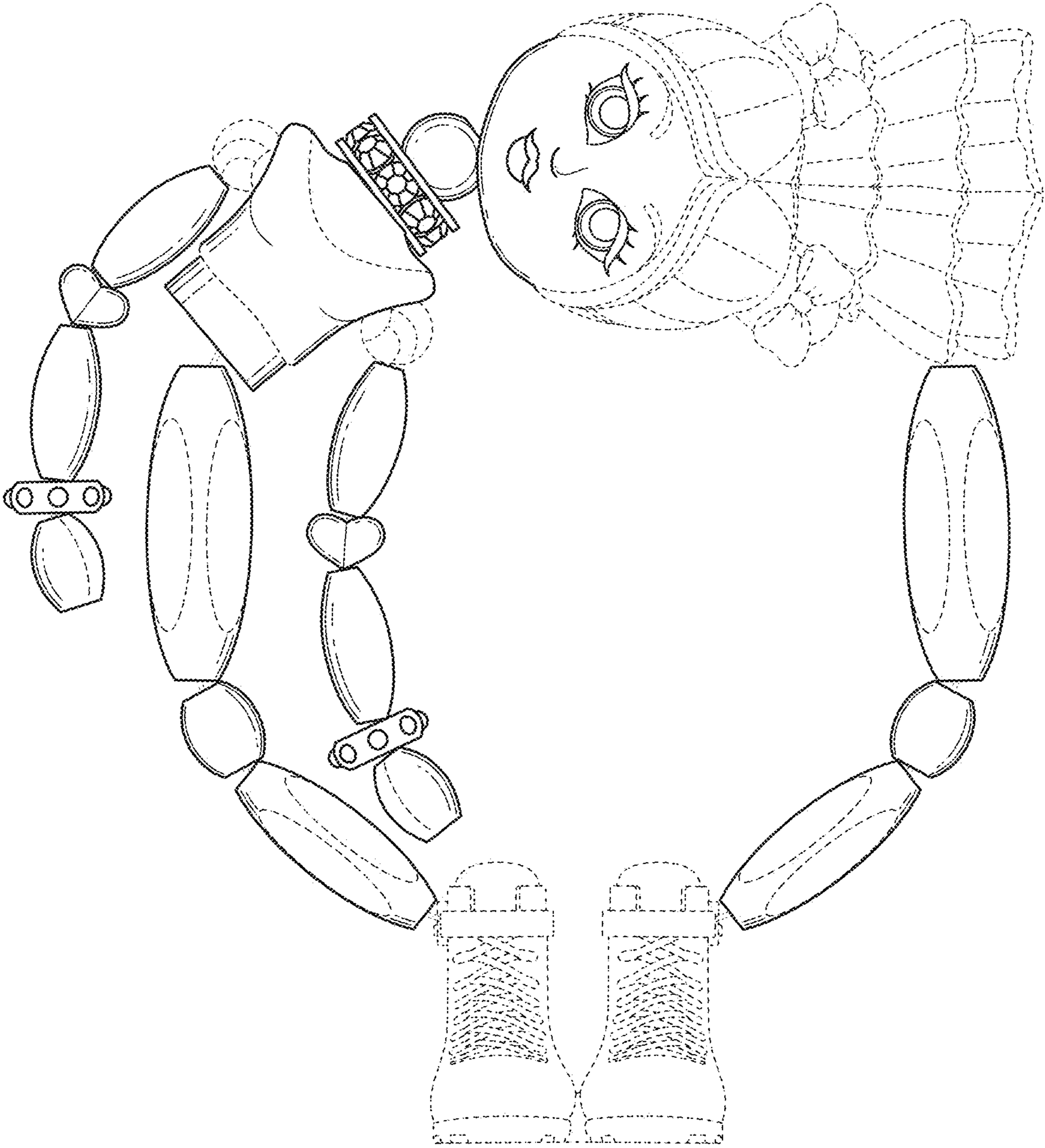

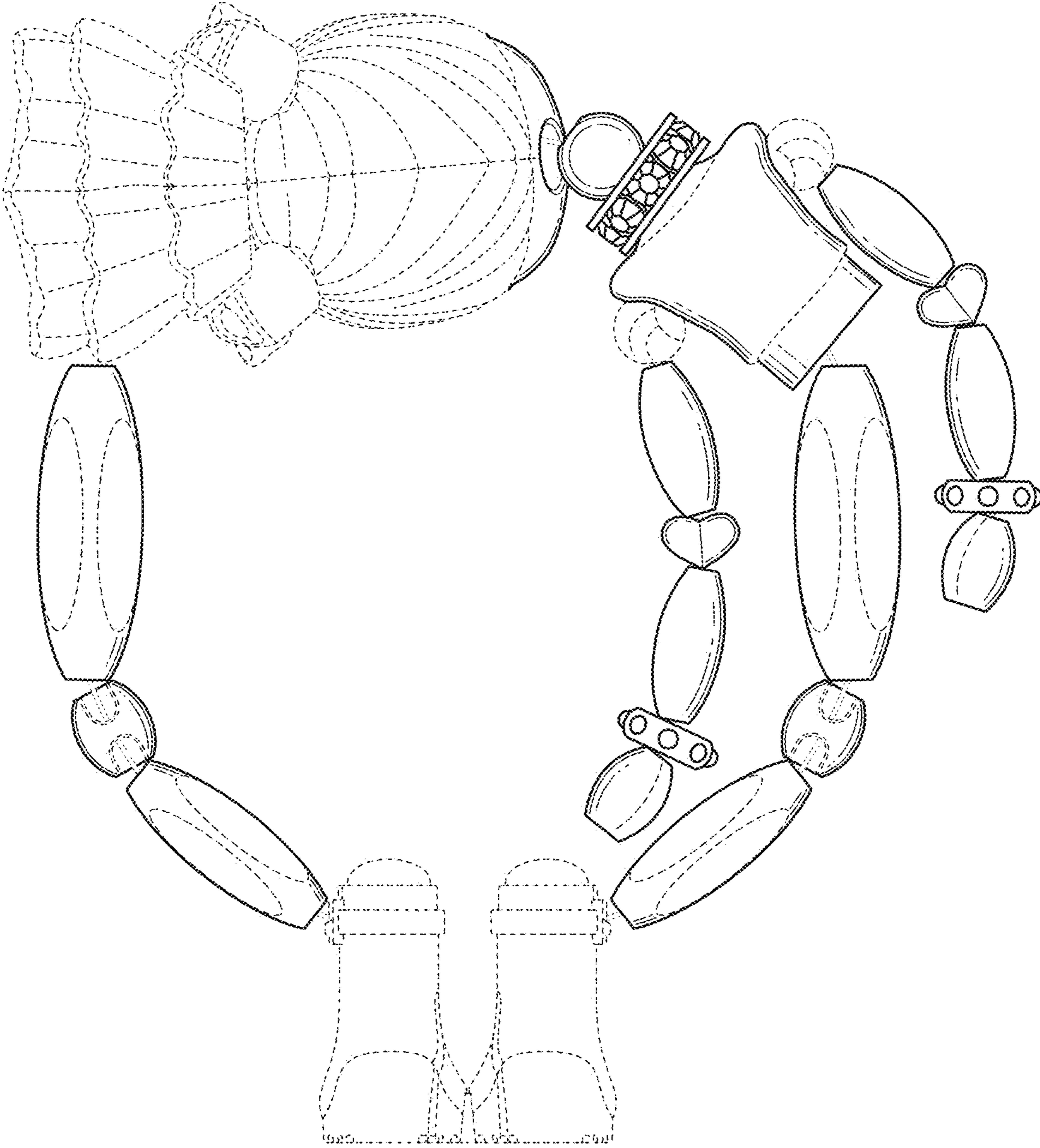

