(57) **CLAIM**

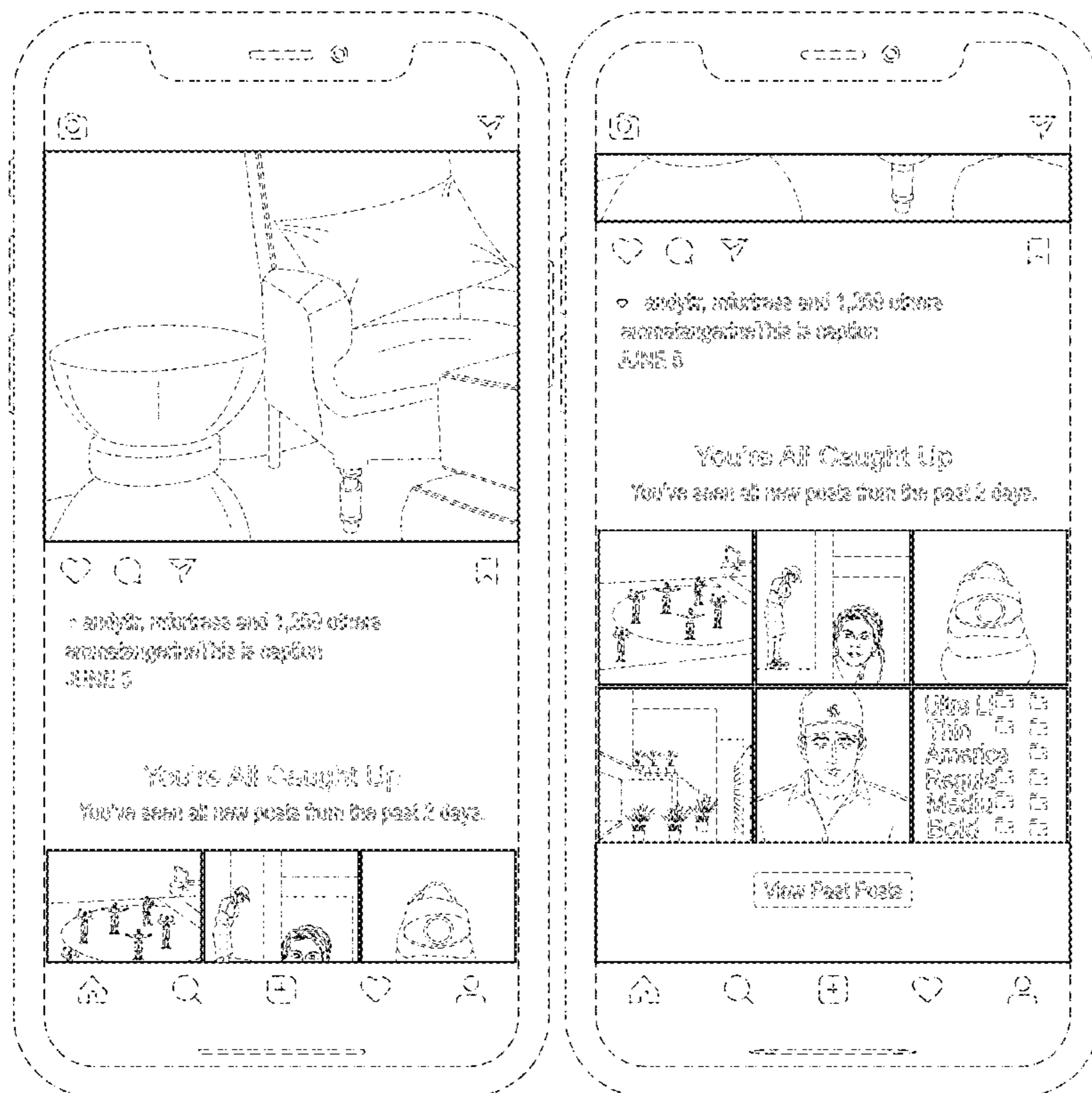
The ornamental design for a display screen with animated graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first image in a sequence for a display screen with animated graphical user interface; FIG. 2 is a front view of a second image thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view of a third image thereof; FIG. 4 is a front view of a fourth image thereof; FIG. 5 is a front view of a fifth image thereof; FIG. 6 is a front view of a sixth image thereof; FIG. 7 is a front view of a seventh image thereof; FIG. 8 is a front view of an eighth image thereof; FIG. 9 is a front view of a ninth image thereof; FIG. 10 is a front view of a tenth image thereof; and, FIG. 11 is a front view of an eleventh image thereof.

The appearance of the animated graphical user interface sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-11. The process or period in which an image transitions to another forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines corresponding to a mobile device and display screen forms no part of the claimed design. The remaining broken lines, including the closely spaced broken lines showing of text, faces, and other images, show portions of the graphical user interface that form no part of the claimed design.

