DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a front view of the bicycle saddle with through-hole handle;

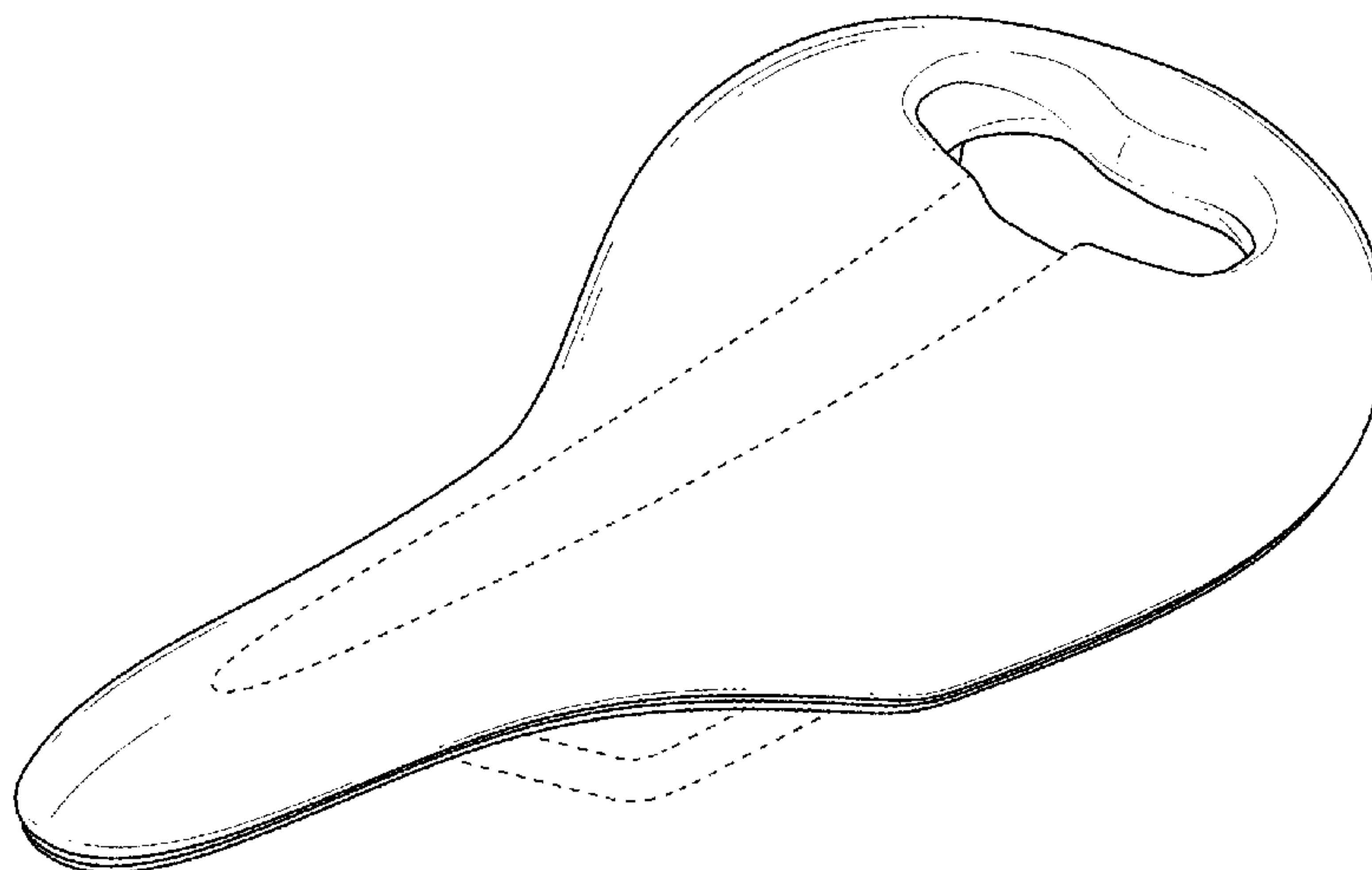
FIG. 6 is a rear