The ornamental design for a wiper/headlight switch retain-
ing nut removal tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

switch retaining nut removal tool;

FIG. 2 shows a rear perspective view of the wiper/headlight
switch retaining nut removal tool;

FIG. 3 shows a right side elevation view of the wiper/
headlight switch retaining nut removal tool;

FIG. 4 shows a left-side elevation view of the wiper/
headlight switch retaining nut removal tool;

FIG. 5 shows a front elevation view of the wiper/headlight
switch retaining nut removal tool;

FIG. 6 shows a rear elevation view of the wiper/headlight
switch retaining nut removal tool;

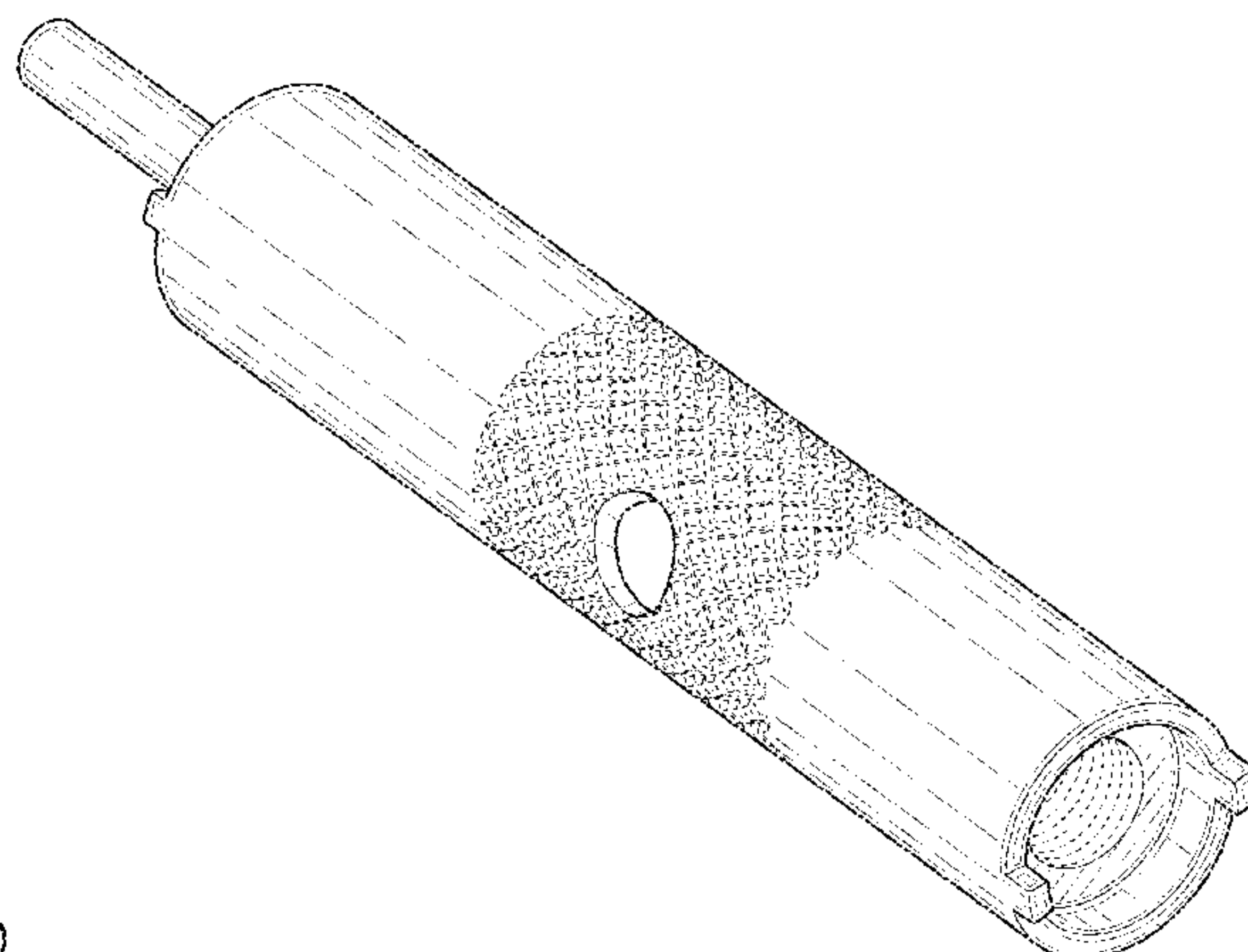
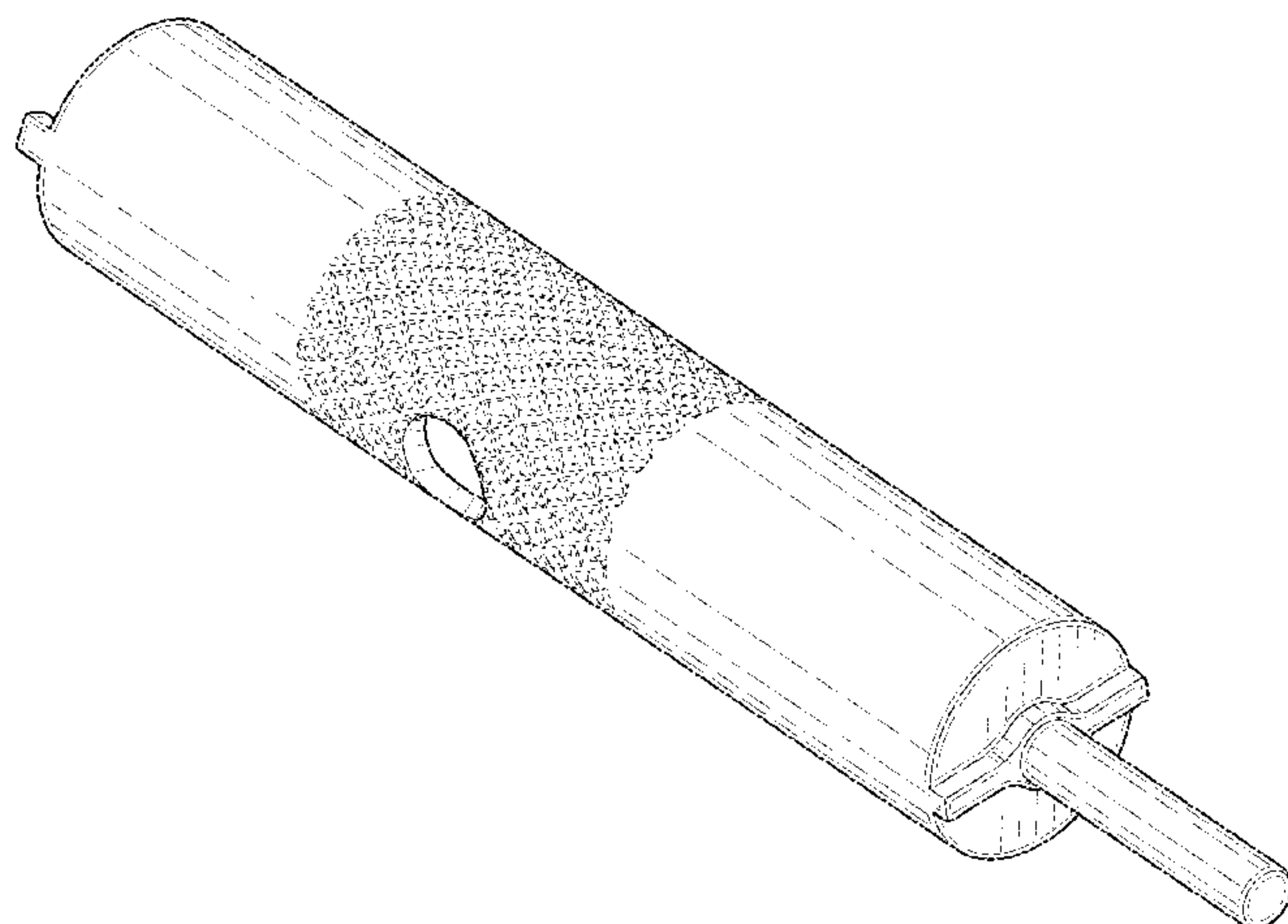
FIG. 7 shows a top plan view of the wiper/headlight switch

