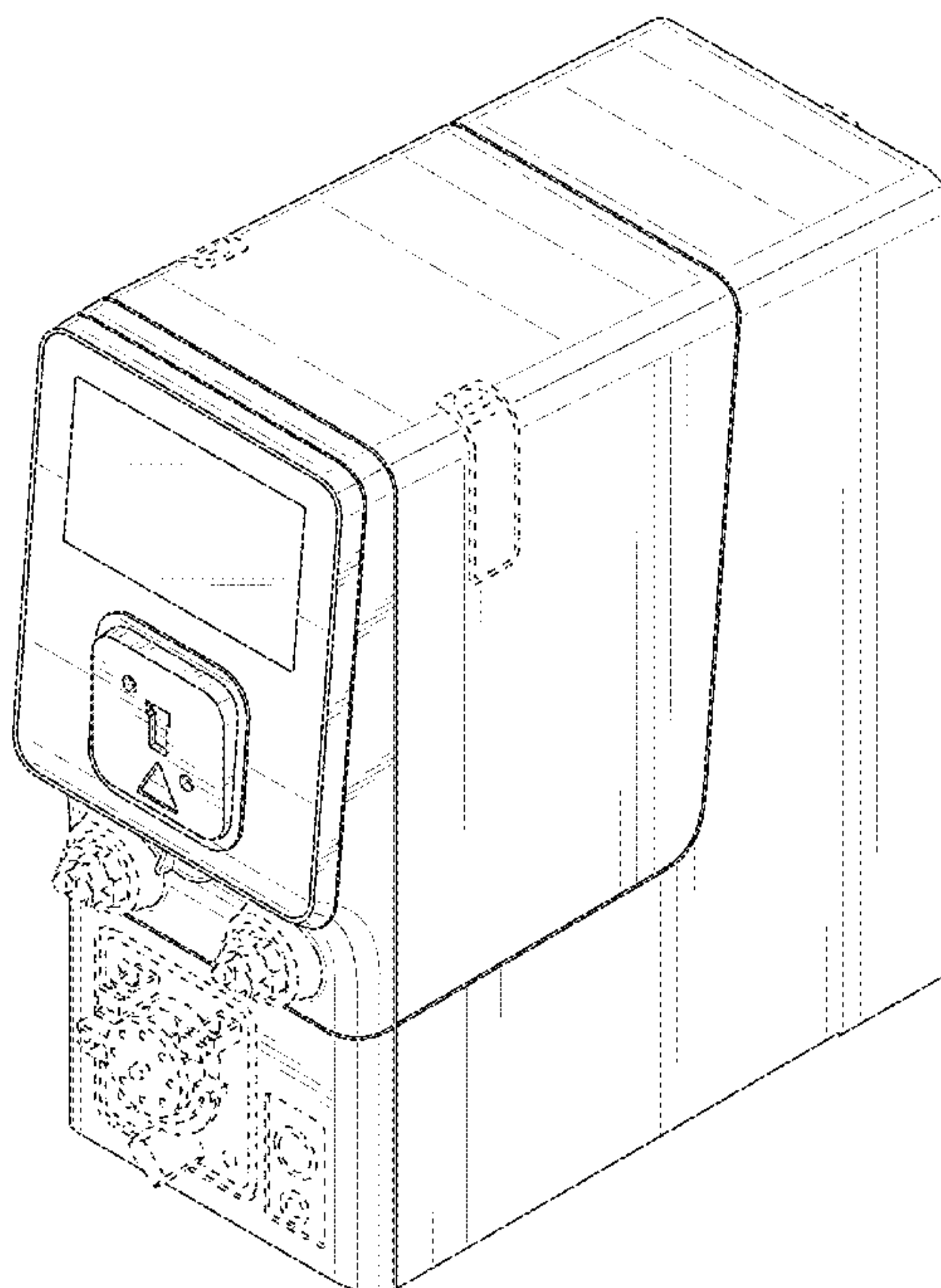
The ornamental