FIG. 4 is a back view;

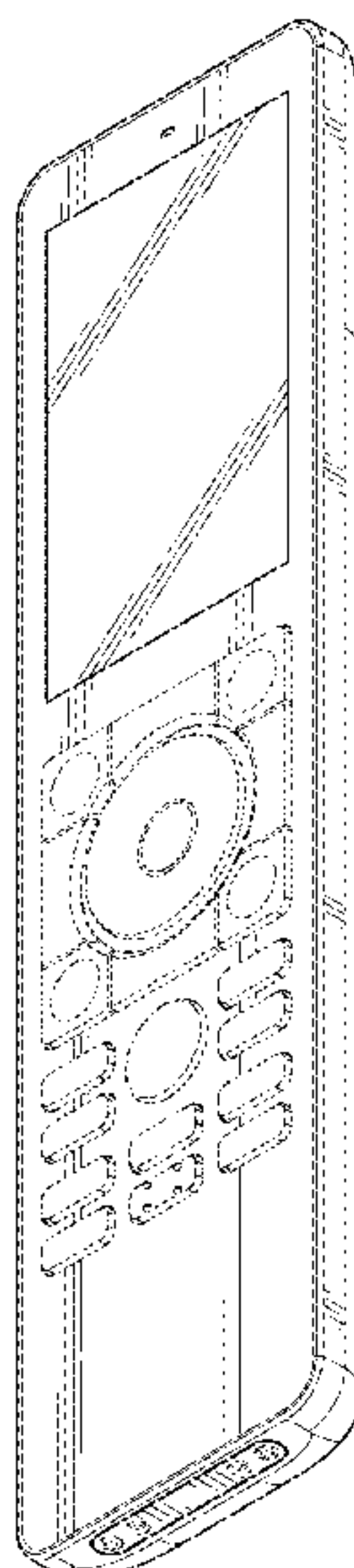
FIG. 5 is a side view, with the left side and right side being

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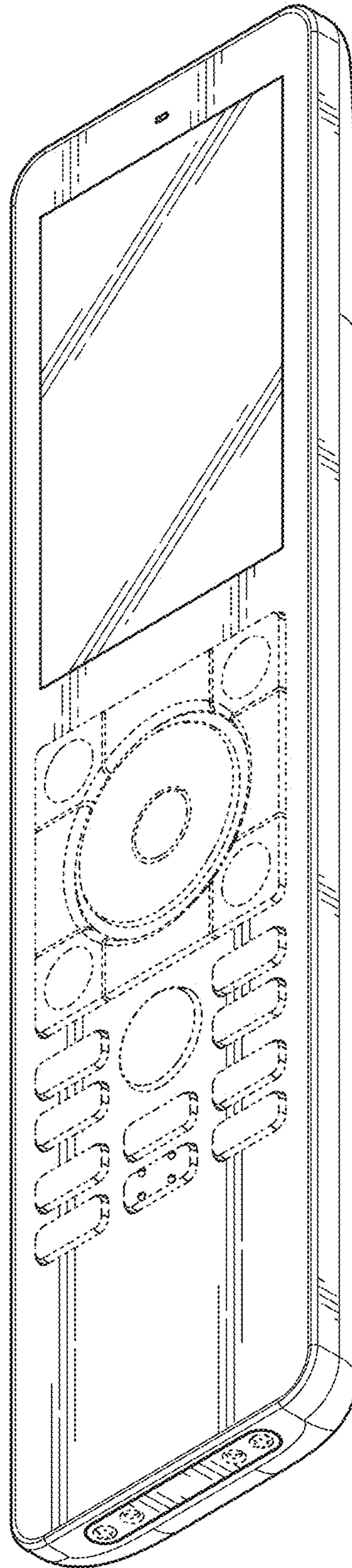

