DESCRIPTION

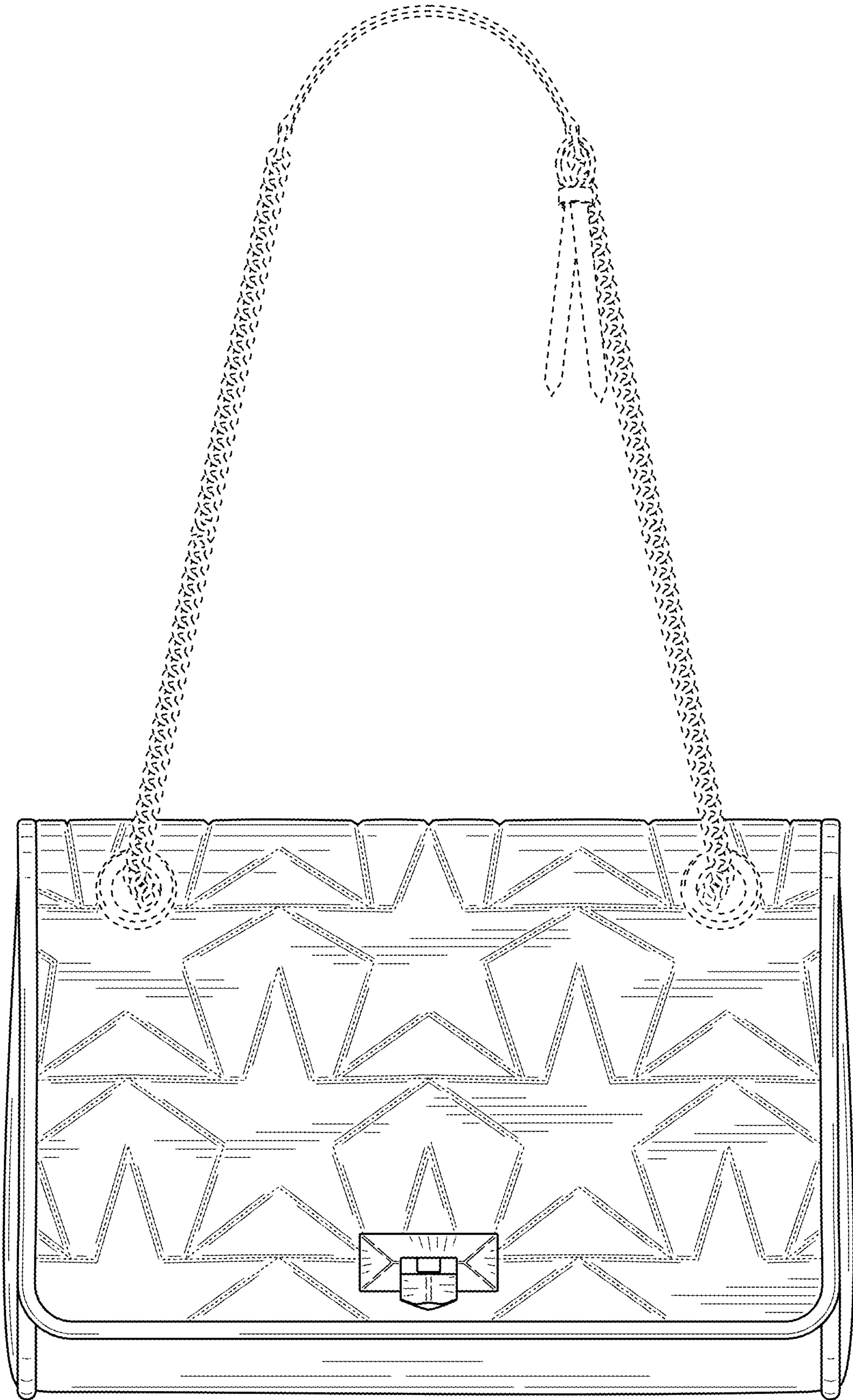