design for an electroporation device, as

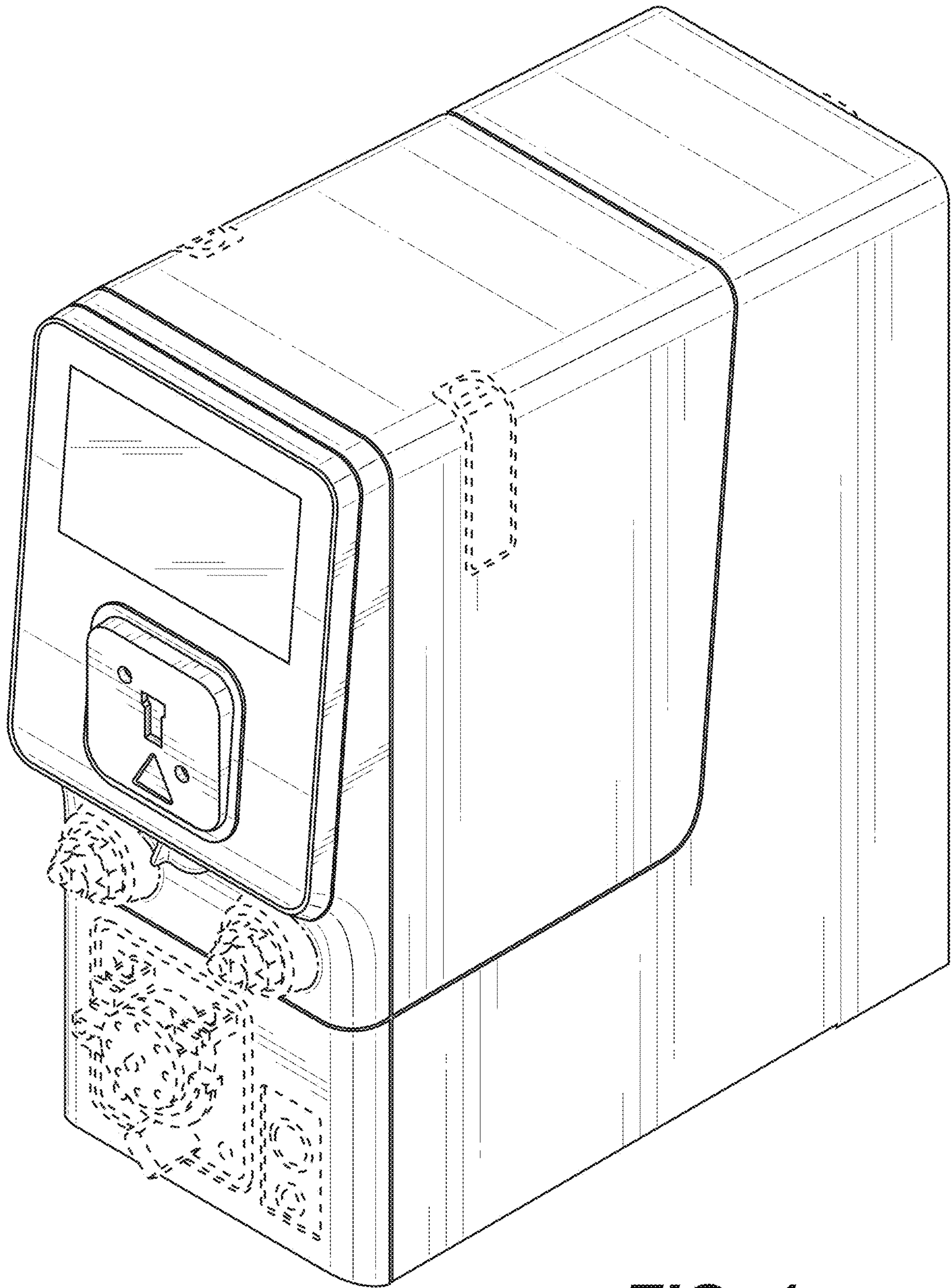

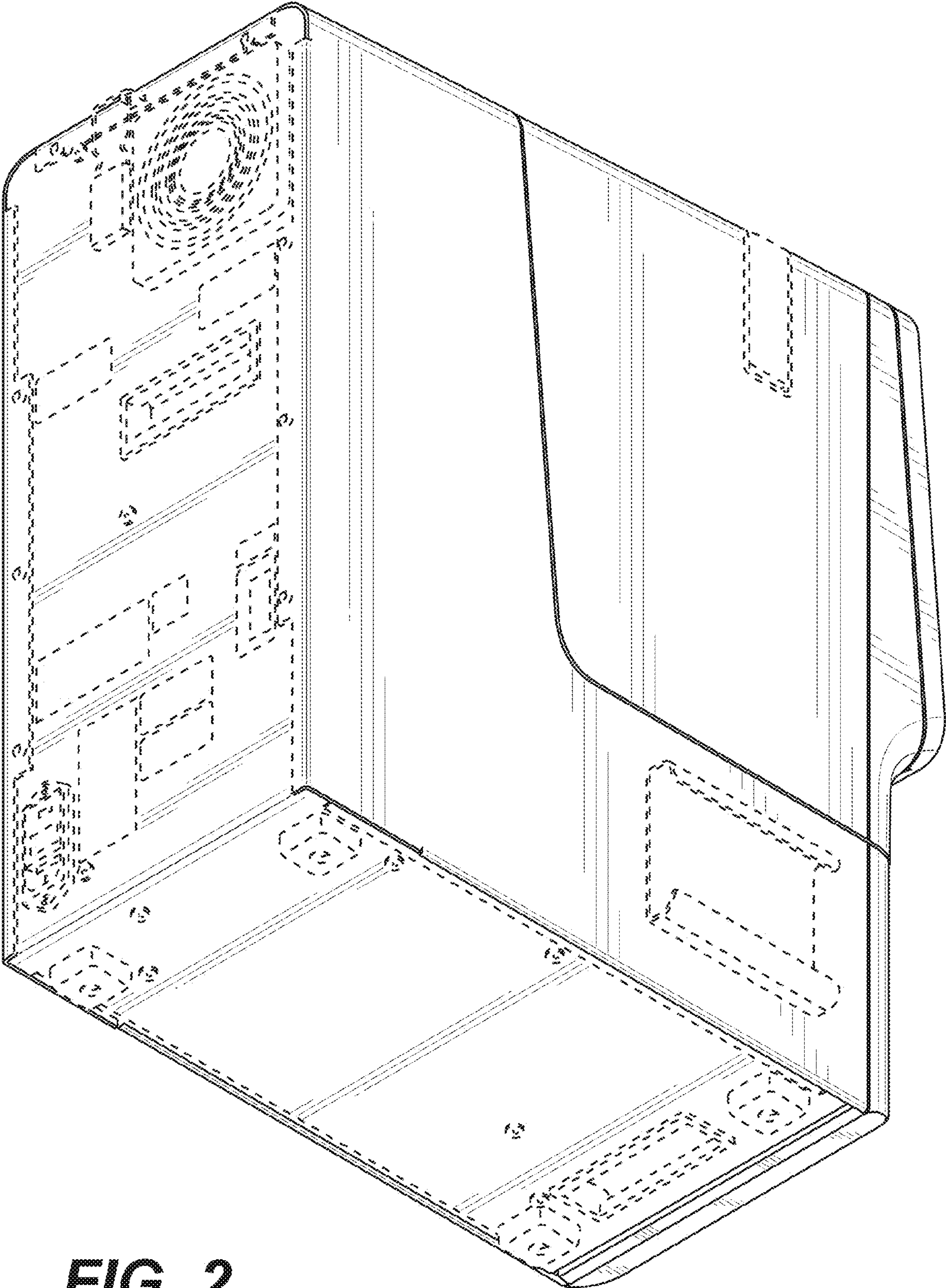