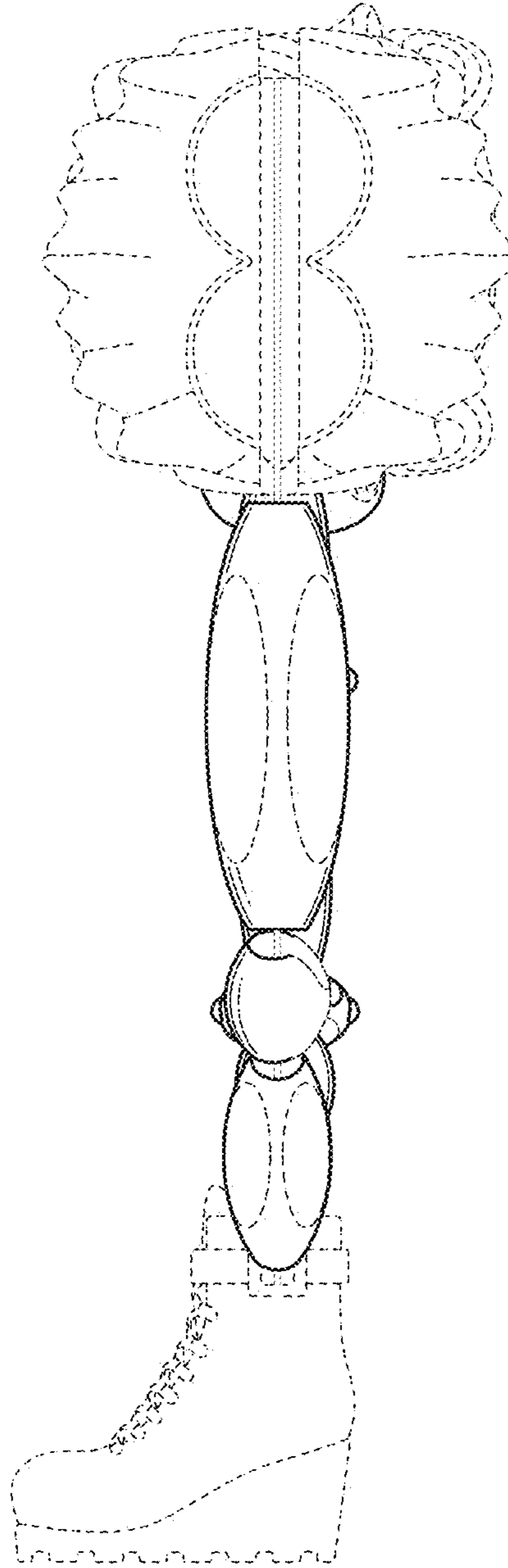

