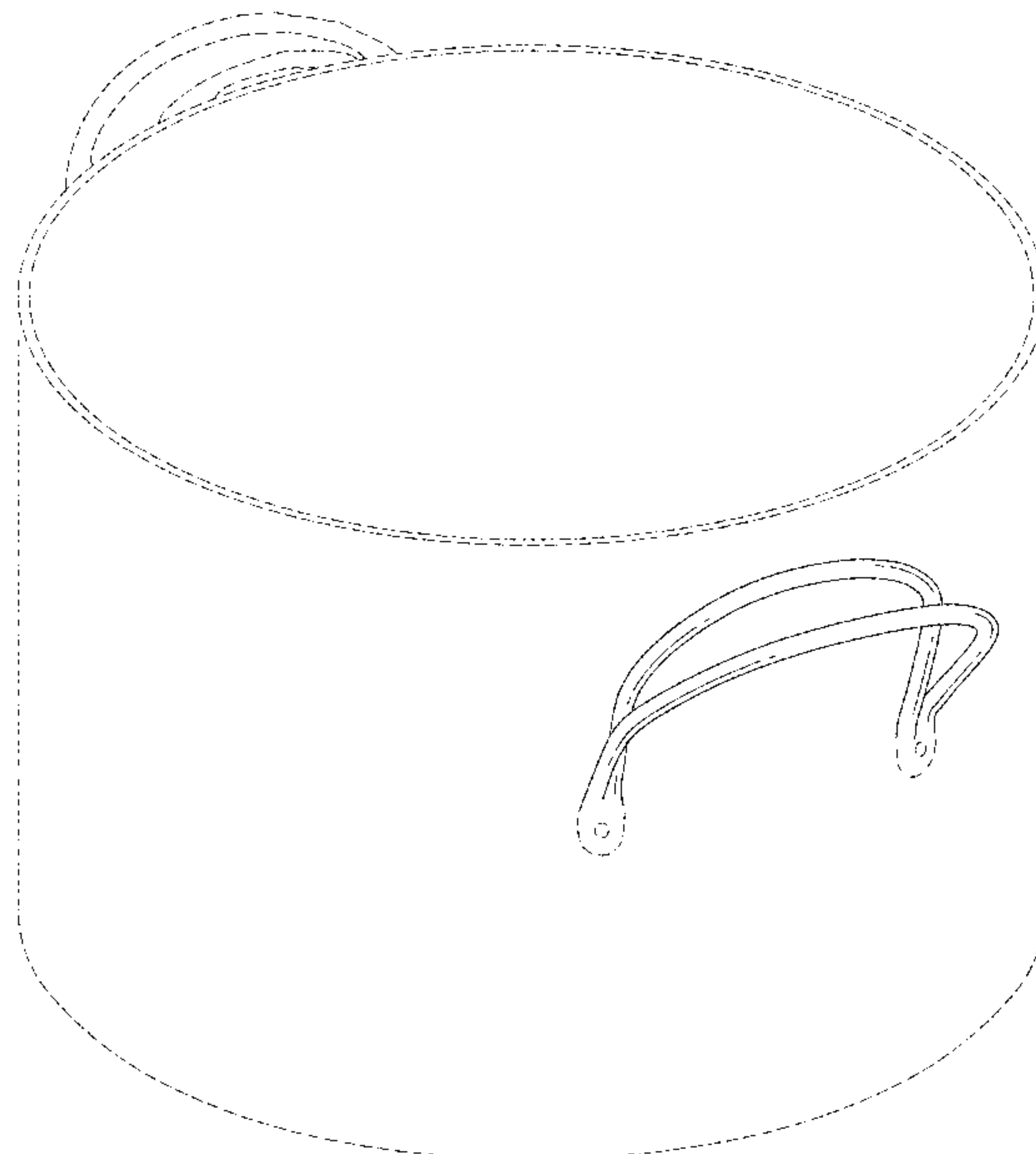
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cookware handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pair of a new cookware handle design;
 FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front view of the new cookware handle design;
 FIG. 4 is a top view of a pair of the new cookware handle design;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged perspective view of the new cookware handle design;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged side view of the new cookware handle design;
 FIG. 7 is an enlarged front view of the new cookware handle design; and,
 FIG. 8 is an enlarged back elevation view of the new cookware handle design.