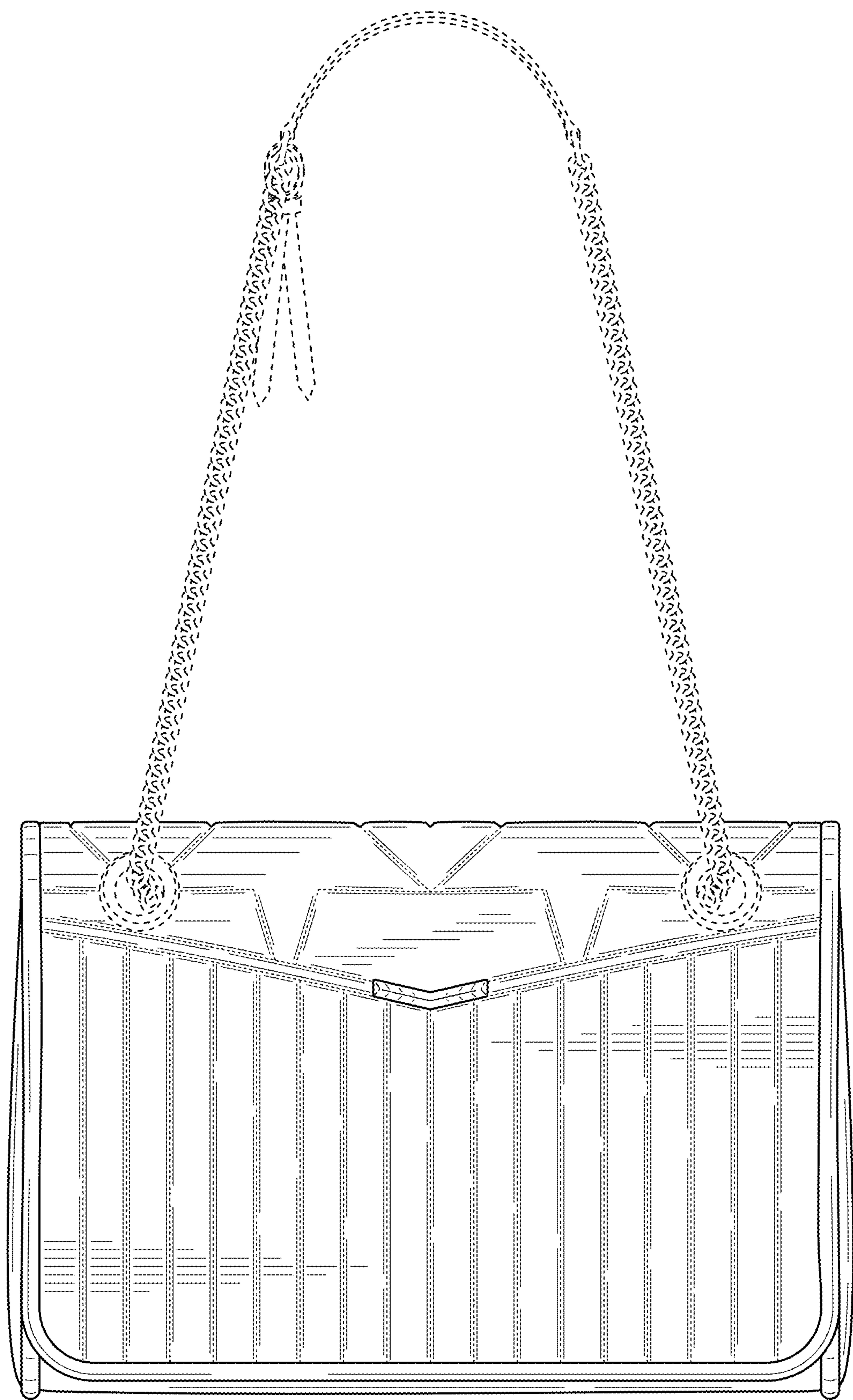

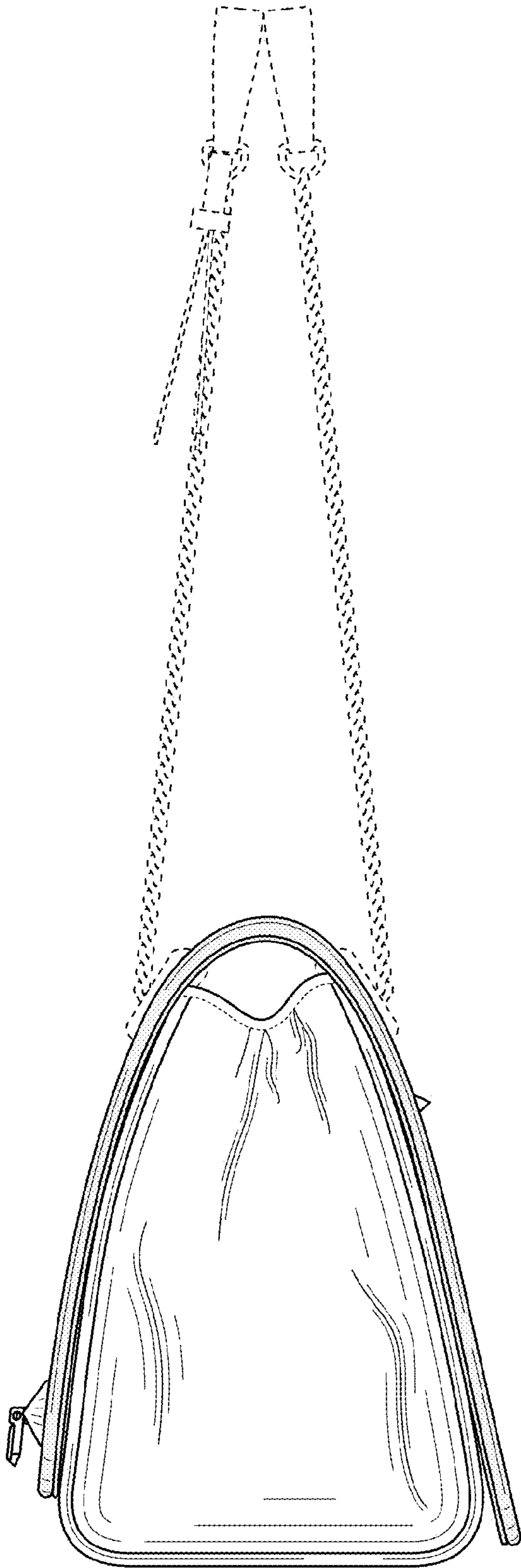