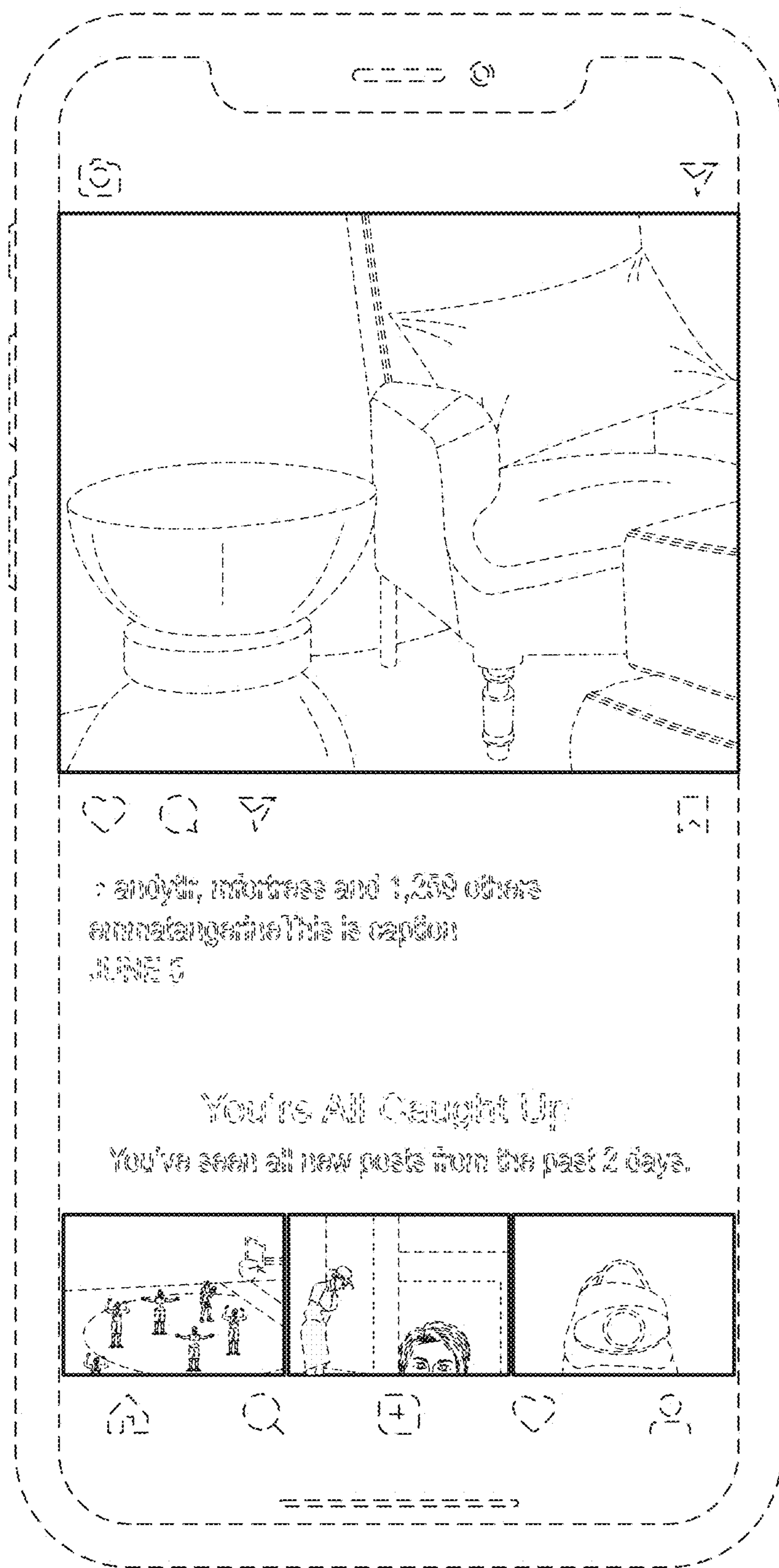

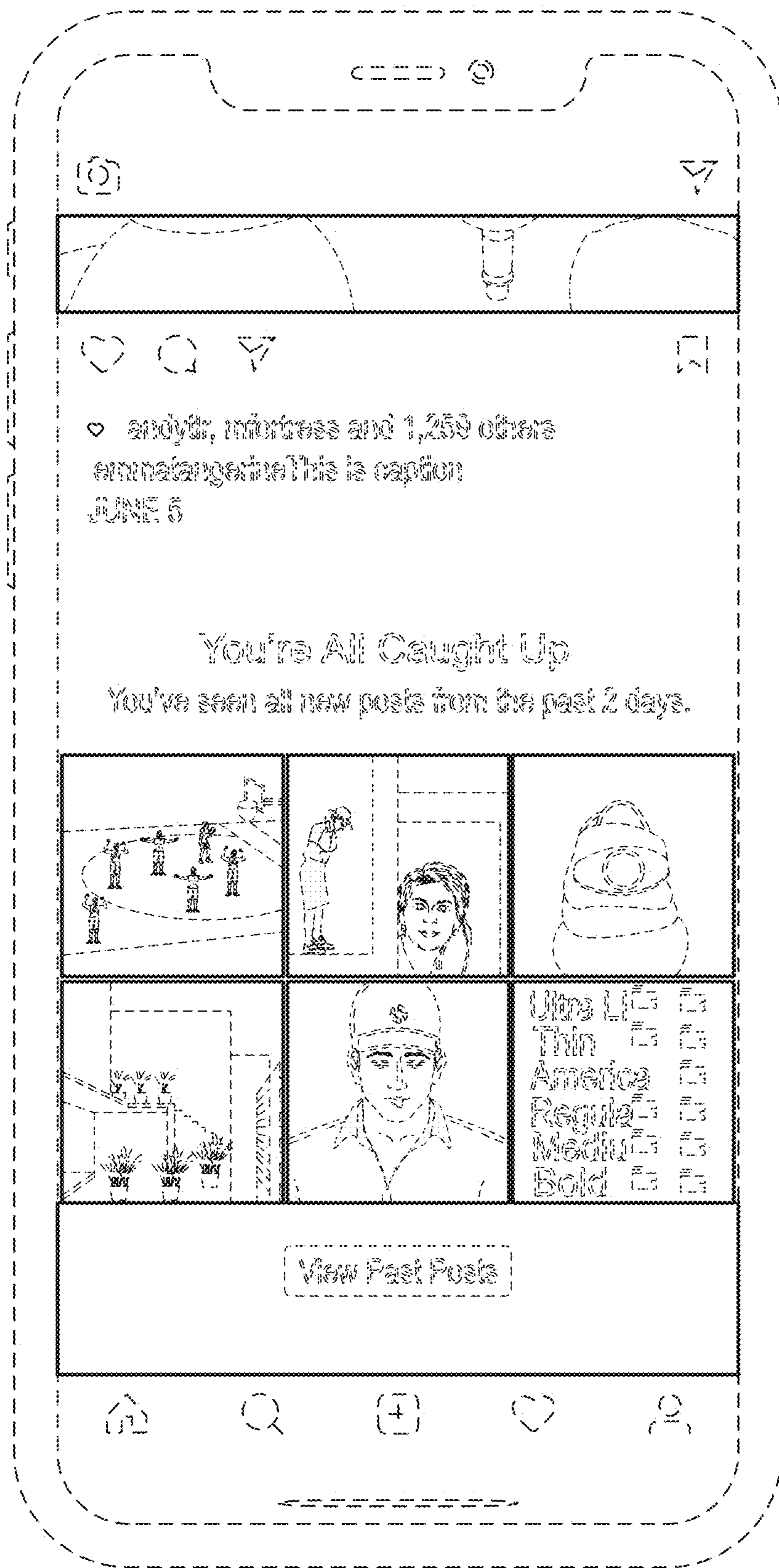