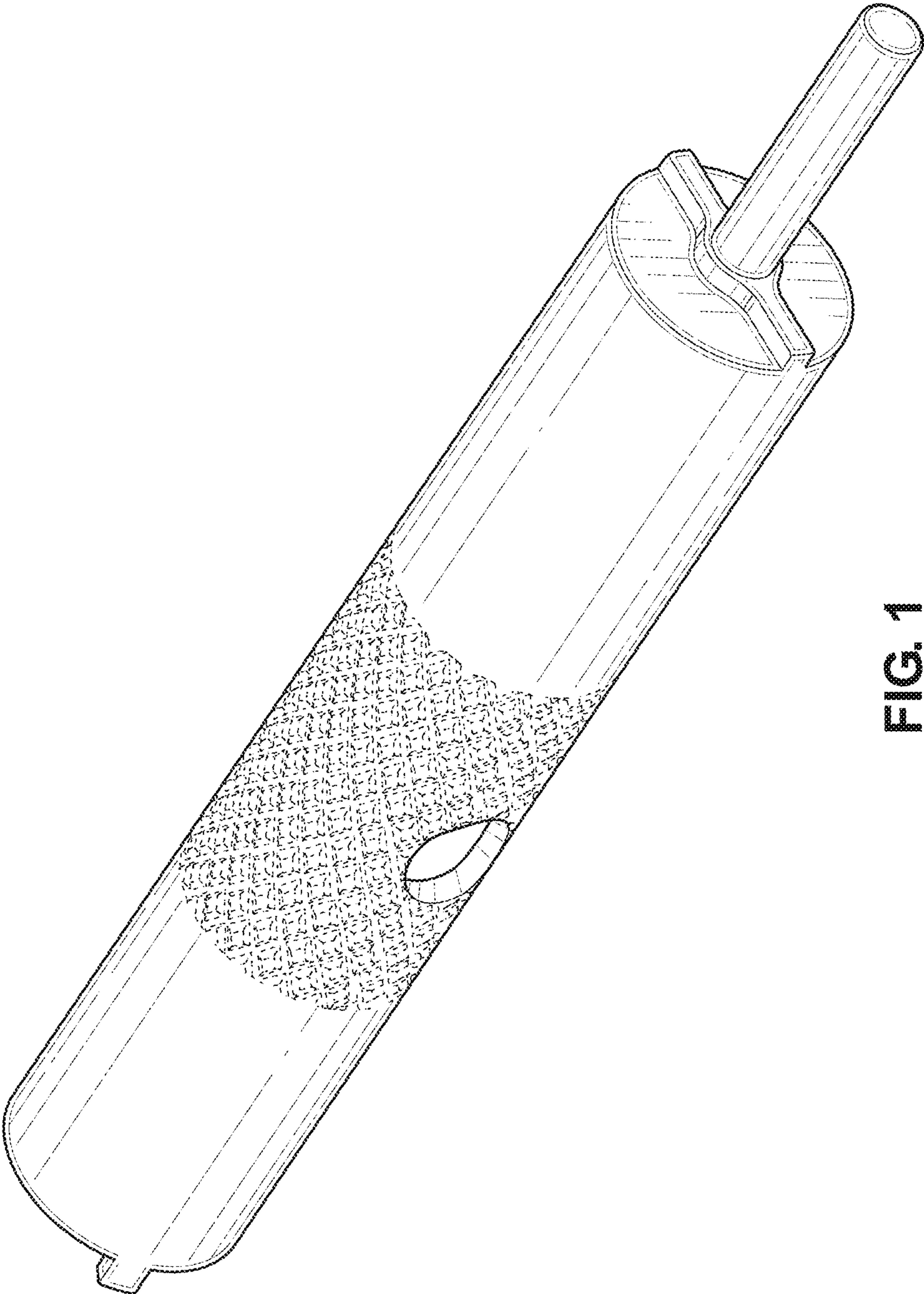

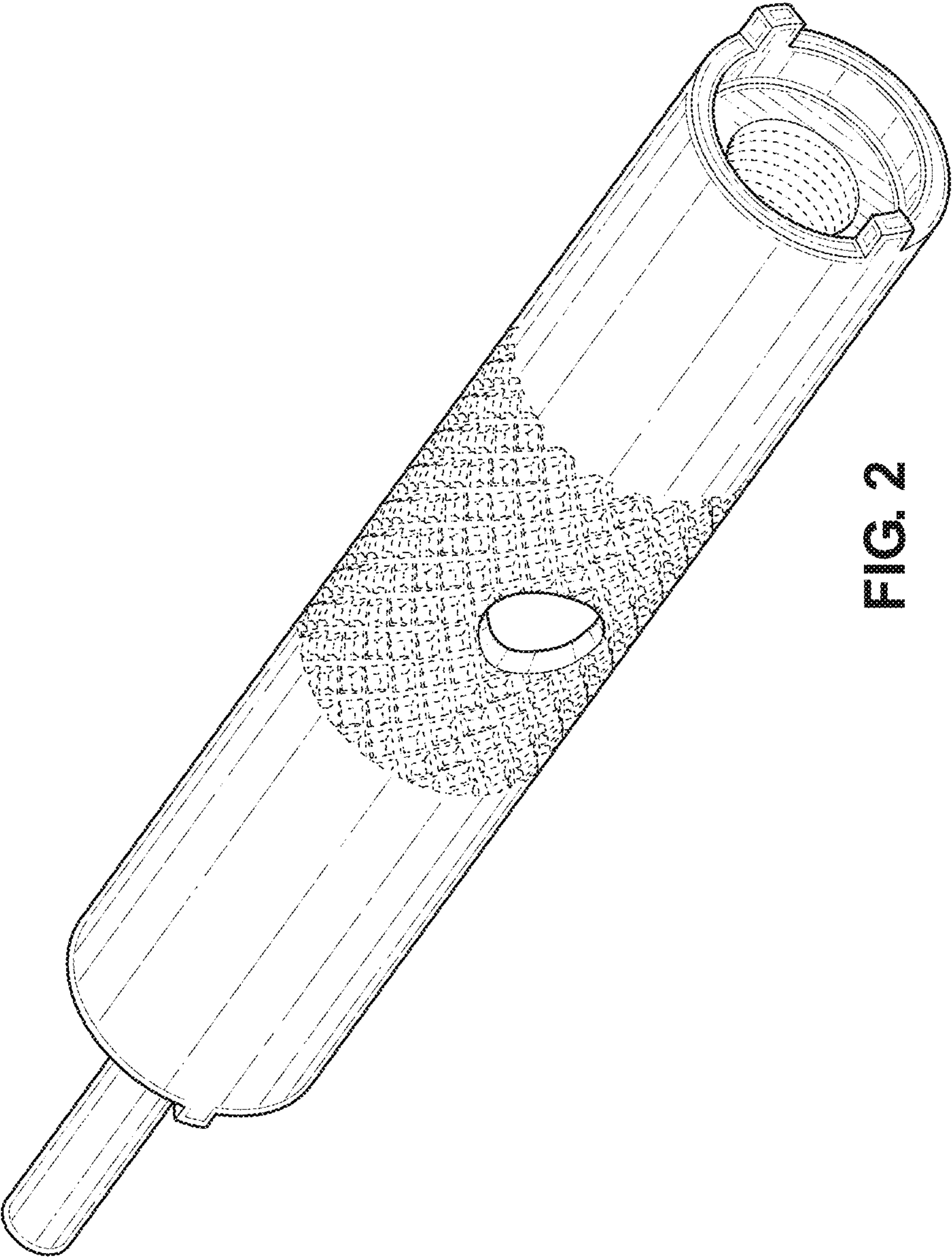