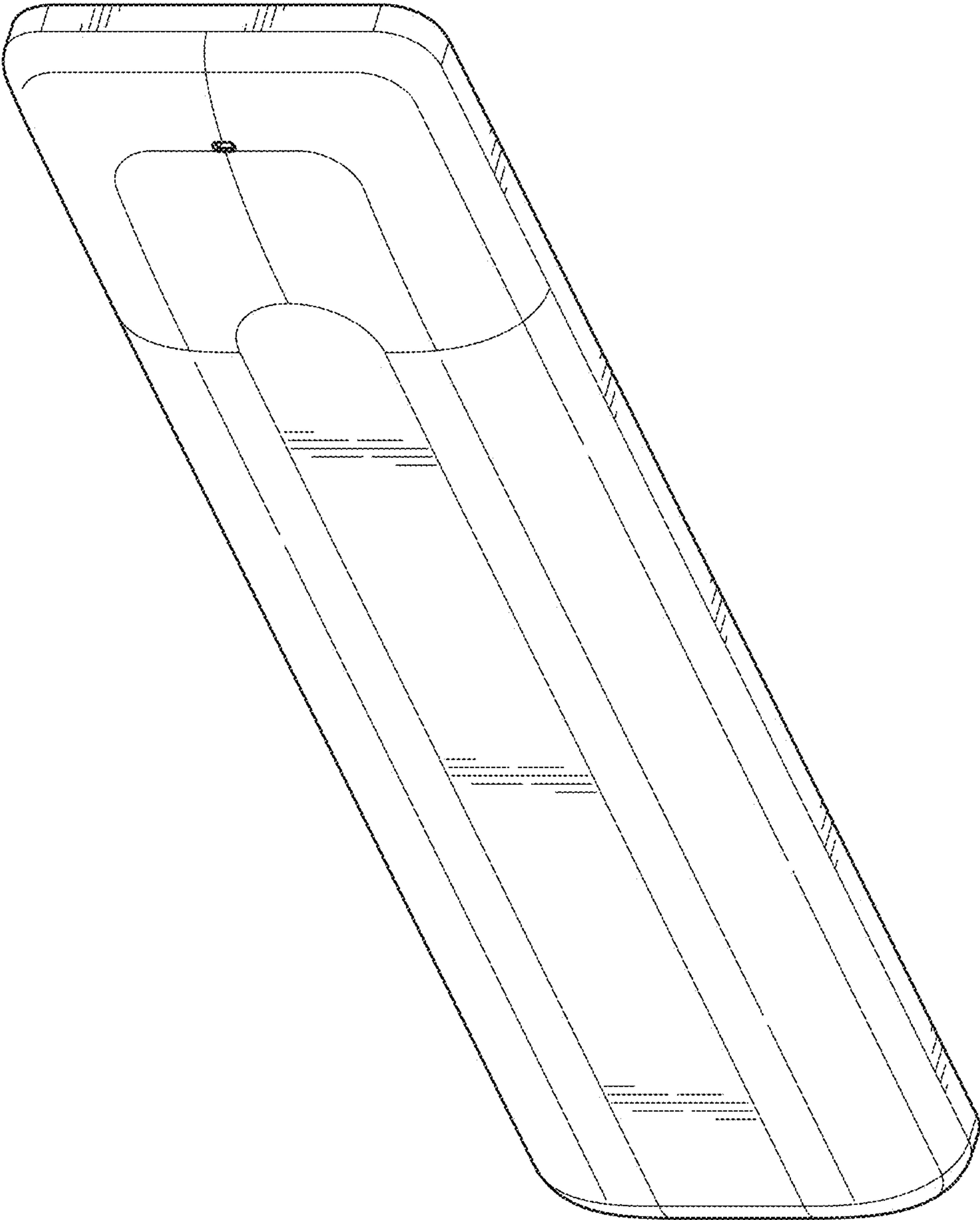

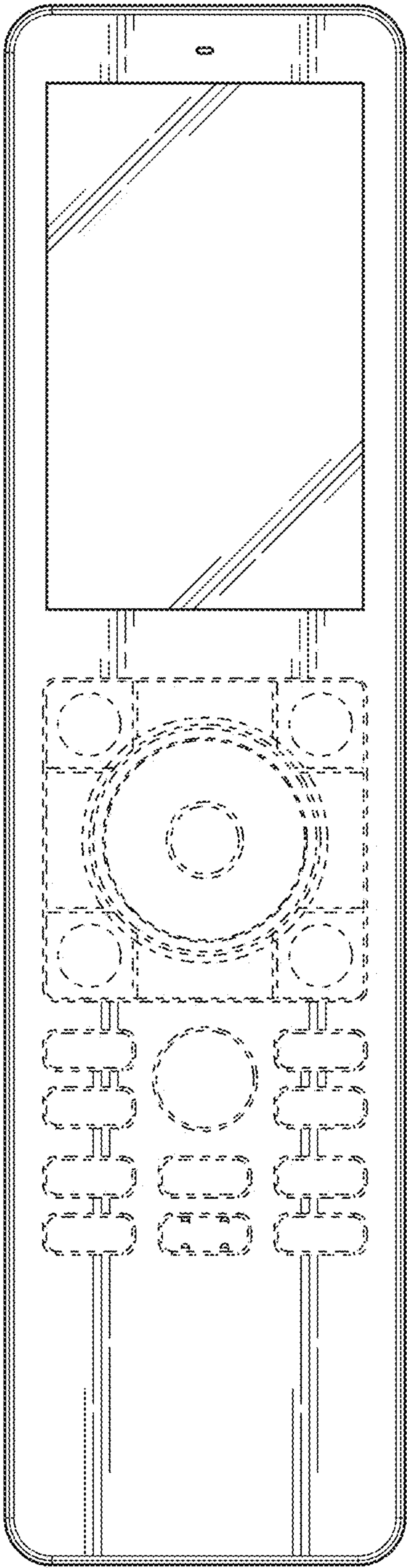