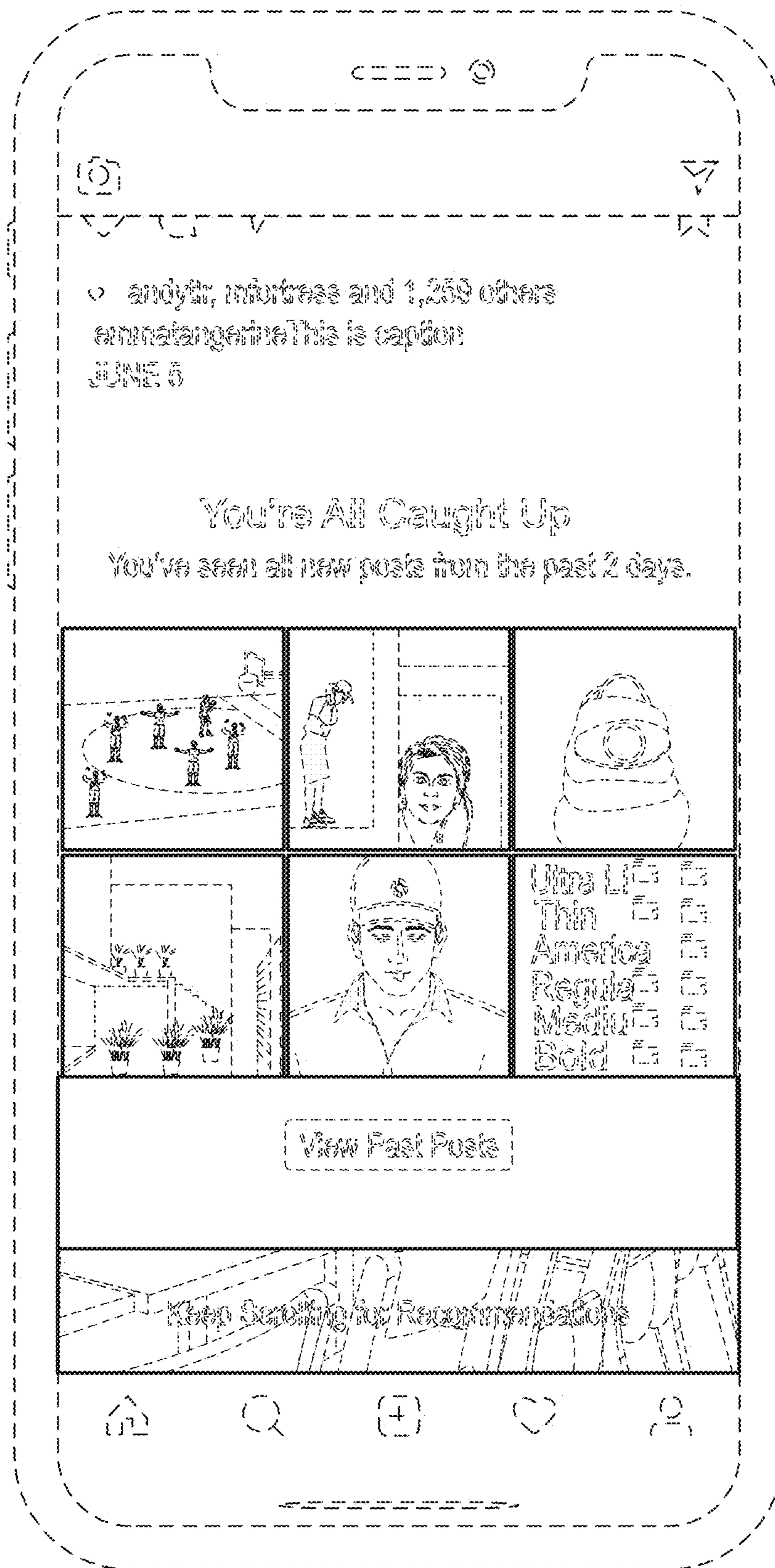

