(57) **CLAIM**

What is claimed is the ornamental design for a luminaire structure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view as viewed from below of the luminaire structure showing our design showing one illuminatable surface in an illuminated state;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view as viewed from above thereof showing two illuminatable surfaces in an illuminated state;

FIG. 3 is a left hand side elevational view thereof, showing two illuminatable surfaces in an illuminated state, the right hand side elevation being a mirror image thereof and therefore omitted;

FIG. 4. is a rear elevational view thereof, showing two illuminatable surfaces in an illuminated state;

FIG. 5. is a front elevational view thereof, showing two illuminatable surfaces in an illuminated state;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof, showing one illuminatable surface in an illuminated state;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof, showing one illuminatable surface in an illuminated state;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view as viewed from below of the luminaire structure showing our design;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view as viewed from above thereof;

FIG. 10 is a right hand side elevational view thereof, the left hand side elevation being a mirror image thereof and therefore omitted;

FIG. 11. is a front elevational view thereof;

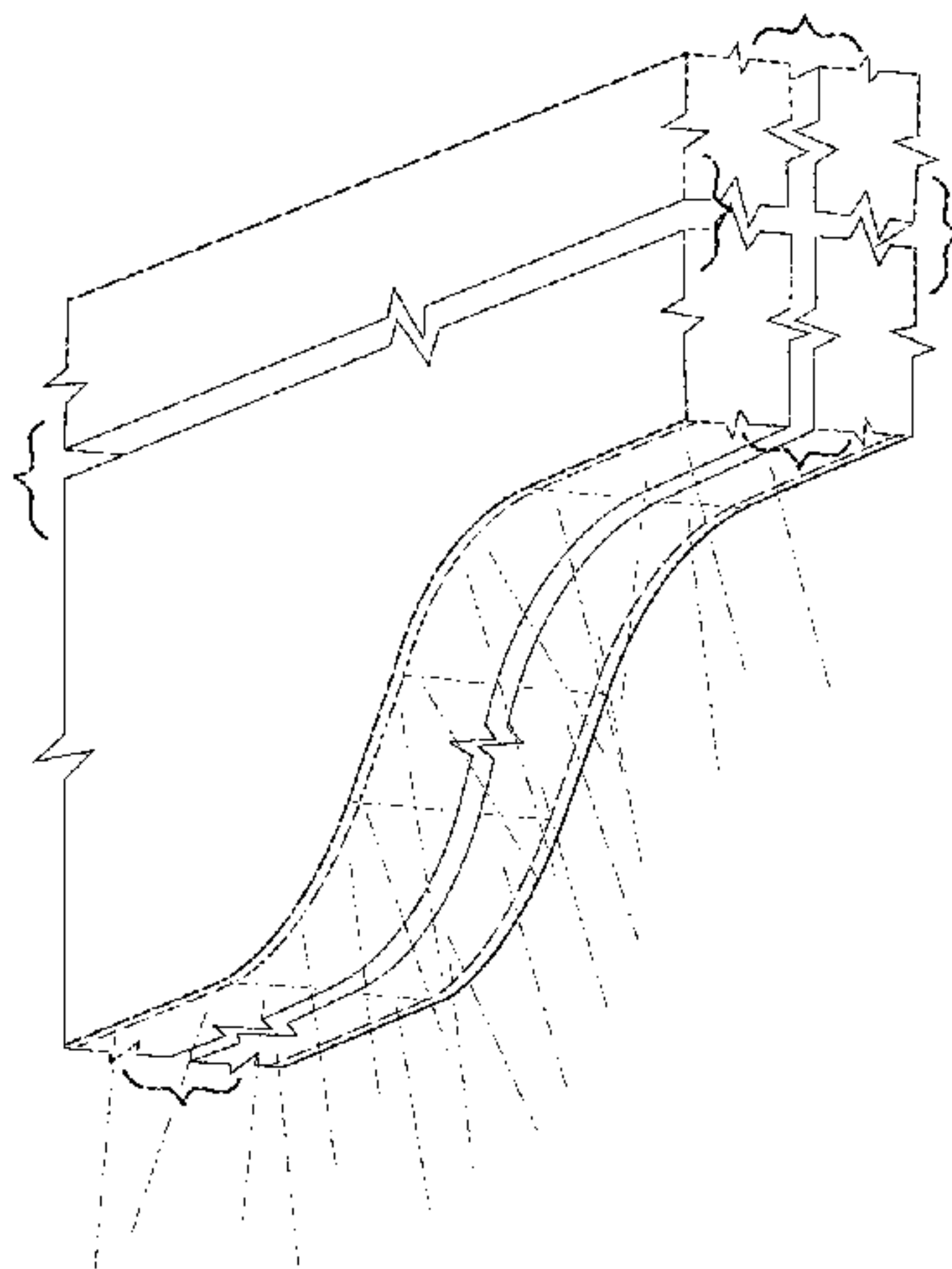
FIG. 12. is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The luminaire structure is an illuminatable device capable of multiple states of illumination. The broken radiating line representations shown in FIGS. 1 to 7 are provided for the purpose of illustrating illumination surfaces in a state of illumination and are not intended to depict any particular color, texture, reflectivity, or material. Light providing the illumination in an illuminated state is not indicated to be nor

intended to be emanating from any particular source or type of lighting device. Further, the broken line radiating line representations may also apply to any one or more surfaces in the embodiments of FIGS. 1 to 7. The broken lines in the drawings are directed to environment and are for illustrative purposes and form no part of the claimed design.

