The ornamental design for a thermal imager, as shown and  
described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a thermal  
imager showing my new design in a first embodiment.

FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, left side perspective view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view thereof.

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 9 is a top, front, right side perspective view of the  
thermal imager in a second embodiment.

FIG. 10 is a bottom, rear, left side perspective view thereof.

FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof.

FIG. 12 is a right side elevation view thereof.

FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof.

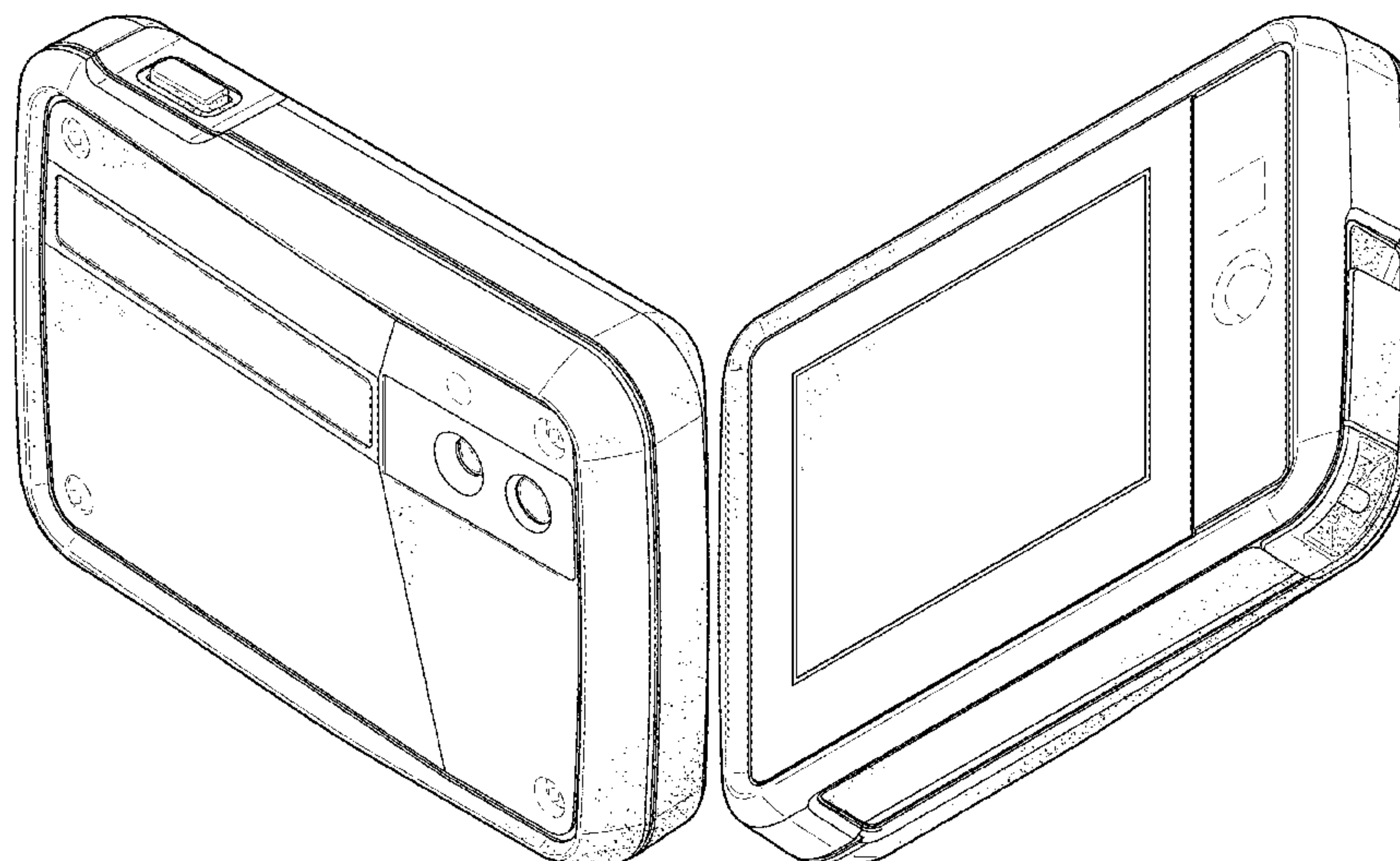
FIG. 14 is a rear elevation view thereof.

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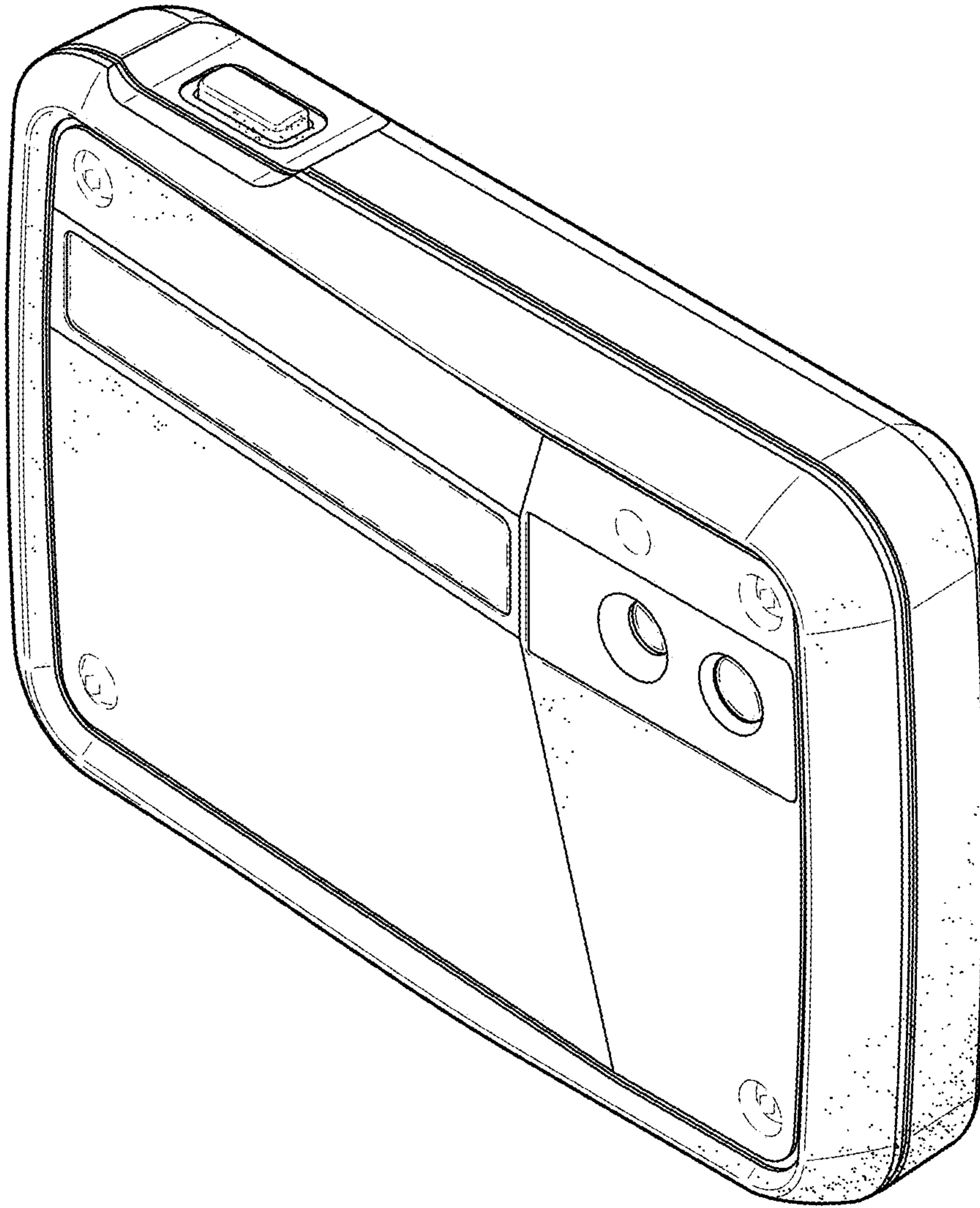

