DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof.

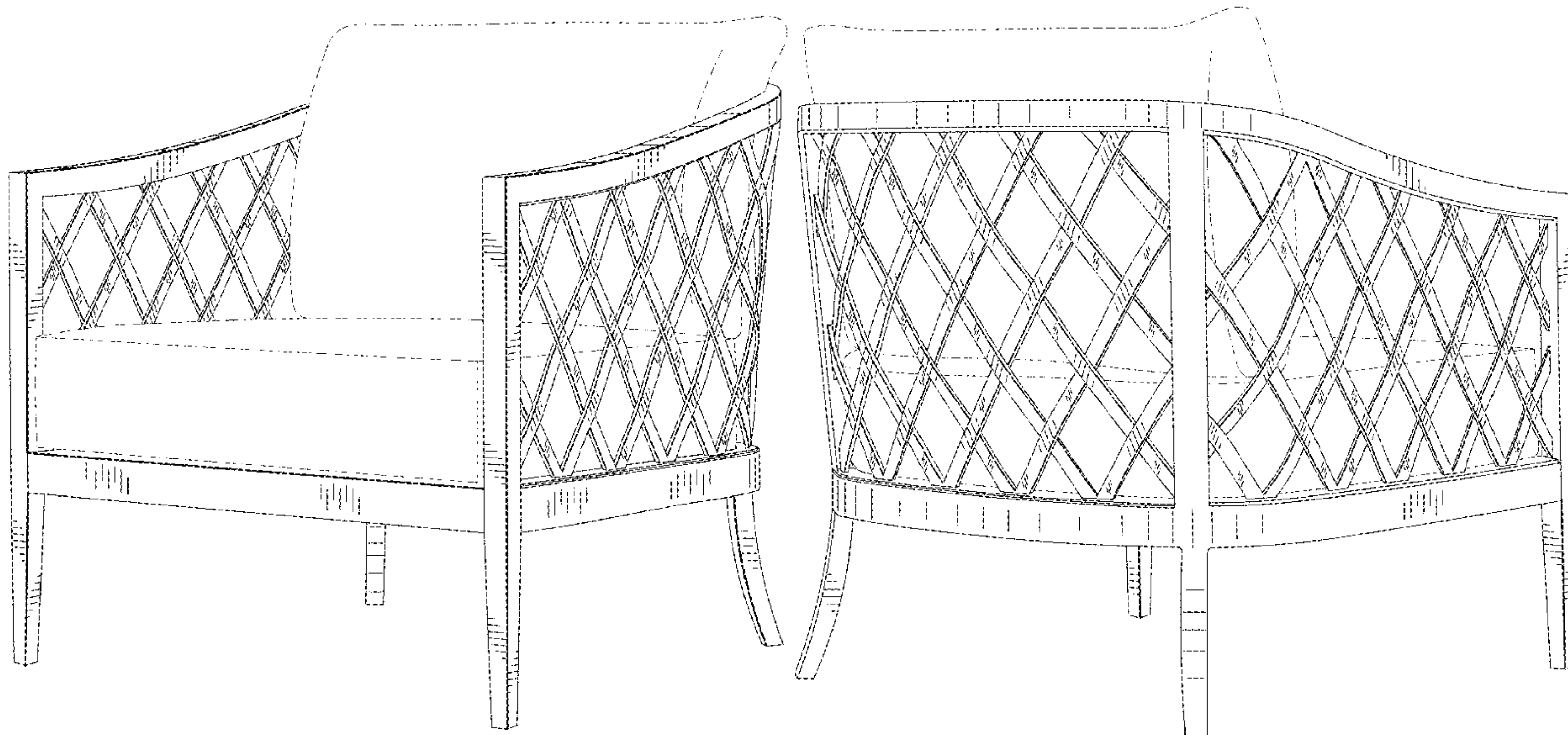

