defined by lines 8-8 and 8'-8'.

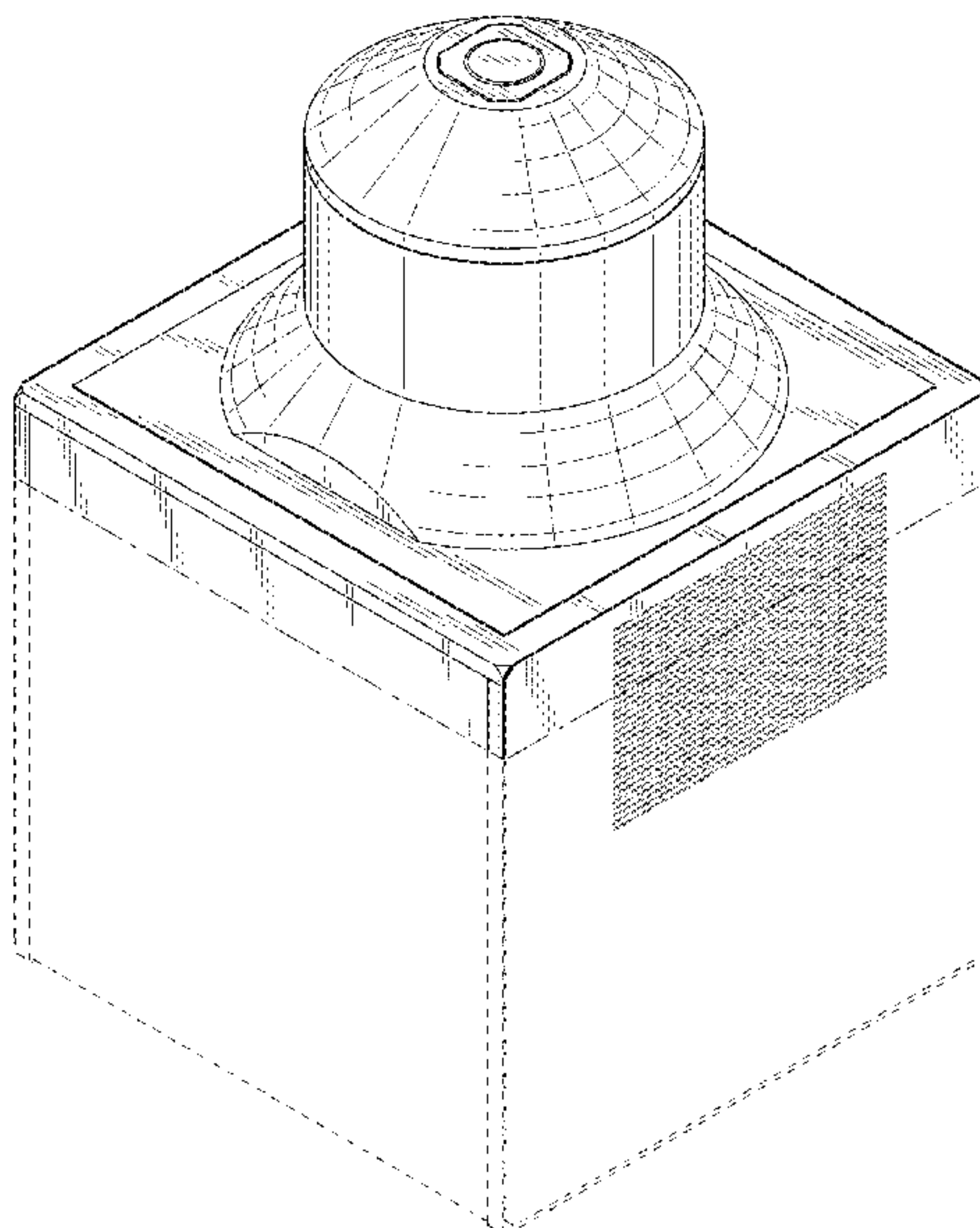

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