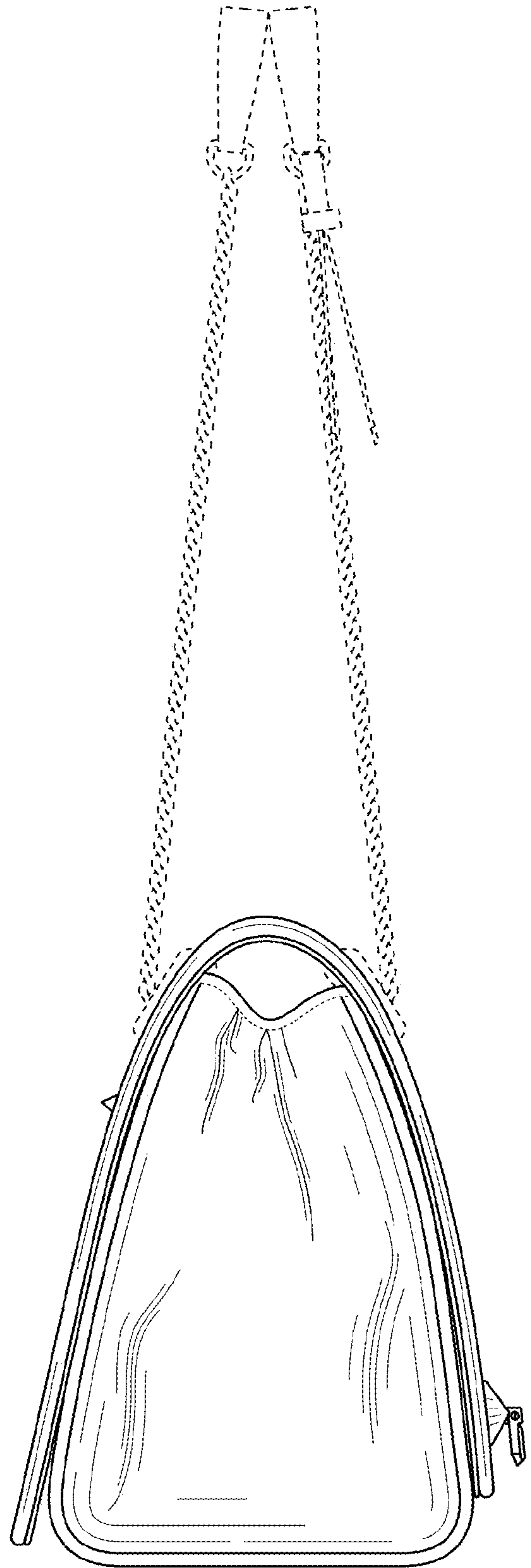

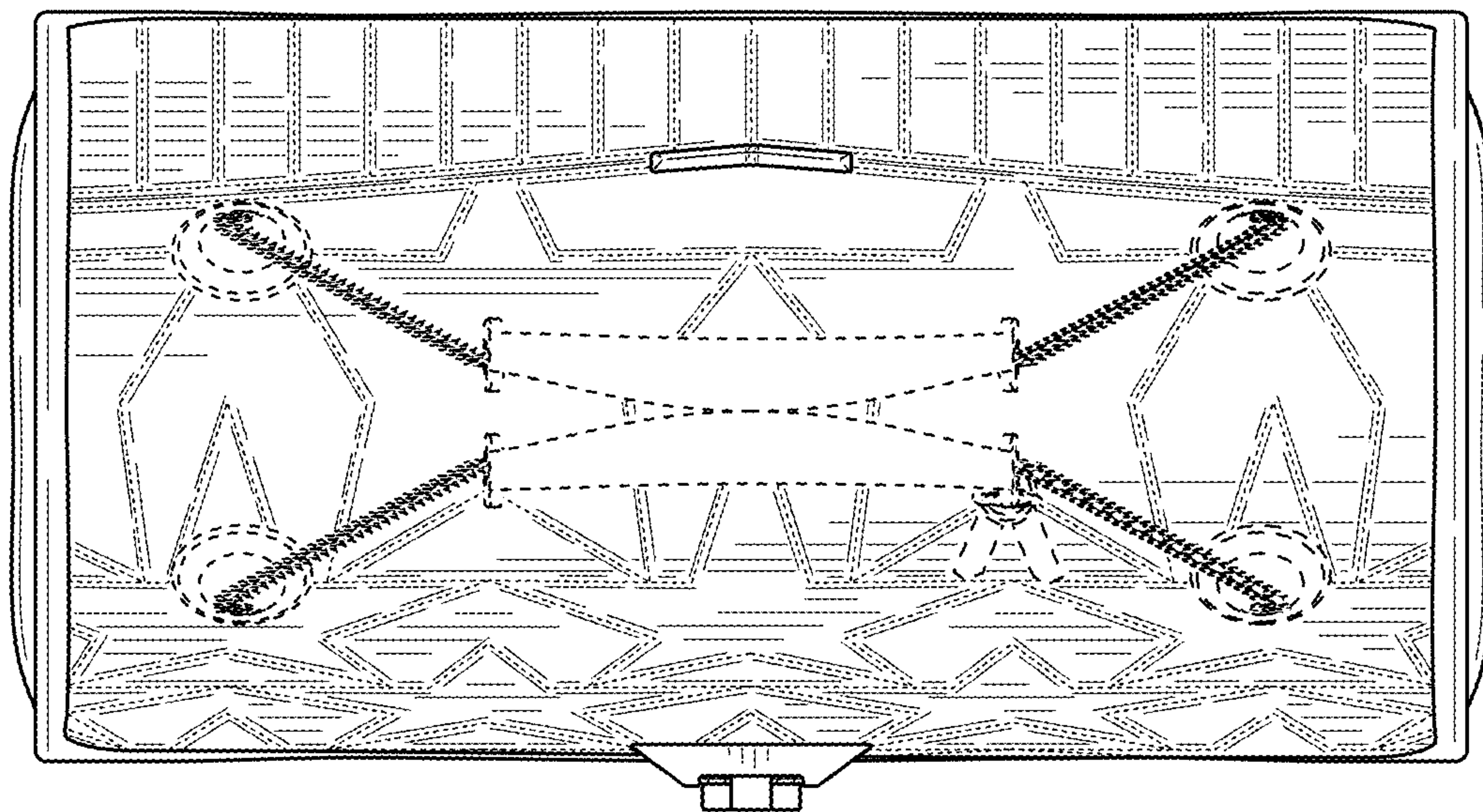