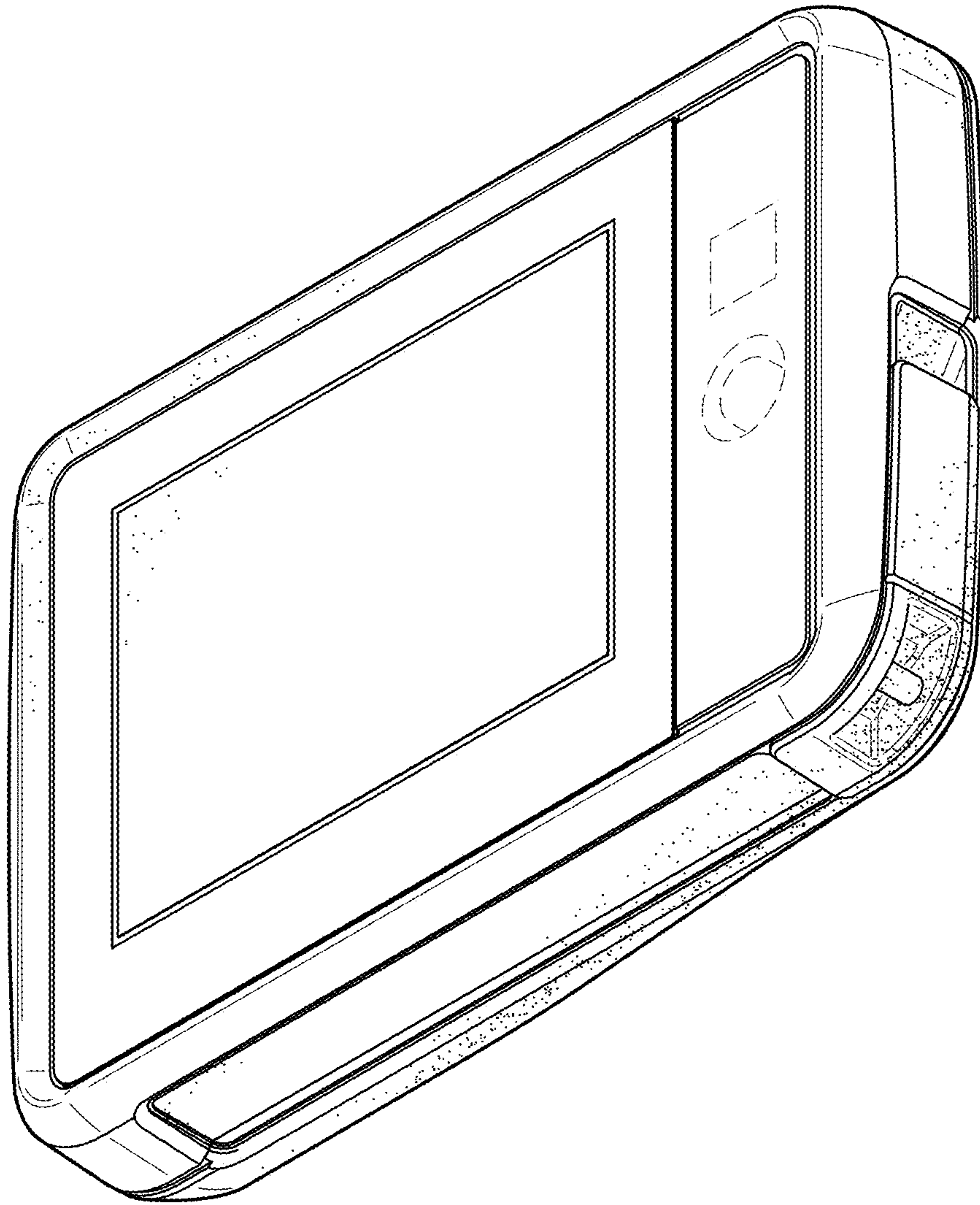

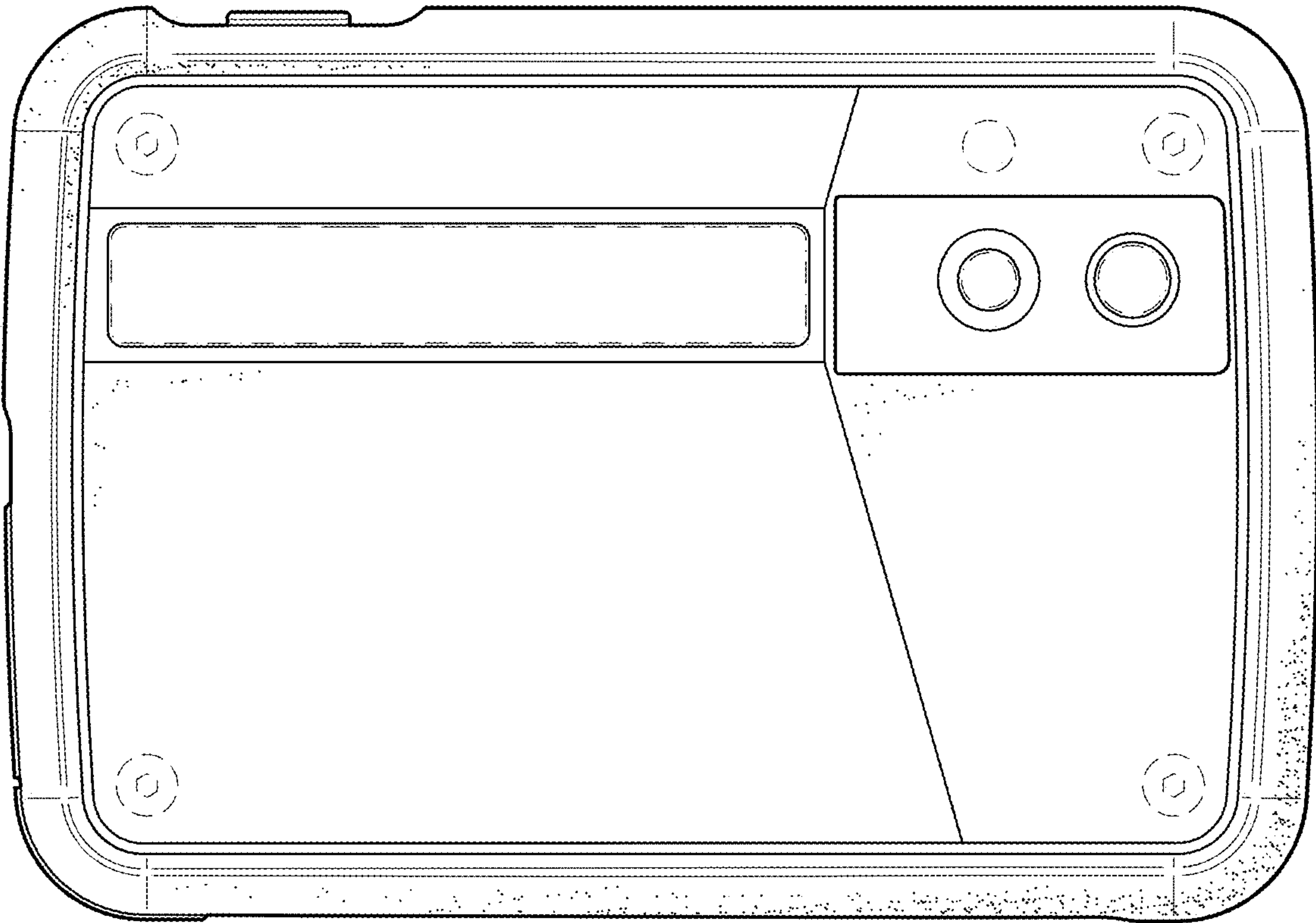