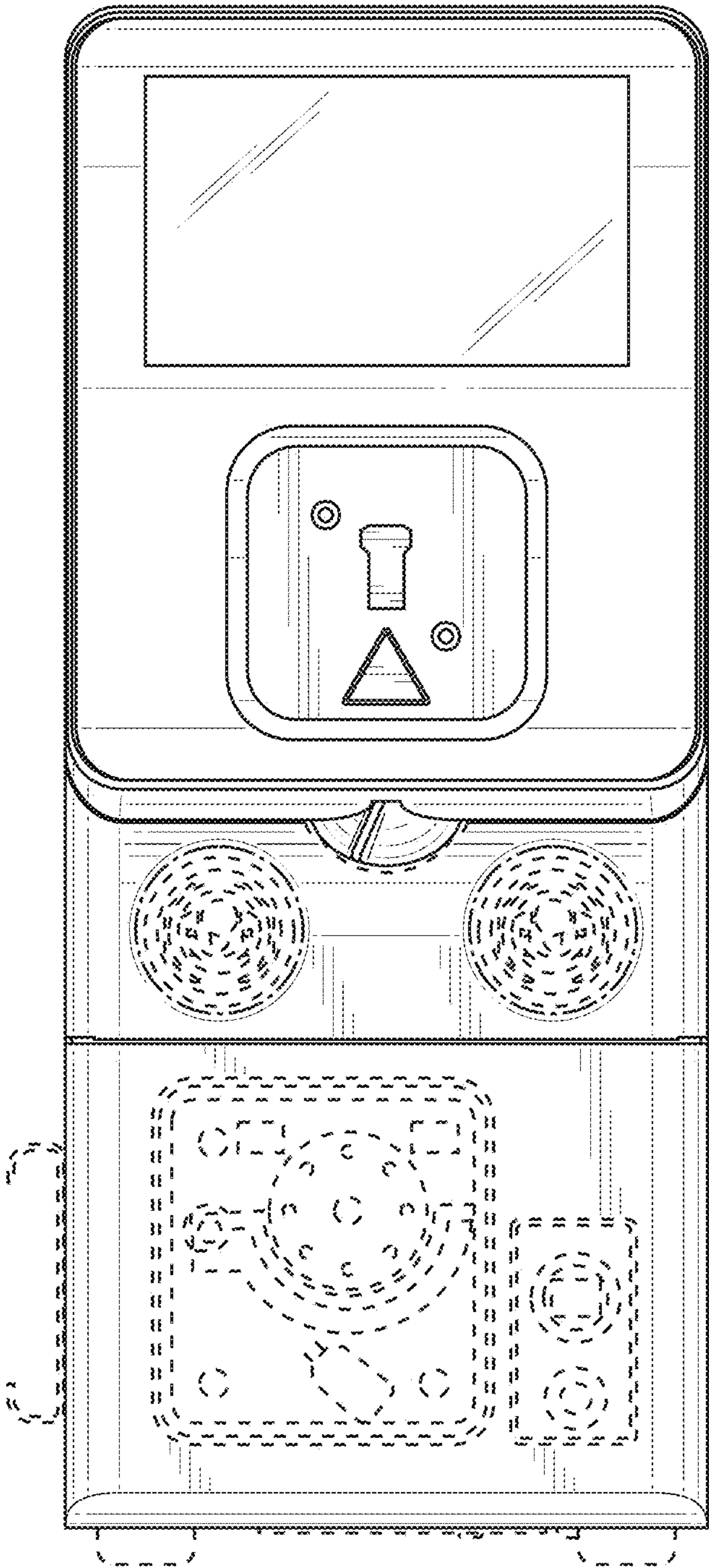

