DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front isometric view of a baseball swing in accordance with the new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof with a seat insert removed;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof with a seat insert removed;

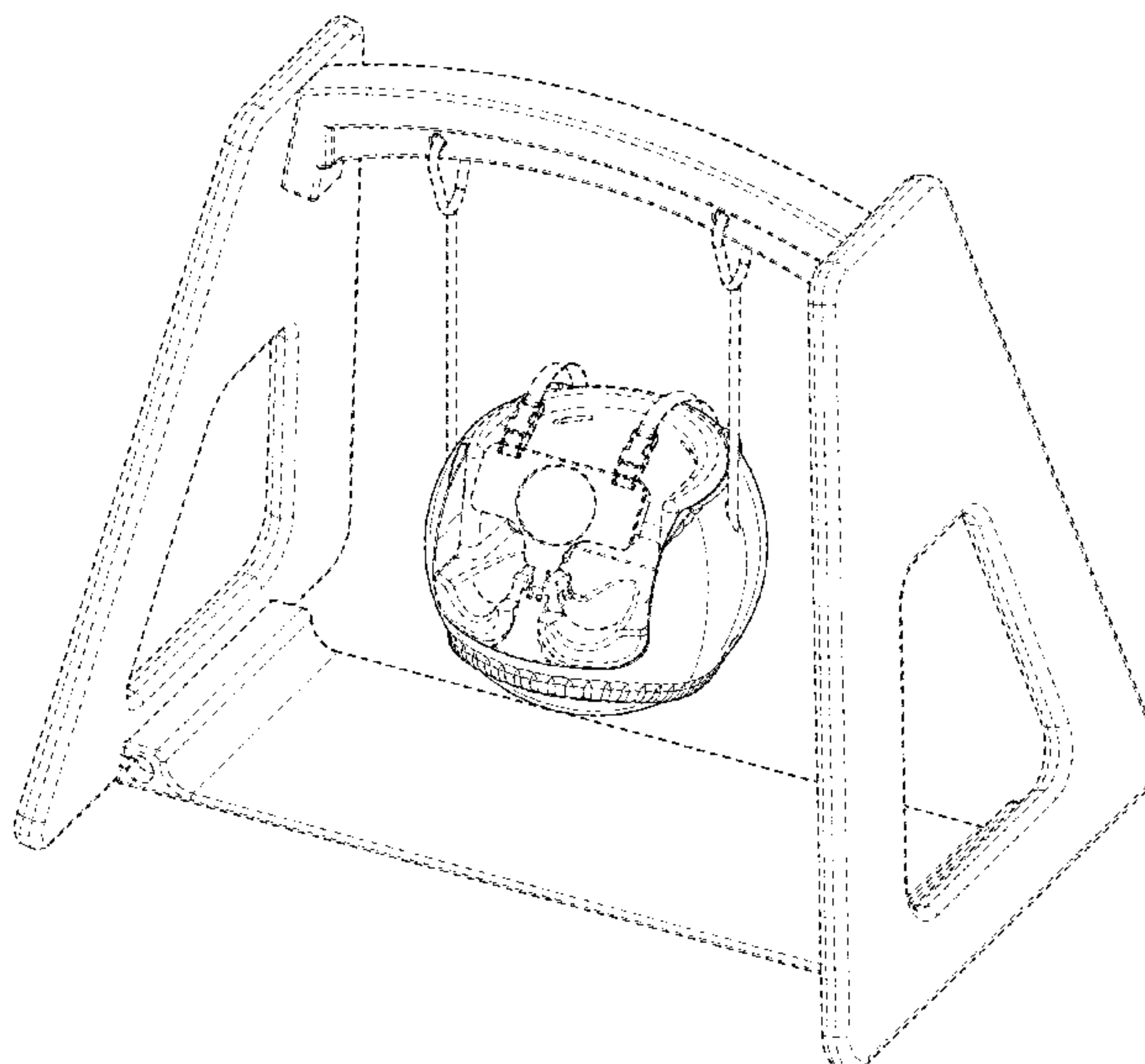
