The broken lines showing portions of the gown form no part of the claimed design.

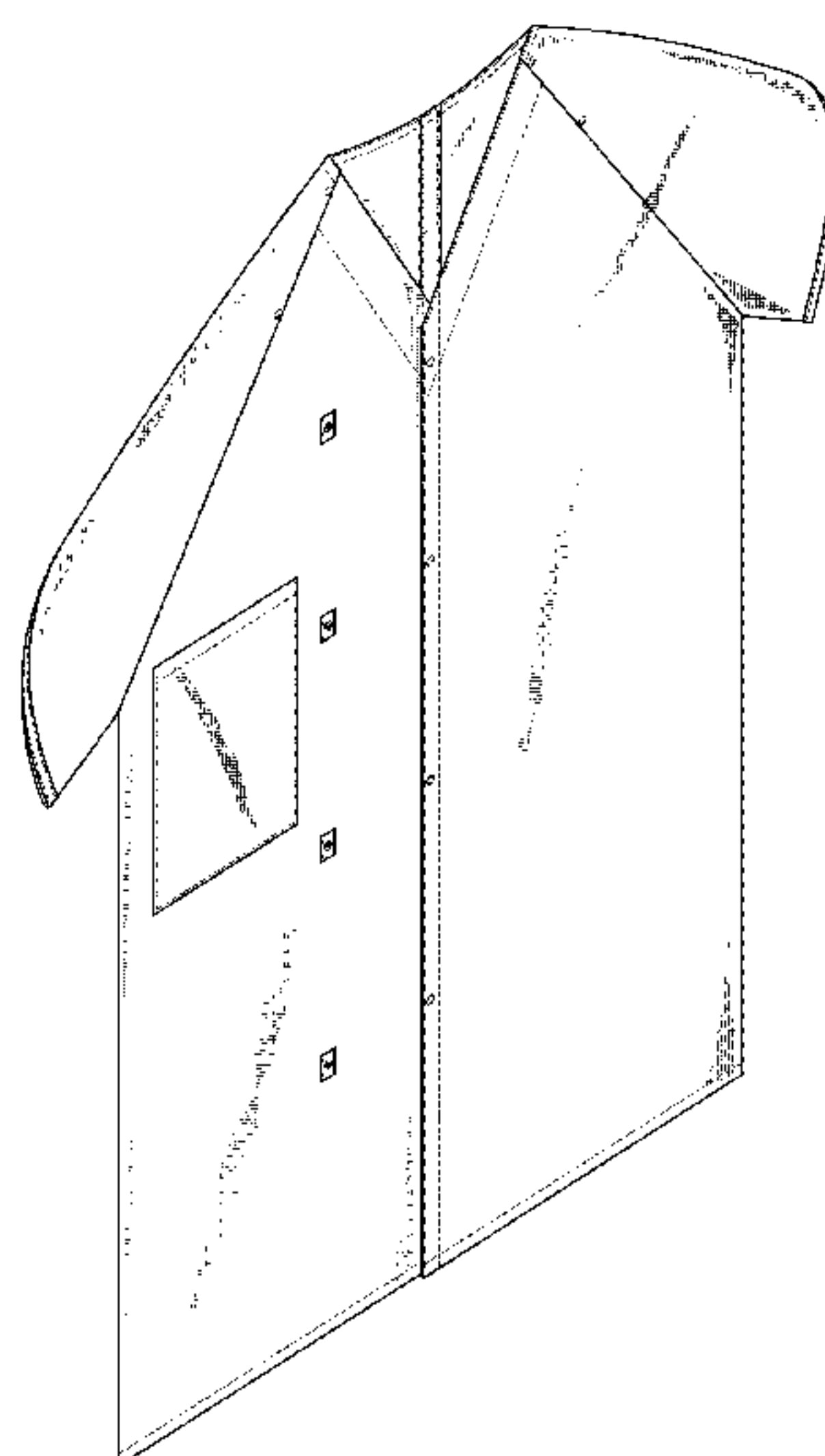

