DESCRIPTION

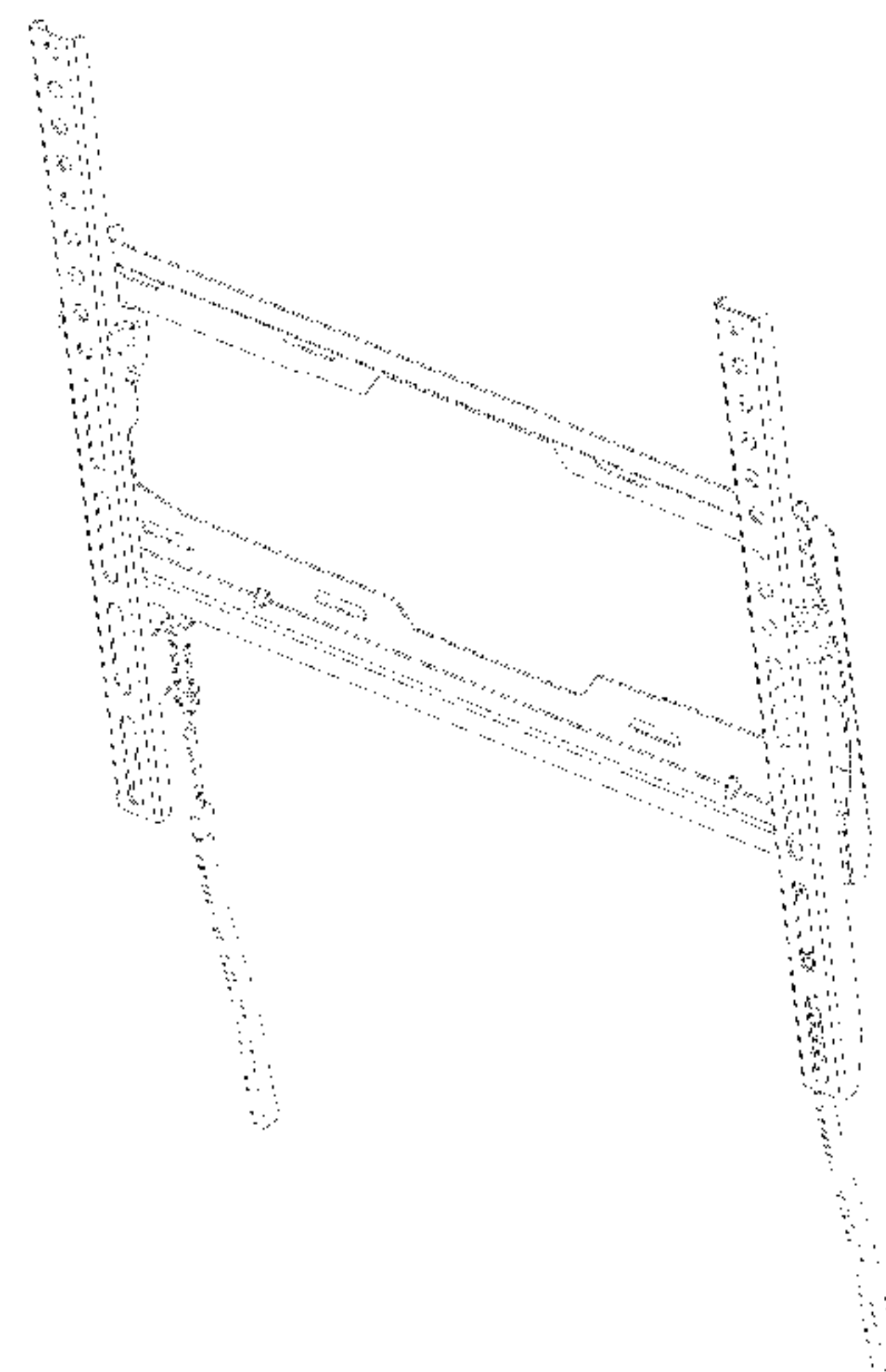
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a monitor wall mount apparatus showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