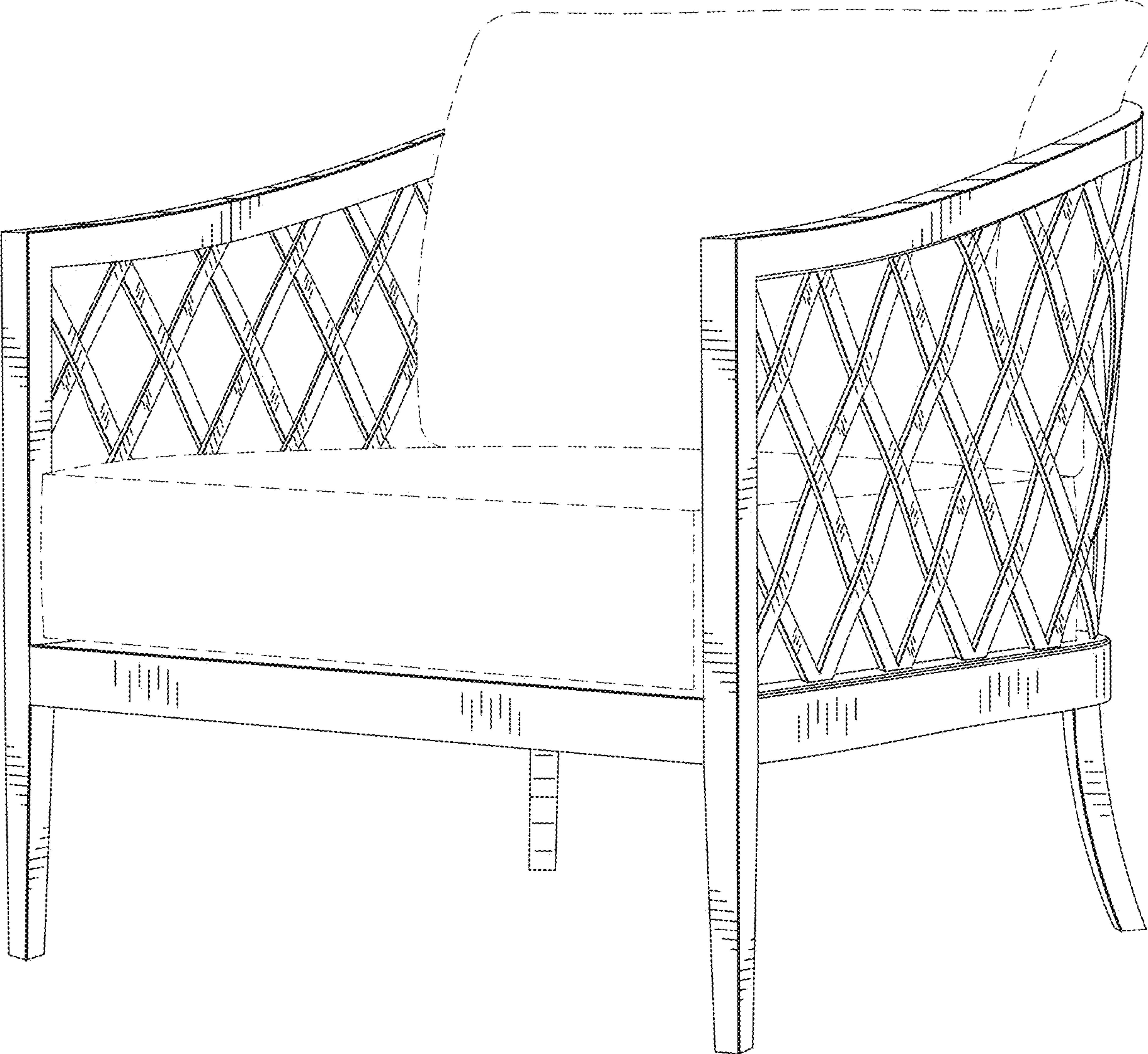