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof with a seat insert removed;

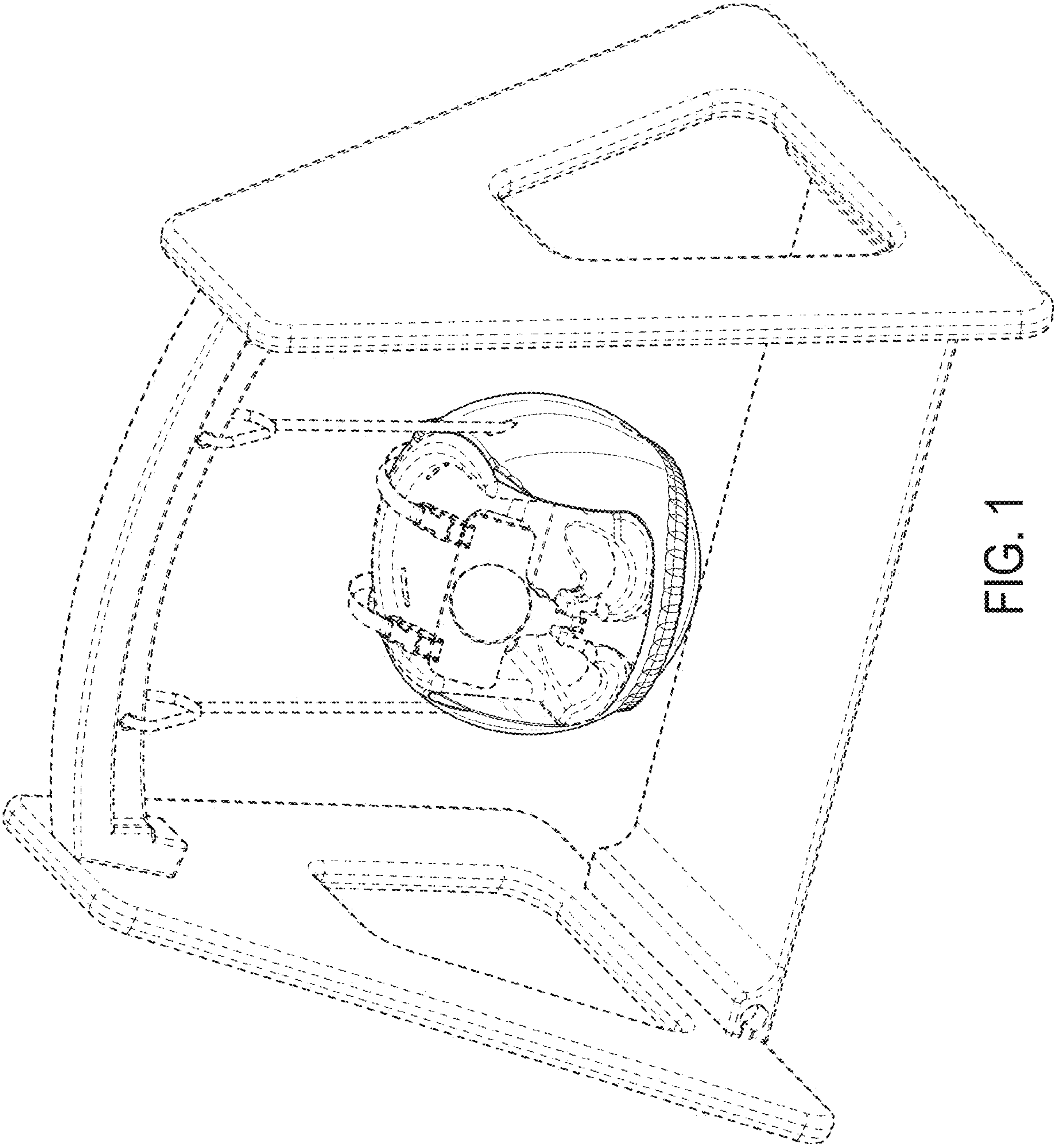

