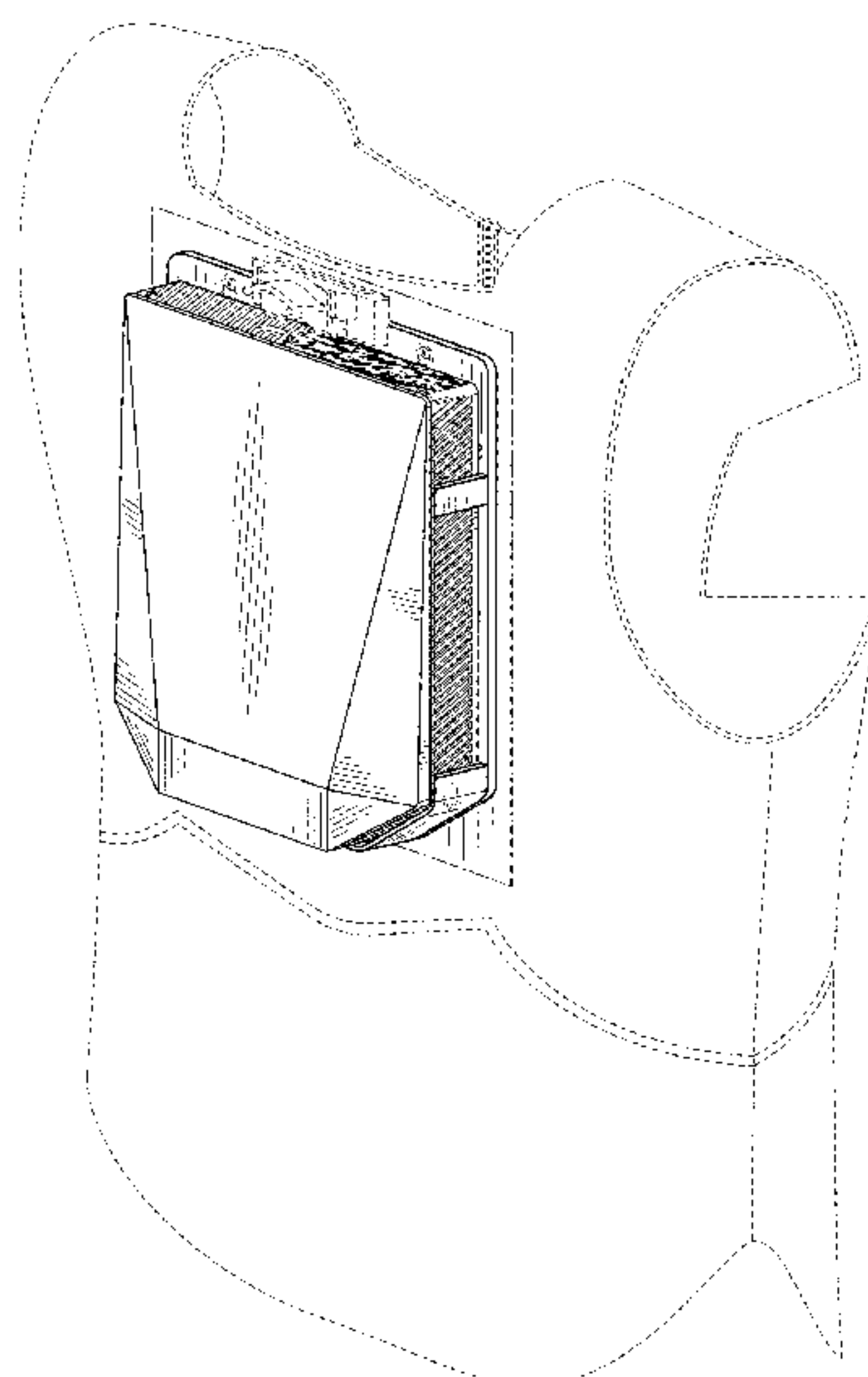
The ornamental design for a wearable device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a back-left-perspective view of a wearable device;
FIG. 2 is a back view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left-side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right-side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a back-left perspective view thereof, in an alternative operating condition with a computing component of the wearable device shown removed from a frame of the device;
FIG. 9 is a left-side view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a top-right-perspective view of the computing component of the wearable device shown isolated from wearable portion of the wearable device to show aspects of the design that may not be apparent in the other views;
FIG. 11 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a right-side view thereof;
FIG. 14 is a left-side view thereof;
FIG. 15 is a back view thereof; and,
FIG. 16 is a front view thereof.