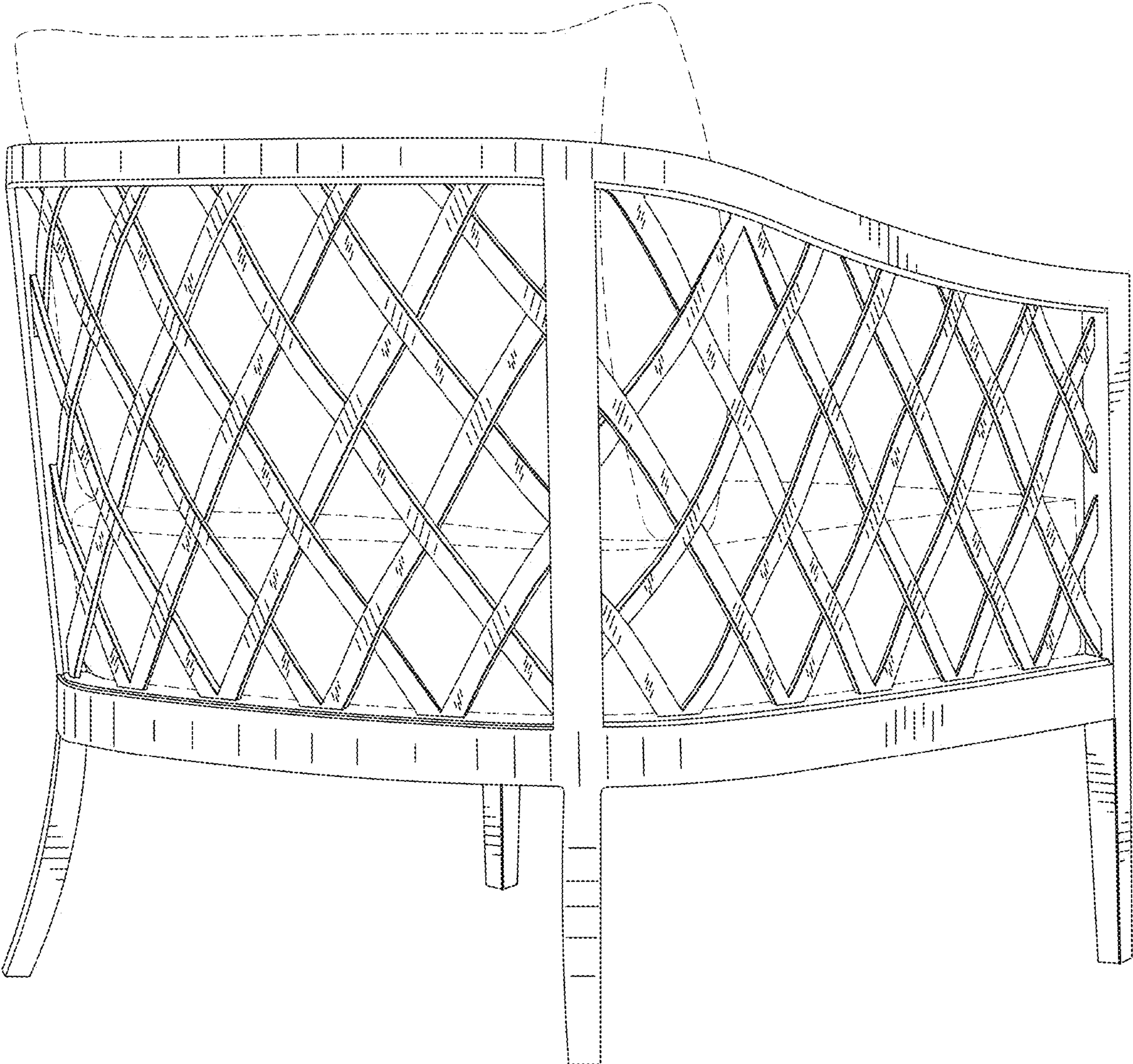

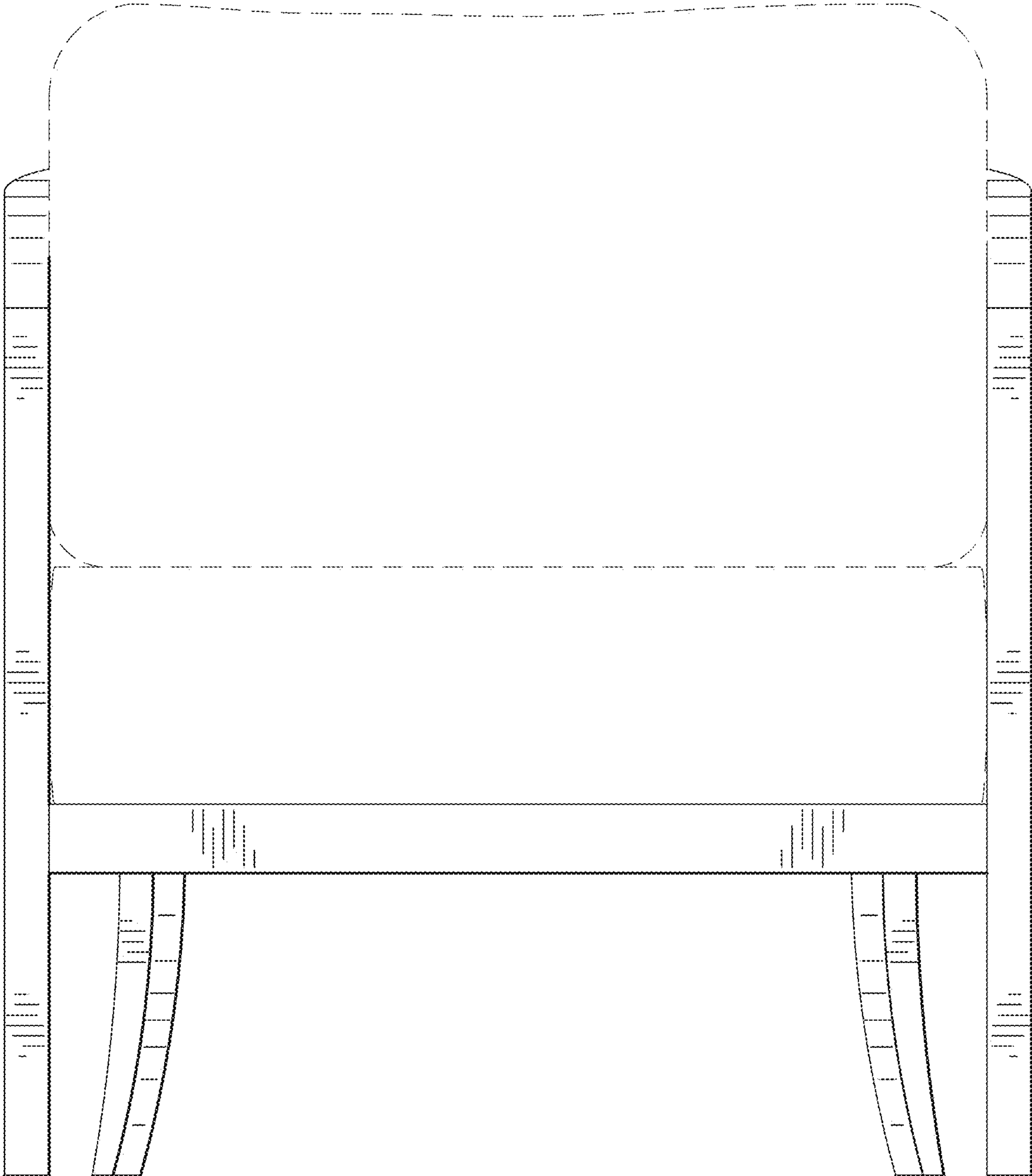