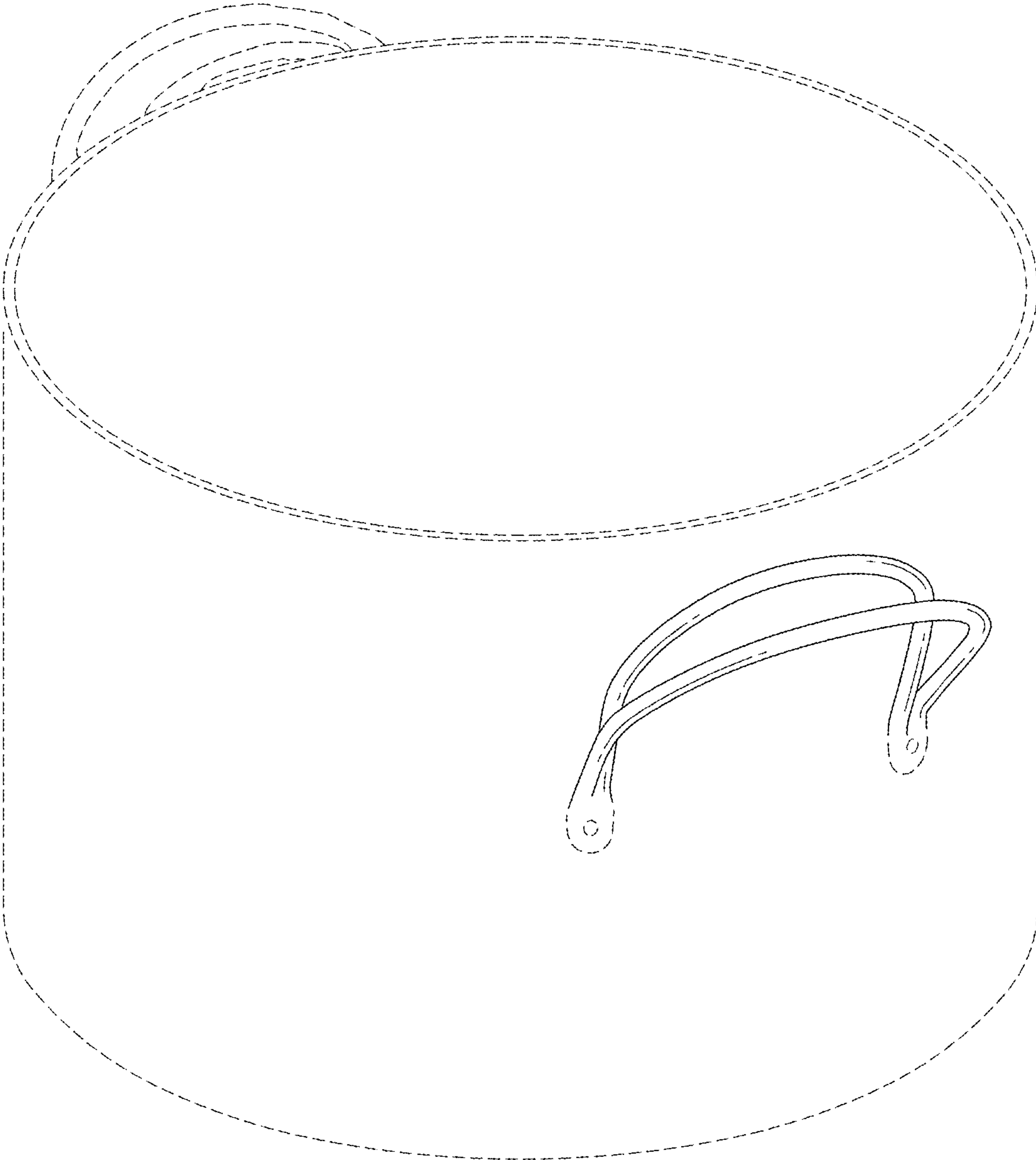

