FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a half-dozen pastry tray showing my new design.

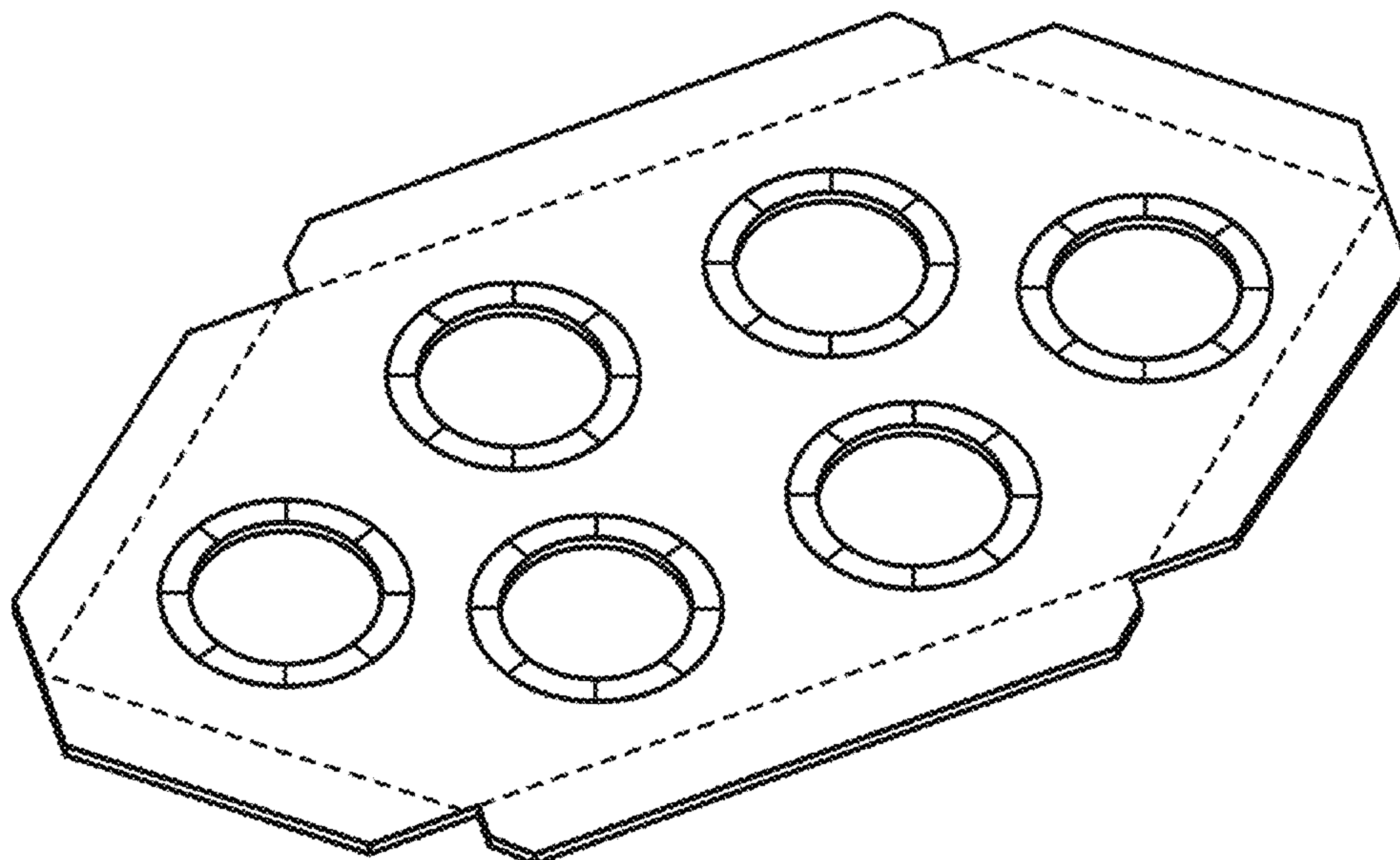
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof; the bottom view being a mirror image.