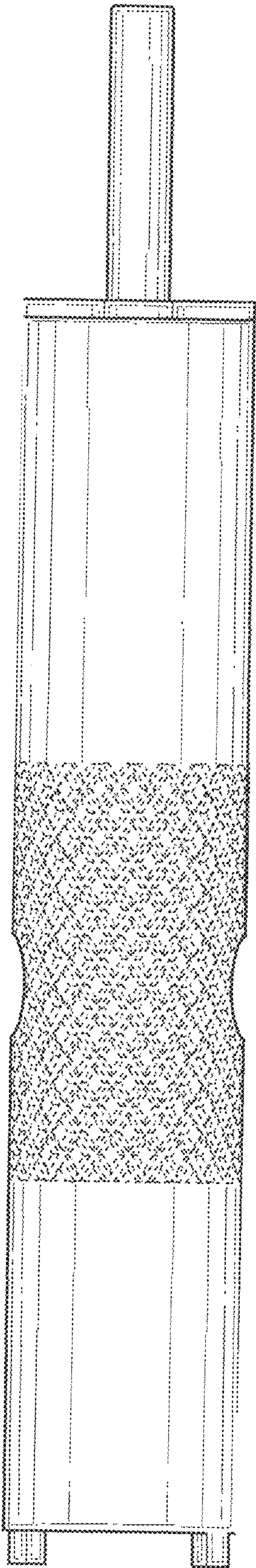