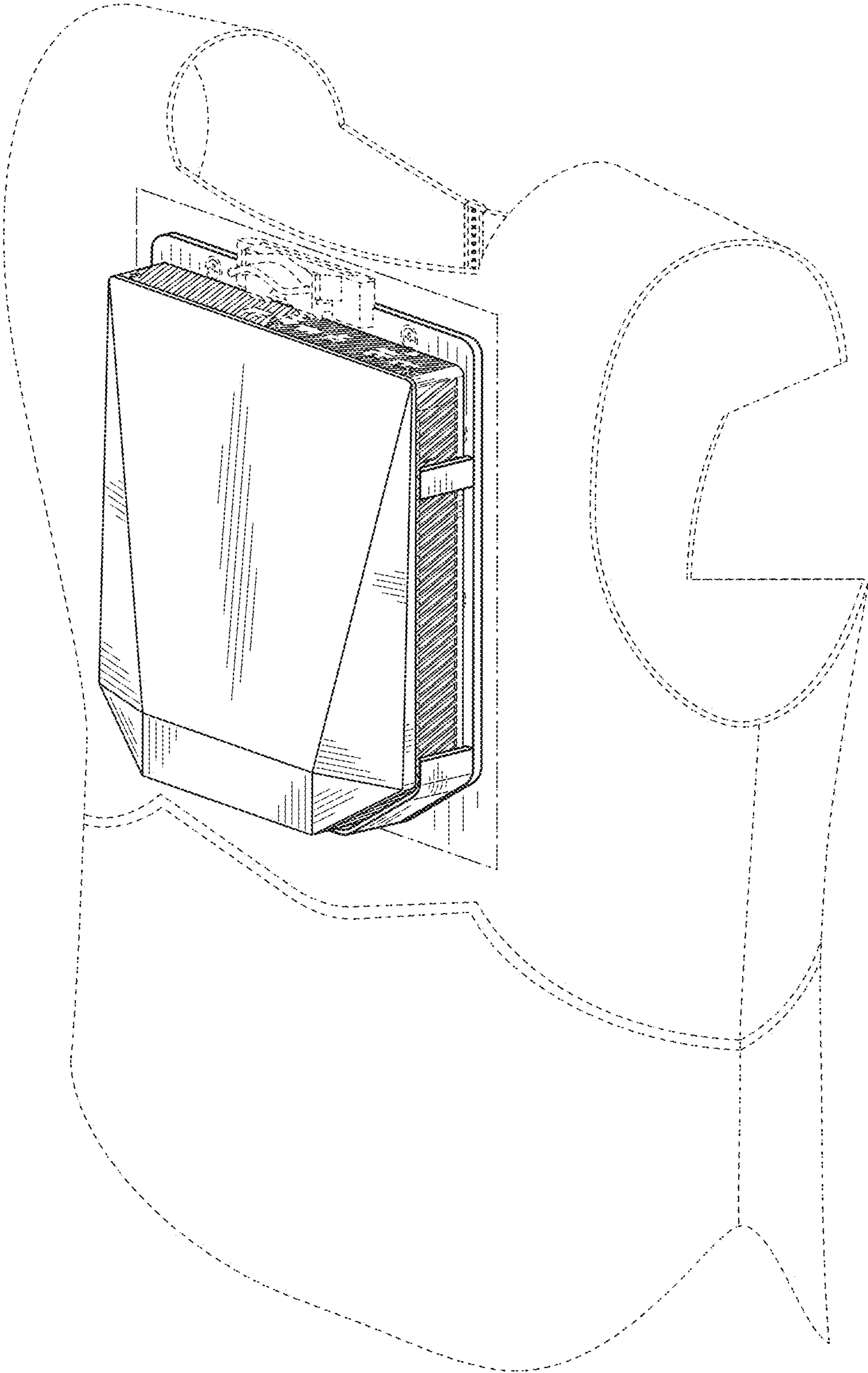

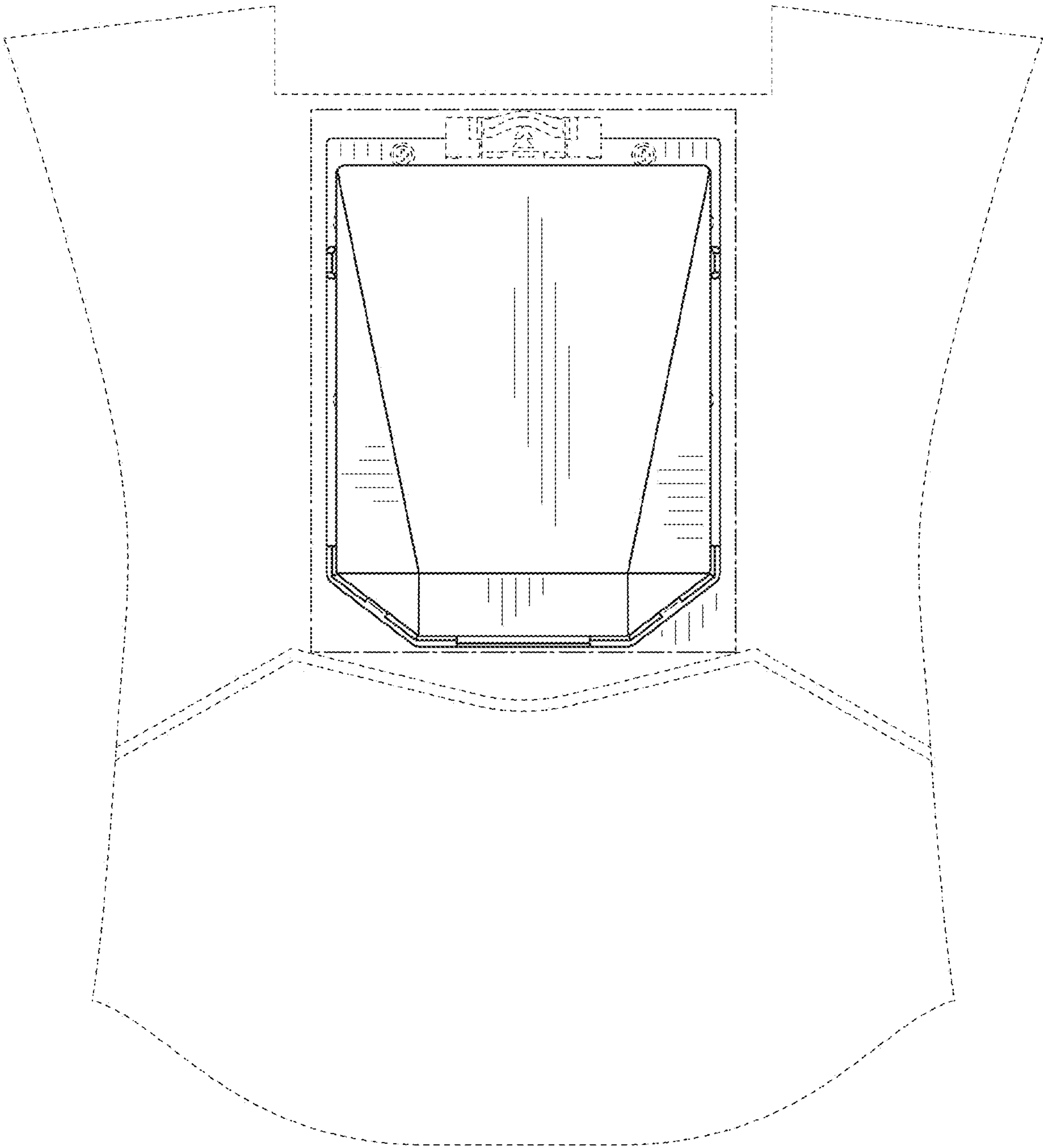

