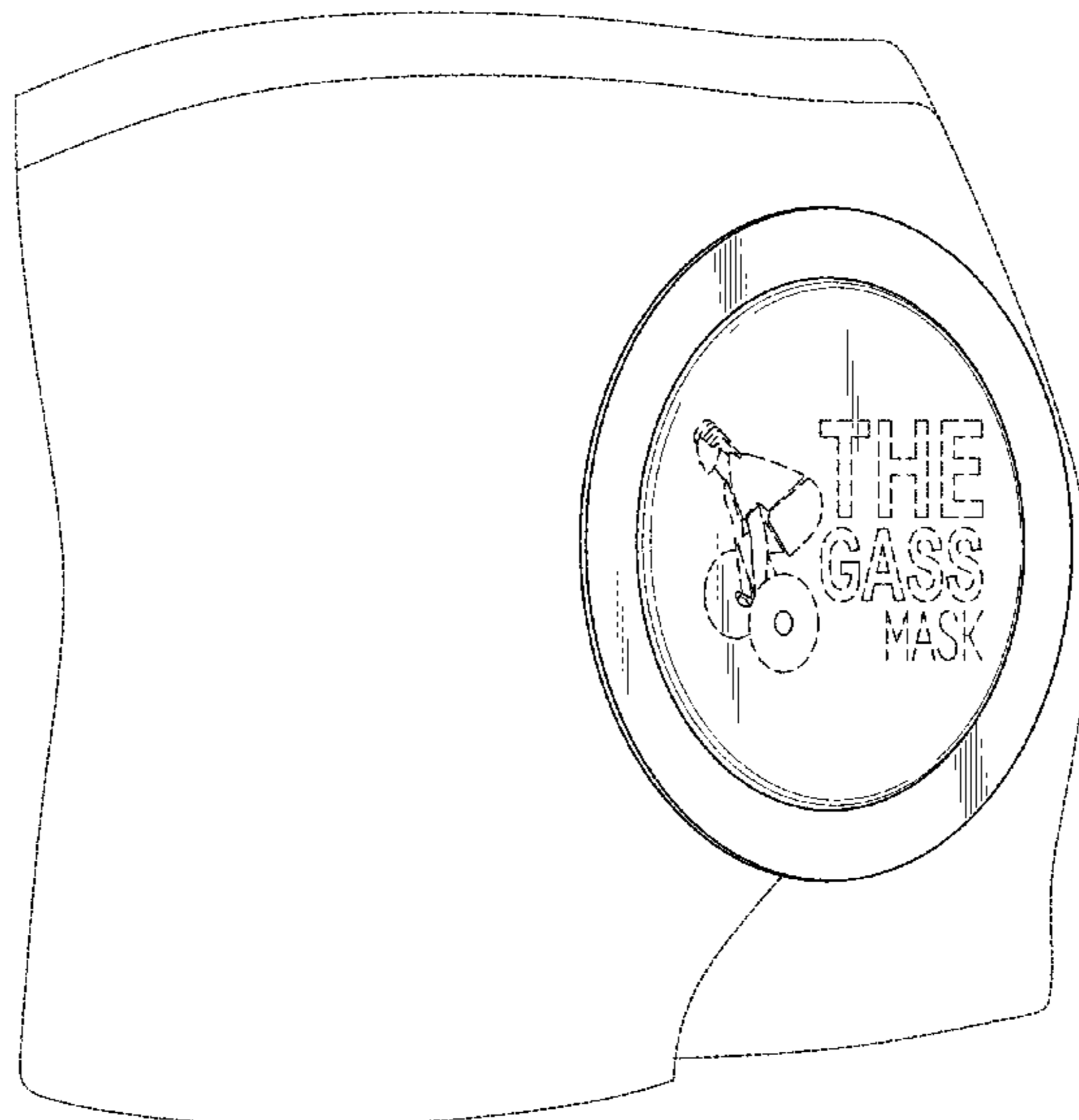
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an odor-absorbing pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

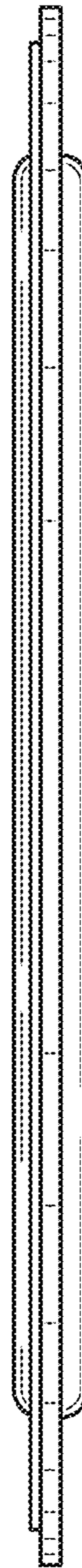

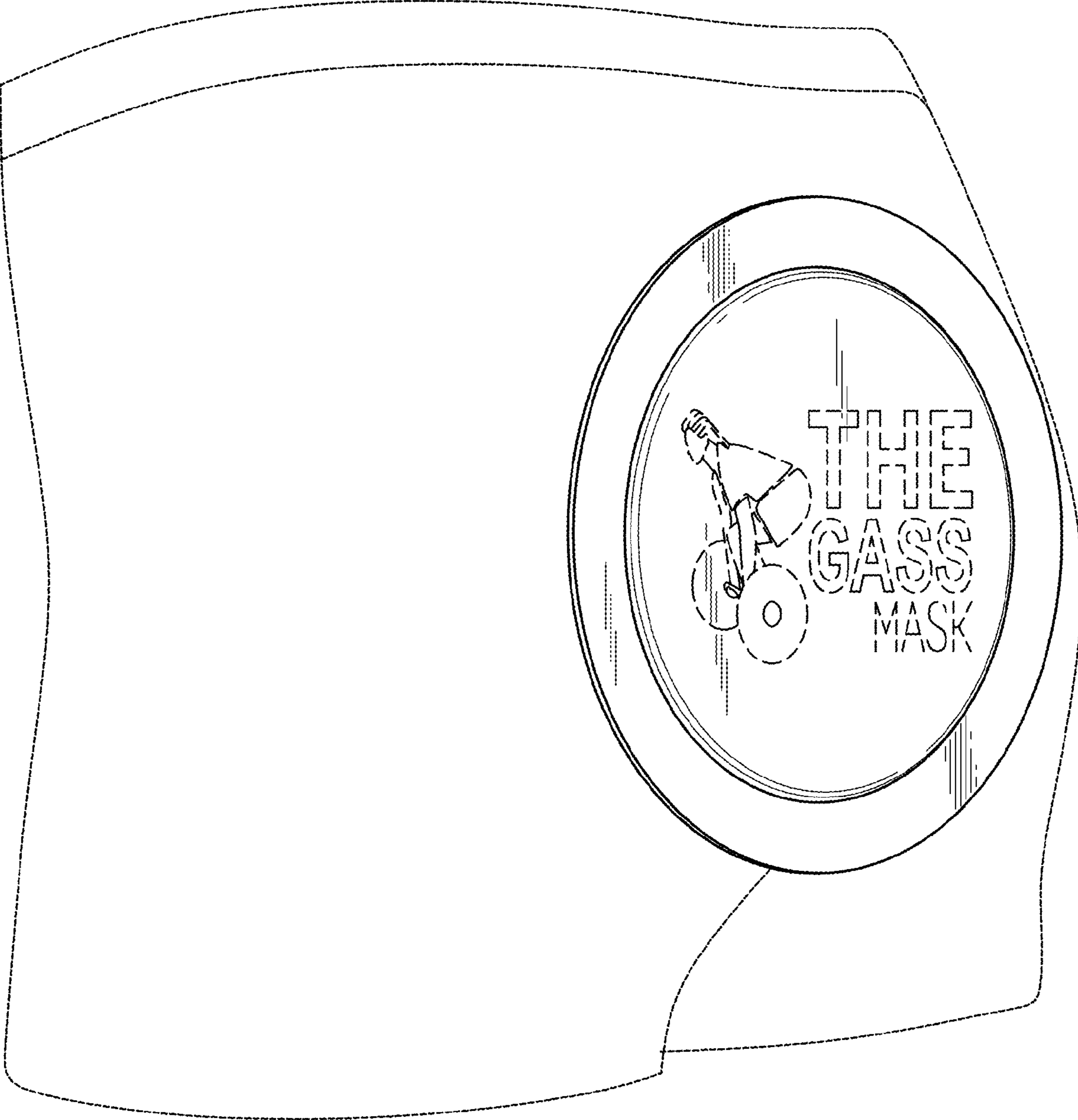