view of the bicycle saddle with through-hole handle;

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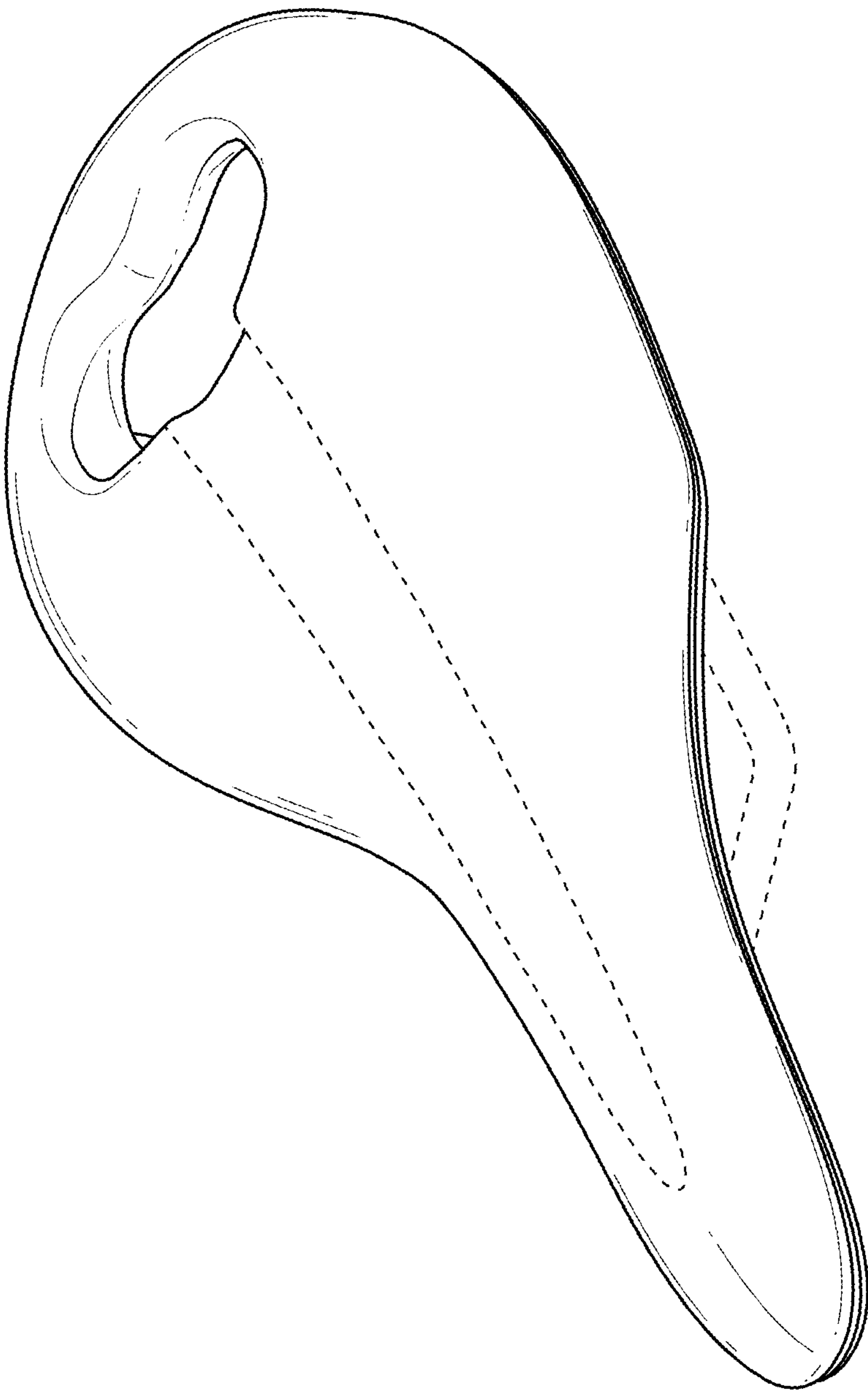

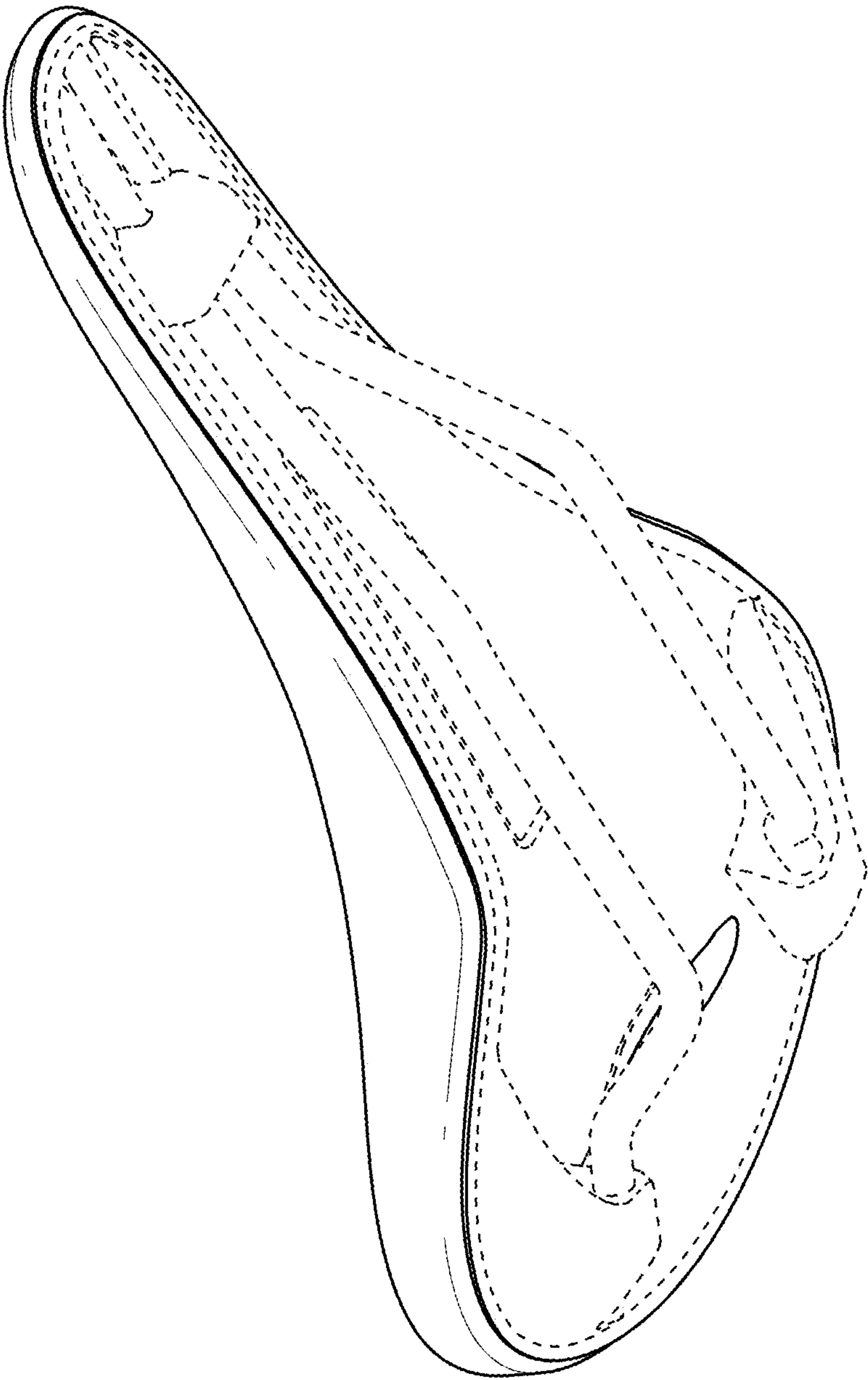