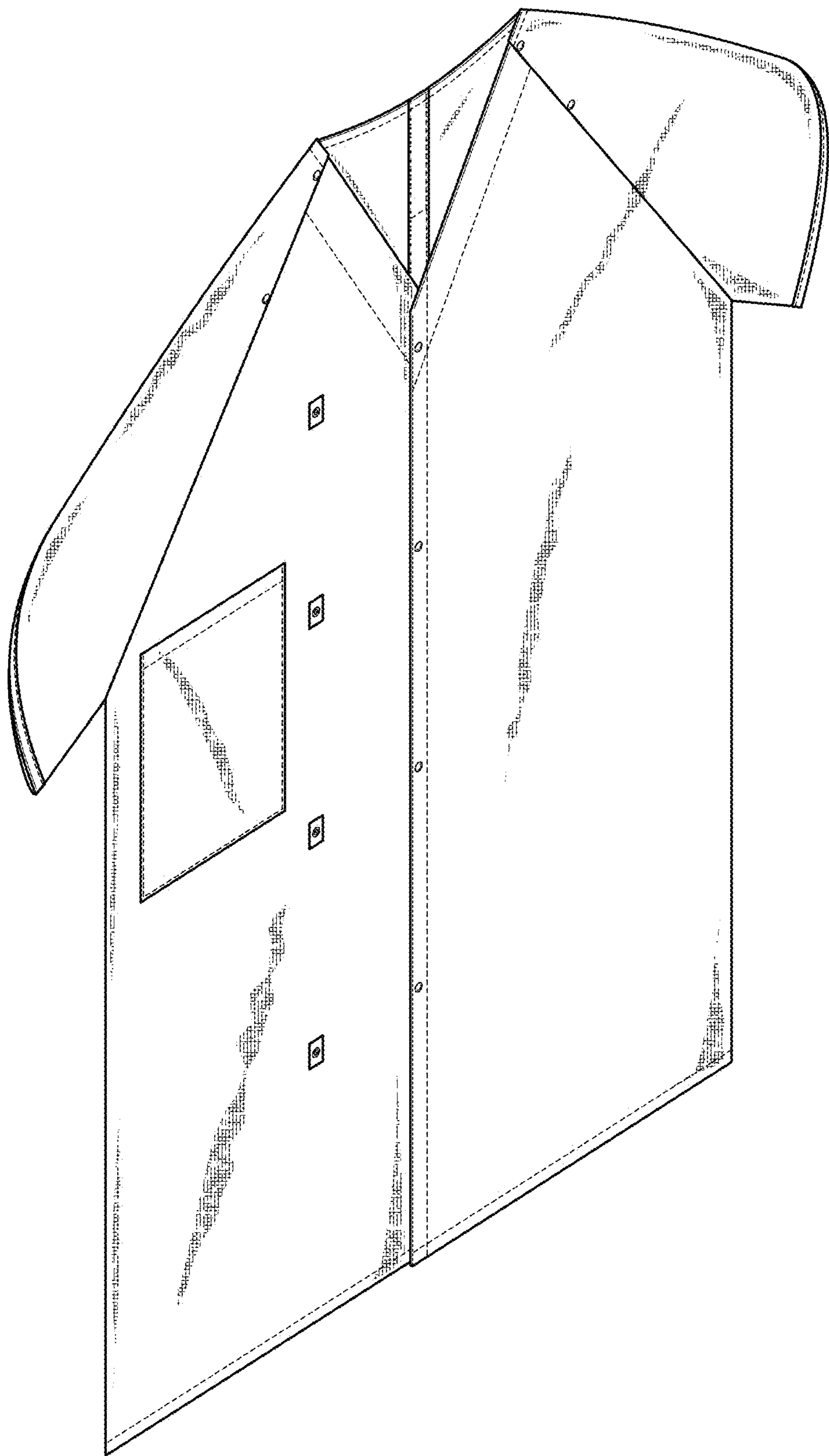