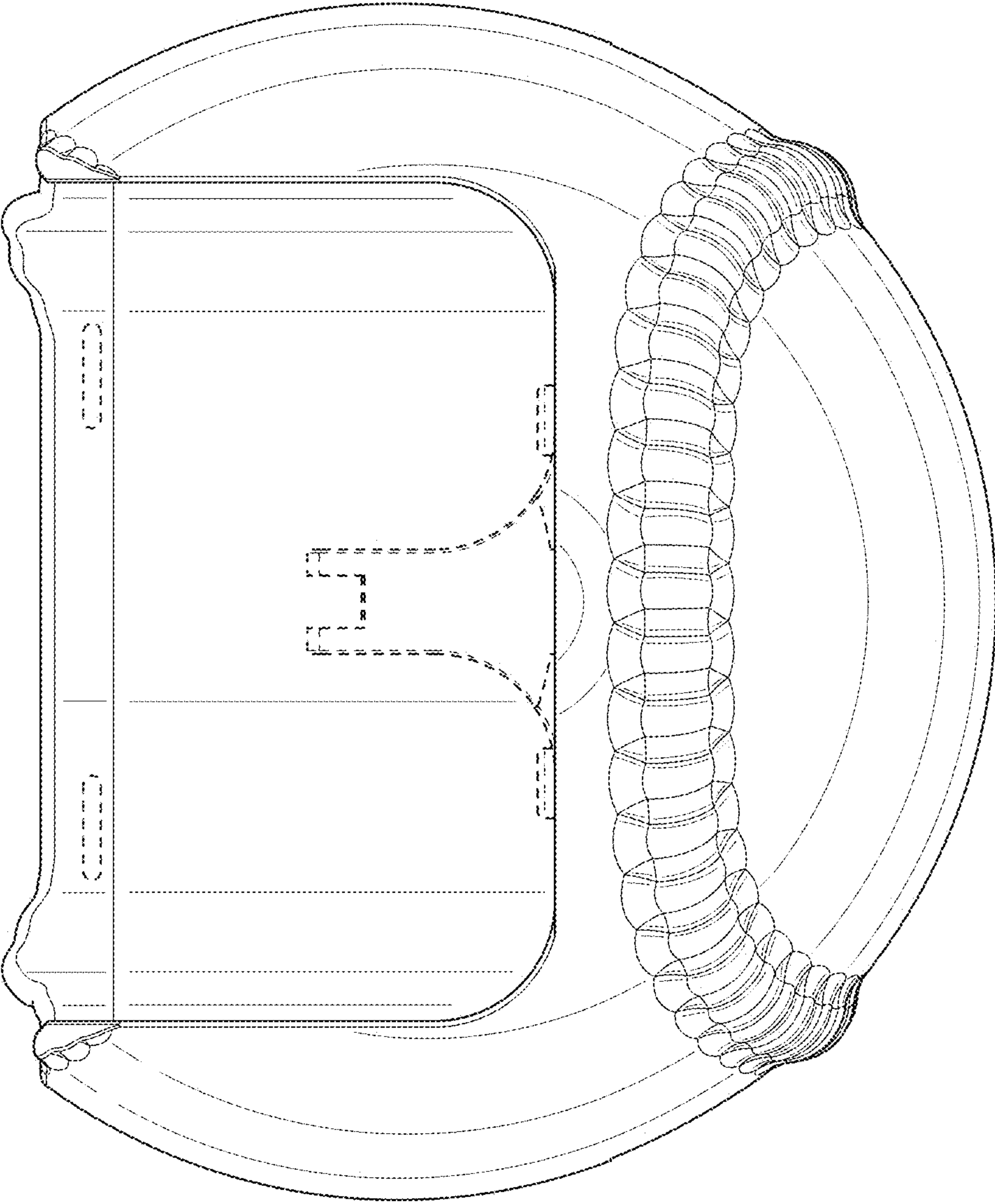

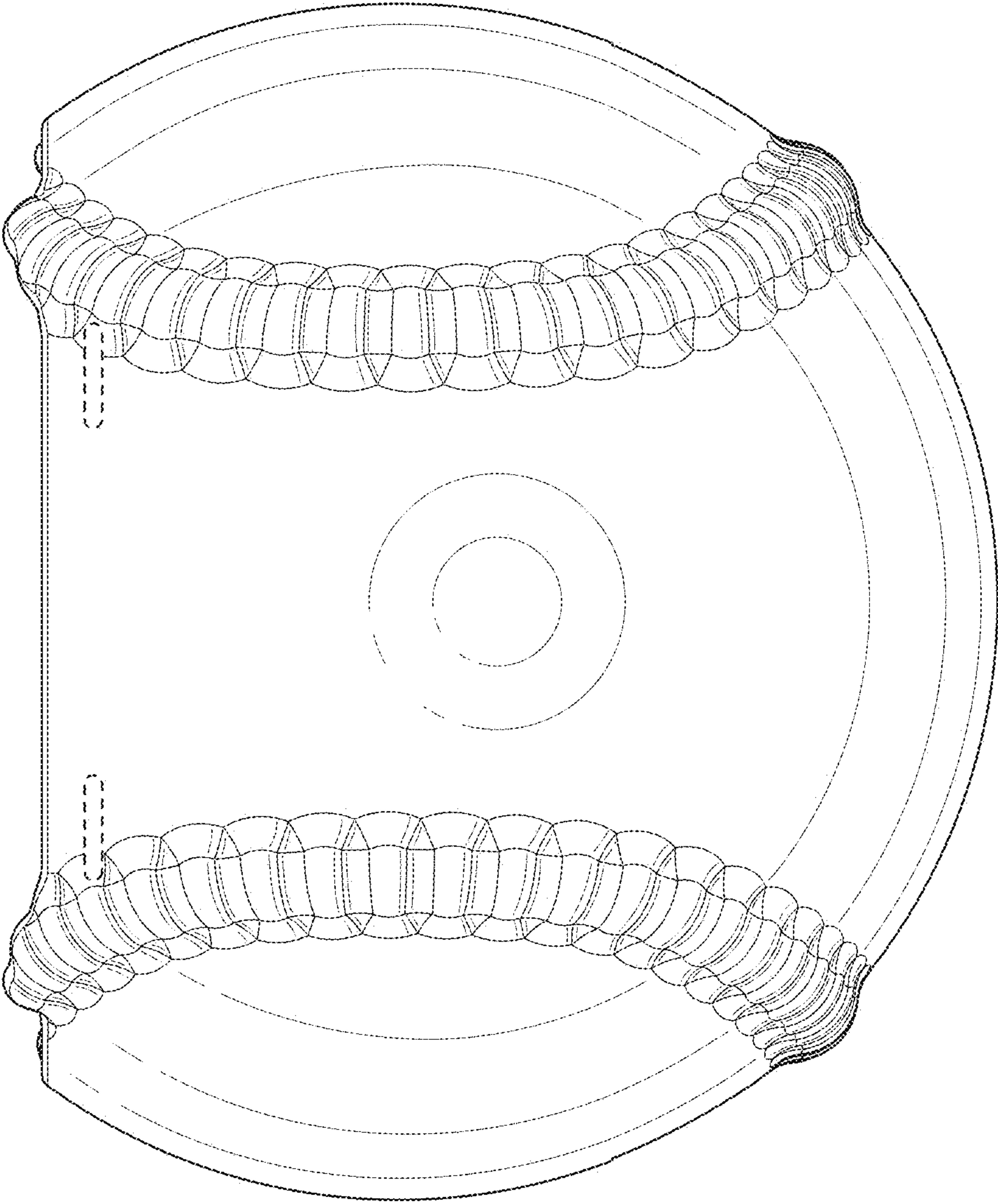

