We claim the ornamental design for a merchandise display hook, as shown and described.

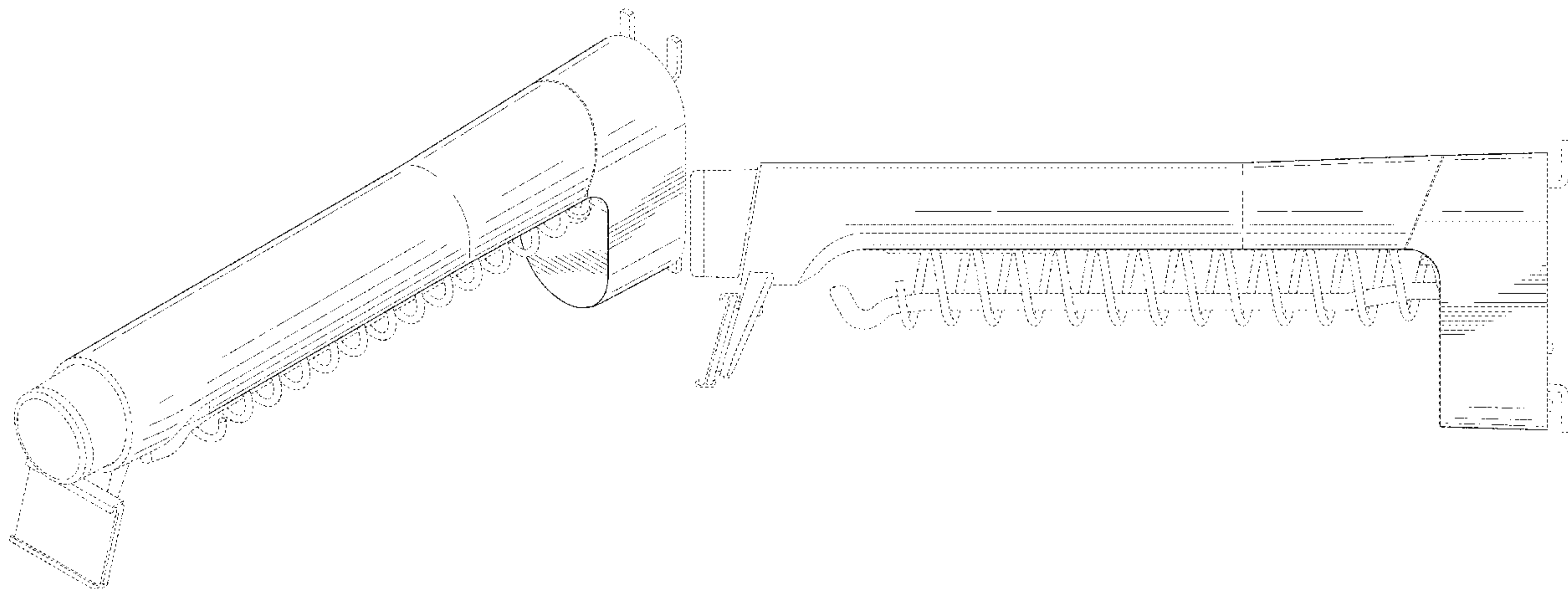
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a merchandise display hook showing our new design, according to a first embodiment; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is left side view thereof; FIG. 5 is right side view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a merchandise display hook showing our new design, according to a second embodiment; FIG. 9 is a front view thereof; FIG. 10 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 11 is left side view thereof; FIG. 12 is right side view thereof; FIG. 13 is a top view thereof; and, FIG. 14 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken lines in the drawings are for the purpose of illustrating environmental subject matter and portions of the merchandise display hook that form no part of the claimed design.

The second embodiment of the merchandise display hook is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