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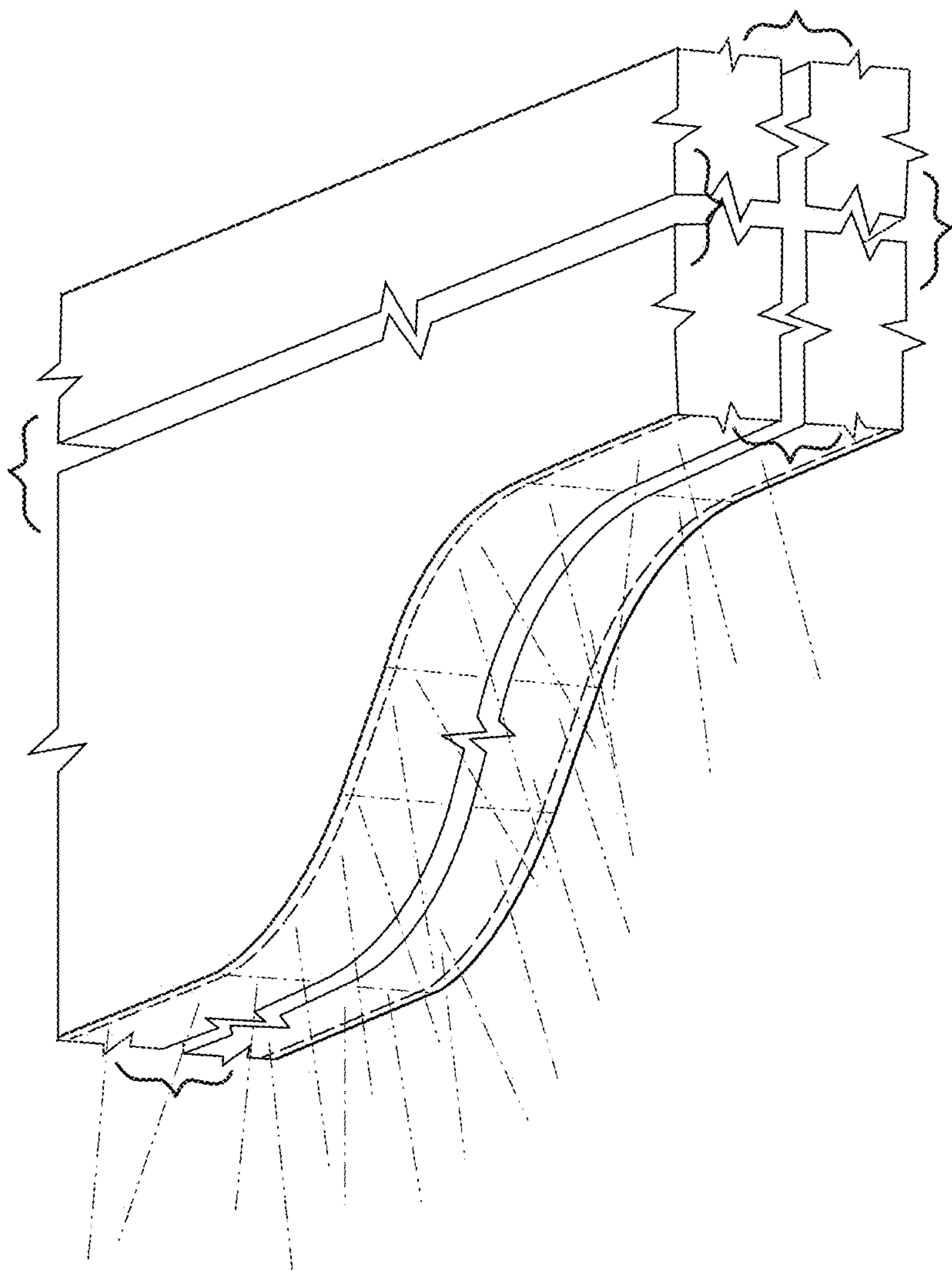