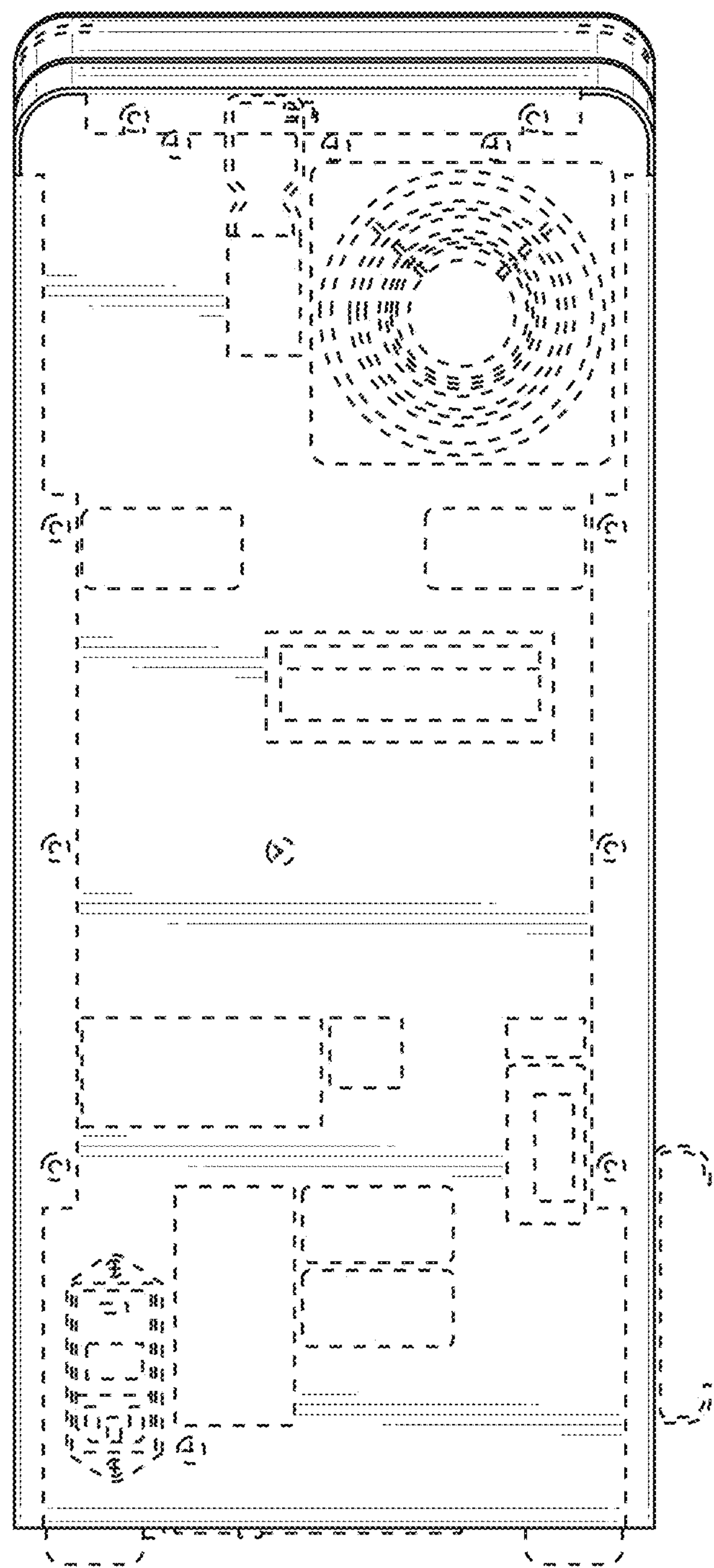