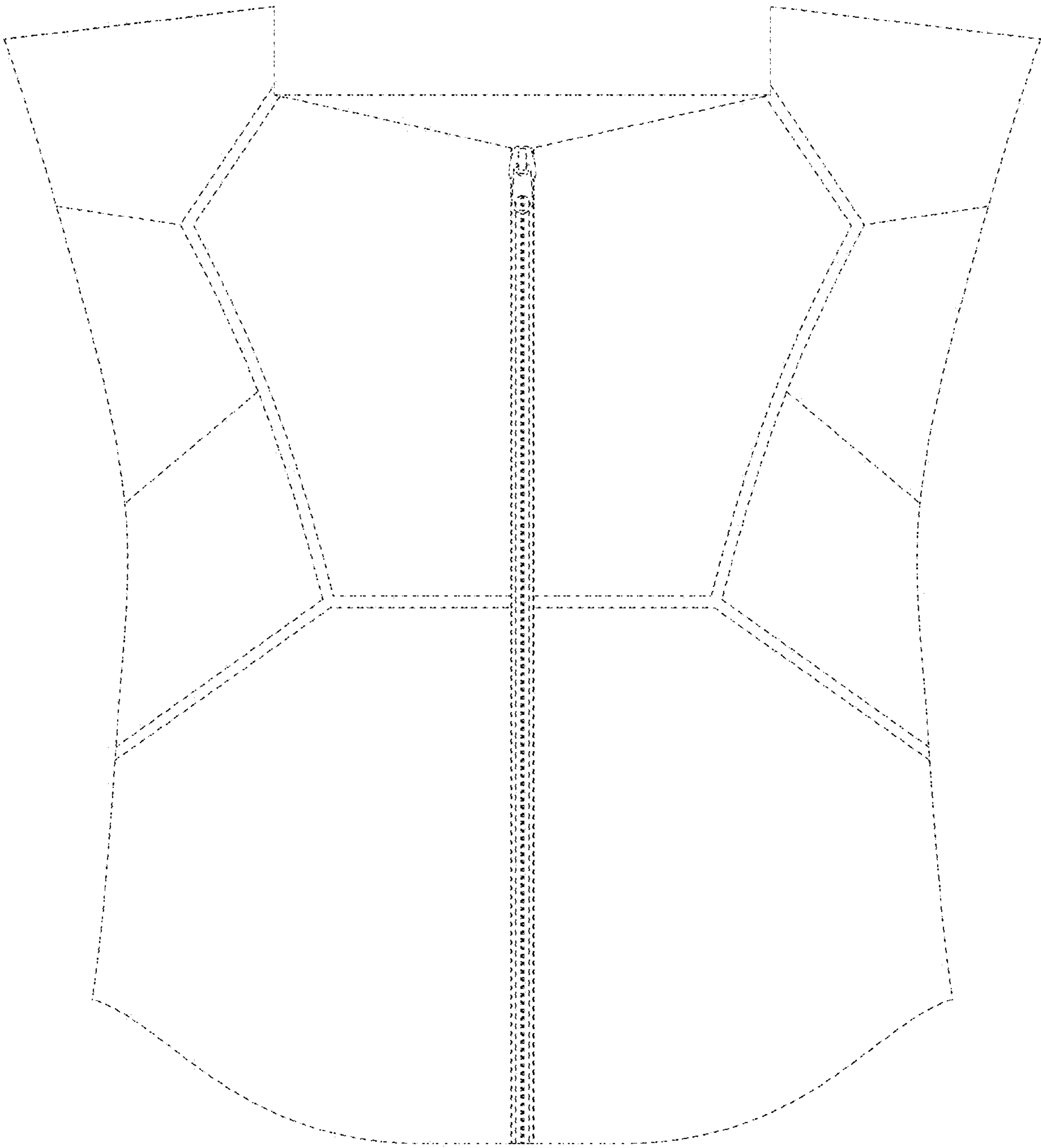

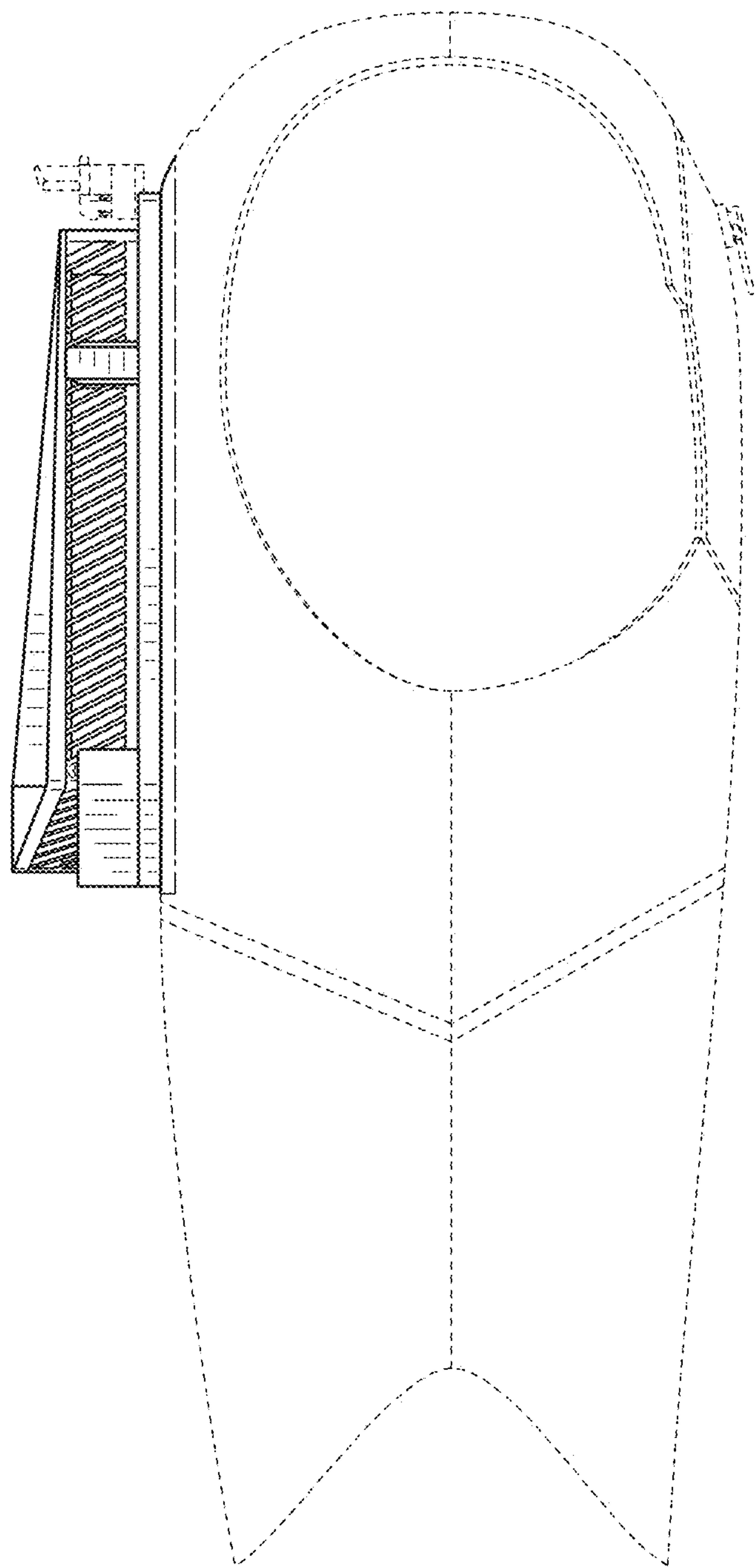

