(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bath cabinet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right perspective view, the left perspective view thereof being symmetrical to the right perspective view.

FIG. 2 is a front view.

FIG. 3 is a right upper view, the left upper view thereof being symmetrical to the right upper view.

FIG. 4 is a left upper view, the right upper view thereof being symmetrical to the left upper view.

FIG. 5 is a top view.

FIG. 6 is a front right side perspective view, the front left side perspective view thereof being symmetrical to the front right side perspective view.

FIG. 7 is a right upper perspective view, the left upper perspective view thereof being symmetrical to the right upper perspective view; and,

FIG. 8 is a front left perspective view, the front right perspective view thereof being symmetrical to the front left perspective view.

The back and bottom sides are unclaimed and unornamented.

The surface of the bath cabinet is understood to have a glossy, shiny surface overall. The appearance of any reflected objects or shadows on the bath cabinet surface is not part of the claimed design.

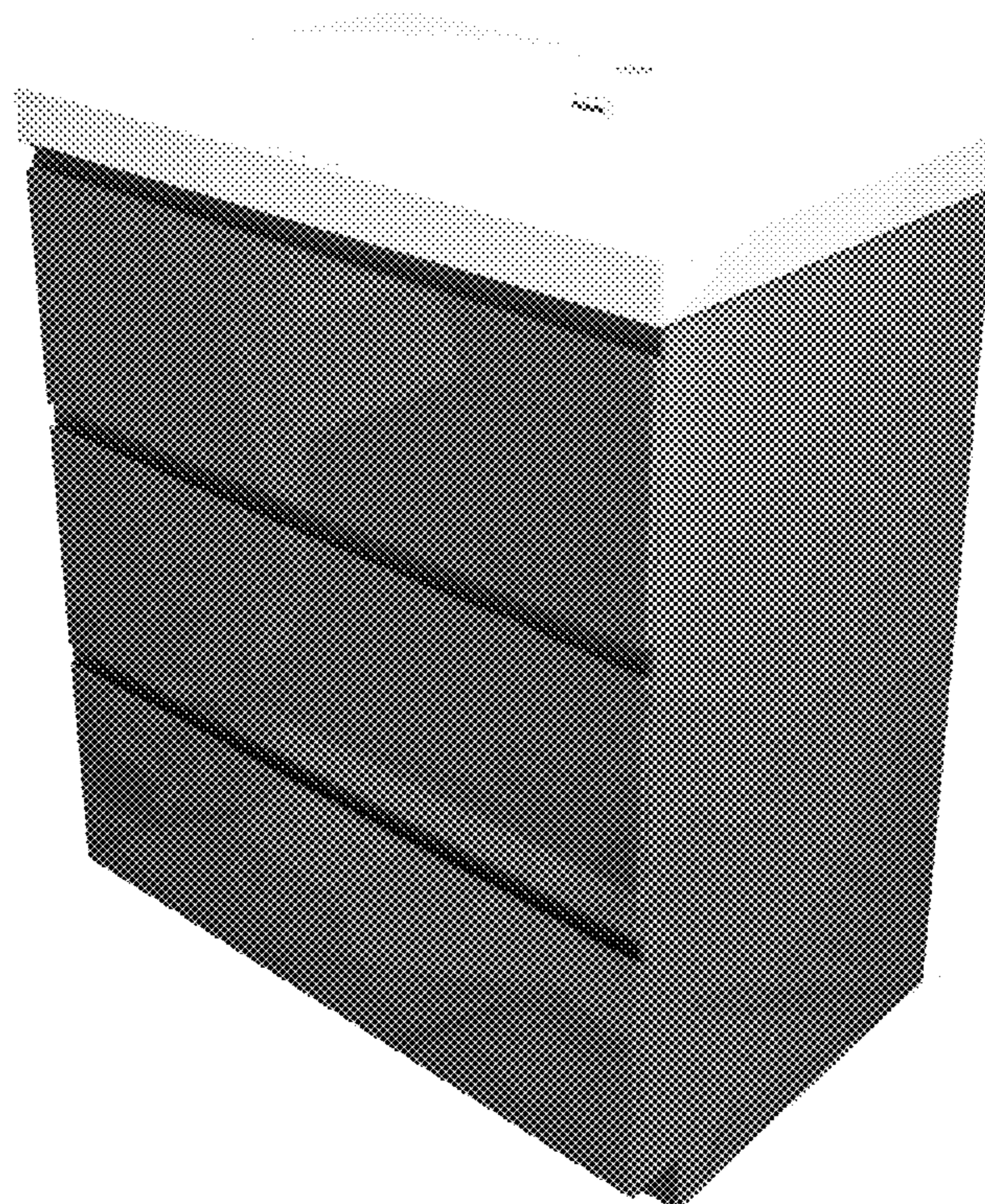

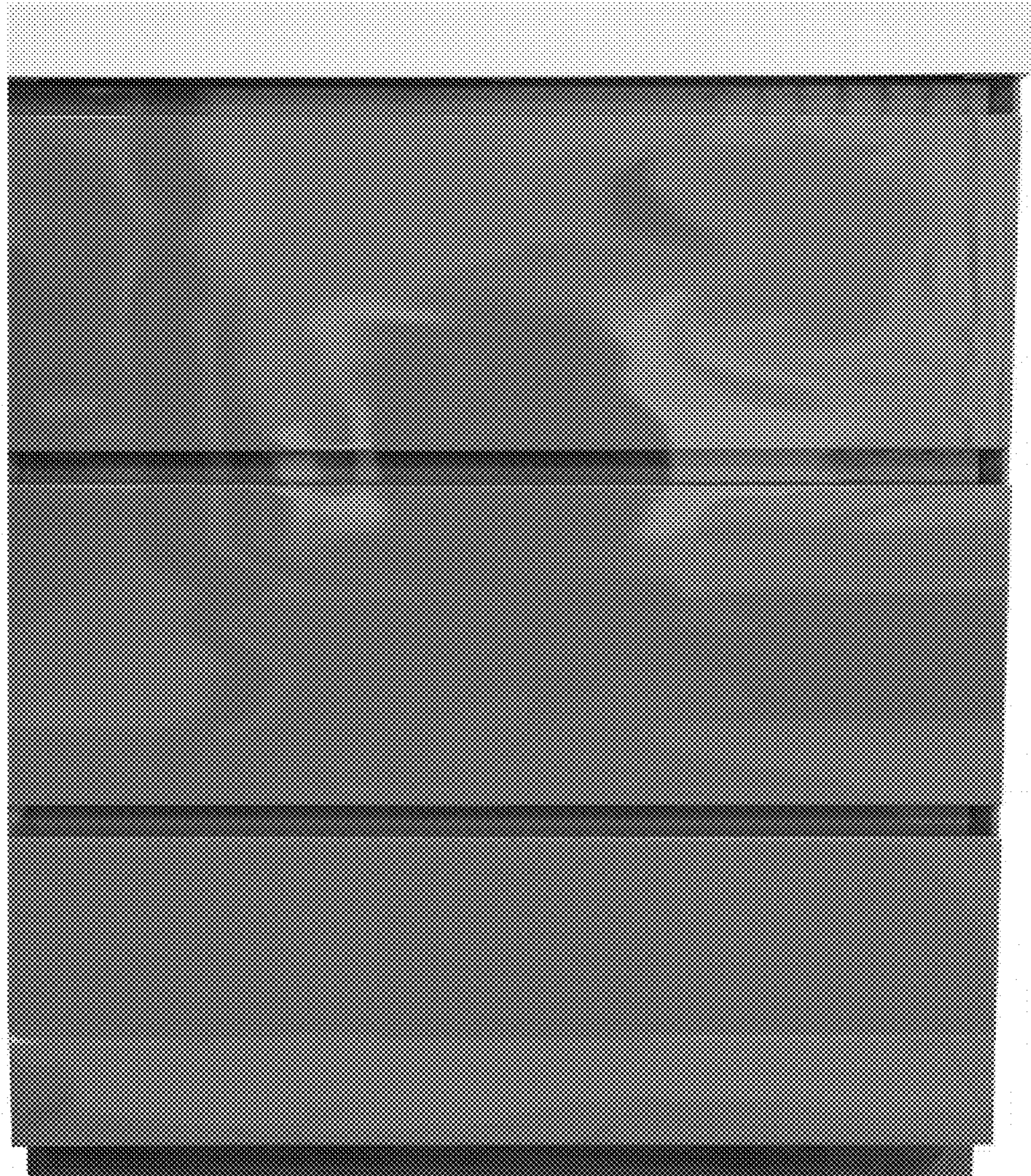

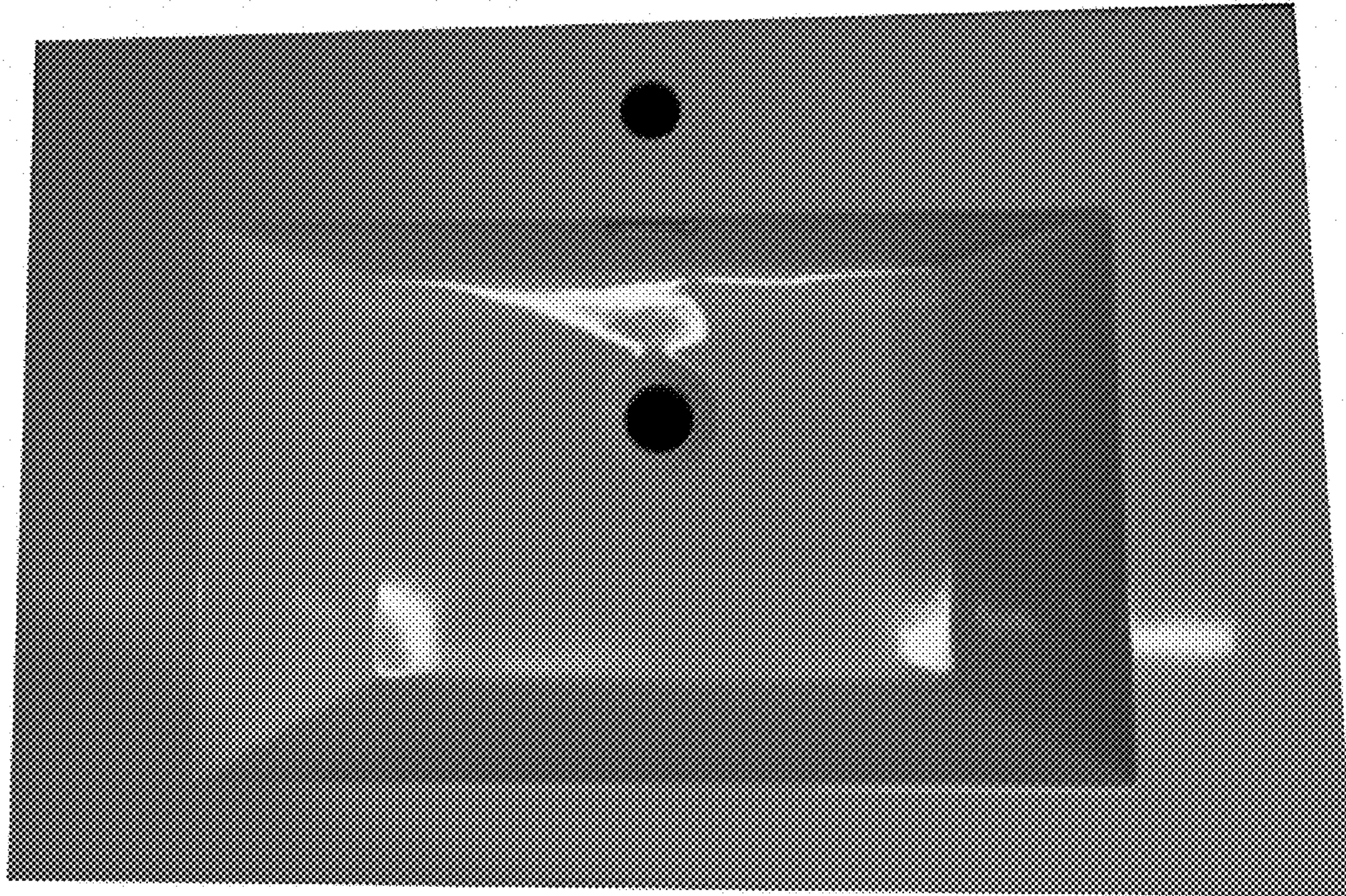