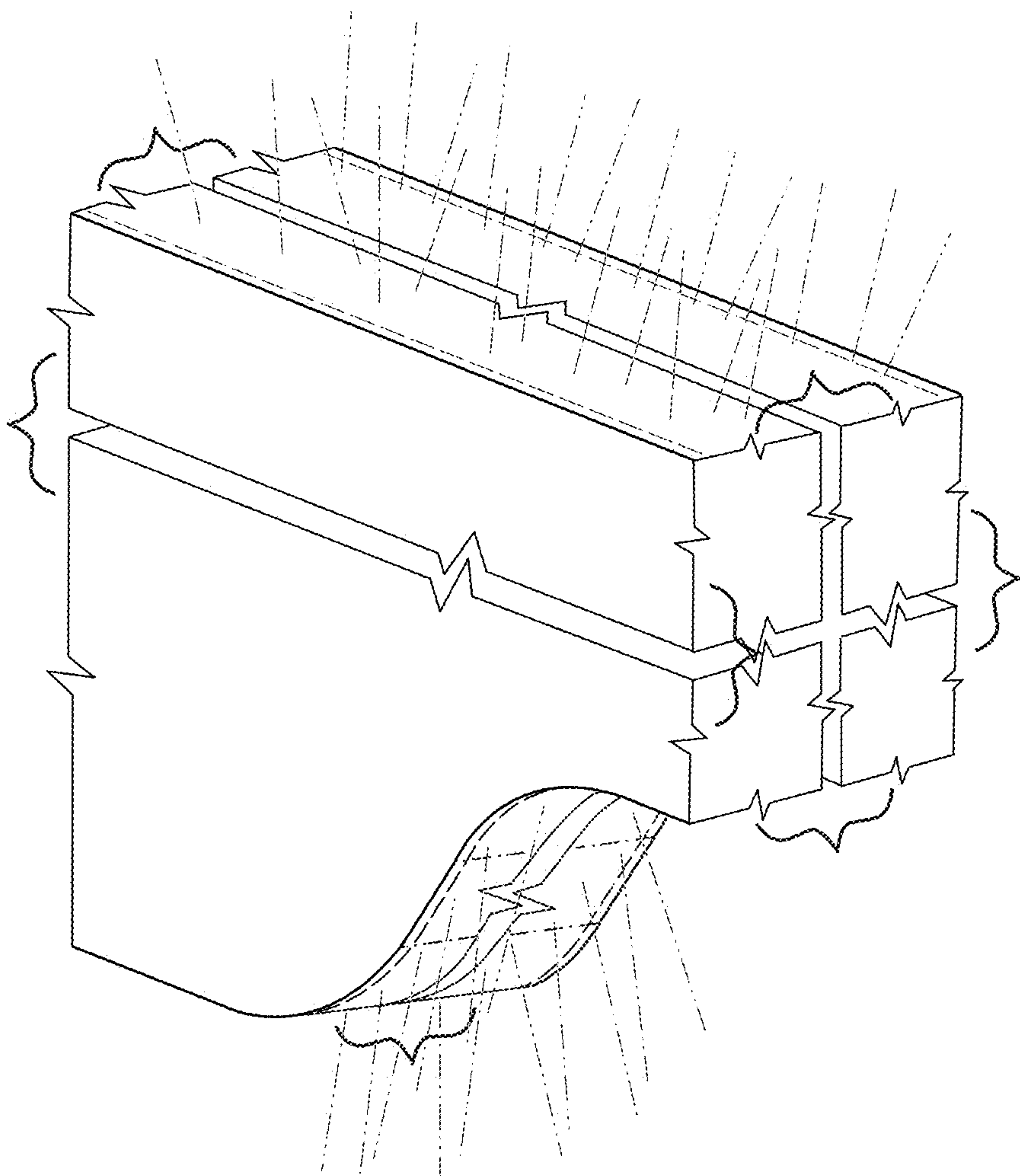
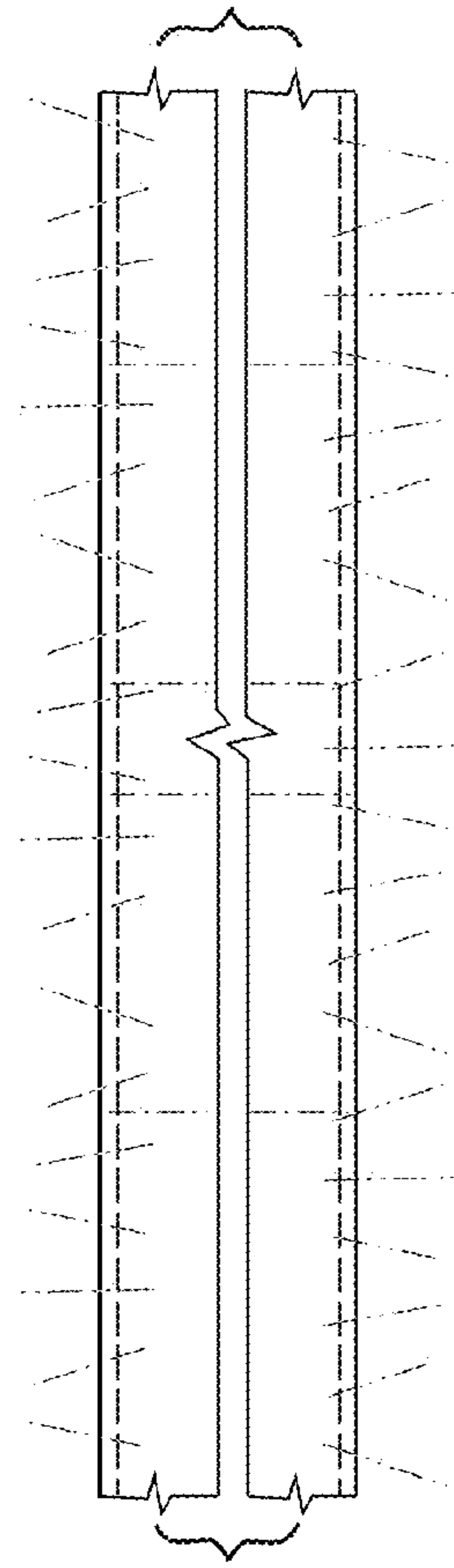