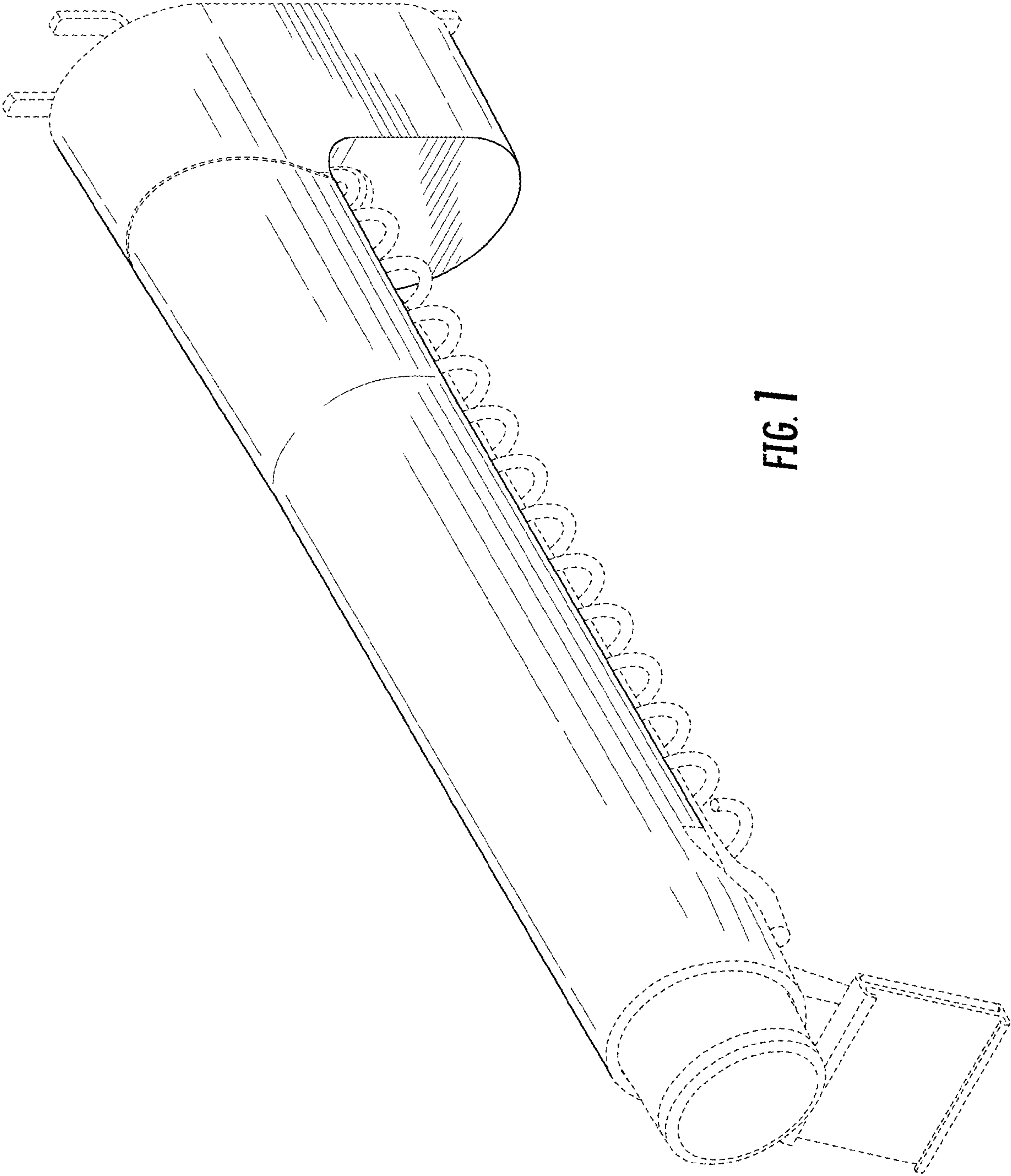

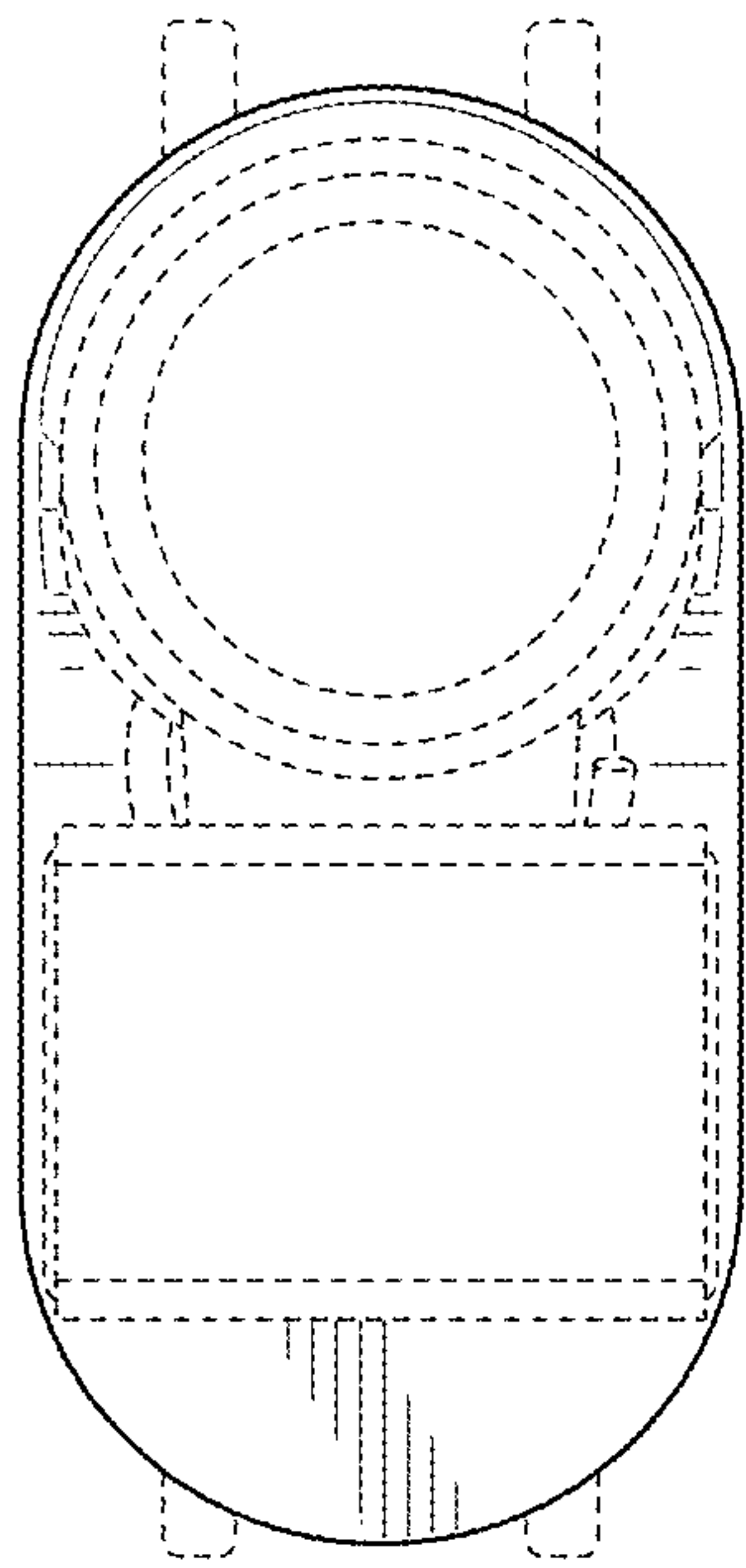