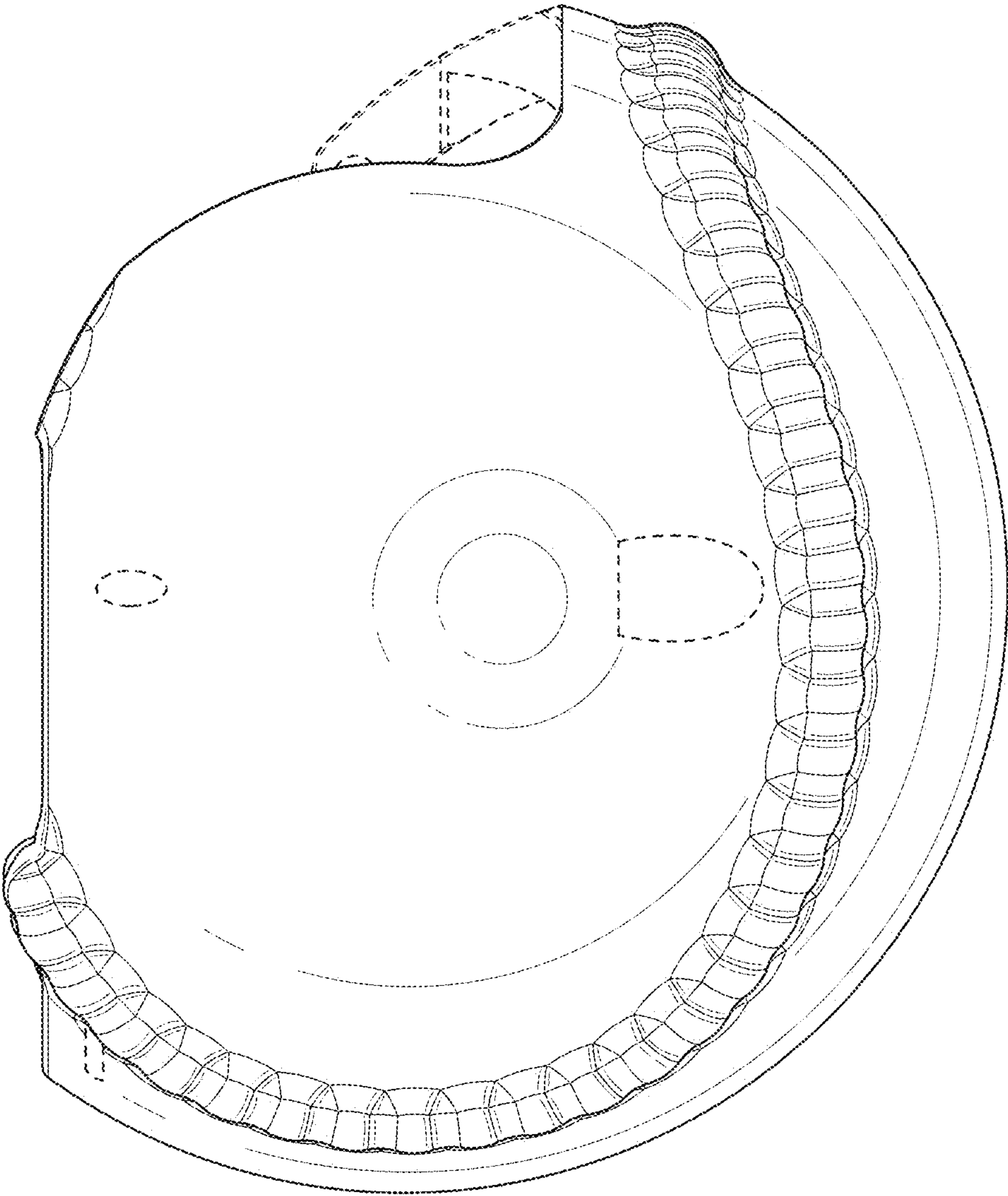

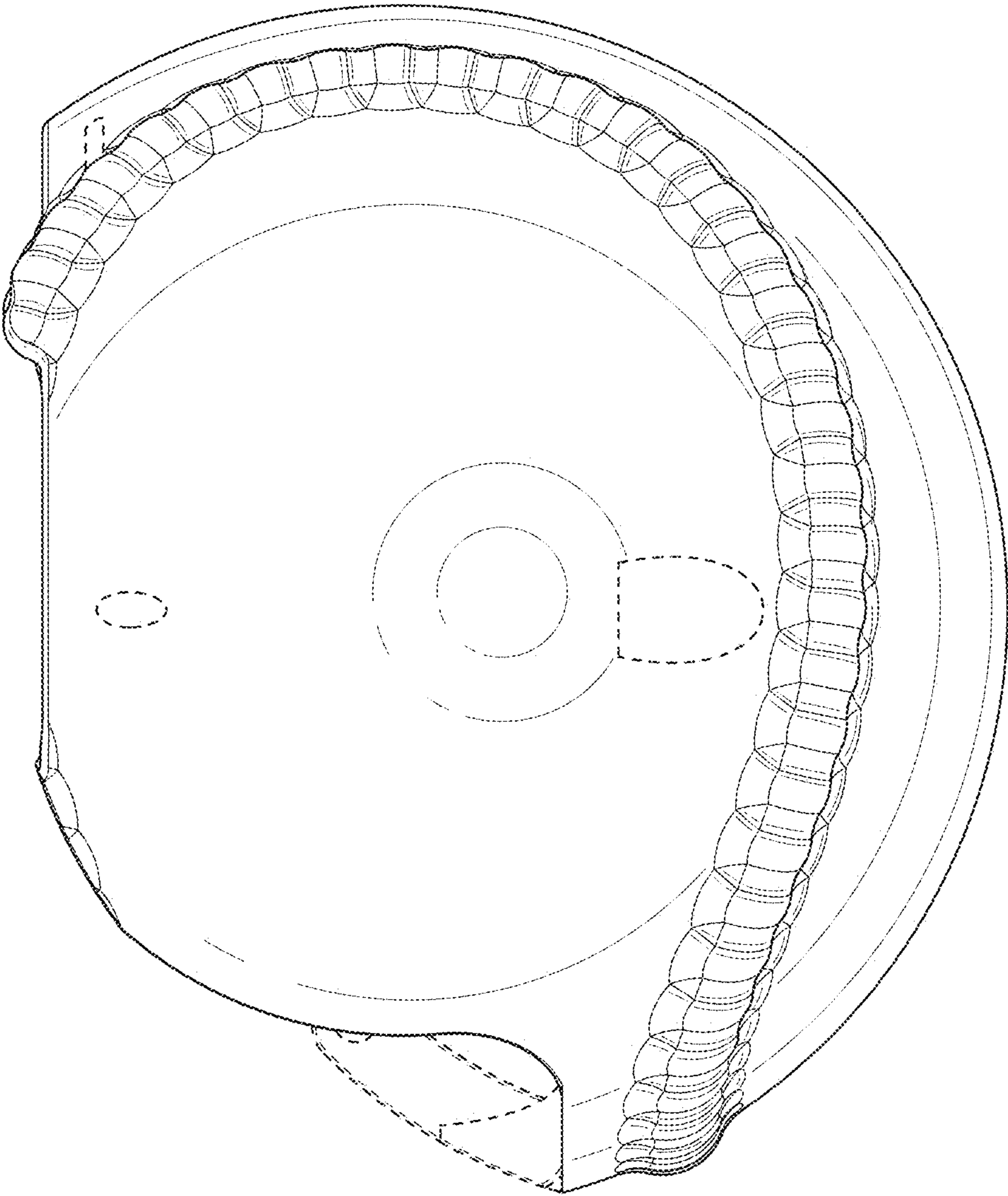

