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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a square shelving pole, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a square shelving pole;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the square shelving
pole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the square shelving pole shown
in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is front elevational view of the square shelving pole
shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the square shelving pole
shown in FIG. 1;

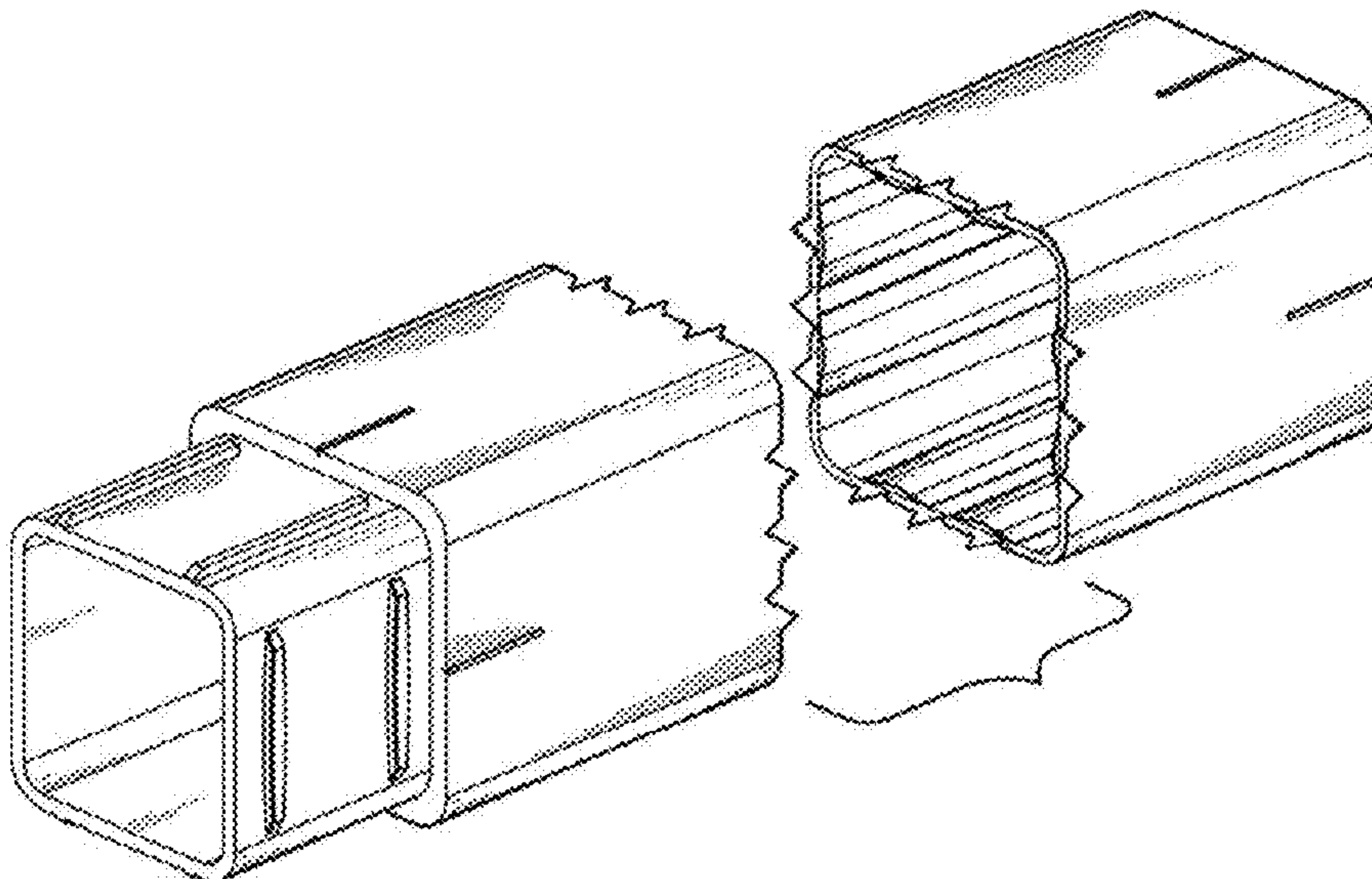
FIG. 6 is an enlarged, rear elevational view of the square
shelving pole taken at call-out 6 in FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional, bottom plan view of the square
shelving pole taken at section line 7-7 in FIG. 4.