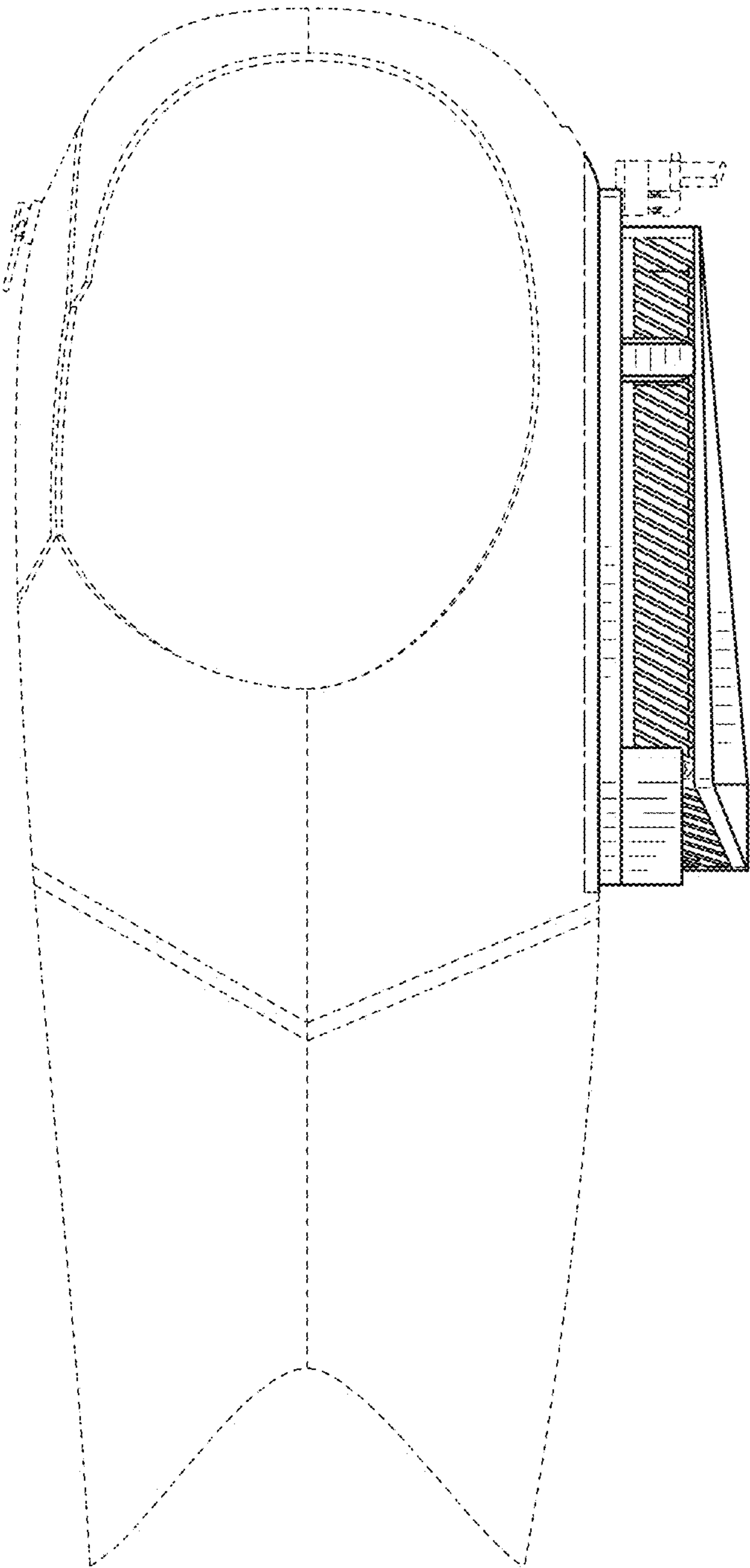

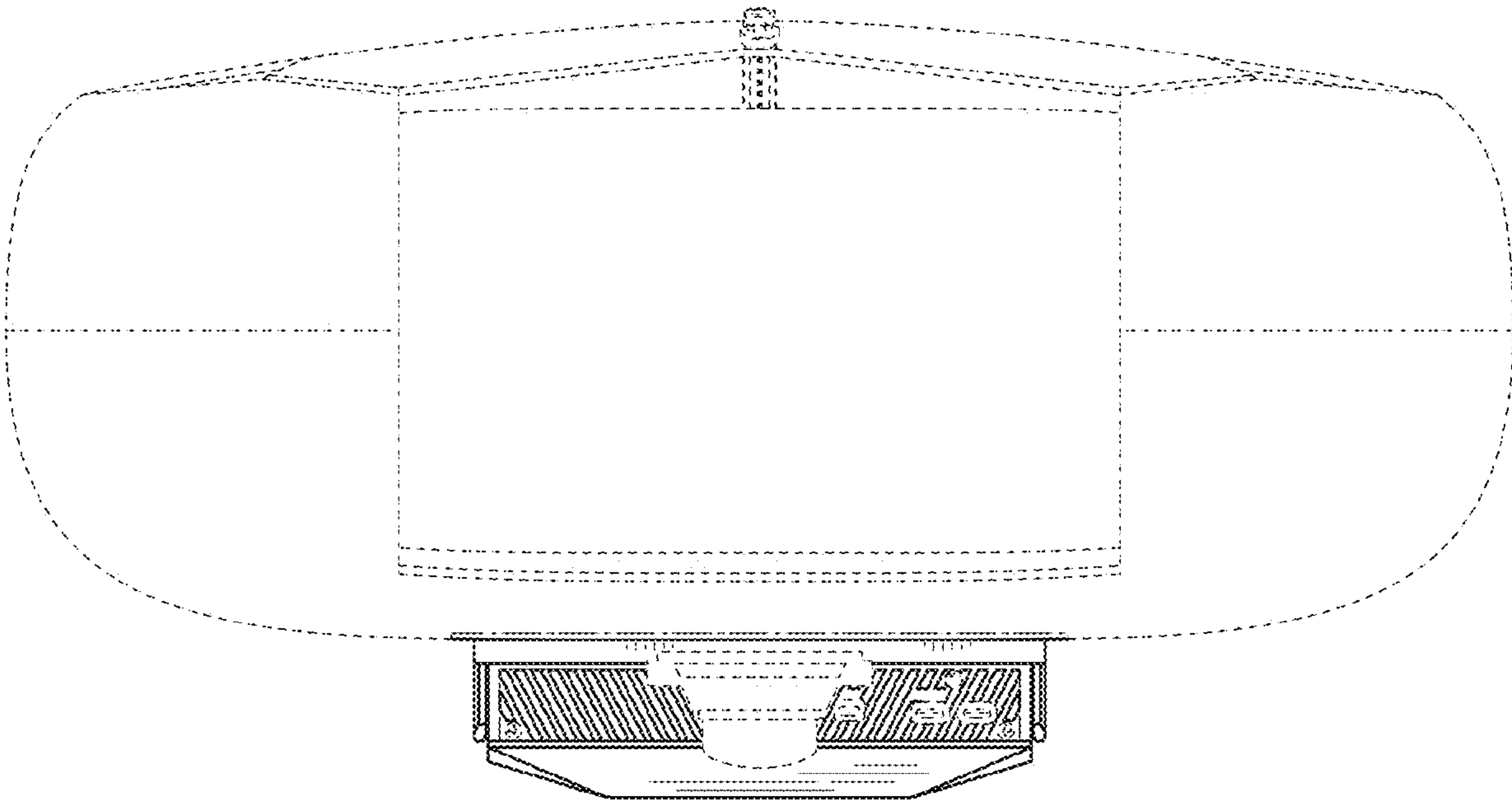