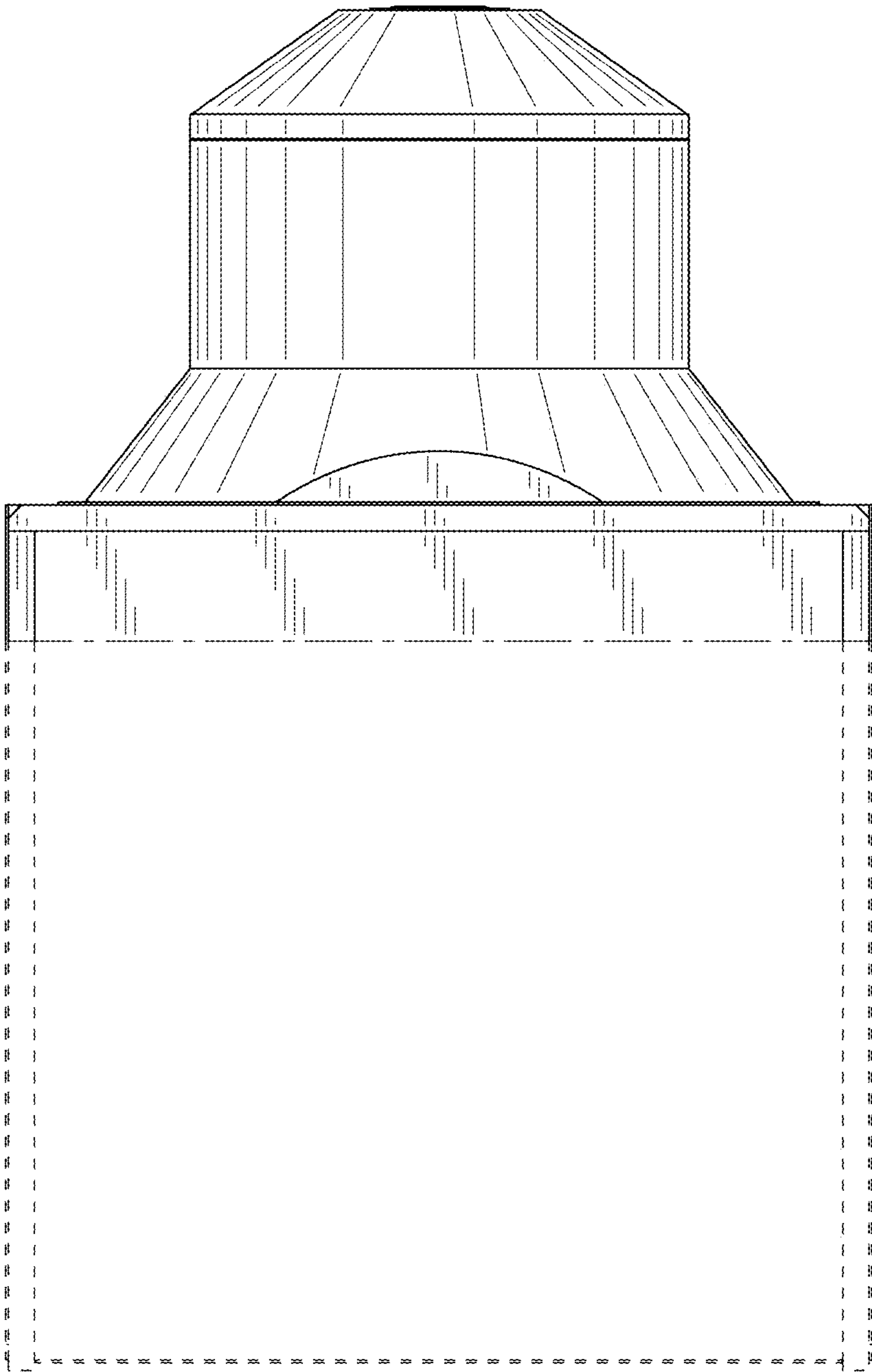