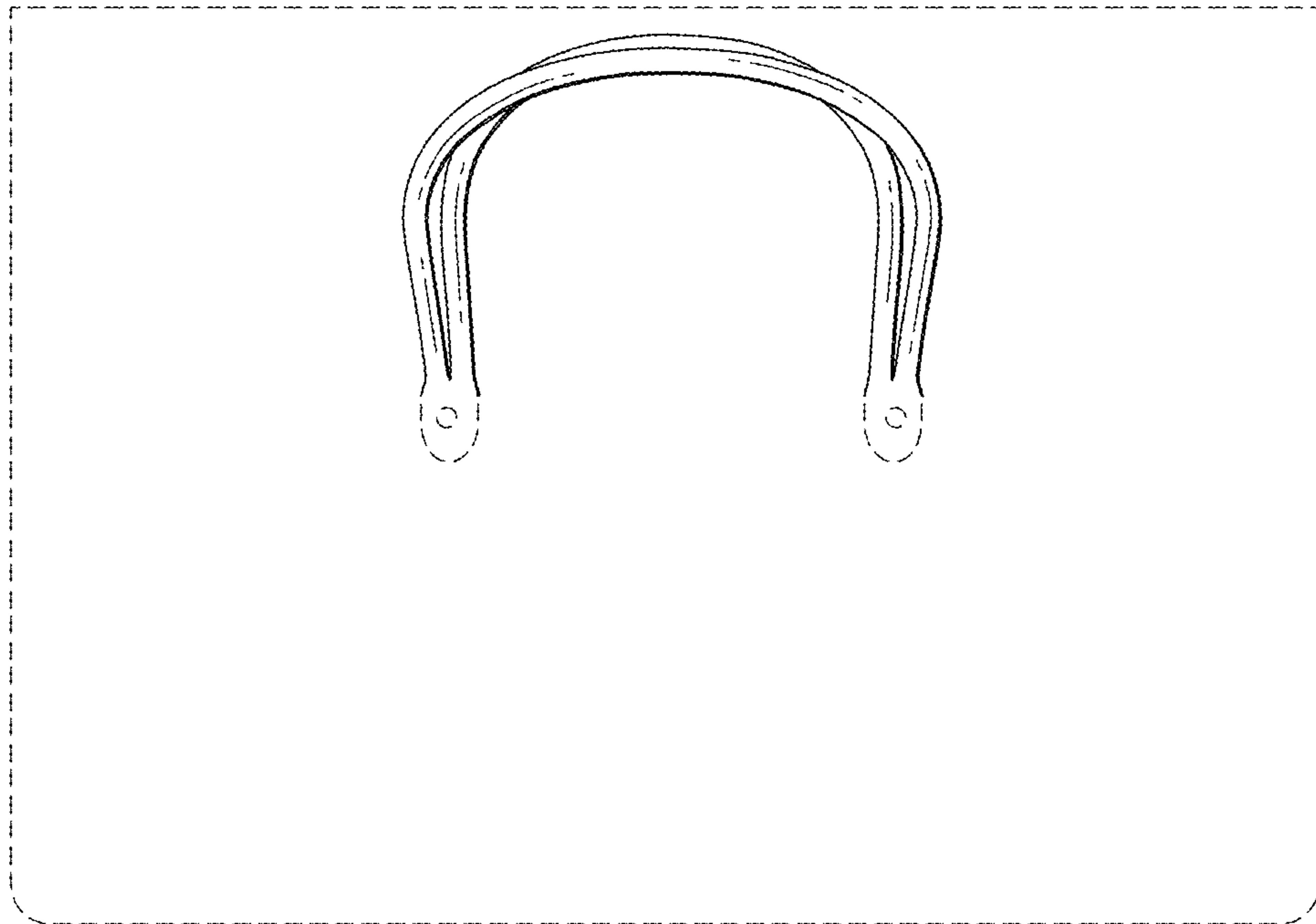