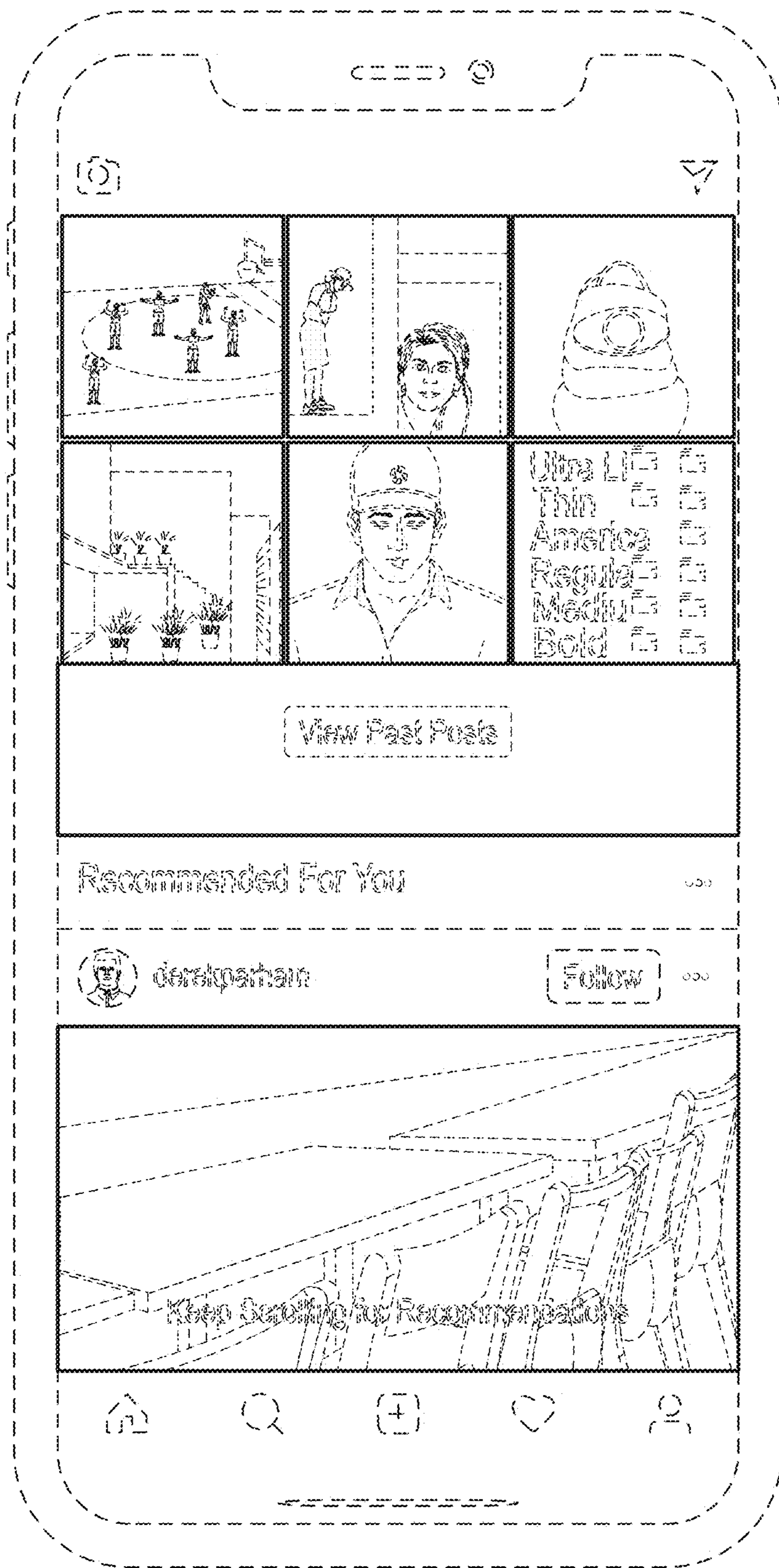

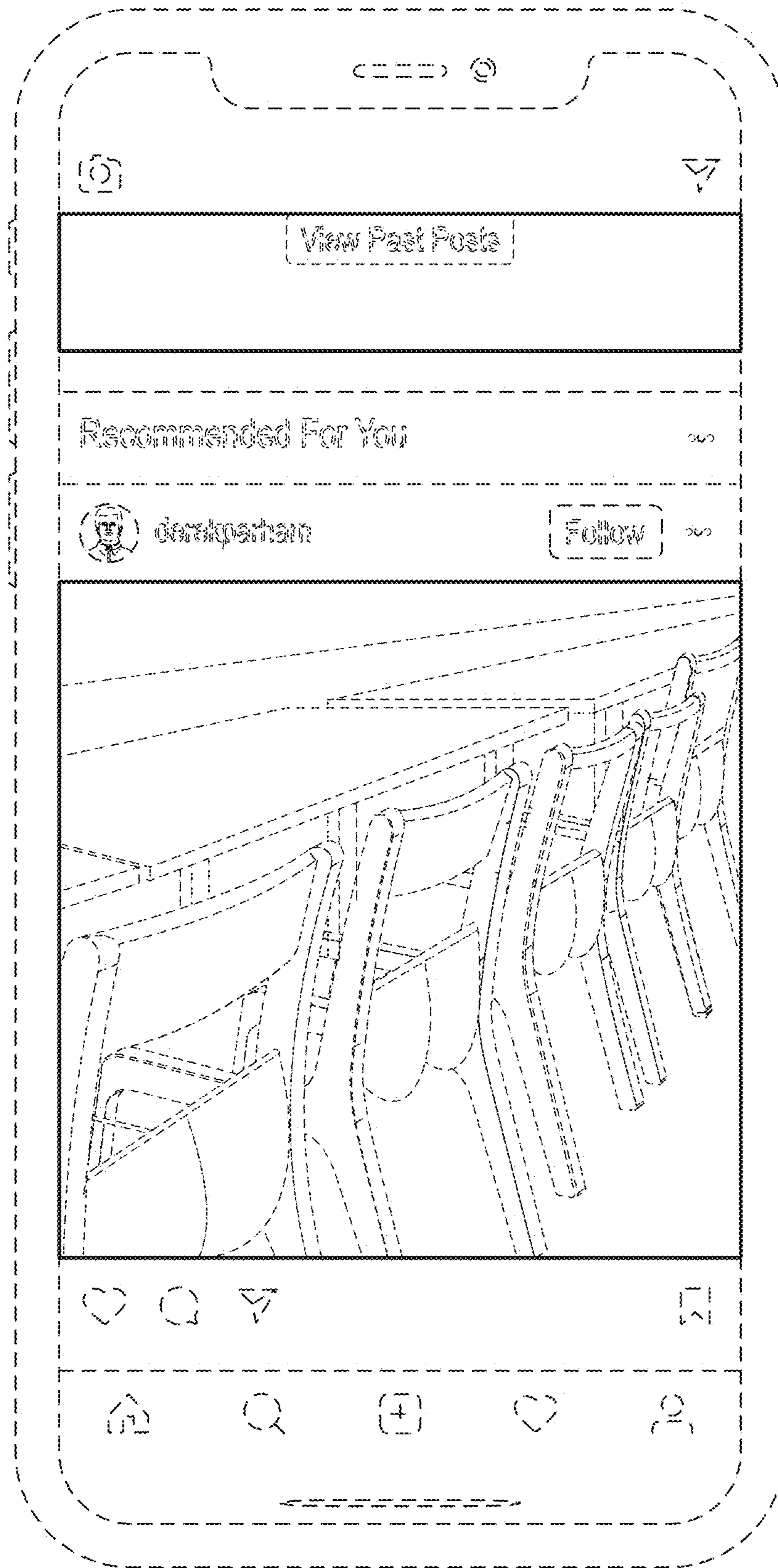