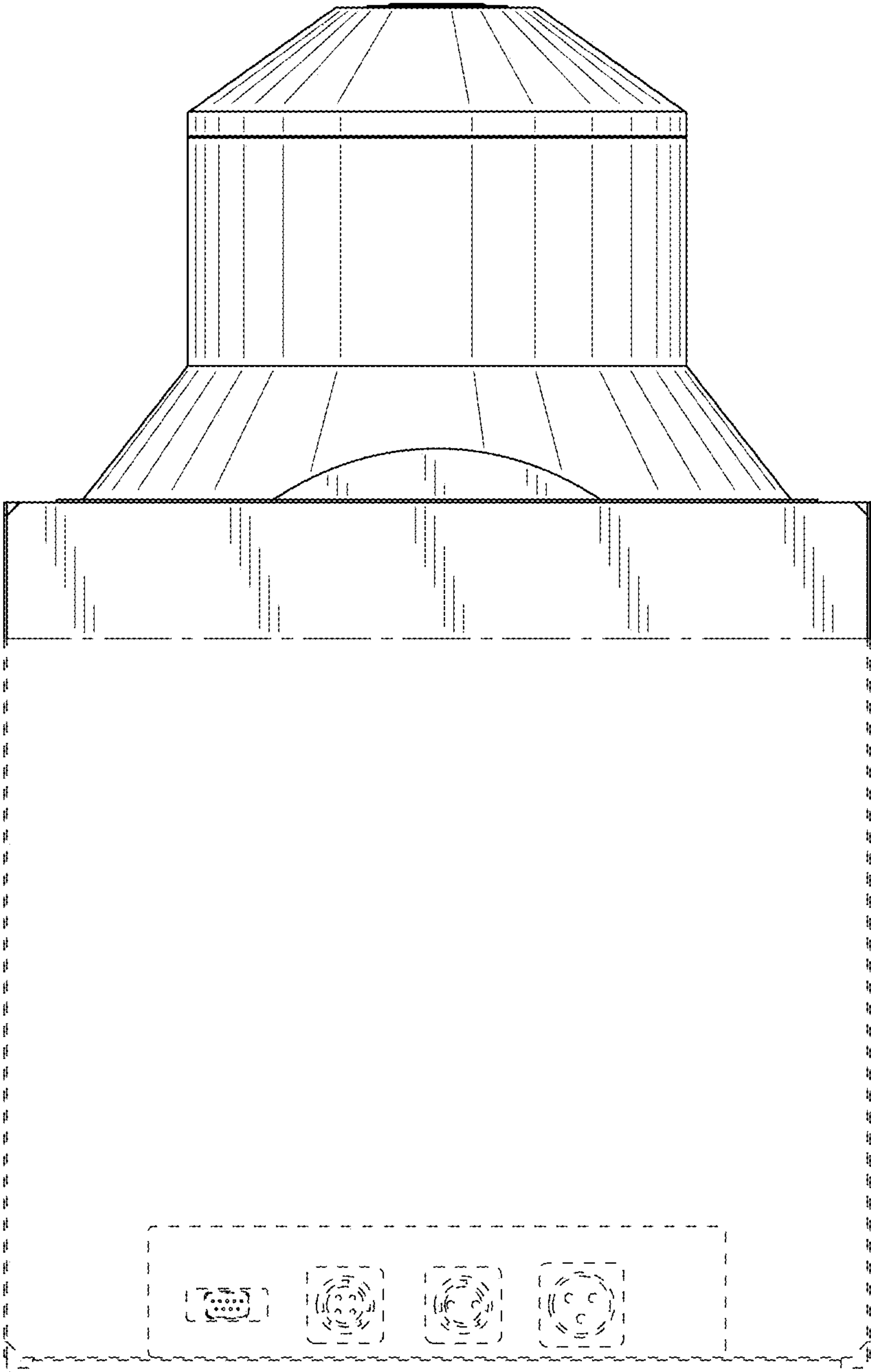