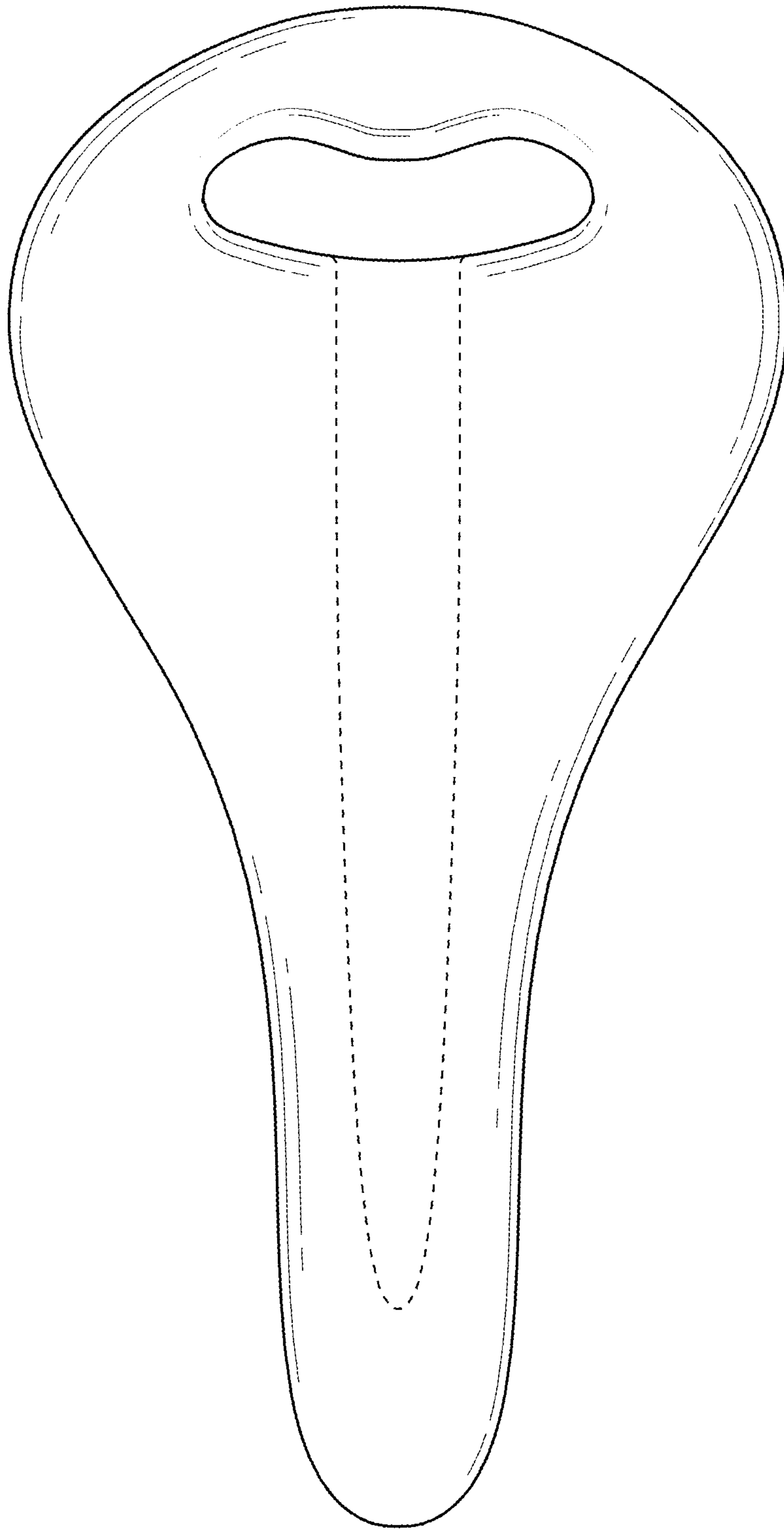

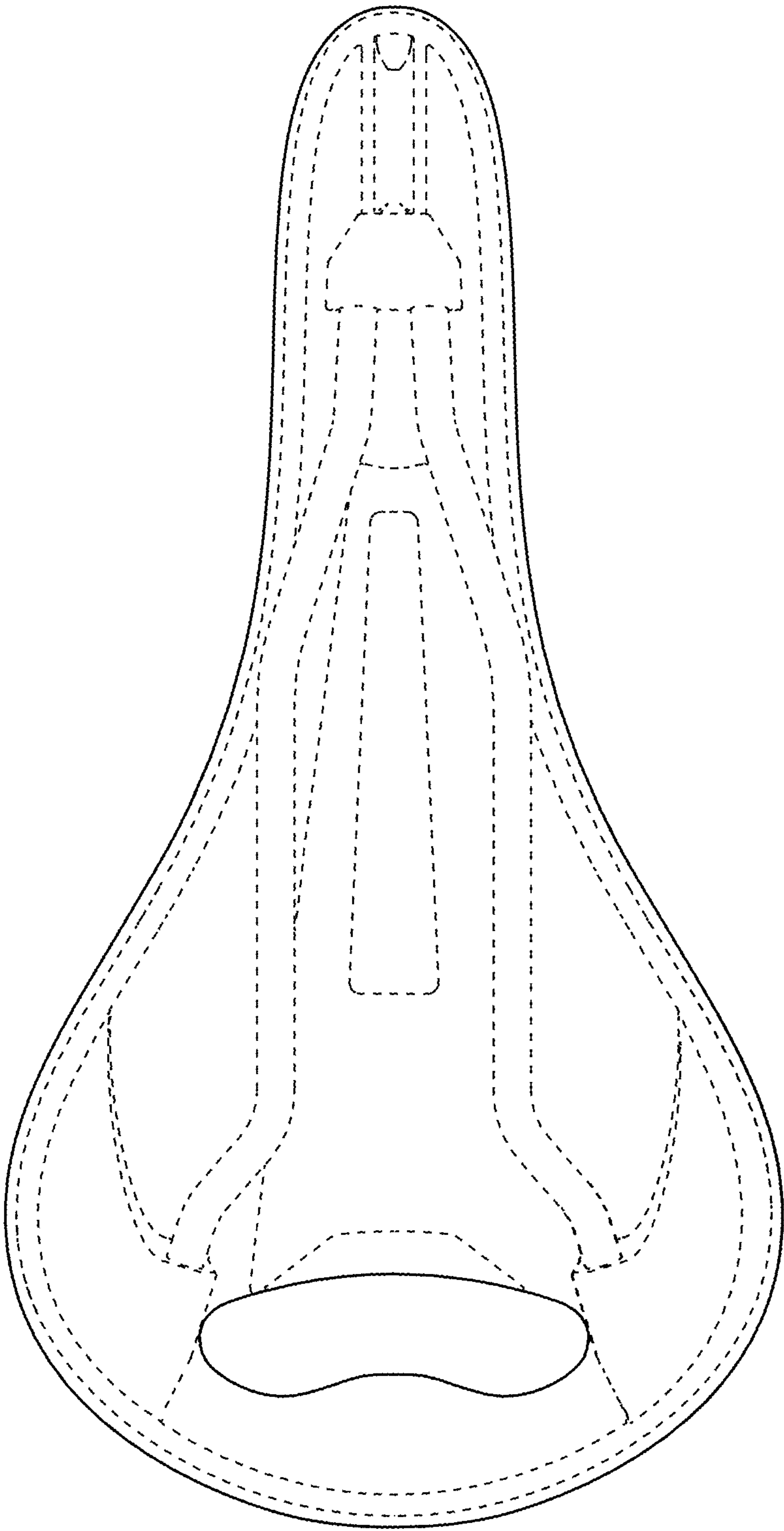