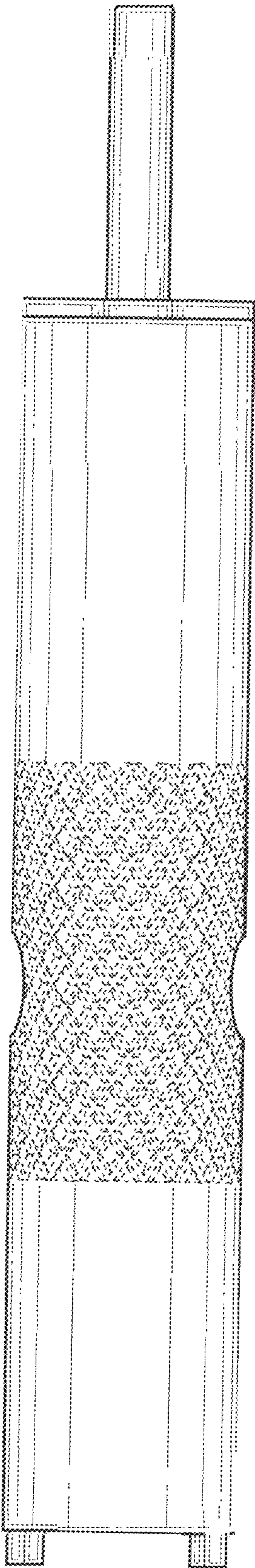

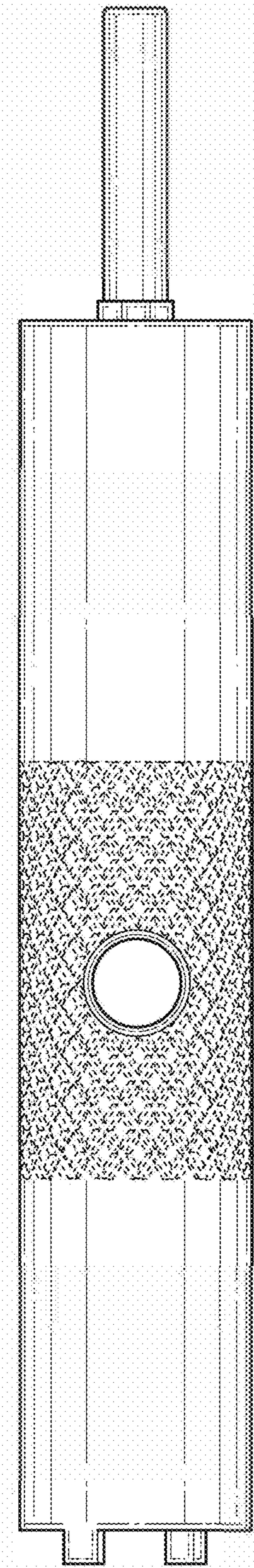