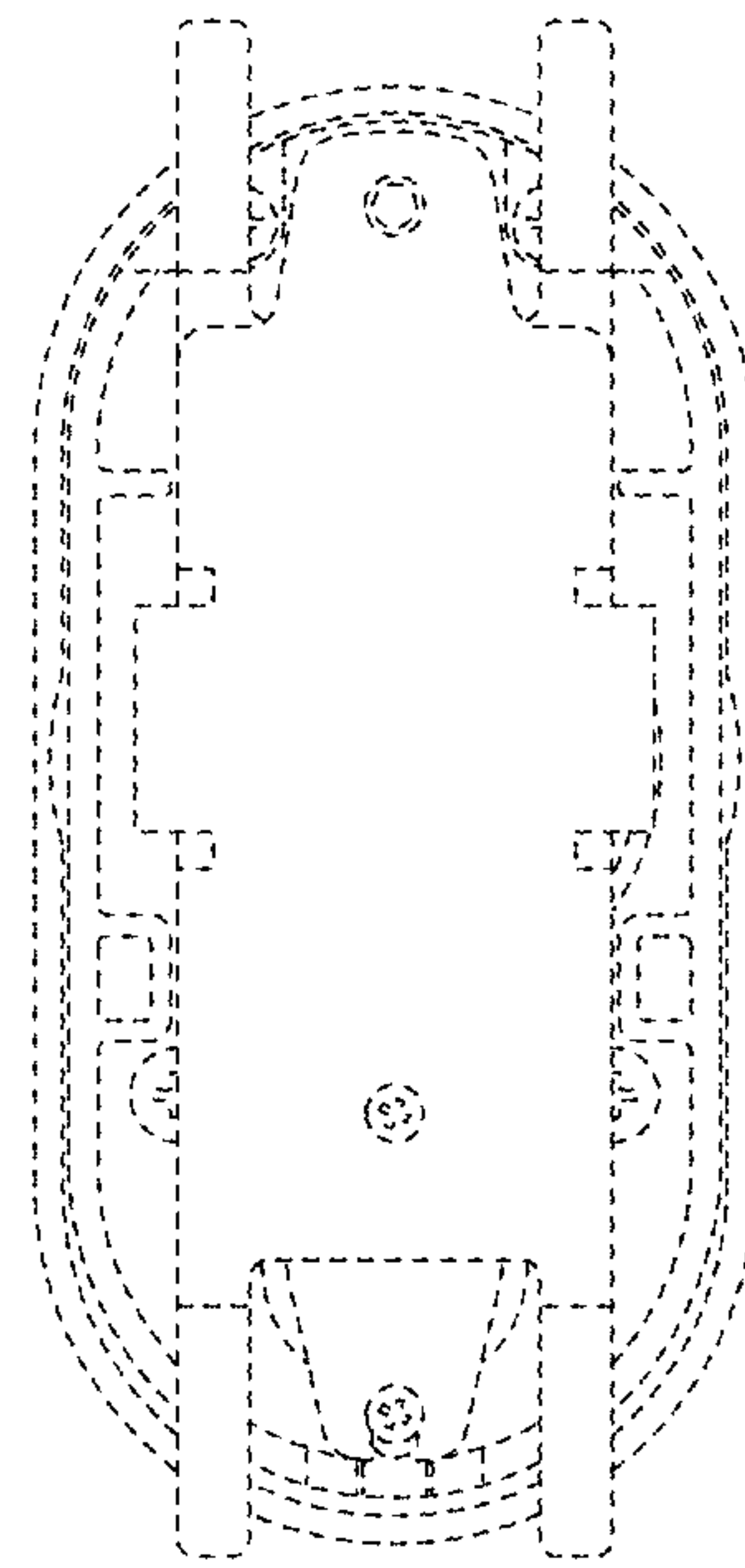

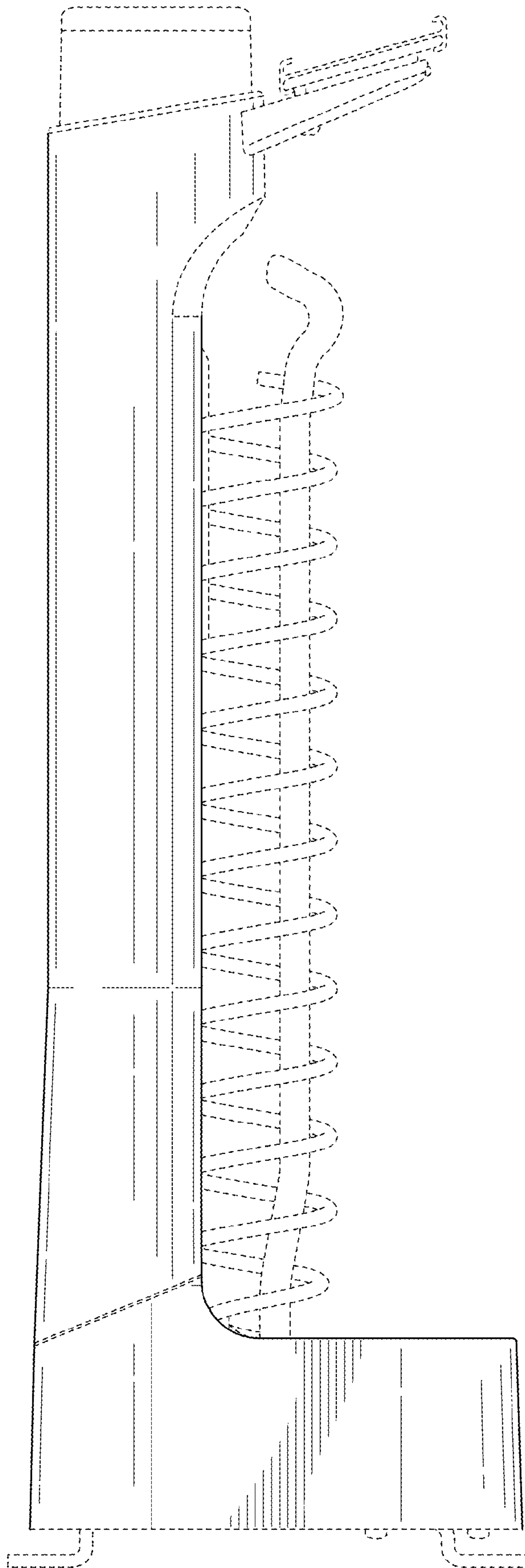

