FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of the motorbike handlebar clamp mechanism;

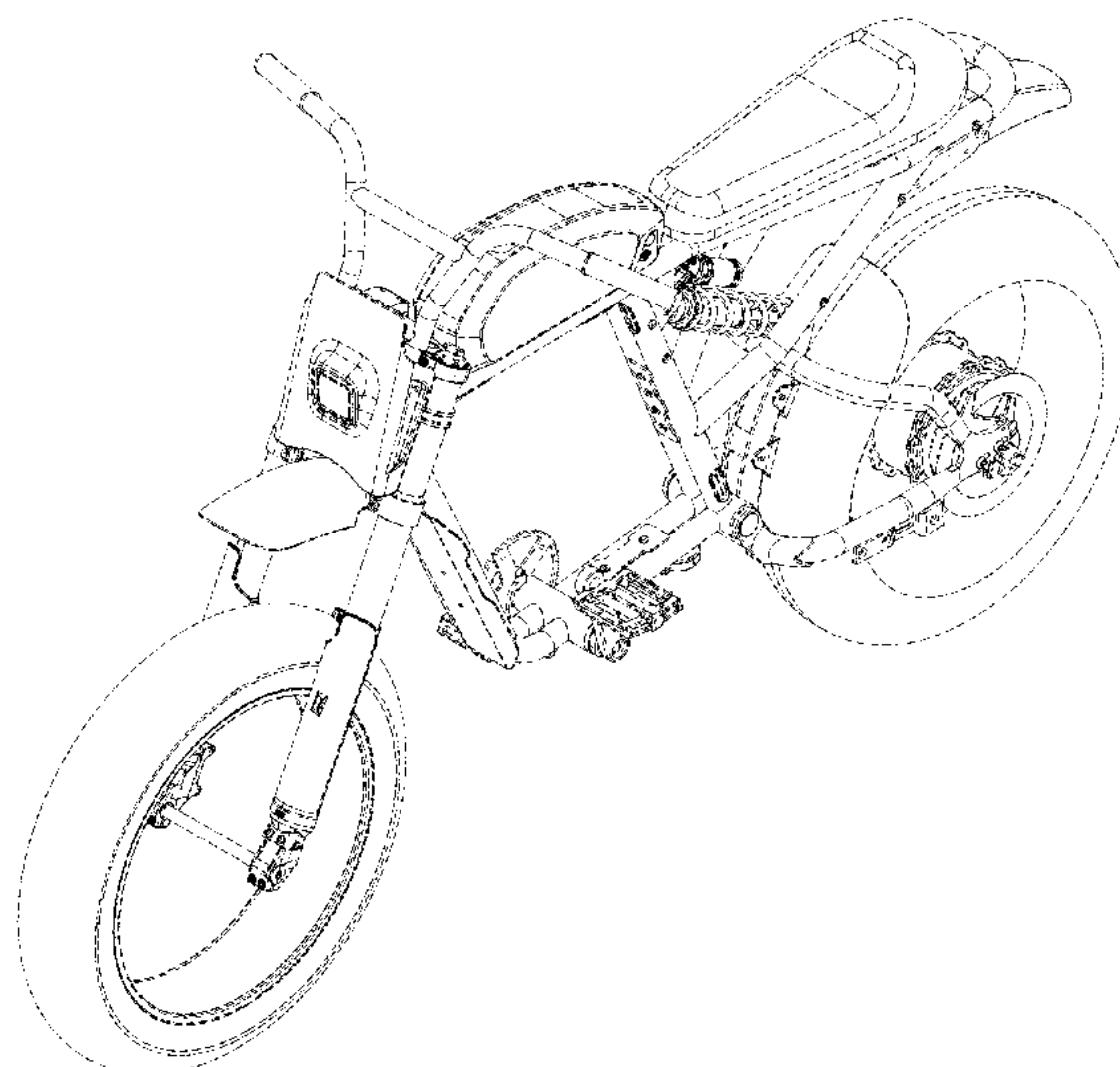
FIG. 8 is a rear elevation view