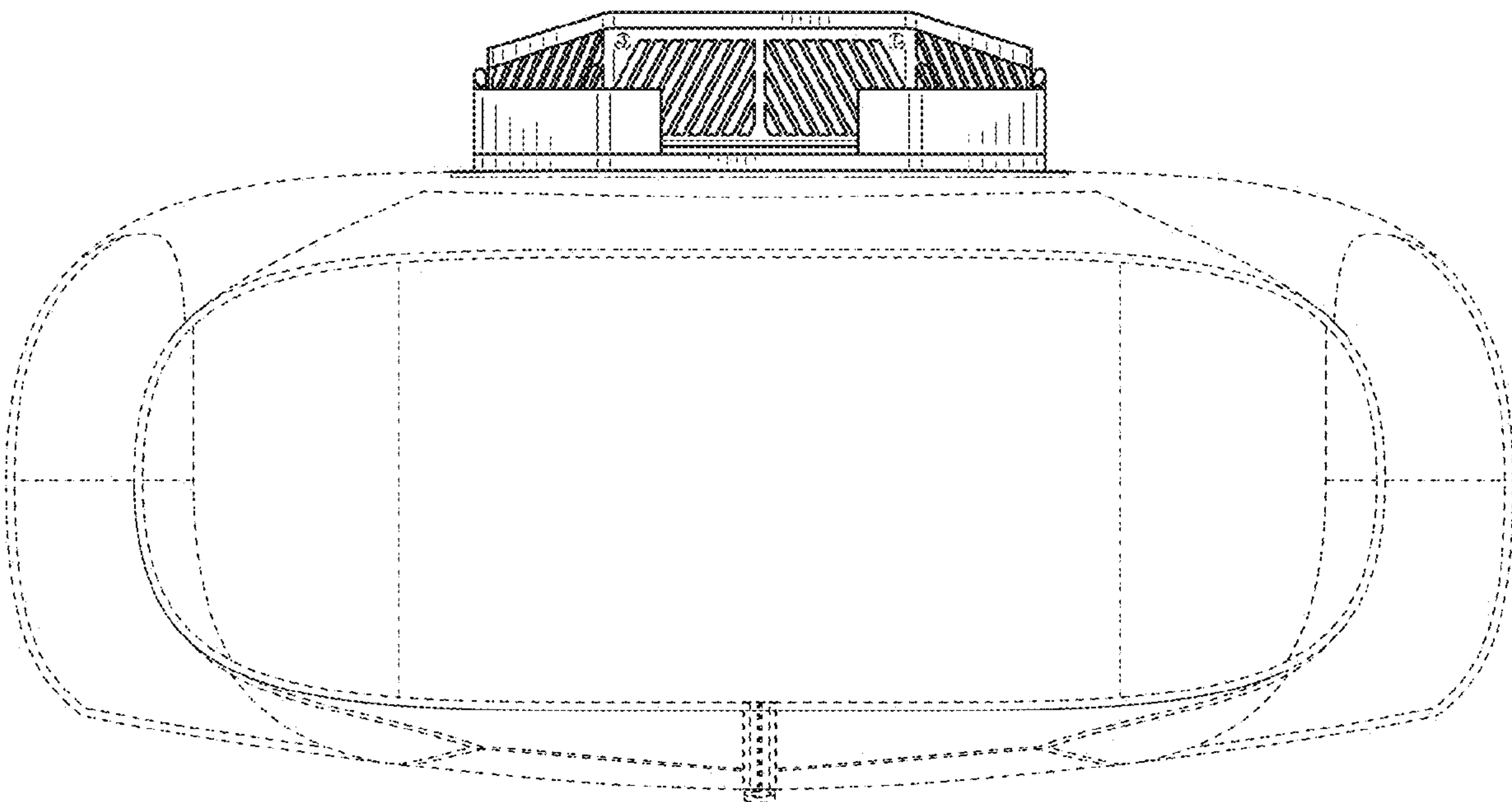

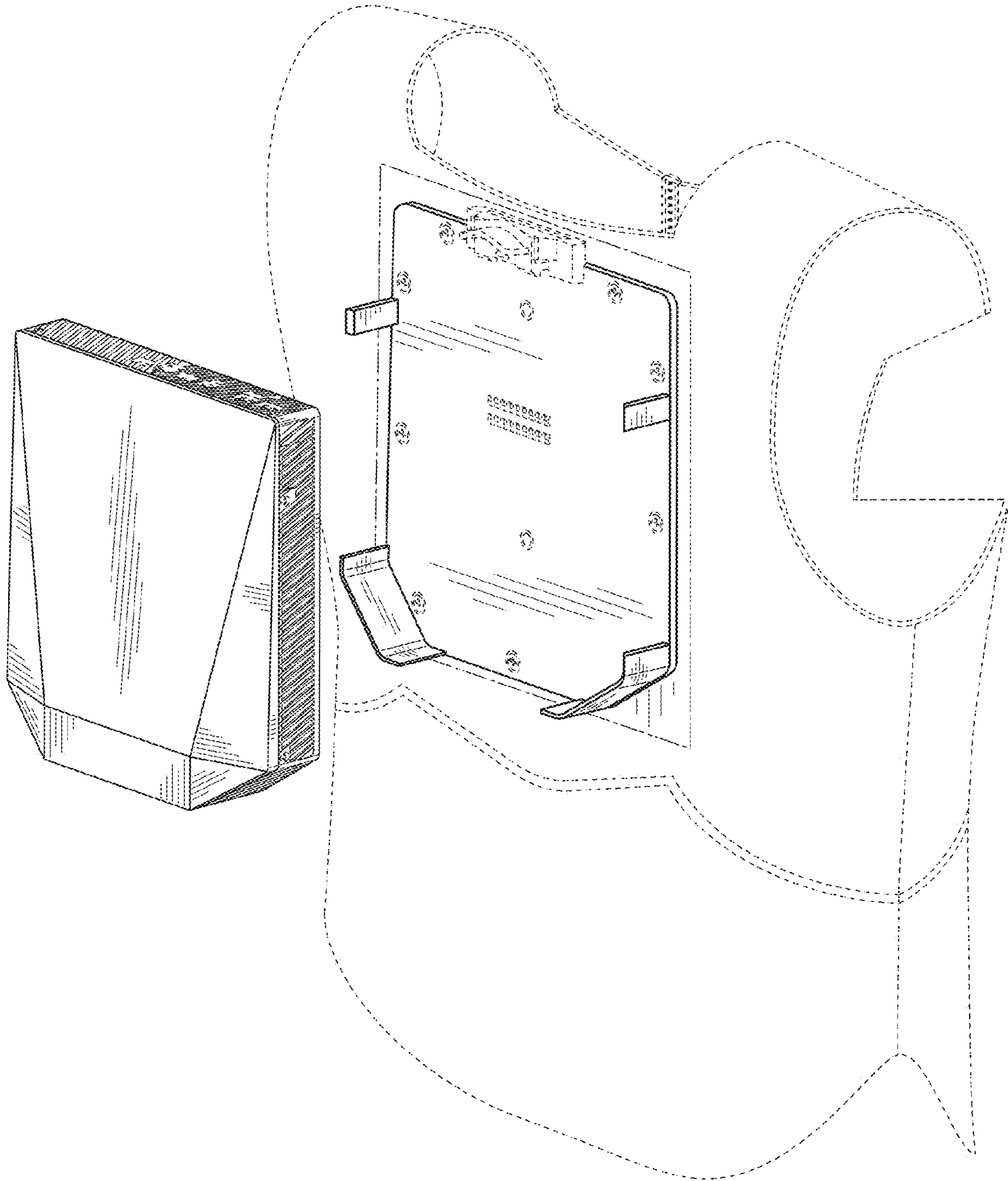