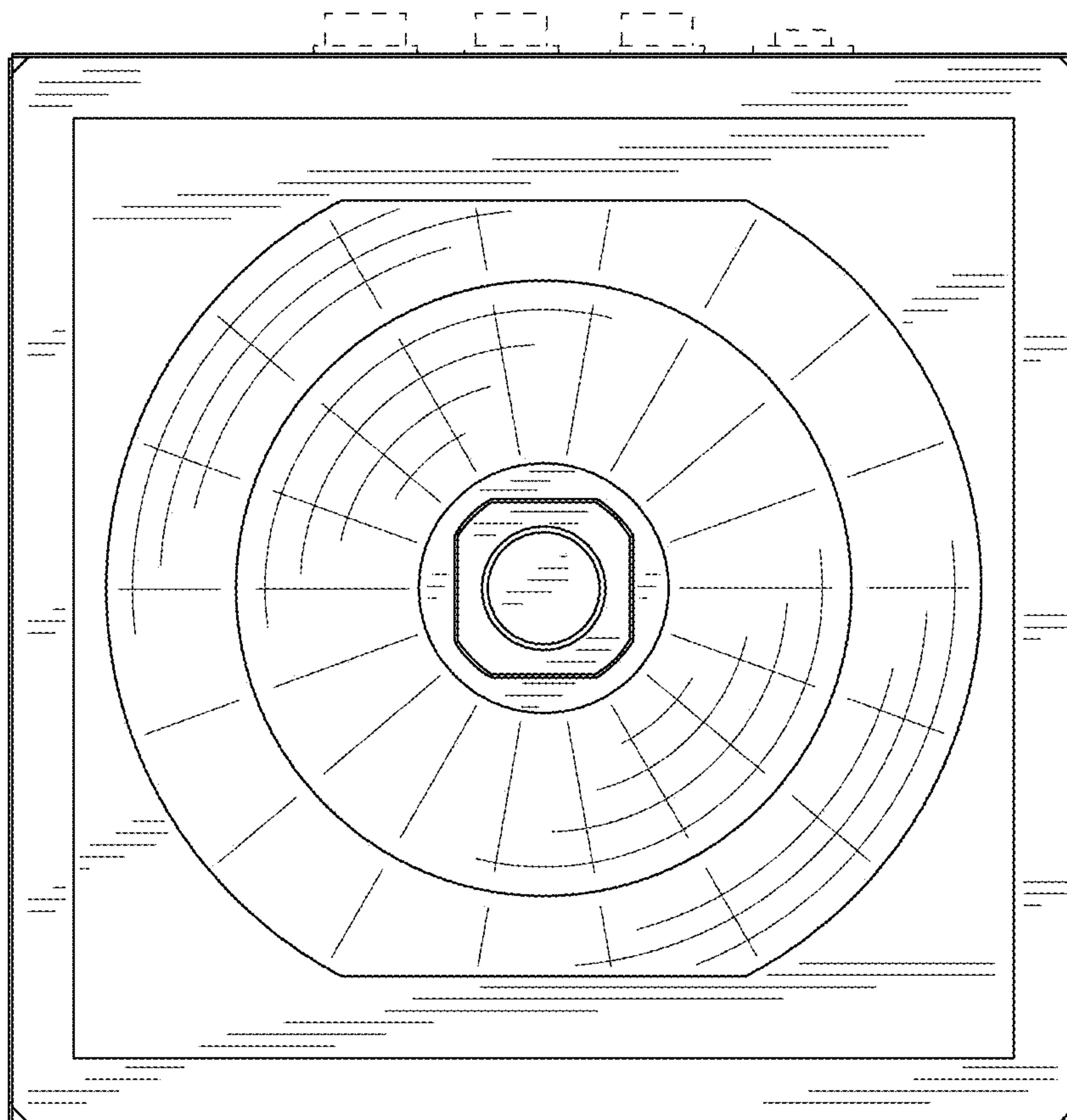