of the motorbike handlebar clamp mechanism;

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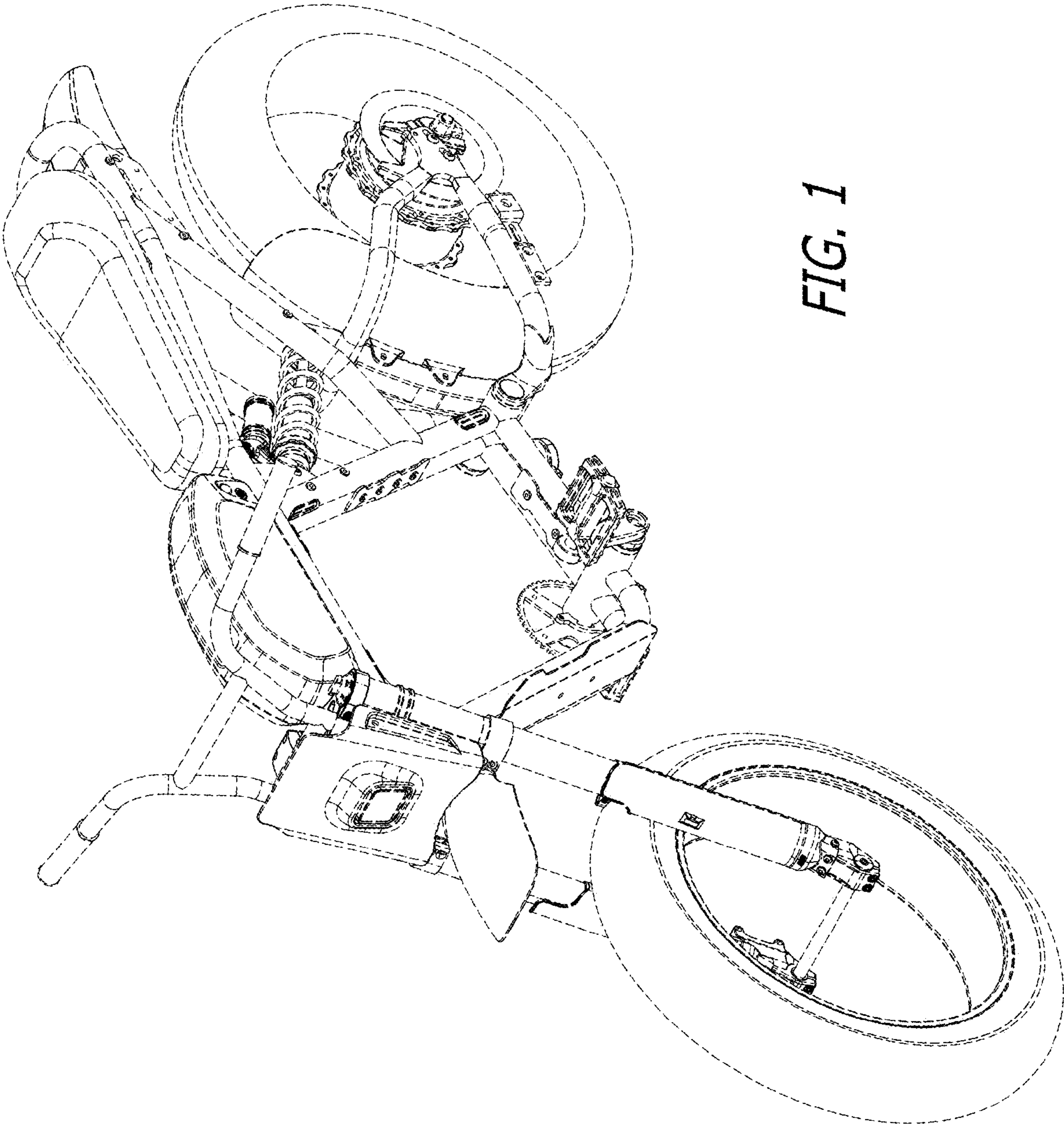

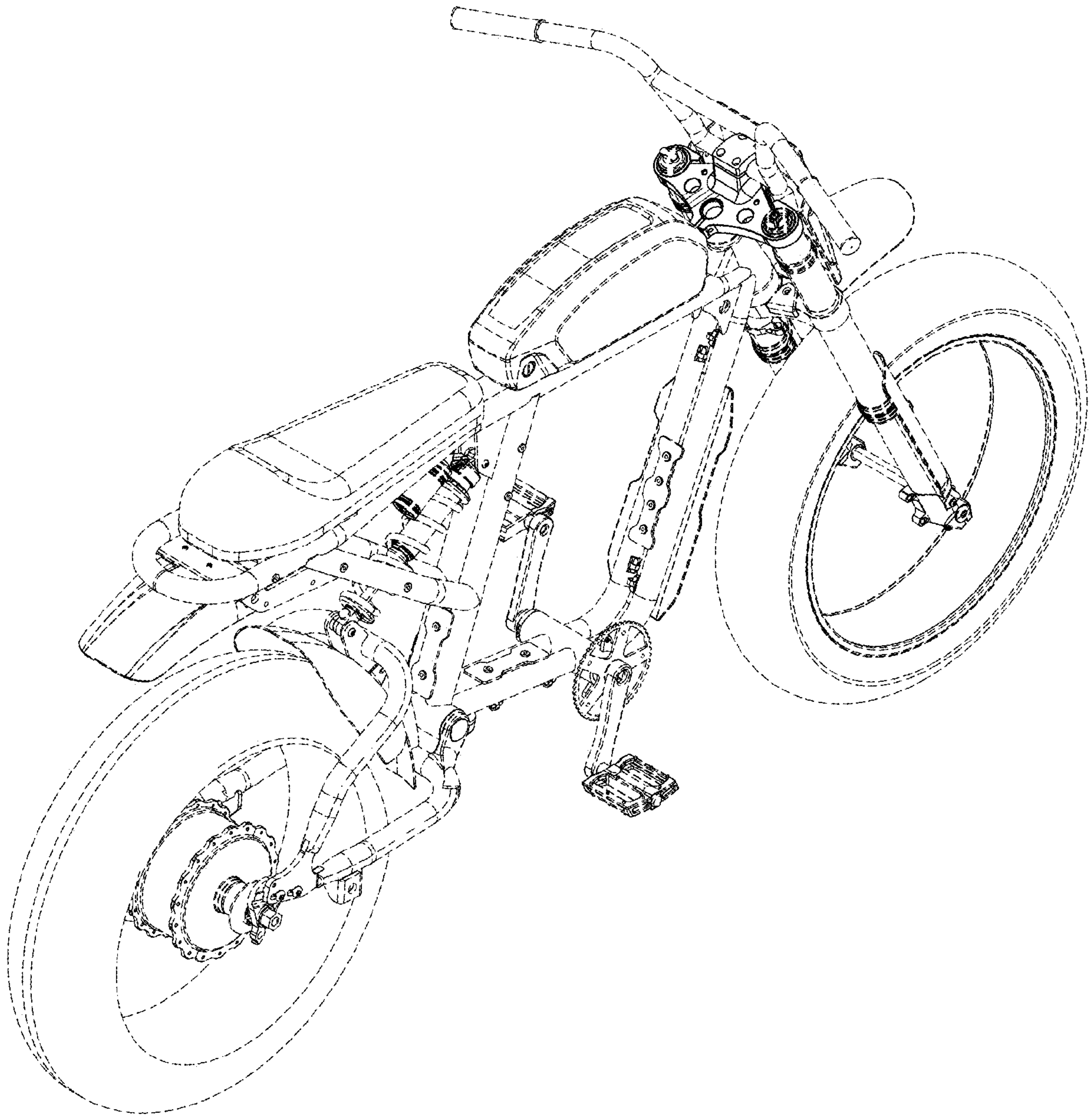