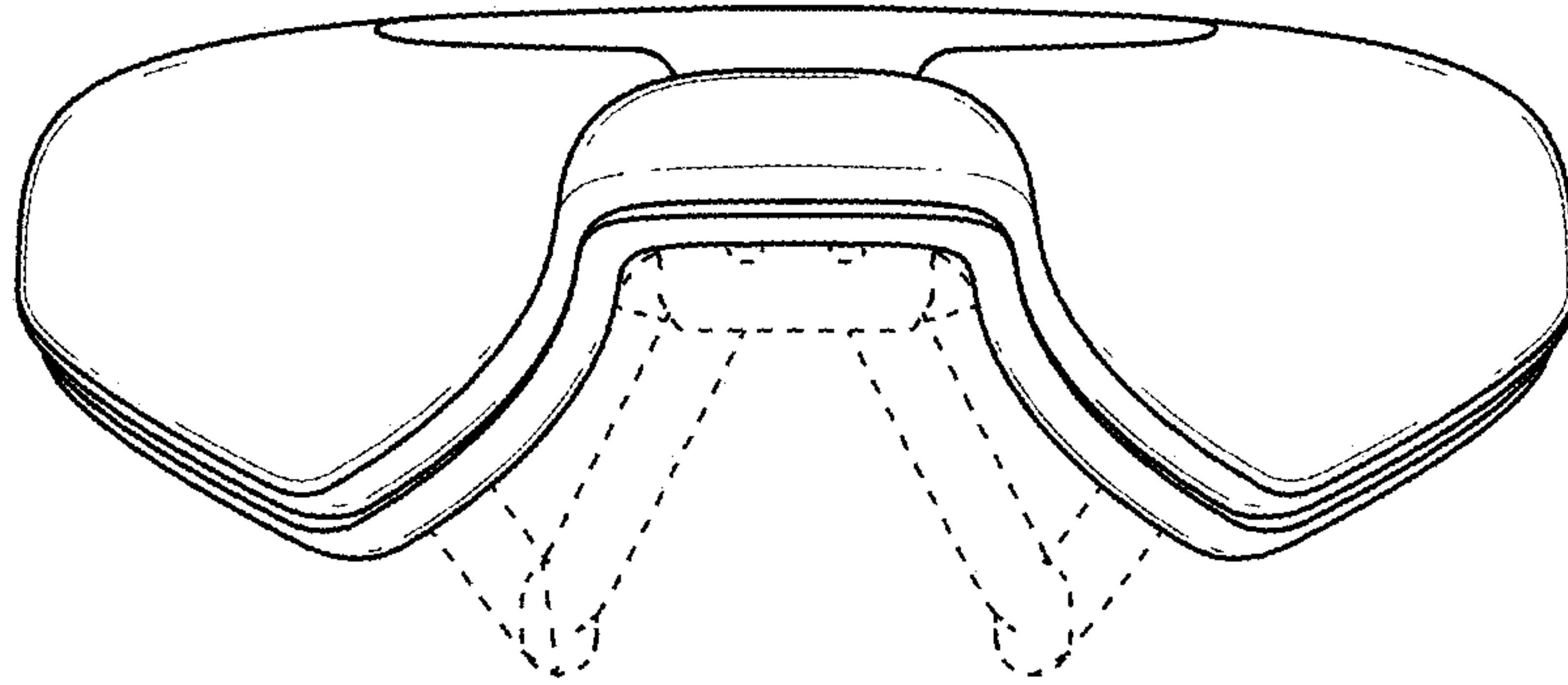

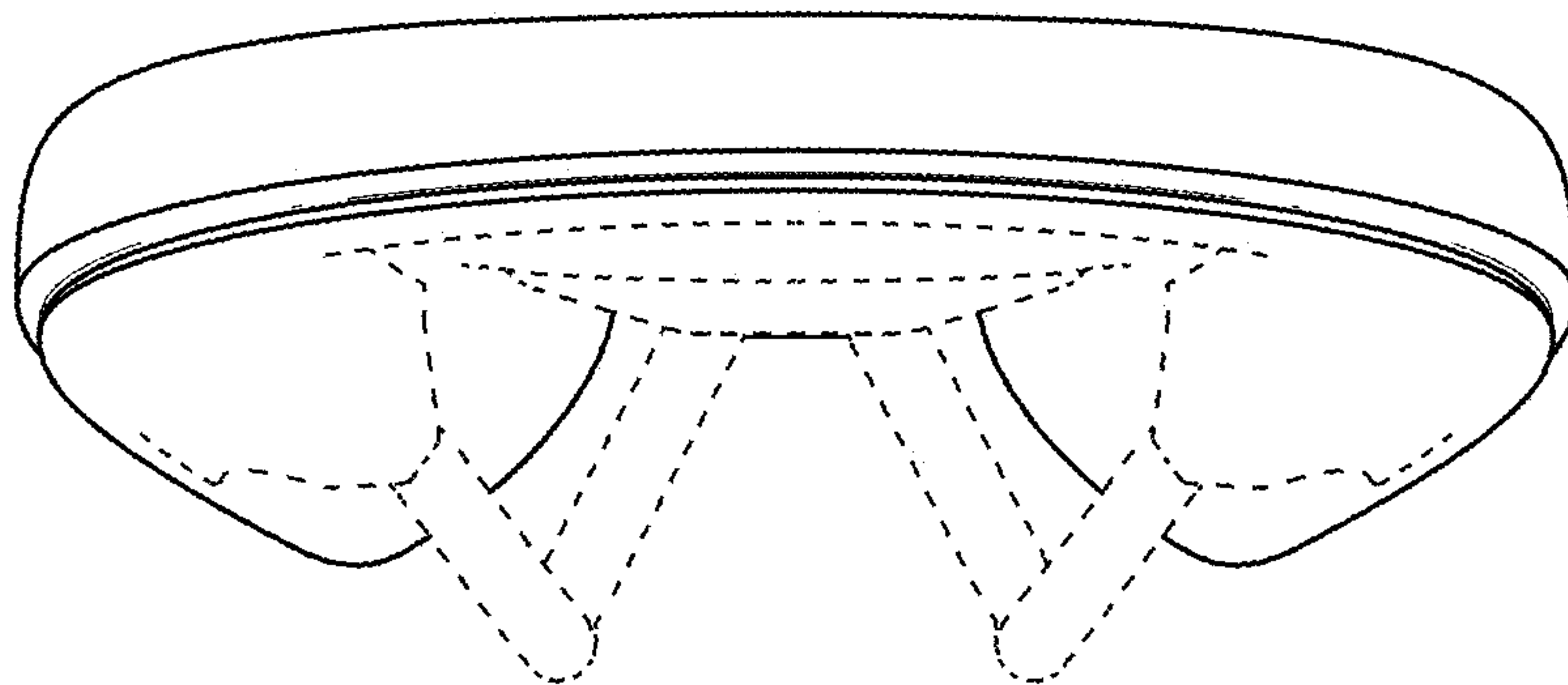