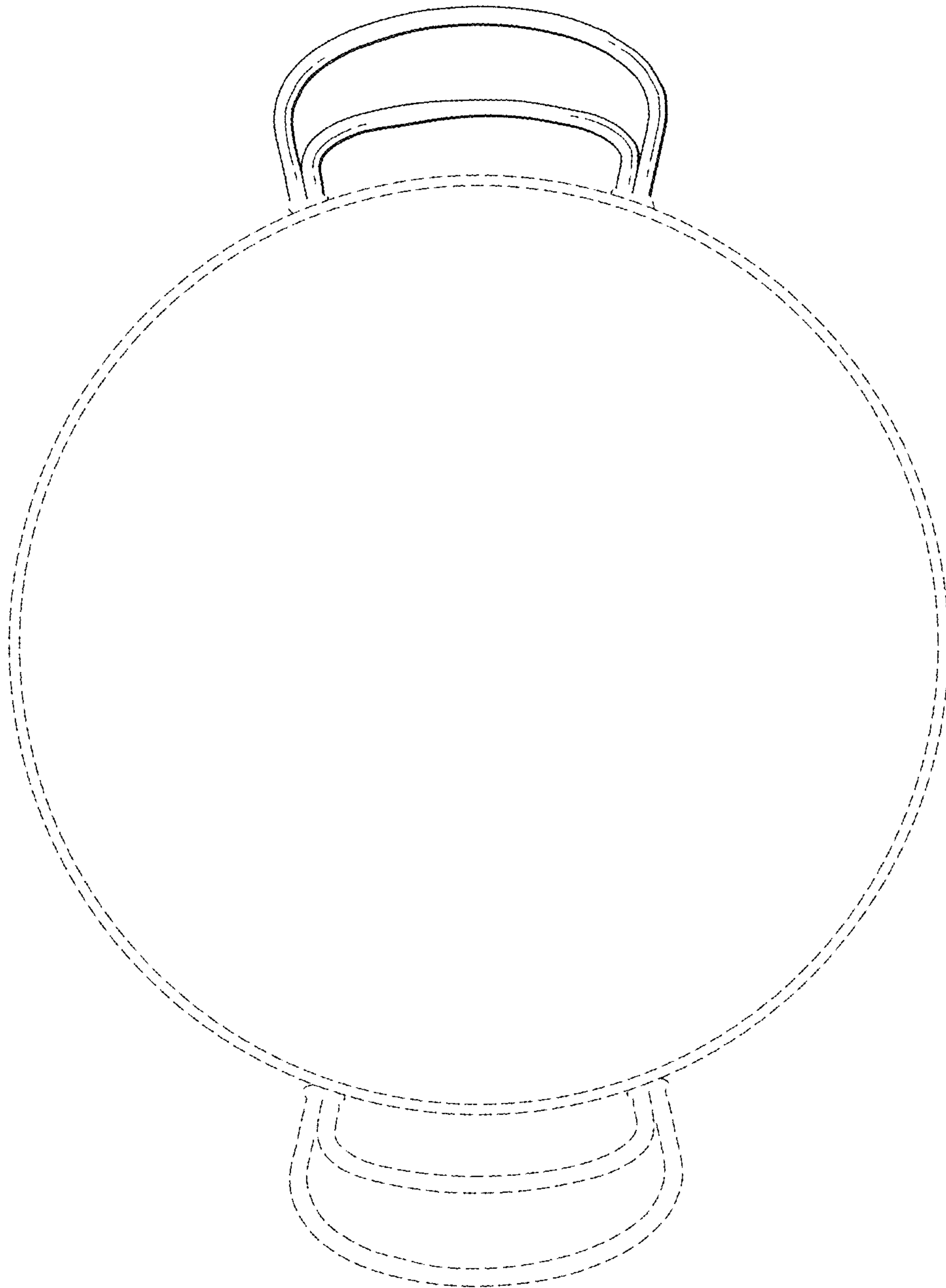