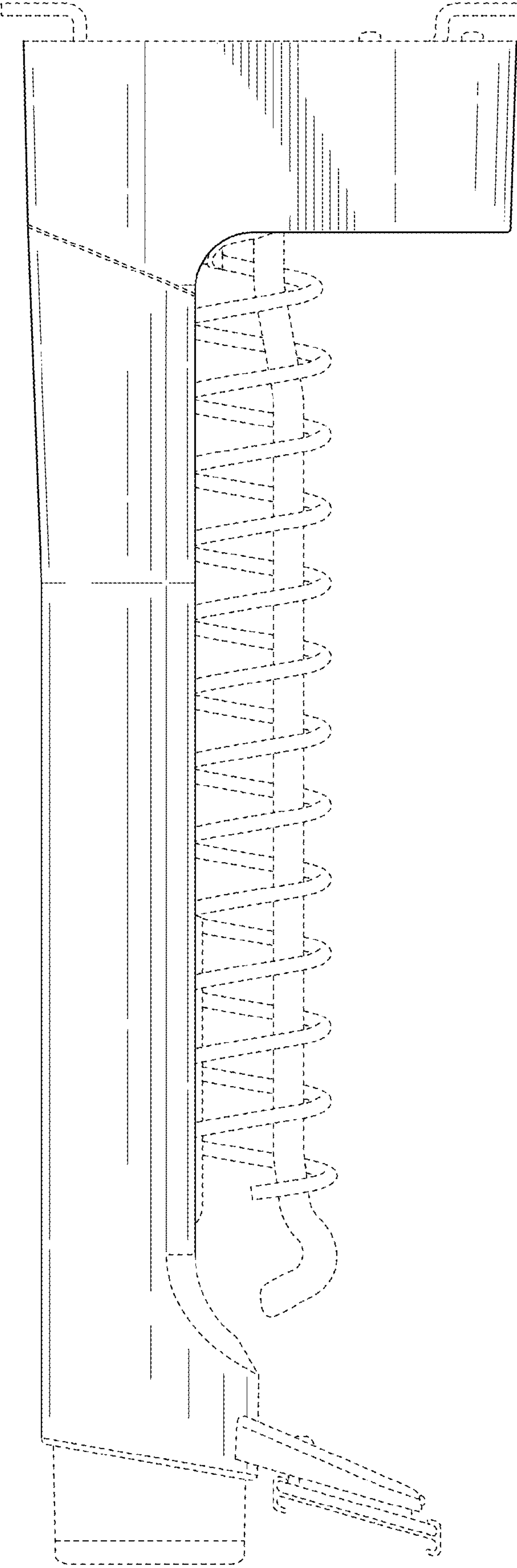

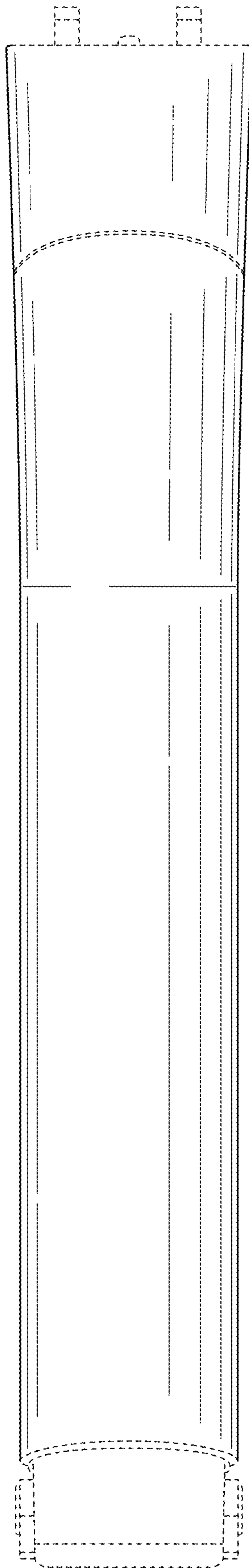