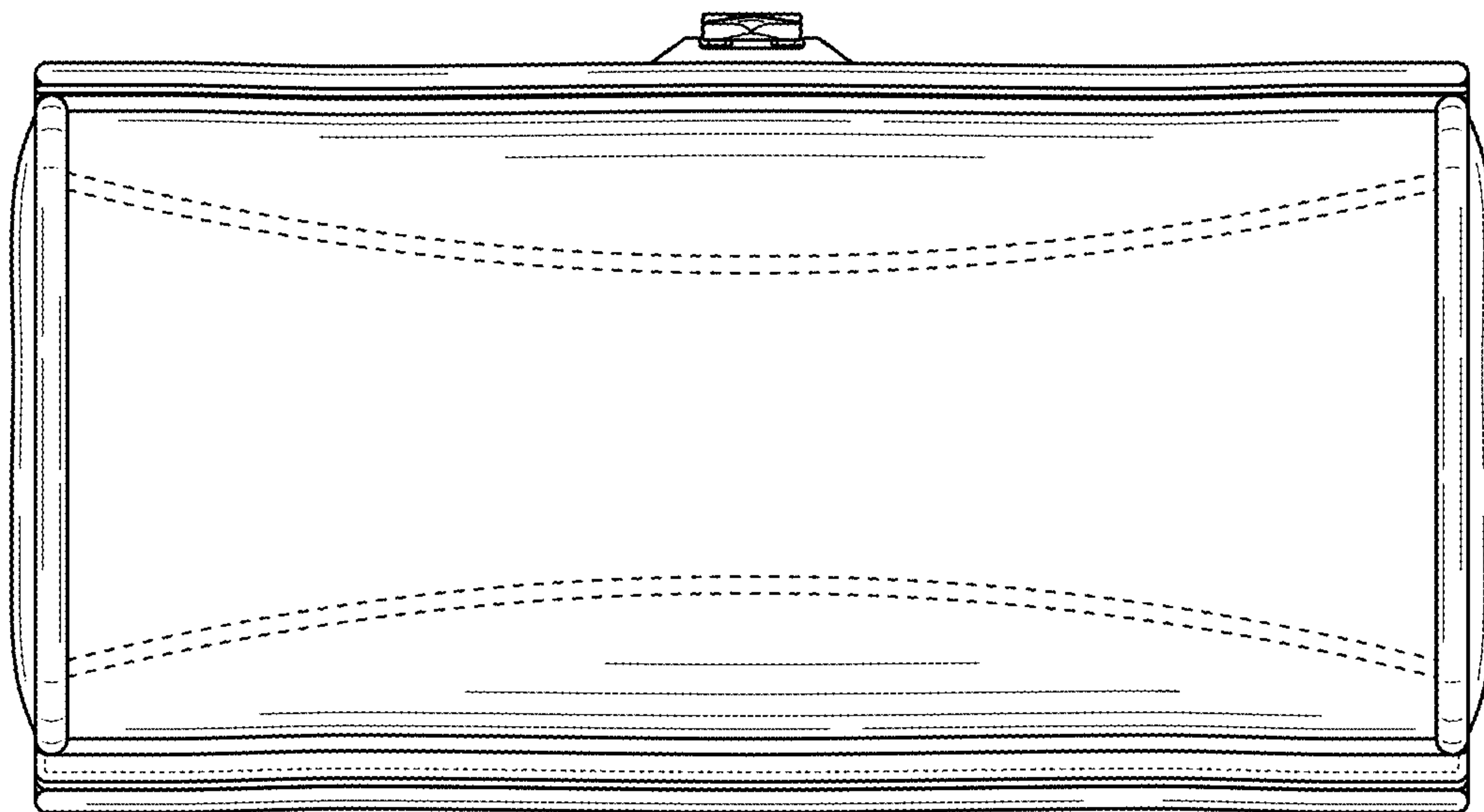