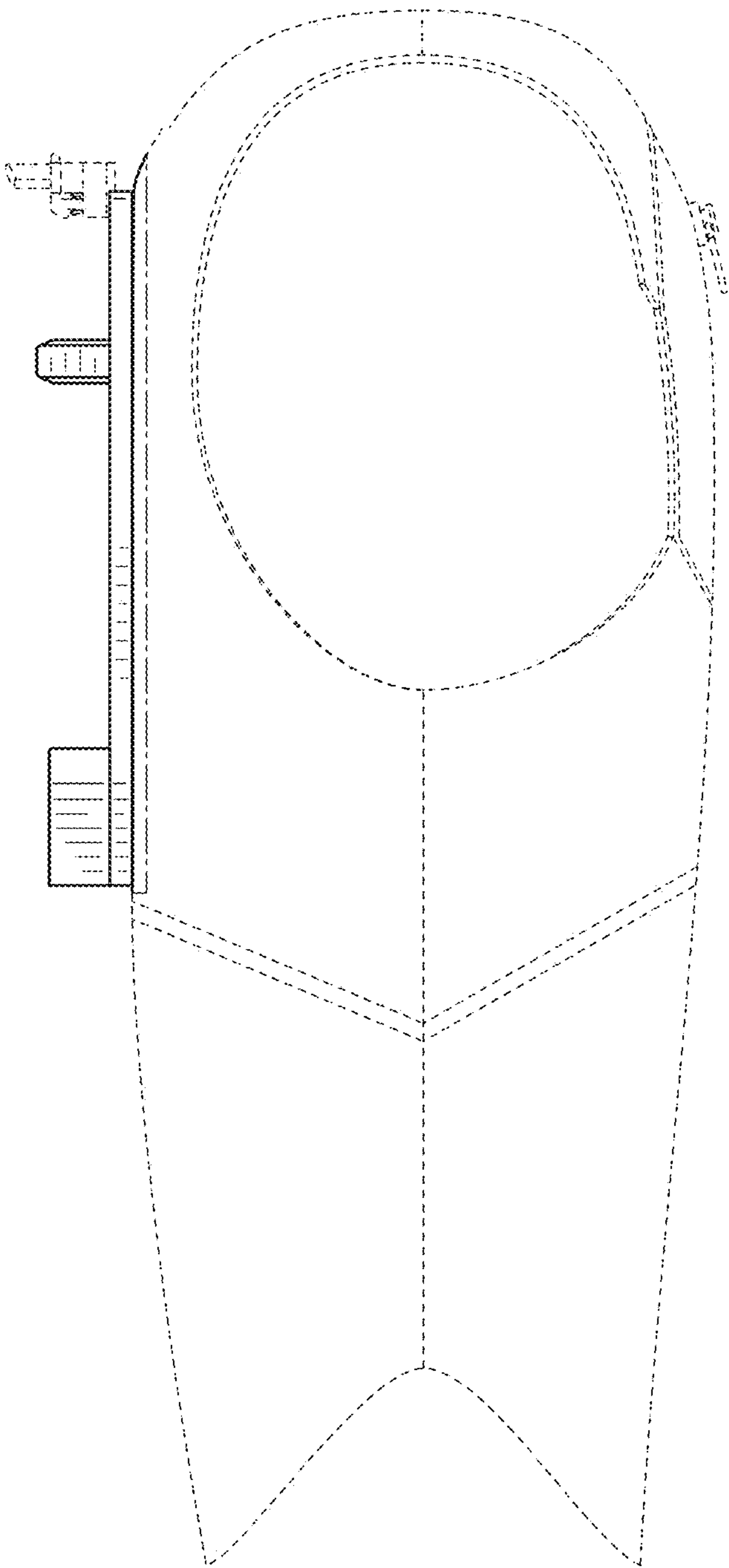
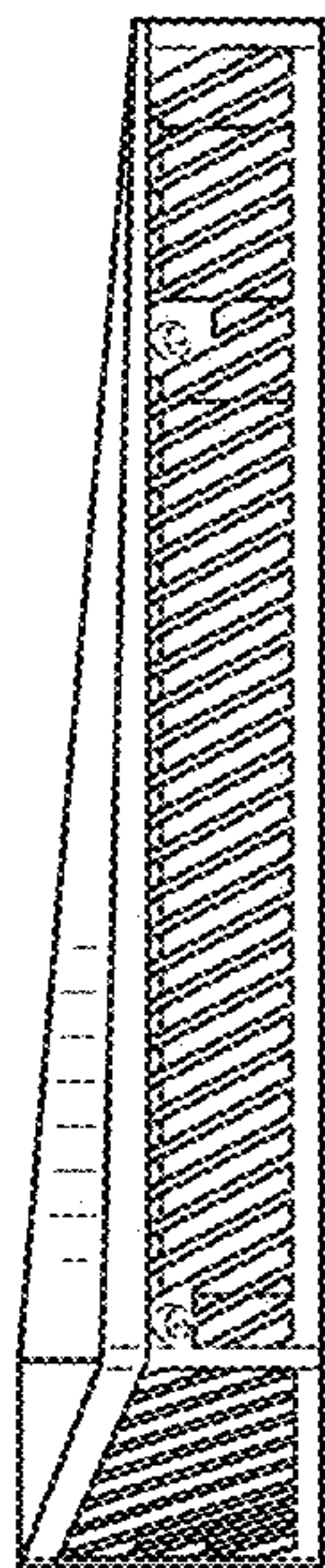