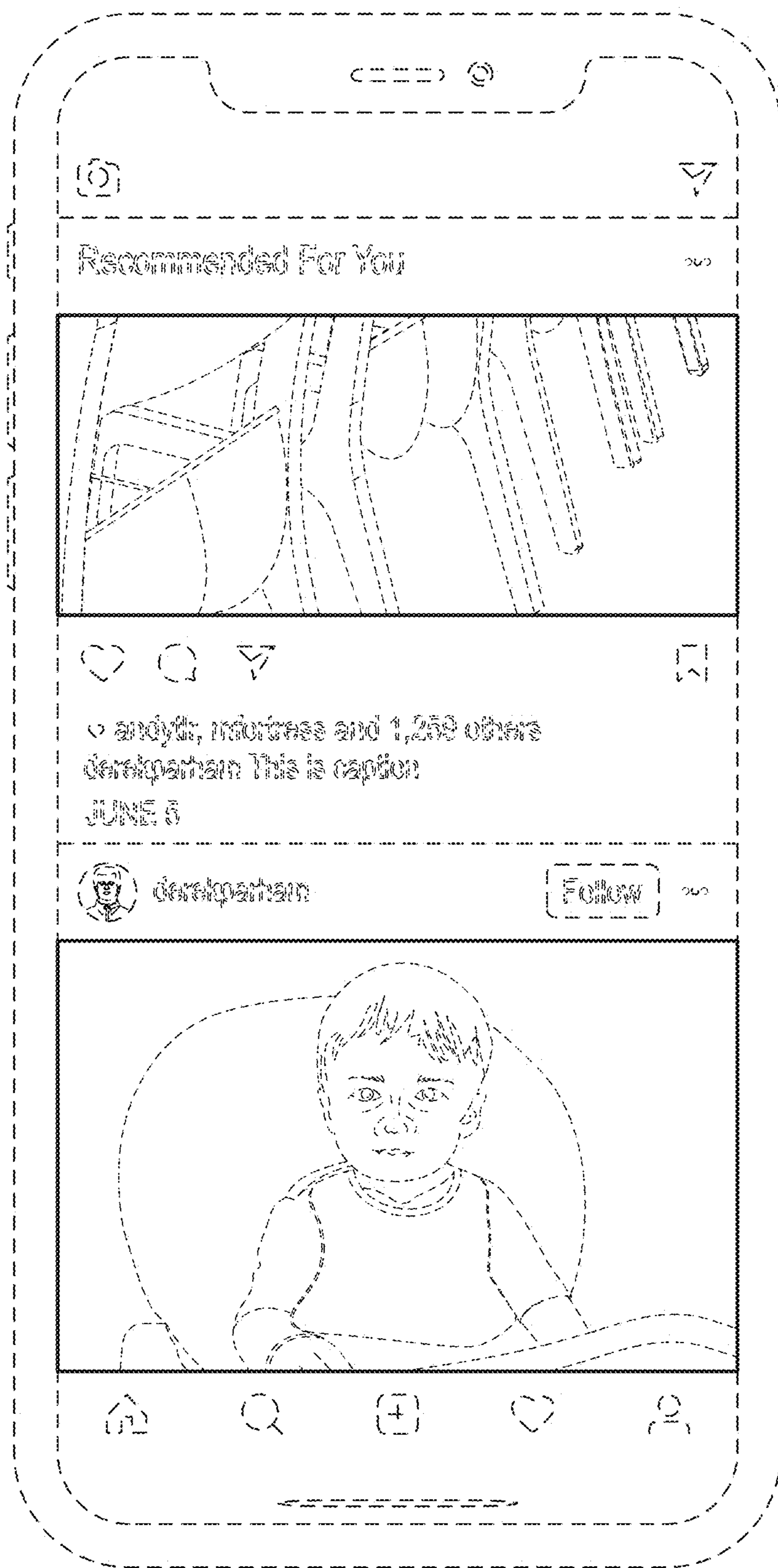