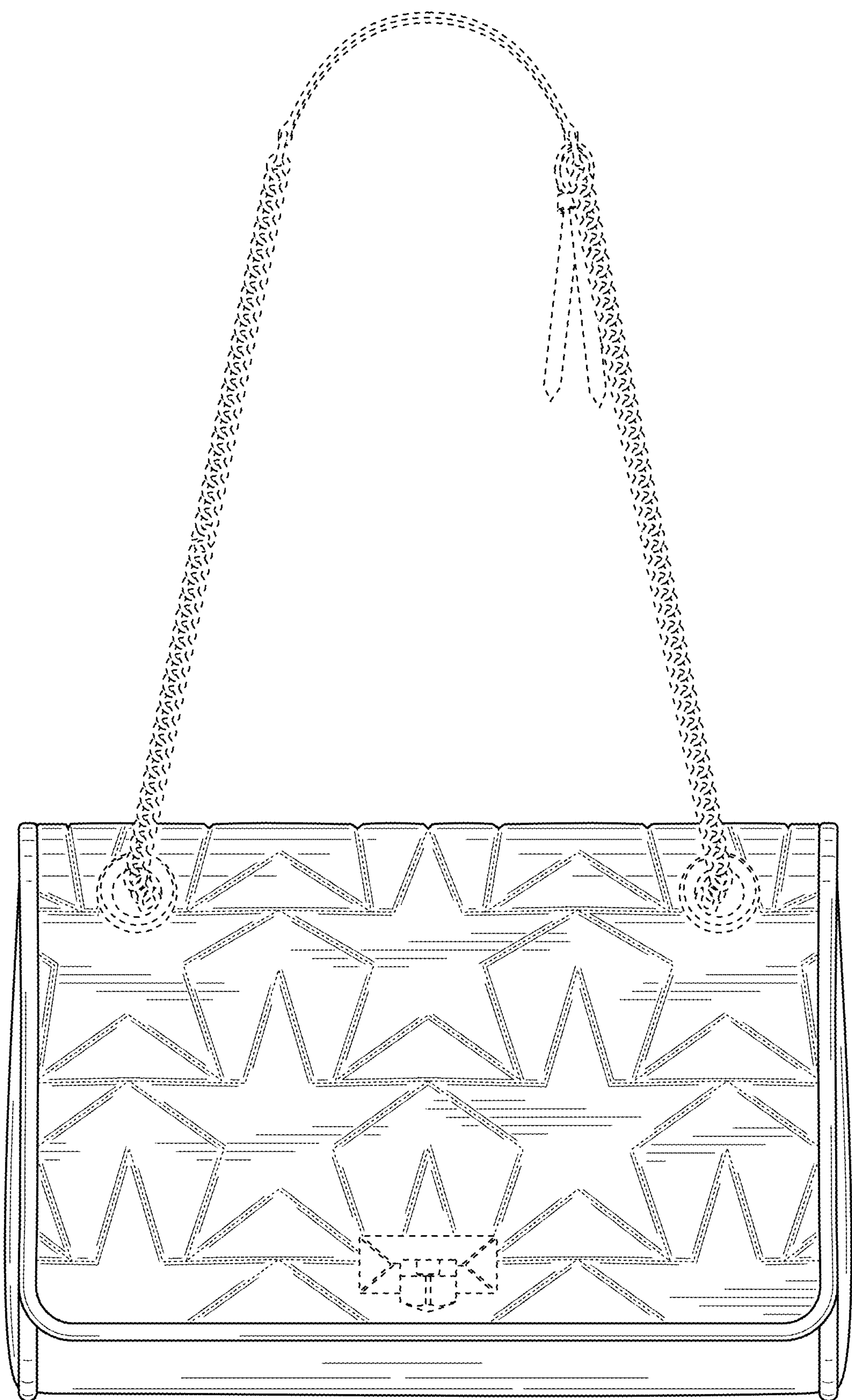

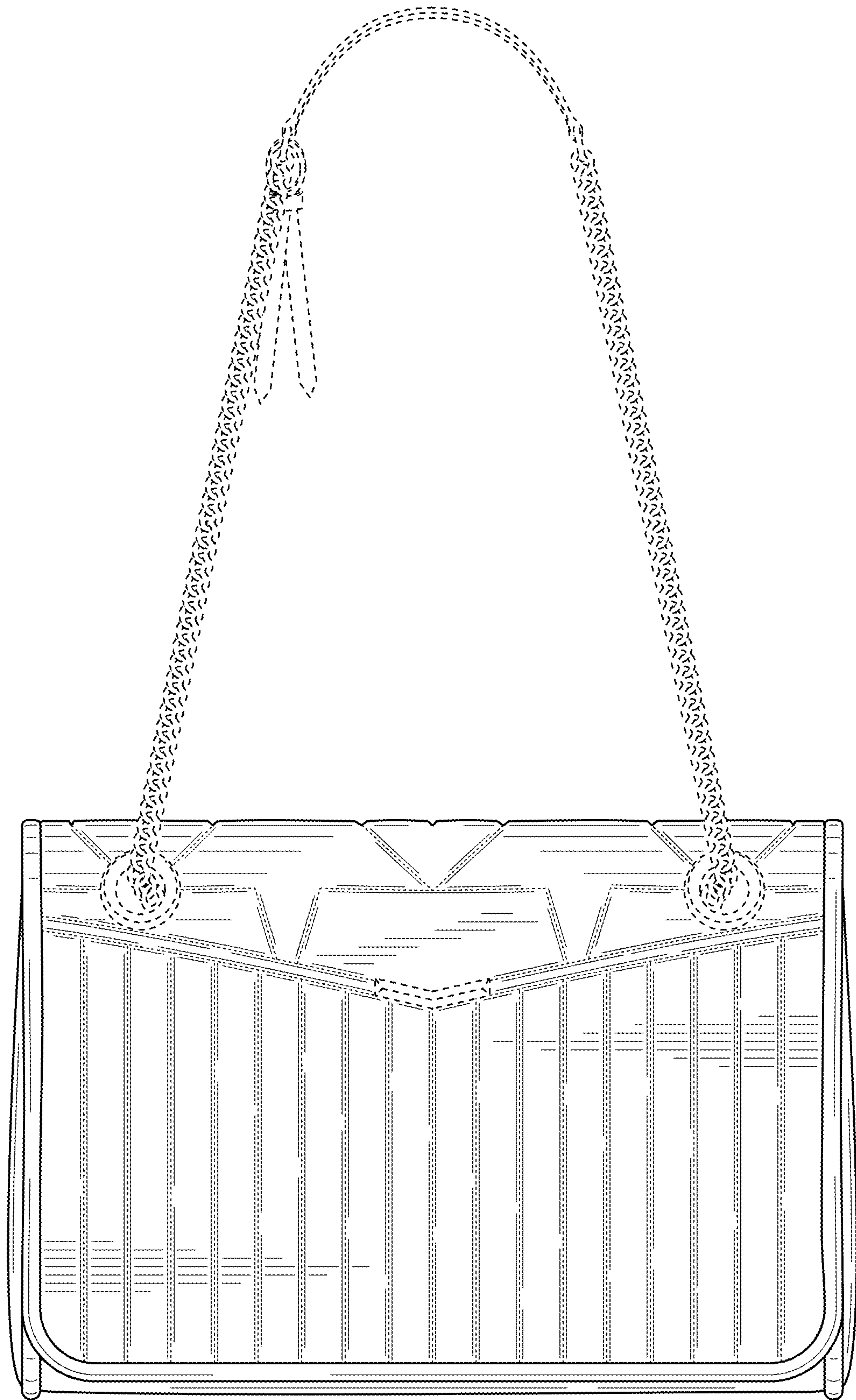