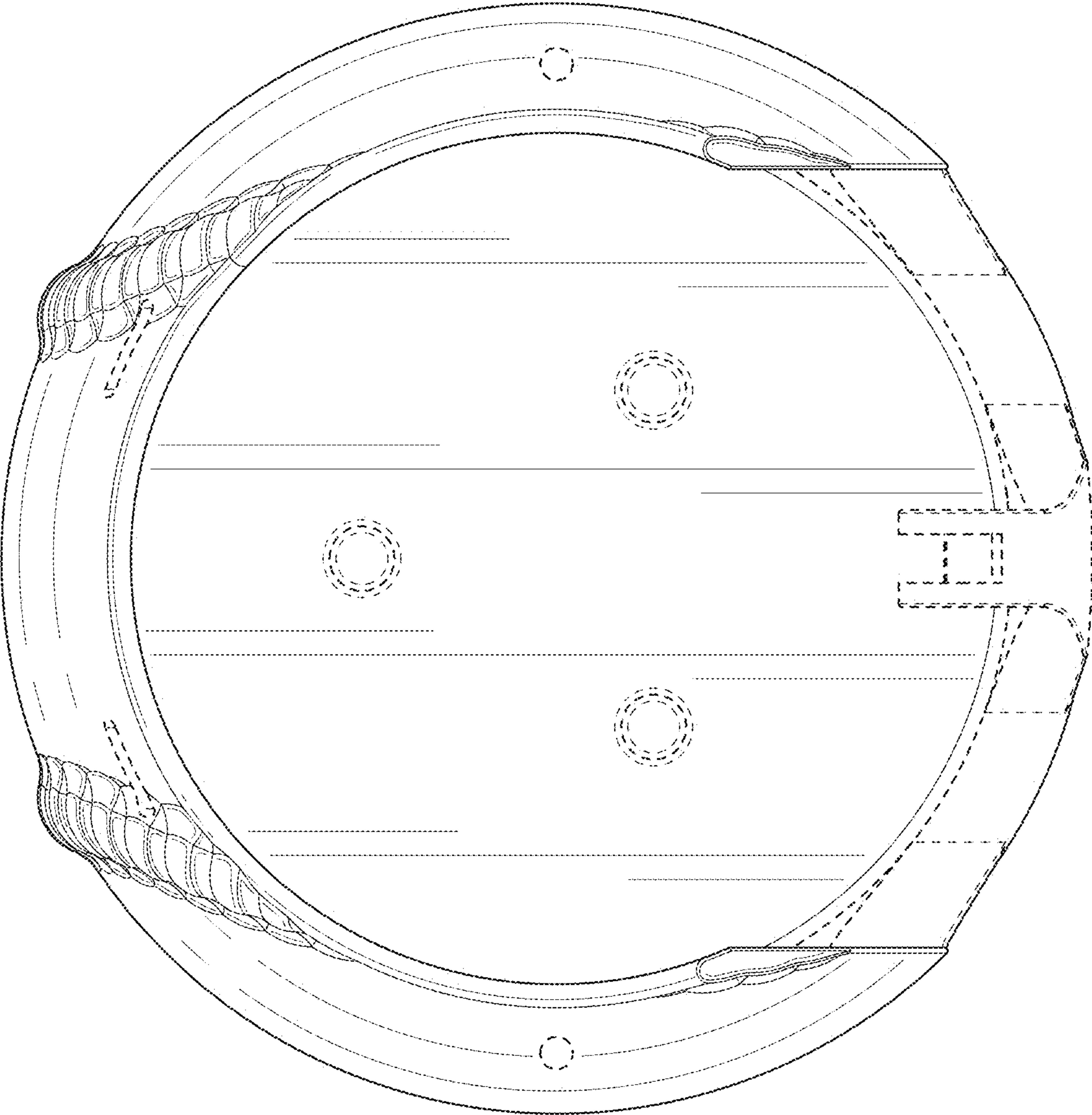

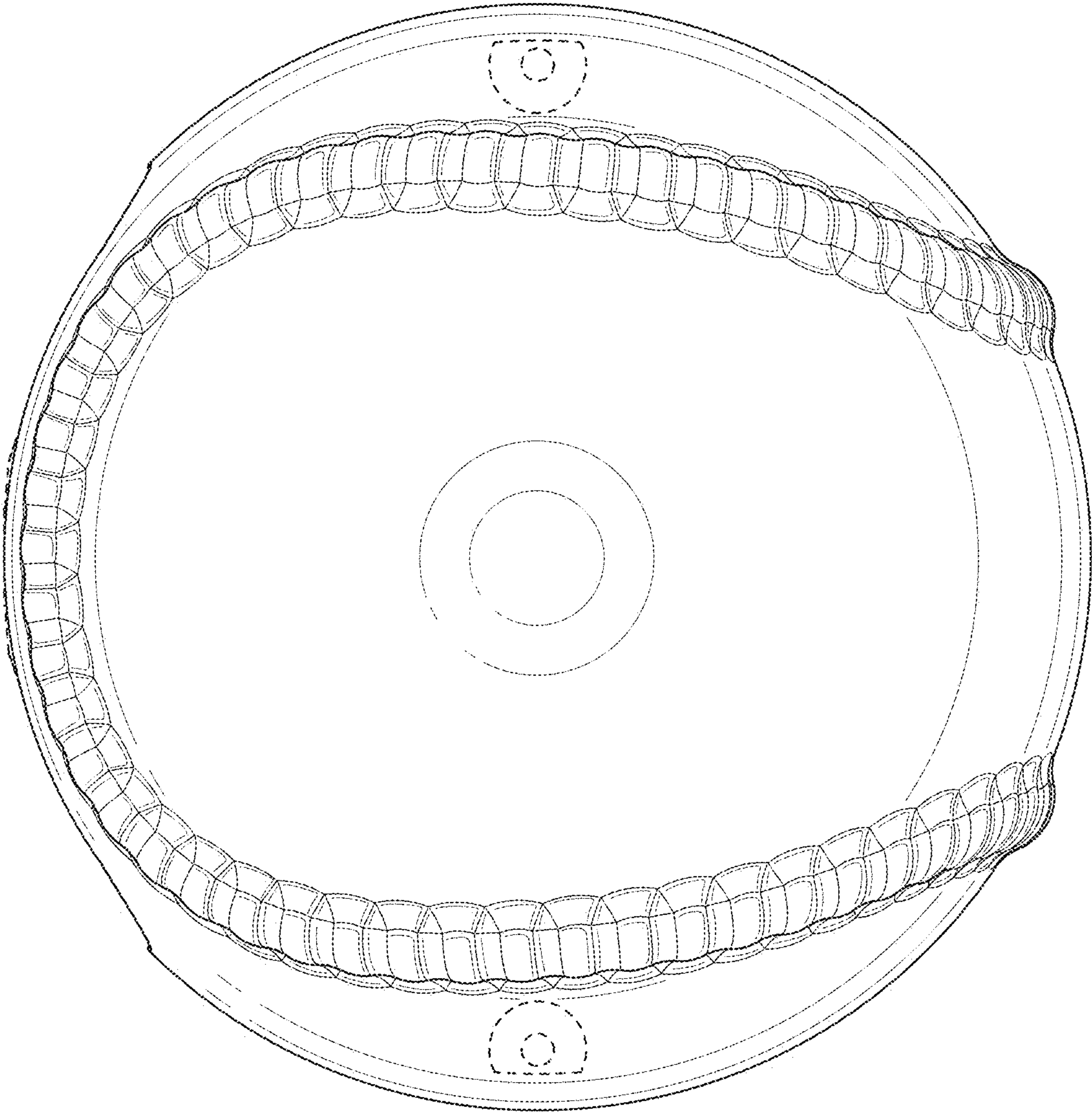