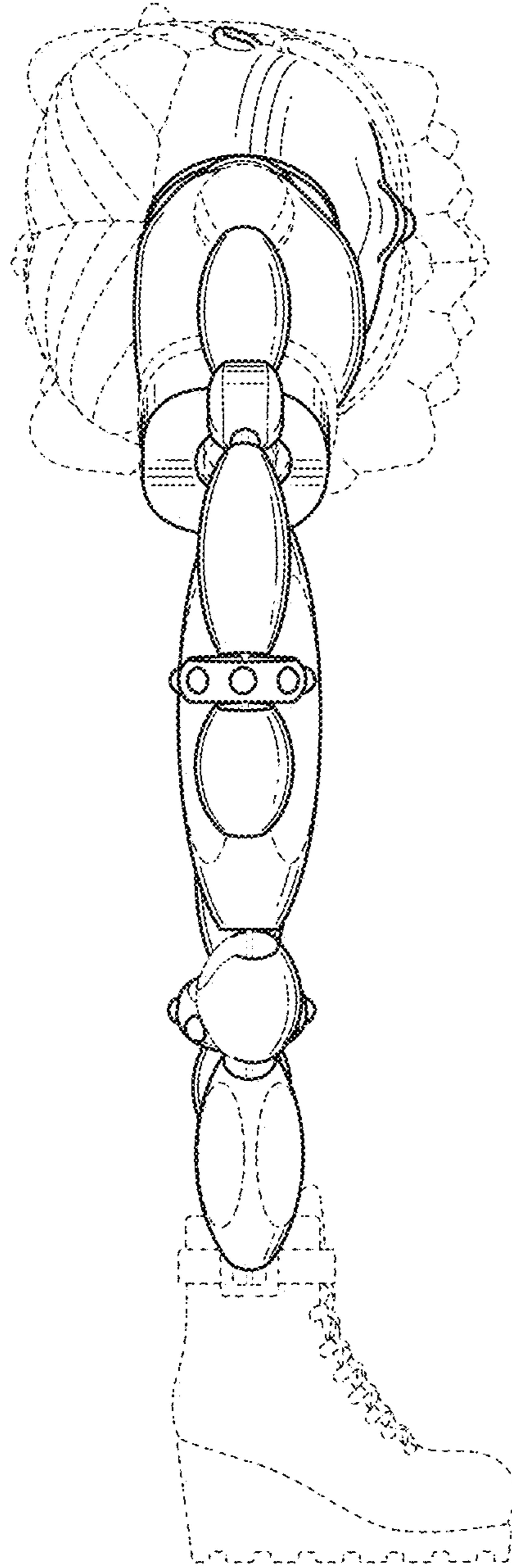