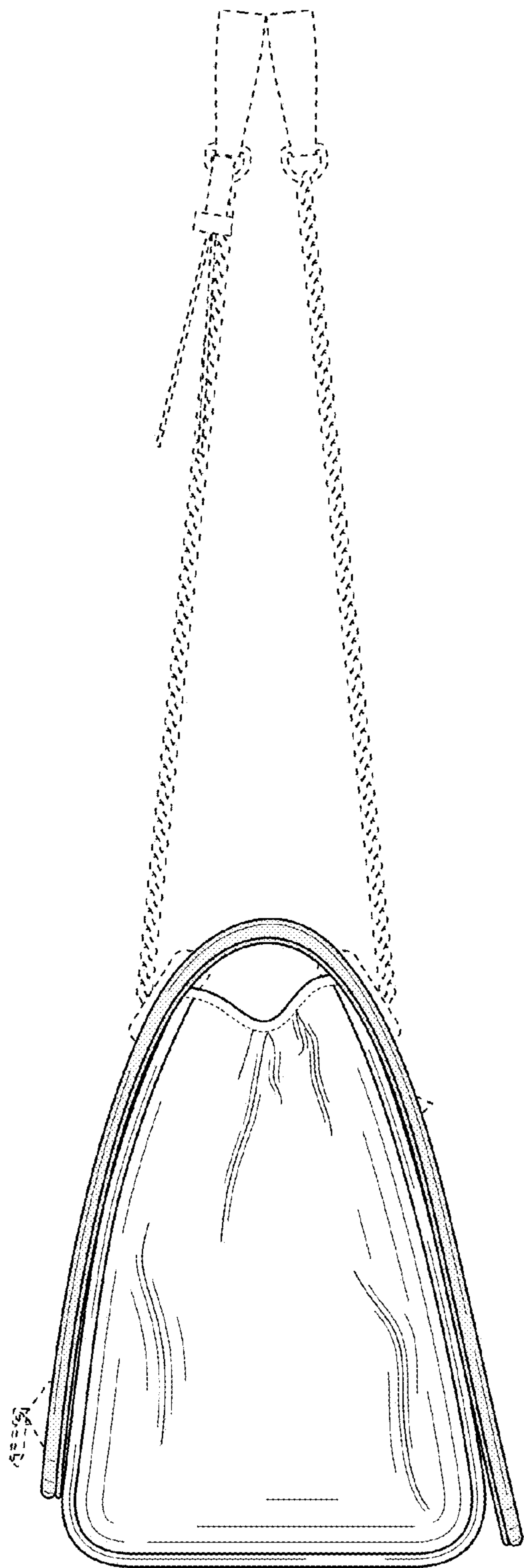

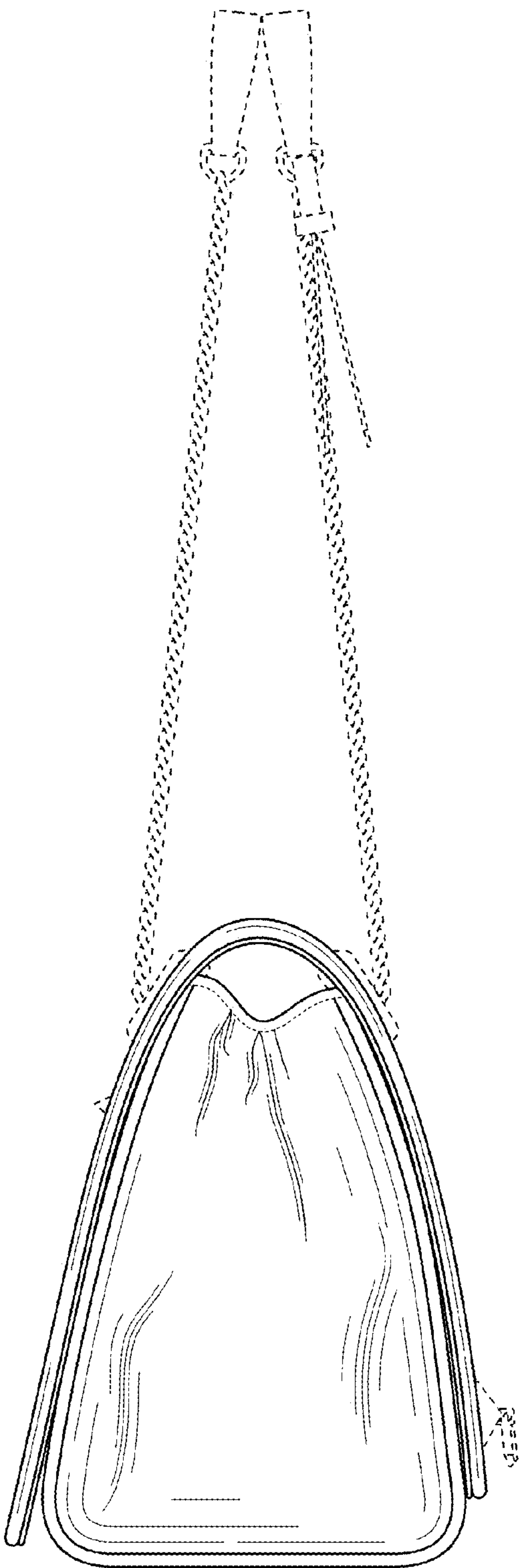