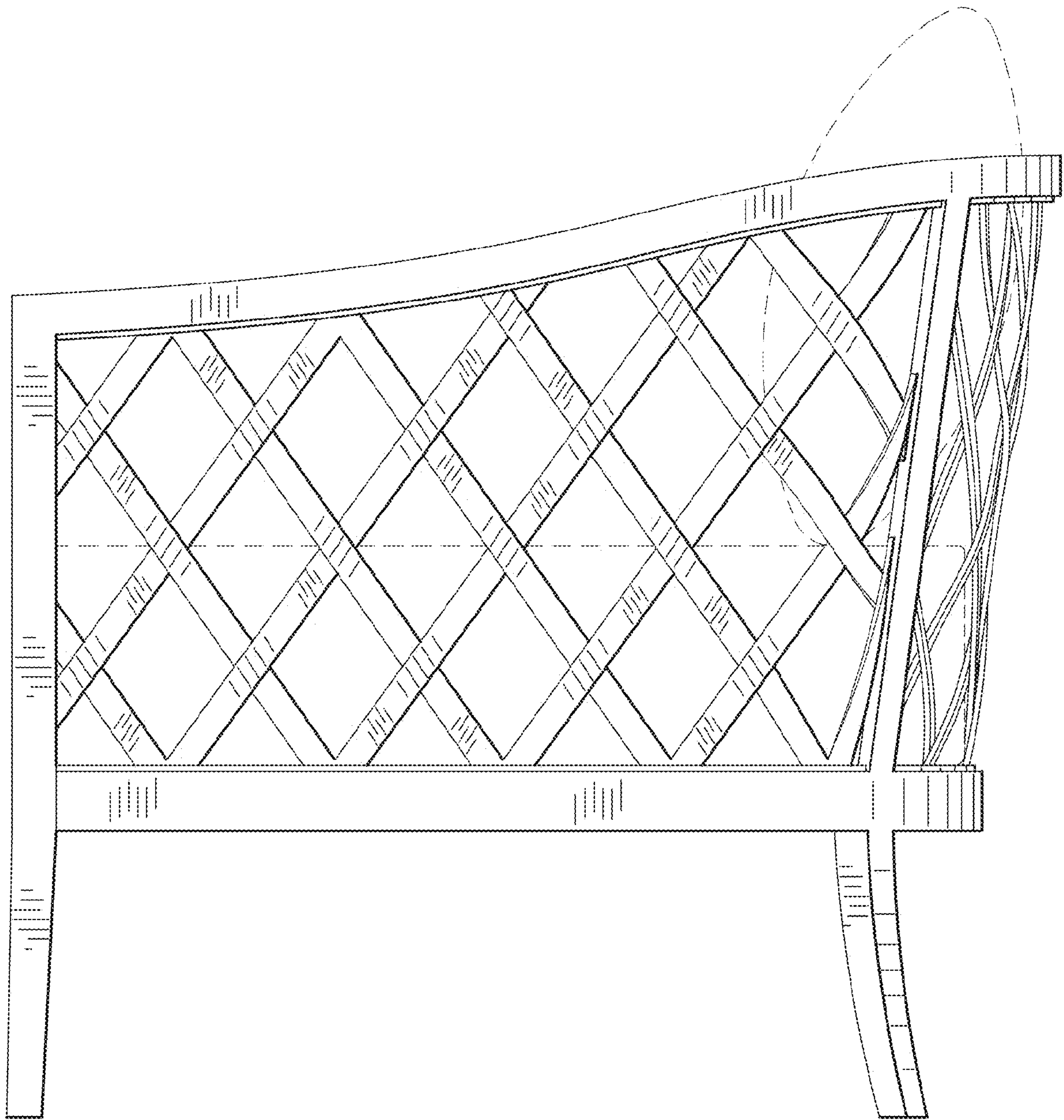