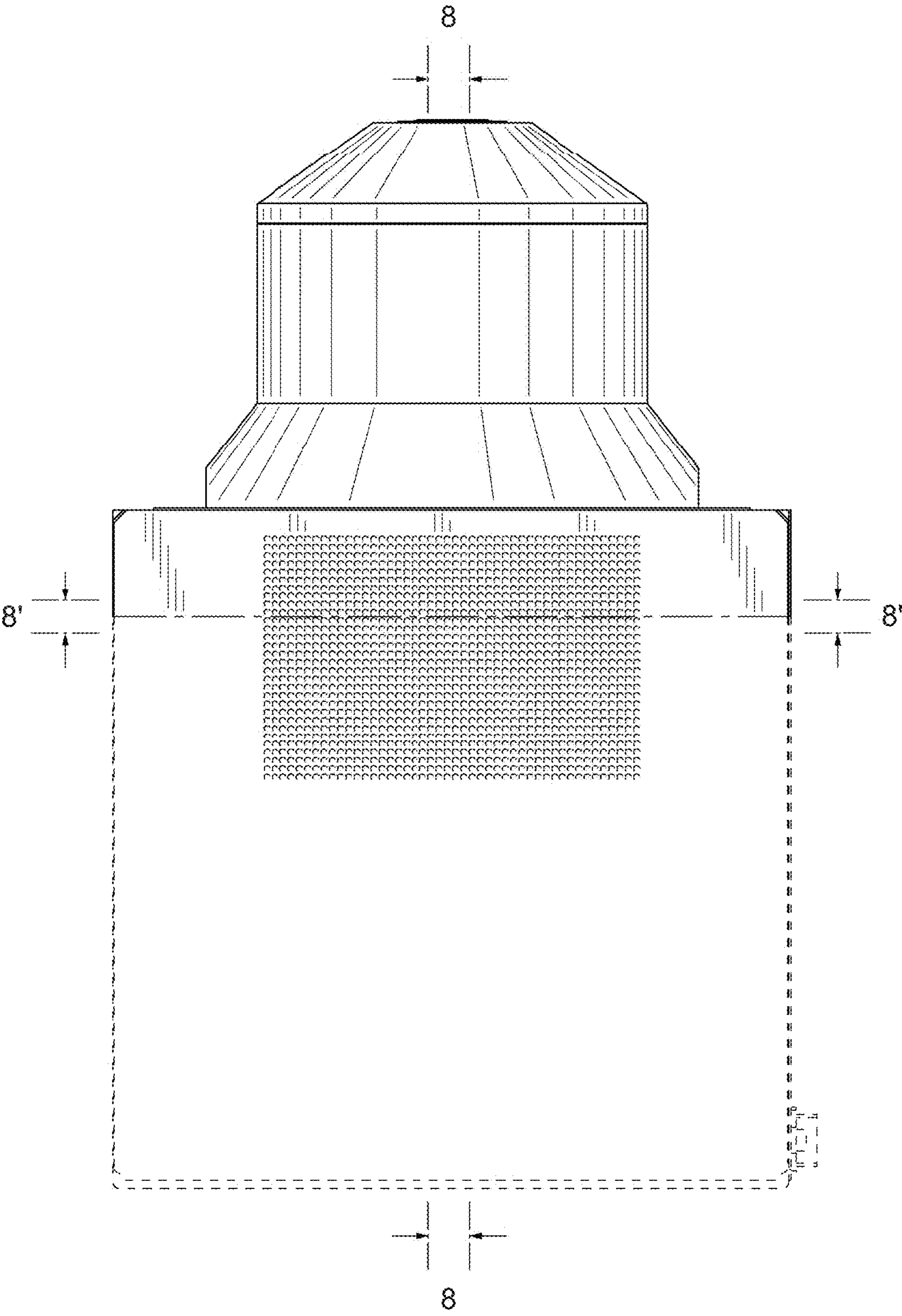