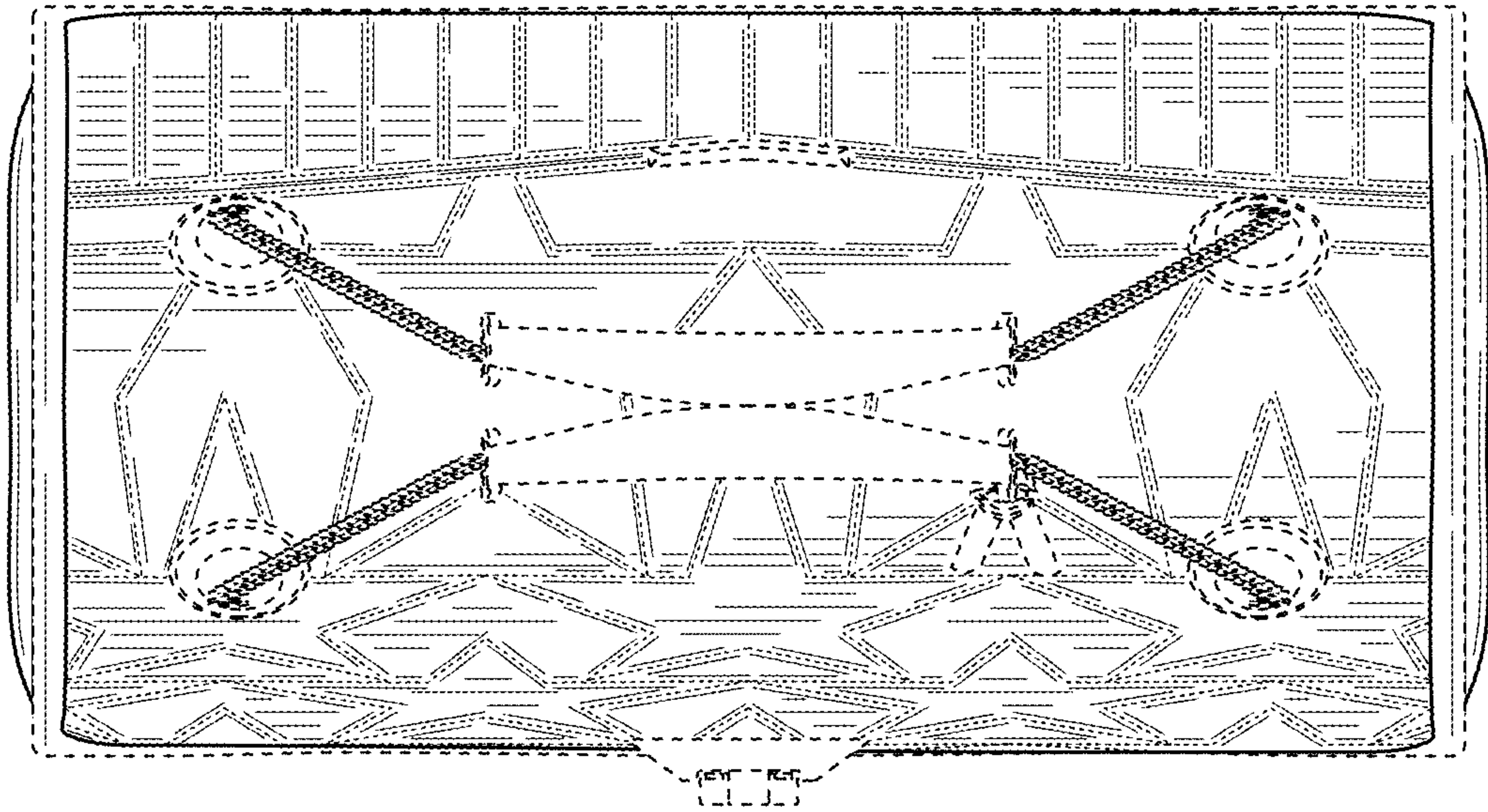