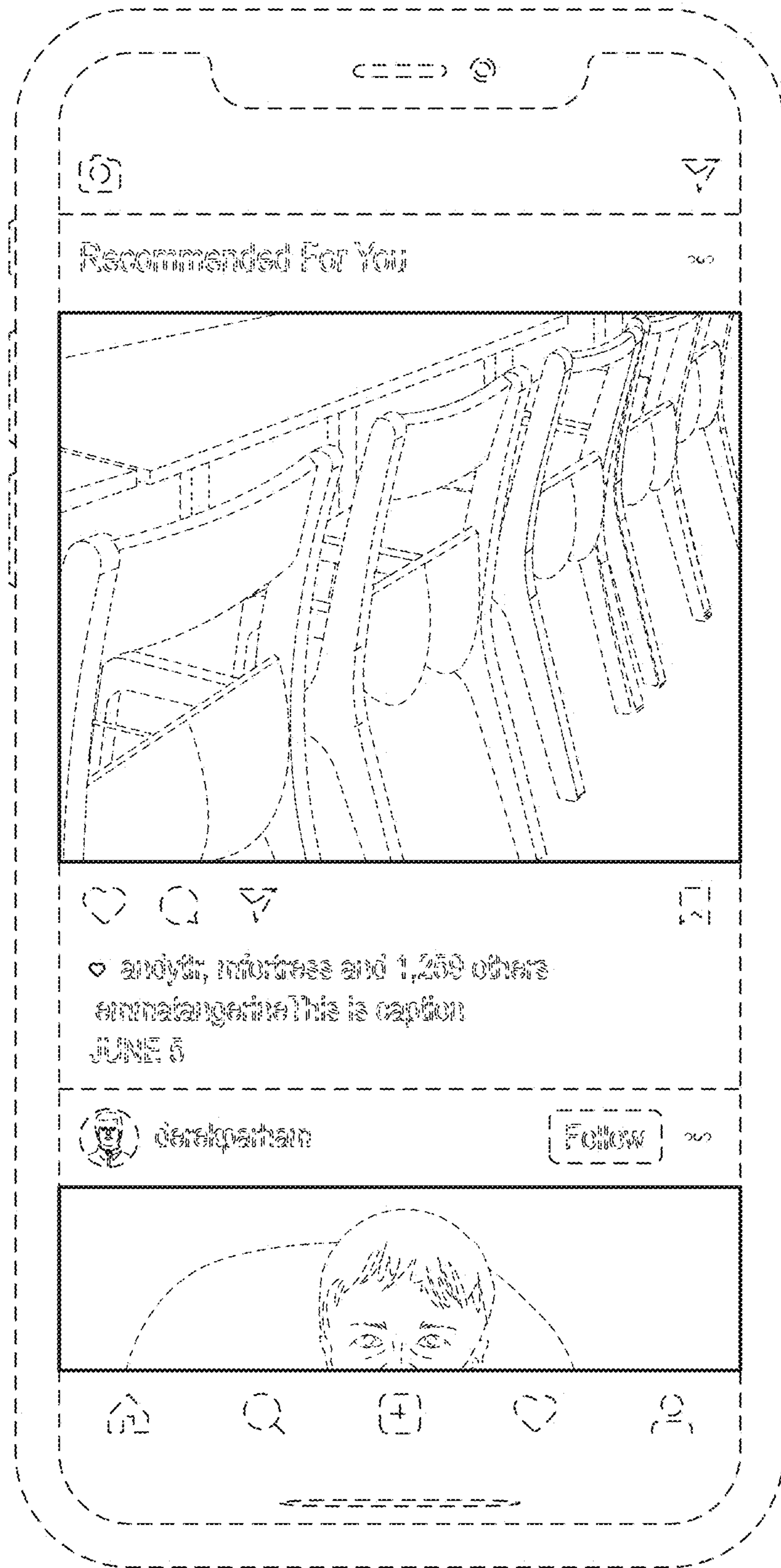

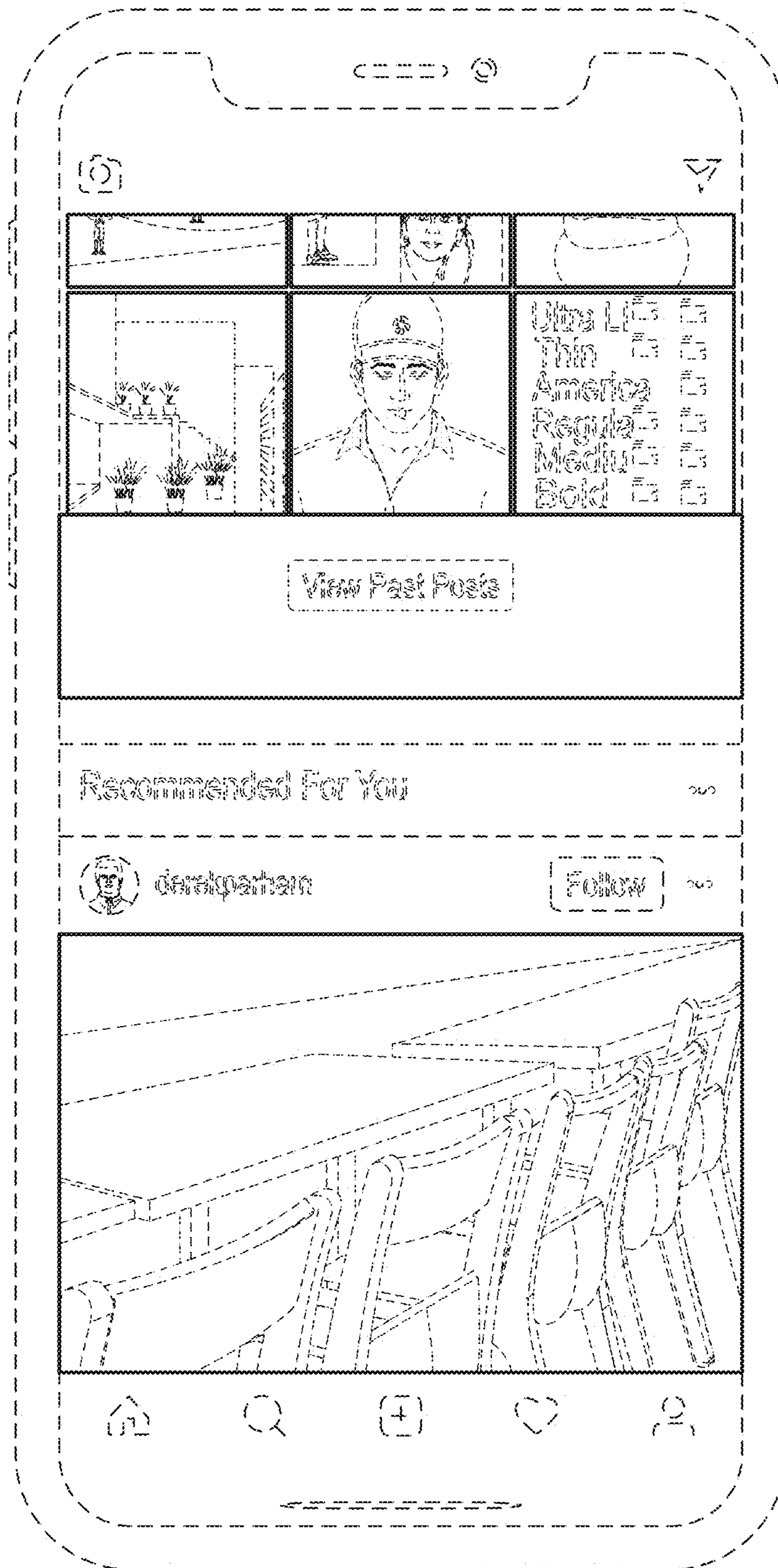