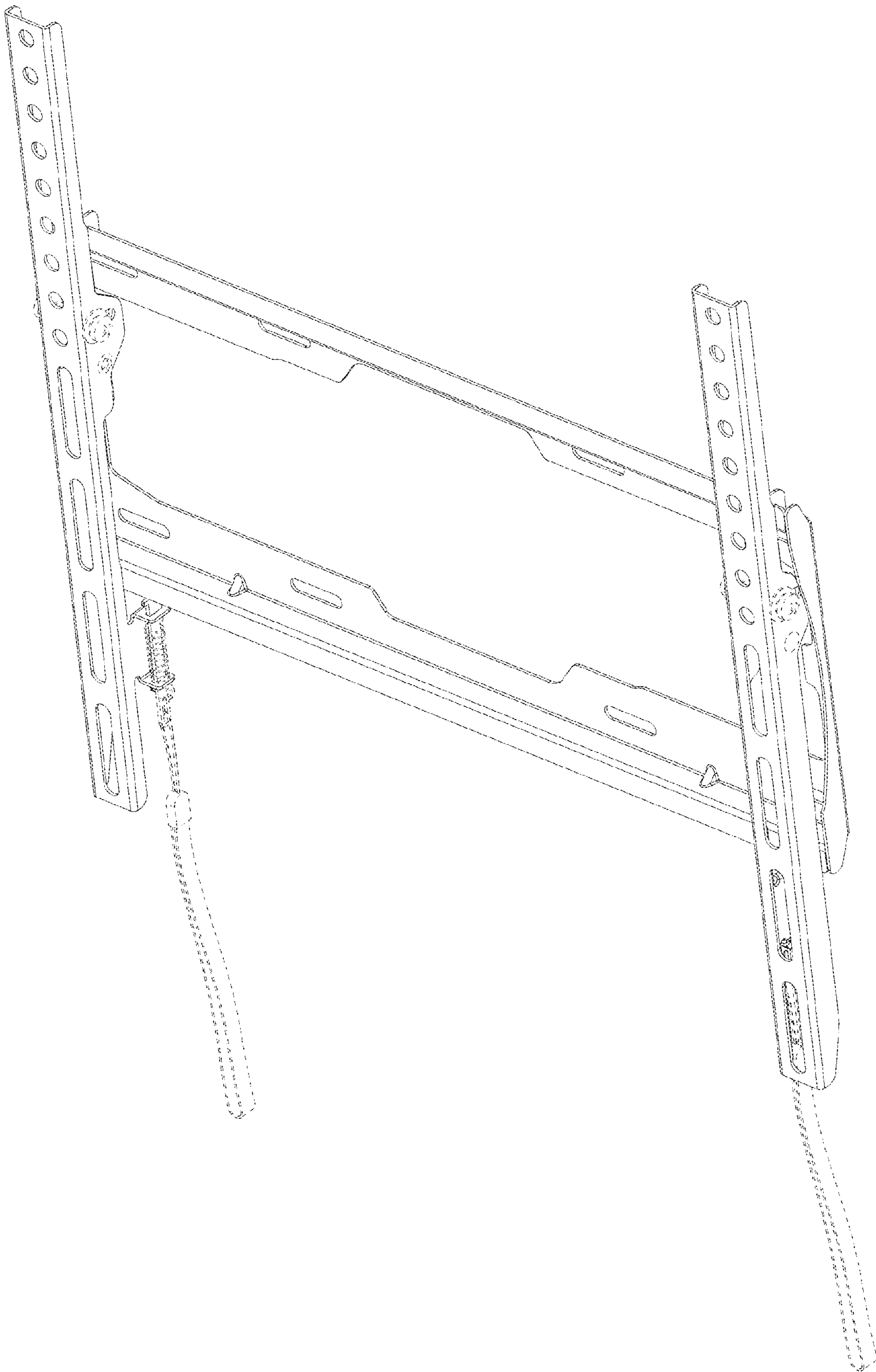

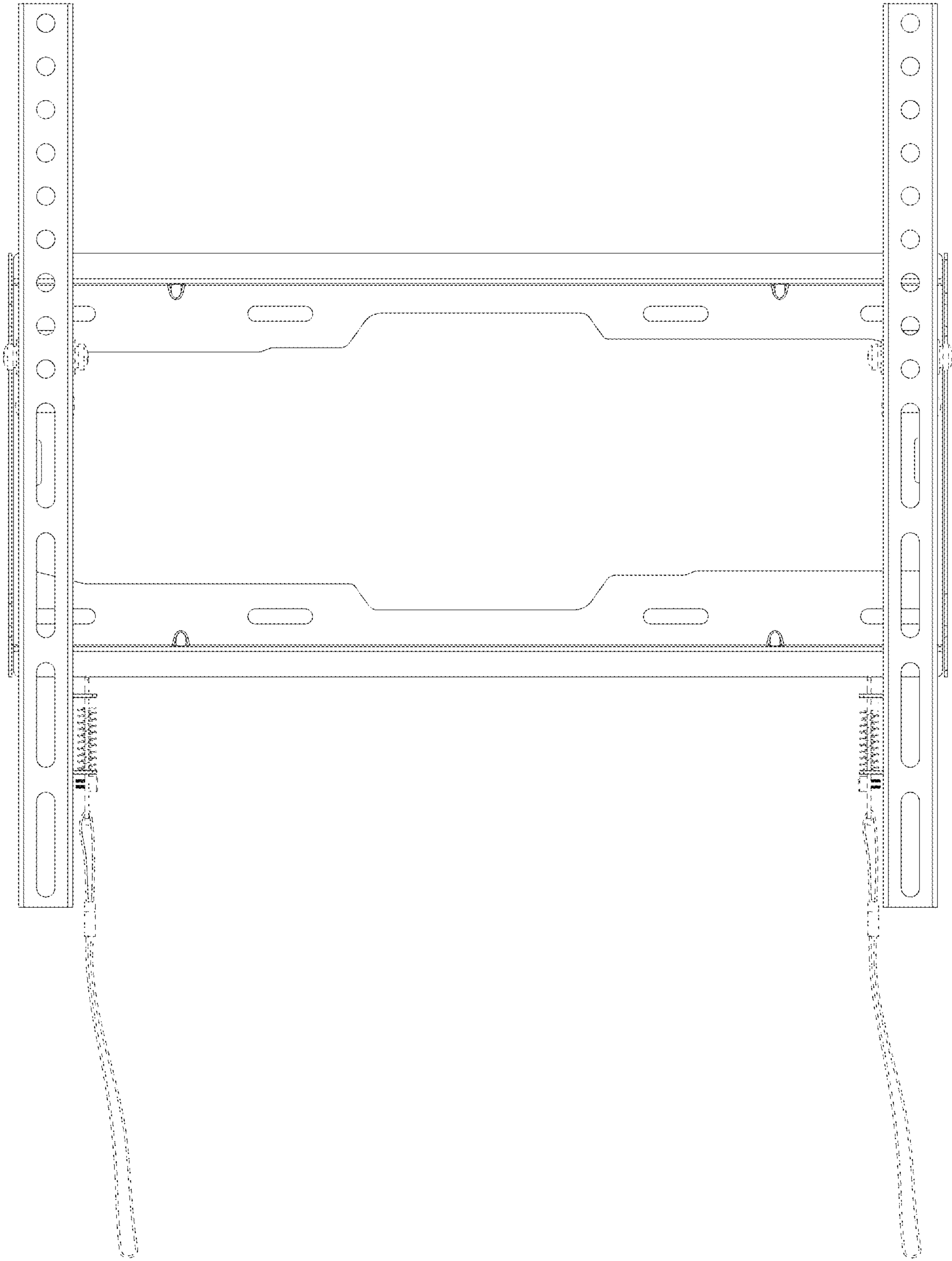