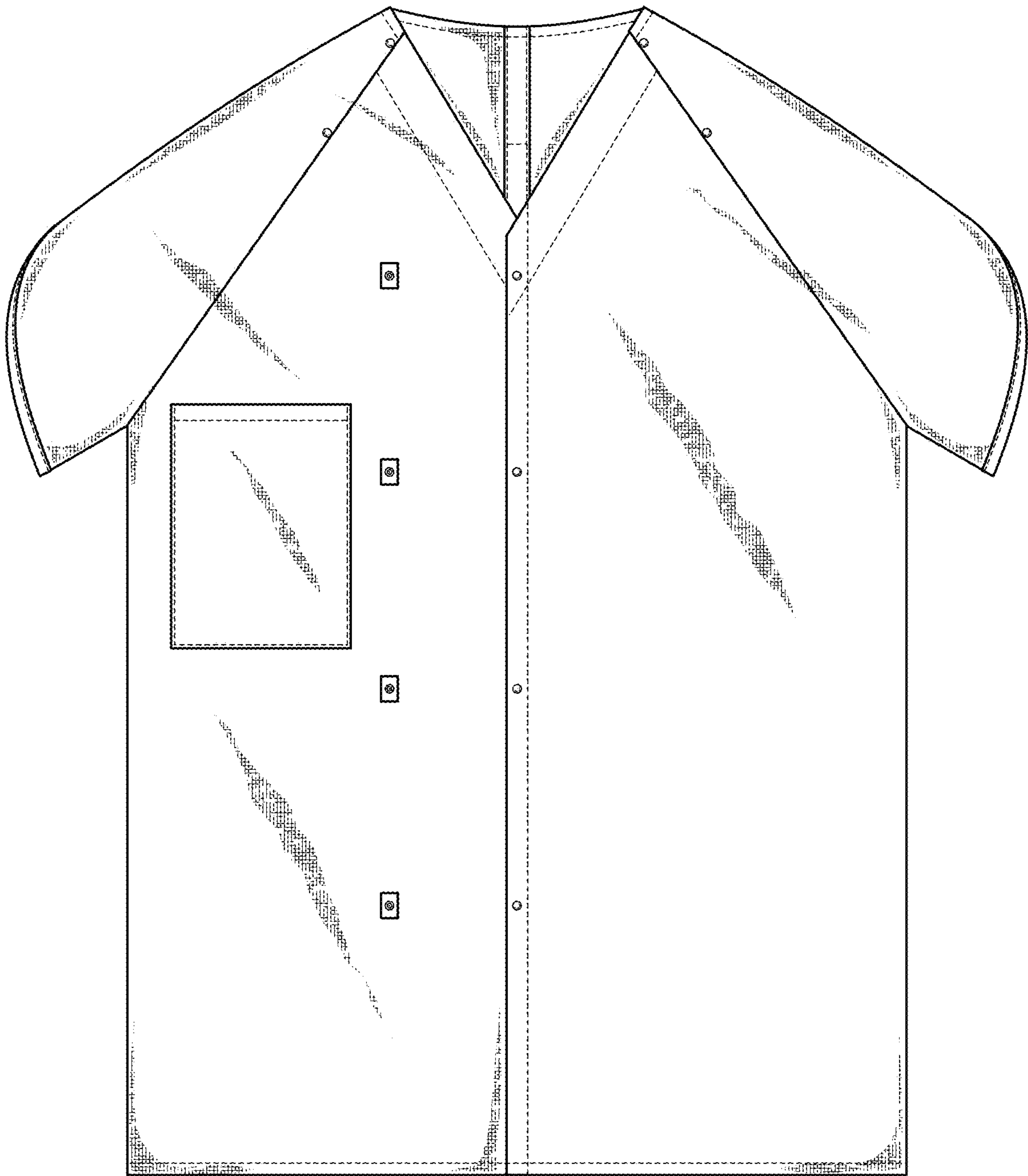