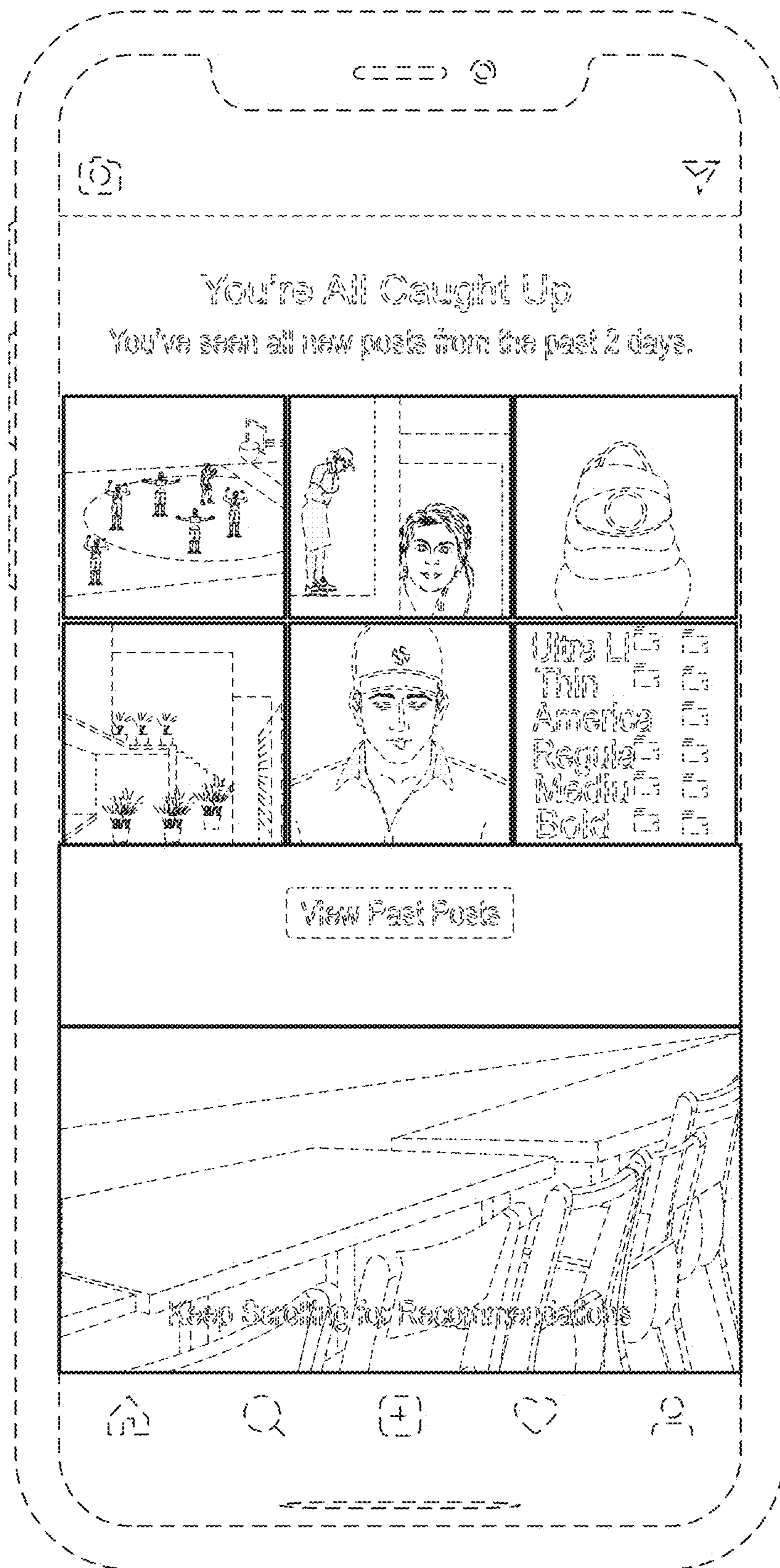