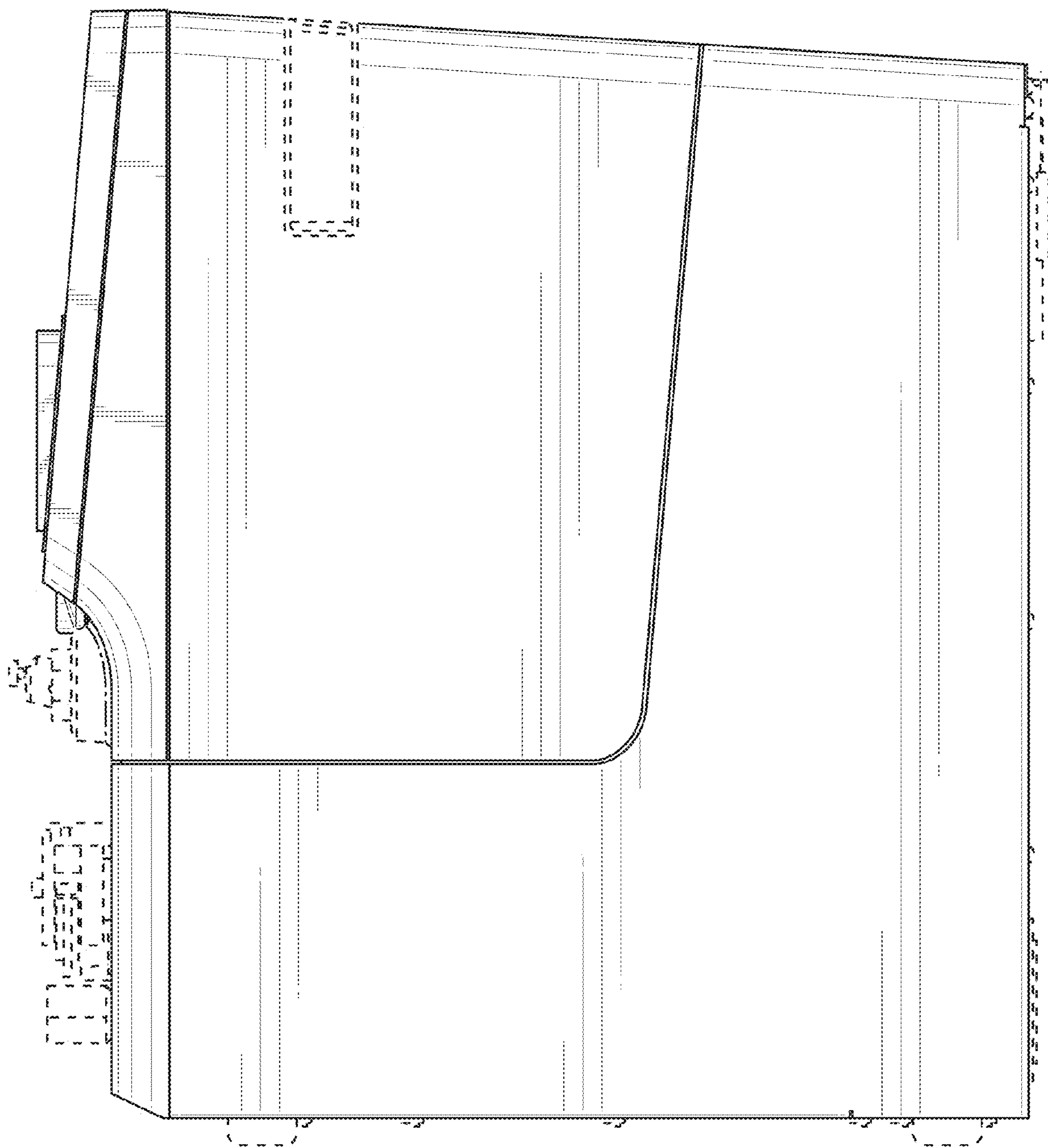