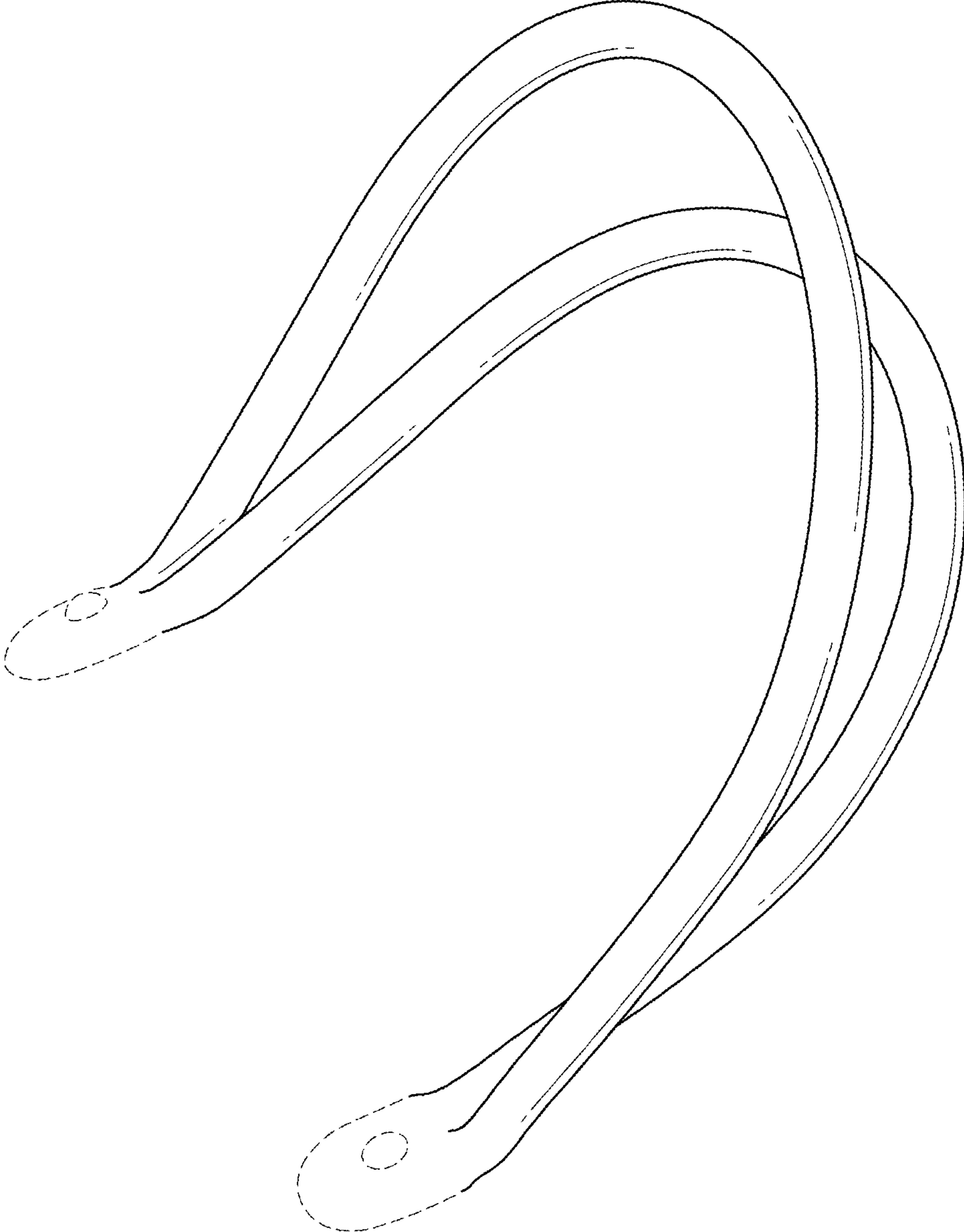