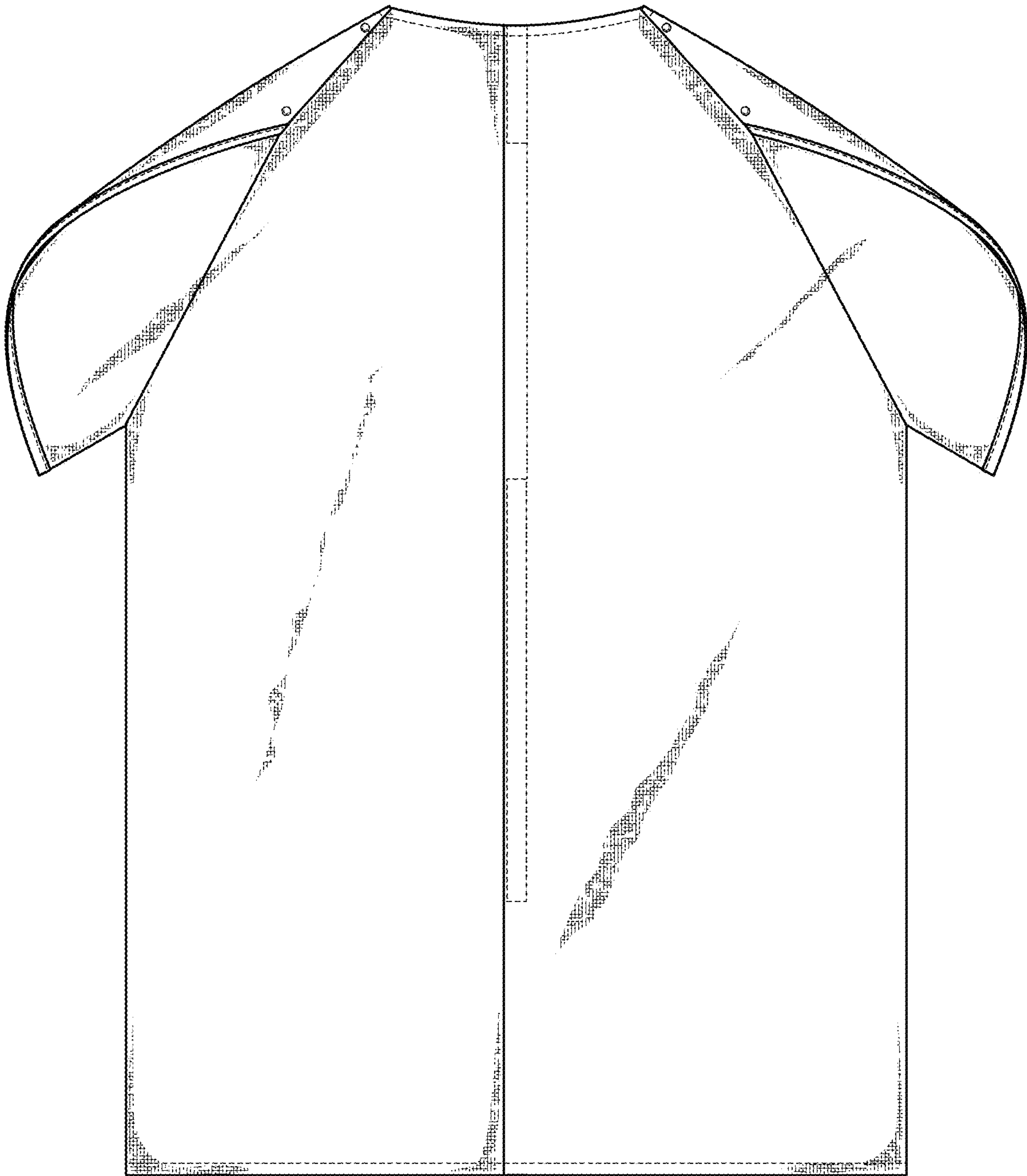

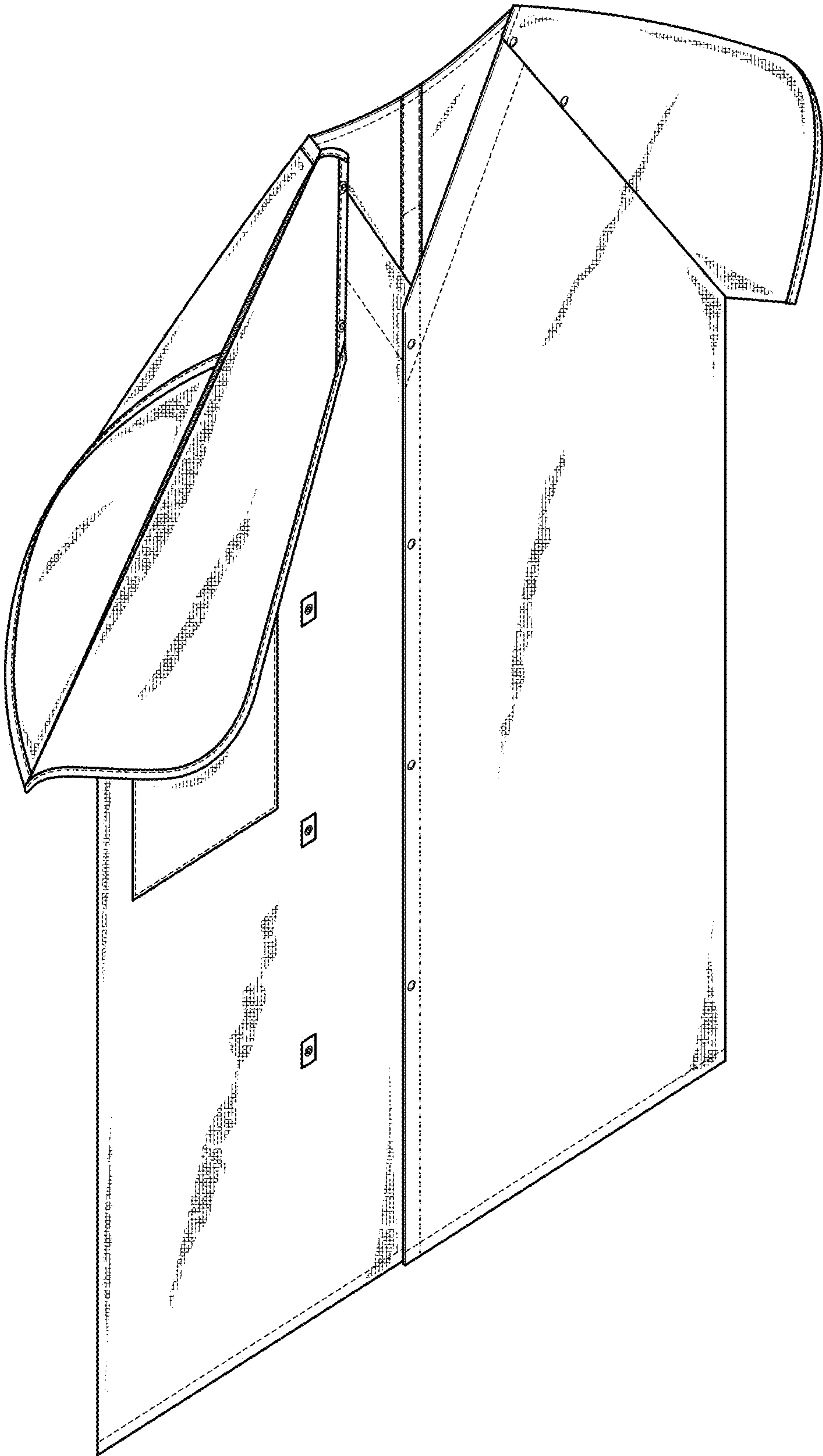