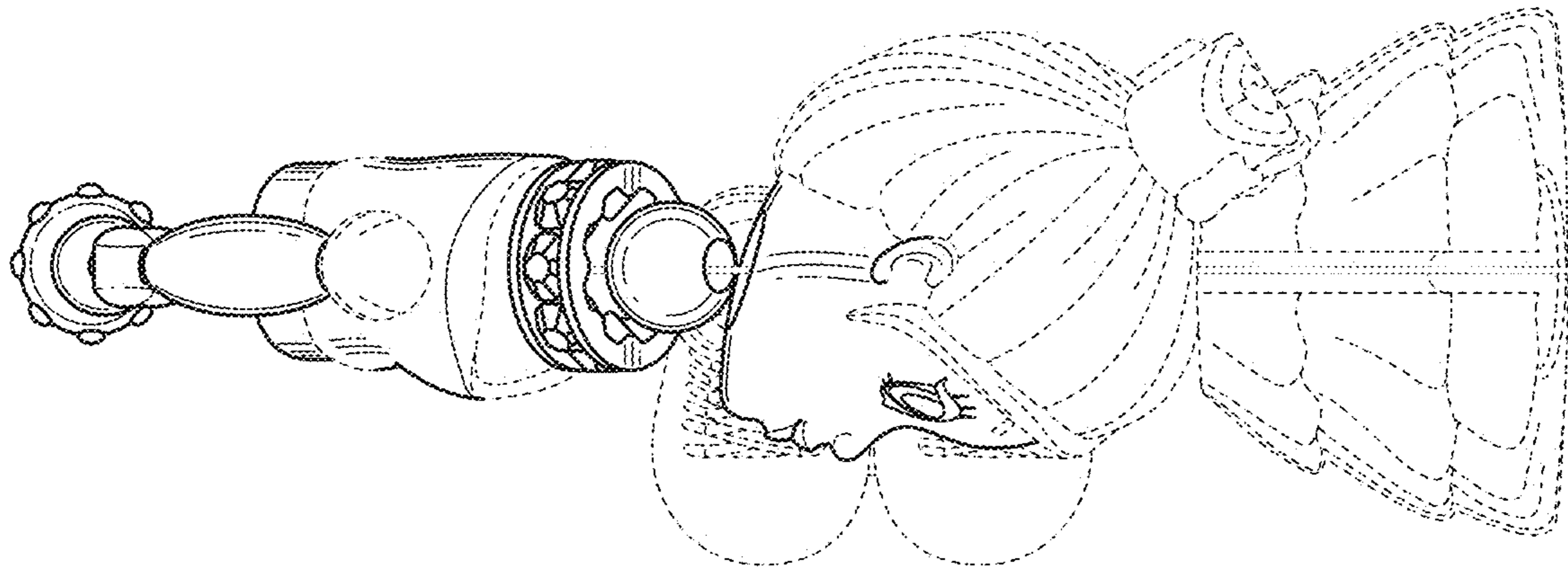

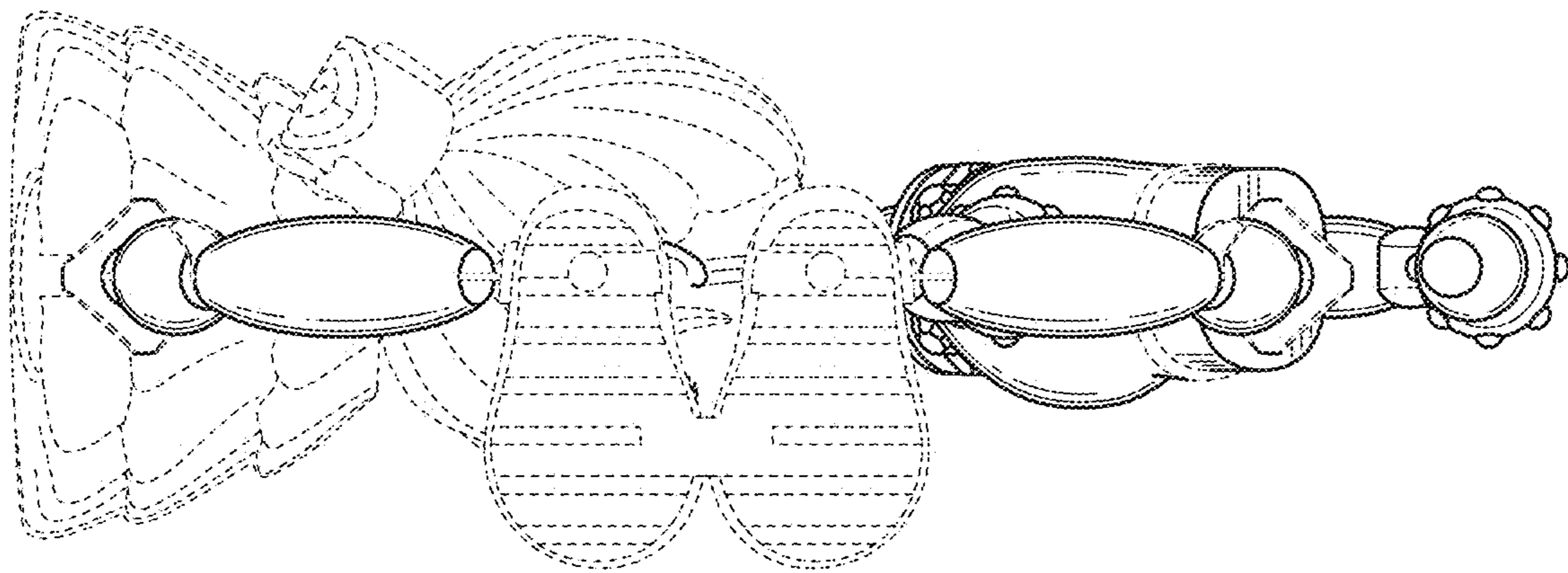