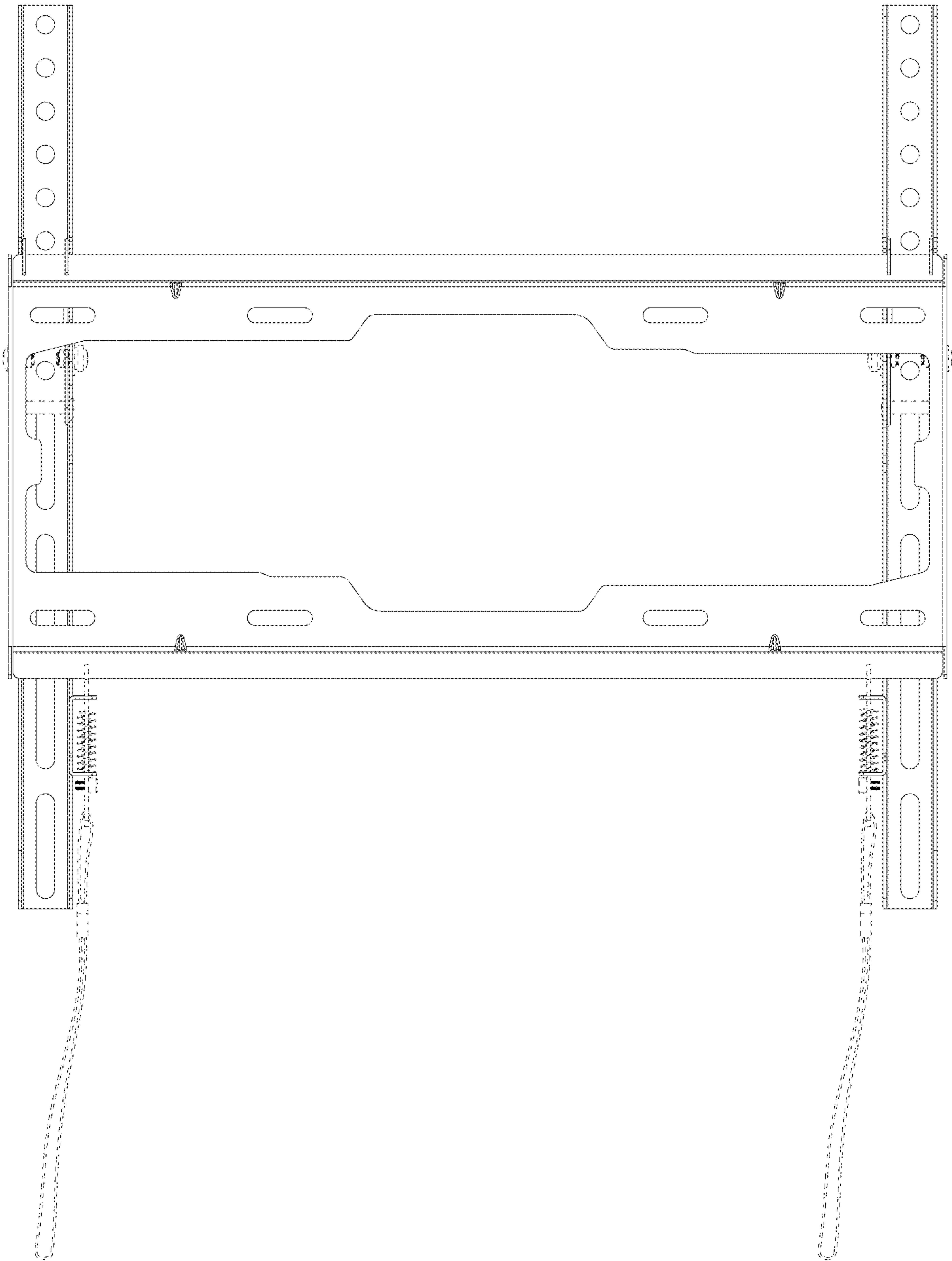

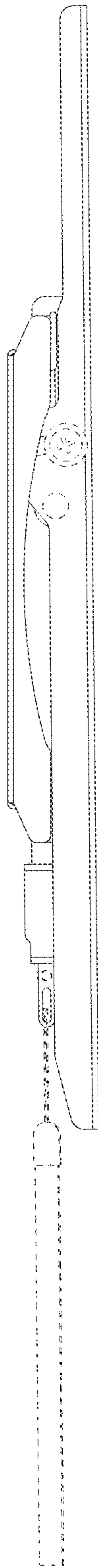