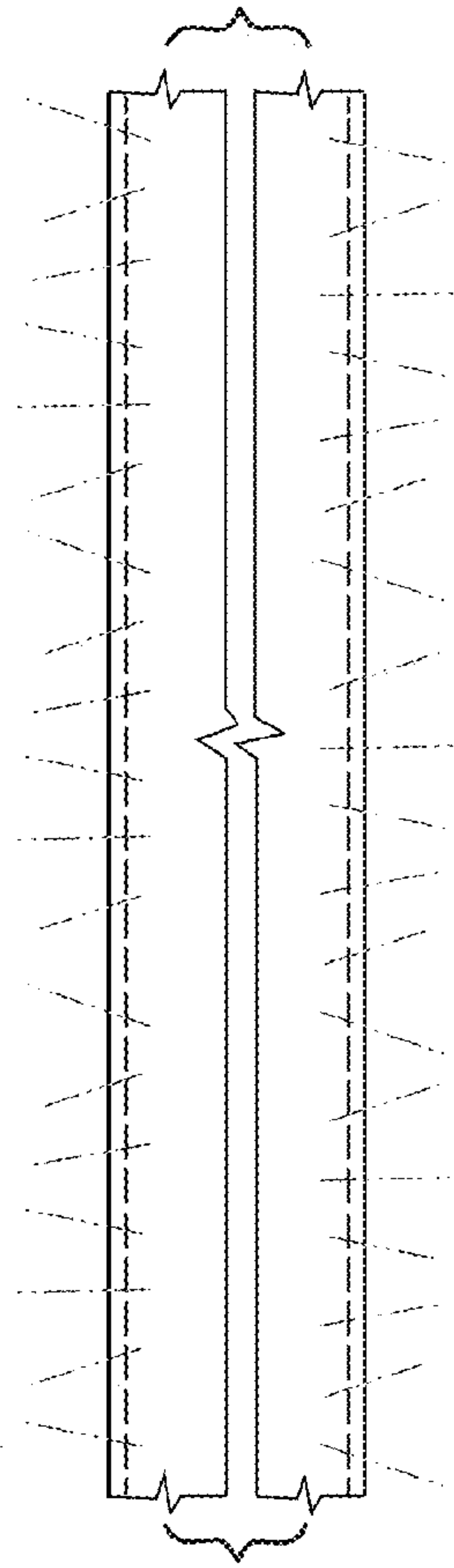
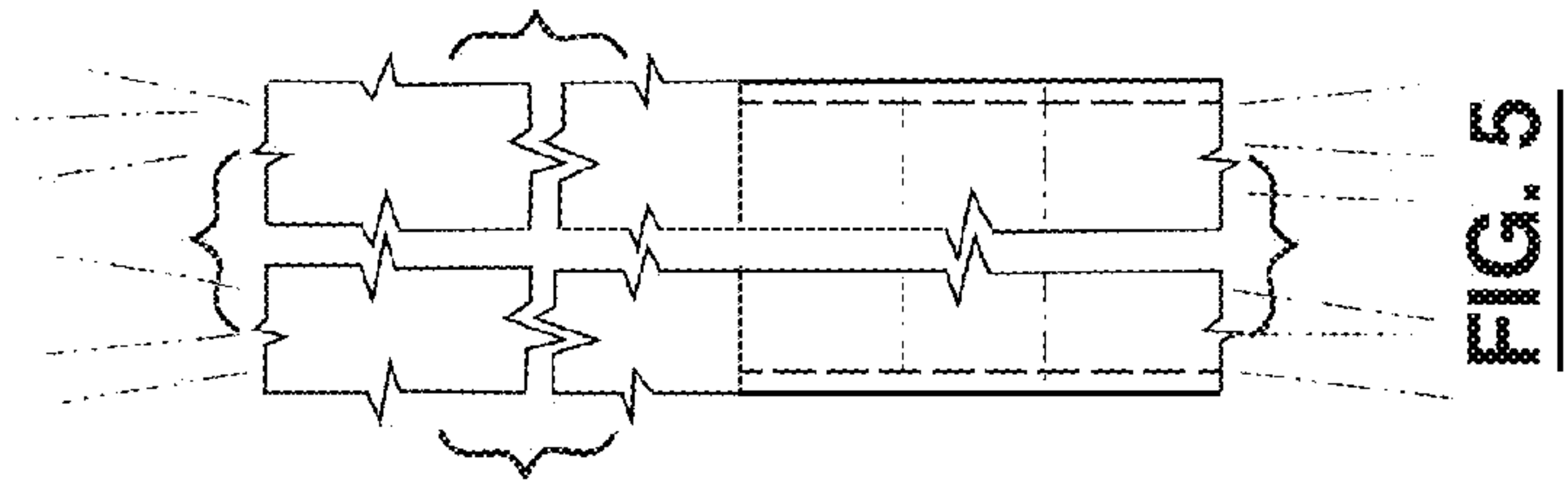