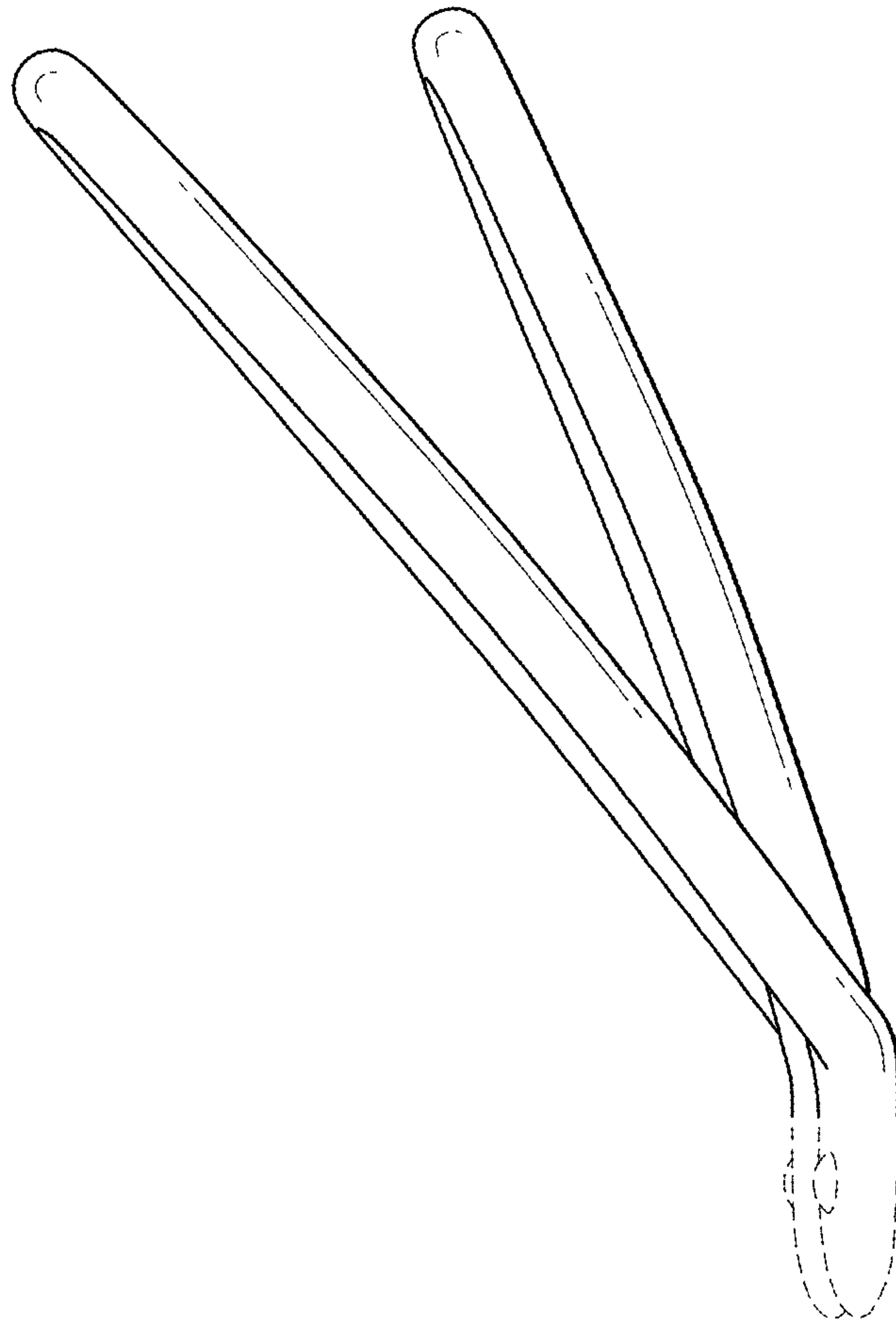