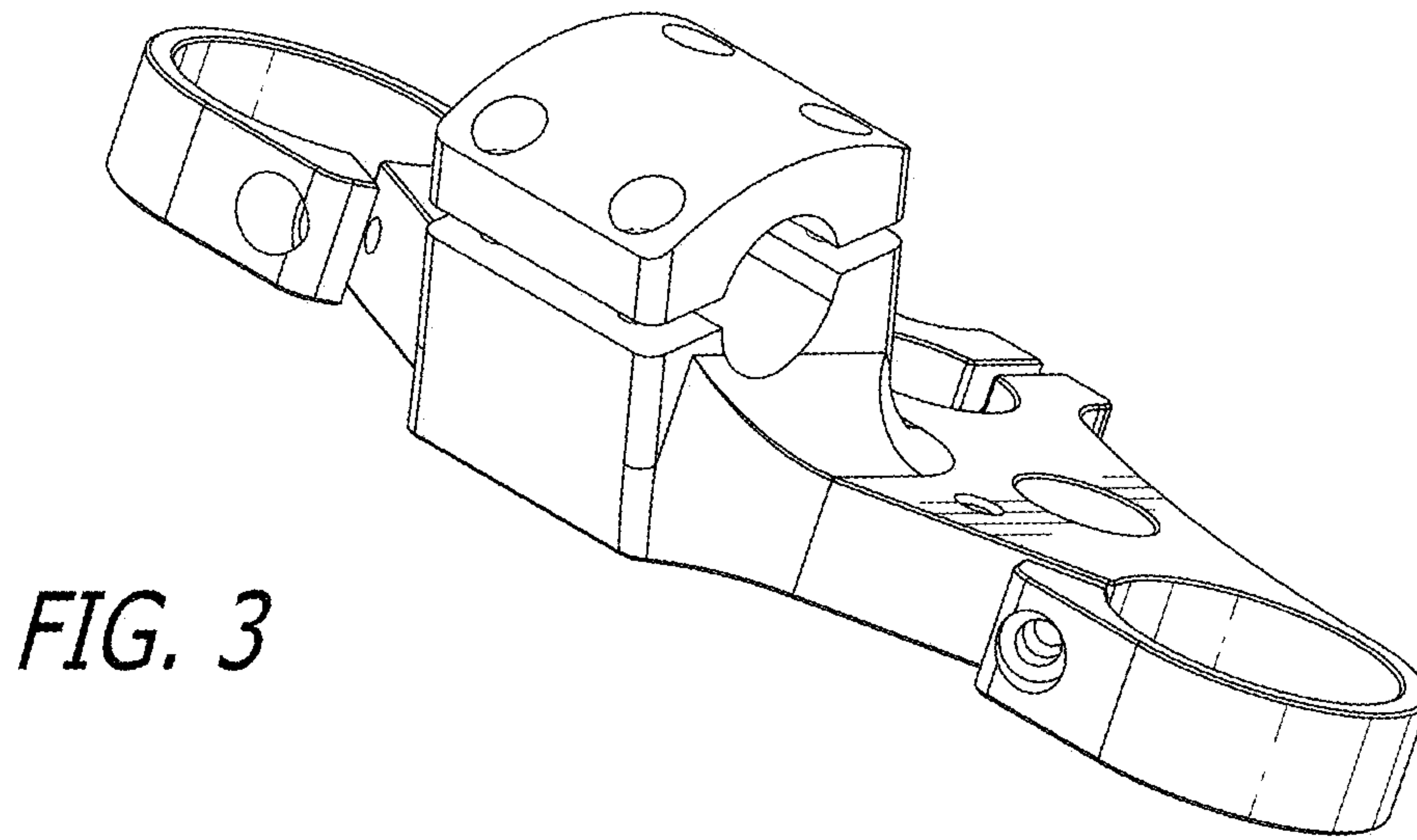

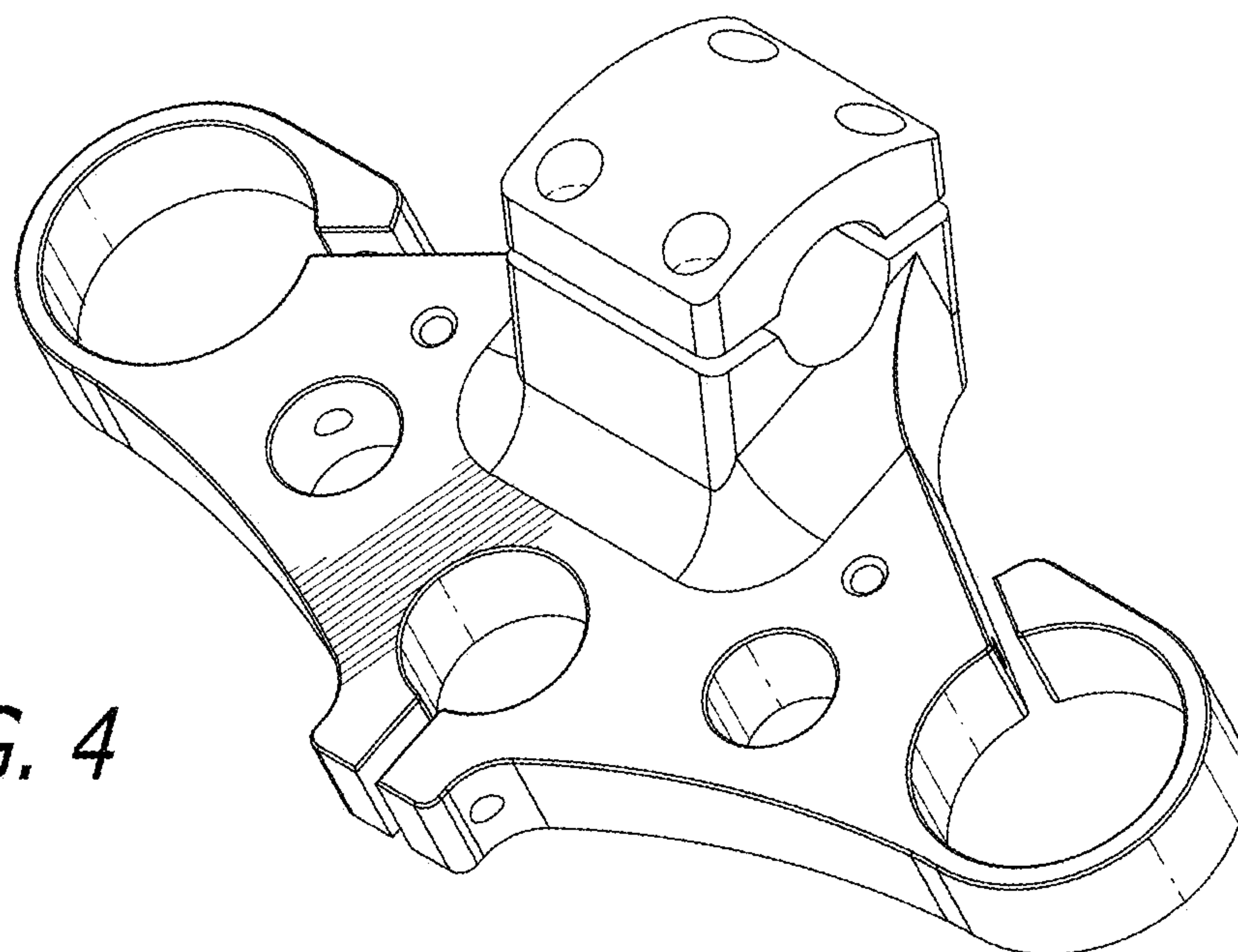