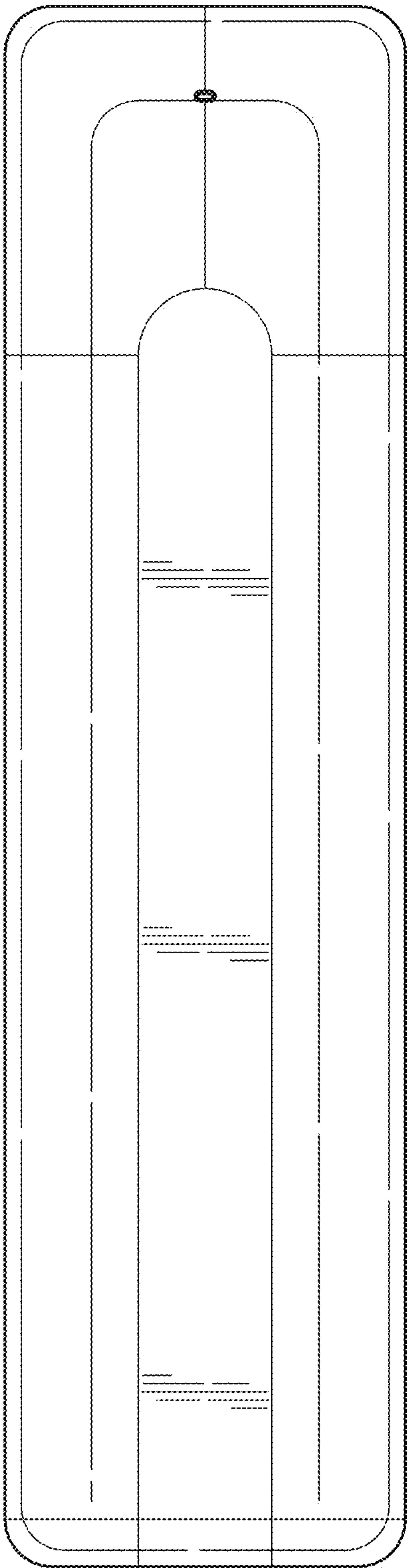

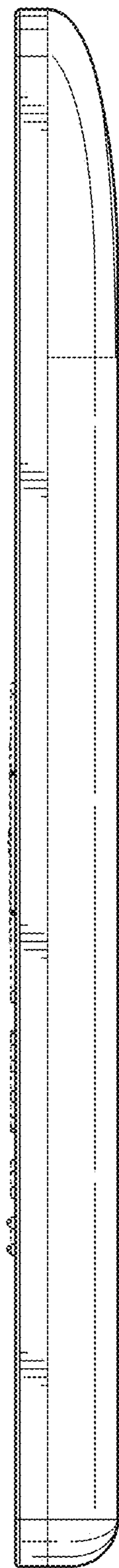