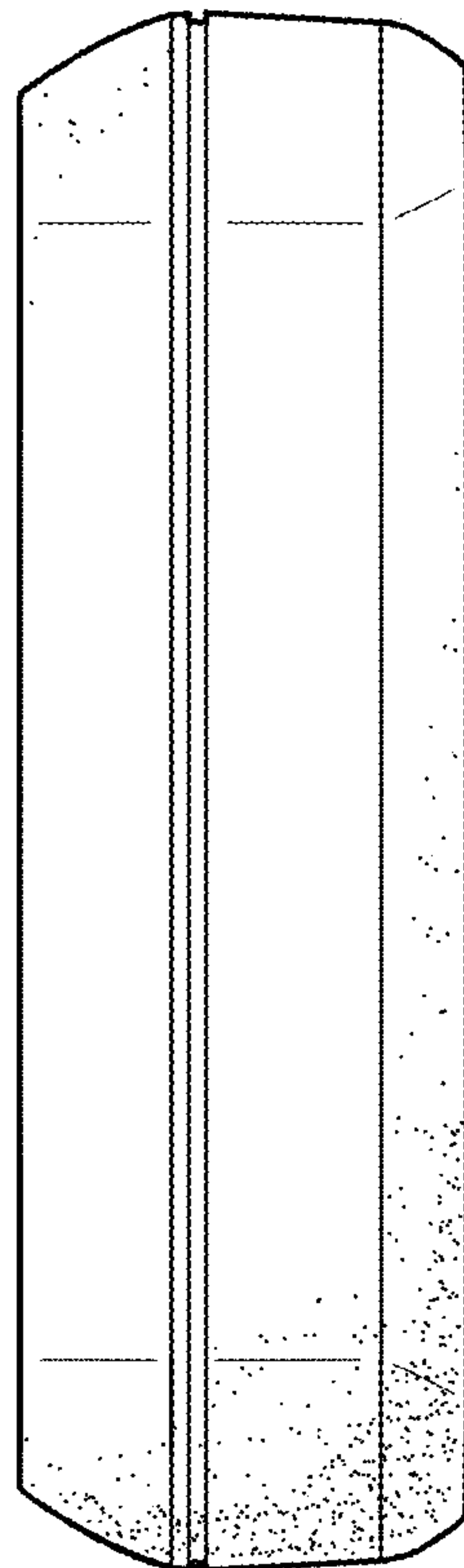

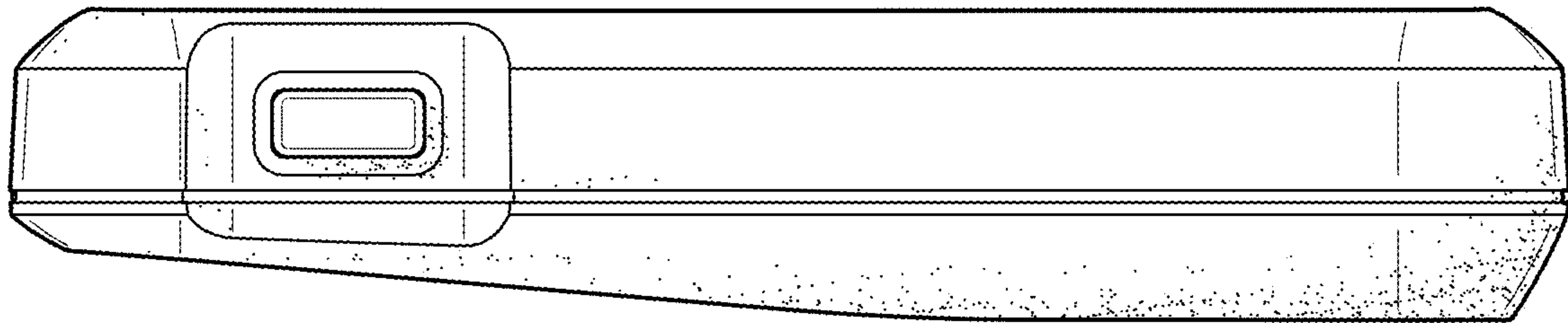