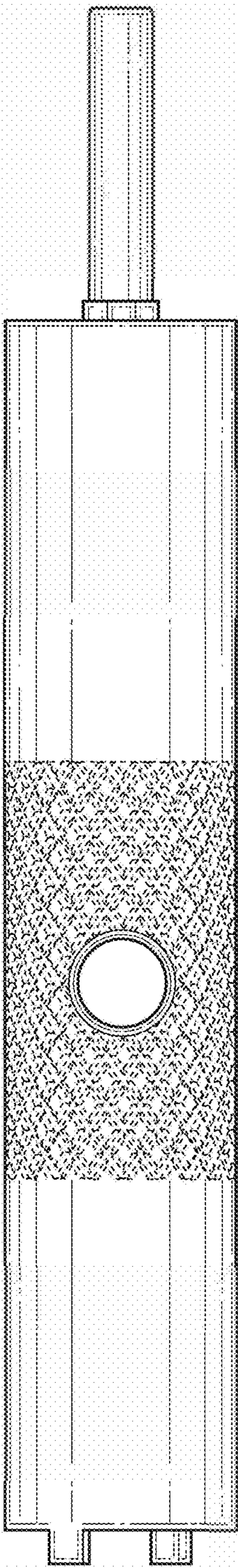

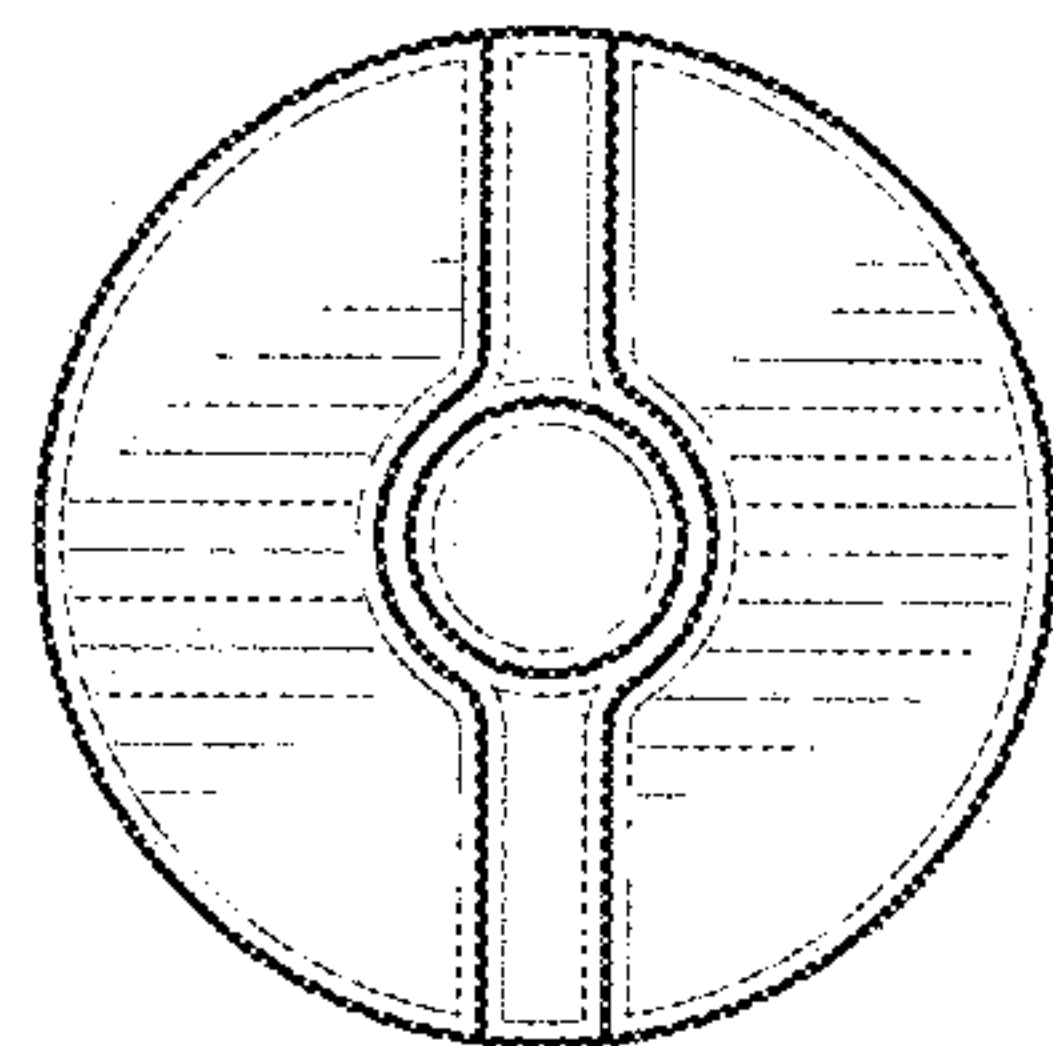

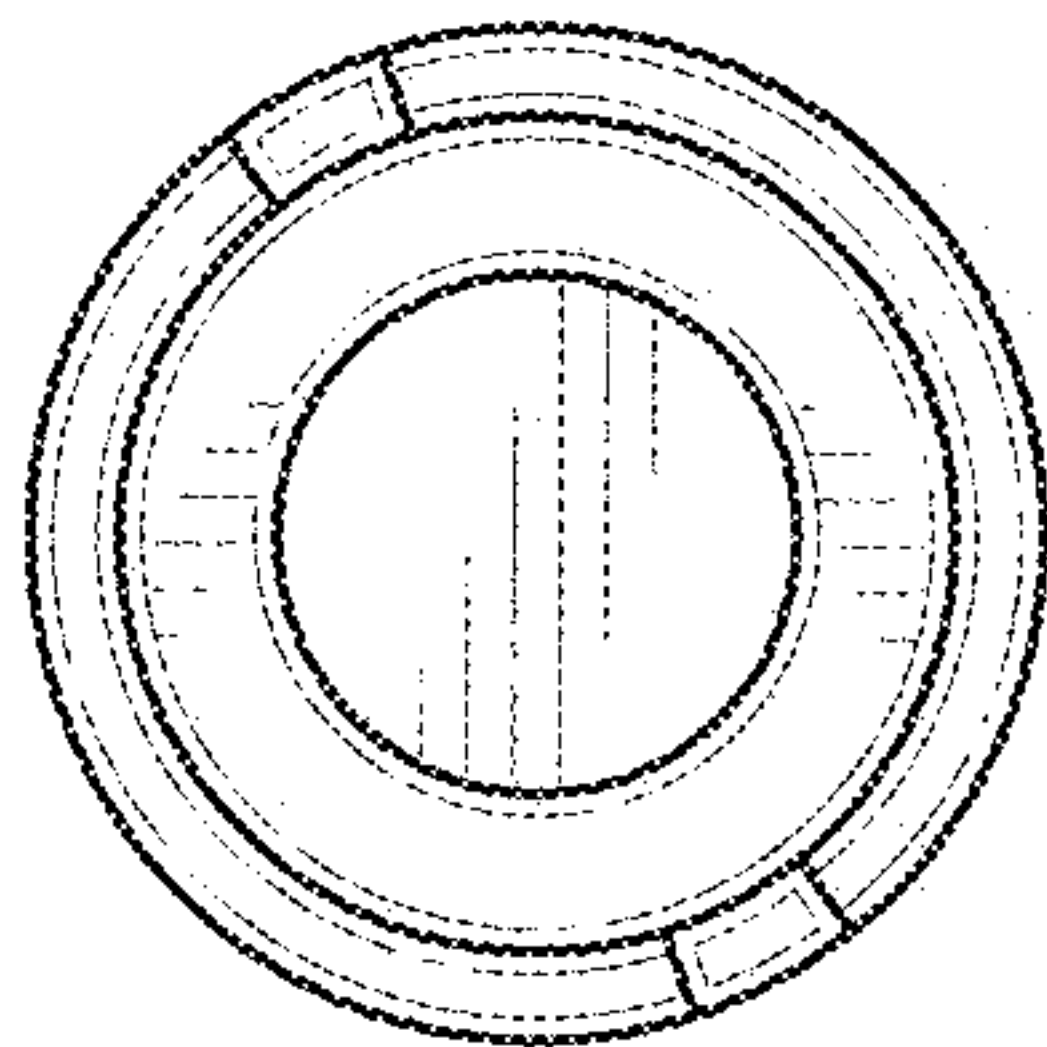
