(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

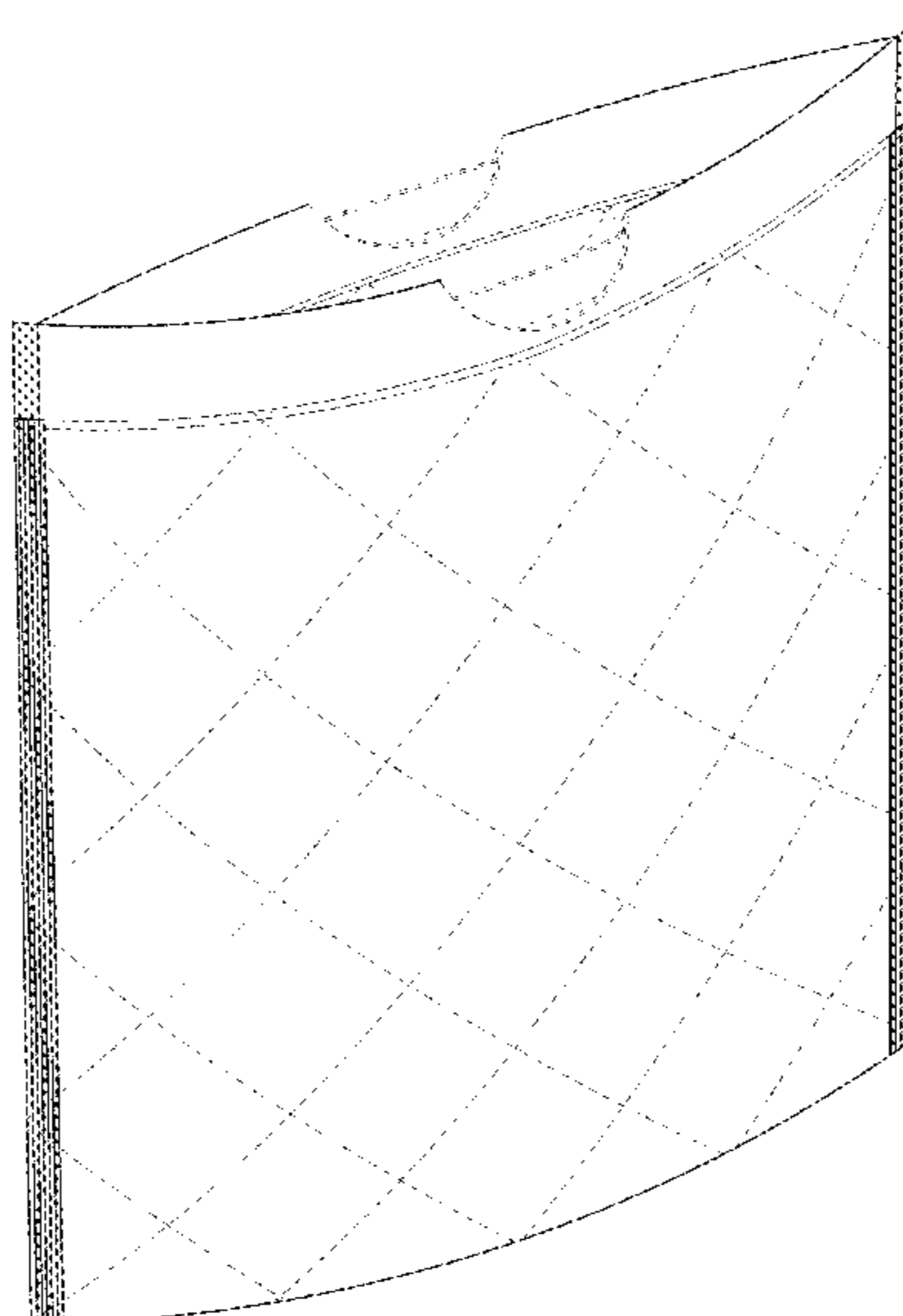
FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a bag showing the claimed design in an open configuration; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof in a closed configuration; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

The dashed broken lines in the figures show environment, which forms no part of the claimed design.

The dot-dash broken lines and the portions between pairs of dot-dash lines that are broken away show the bag has no specific length and form no part of the claimed design. For ease of illustration, the dot-dash broken lines do not appear in FIG. 1.