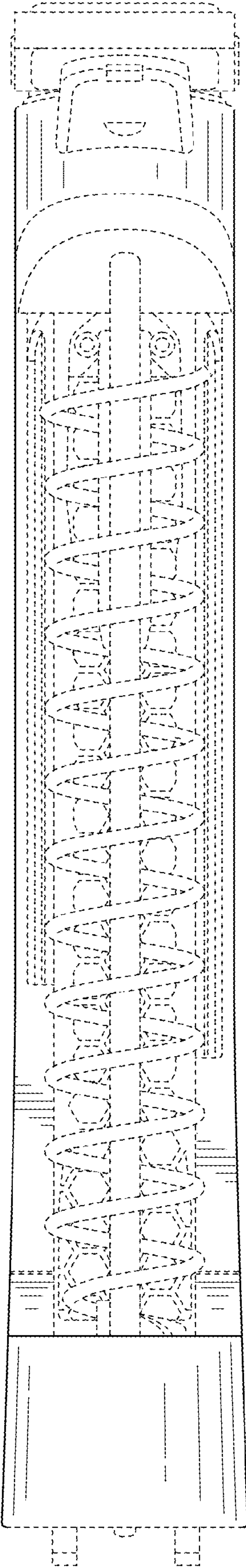

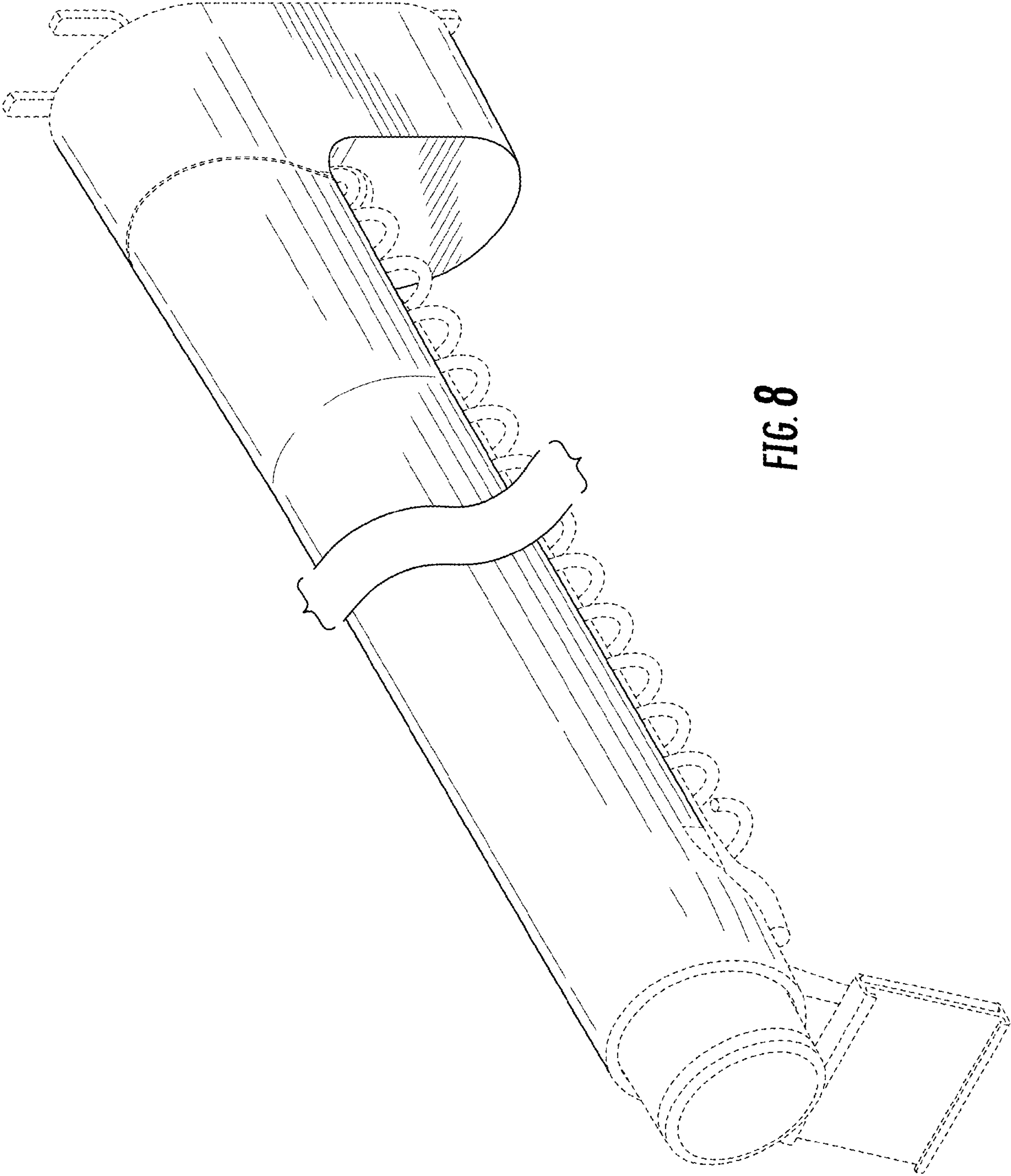