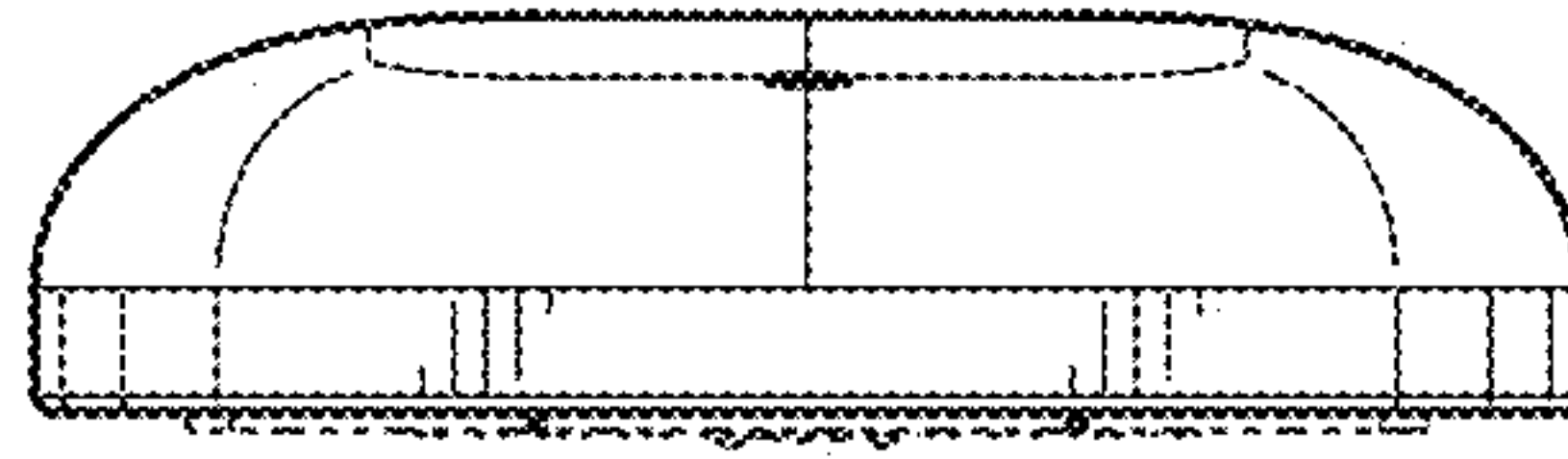

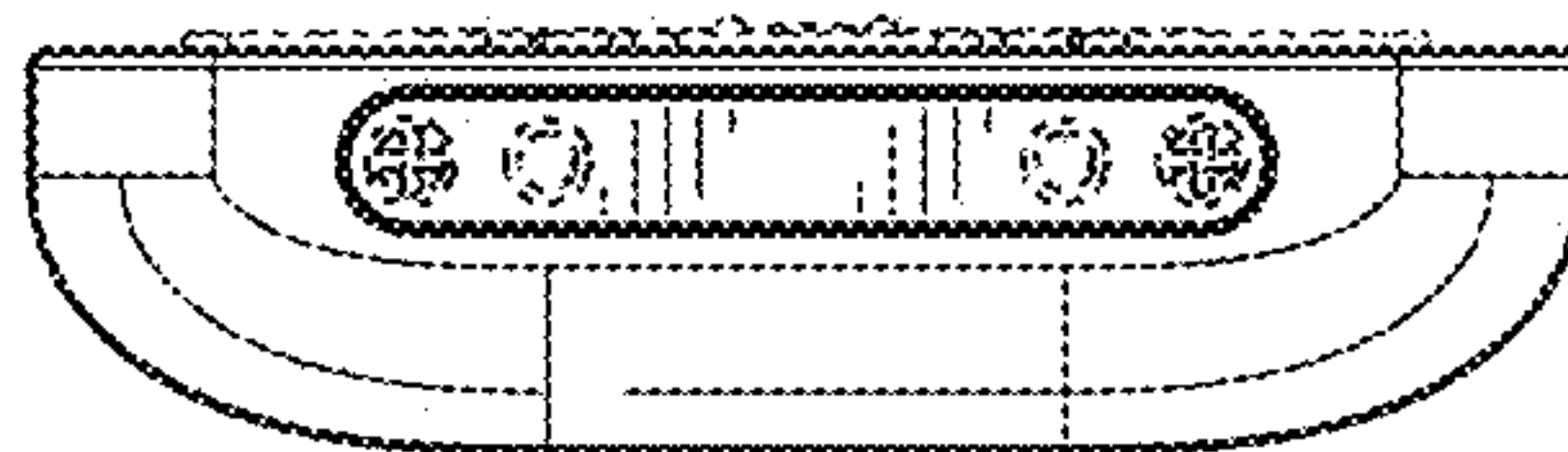