The gray-shaded portions in the figures show contrasting appearance.

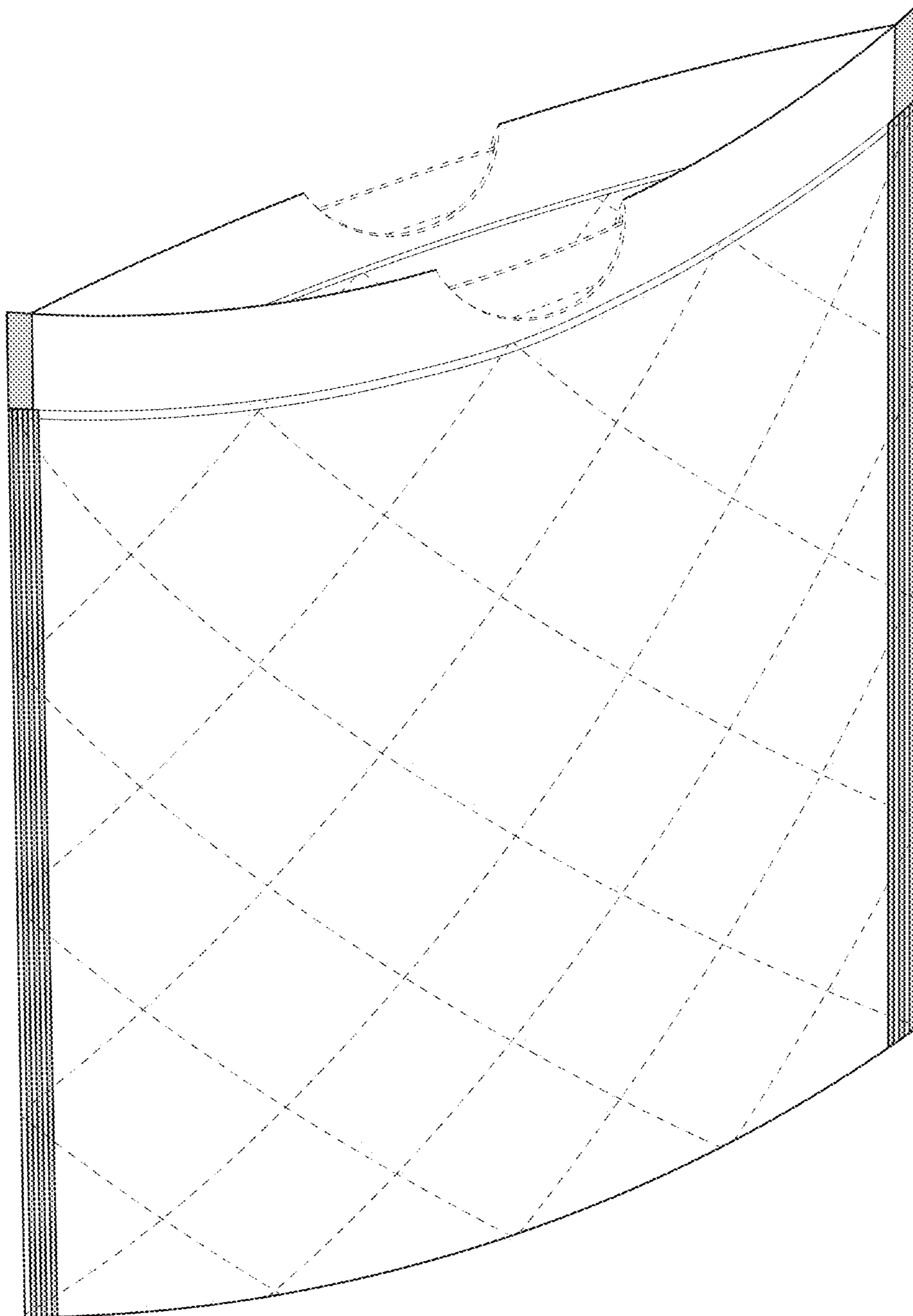