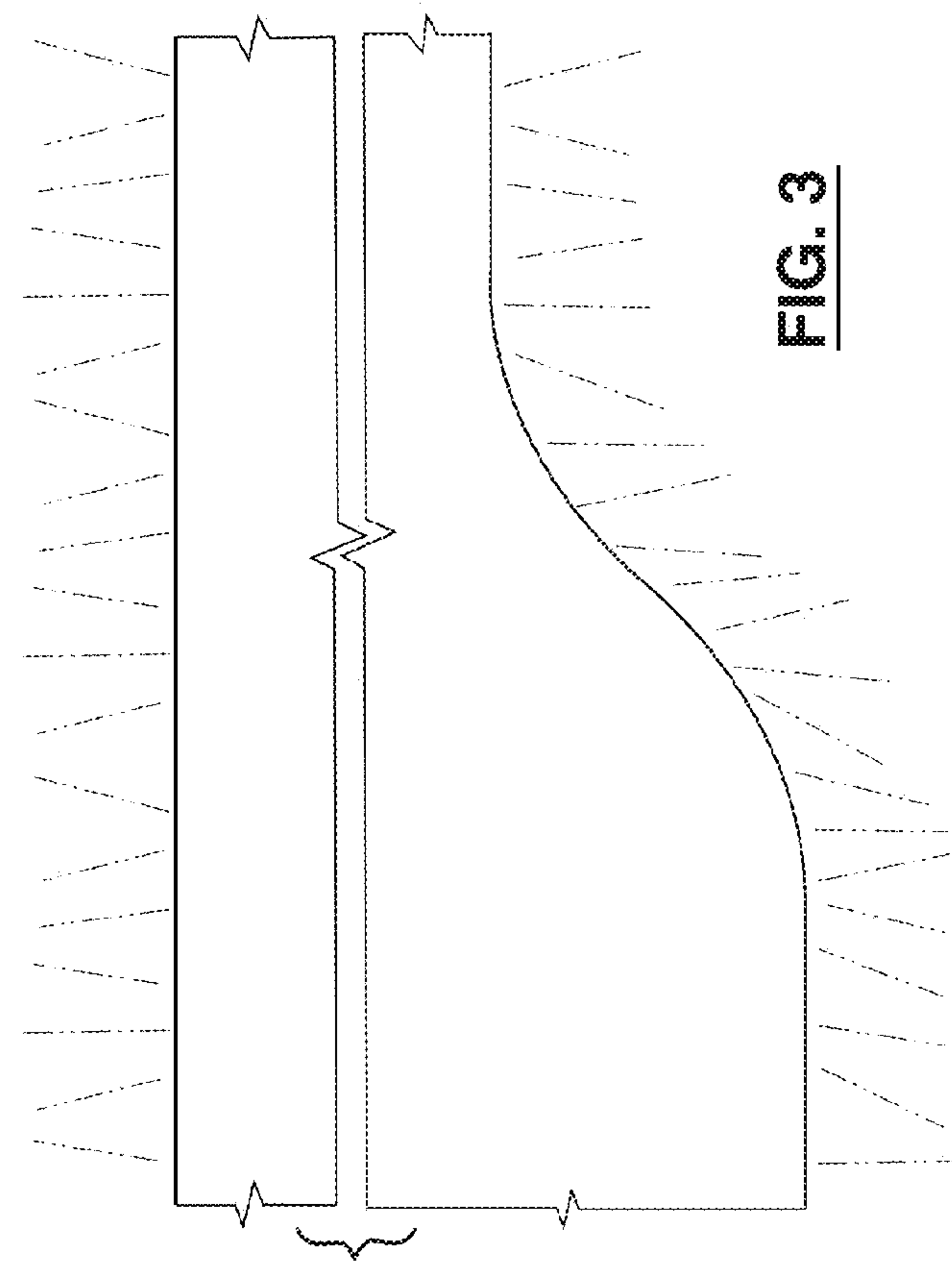
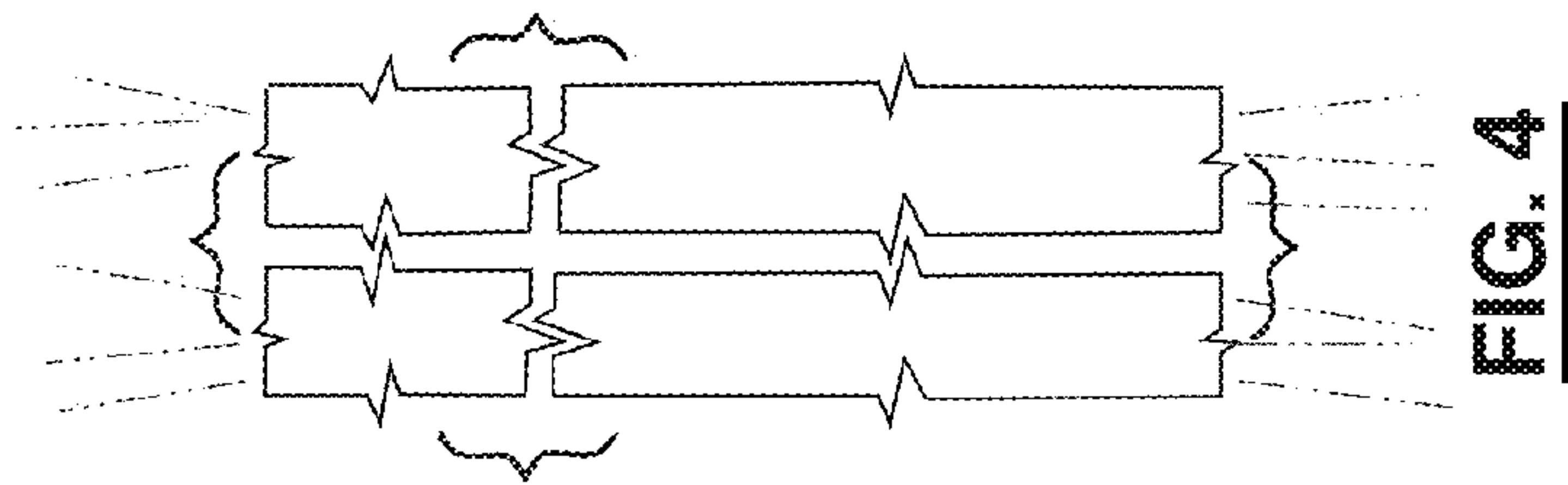