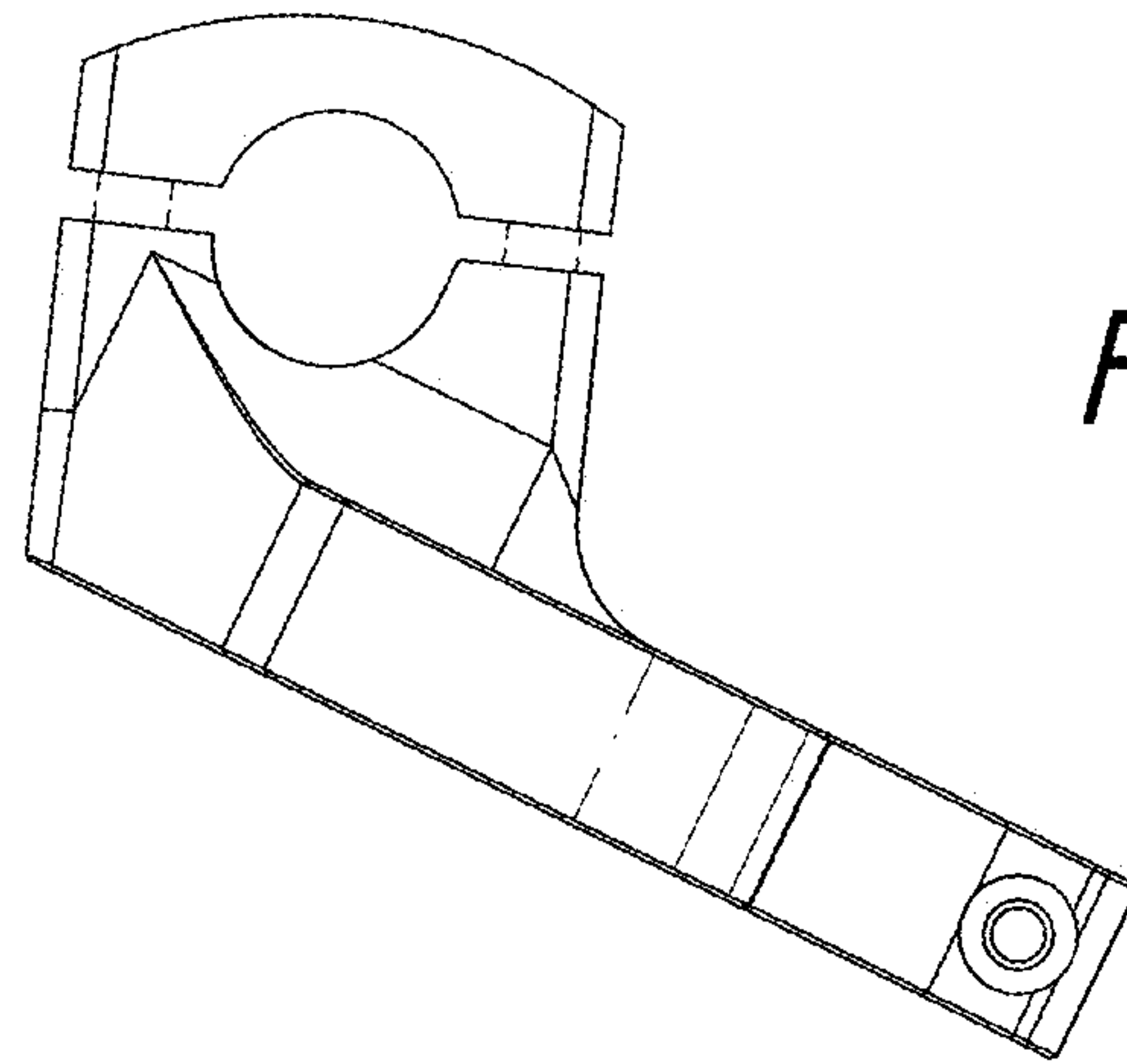

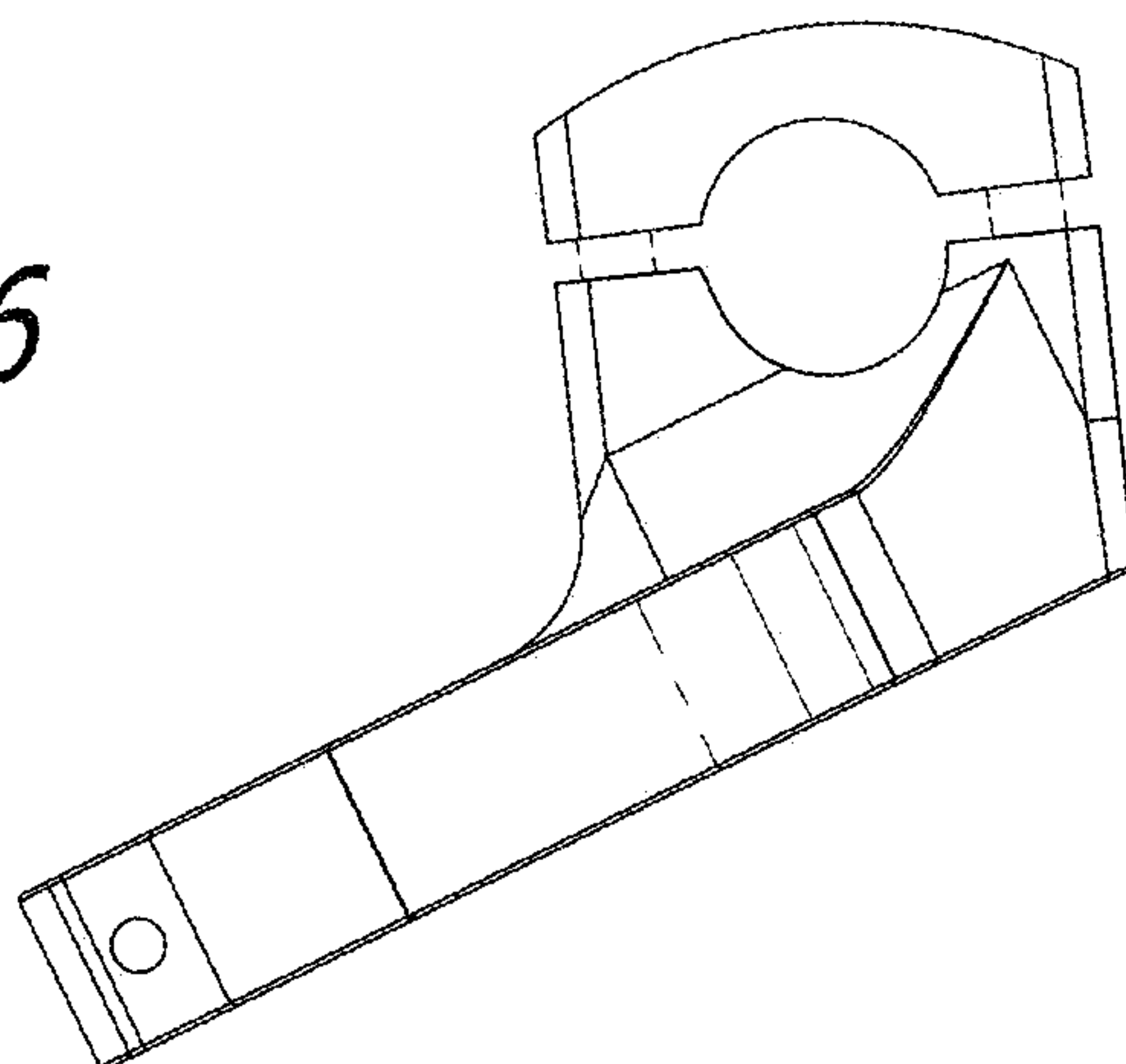