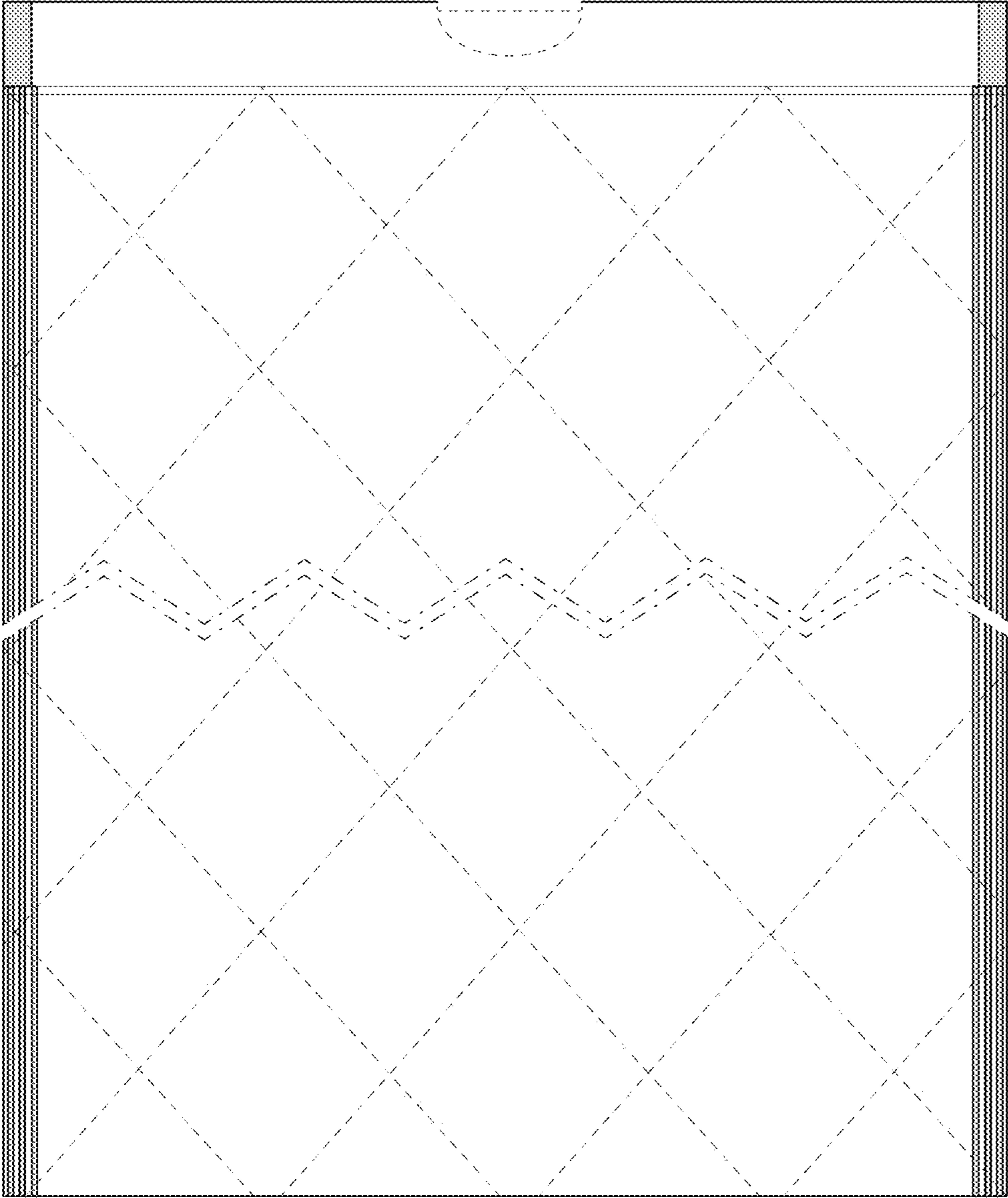

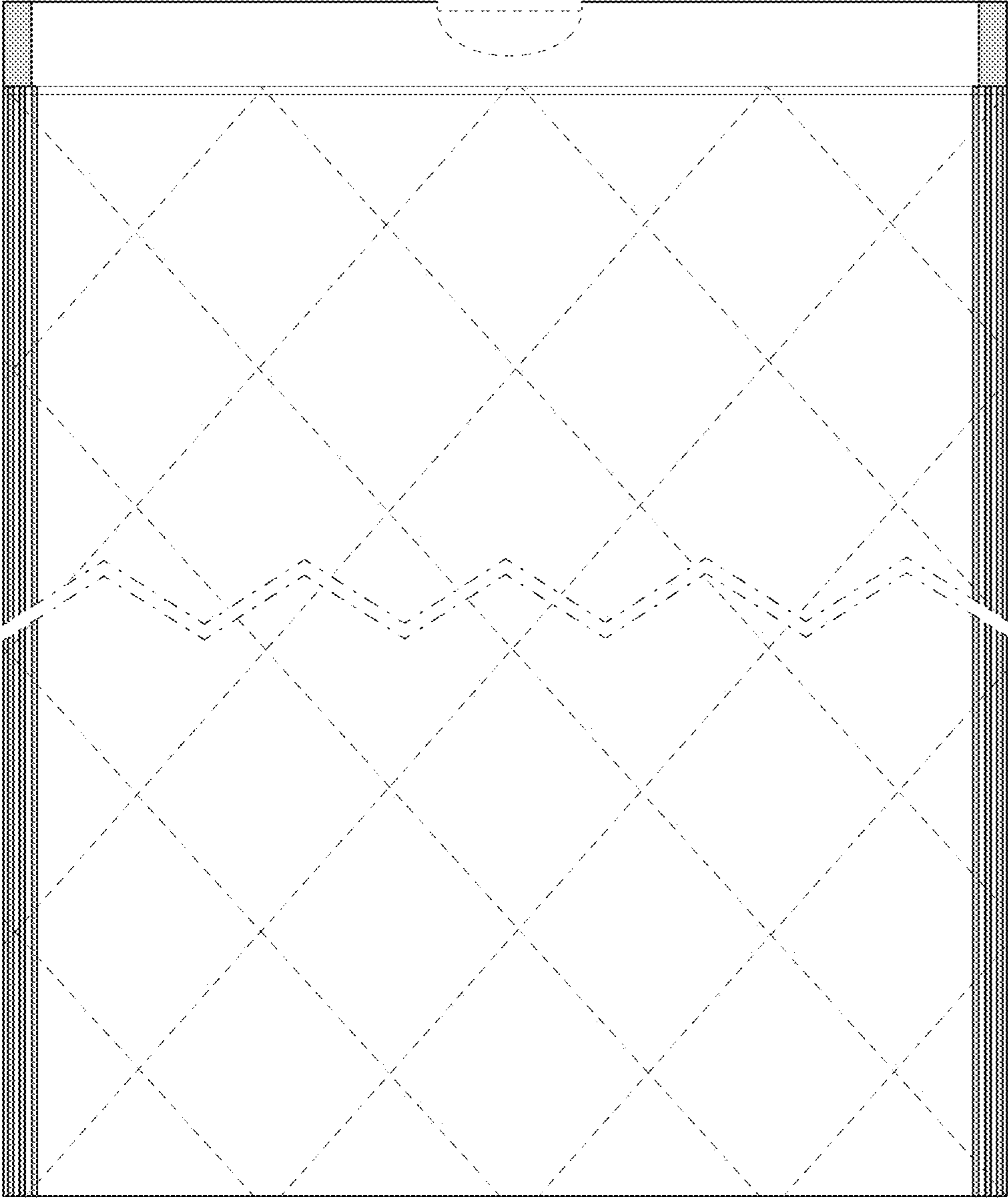

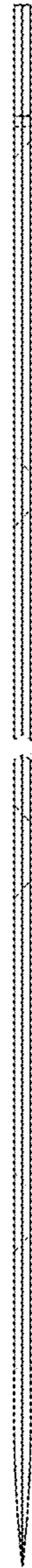

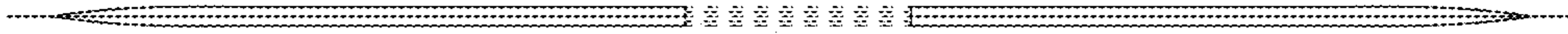

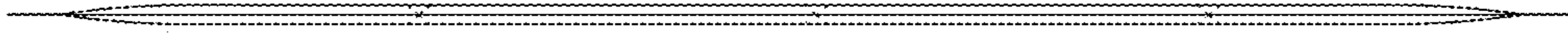