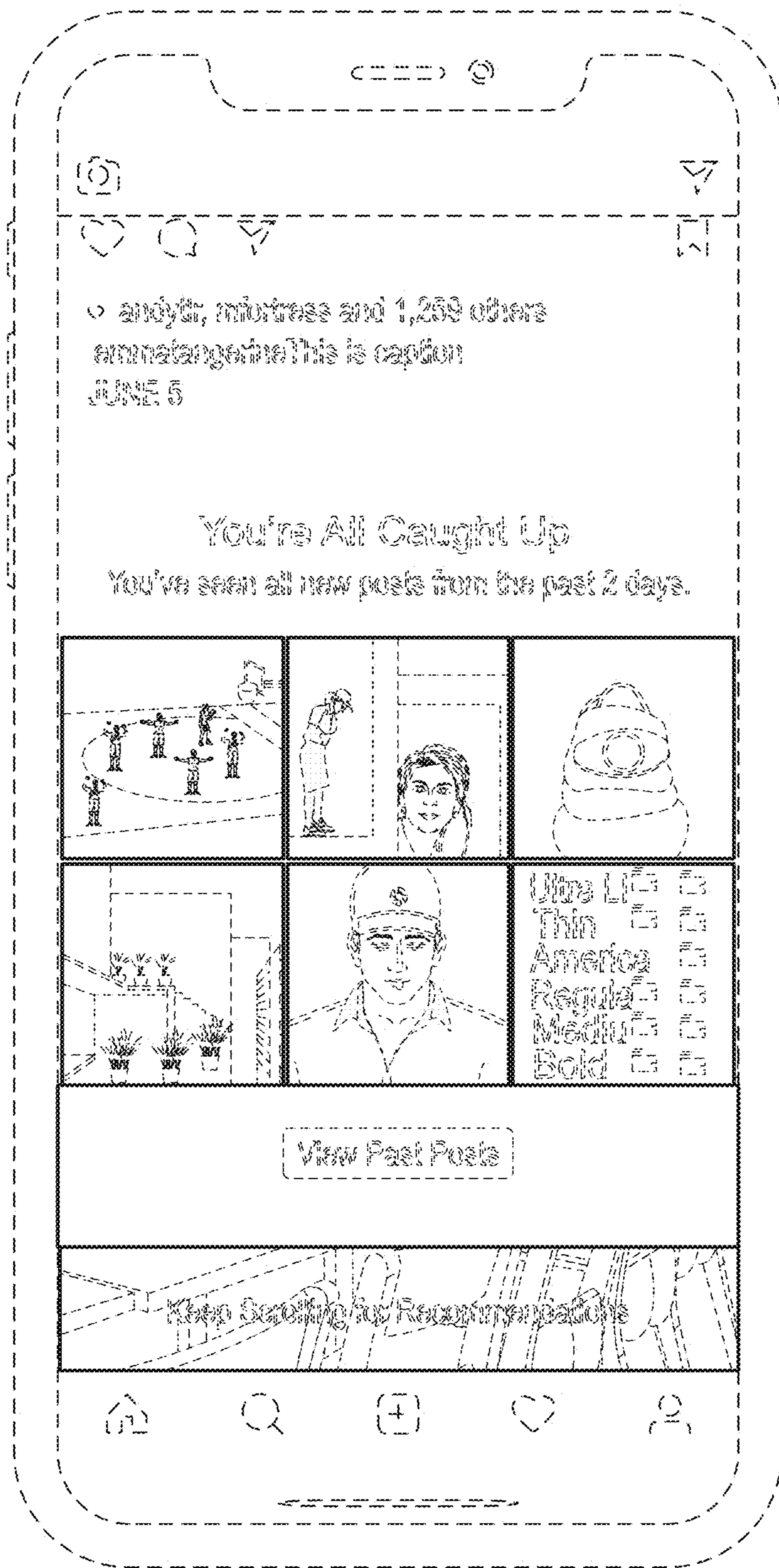

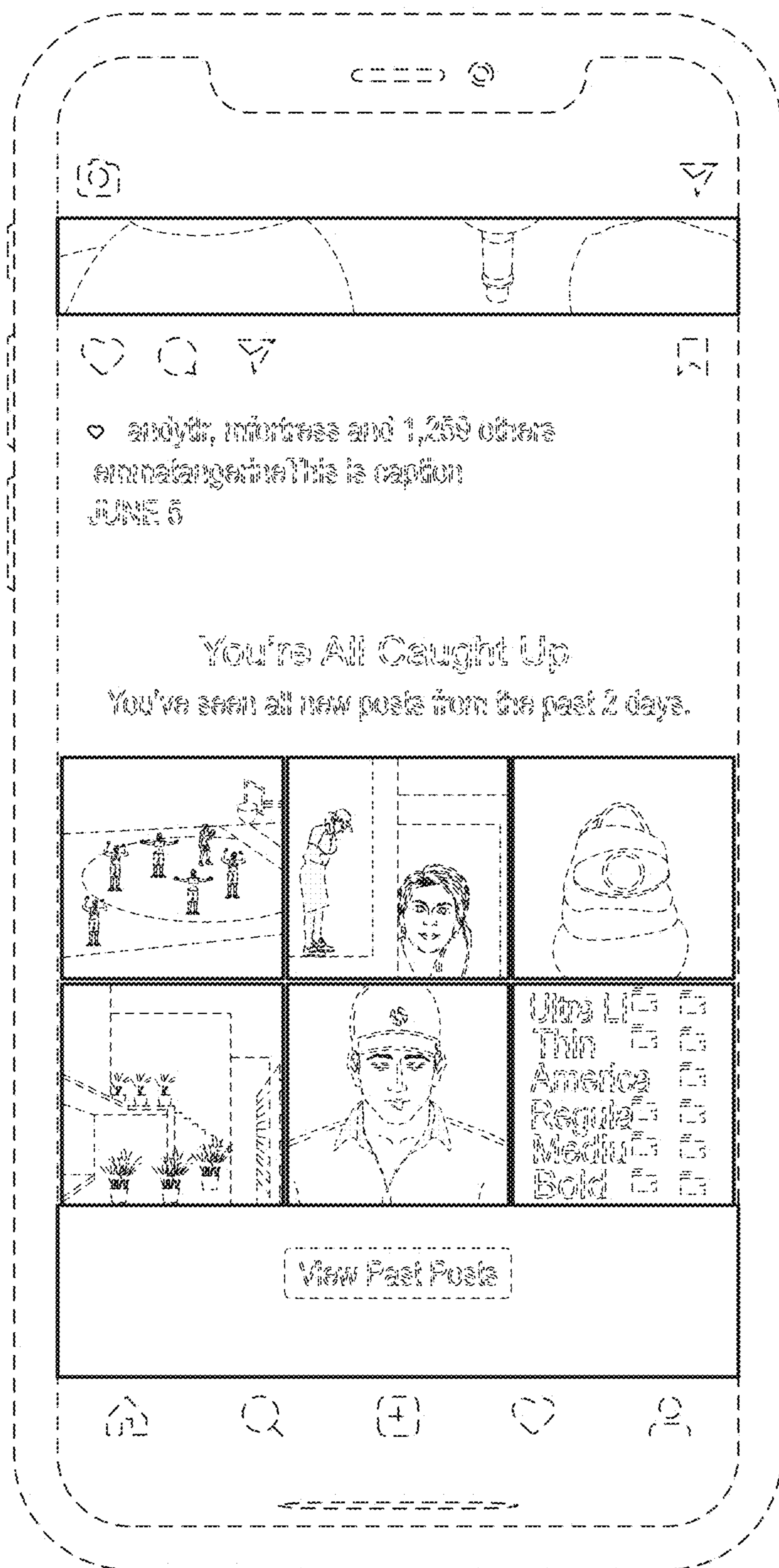