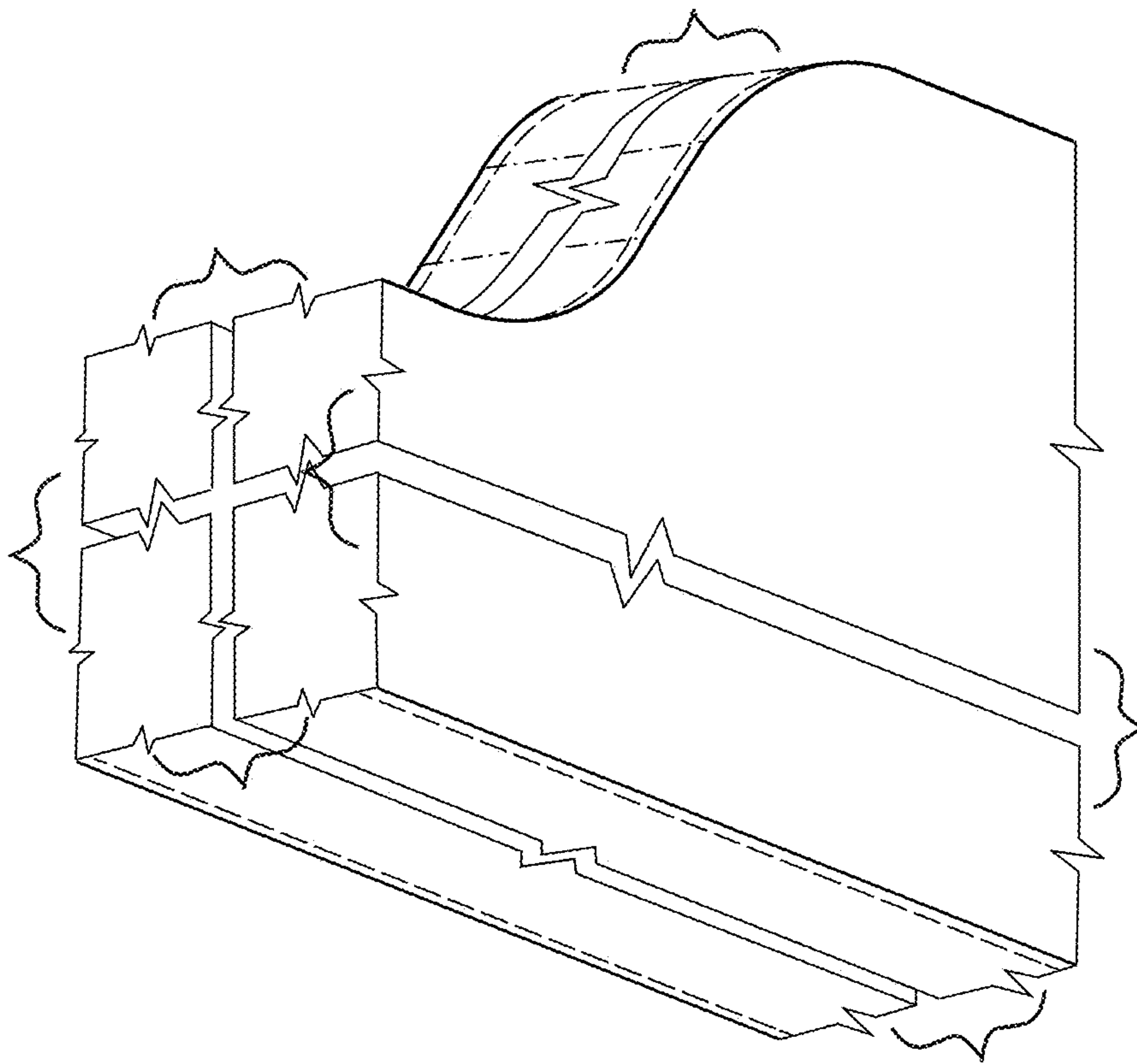

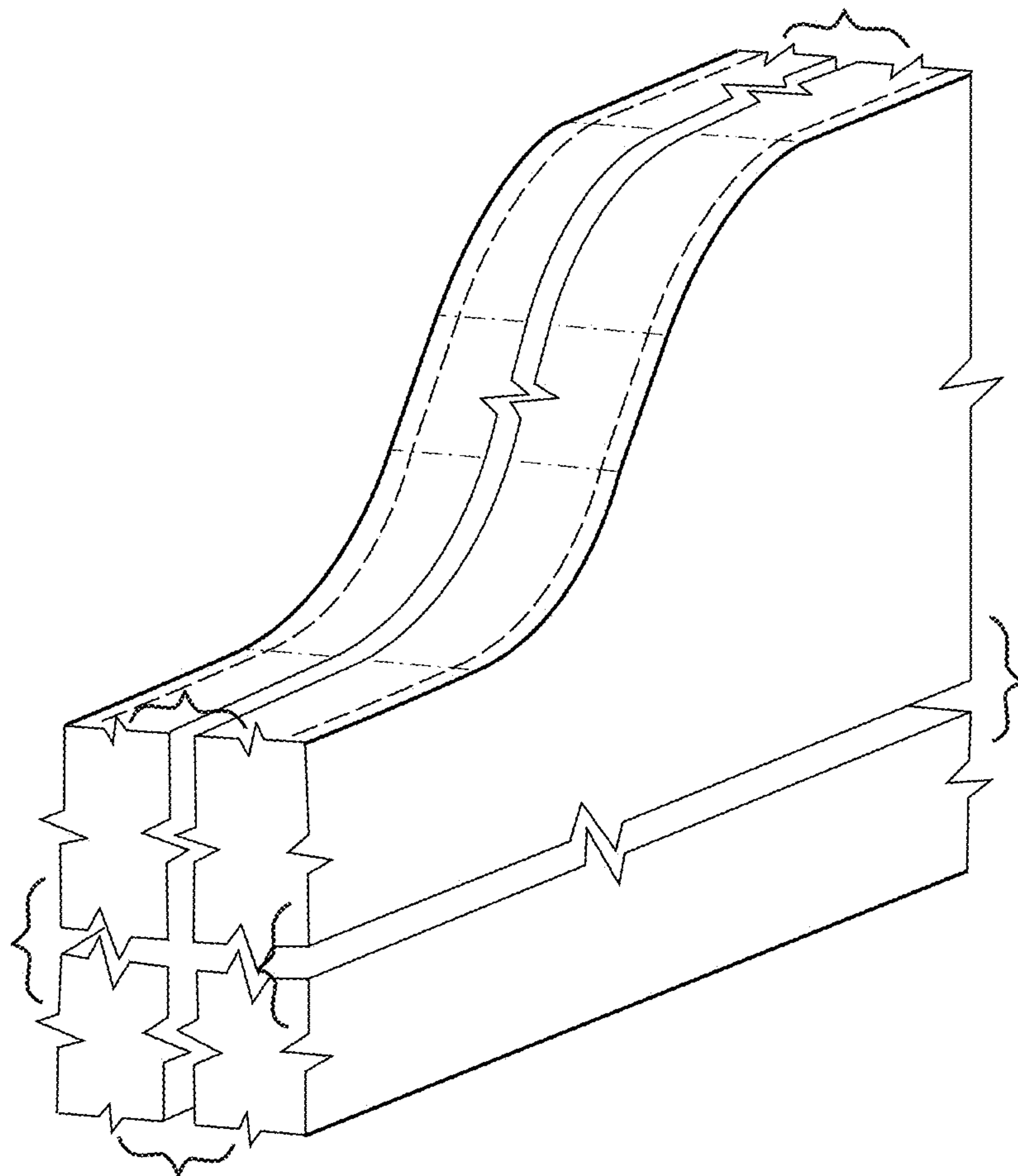