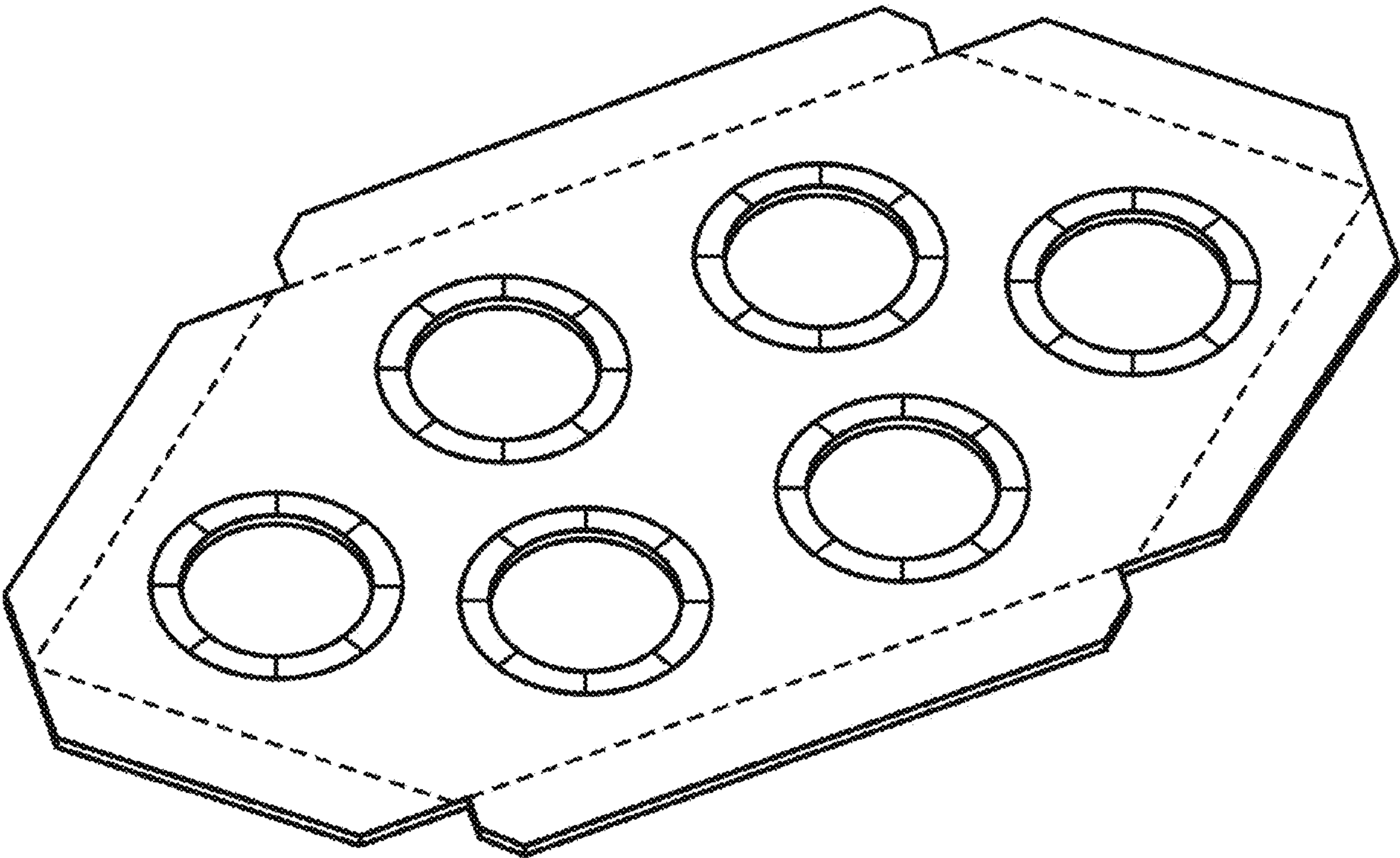