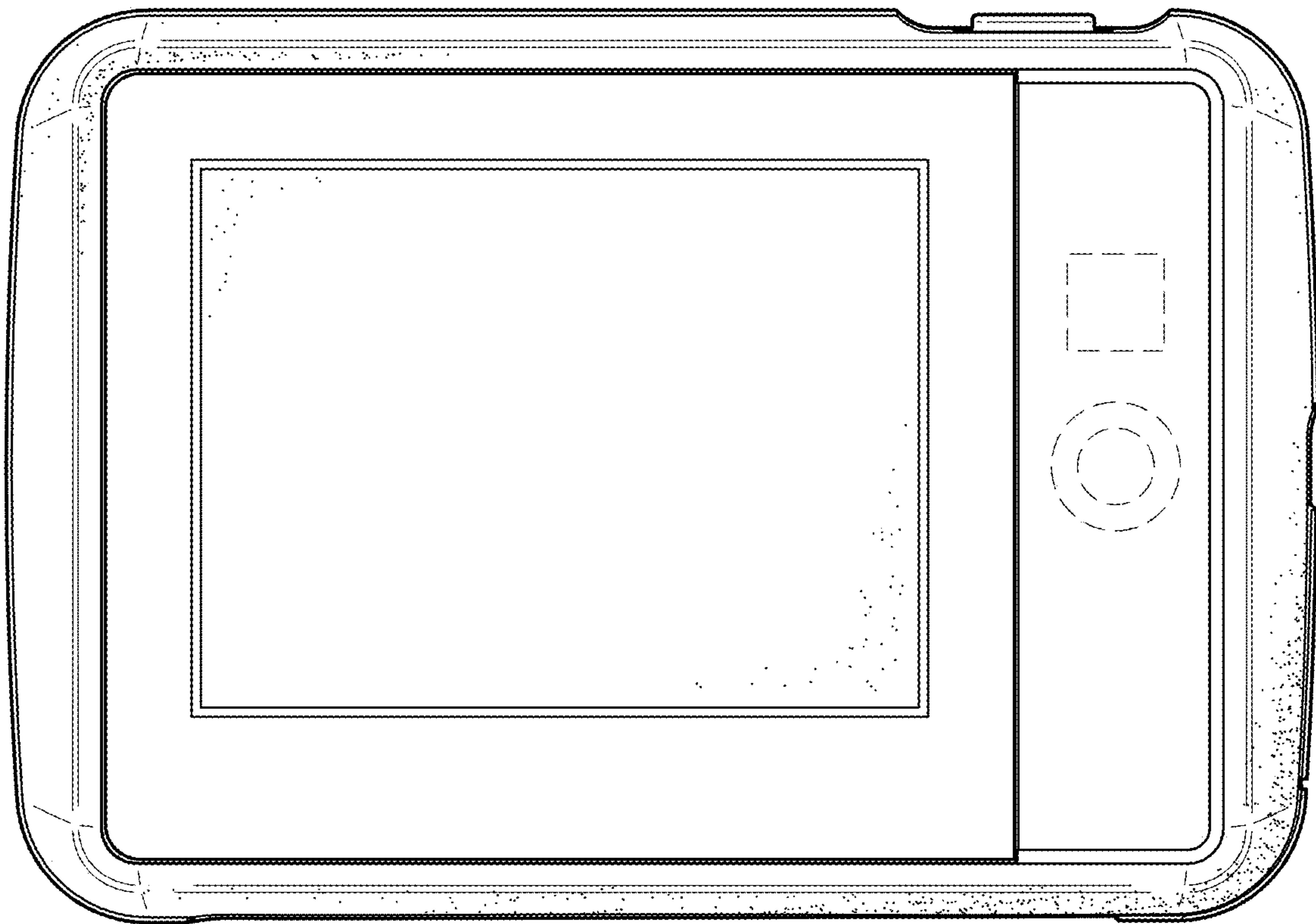

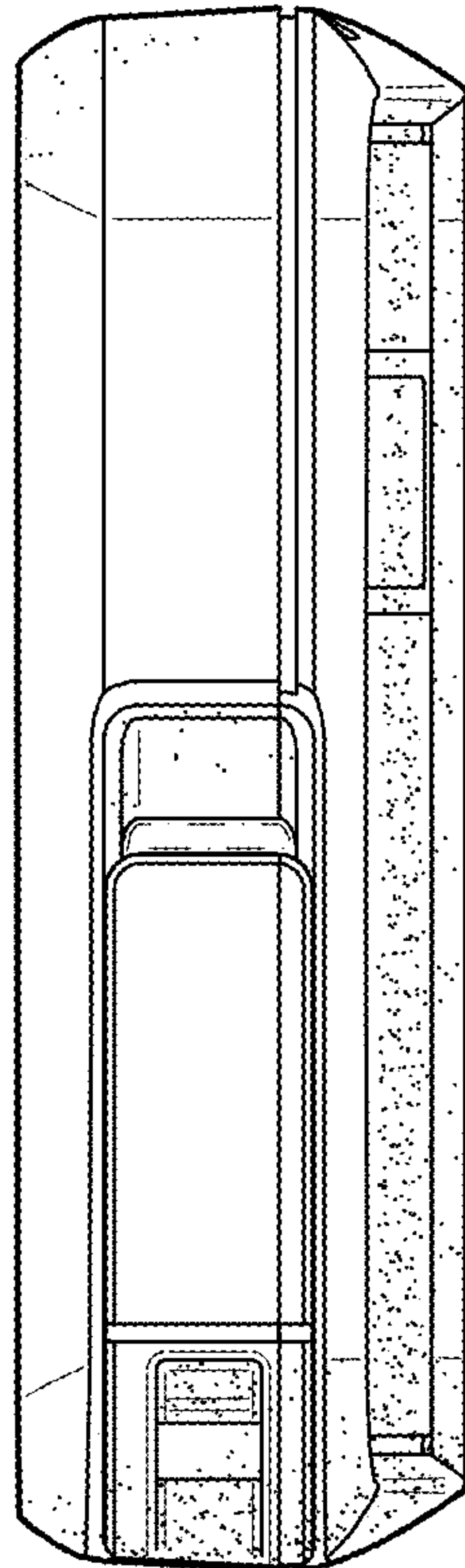