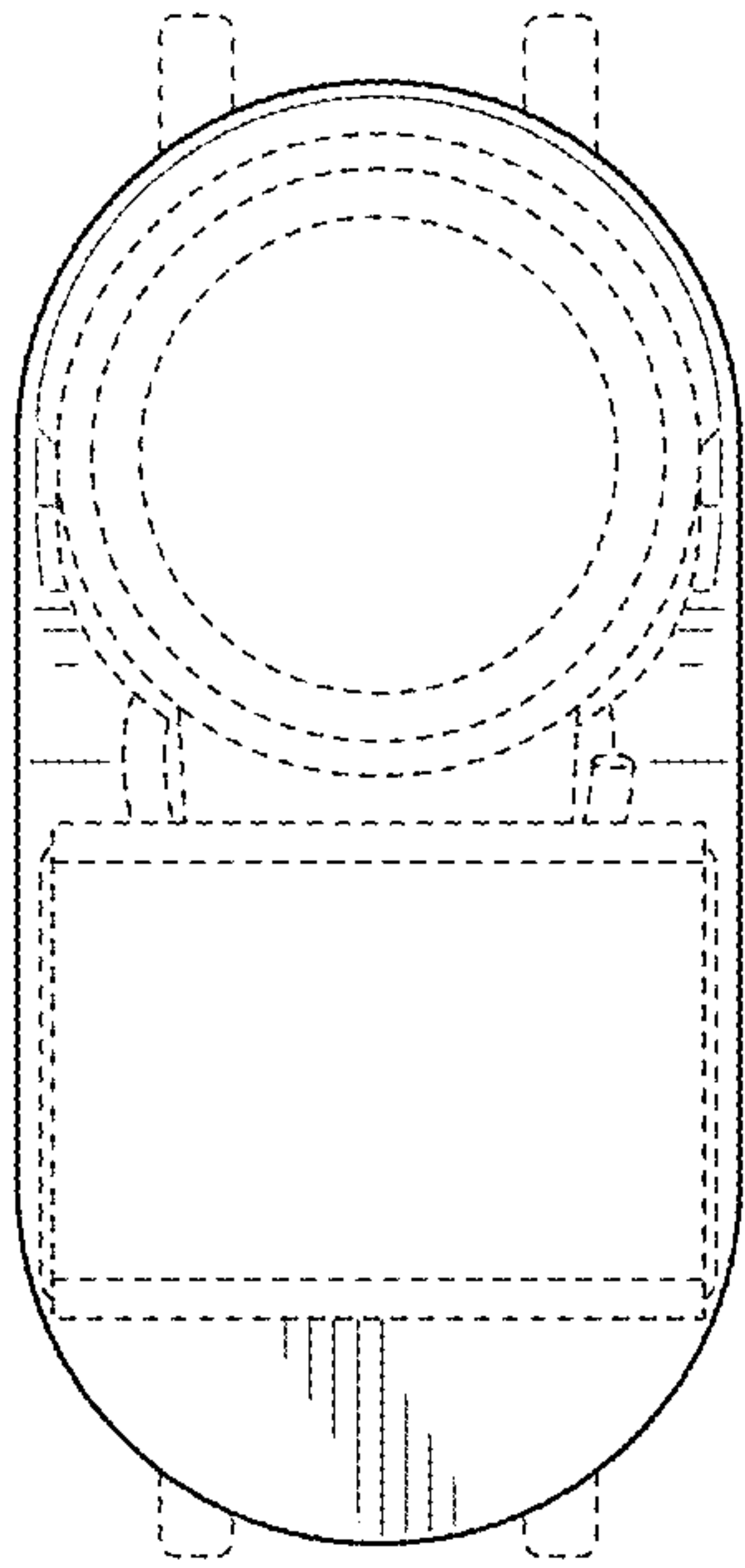

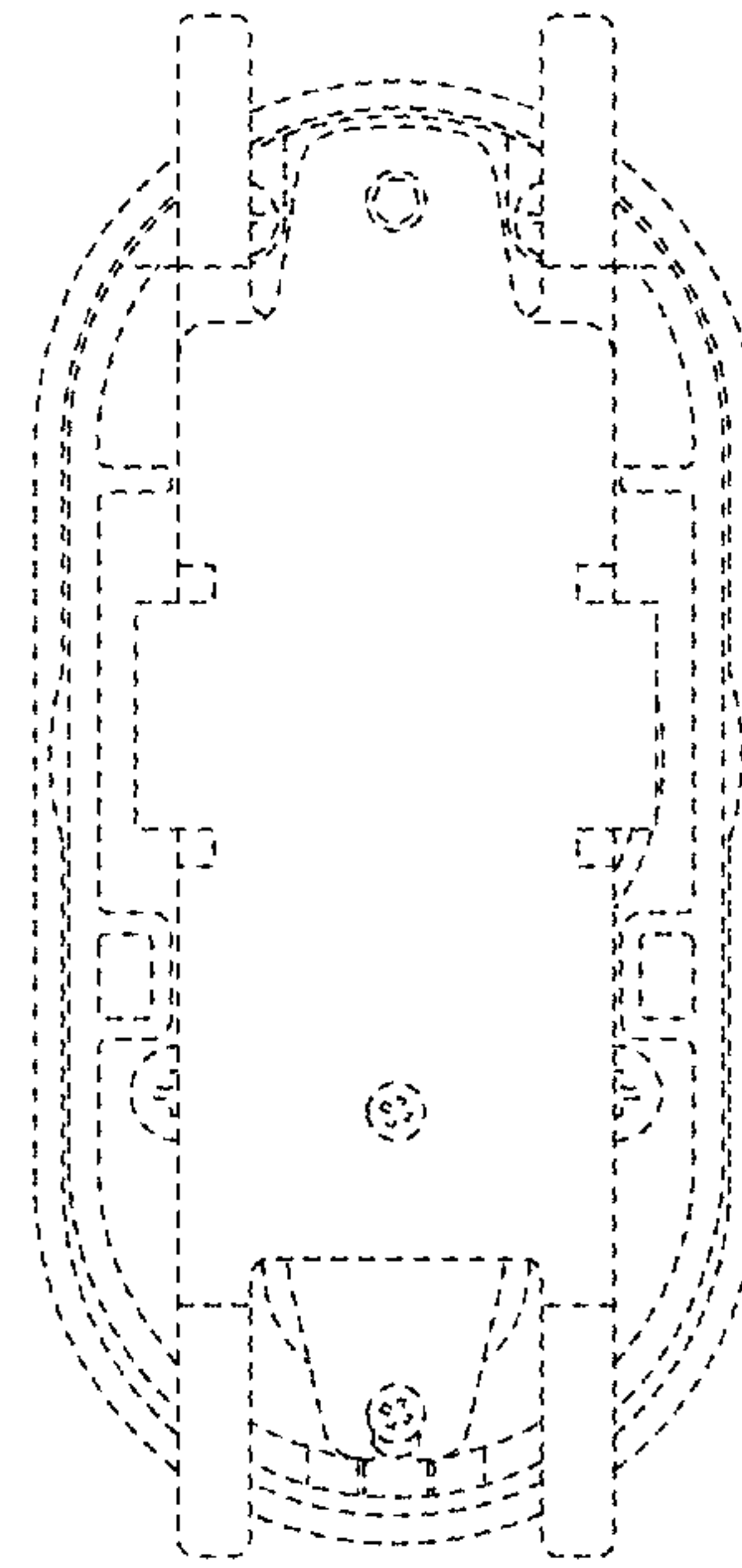