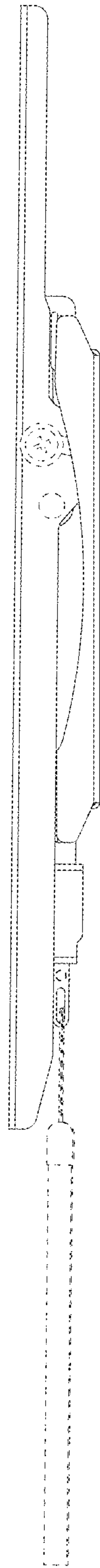

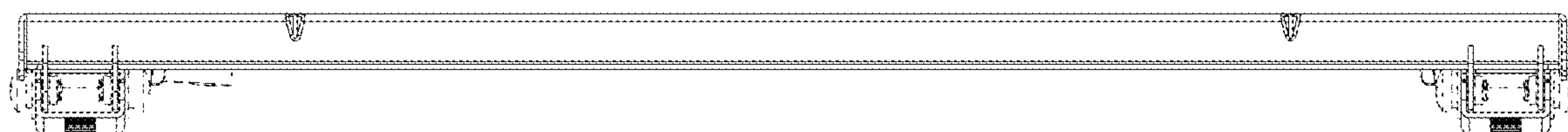

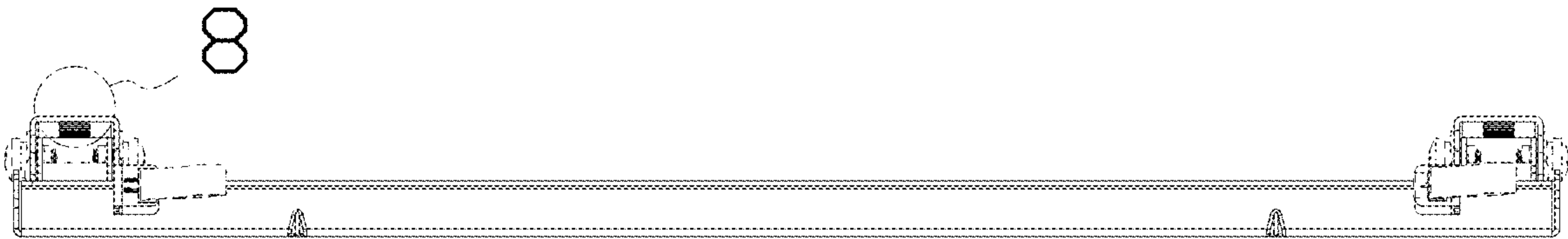

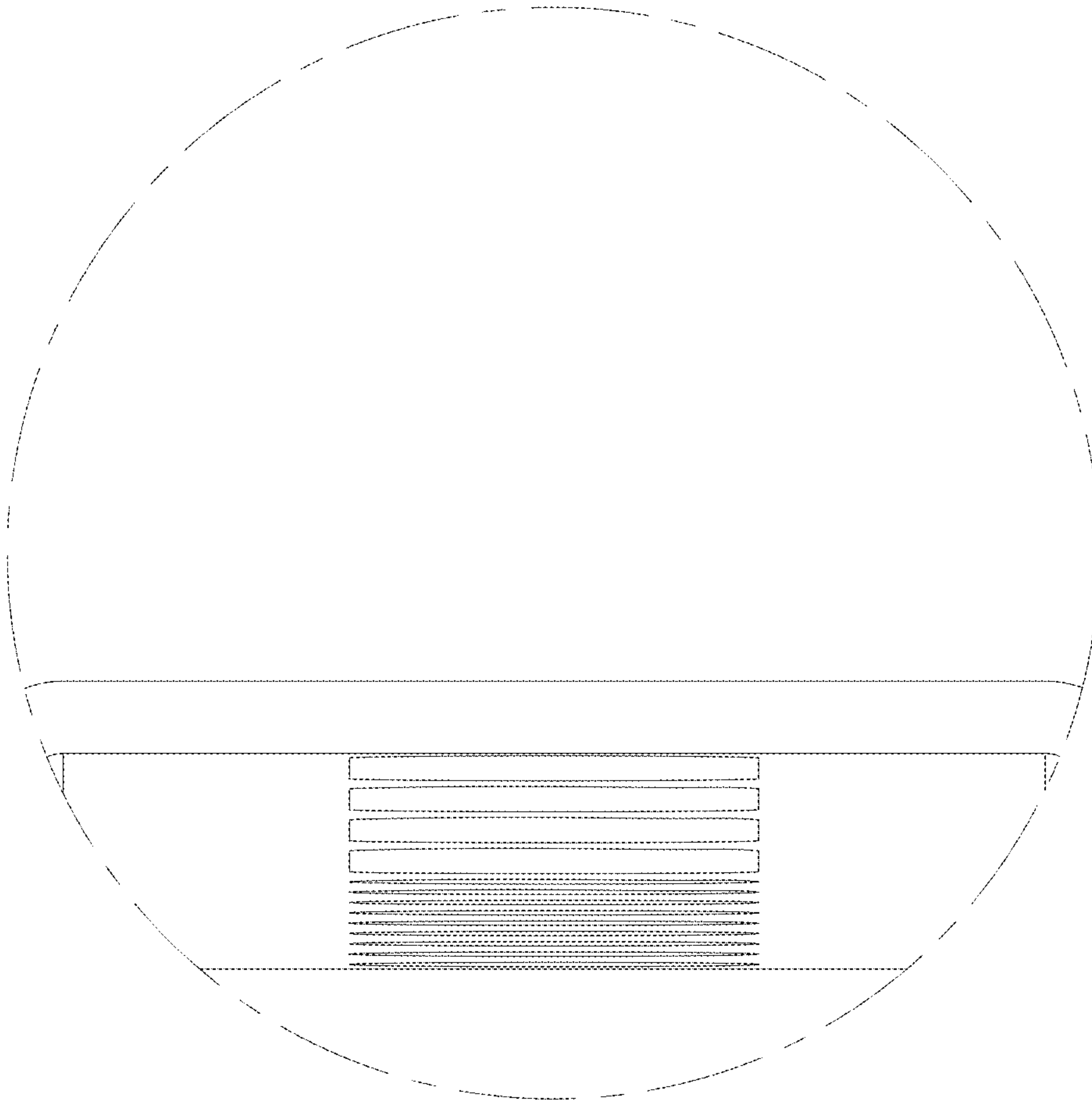