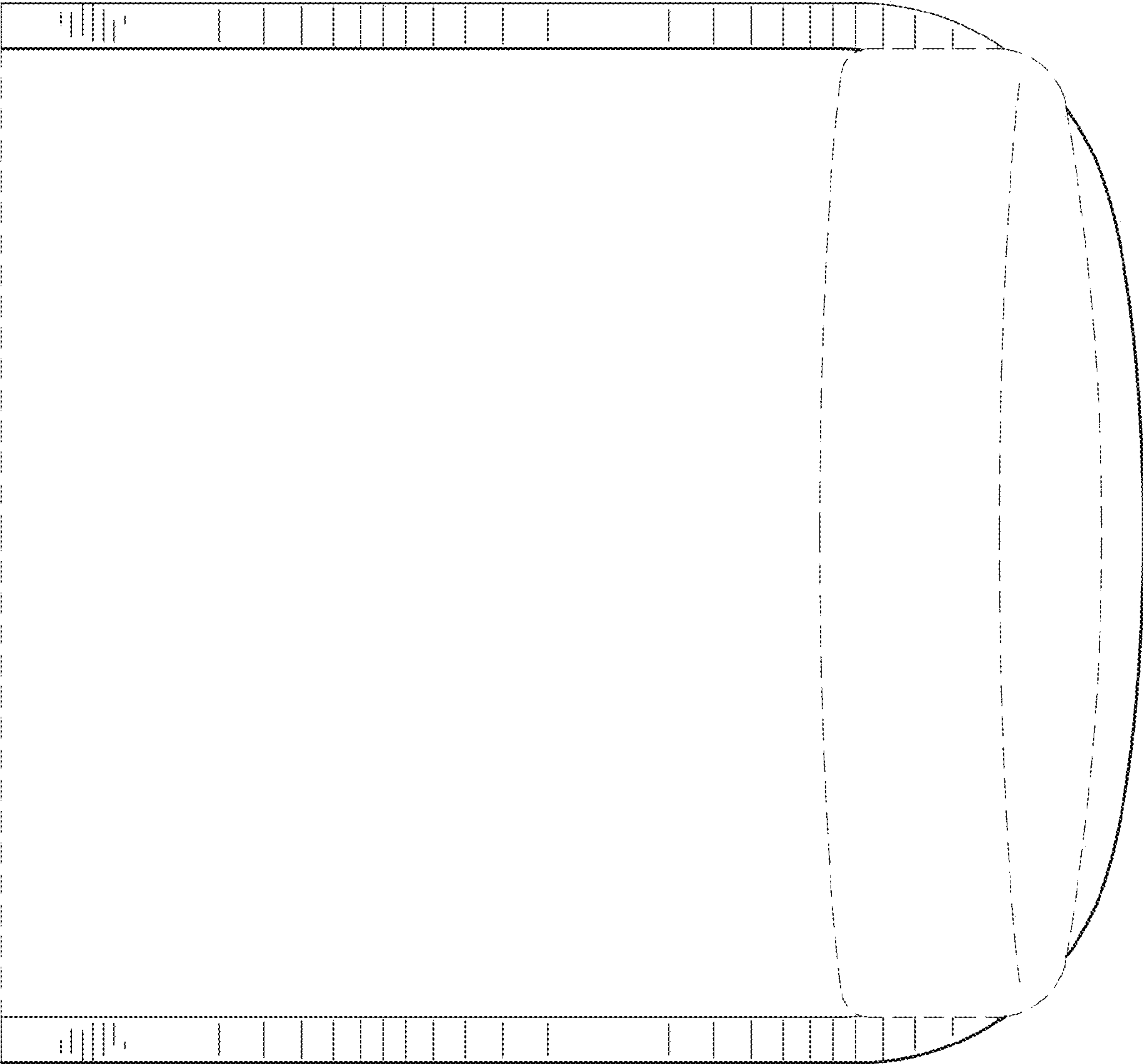