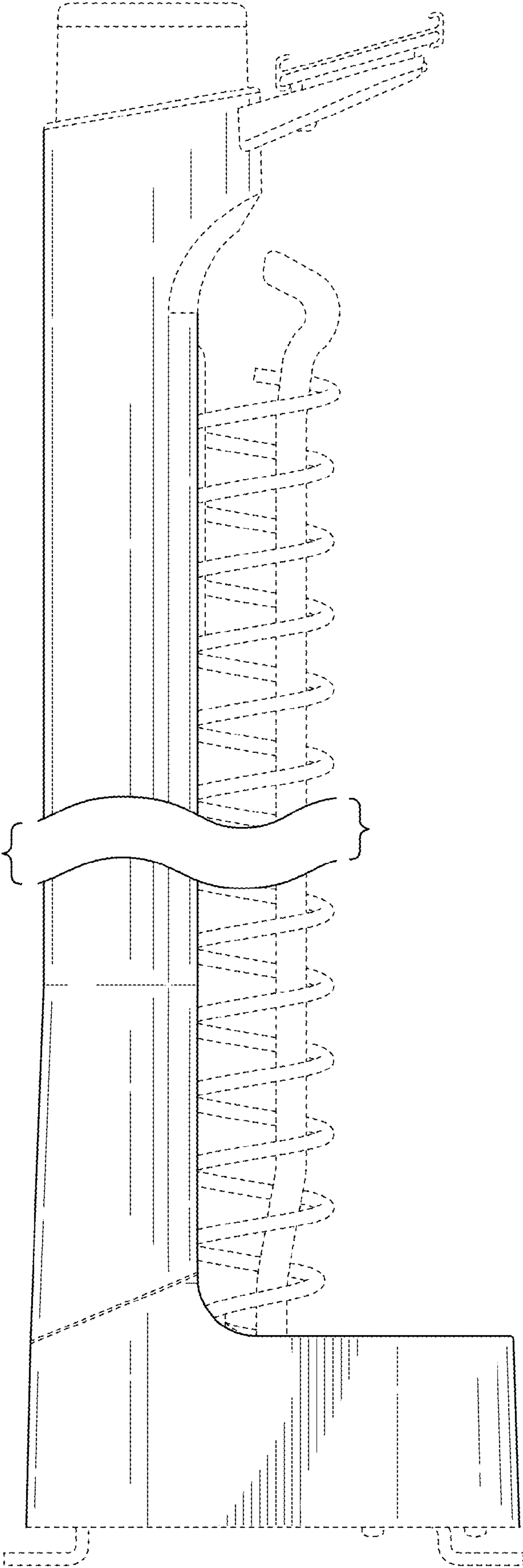

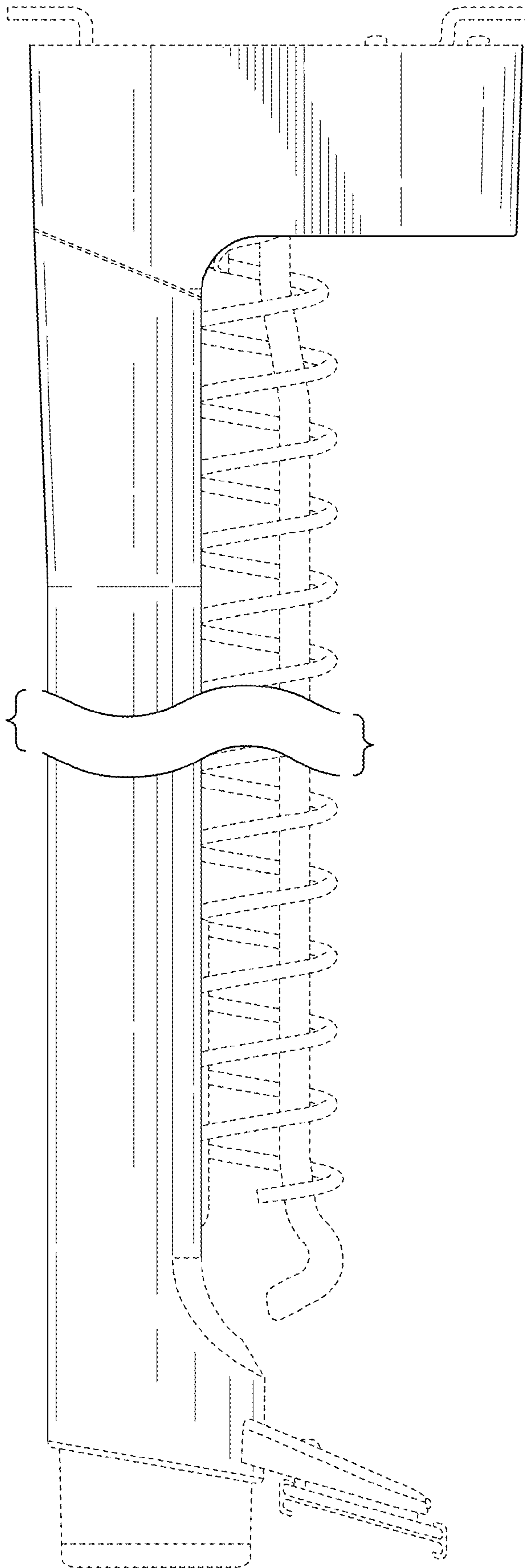