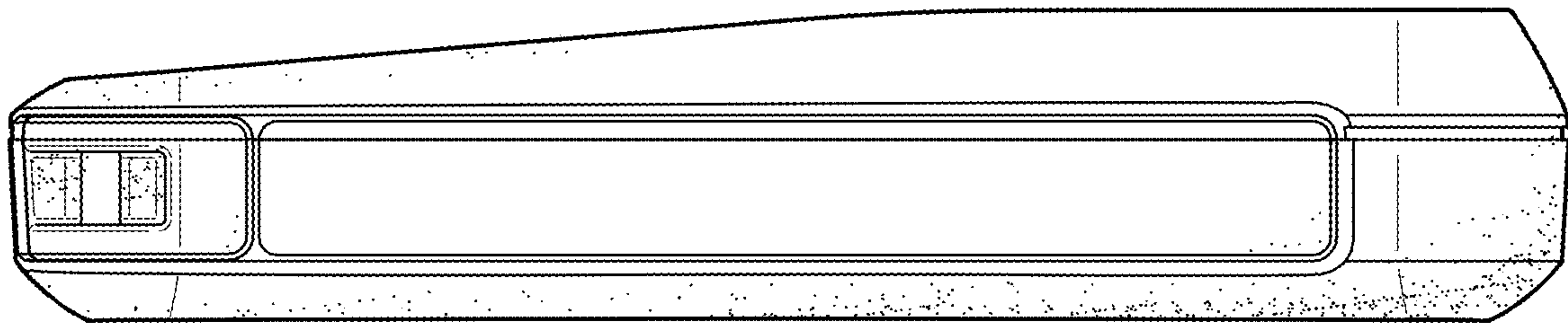

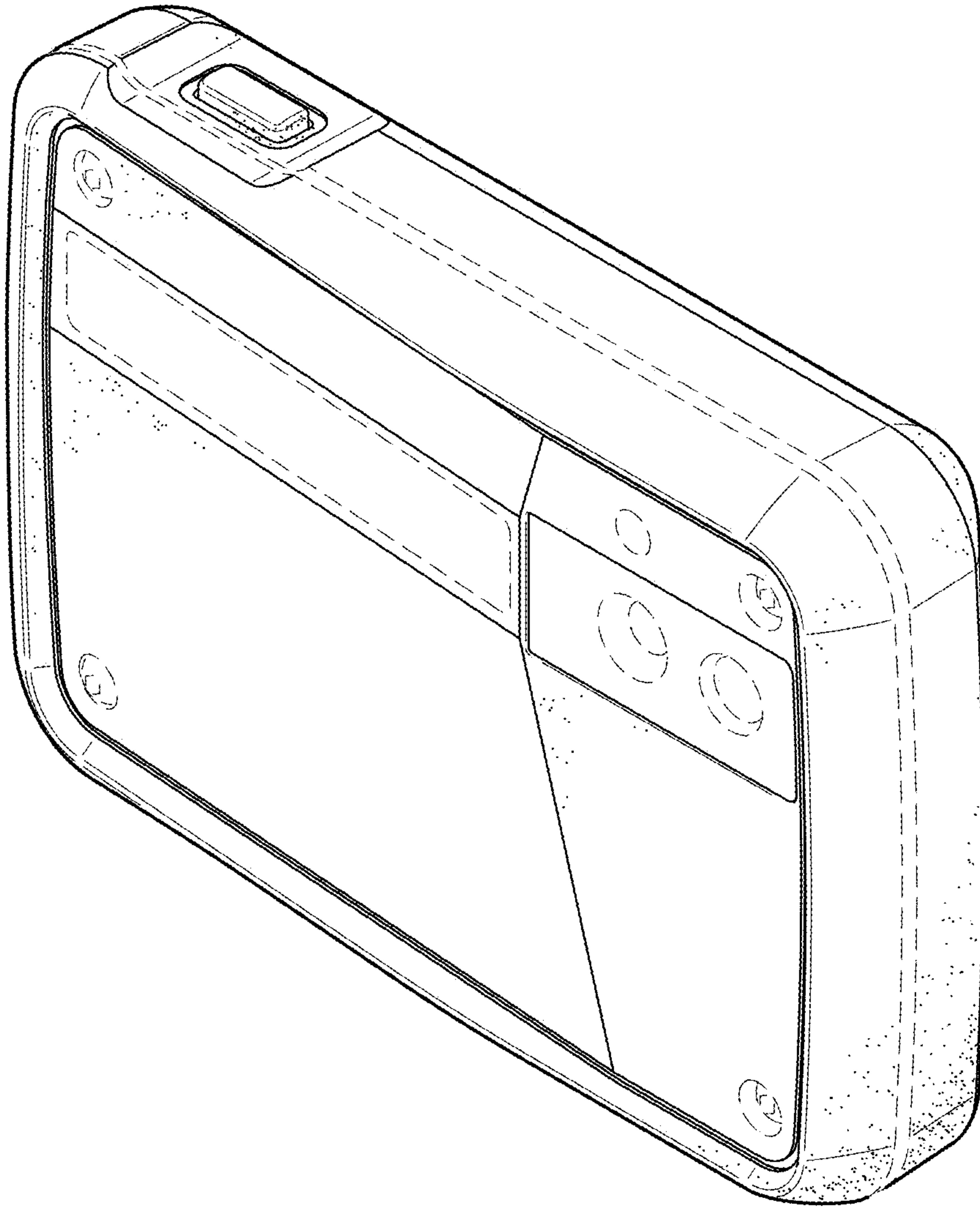

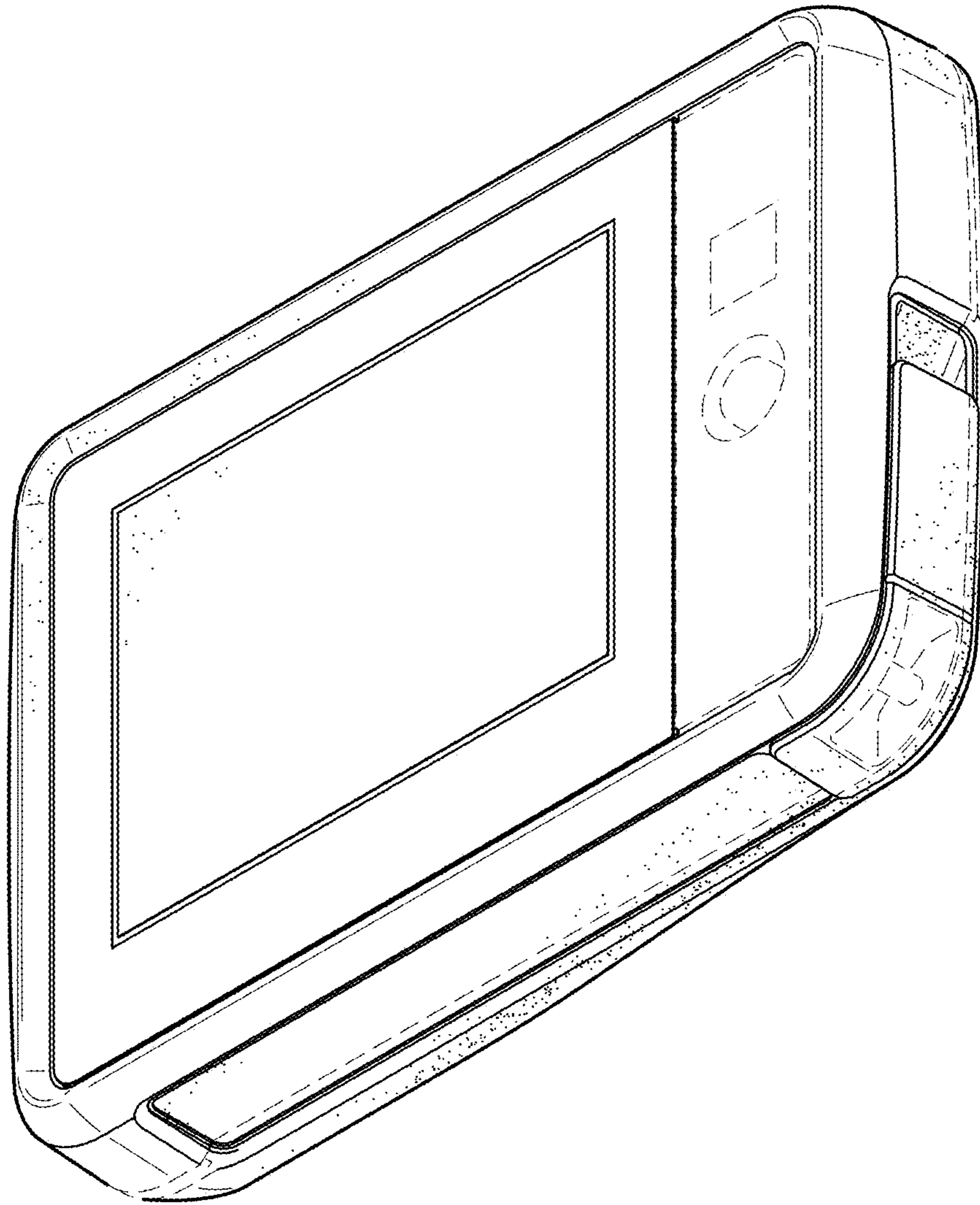