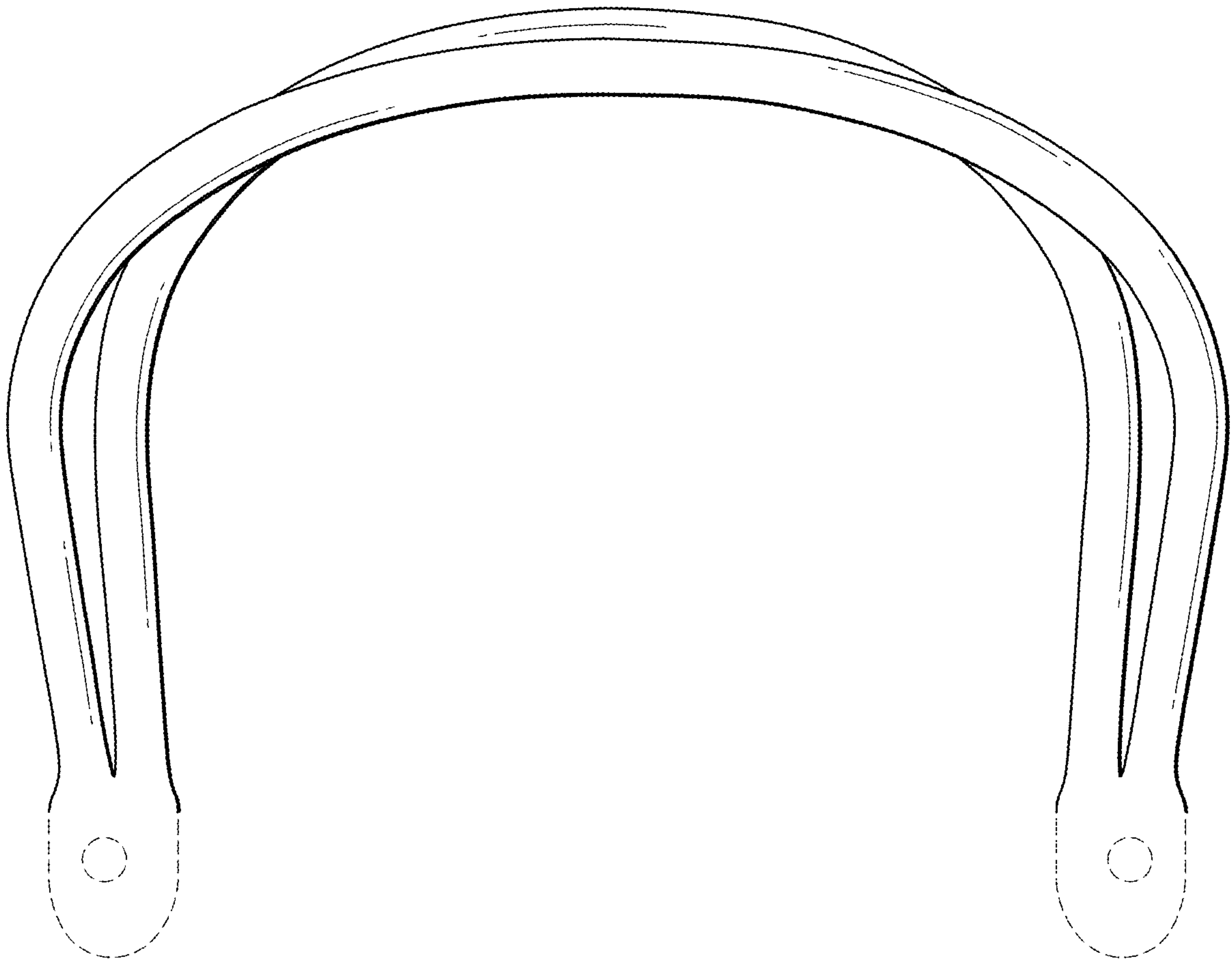