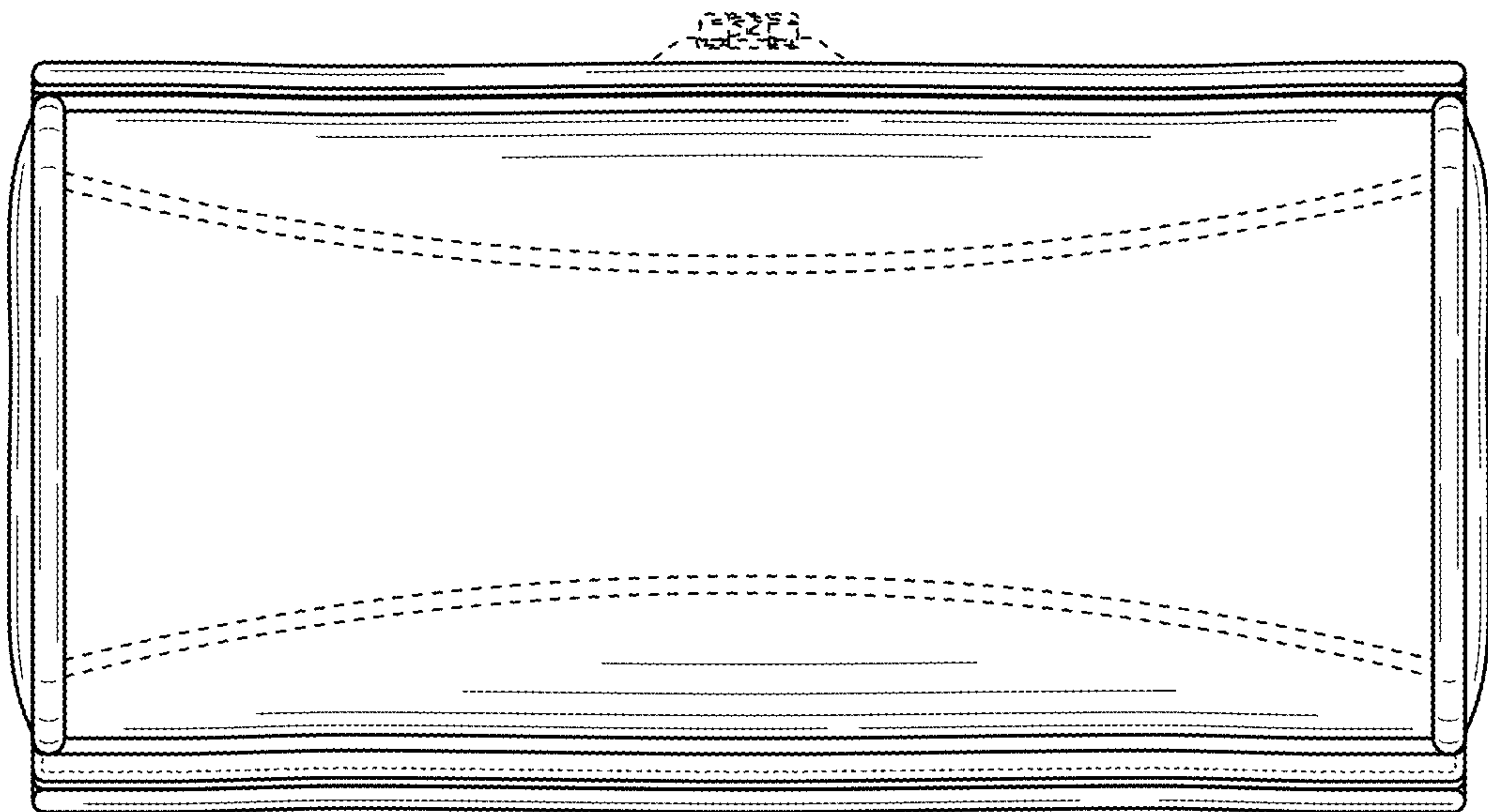

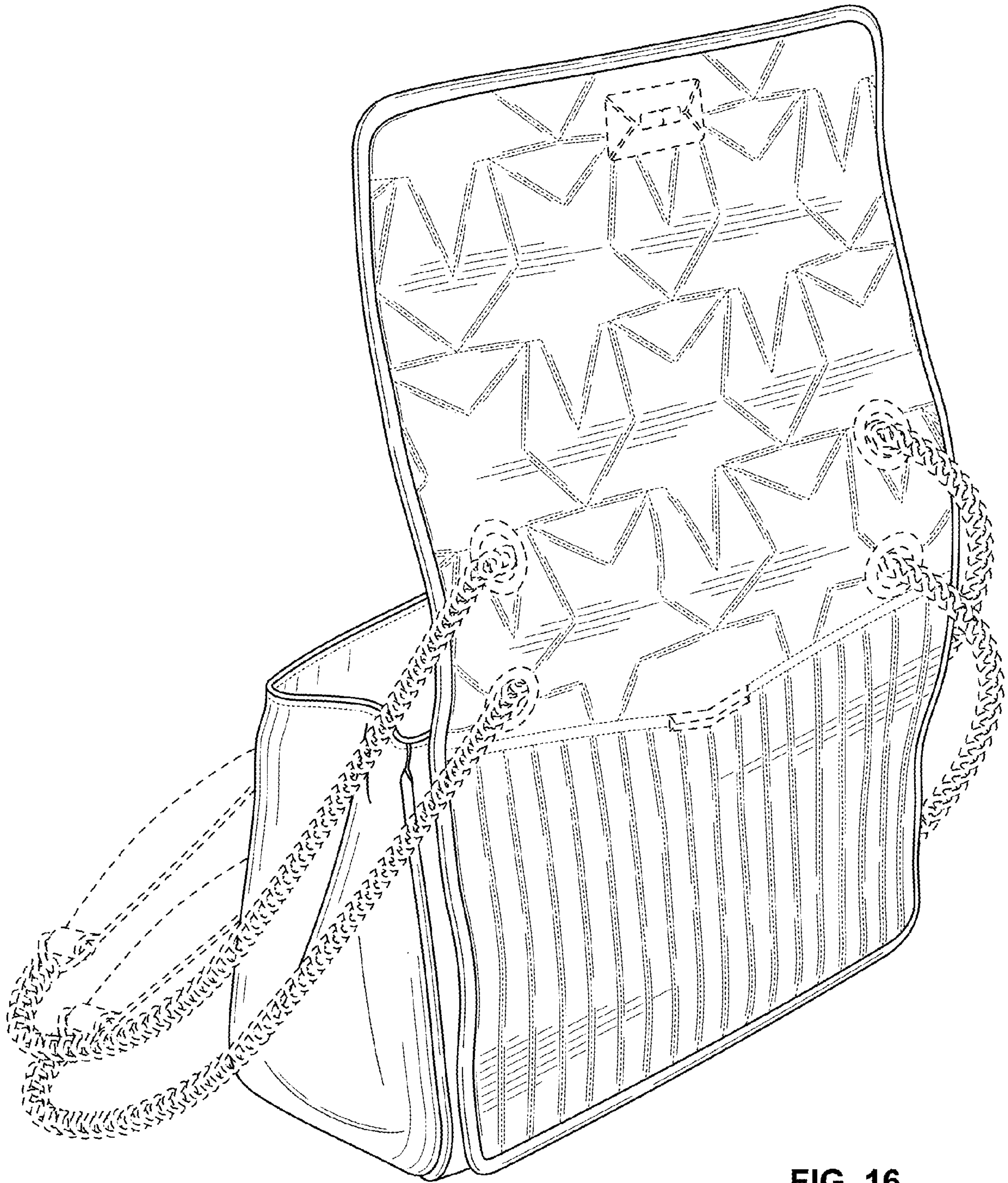