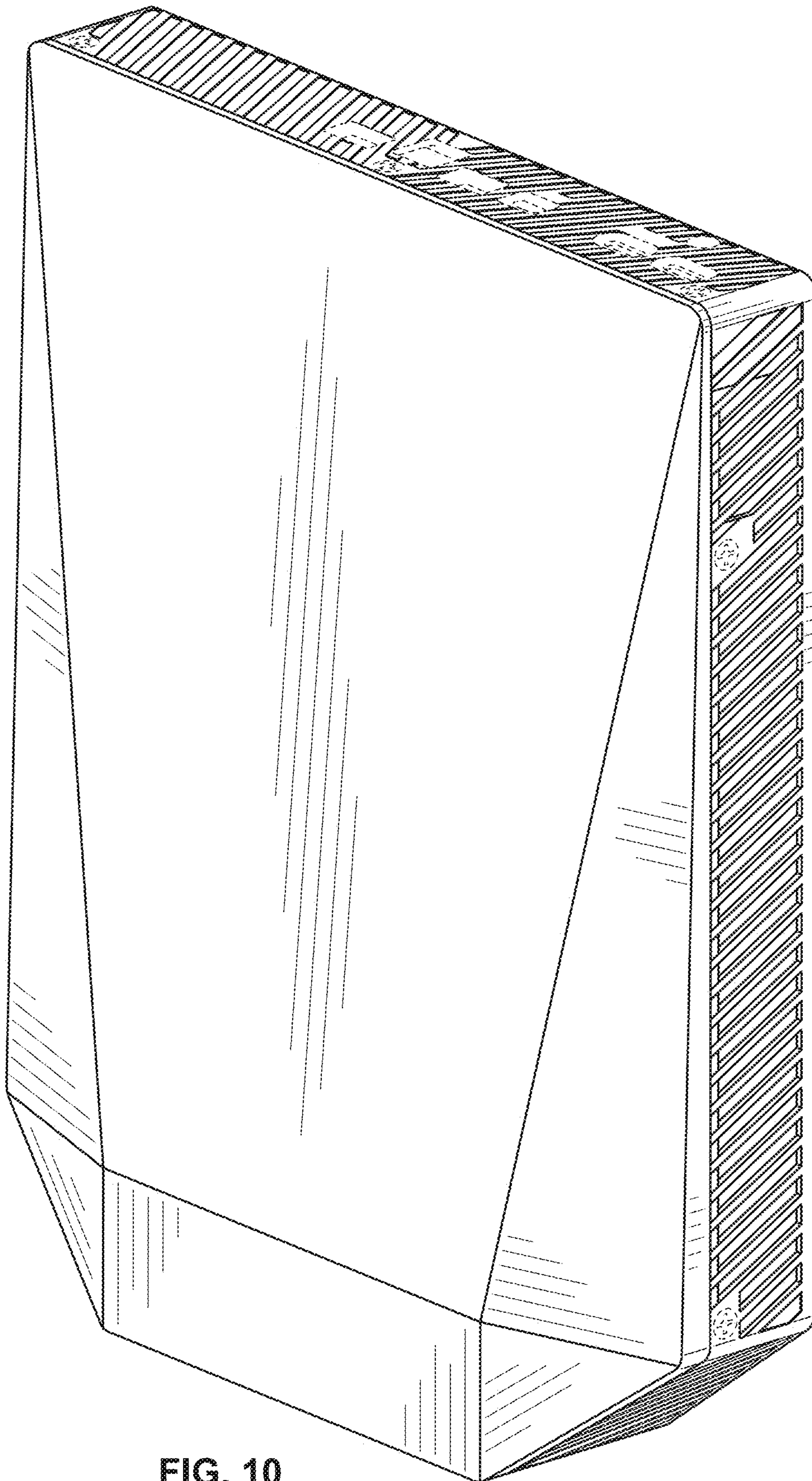

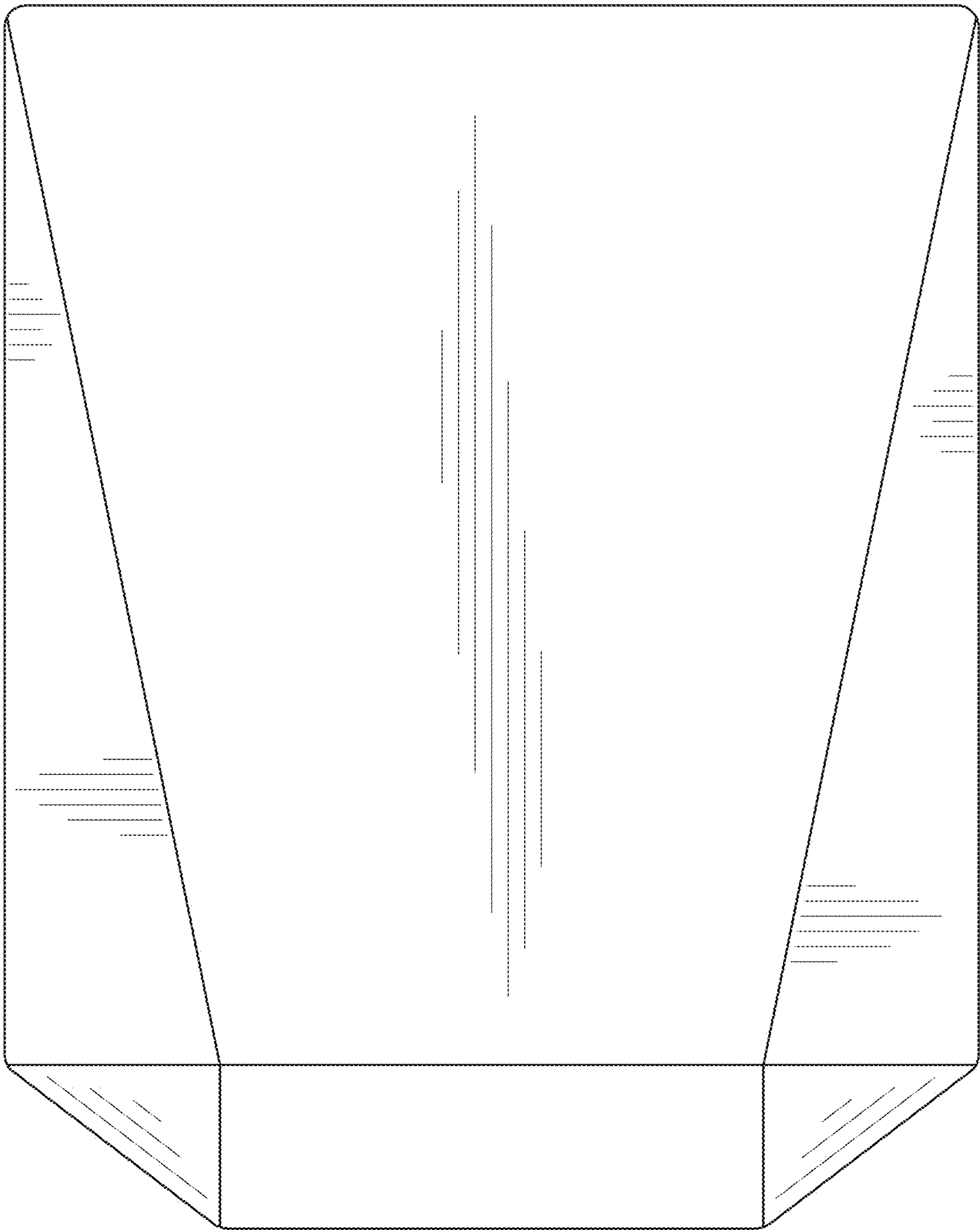

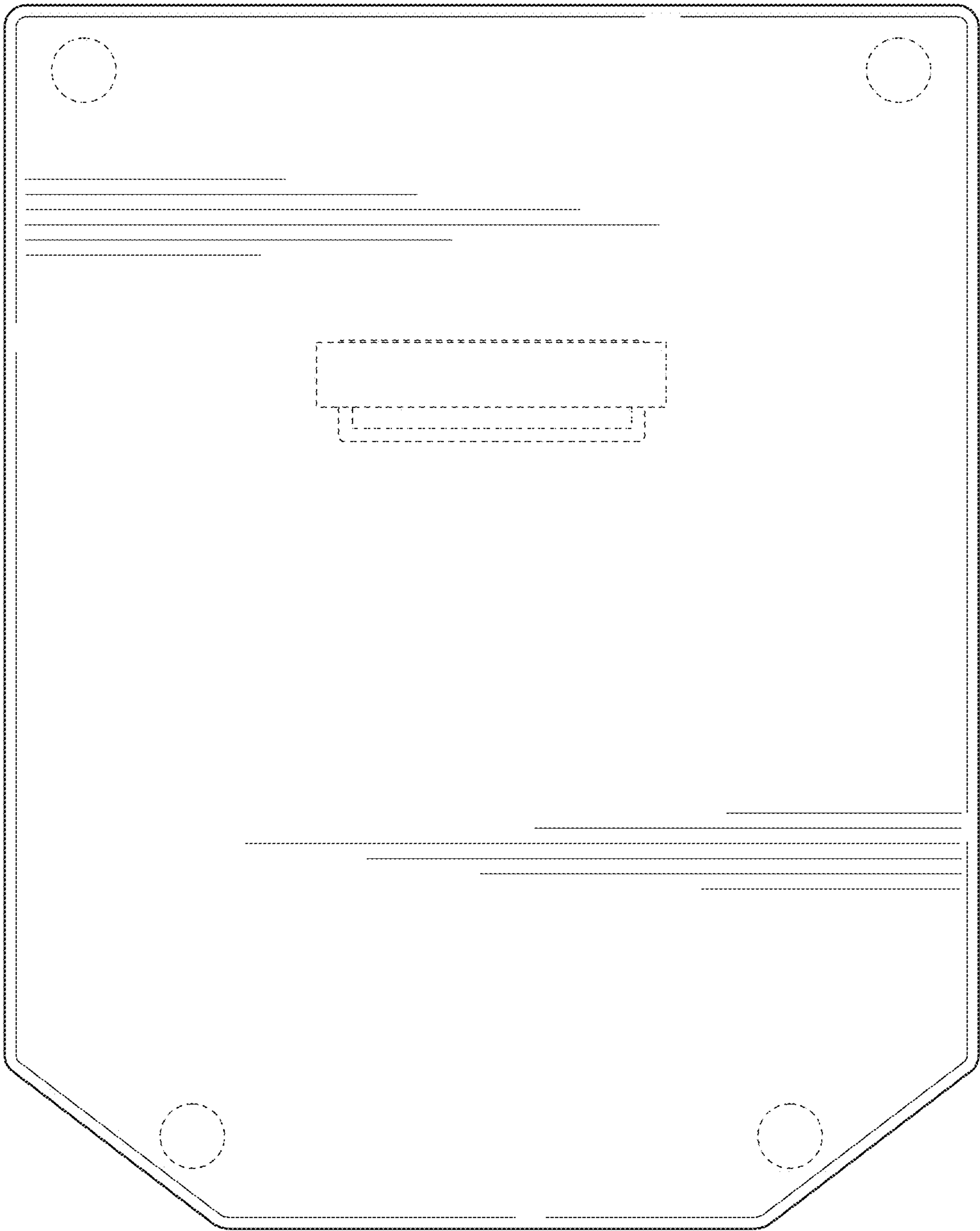