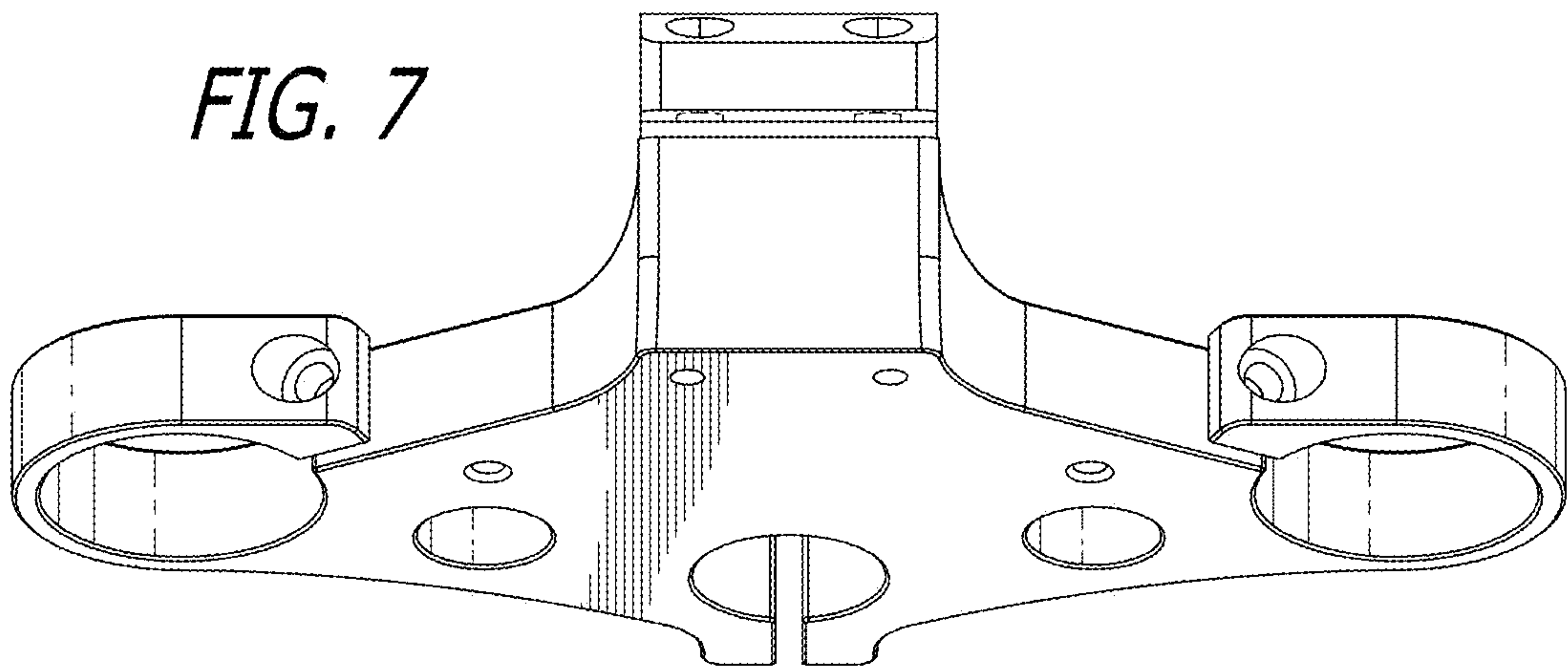
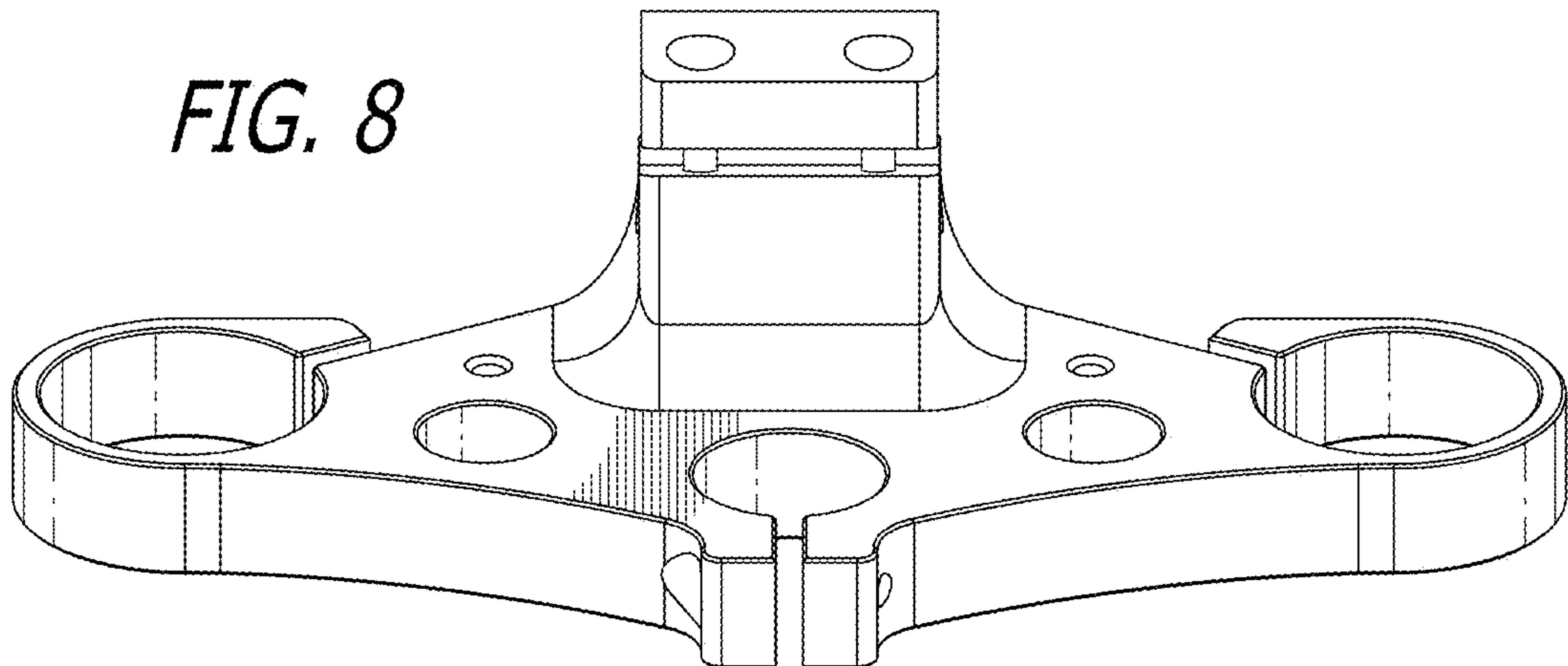