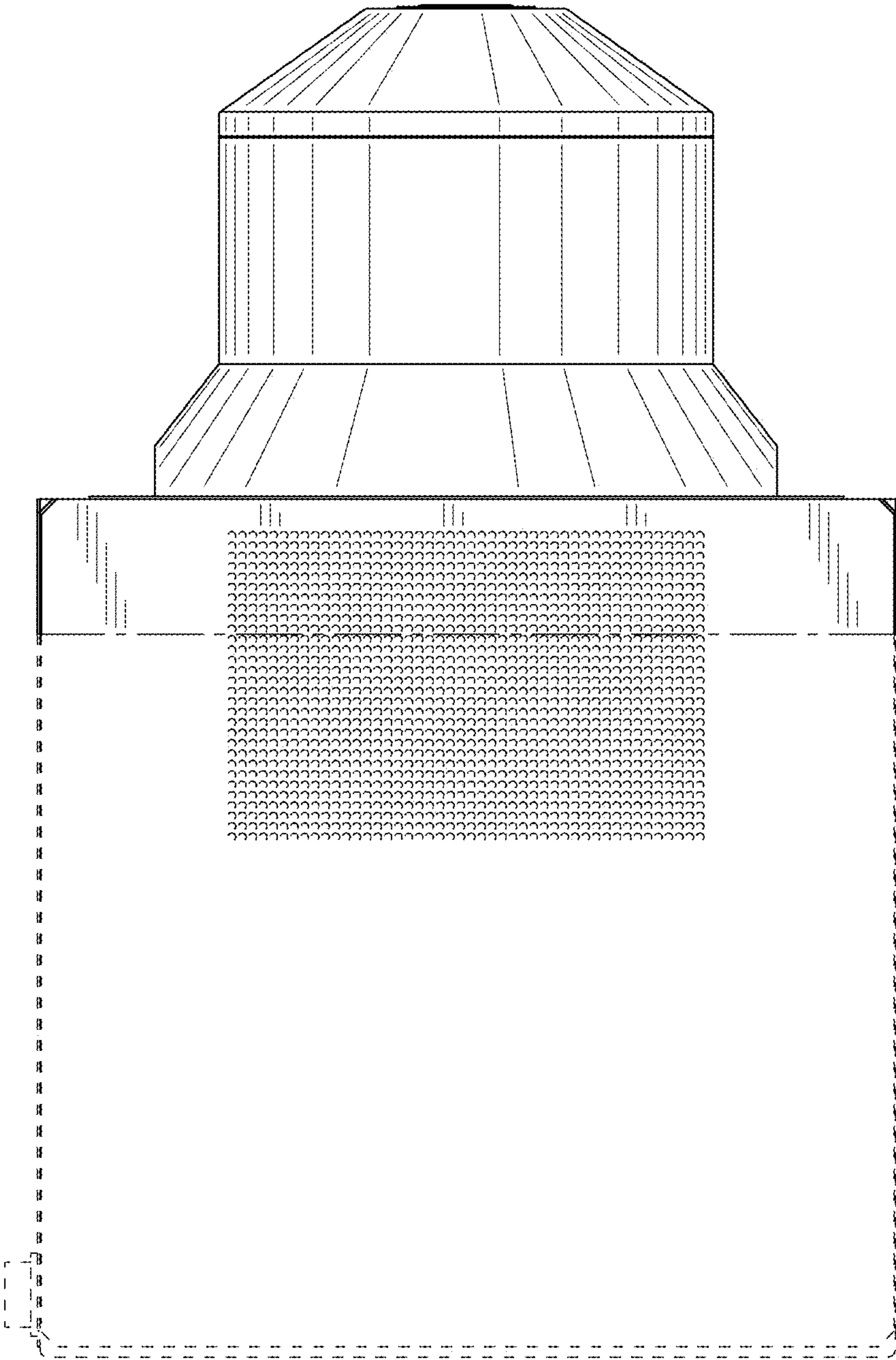

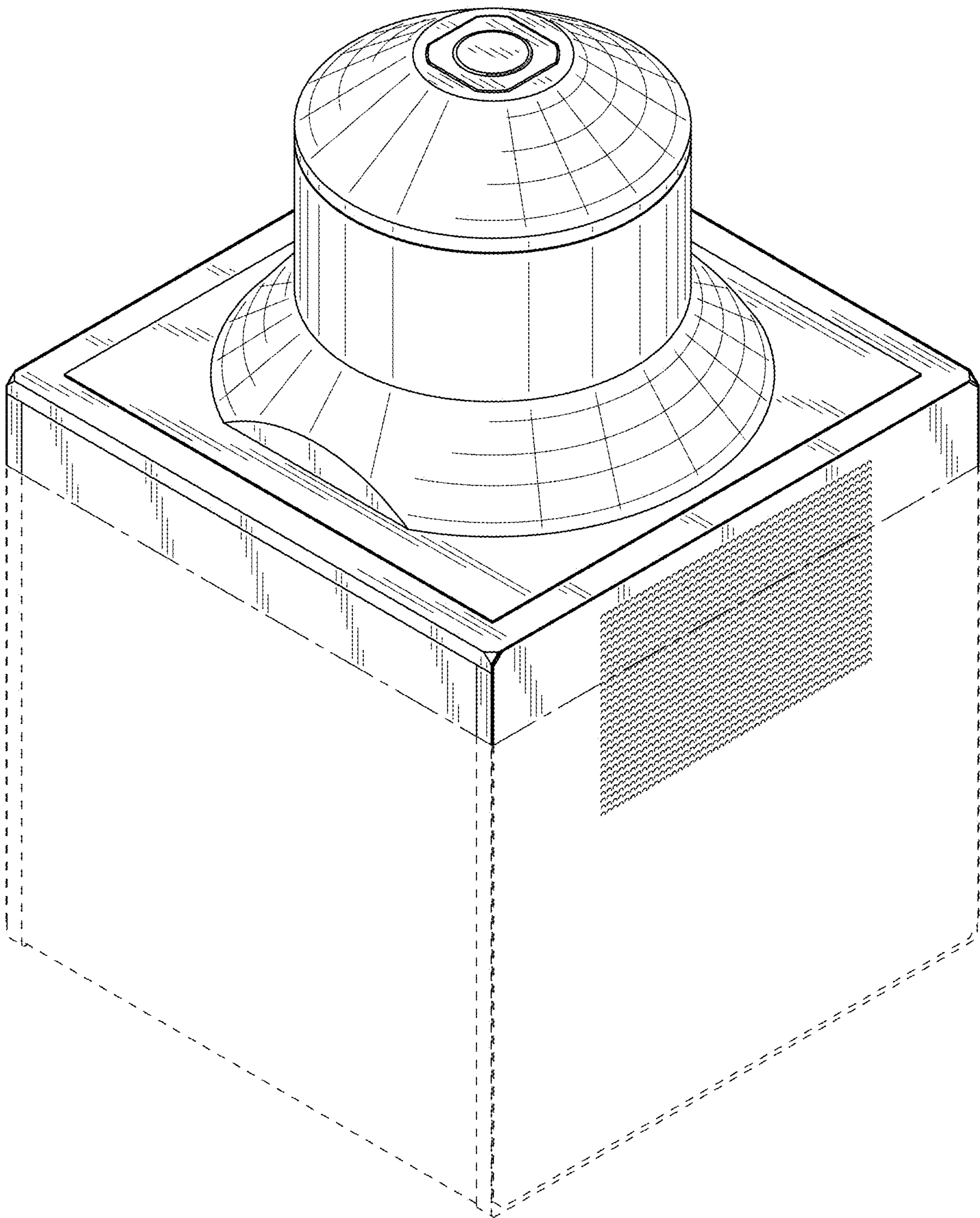