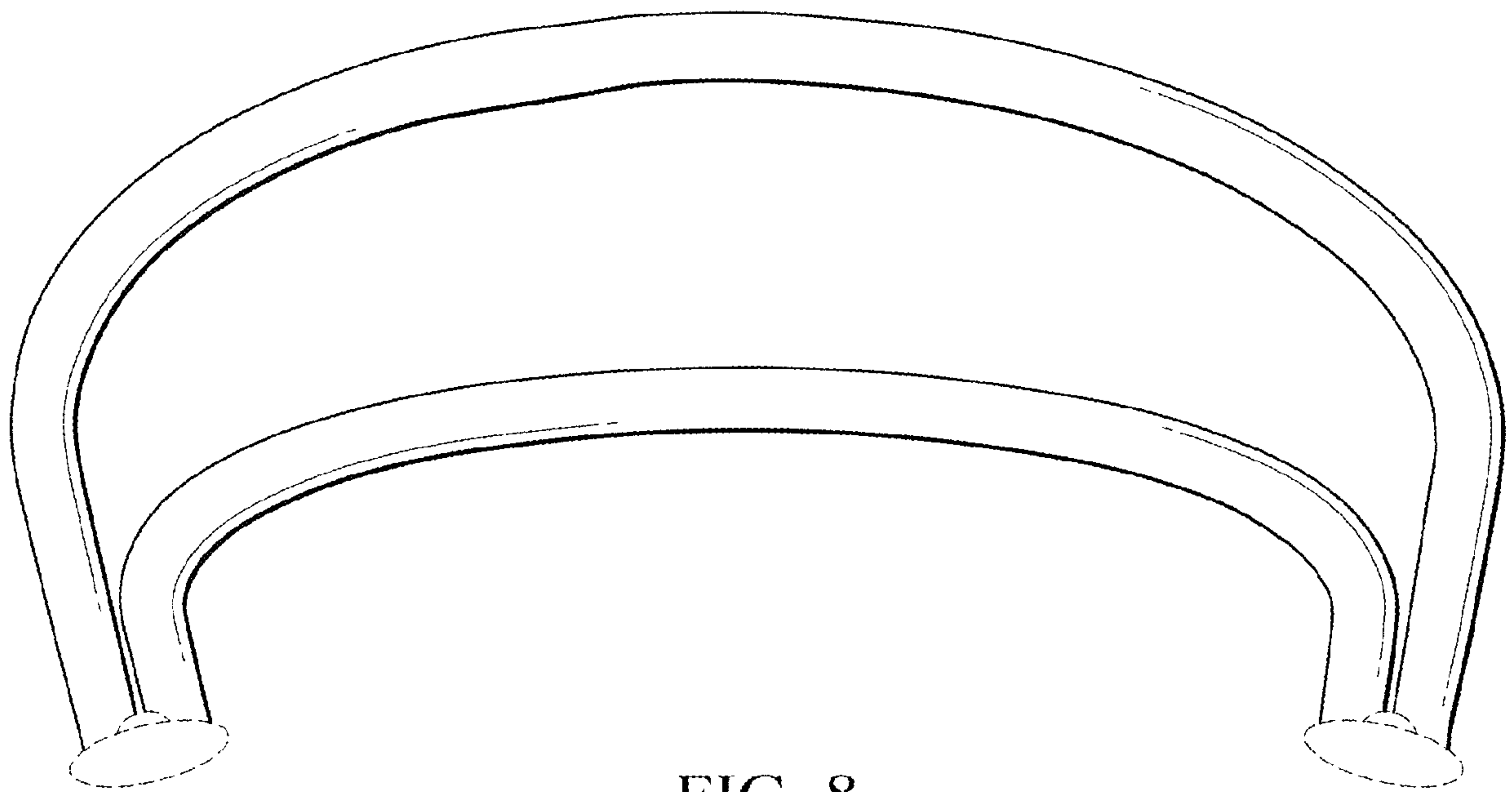