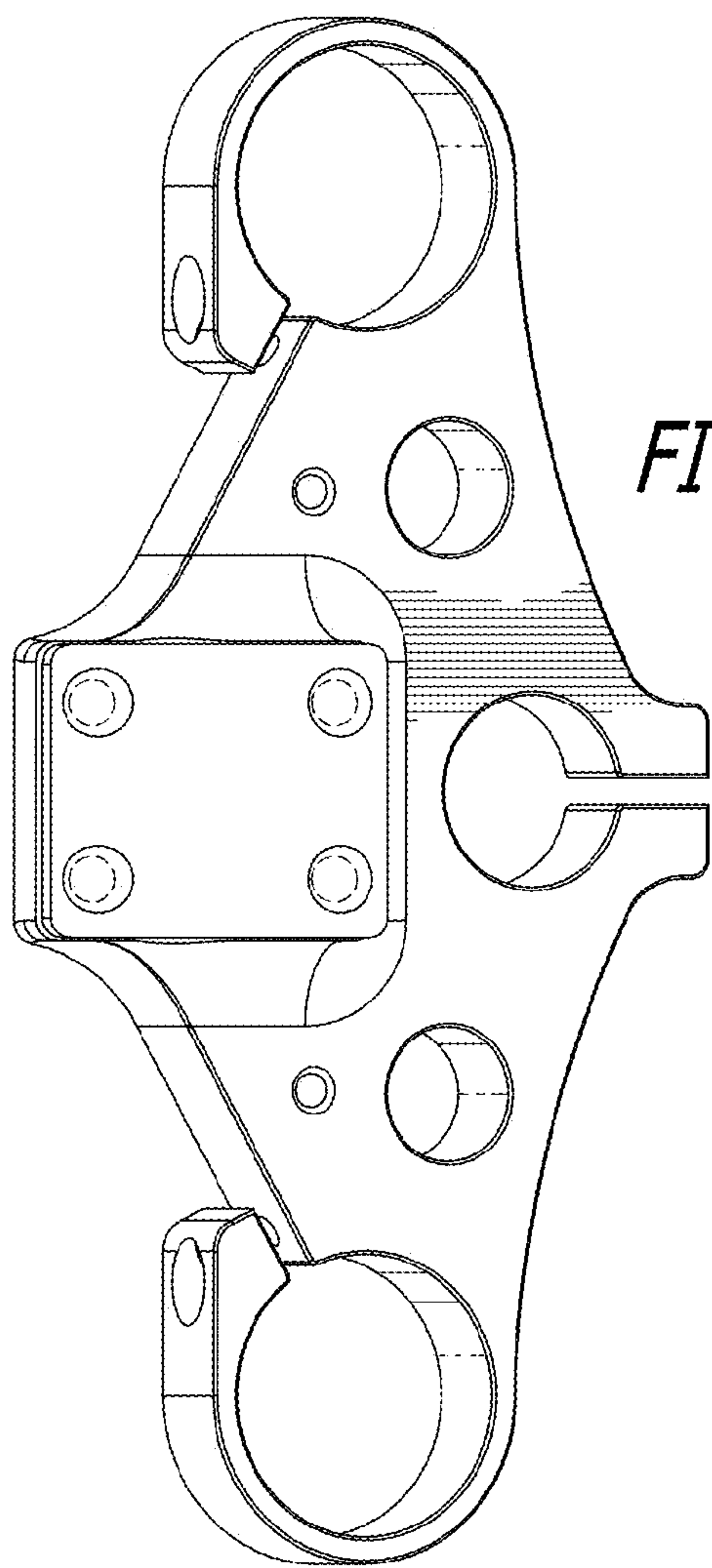

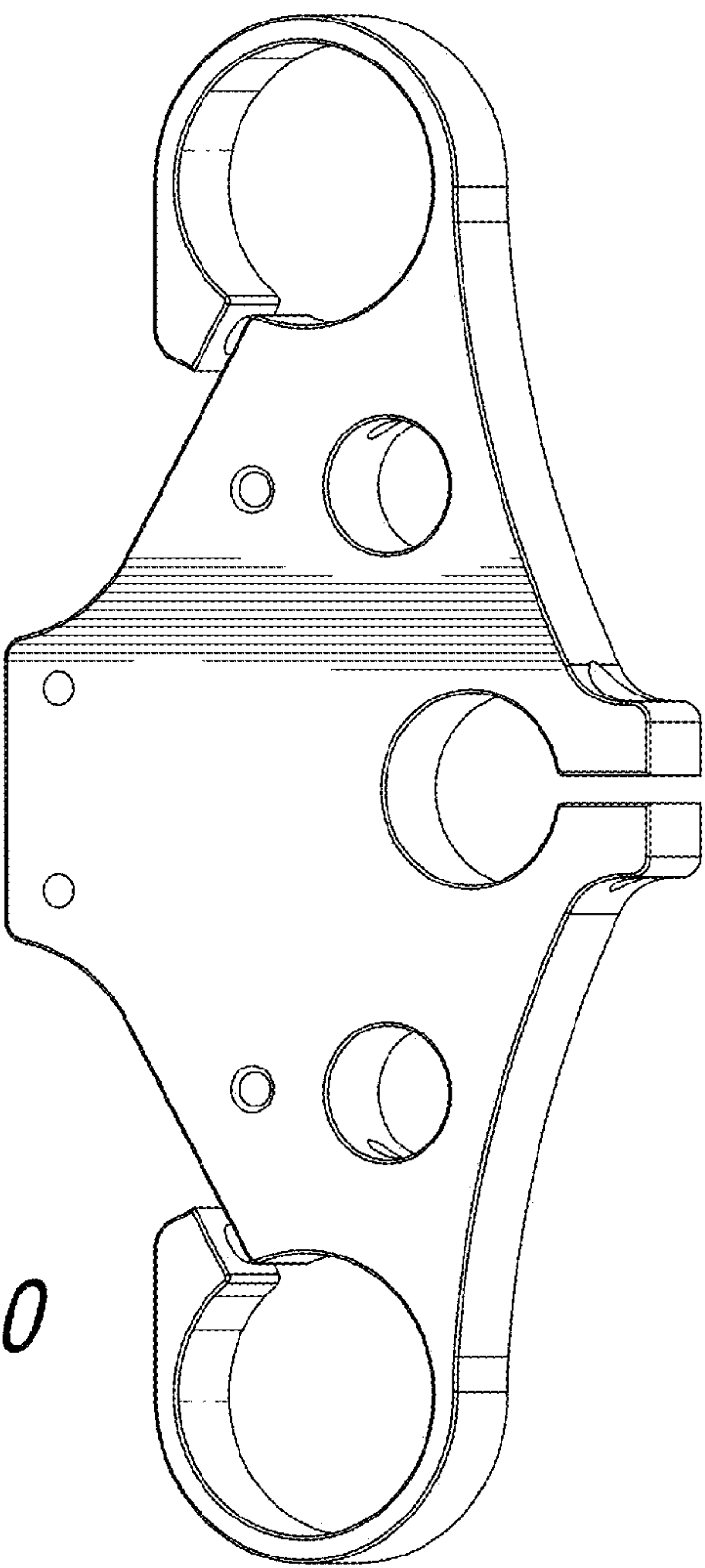