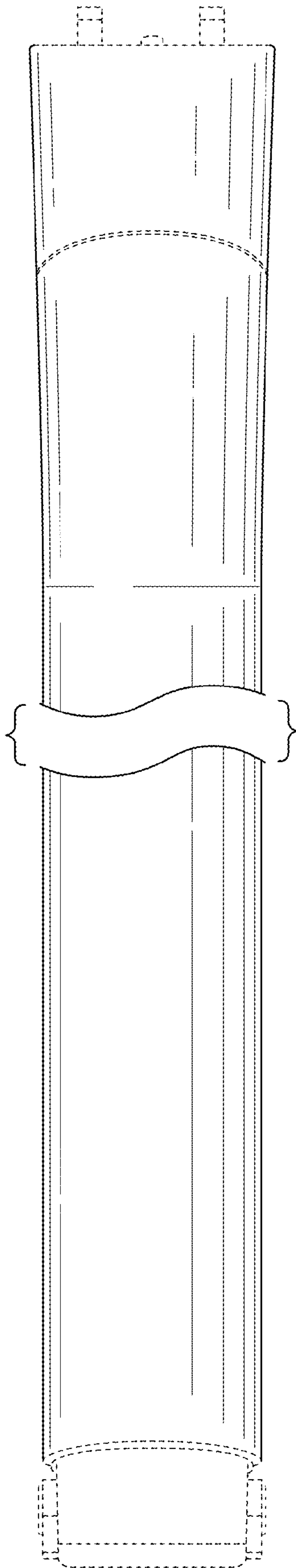

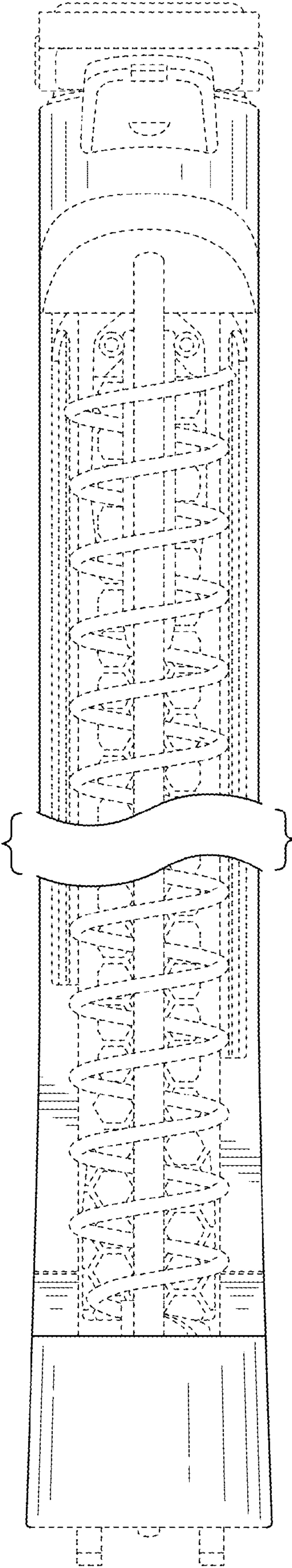