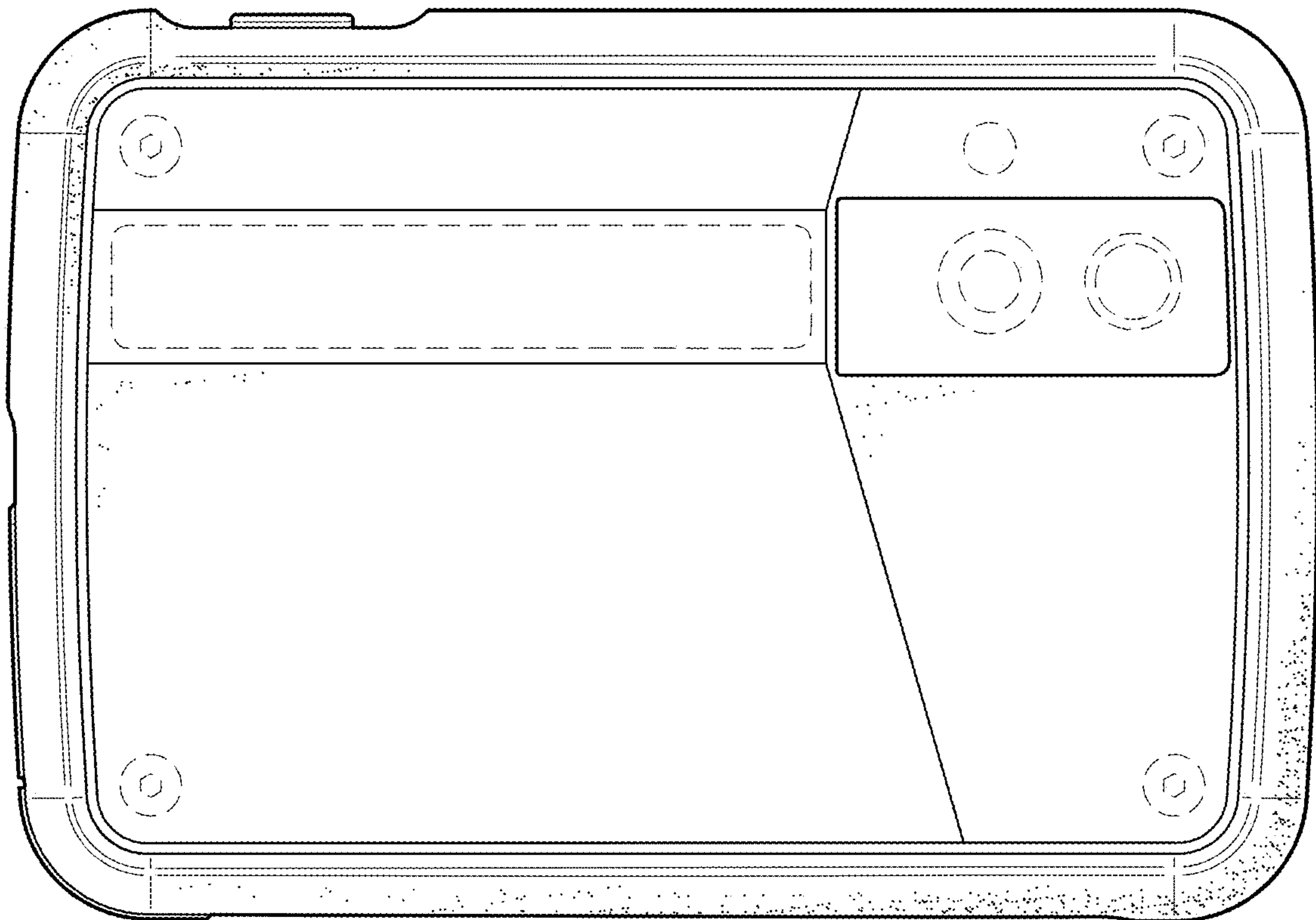

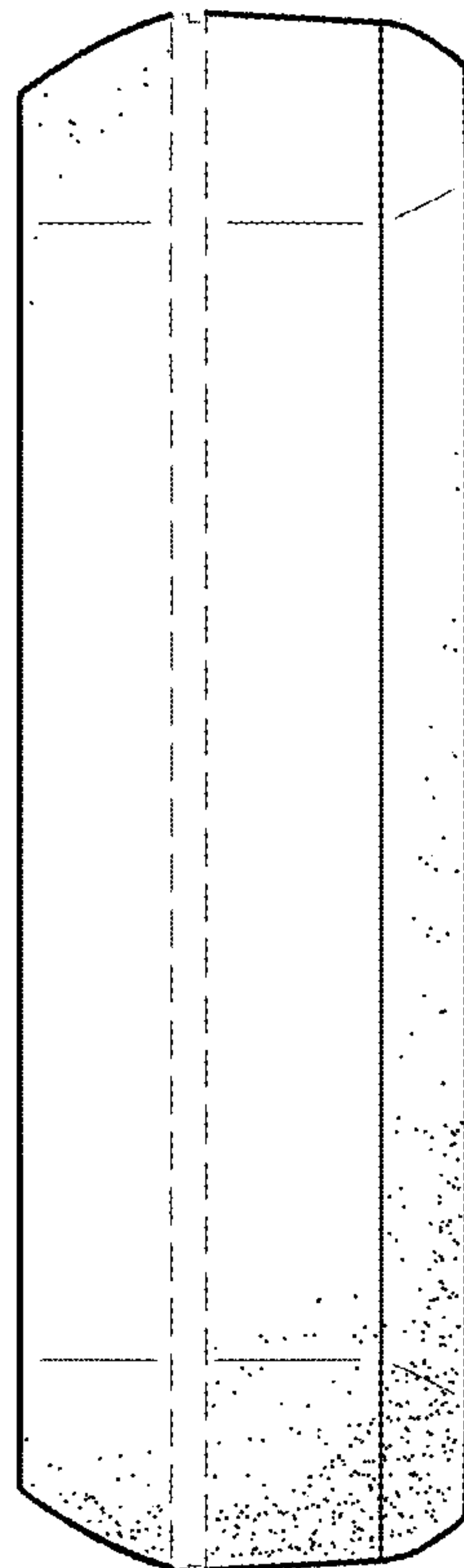