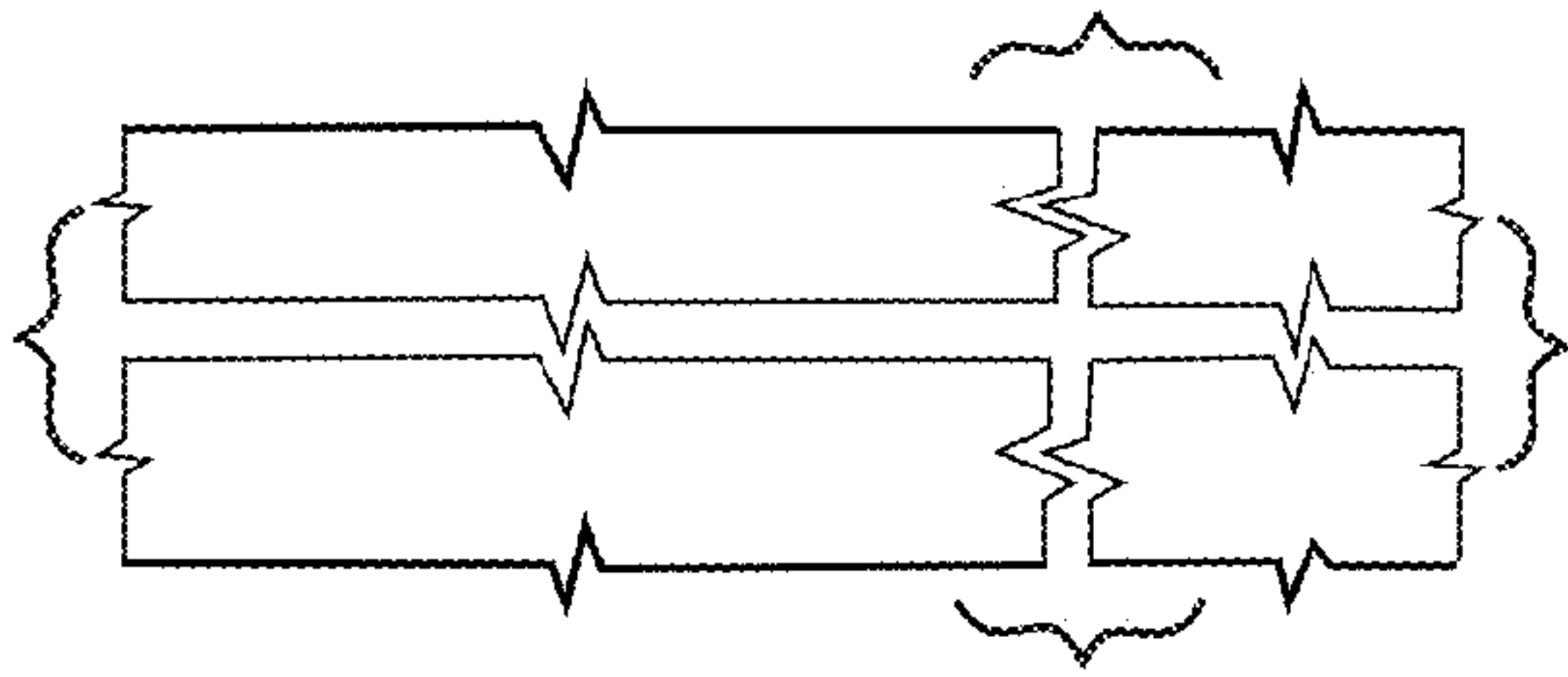

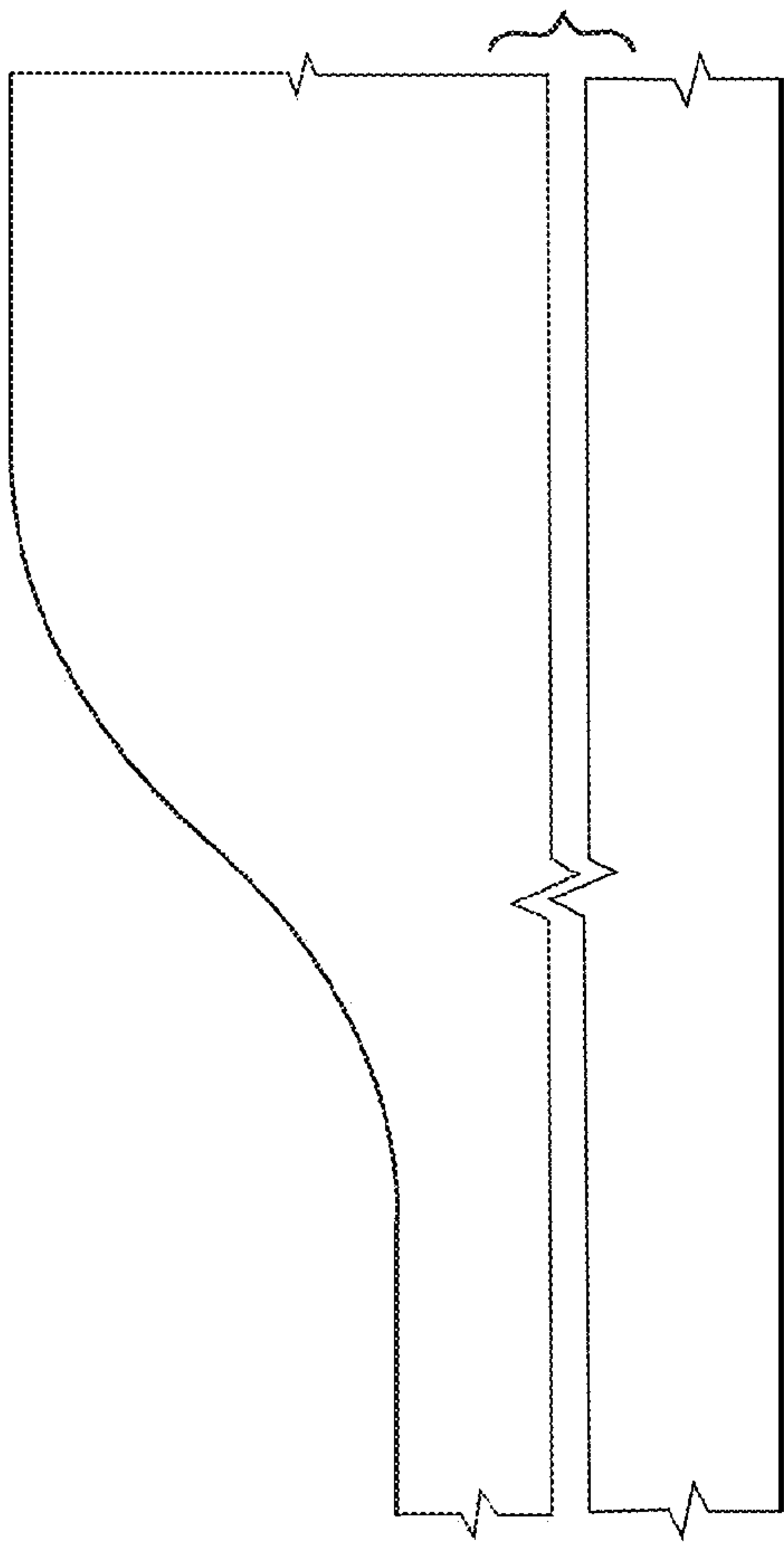

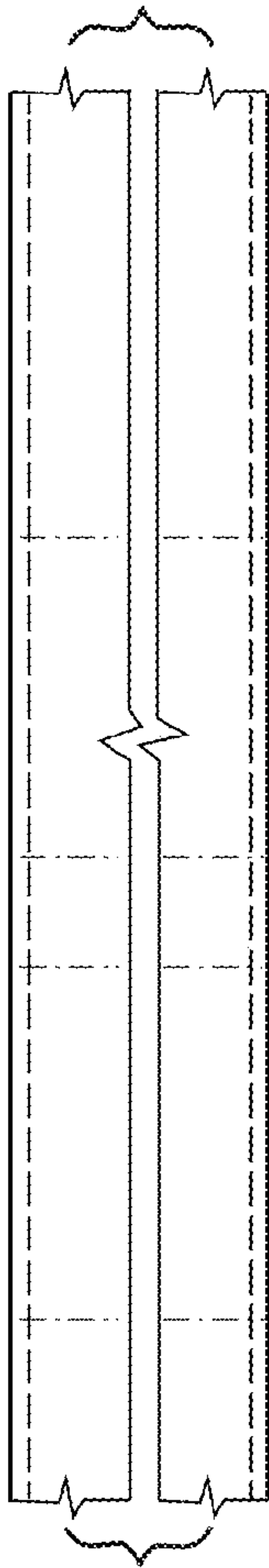