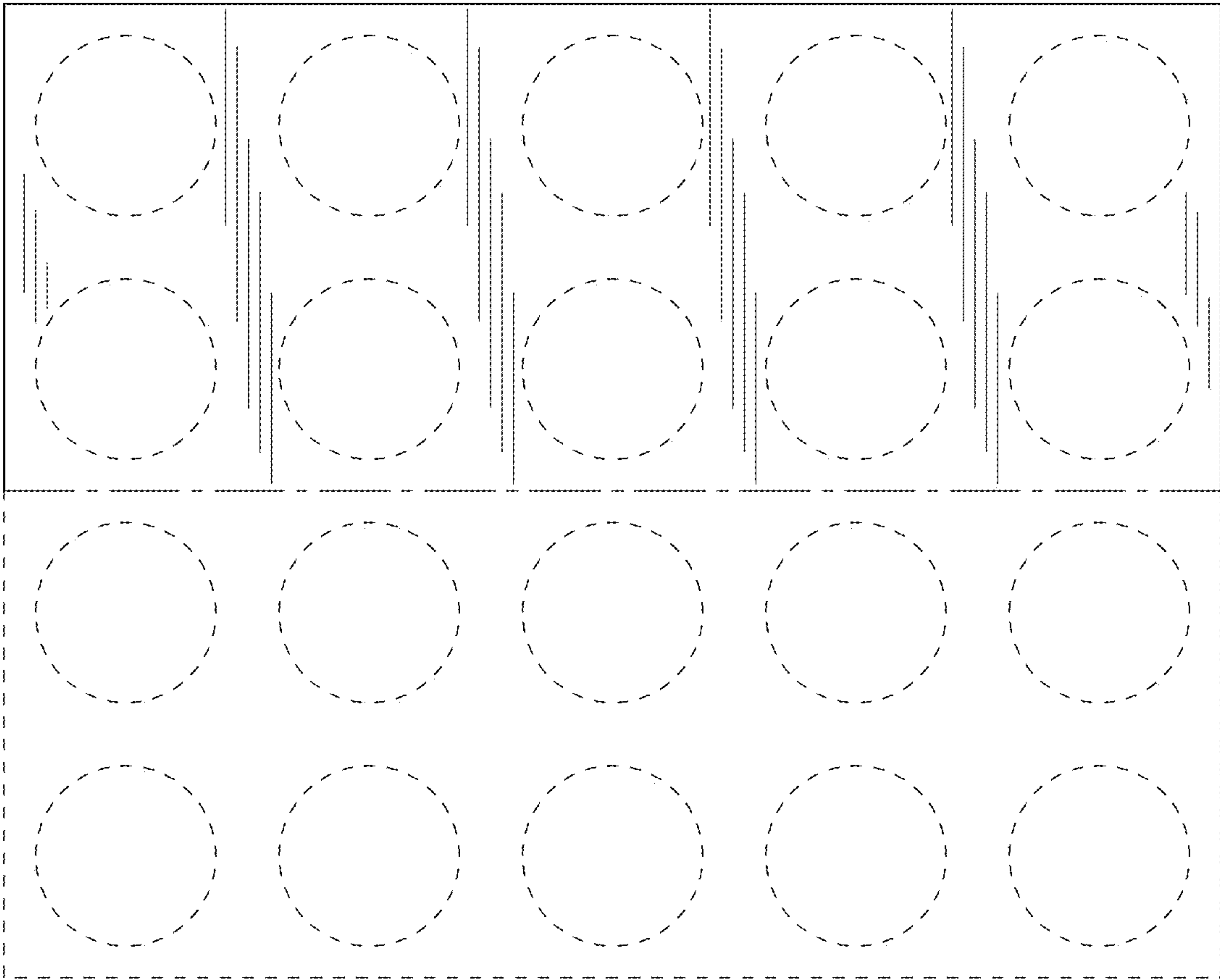