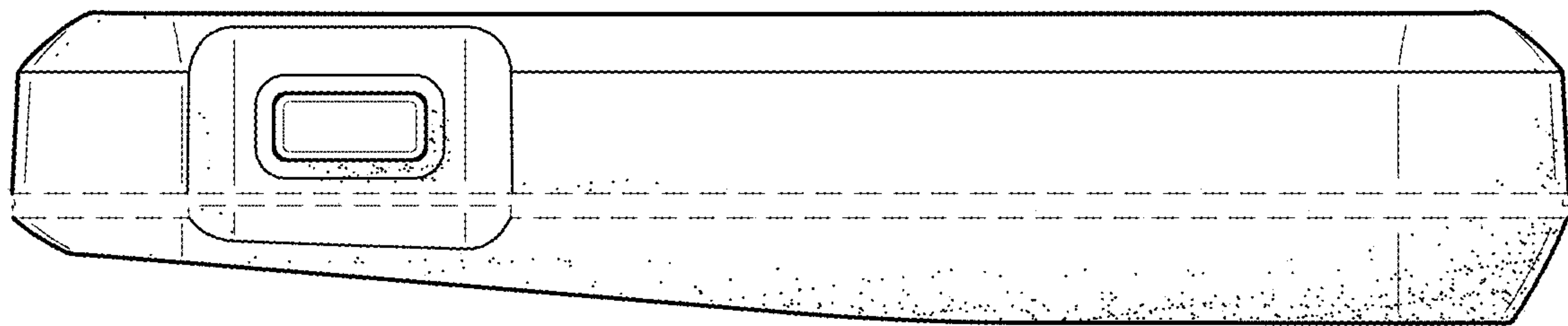

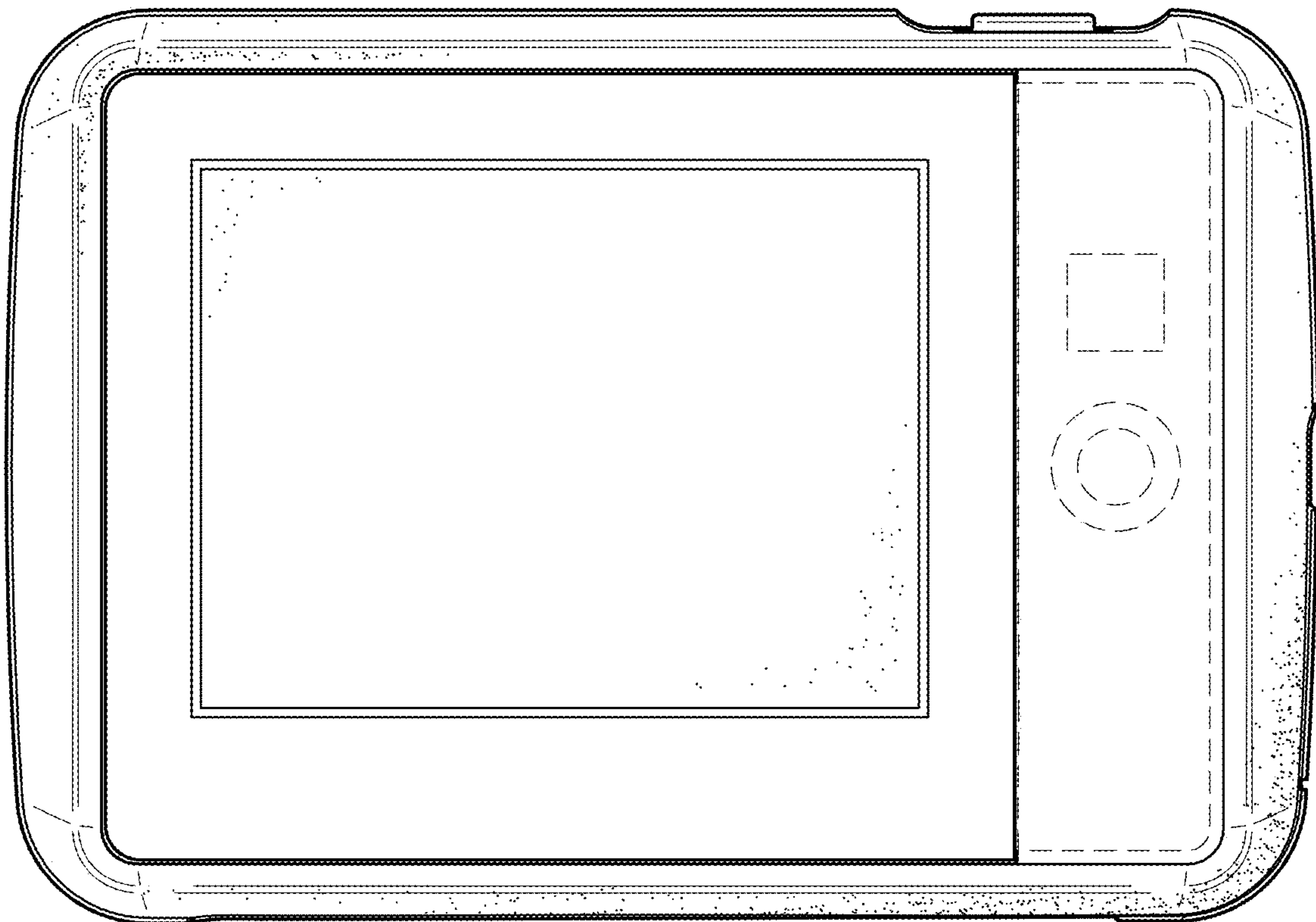