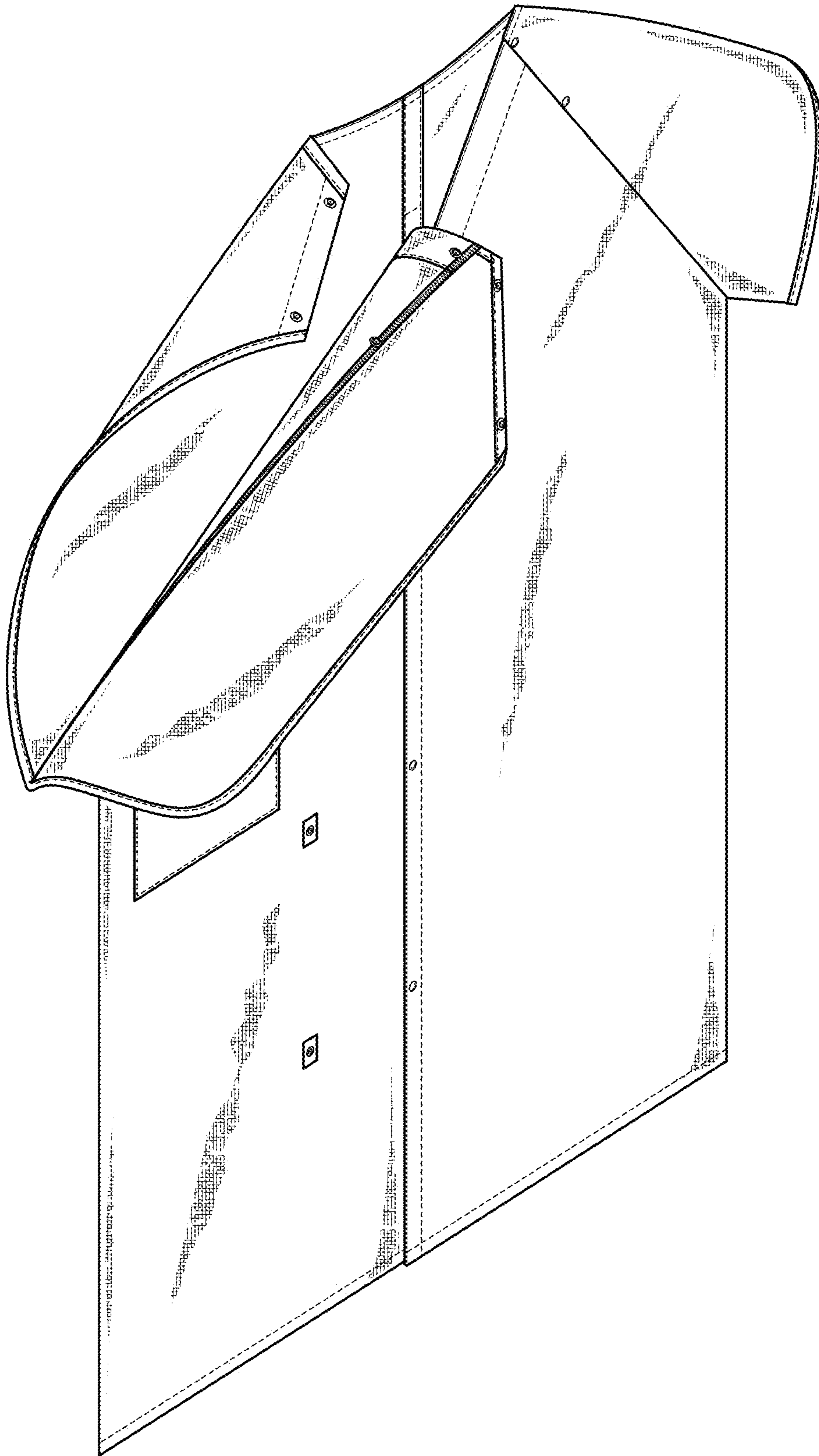