A left side elevational view of the square shelving pole is not
shown because it is a mirror image of the right side eleva-
tional view of the square shelving pole that is shown in FIG.
2. A bottom plan view of the square shelving pole is not
shown because it is identical to the top plan view that is
shown in FIG. 3.

The square shelving pole is shown broken in one place along
the height direction in FIGS. 1-3 and 7 to indicate indeter-
minate length, with the understanding that the “indetermi-
nate” length portion of the square shelving pole not shown
forms no part of the claimed design. Patentability is based
only on those portions of the article that are shown in solid
lines.

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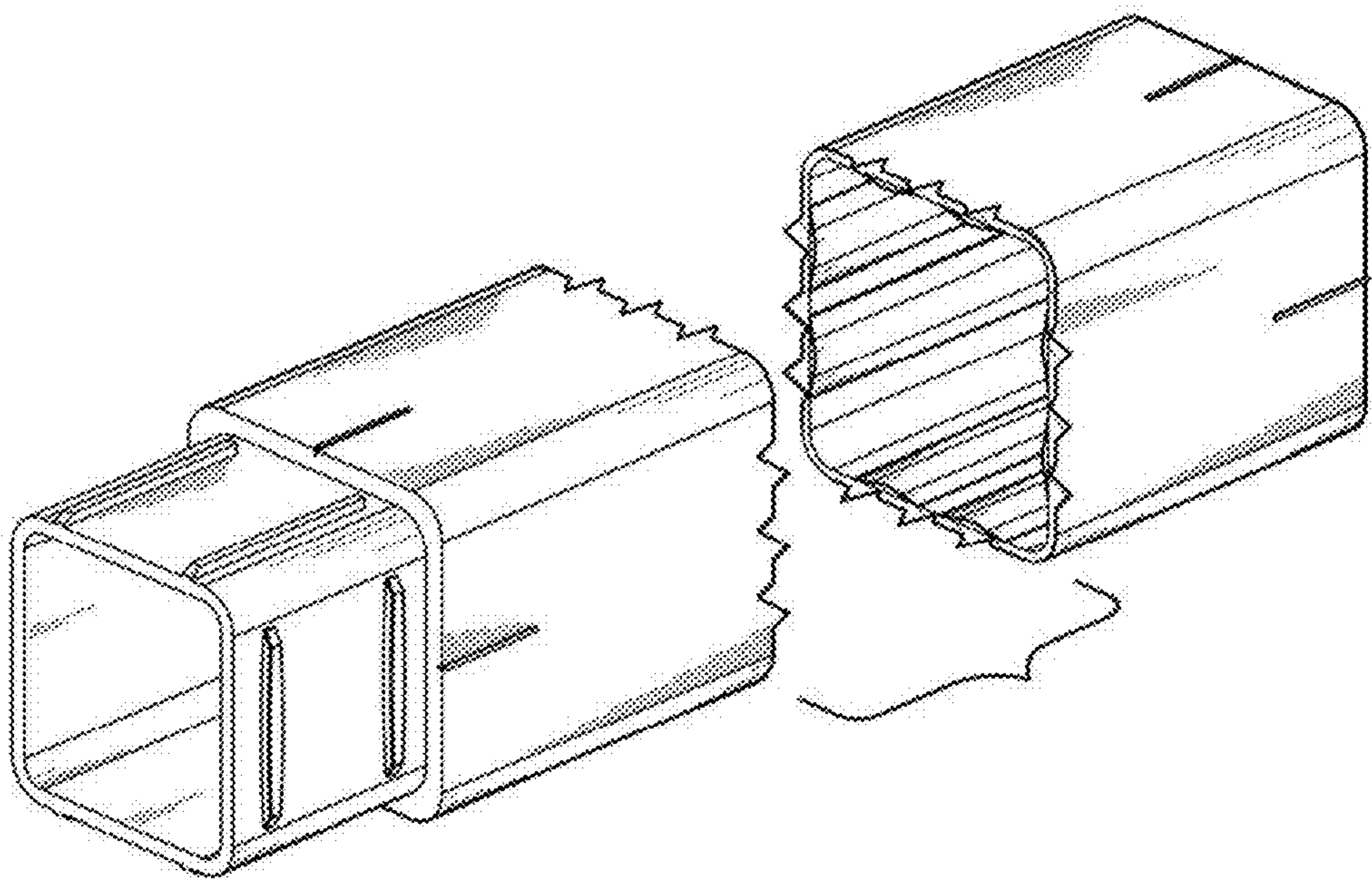

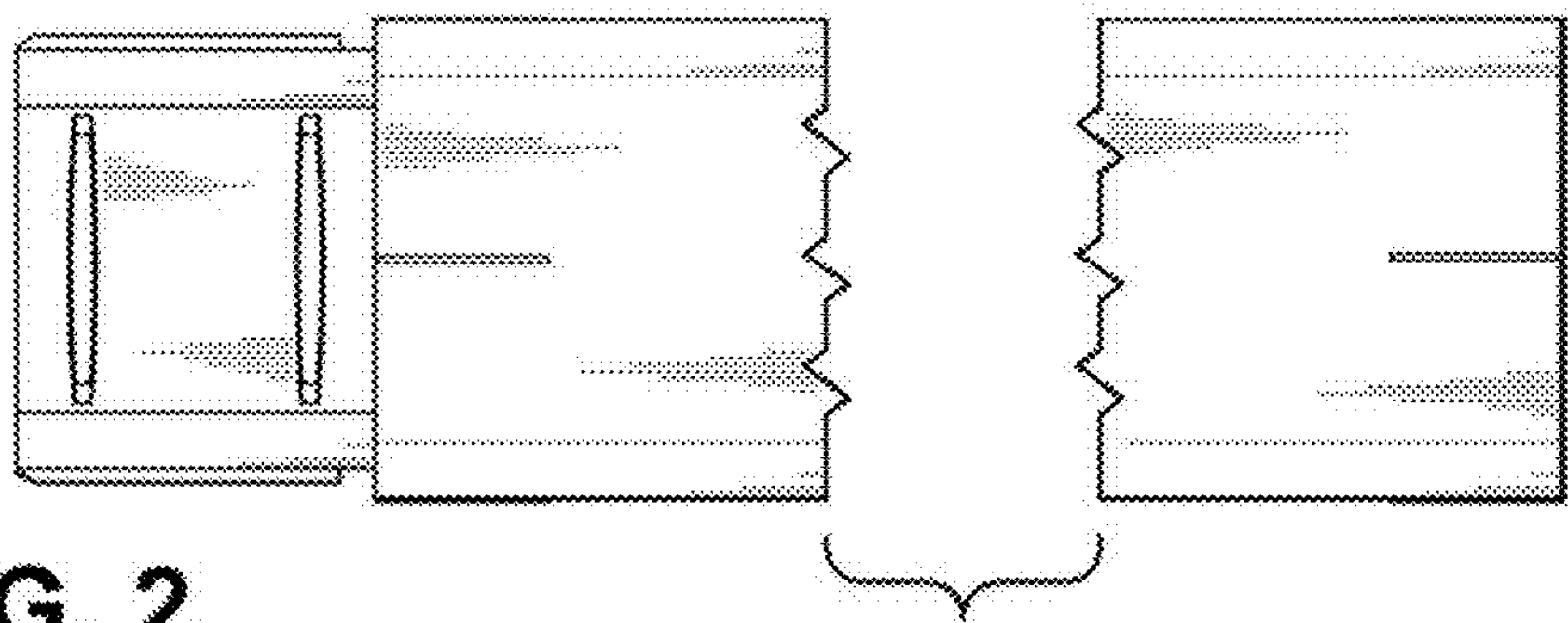

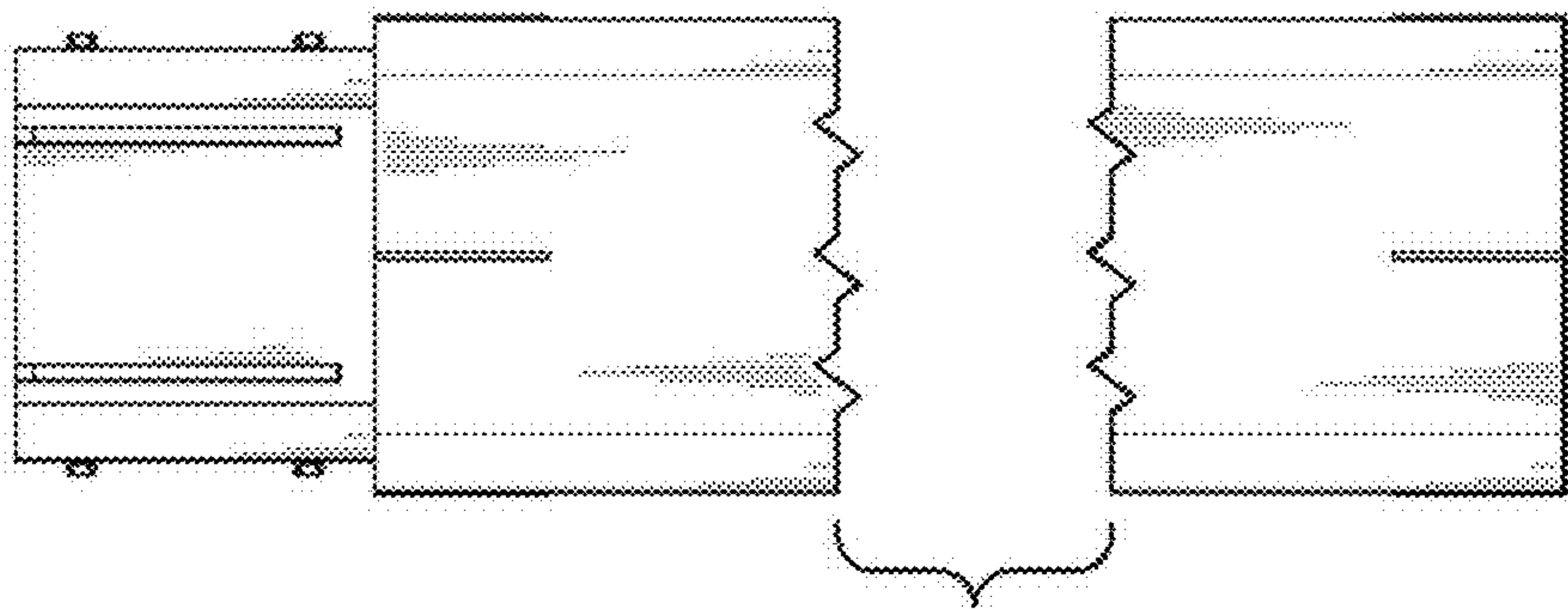