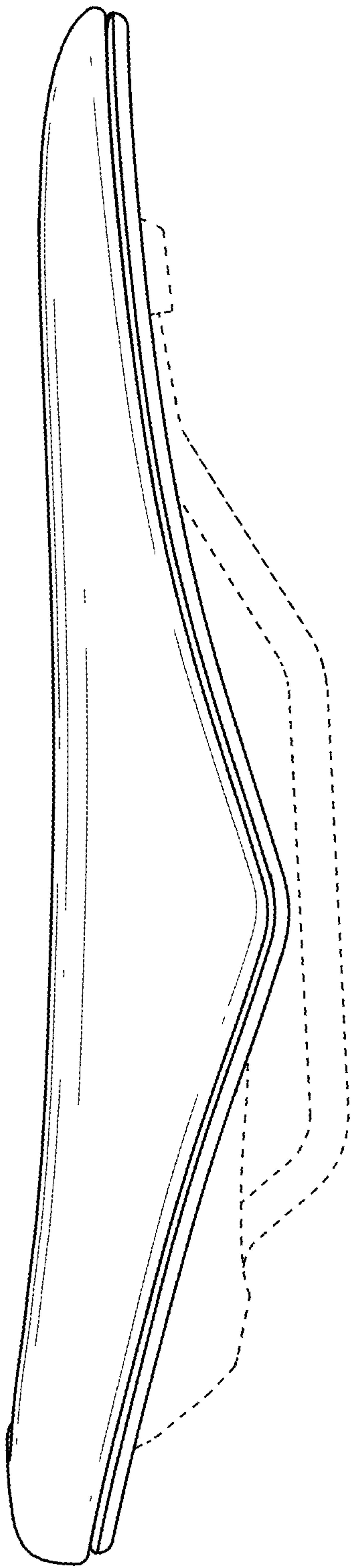

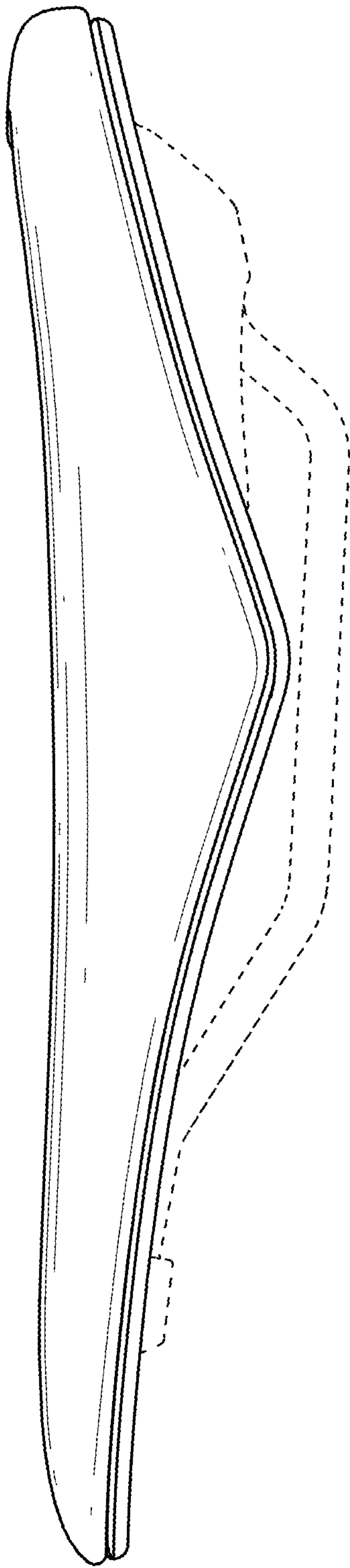