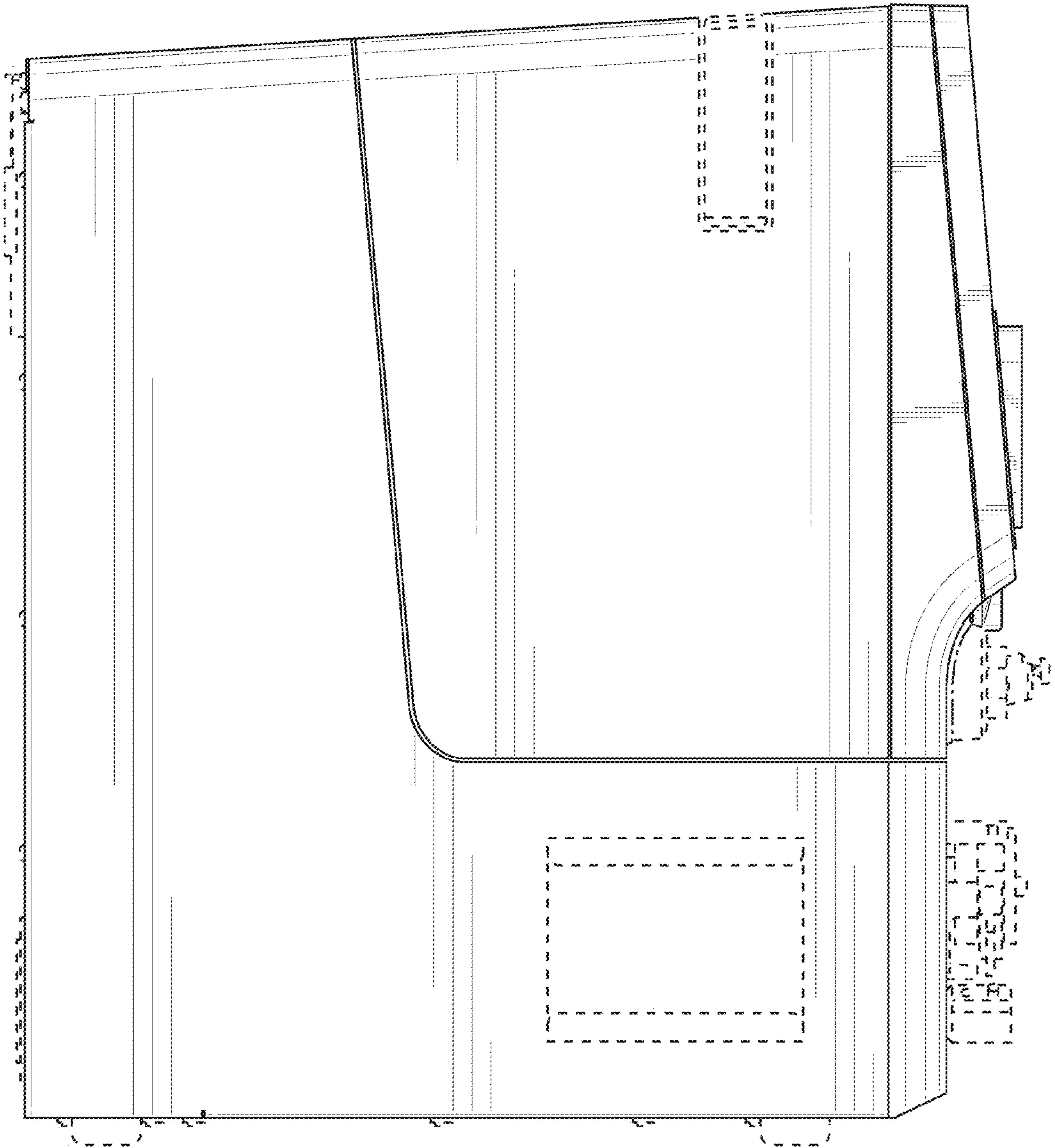

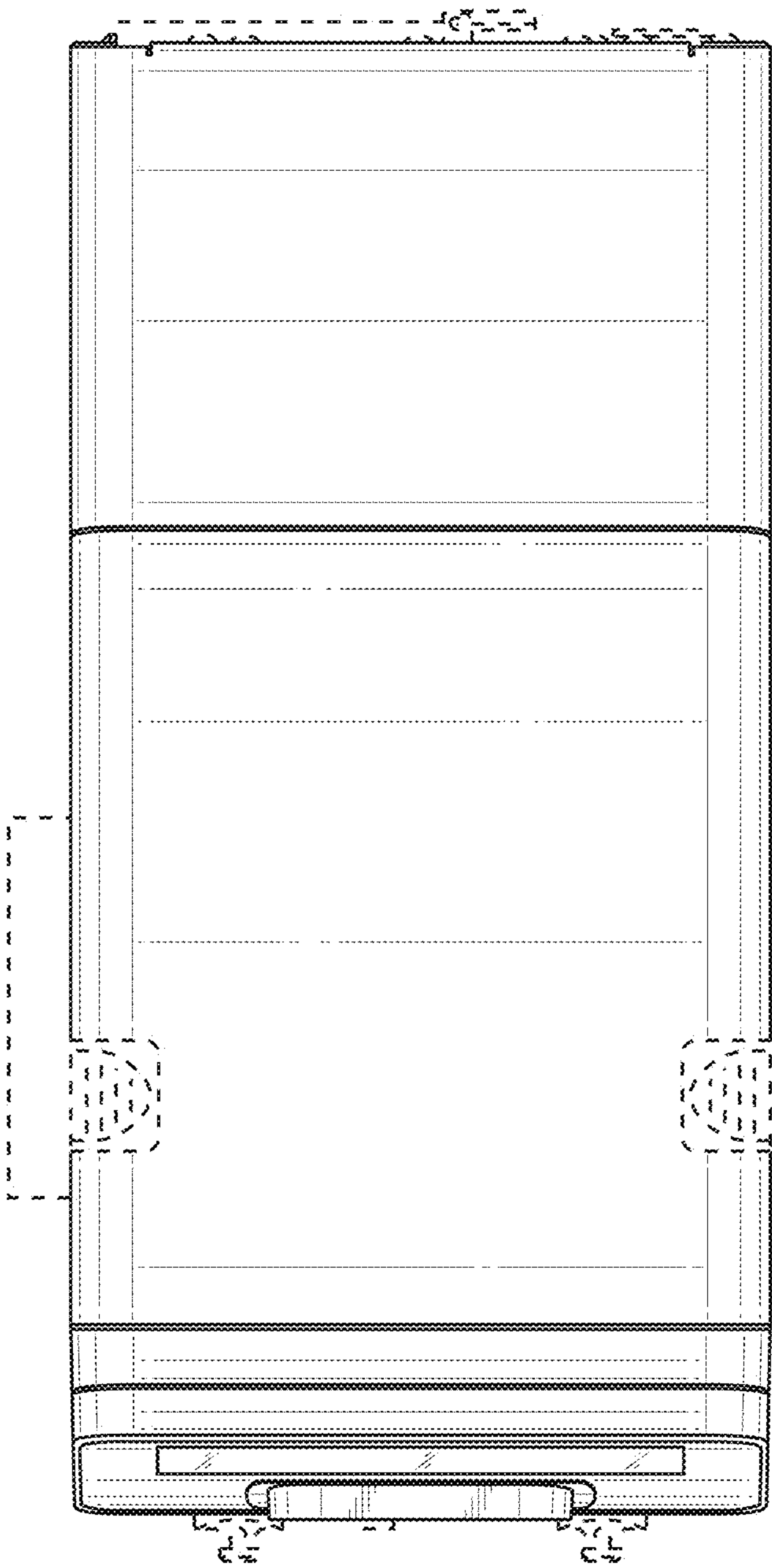