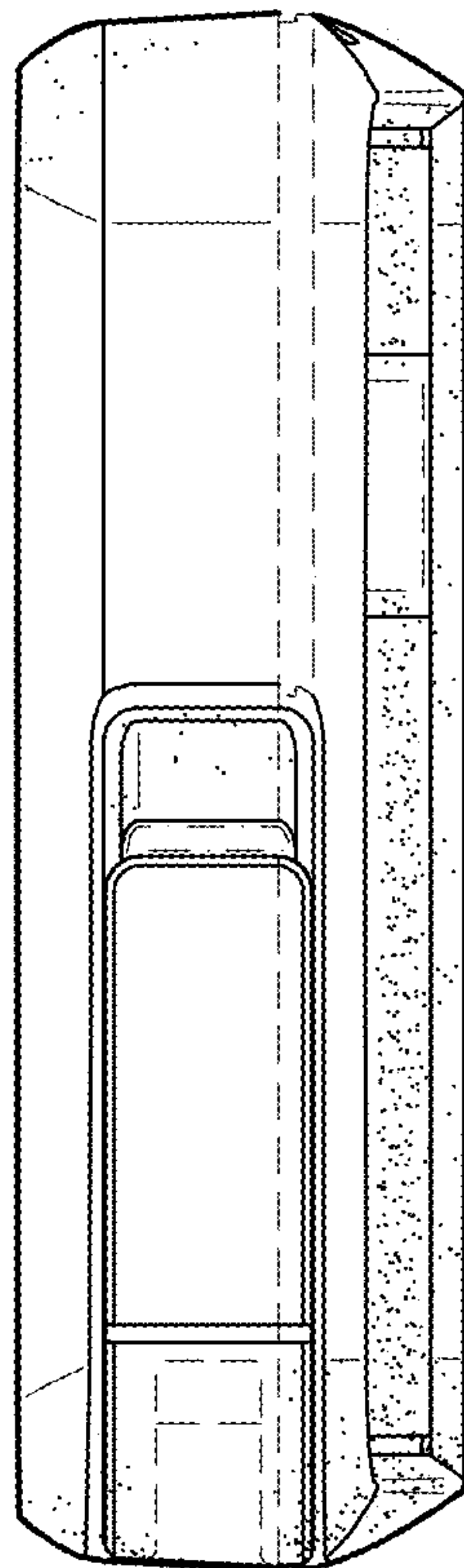

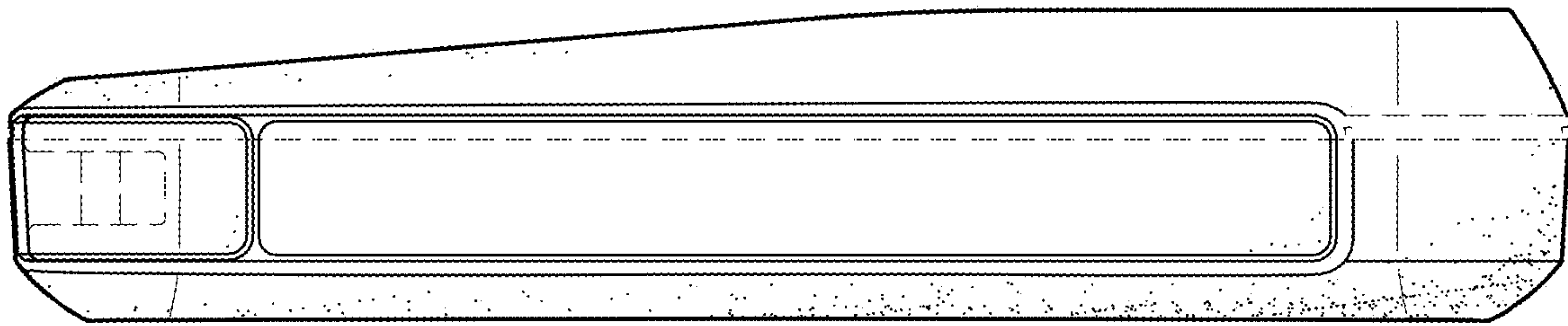