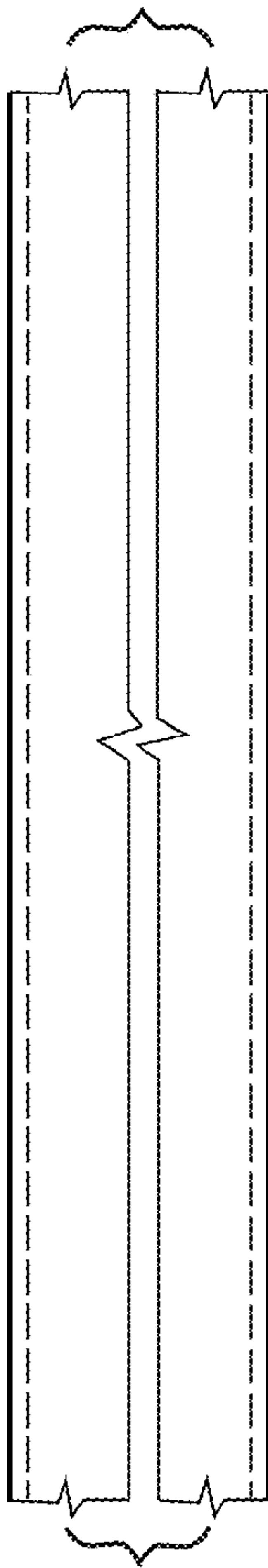

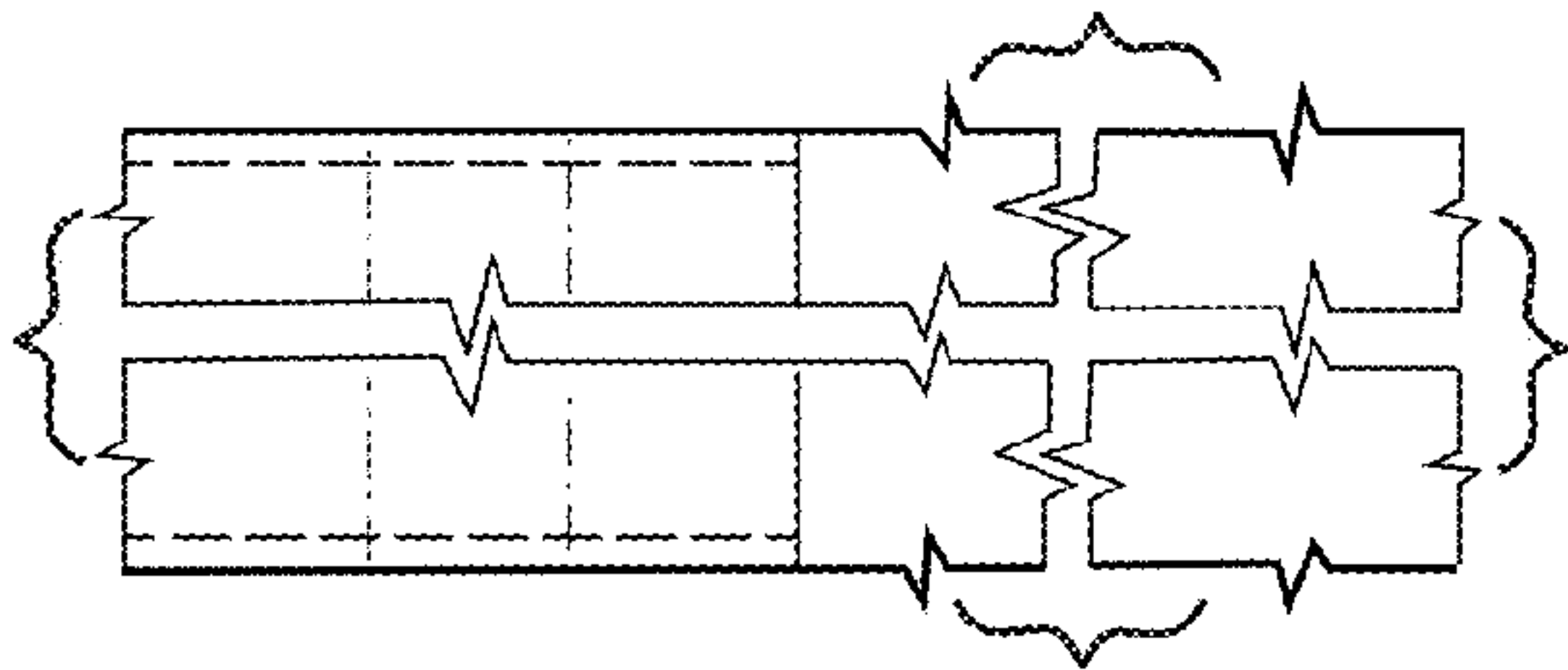