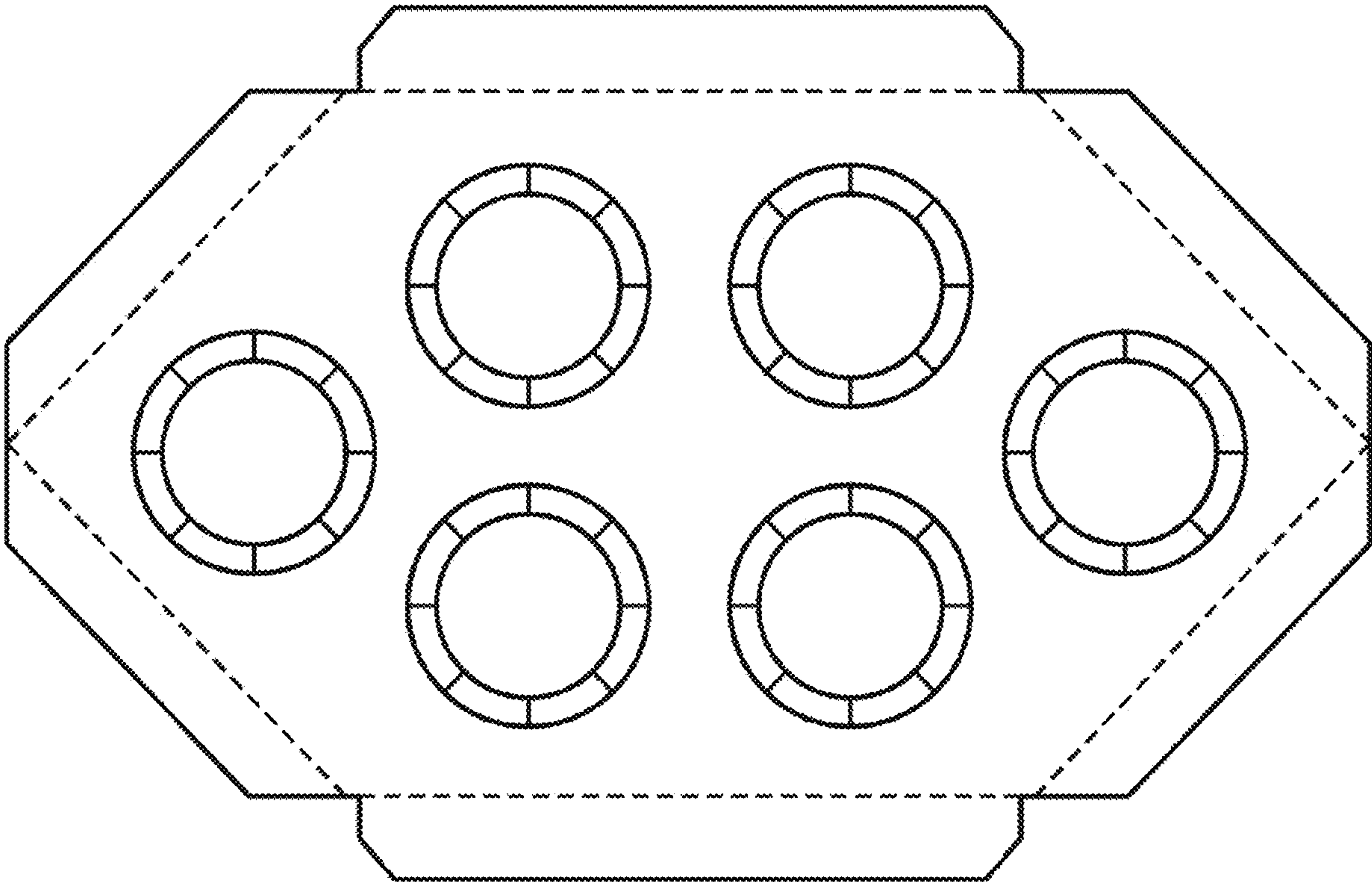