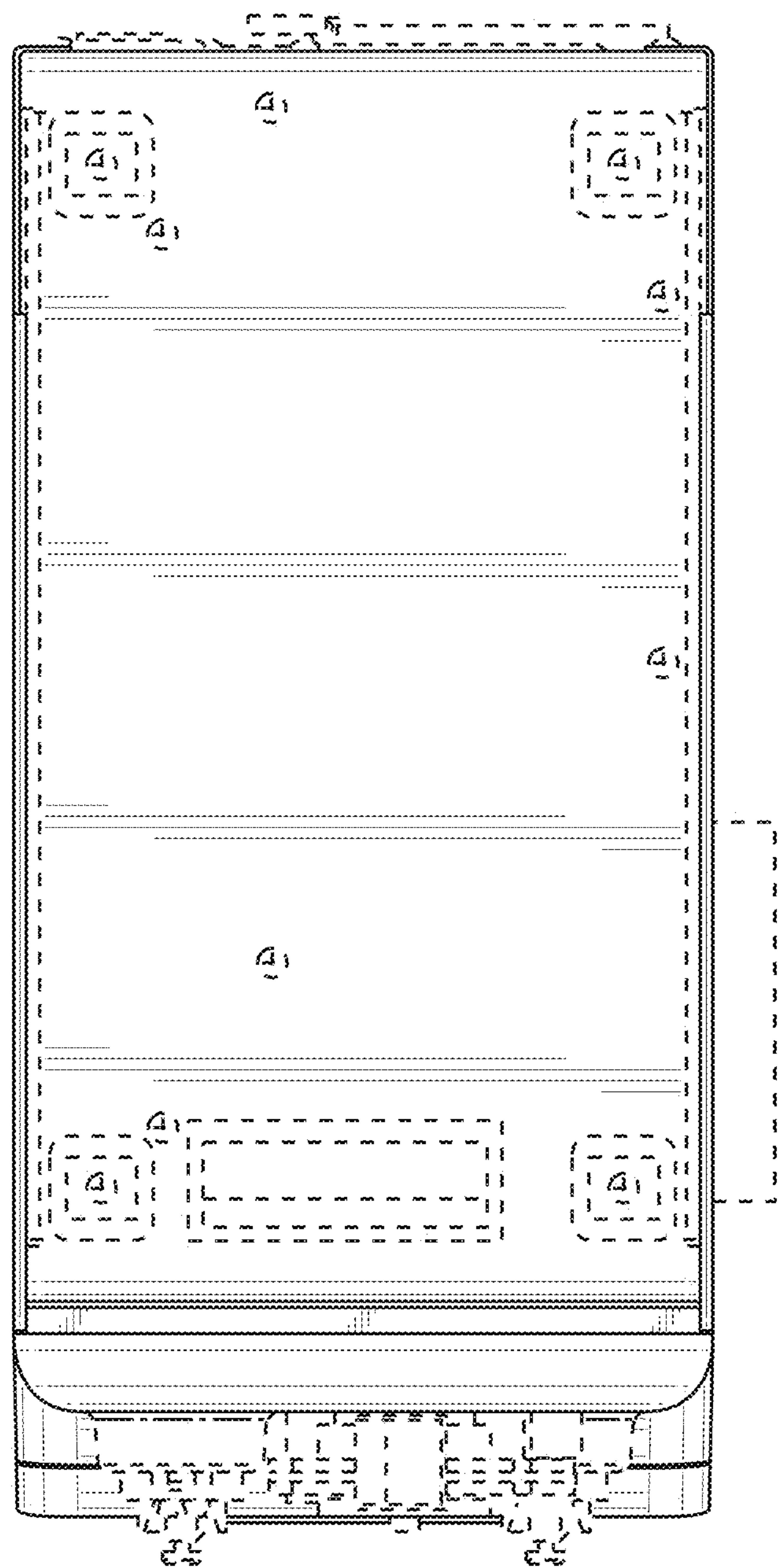