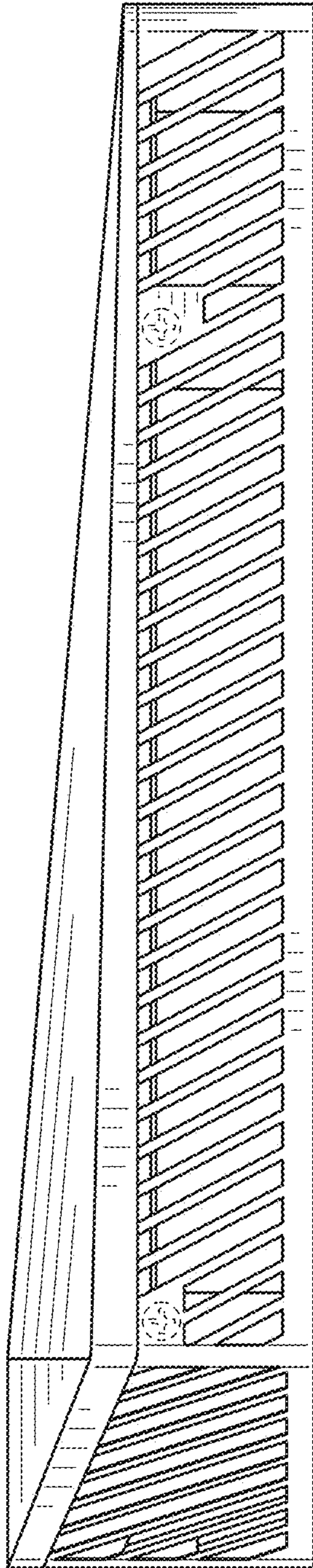

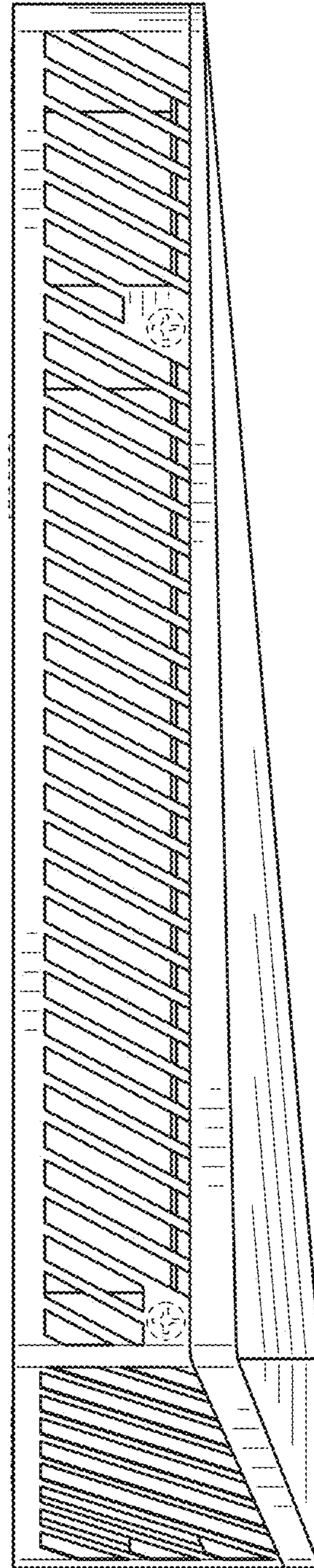

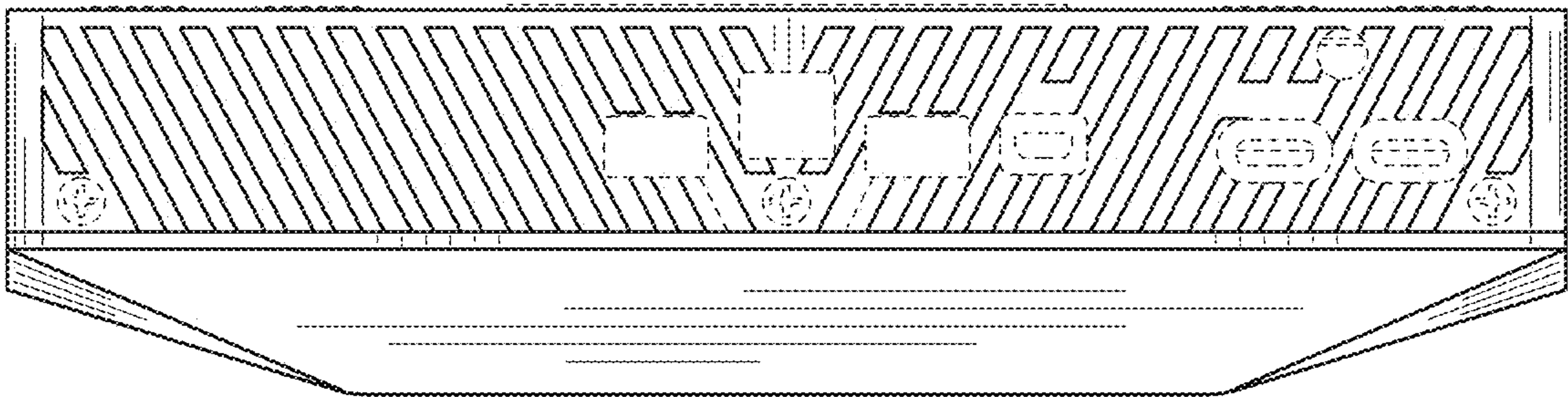

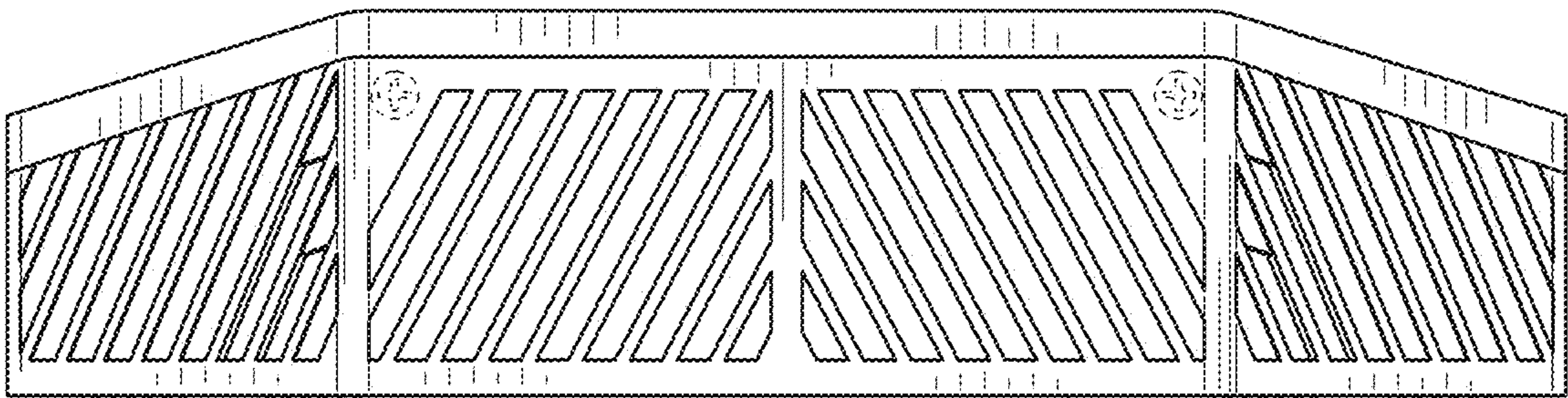