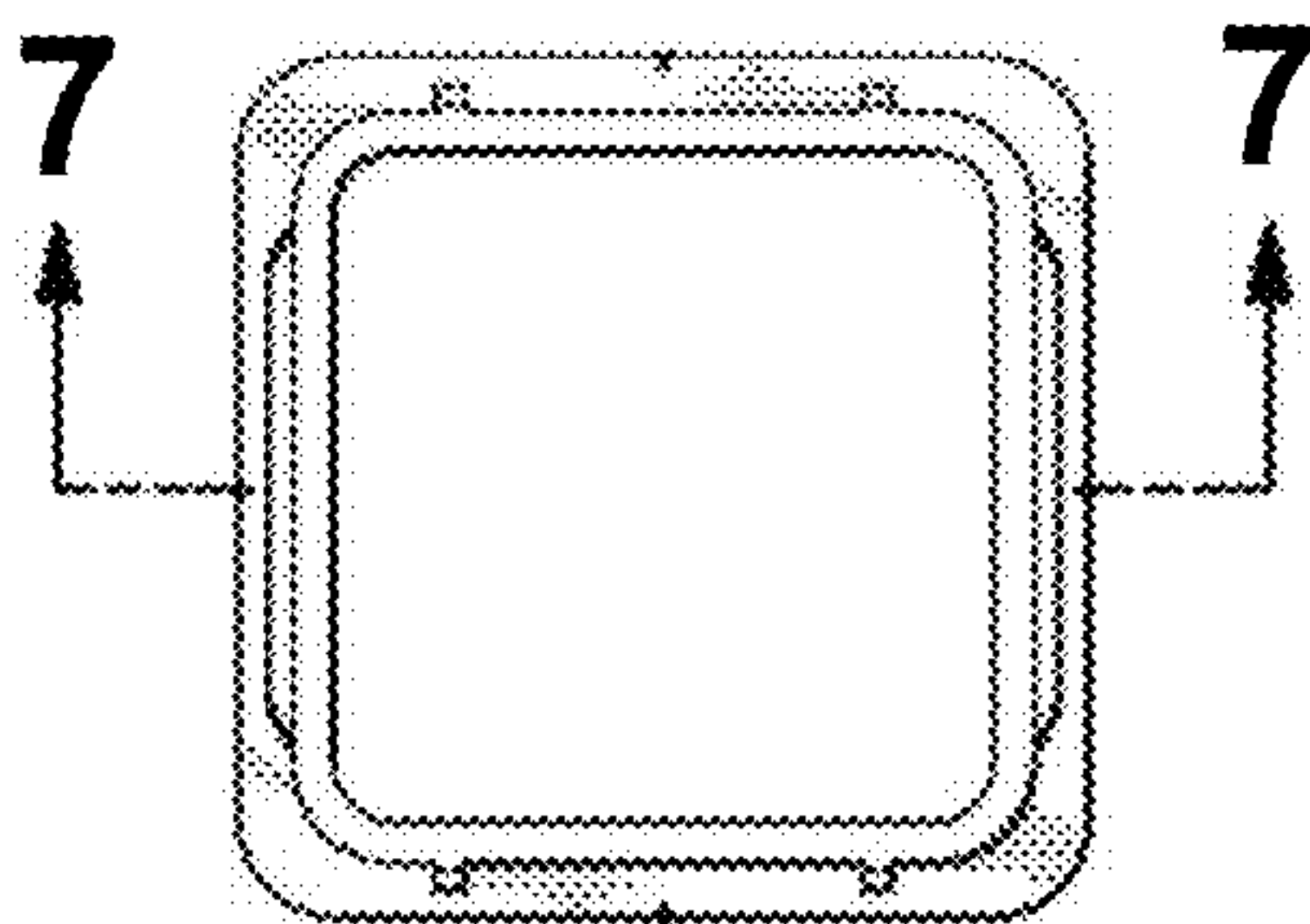

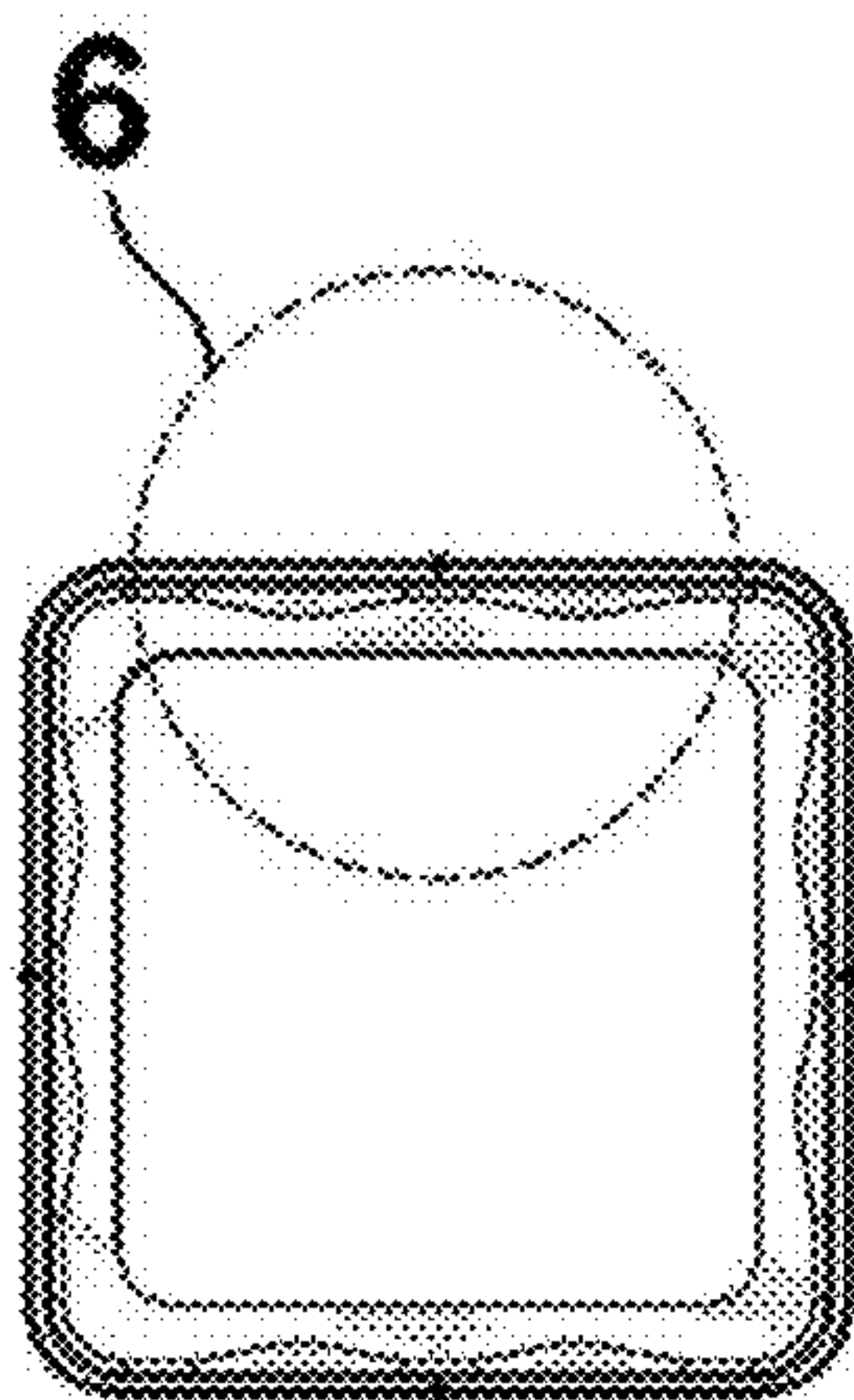

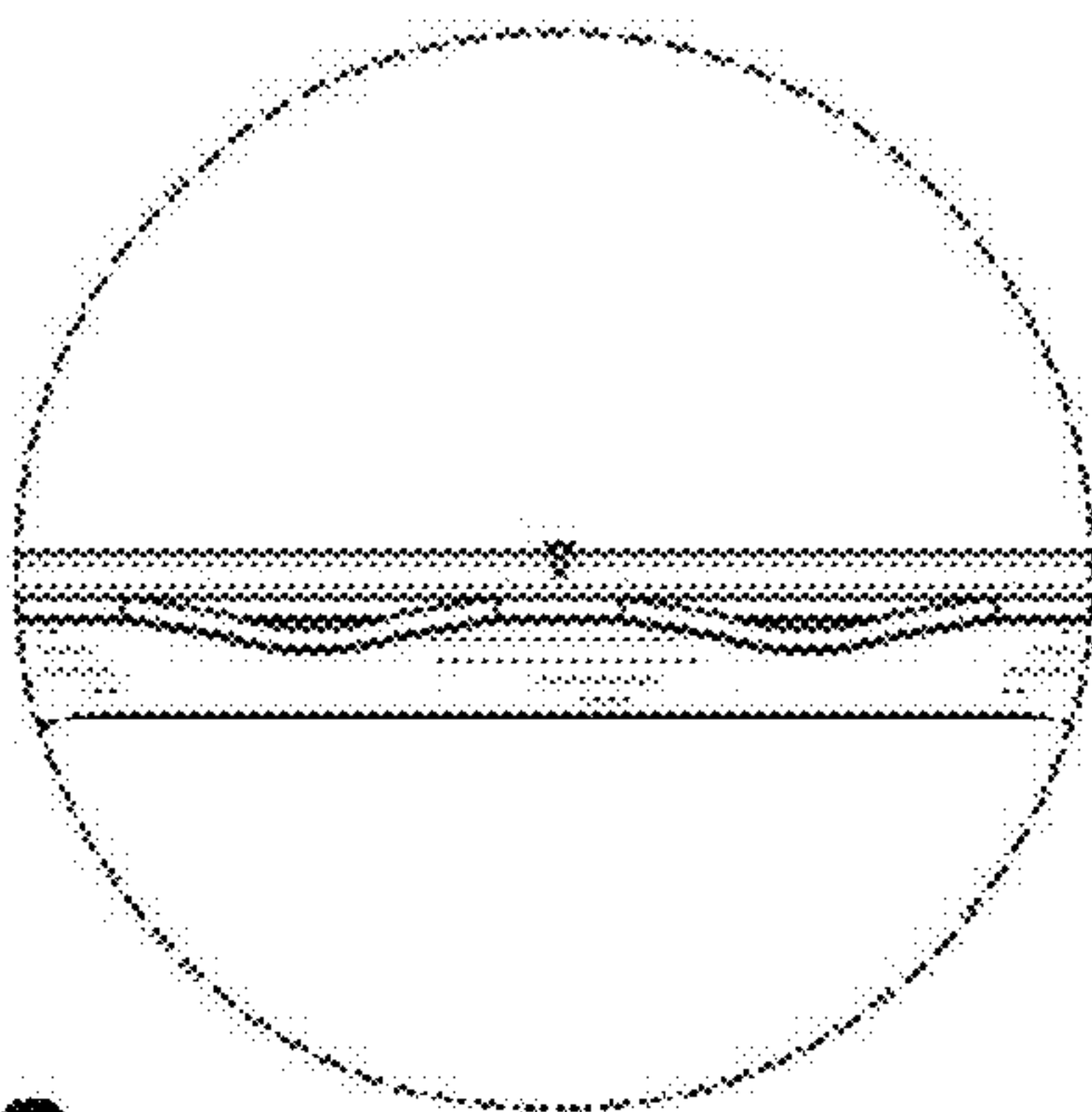

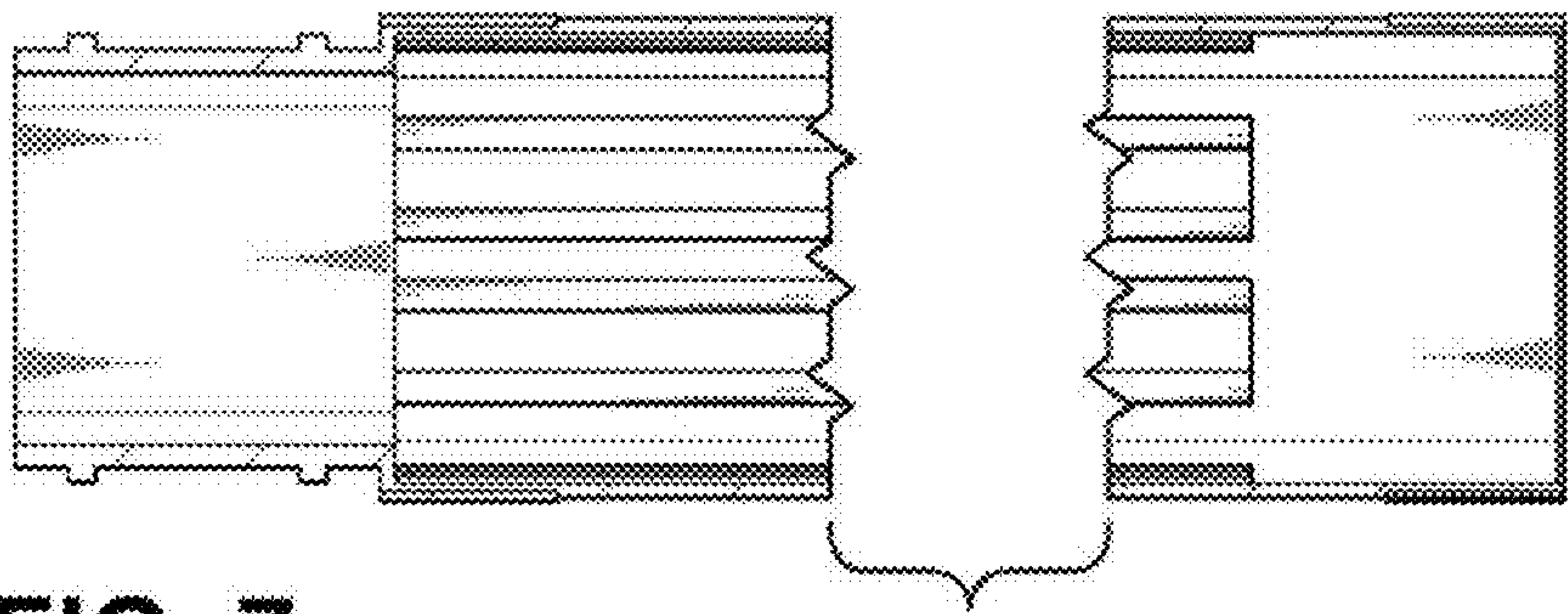
